DESIGN FOR A CARPET.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 15,573, dated November 25, 1884.

Application filed September 12, 1884. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Noric Komori, of New York city, in the county and State of New York, have invented and produced by my own industry, genius, efforts, and expense a new and original Design for a Carpet, of which the following is a correct description, reference being had to the annexed photograph, which represents a face view of my new carpet.

This invention relates to new ornamentation of a carpet, oil-cloth, or similar fabric; and it consists of the novel grouping and outlines of figures hereinafter described. In the accompanying photograph, the letters A A represent snail-like ornaments of 15 varying sizes, over which are thrown leaf-like figures B, C, D, E, F, G, H, and I. I claim—

The design for carpet or other fabric, the same consisting of the figures A, B, C, D, E, 20 F, G, H, and I, substantially as shown.
