

DESIGN FOR A CARPET.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 15,989, dated March 24, 1885.

Application filed February 13, 1895. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ARTHUR L. HALLIDAY, a resident of Yonkers, in the county of West-chester and State of New York, have invented and produced, by my own industry, genius, efforts, and expense, a new and original Design for a Carpet, of which the following is a full description, in connection with the accompanying photograph, which represents a face view of my new design for a carpet.

This invention relates to a new ornamentation of the face of a carpet, oil-cloth, or analogous fabric.

In the accompanying photograph are represented the various parts which enter into my new design.

A is a leaf-like figure surrounded along its outline by flower-like figures a. B is another fan-like figure containing floral decorations b. The two figures A and B are conceed by floral ornaments d and e and placed between two stripes, C and D.

I claim—

The design for a carpet, the same consisting of the figures A, B, C, D, a, b, d, and e, sub-25 stantially as shown.
