DESIGN FOR A CARPET.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 16,052, dated April 21, 1885.

Application filed February 7, 1885. Term of patent 31 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ARTHUR L. HALLIDAY, a resident of Yonkers, in the county of West- Howers thereon. chester and State of New York, have invented 5 and produced, by my own industry, genius, efforts, and expense, a new and original Design for a Carpet, of which the following is a full description, in connection with the accompanying photograph, which represents a face to view of my new design for a carpet.

This invention relates to a new ornamentation of the face of a carpet, oil-cloth, or analogous fabric.

In the accompanying photograph are rep-15 resented the various parts which enter into my new design.

A is a group of flowers adjoining the angular figure B and rosette C, and bearing the branch D, which is studded with star-like 20 flowers.

E is a group of geometrical figures bearing a floral group, F, from which a series of stems, G, that are studded with star-like flowers, project.

H is a group of flowers and leaves, which 25 group also carries a stem, I, having star-like

J is a geometrical figure connected with branches that carry flowers, and L is another geometrical figure, which connects with 30 branches and flowers.

I claim—

1. The design for a carpet, the same consisting of the figures A, B, C, and D, substantially as shown.

2. The design for a carpet, the same consisting of the figures E, F, and G, substantially as shown.

3. The design for a carpet, the same consisting of the figures H, I, and J, substantially as 40 shown.

4. The design for a carpet, the same consisting of the figures A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J, and L, substantially as shown. ARTHUR L. HALLIDAY.
