

DESIGN FOR GIMP.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 16,144, dated June 30, 1885.

Application filed May 14, 1885. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

it known that I, HENRY WYNKOOP, a citizen of the United States, residing in the city and county of Philadelphia, State of Pennsylvania, have invented and produced a new and original Design for Gimp, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.

10 The leading feature of my design is a figure having one side stair-shaped in reversed directions, and the opposite side a right or straight line the entire length thereof.

15 A represents a piece of gimp having a well-known heading, *a*.

On the face of the piece is a series of figures, B, each having one side, *b*, right-lined, and the

opposite side, *c*, stair-shaped in reversed directions—that is to say, the lower half of the side is stair shaped from the bottom to the center, and the upper half of said side is similarly shaped from the center to the top, excepting that the upper stairs are inverted.

I claim—

A design for gimp, having a figure which on one side is a straight or right line the entire length thereof, and stair-shaped in reverse directions on the other side, as shown and described.
