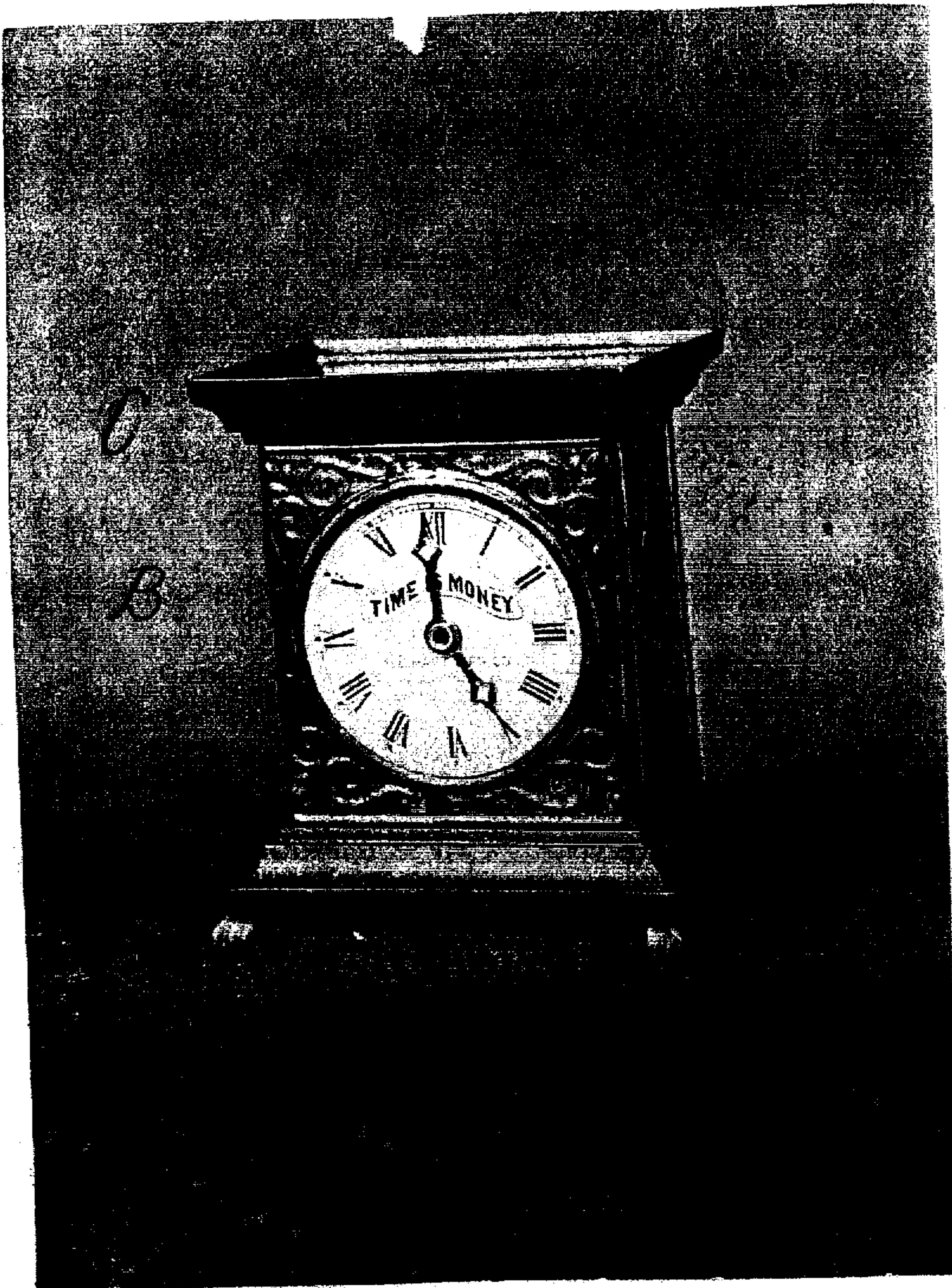

DESIGN FOR A TOY BANK.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 16,146, dated July 7, 1885.

Application filed April 24, 1885. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, HENRY C. HART, of Detroit, in the county of Wayne and State of Michigan, have invented a new and original
5 Design for Toy Banks, of which the following is a specification.

In the accompanying drawing, the figure represents a perspective view of my design for a toy bank.

10 The bank is made of a base-molding, A, an ornamented body, B, on which is a clock-dial and a pair of clock-hands, and a top molding, C, the whole resembling an ornamental clock.

What I claim is—

The design for a toy bank herein shown and 15 described, the same consisting of the ornamented body B, provided along its front and sides with base and top moldings, A and C, of the configuration shown, and on its front with the clock-face.
