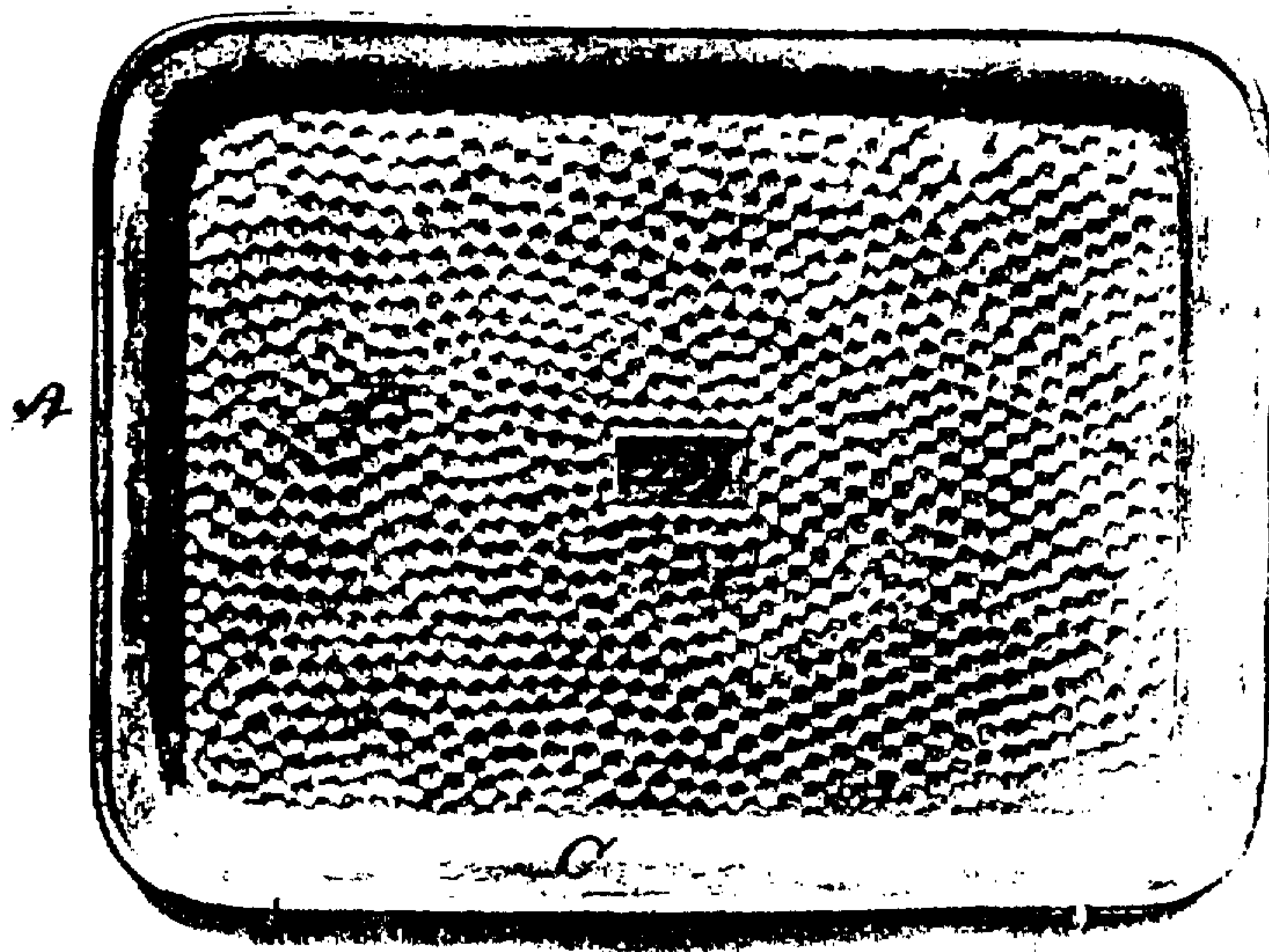

DESIGN FOR A TRAY.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 16,150, dated July 7, 1885,

Application filed May 14, 1885. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, AUGUST LEDIG, a citizen of the United States, residing in the city and county of Philadelphia, State of Pennsylvania, have invented and produced a new and original Design for Trays, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying photographic illustration, forming part thereof.

10 The leading feature of my design is an indented face with a central plain field, which relieves the apparent uniformity of said indented face.

15 A represents a tray having an indented face, B, a plain rim, C, and a central plain field, D, the rim C being beaded.

I claim—

1. The design for a tray herein shown and described, the same consisting of the central flat field, D, the exterior plain rim, C, and the indented face B between the field and rim. 20

2. The design for a tray, consisting of a central plain field, D, the indented face B, and the plain and beaded rim C, as herein described and shown.
