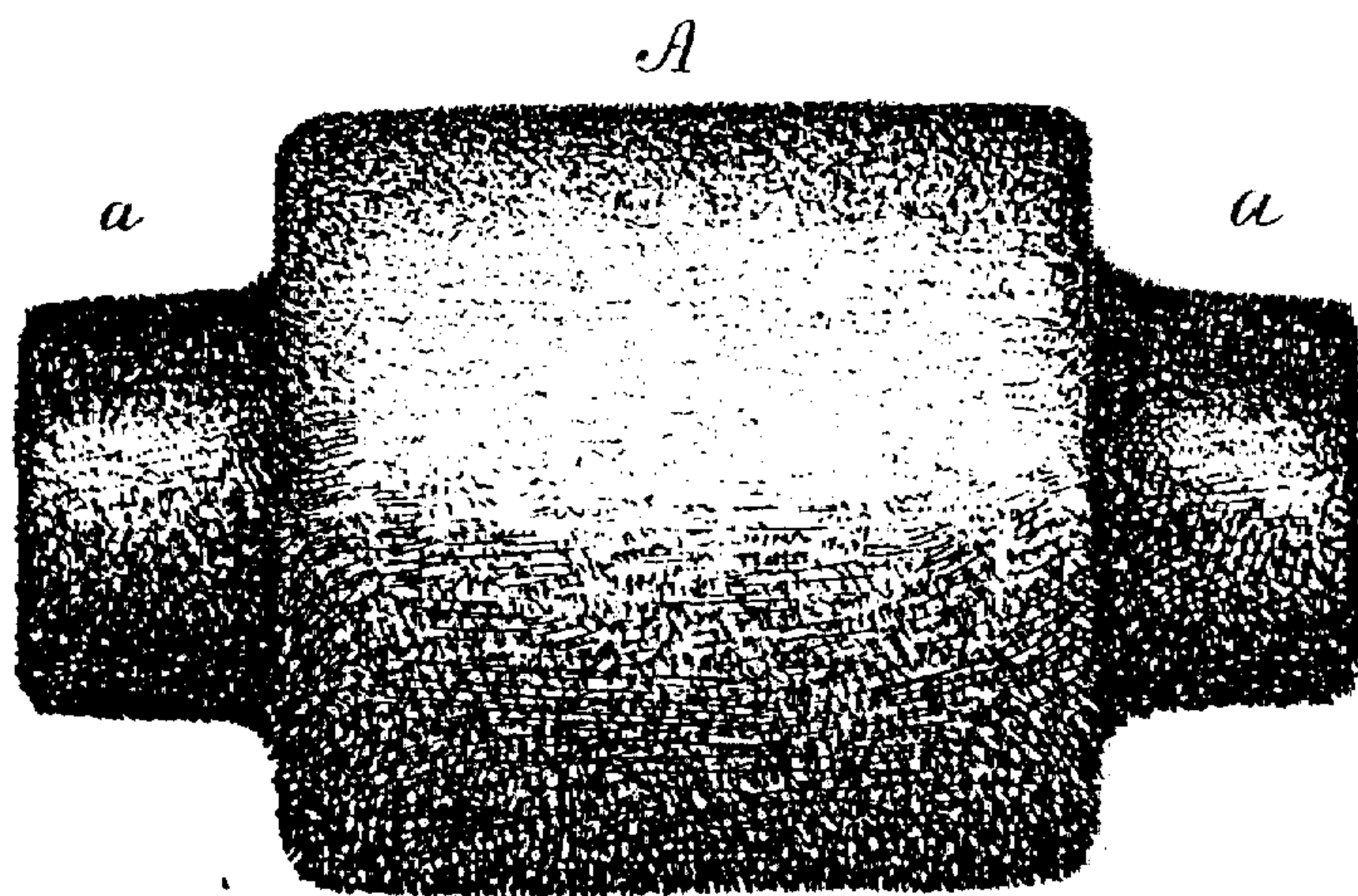

DESIGN FOR A MUFF.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 16,644, dated April 20, 1886.

Application filed October 28, 1885. Serial No. 181,203. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JACOB A. SPITZER, a citizen of the United States, residing in the city of Philadelphia, in the county of Philadelphia, in the State of Pennsylvania, have
5 invented and produced a new and original Design for Muffs, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
10 The figure is a front elevation of my newly-designed muff, which figure of itself fully illustrates my design.
The design consists, as shown in the accom-

panying drawing, of the outer body portion, A, of the muff, having its end portions reduced to form extensions *a a* at each side.

I claim—

The design for a muff herein described, the same consisting in the outer body portion, A, having its ends reduced to form projecting ex-
20 tensions *a a*, substantially as set forth.
