Application filed April 8, 1886. Serial No. 198,310. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, SIGMUND LOEWENHERZ, a citizen of the United States, residing at New York, in the county and State of New York,
5 have invented and produced a new and original Design for Ornamenting Leather and Fabrics, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
10 The accompanying drawing fully represents said design, and is sufficient, without further aid, to enable any person skilled in the art to reproduce the same for practical use.

The colors employed for the different por-

tions of this design may be varied to suit the convenience or taste of the manufacturer. 15

The design for ornamenting leather and fabrics, as shown. 20
