

DESIGN FOR A PICTURE OR LOOKING-GLASS FRAME.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 16,965, dated November 2, 1886.

Application filed August 17, 1886. Scrint Nov.211, 166. Term of patent 33 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Benjiamin S. Donahue, a citizen of the United States, residing at Brooklyn, in the county of Kings and State of New York, have invented and produced a new and original Design for the Ornamentation of Picture-Frames and Looking-Glasses, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a generally iew of my new design for picture frames or looking glasses. Fig. 2 is a side elevation of the same, these two views being deemed necessary to fully illustrate my design.

In the drawings, A represents a frame of

any suitable dimensions, with a central opening, B, intended for the neception of the picture or mirror, as may be desired. On the upper part of the frame a figure, C, representing 20 a kitten is mounted, as shown.

Having thus described my invention, what I chain as new therein, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for the omnumentation of picture: 25 or mirror frames: herein shown and described, the same consisting of a frame having the figure of a kitten mounted thereon.
