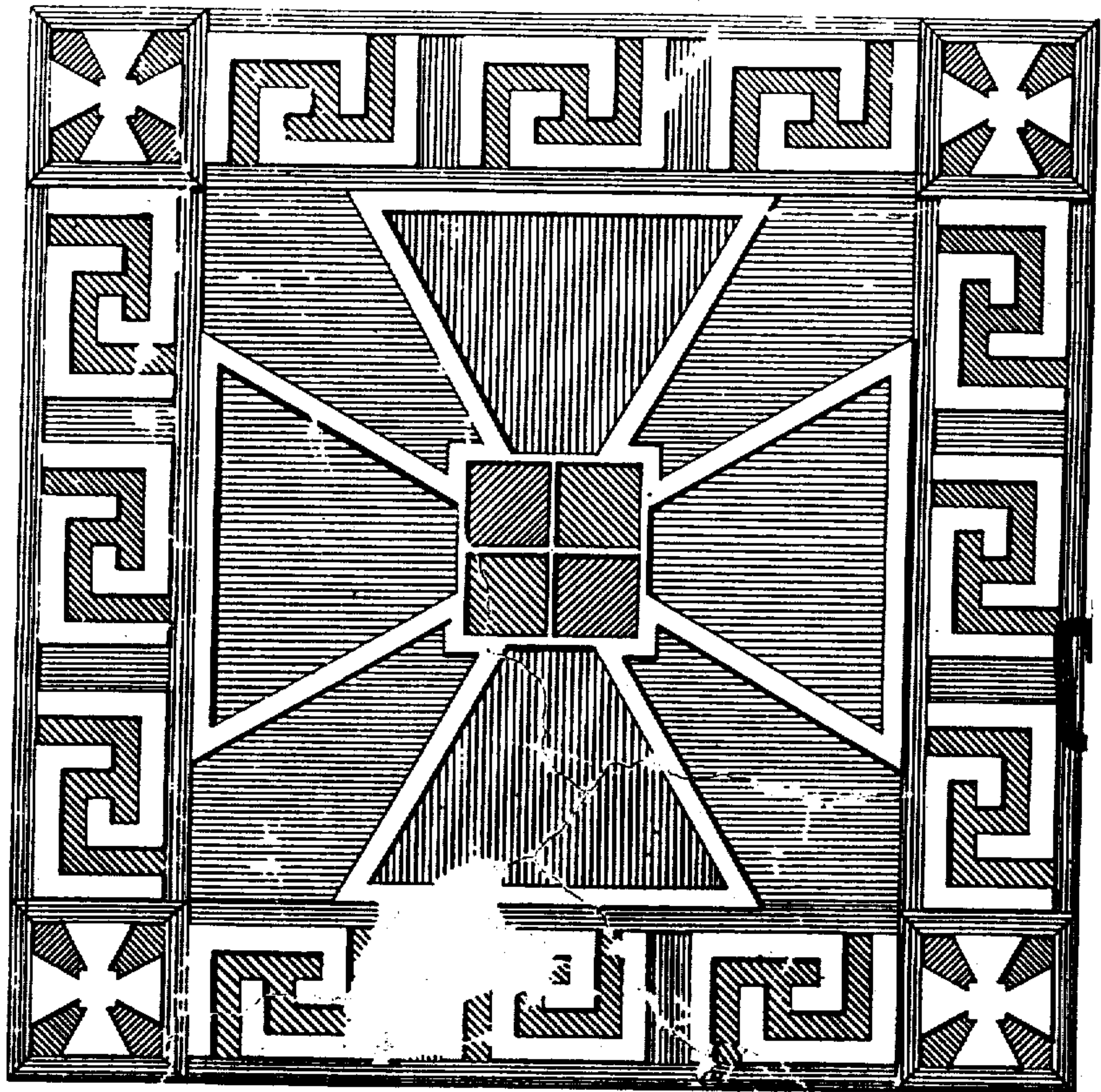

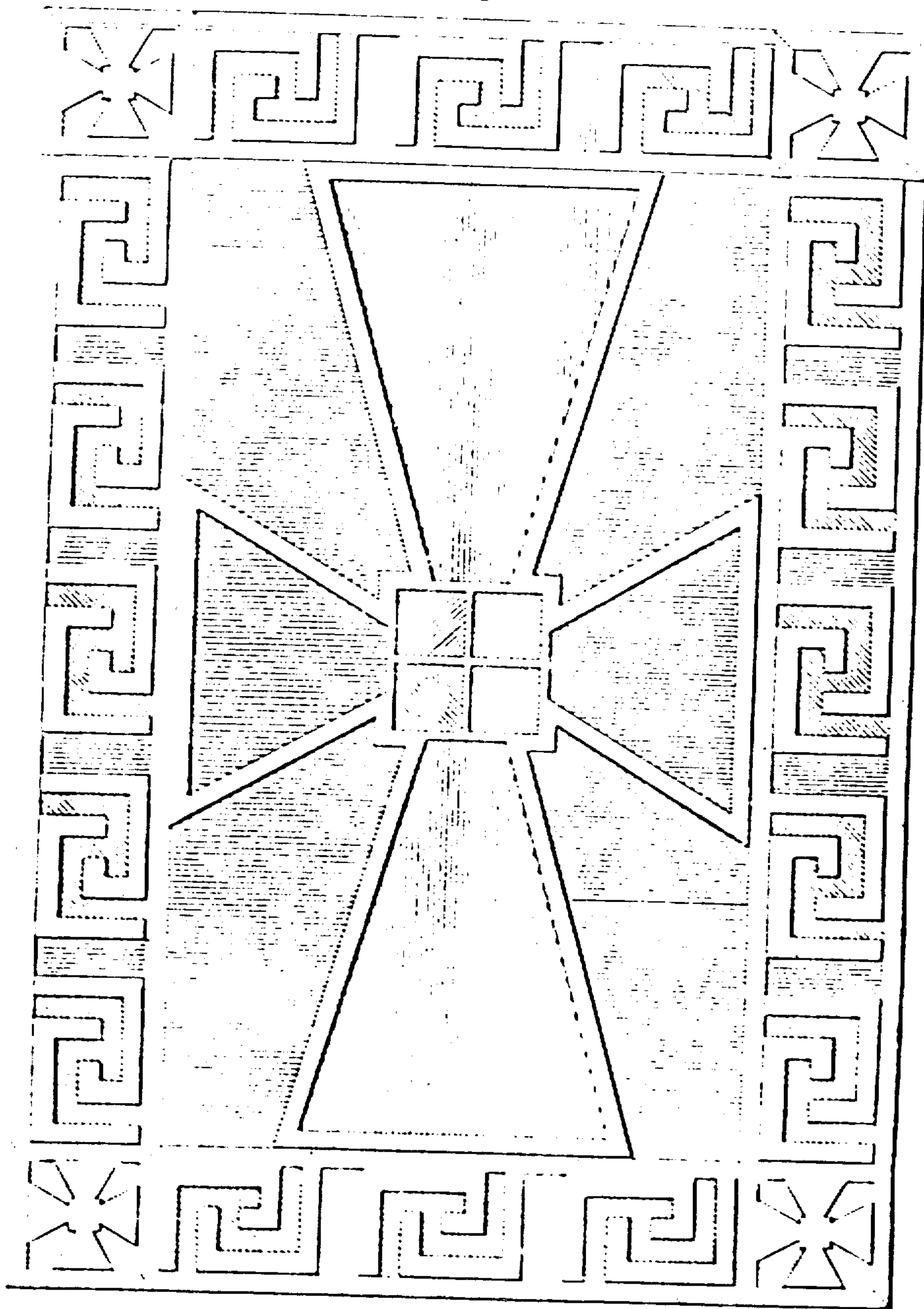

DESIGN FOR A MAT.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 16,982, dated November 9, 1886.

Application filed September 30, 1886. Serial No. 215,020. Term of patent 14 years

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, AMADEE SPADONE, a citizen of the United States, residing in the city, county, and State of New York, have invented and produced a new and original Design for a Mat, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings.

The nature of my design as developed in sheet-rubber is clearly illustrated in the drawings.

My design consists in a mat having a border made up of crosses or pattee and scroll-work and an inner piece or panel upon which is developed a pattee or cross, the whole wrought in relief upon a groundwork of similar material.

In the drawings, Figure 1, Sheet I, shows my design as applied to a square mat. Fig. 2, Sheet II, shows my design as applied to an elongated mat.

What I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for rubber mat herein shown and described, consisting of a border of pattee and scroll-work and an inner panel ornamented with enlarged pattee.
