

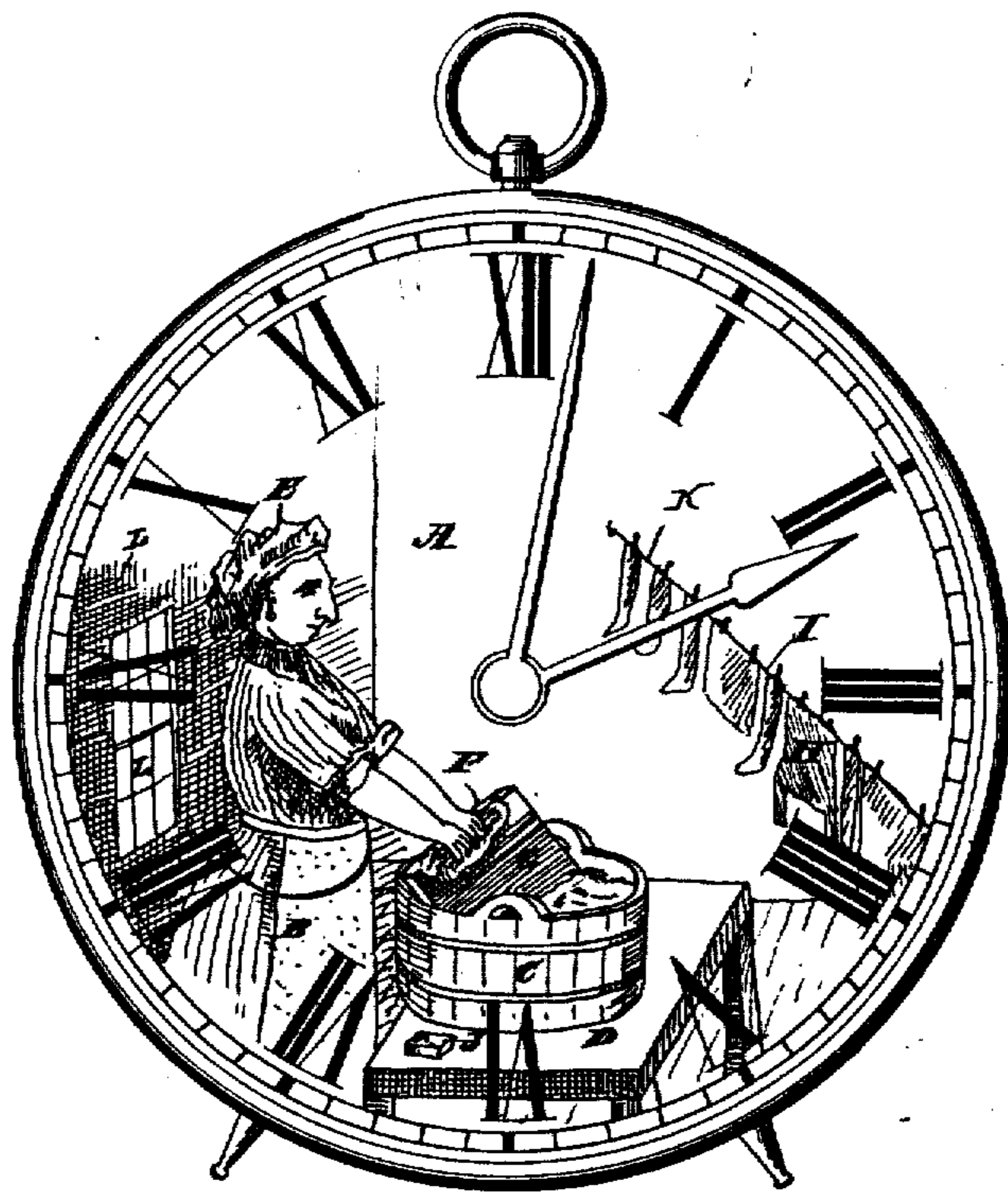

DESIGN FOR A CLOCK-DIAL.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 18,299, dated May 8, 1888.

Application filed May 3, 1887. Serial No. 237,014. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ARCHIBALD BANNA-
TYNE, residing at Waterbury, in the county of
New Haven and State of Connecticut, have in-
5 vented and produced a new and original De-
sign for Clock-Dials; and I do declare the fol-
lowing to be a full, clear, and exact descrip-
tion of the same, reference being had to the
accompanying drawing, which forms a part of
10 this specification.

The accompanying drawing is a view in front
elevation of a clock provided with a dial of my
design.

The leading feature of my design is a clock-
15 dial having upon its face the representation of
a washer-woman engaged in washing clothes.
The washer-woman B is shown at one side of
the picture. She is seen in profile, and wears
a cap or turban, E. She stands behind a
20 wash-bench, D, which supports a wash-tub, C,
containing a wash-board, G, on which is a gar-
ment, F, which she holds in both of her hands.

Opposite from her, and on the opposite side
of the picture, is seen a clothes-line, K, from
which assorted garments H are hung. A cake 25
of soap, J, is seen on the wash-bench. A house,
L, is seen behind the washer-woman, and forms
a foil for her.

I claim—

The design for a clock-dial herein shown and 30
described, the same consisting of a clock-dial
having upon its face the representation of a
washer-woman seen in profile at one side of
the picture, a wash-bench, a wash-tub sup-
ported on such bench, a wash-board in the 35
tub, a clothes-line, clothes hung out on such
line, and a house.
