

DESIGN FOR A STRAP.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 18,811, dated December 11, 1888.

Application filed October 30, 1888. Berial No. 289,561. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, EDWIN B. STIMPSON, of Brooklyn, in the county of Kings and State of New York, have invented and produced a new and original Design for a Strap, of which the following is a specification.

I will describe my design for straps in detail, and then point out the novel features in the claim.

The accompanying drawing illustrates a strap showing my design. This strap has substantially parallel side edges. Near each of these side edges is delineated a band composed of zigzag line a, extending lengthwise of the strap. About midway in the width of the strap, and also extending lengthwise there-

of, is delineated an intermediate band of intersecting zigzag lines, b. As shown, the inner points or angles of the zigzag of the two lines b meet each other.

What I claim as my design is—

The design for a strap having approximately-parallel side edges and a surface ornamentation consisting of bands composed of zigzag lines a and an intermediate band of 25 intersecting zigzag lines, b, substantially as shown and described.
