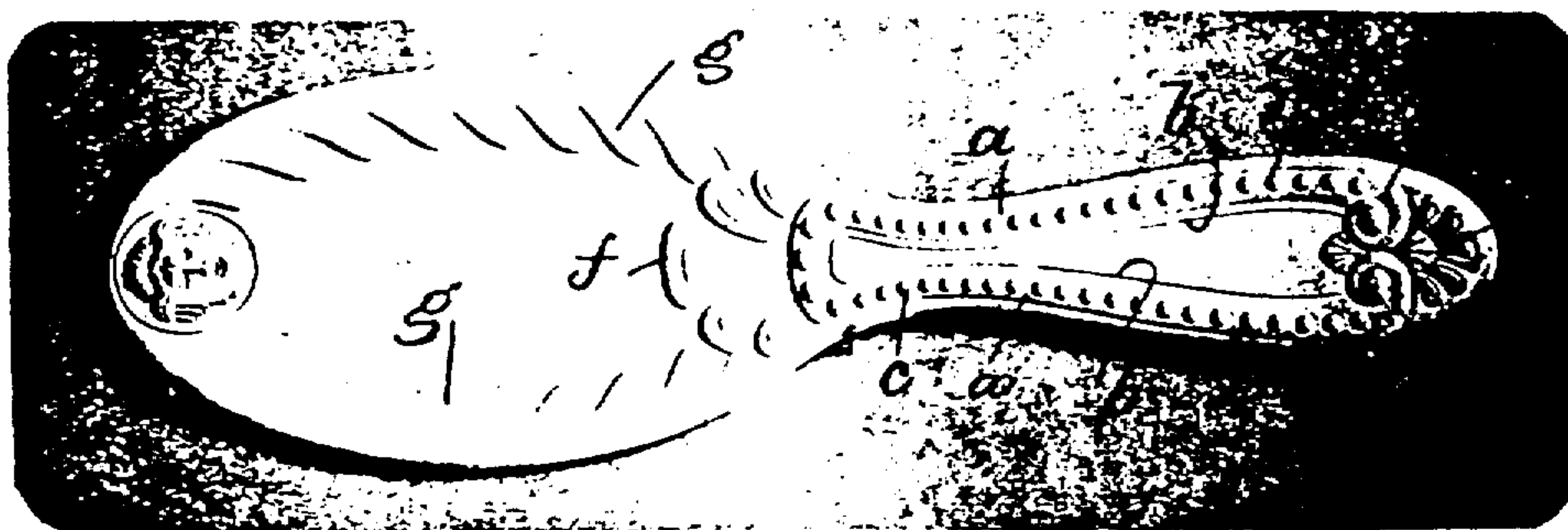

DESIGN FOR A BRUSH OR MIRROR BACK AND HANDLE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 19,045, dated April 9, 1889.

Application filed February 23, 1889. Serial No. 300,948. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILLIAM M. WELLING, of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented a new Design for a Brush and
5 Mirror Back and Handle, of which the following is a specification.

In the accompanying drawing I have shown by a photograph a view of the back of a brush with my new design thereon.

10 The leading feature of my design relates to the raised border ornaments. Around the border are raised ribs or moldings *a b*, with ornamental studs *c*, scroll ends *d*, and leaflet ornaments *e* and *f*, and there are compound

curved corrugations at *g* around the mirror 15 or brush back.

The medallion at *h* may or may not be a part of the ornament.

I claim—

The design for a mirror or brush back, consisting of the raised ornaments, substantially
20 as represented.
