DESCRIPTION

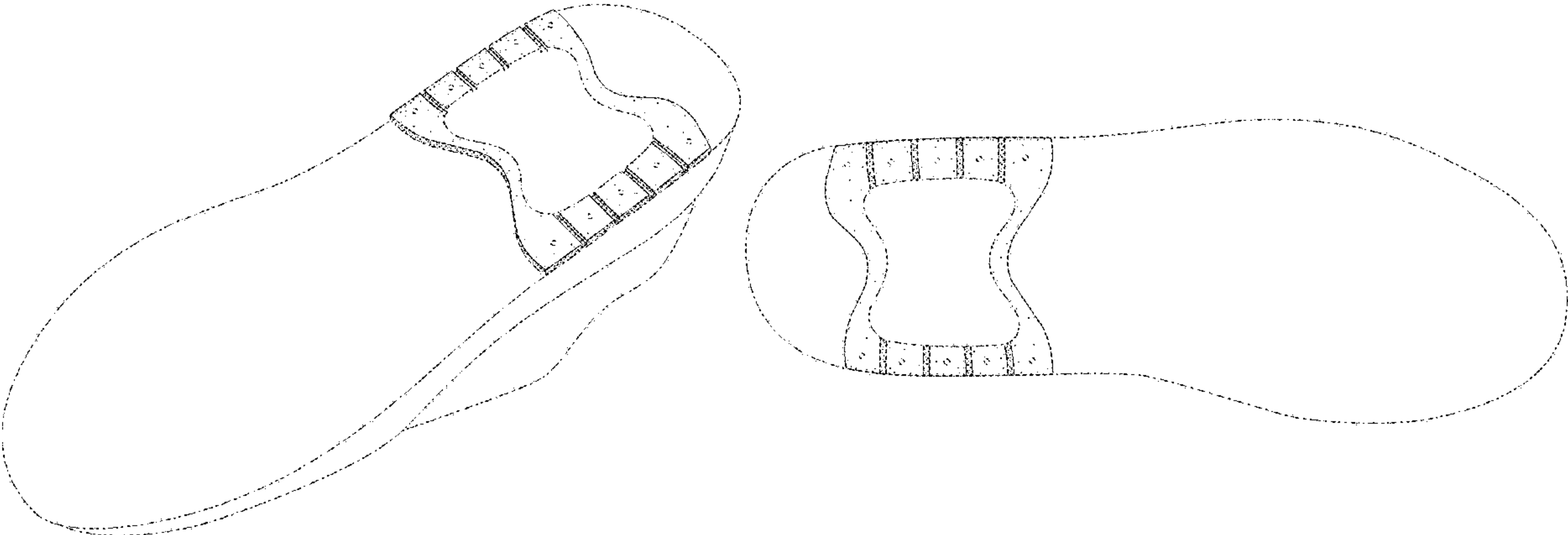
FIG. 1 is a front bottom perspective view of a shoe showing my new design;

The bowtie-shaped broken line and the unshaded region therein form no part of the claimed design. The ten small broken line circles represent tread features that form no part of the claimed design. The broken lines depicting the remainder of the shoe form no part of the claimed design.

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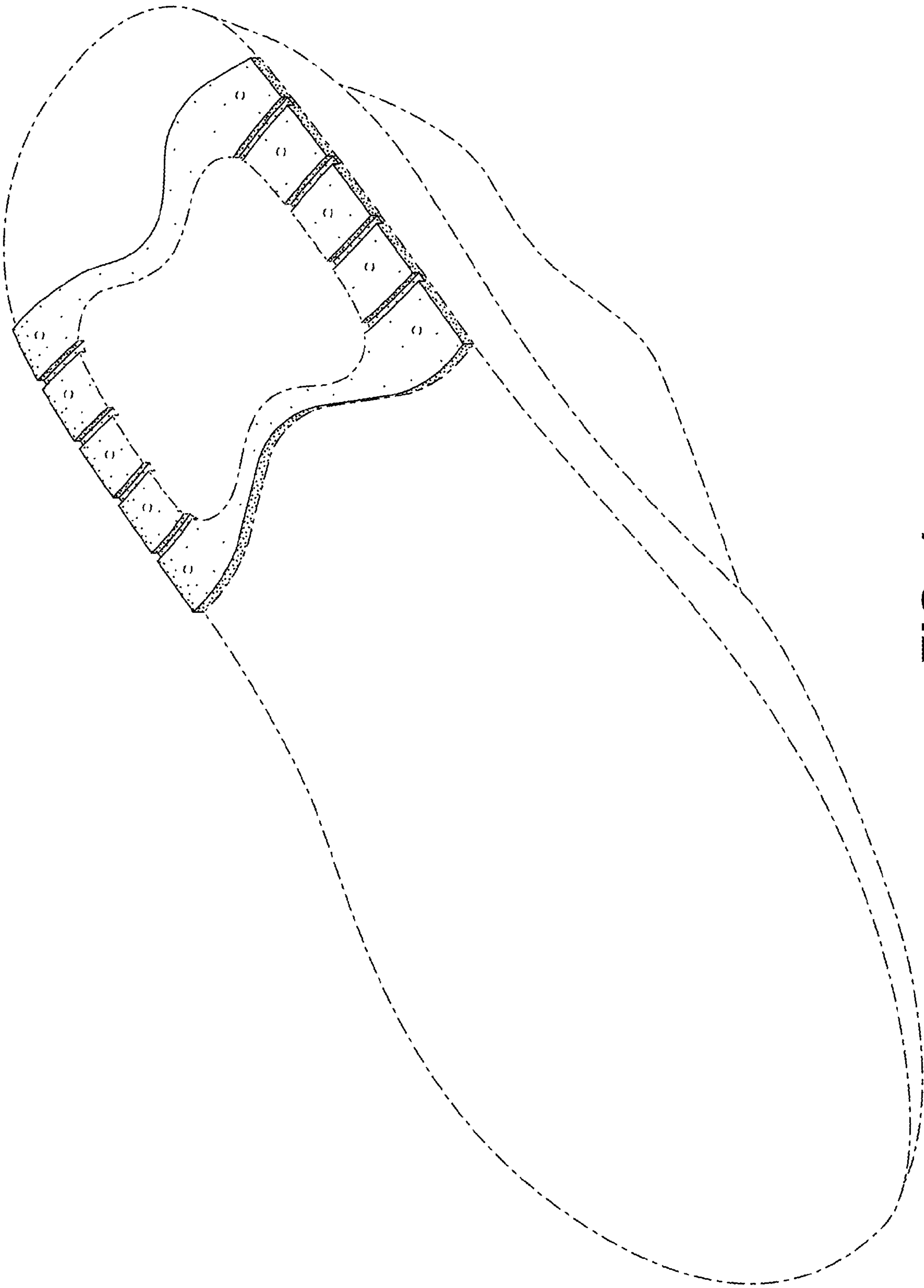

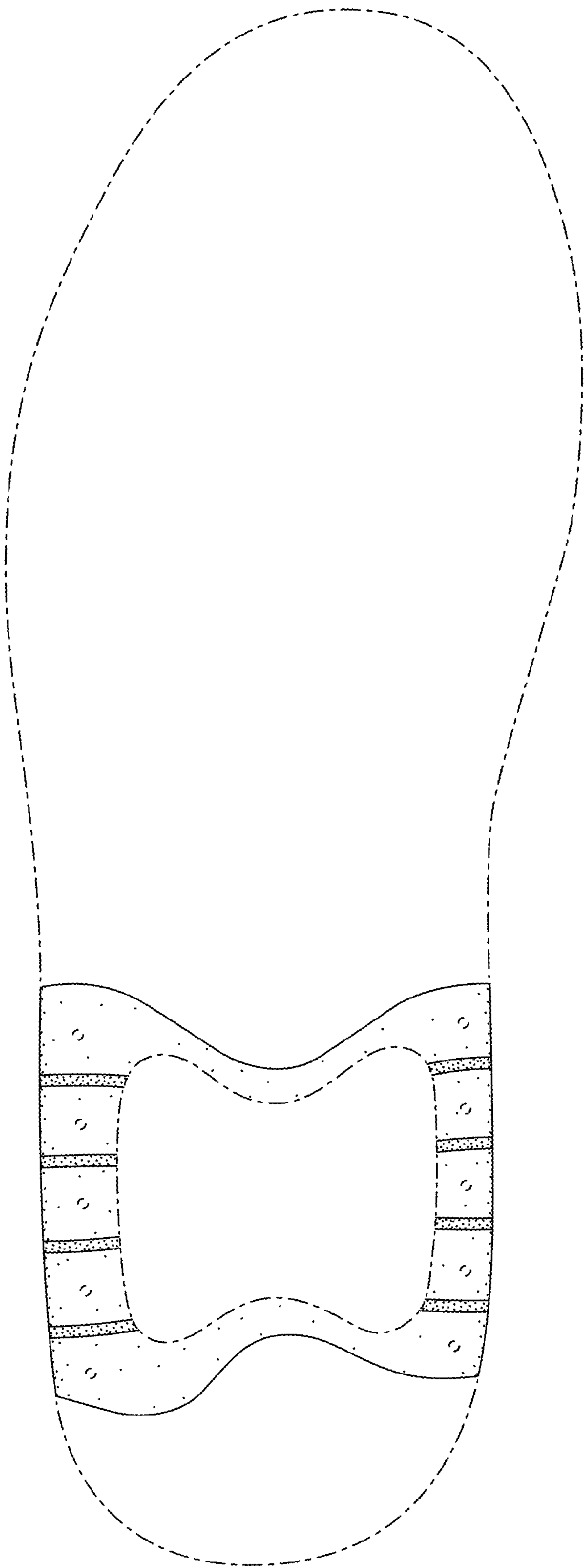

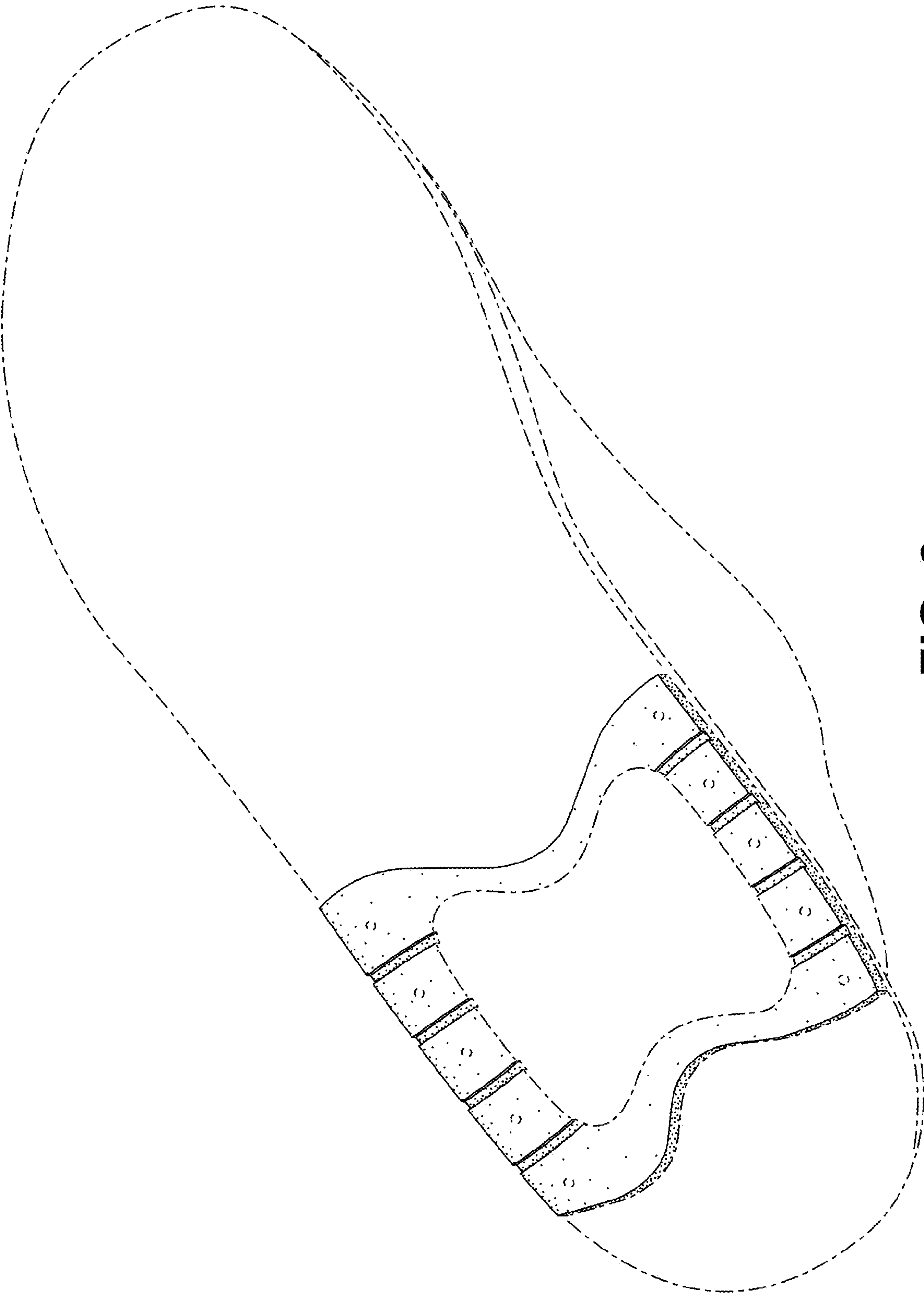
