(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a tool holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top, and right side perspective view of a tool holder showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevation view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 8 is a front, top, and right side perspective view thereof showing an attachment to a vertical pole; and,
FIG. 9 is a front, top, and right side perspective view thereof showing an attachment to a vertical pole and a holding of a tool, namely, a pair of needle nosed pliers.
The broken lines showing a vertical pole in FIGS. 8 and 9 are for illustration purposes and form no part of the claimed design.
The broken lines showing a tool, namely, a pair of needle nosed pliers, in FIG. 9 are for illustration purposes and form no part of the claimed design.

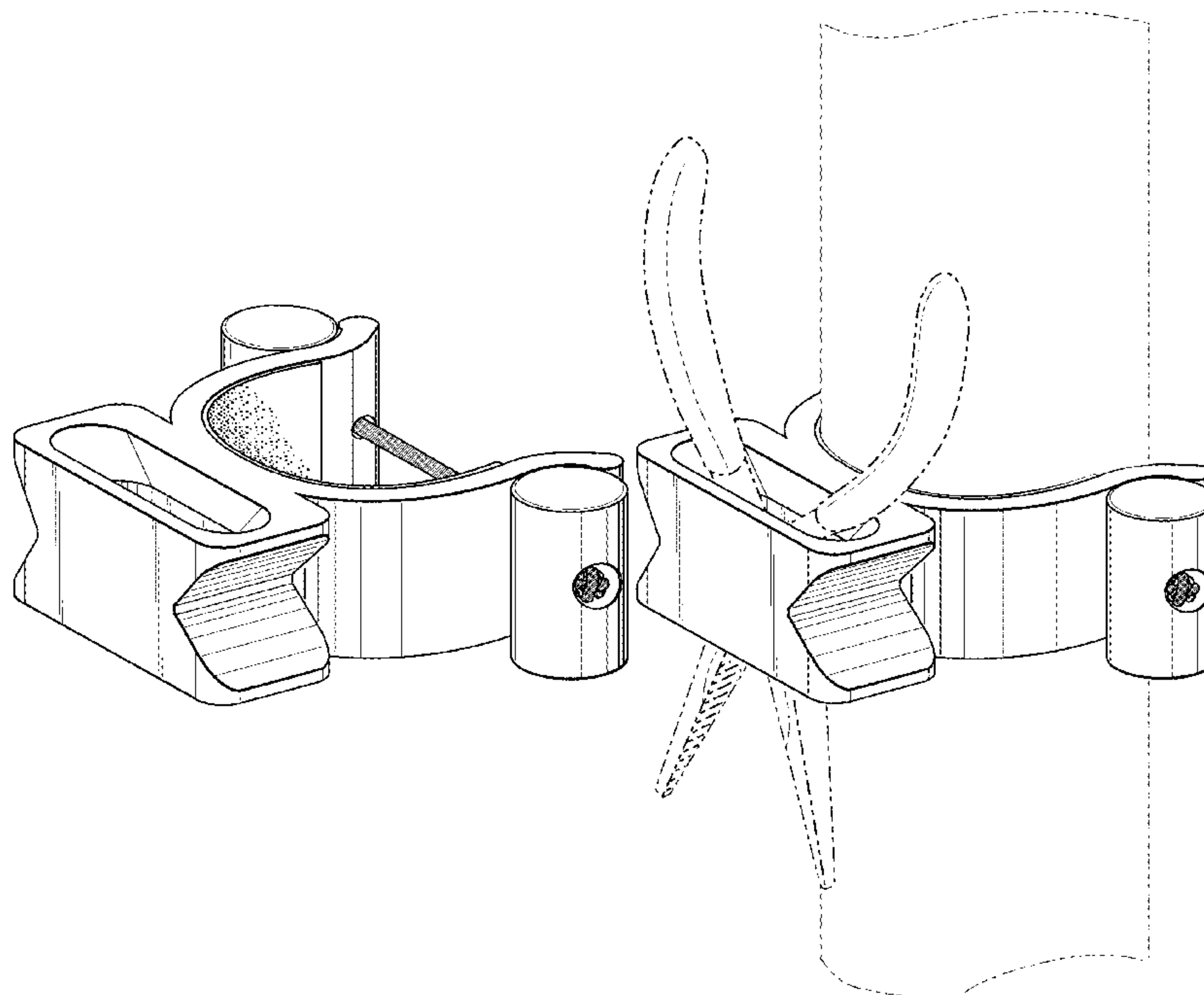

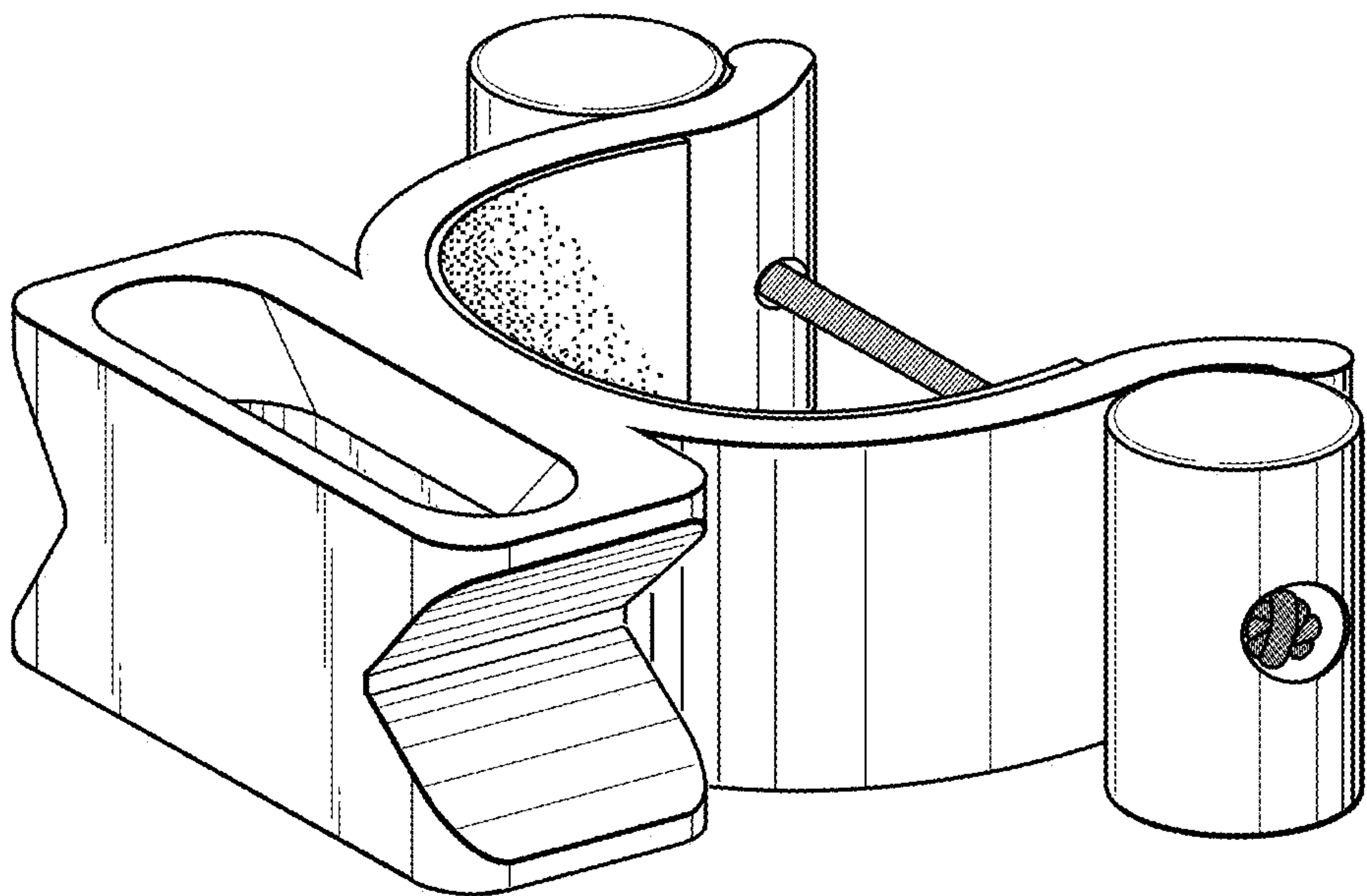

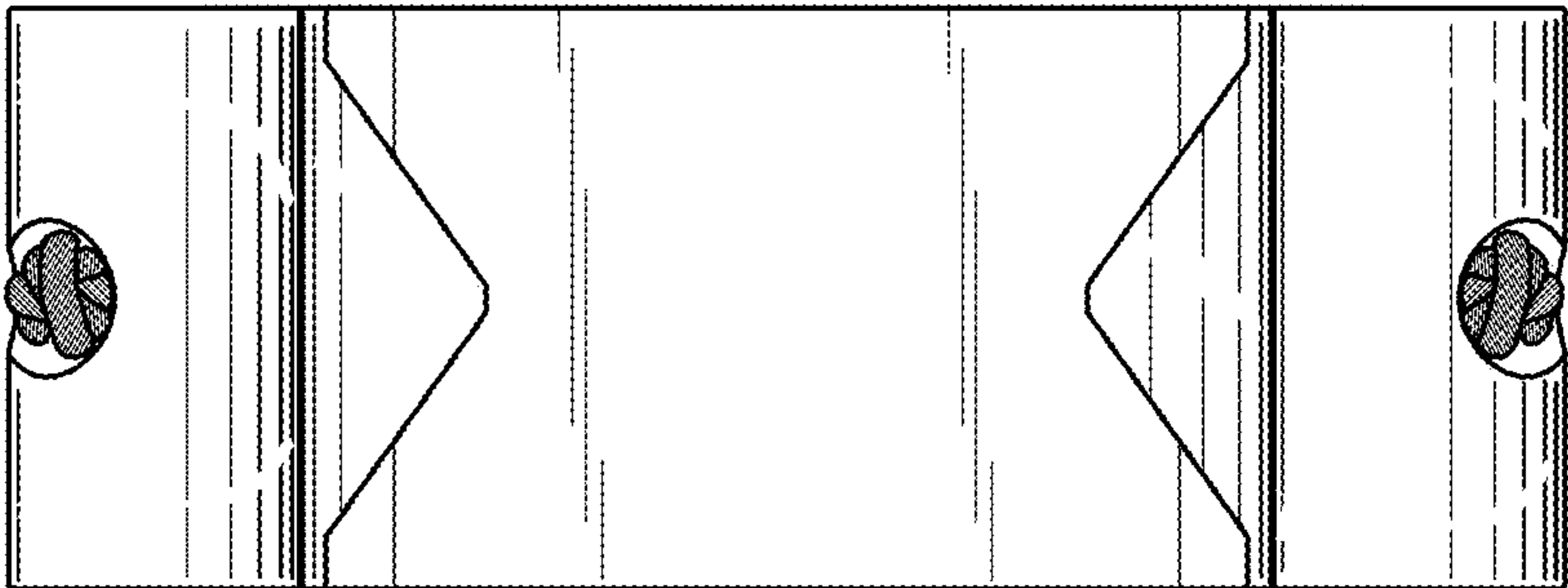

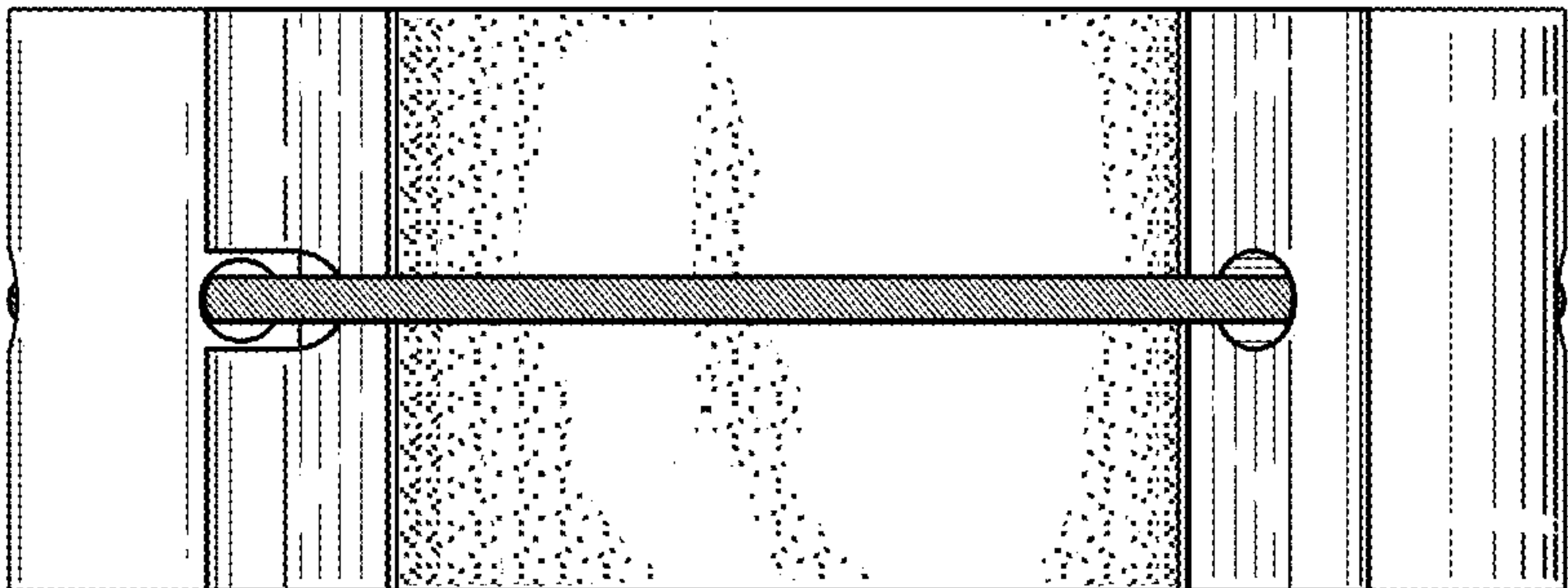

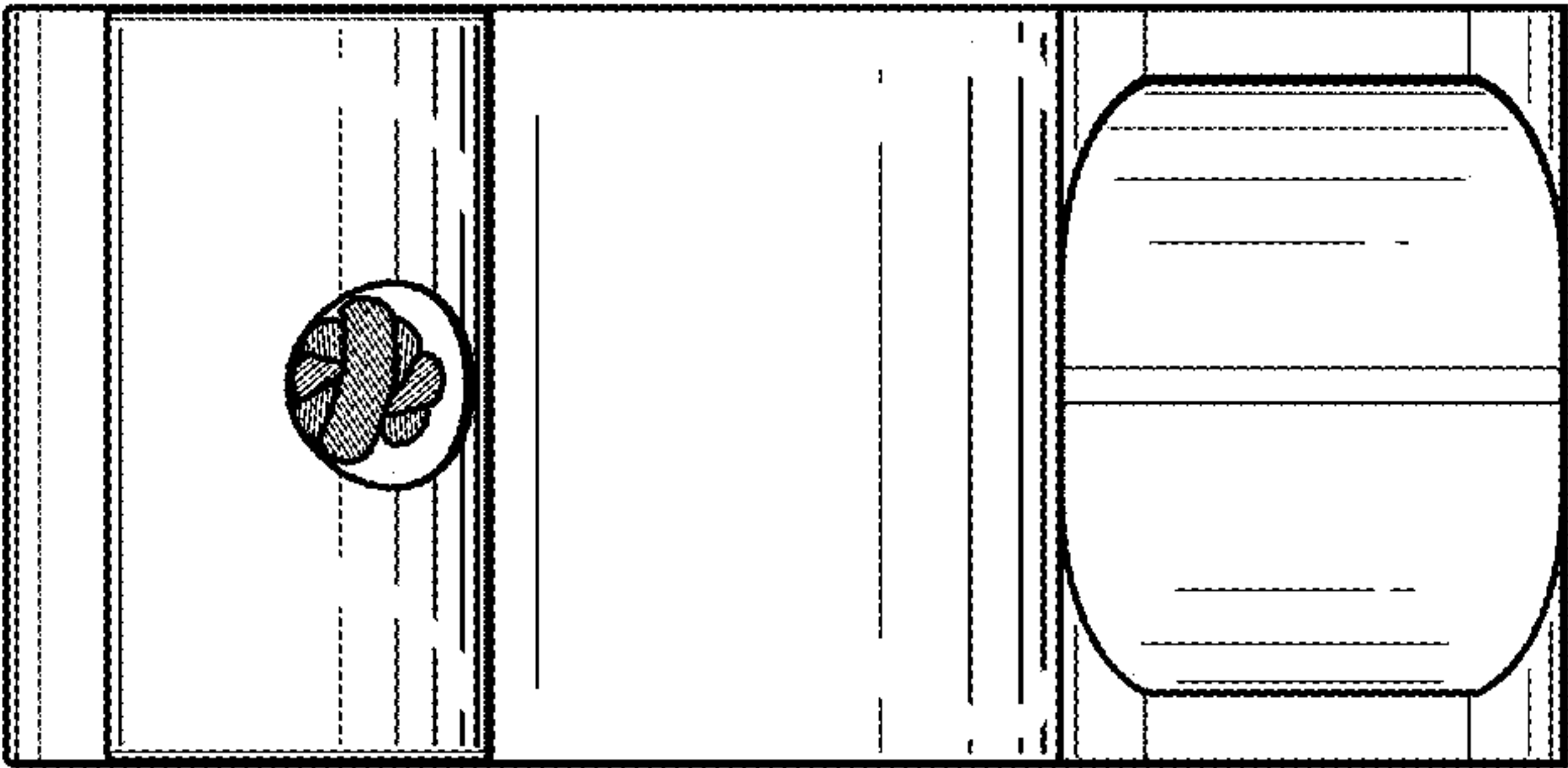

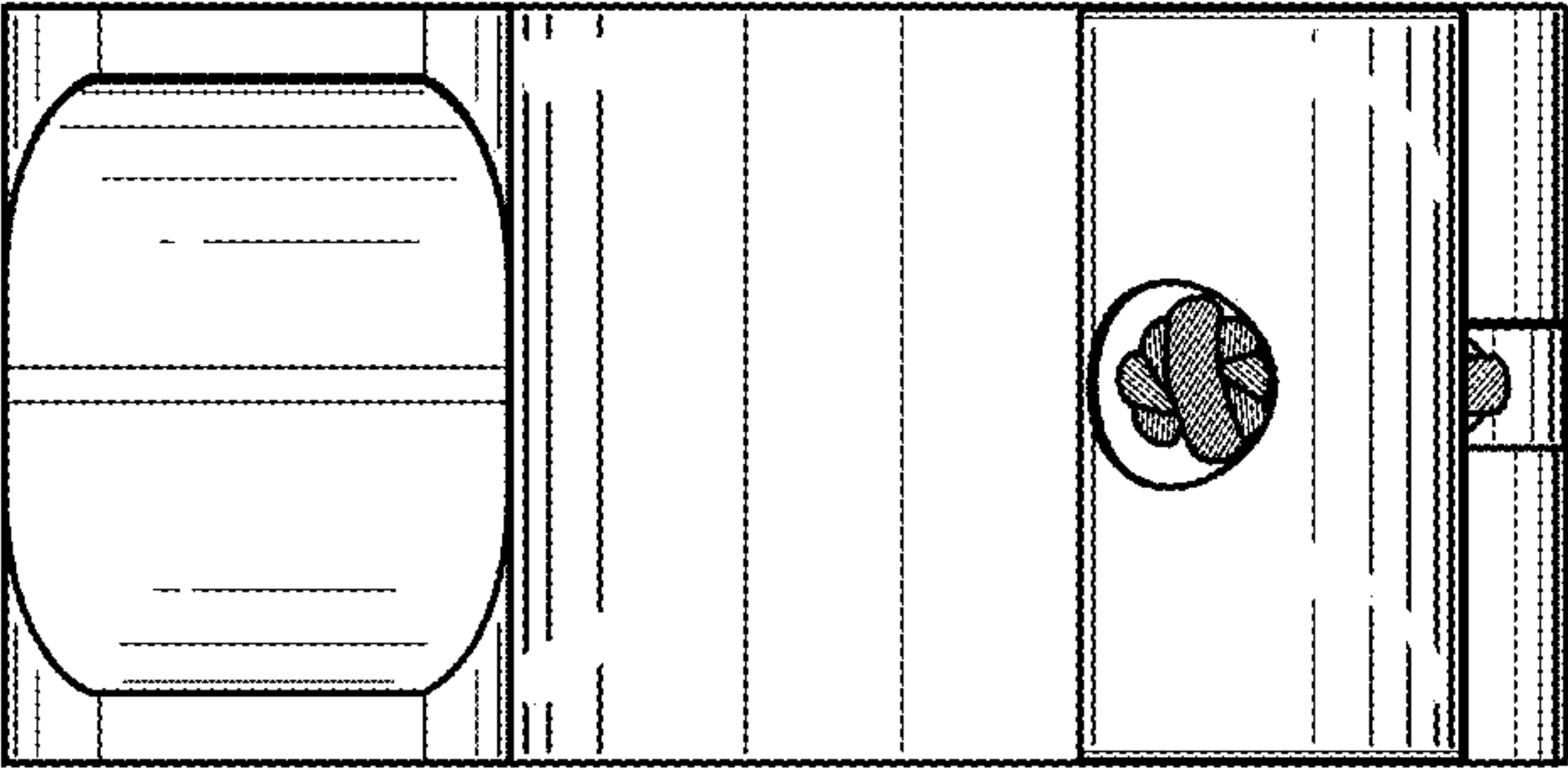

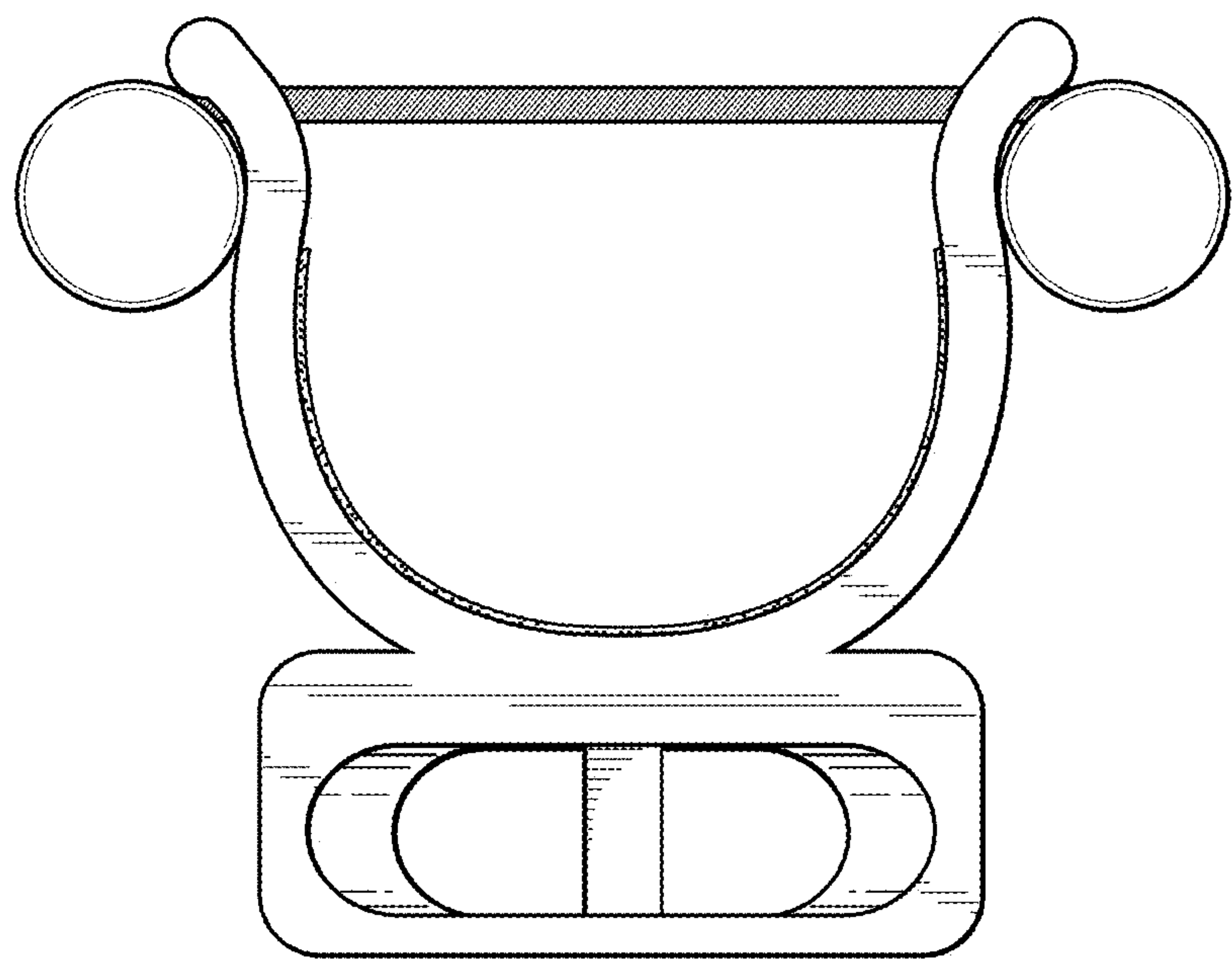

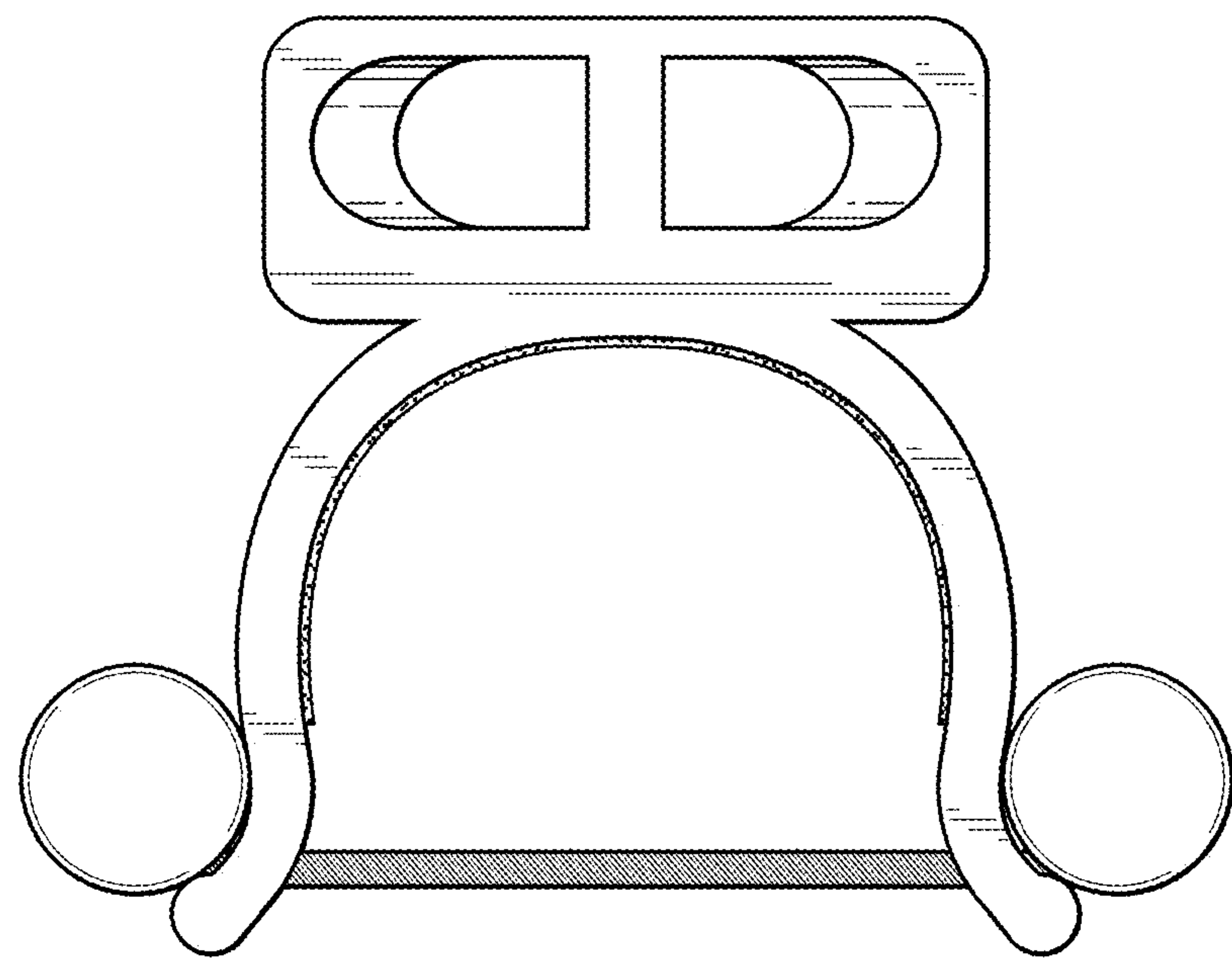

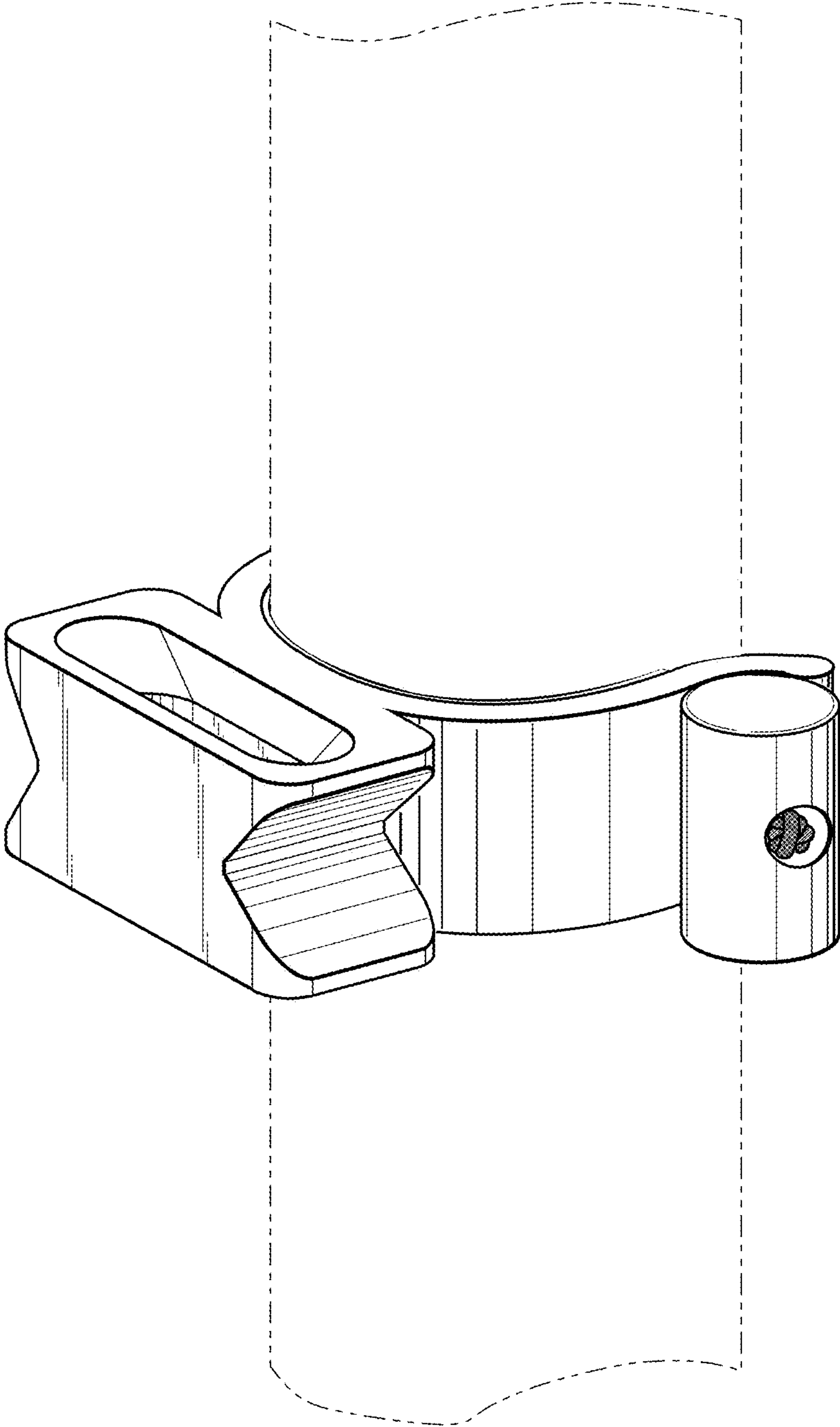
