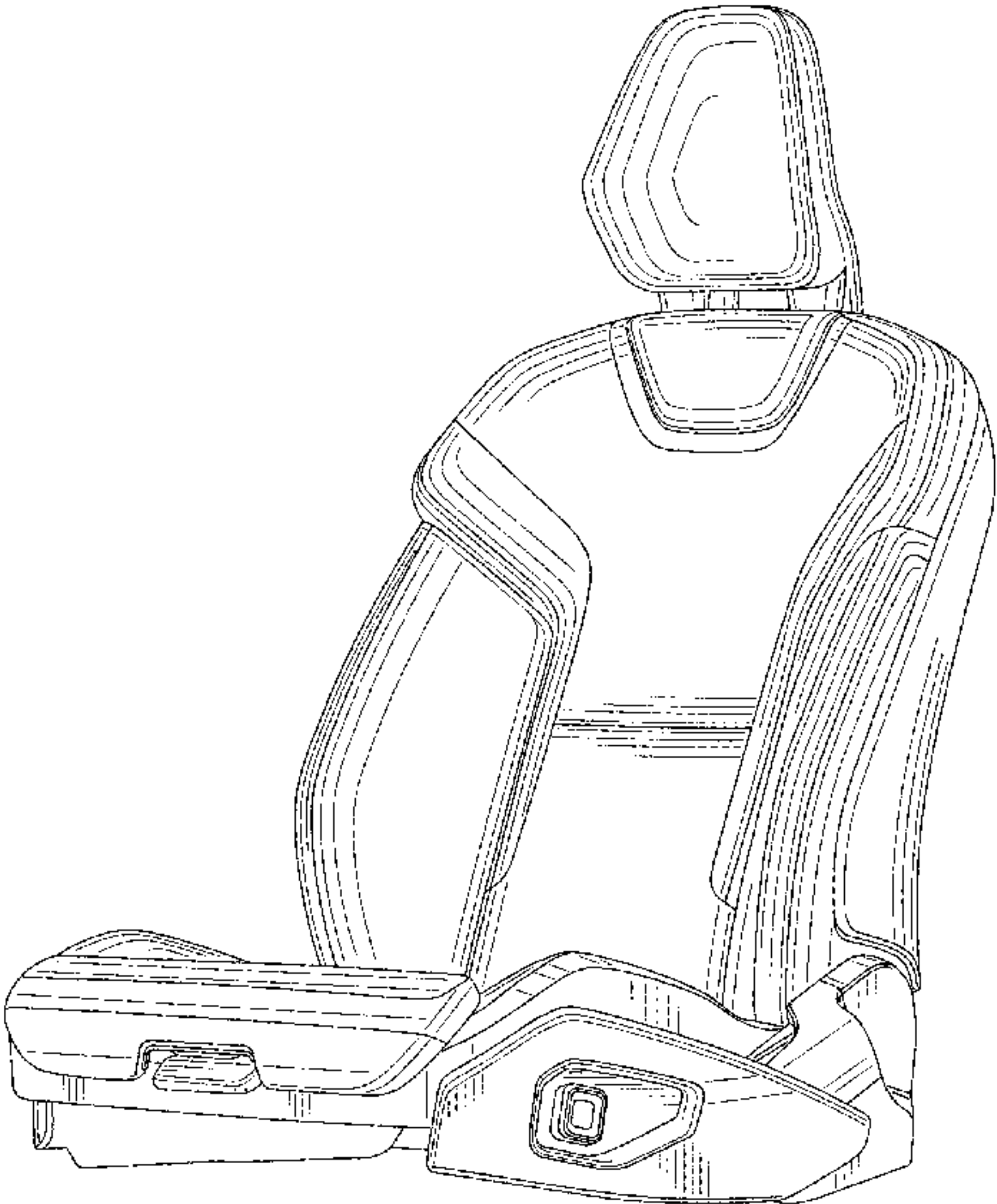
(57) CLAIM

We claim the ornamental design for a vehicle seat, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

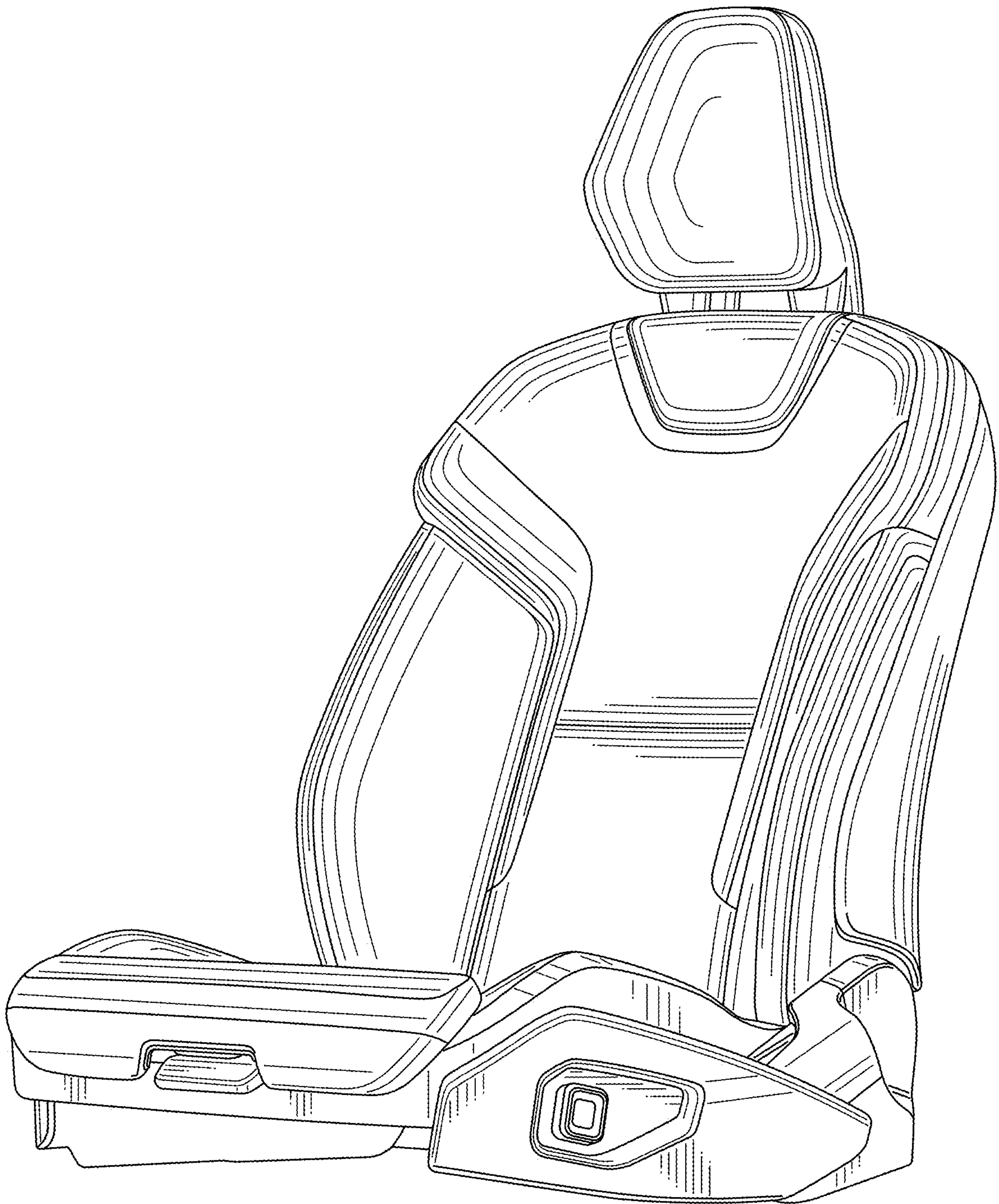

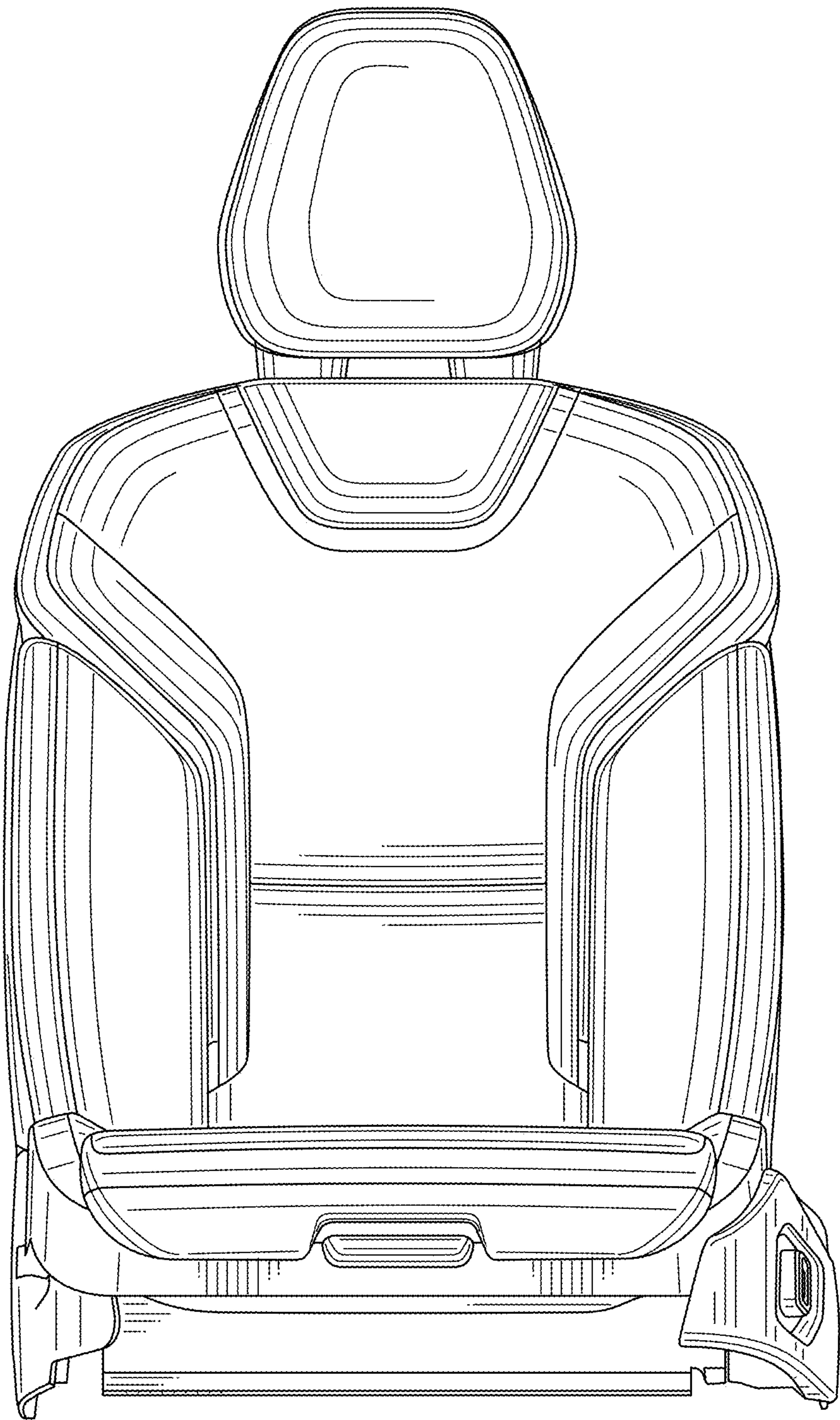

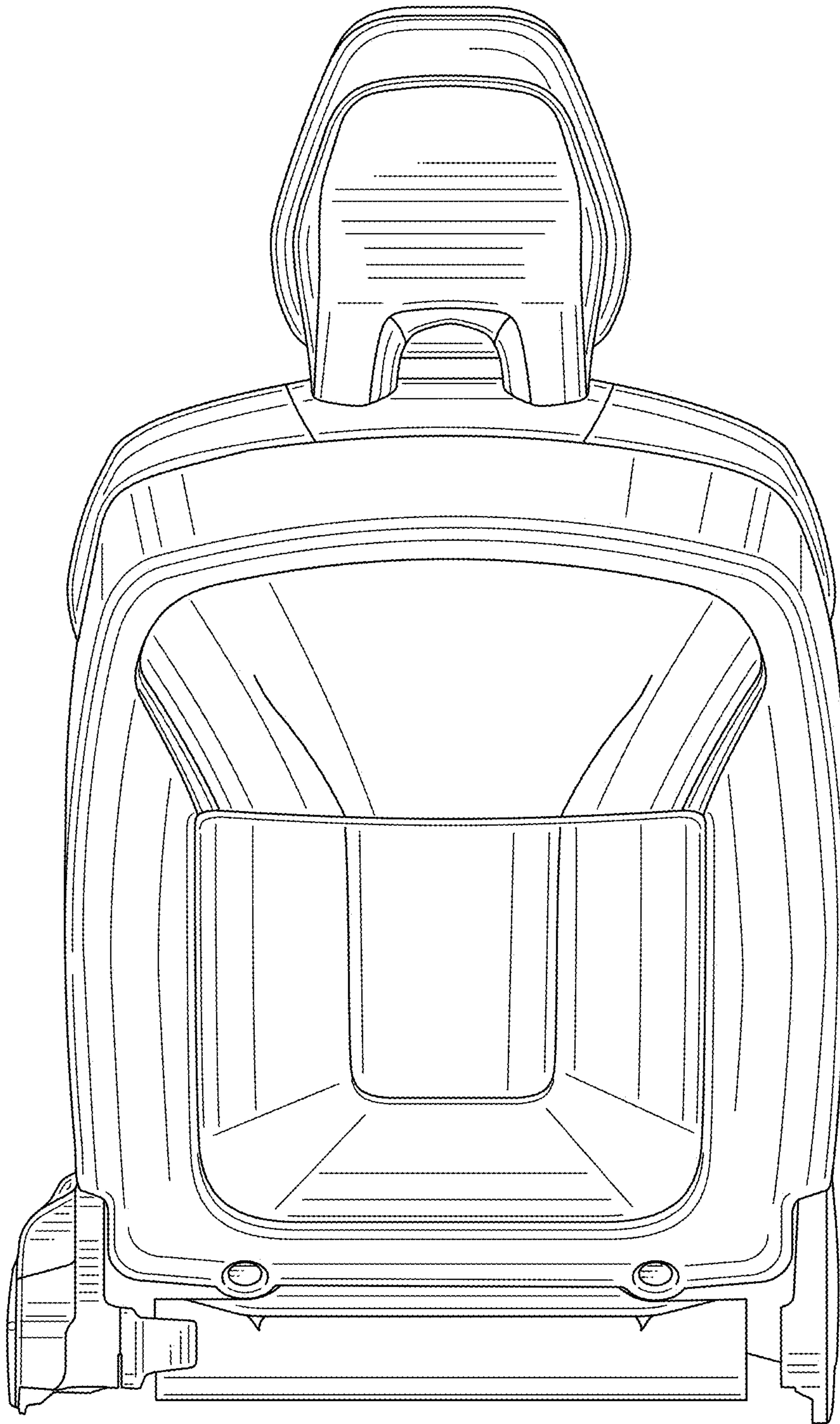

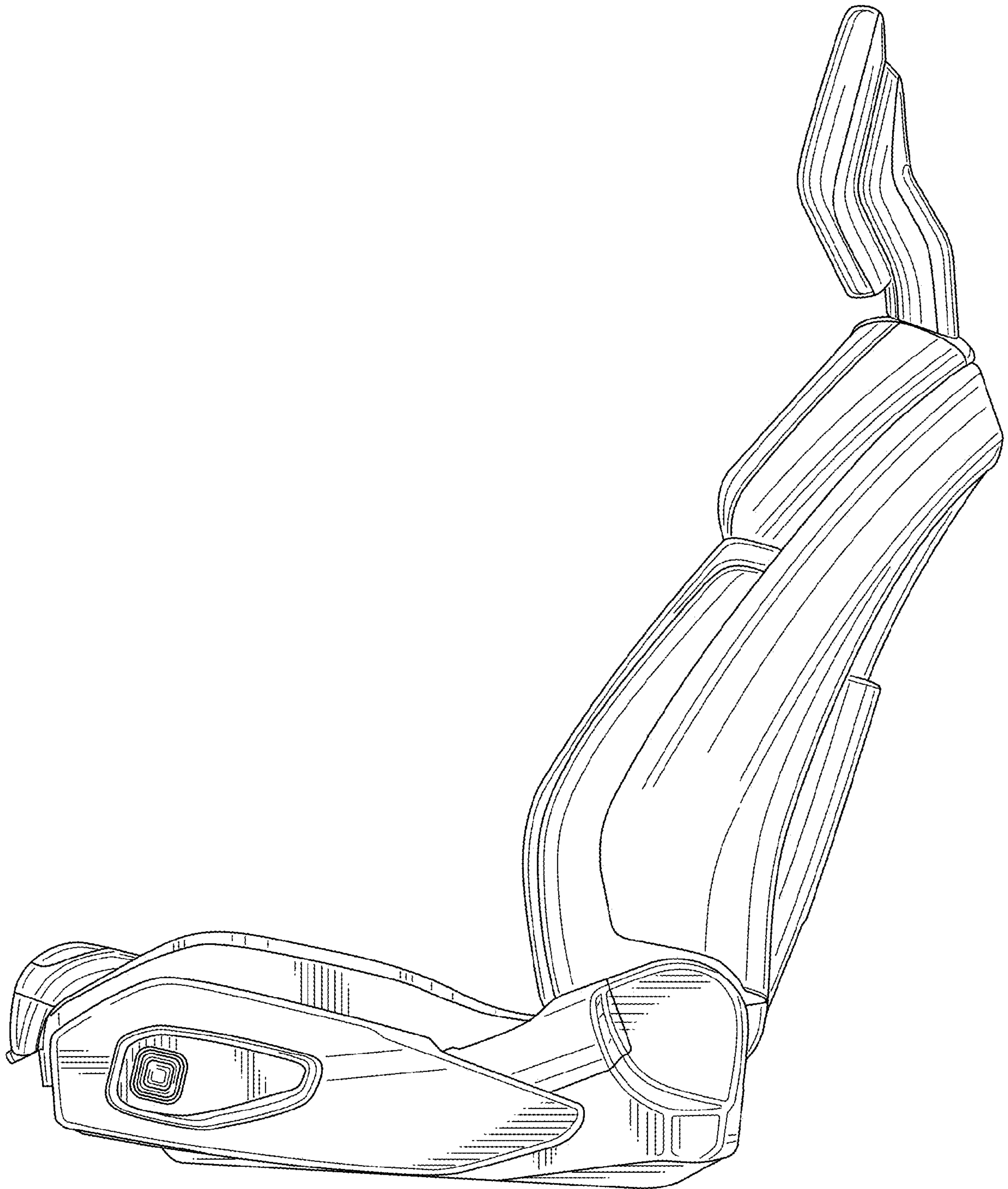

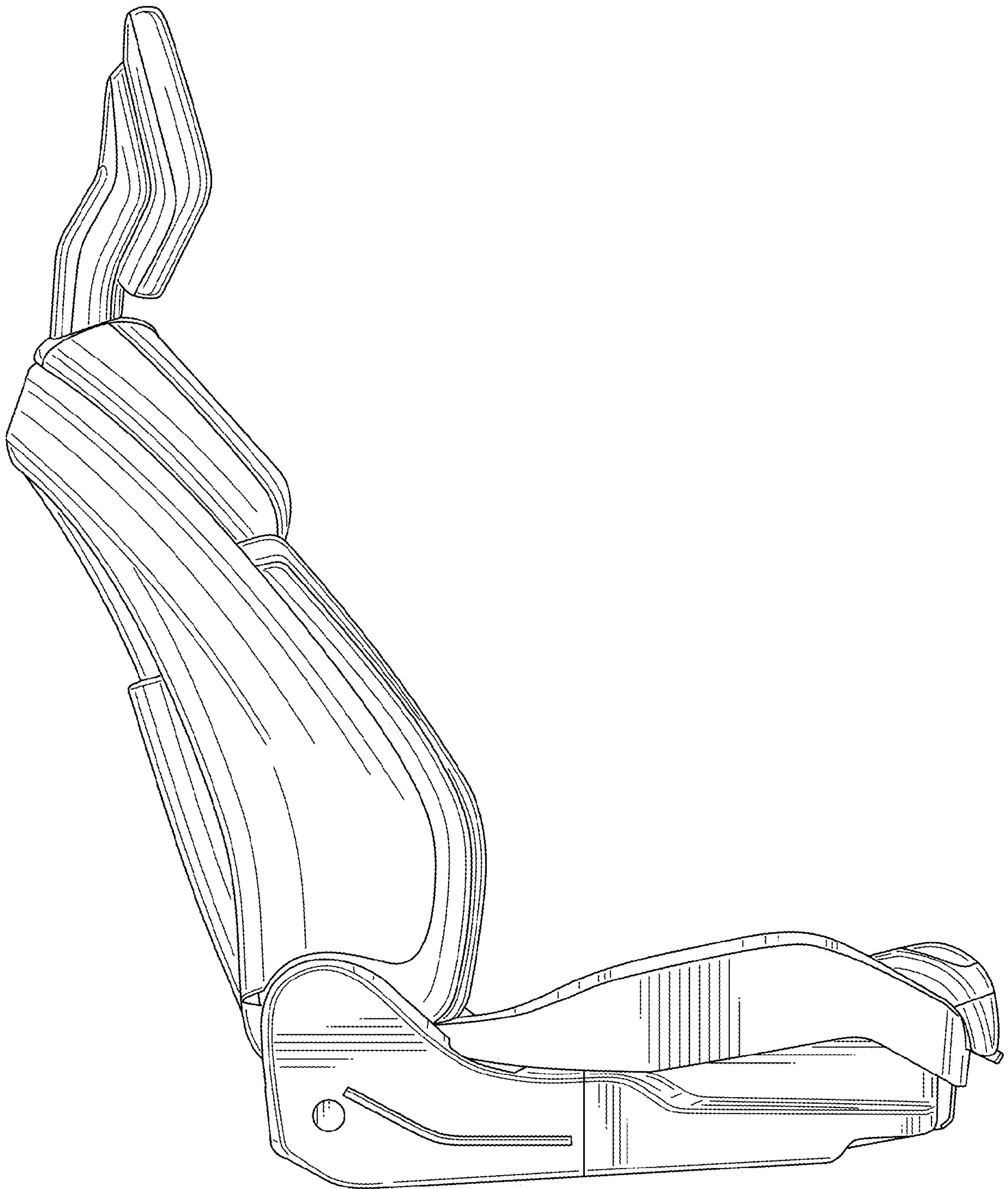

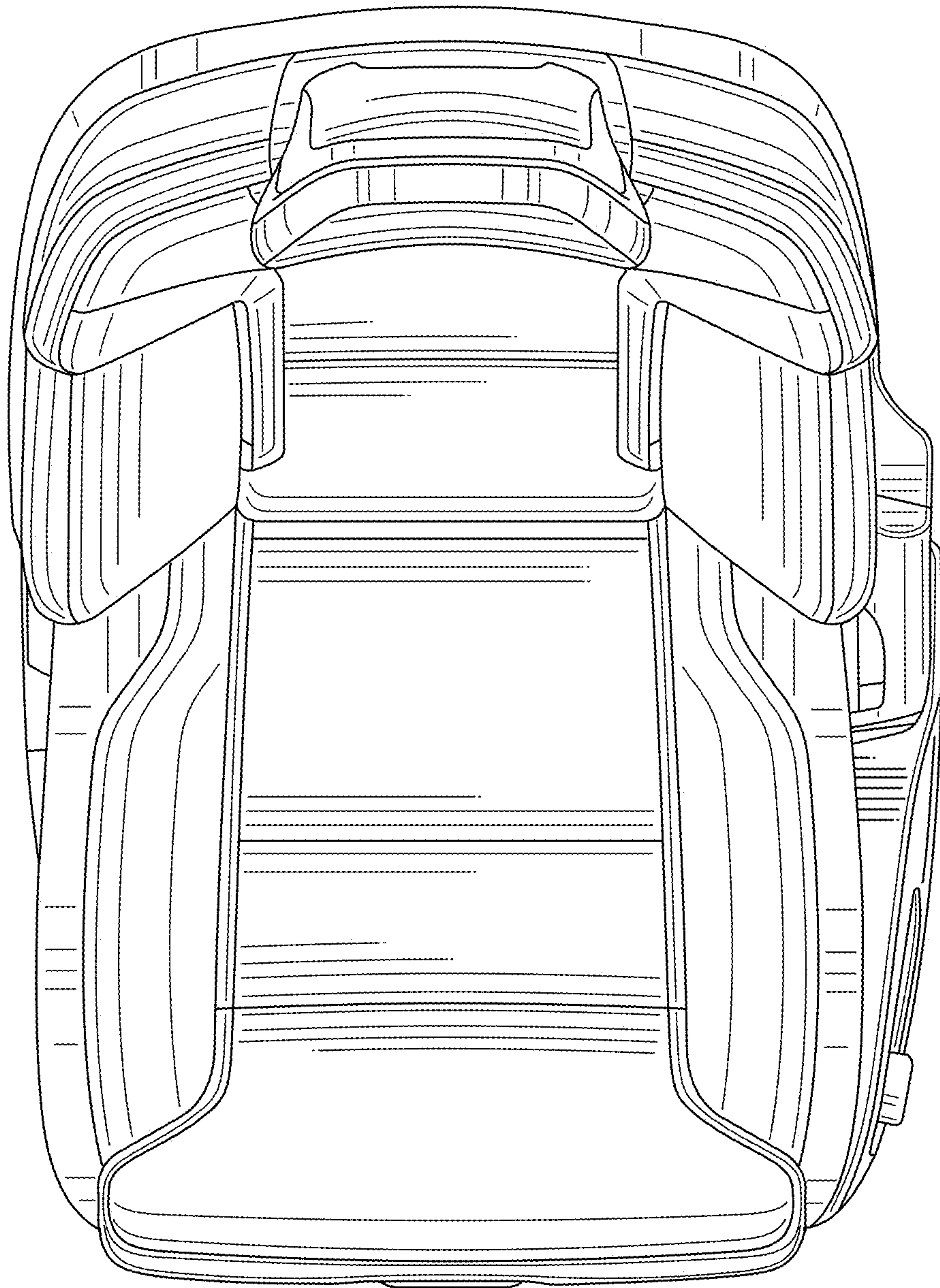

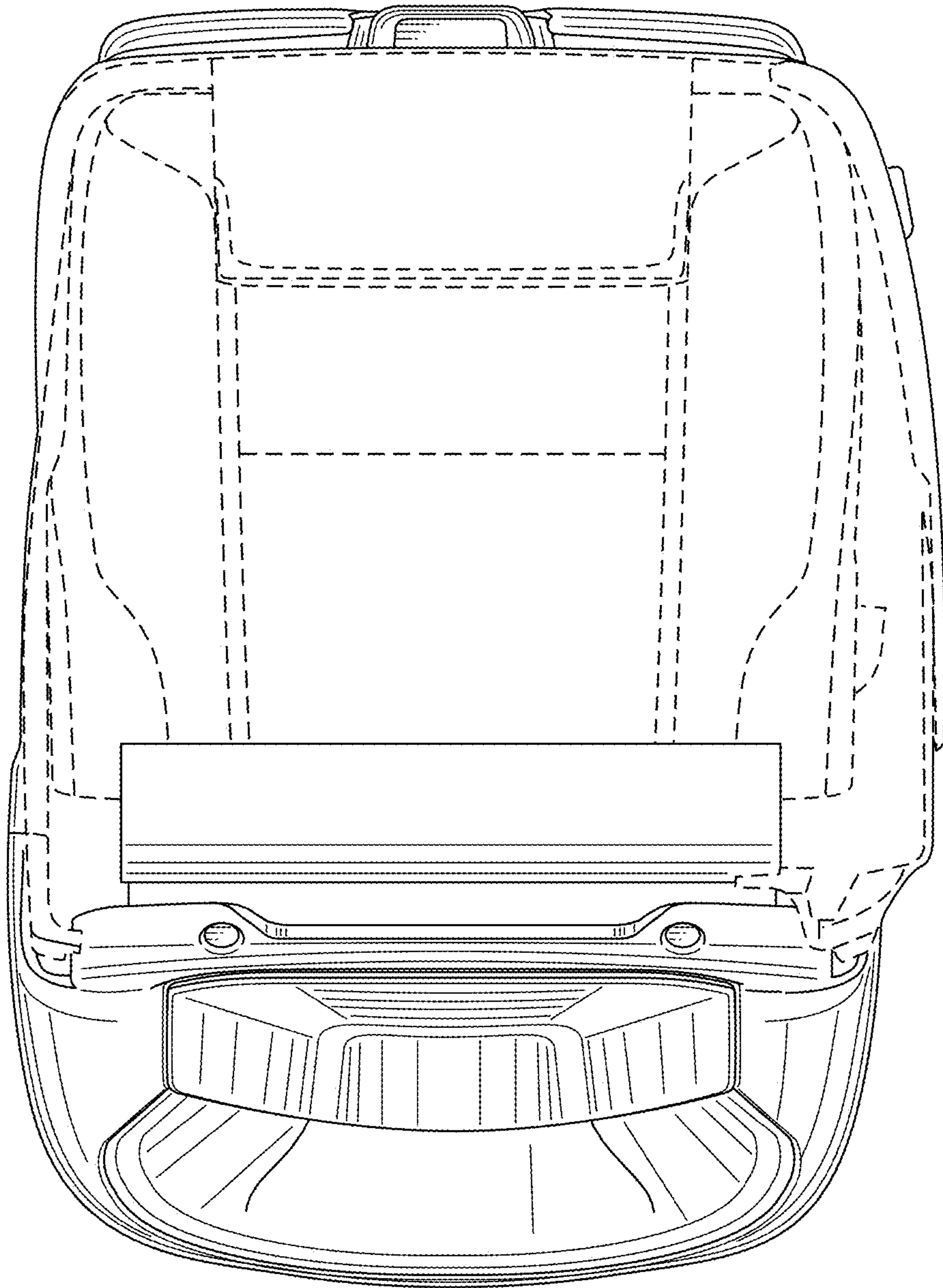
