described.

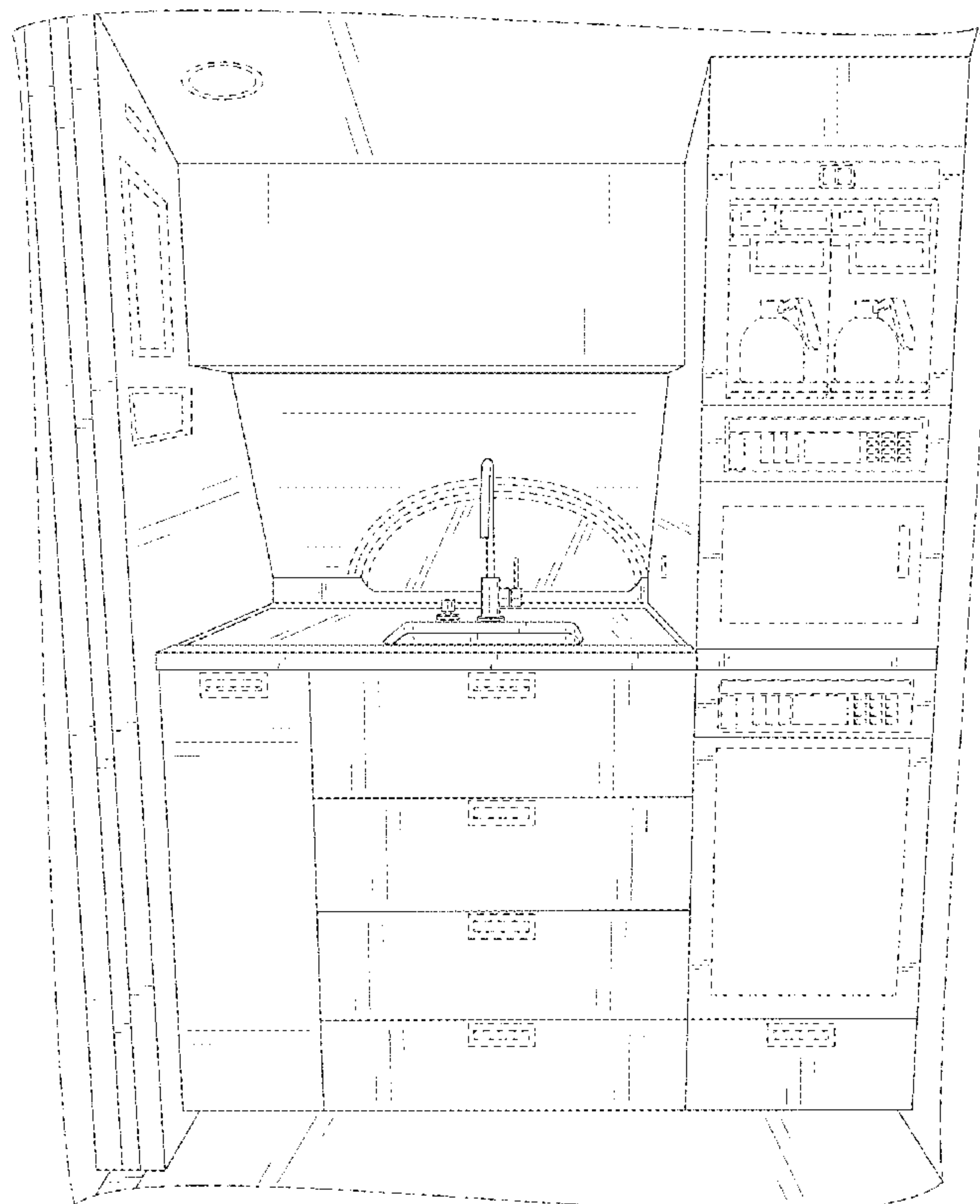
#### DESCRIPTION

vertically oriented wood grain surface treatment;

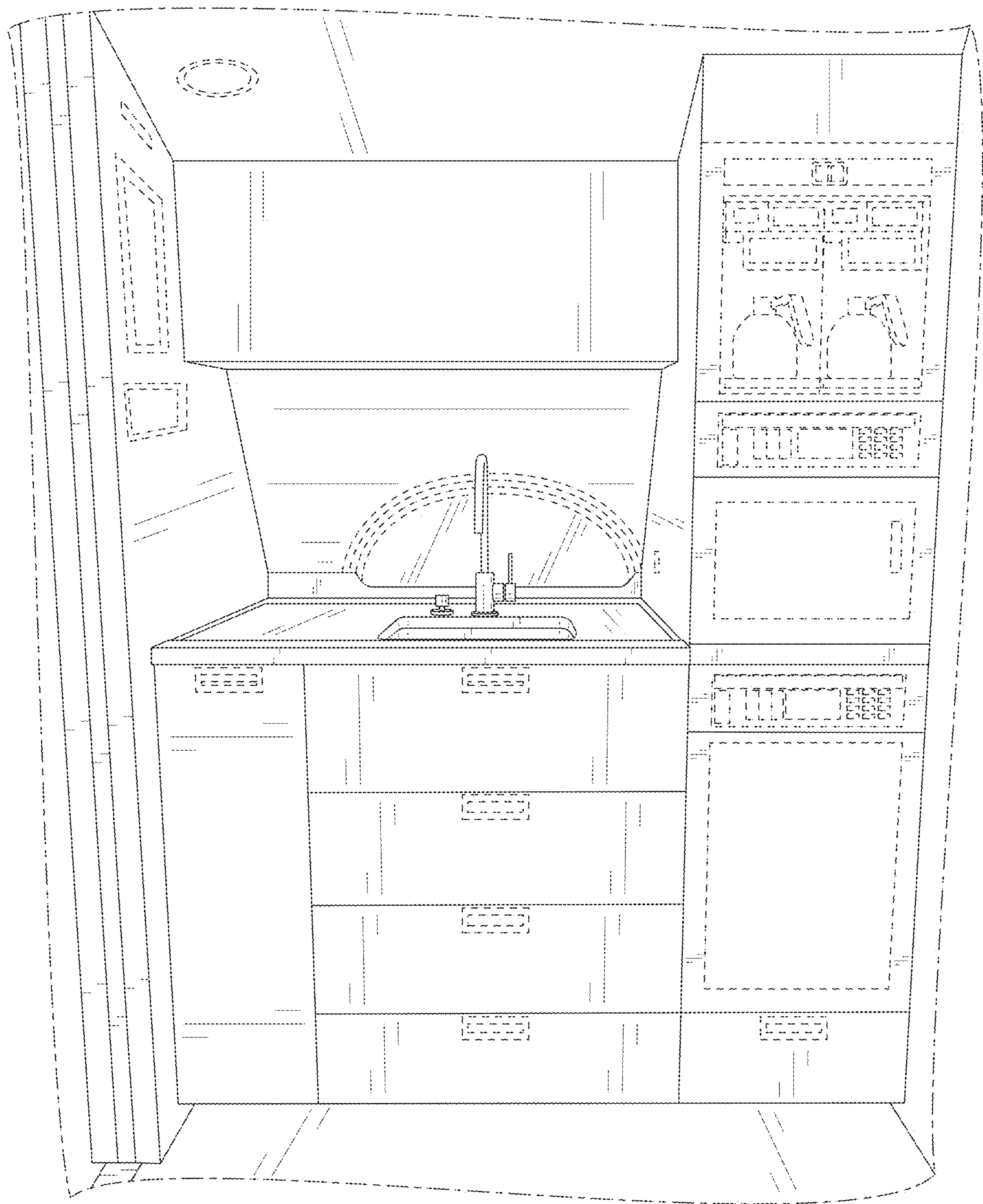

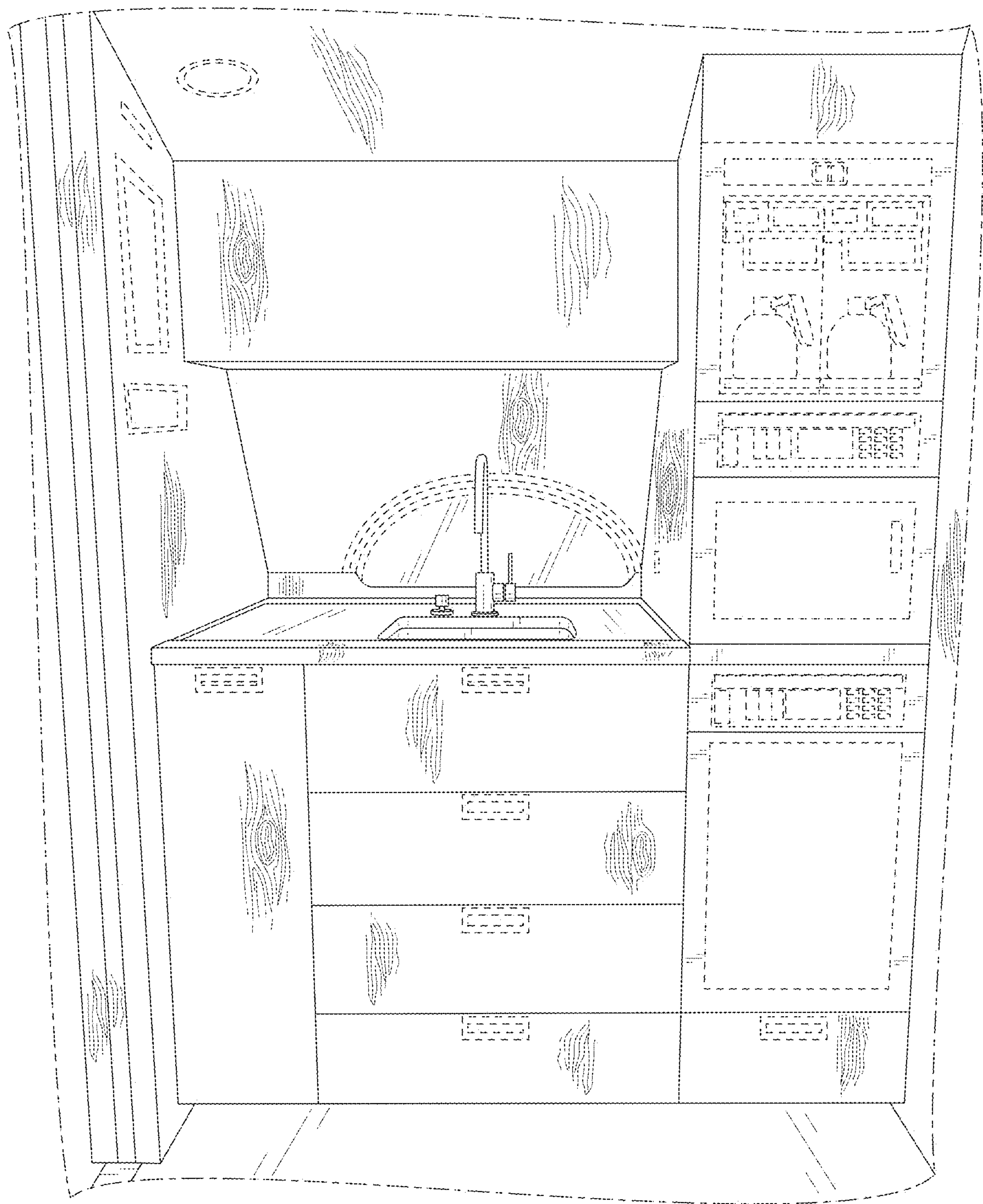

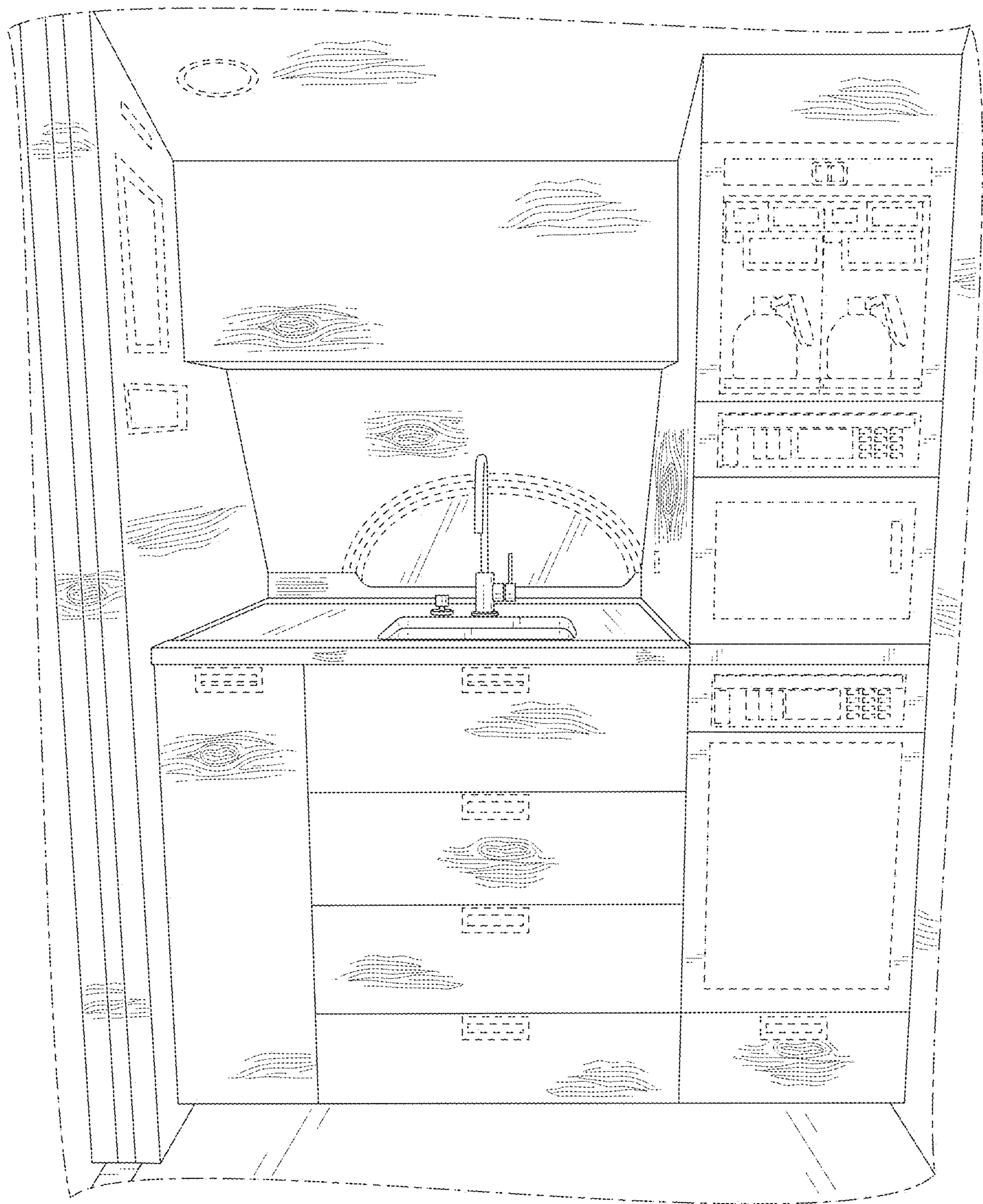

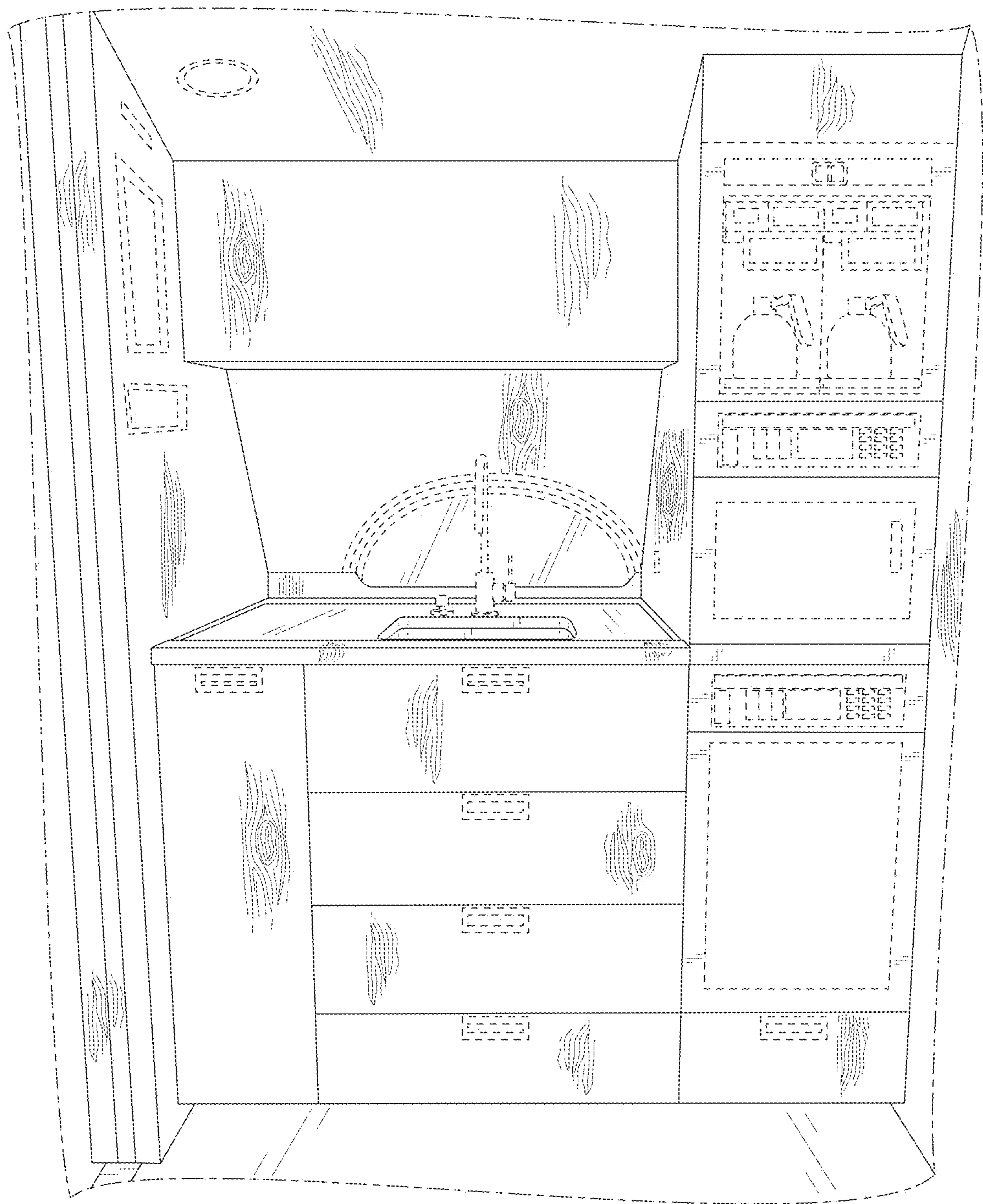
