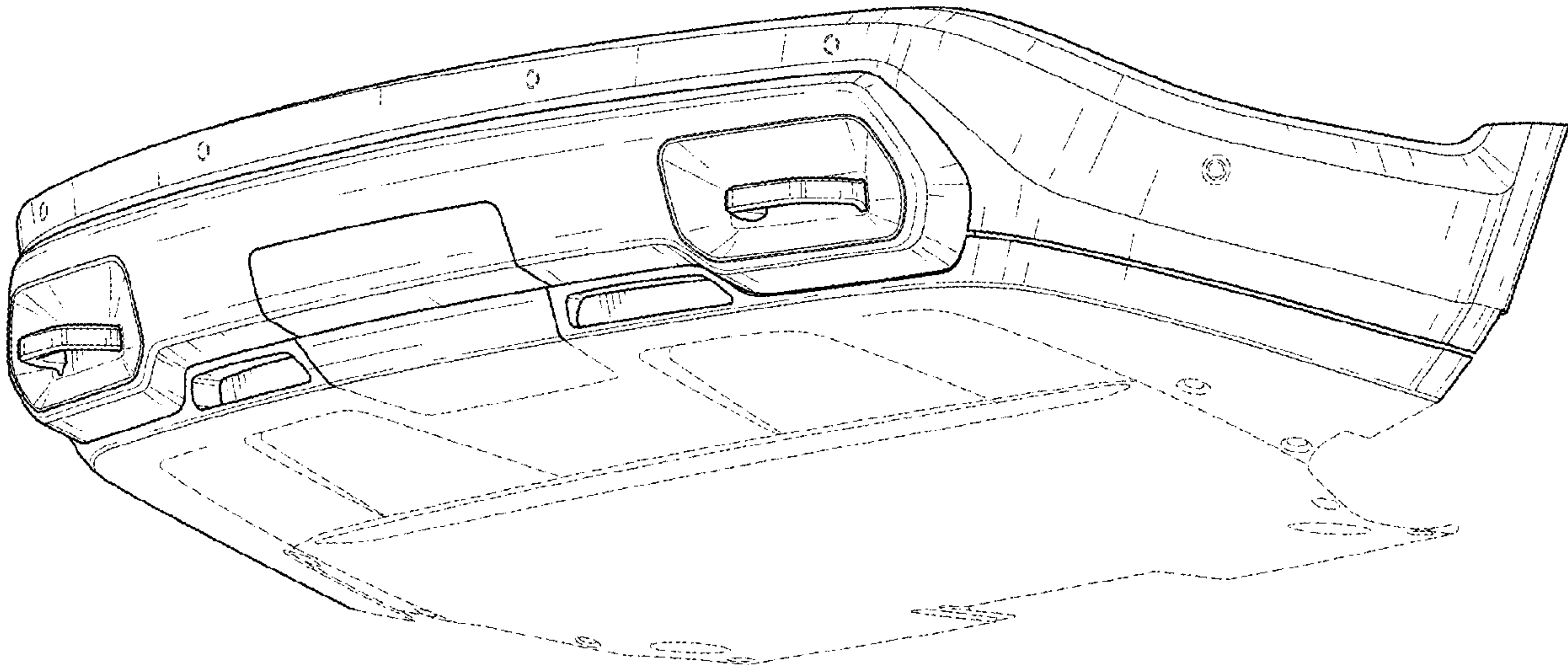
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FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a vehicle bumper.

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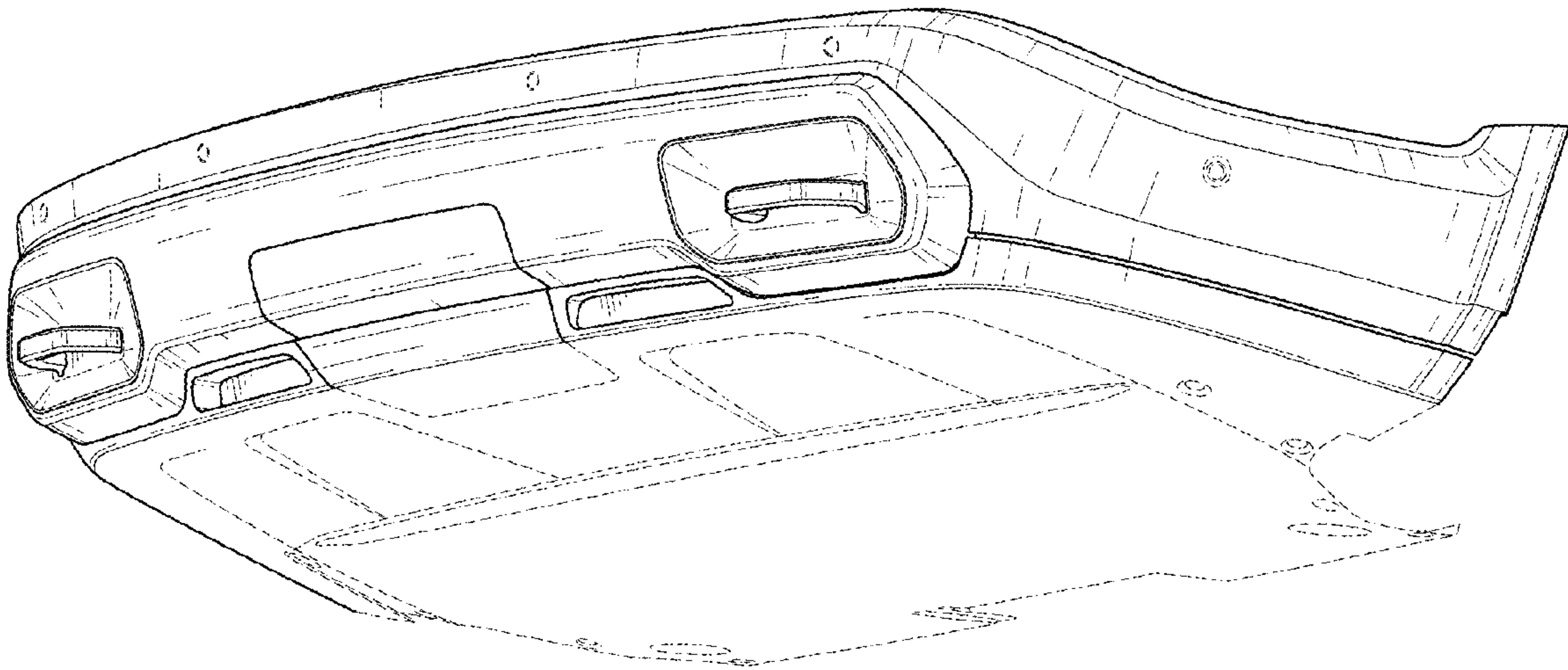

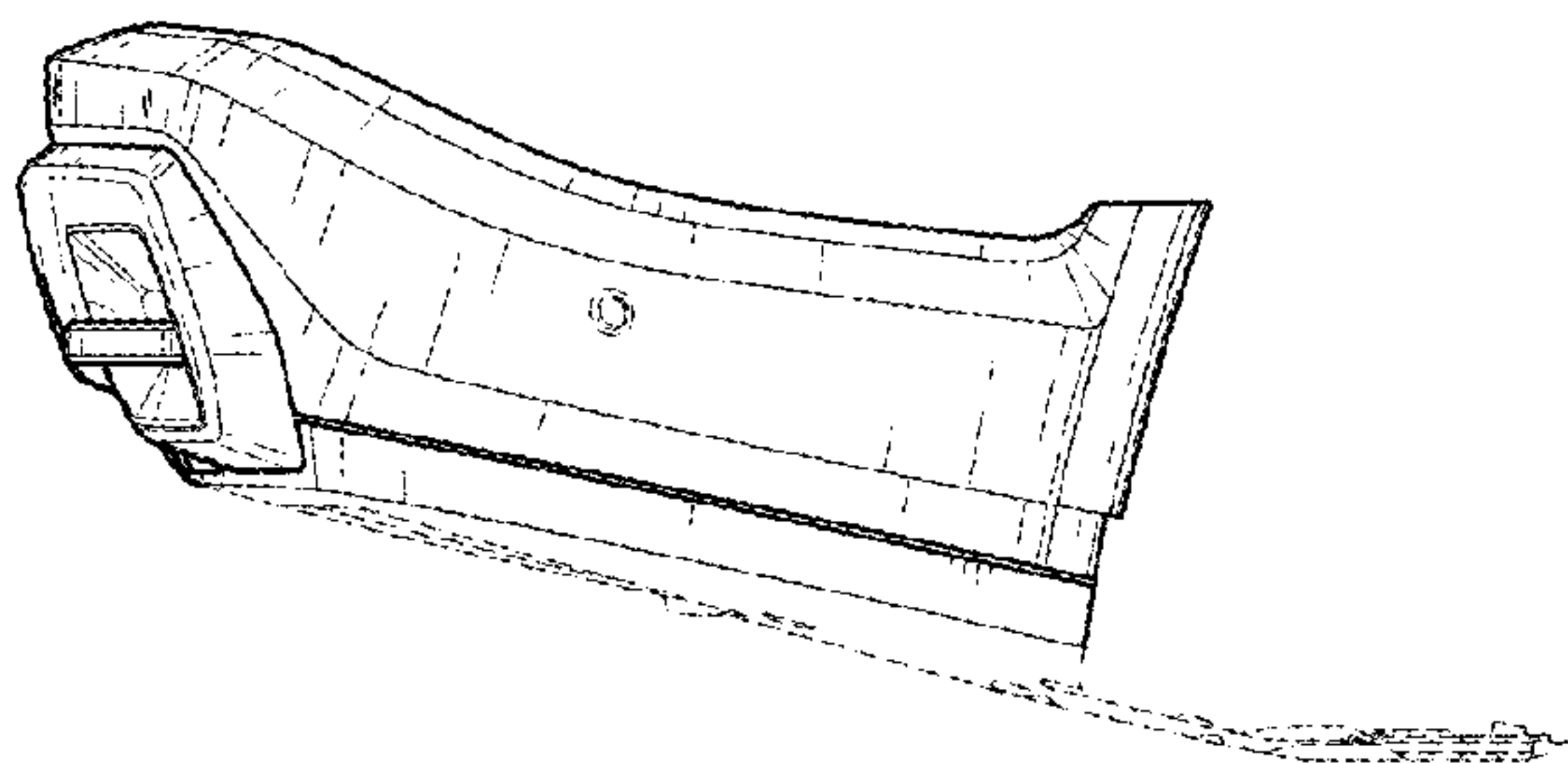

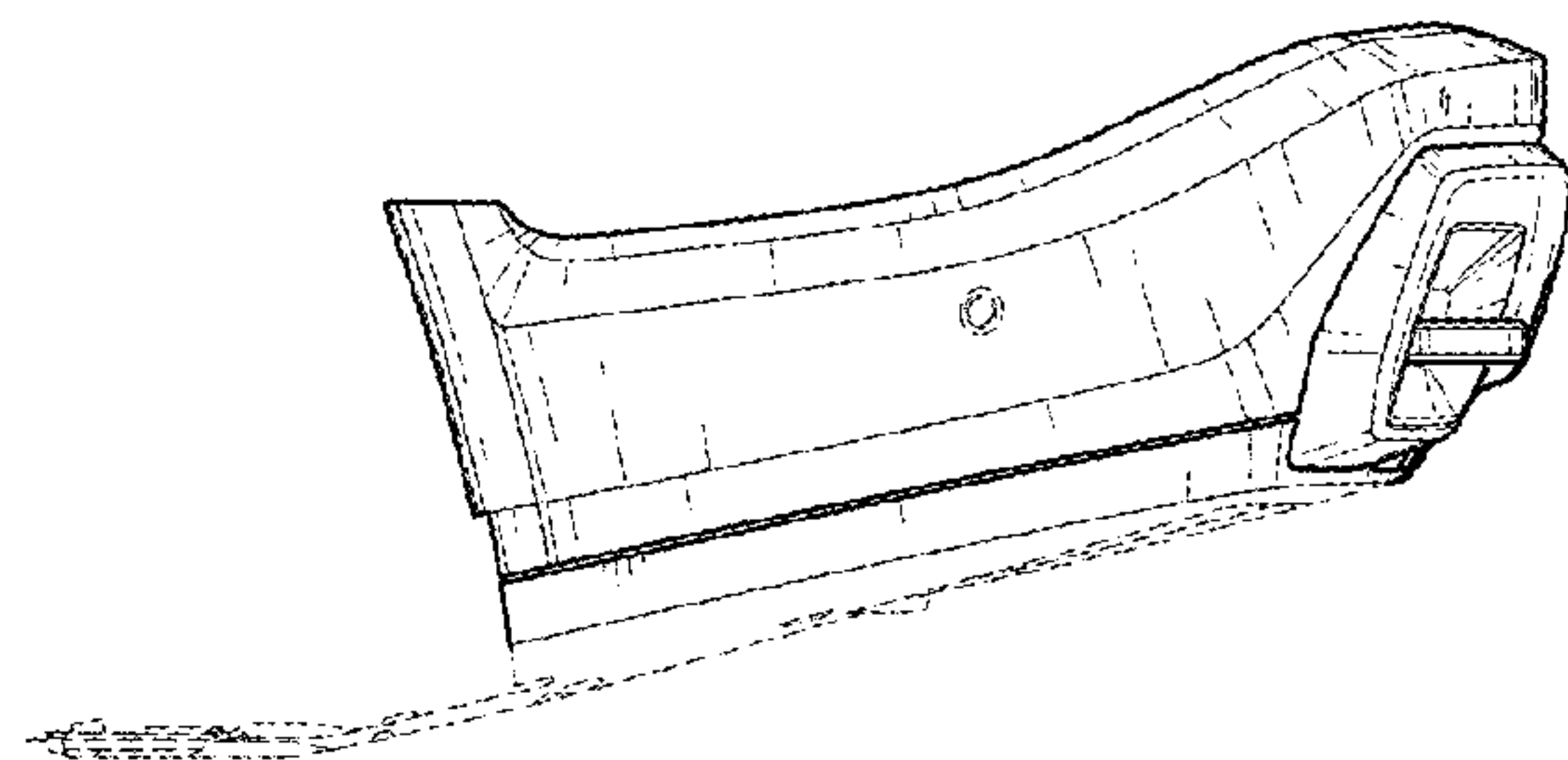

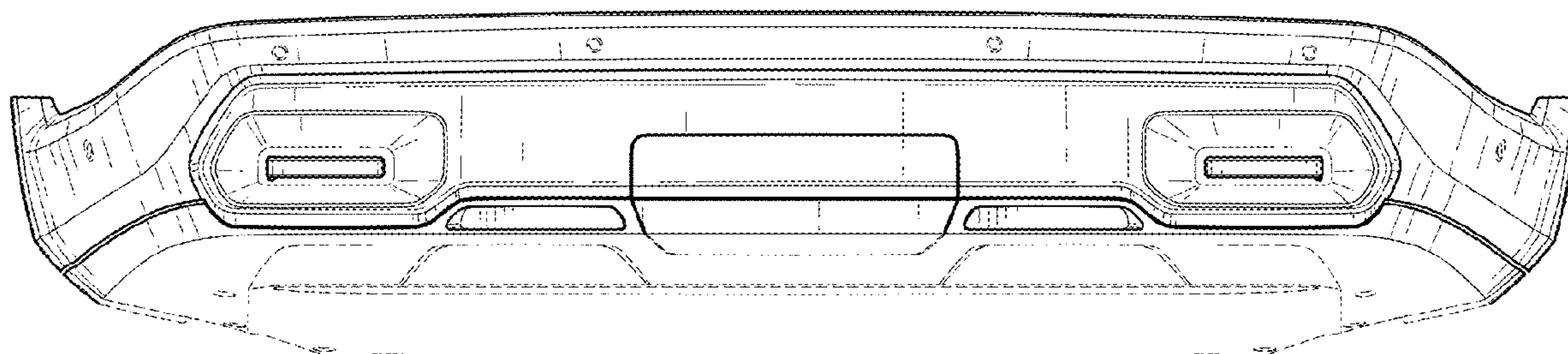

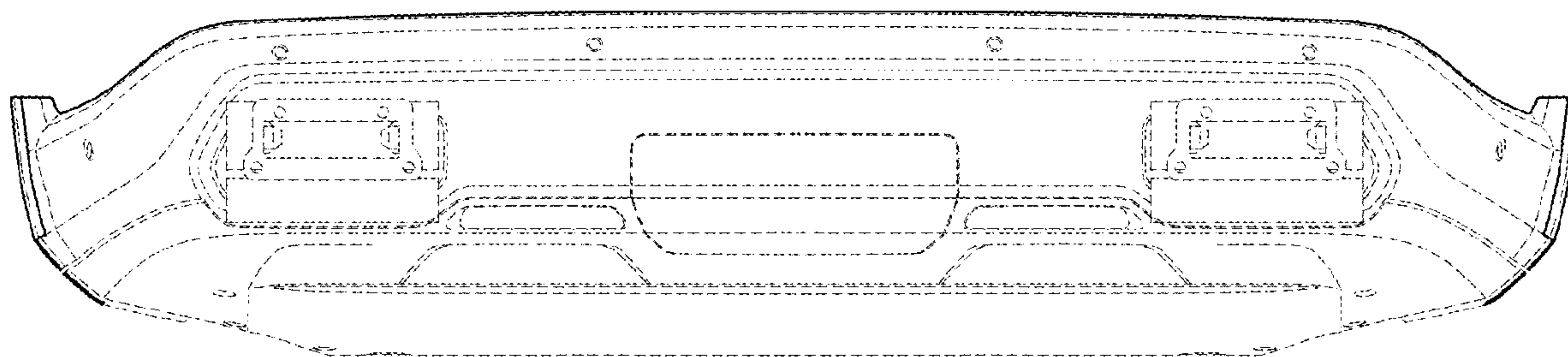

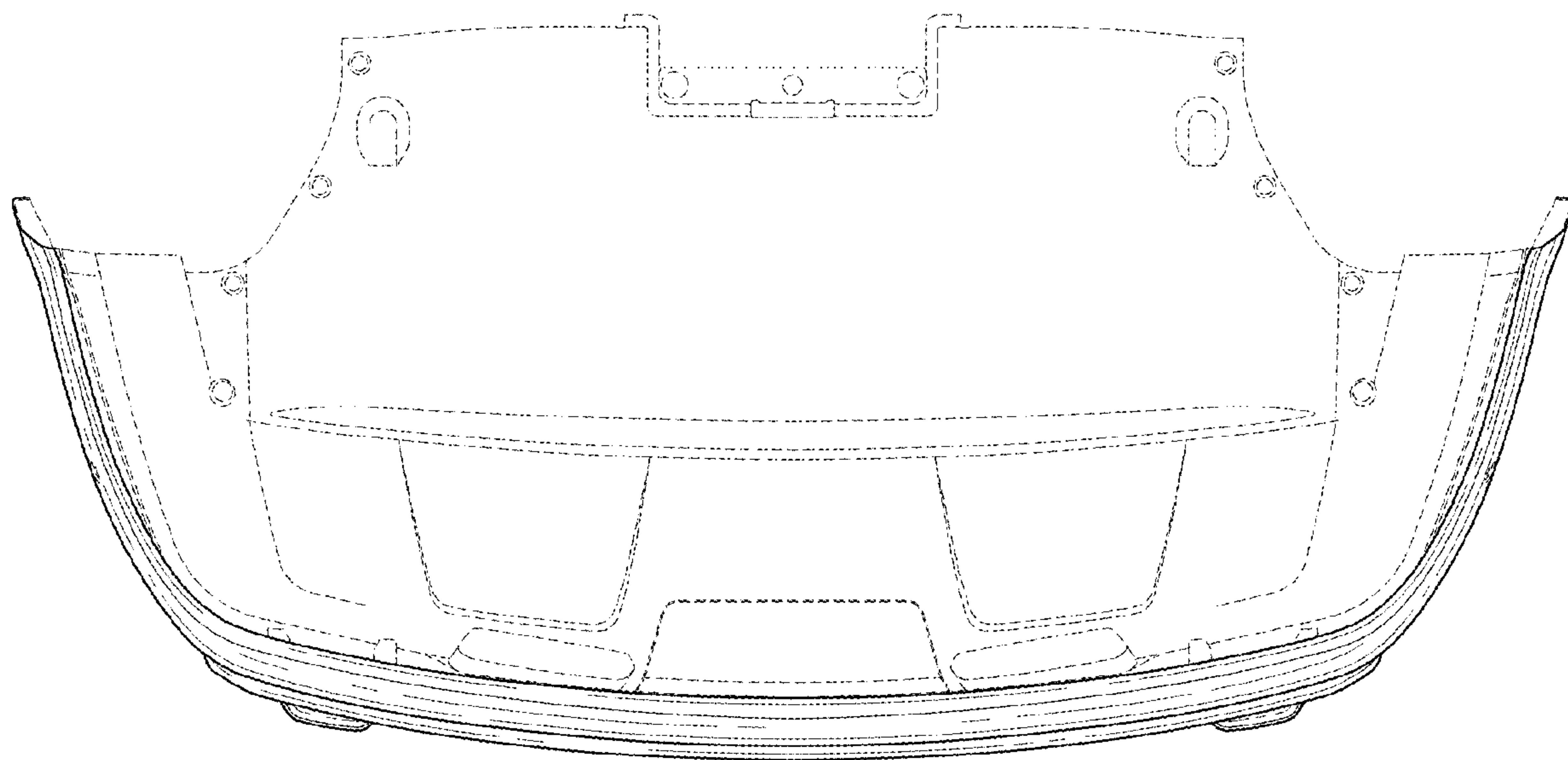

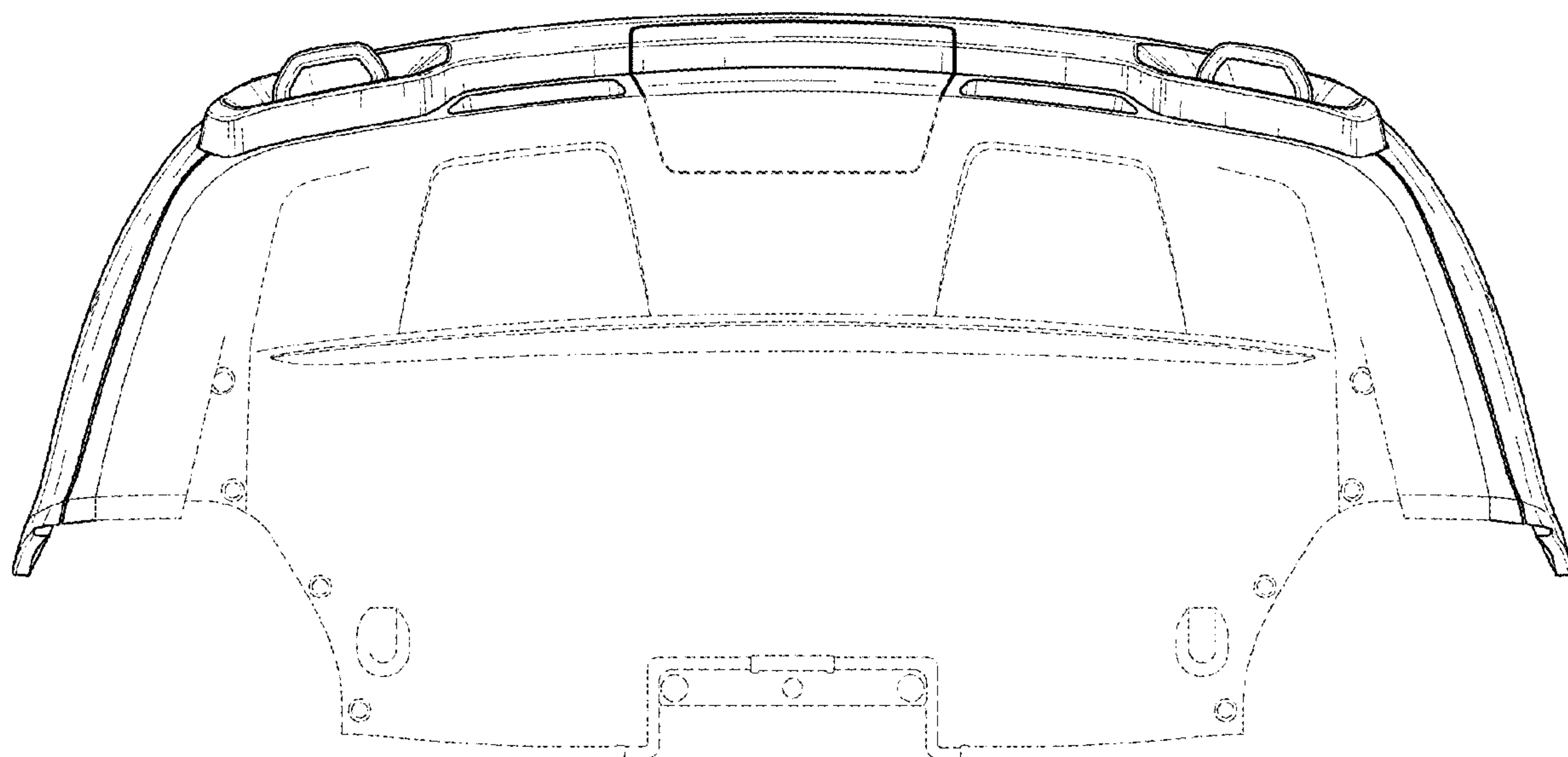
