The ornamental design for a container with a lid, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a container with a lid according to the first embodiment of the present invention. FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view of the container with a lid according to FIG. 1. FIG. 3 is a first side view of the container with a lid according to FIG. 1, the opposite side being a mirror image. FIG. 4 is a top view of the container with a lid according to FIG. 1. FIG. 5 is a front view of the container with a lid according to FIG. 1; the rear view being a mirror image. FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the container with a lid according to FIG. 1. FIG. 7 is a top perspective view of a container with a lid according to the second embodiment of the present invention. FIG. 8 is a bottom perspective view of the container with a lid according to FIG. 7. FIG. 9 is a front view of the container with a lid according to FIG. 7 the rear view being a mirror image. FIG. 10 is a top view of the container with a lid according to FIG. 7. FIG. 11 is a first side view of the container with a lid according to FIG. 7; the opposite side being a mirror image. FIG. 12 is a bottom view of the container with a lid according to FIG. 7. FIG. 13 is a top perspective view of a container with a lid according to the third embodiment of the present invention. FIG. 14 is a bottom perspective view of the container with a lid according to FIG. 13. FIG. 15 is a front view of the container with a lid according to FIG. 13, the rear view being a mirror image.

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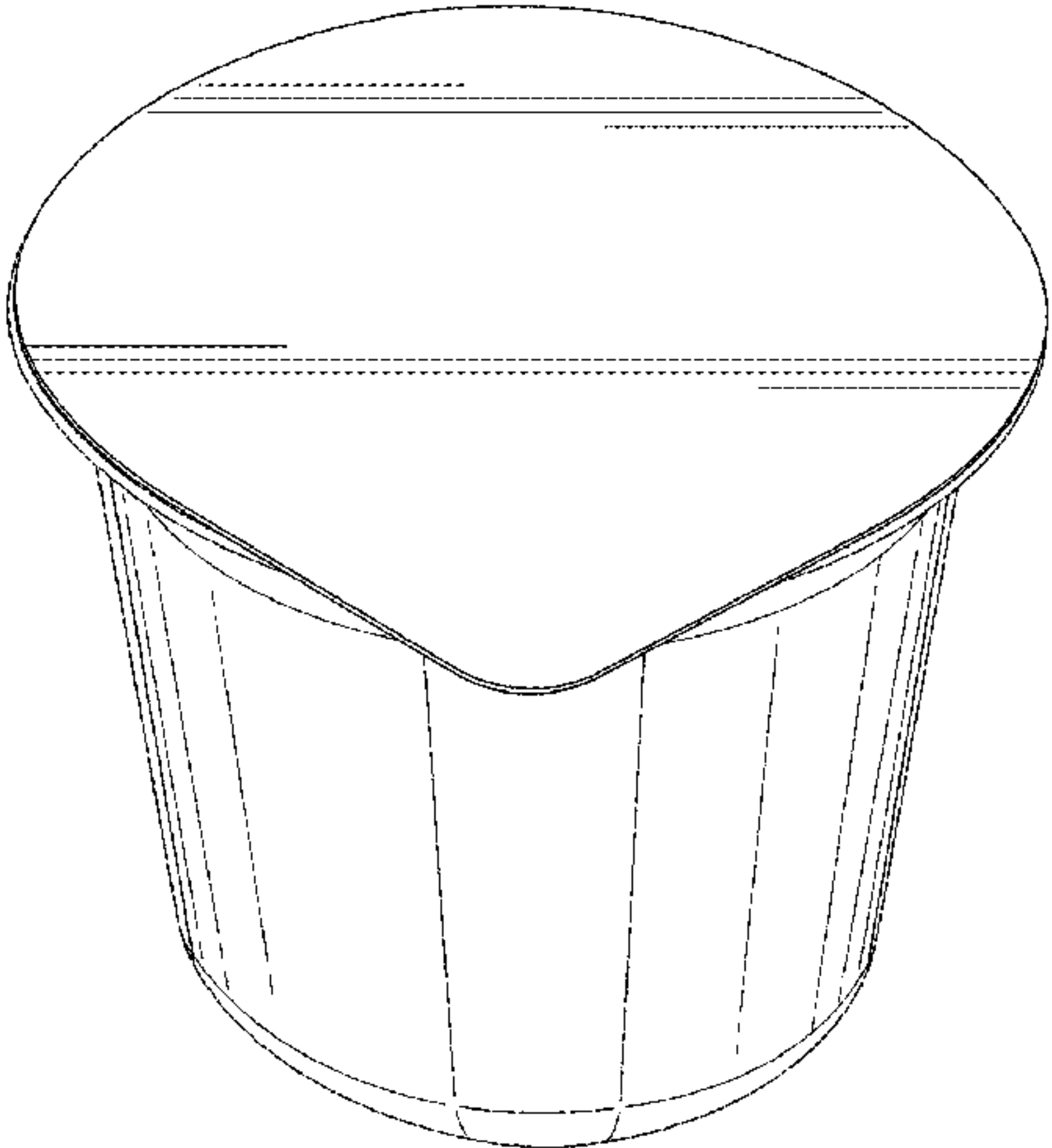


FIG. 16 is a top view of the container with a lid according to FIG. 13.

FIG. 24 is a bottom view of the container with a lid according to FIG. 19.

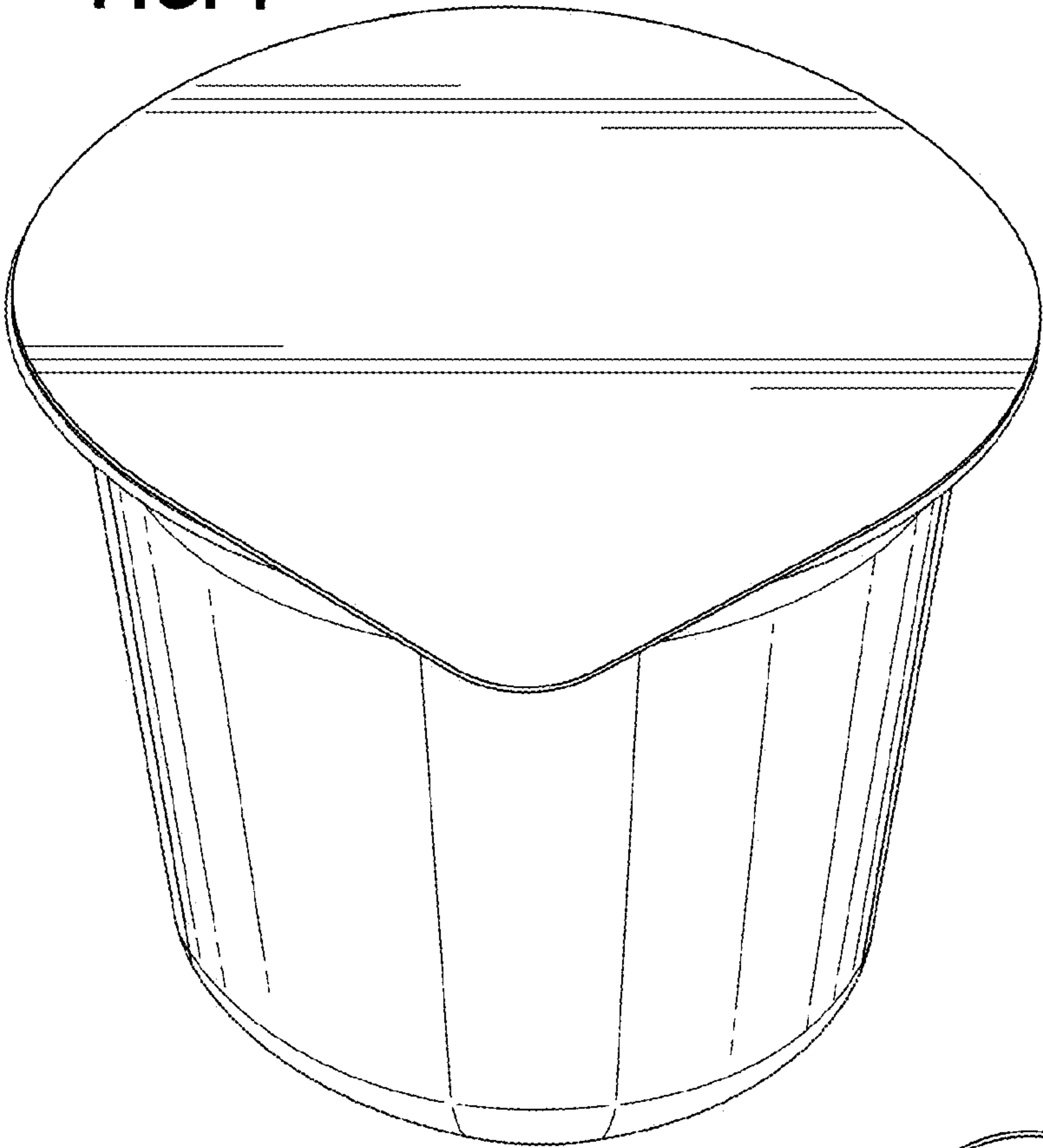

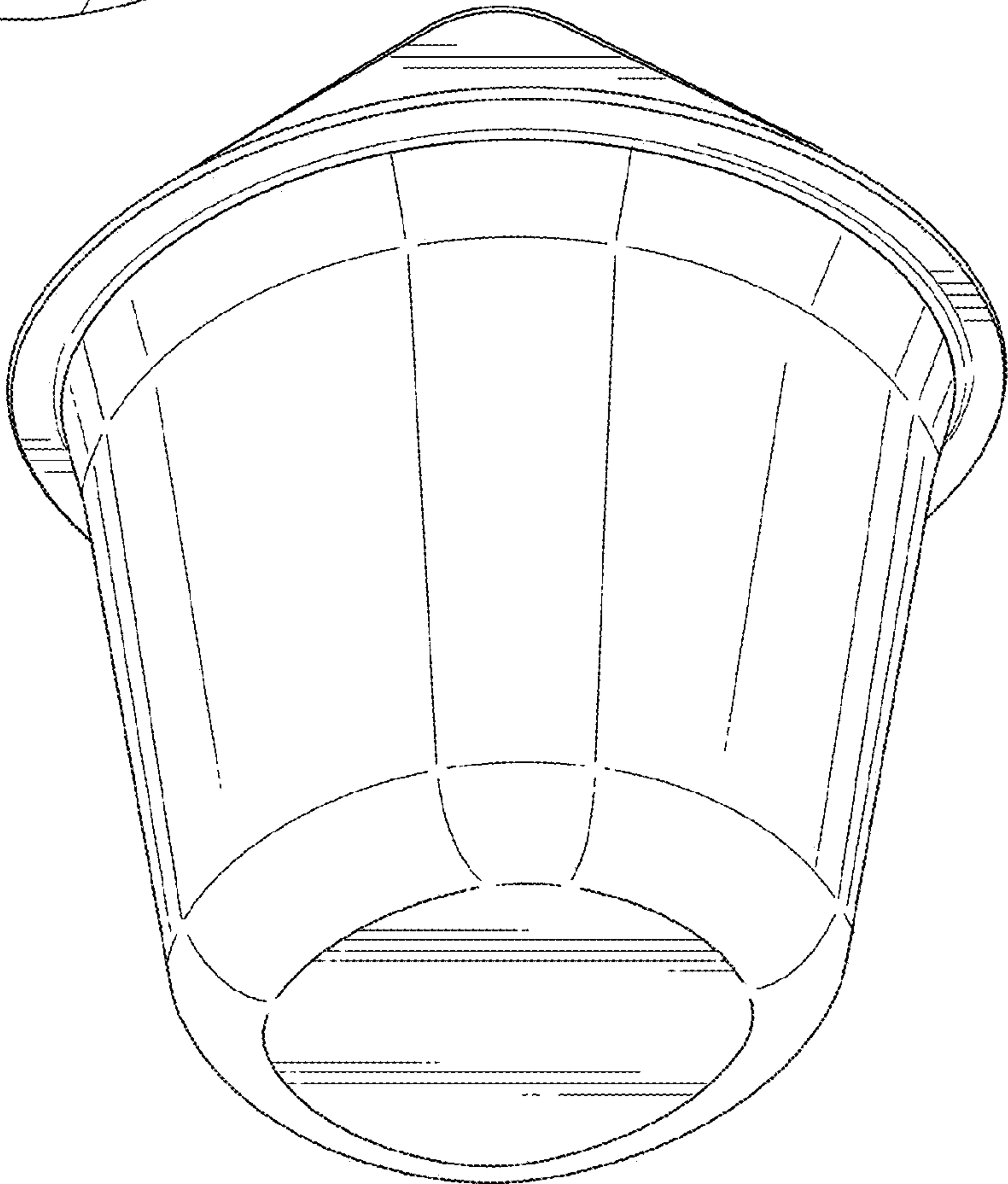

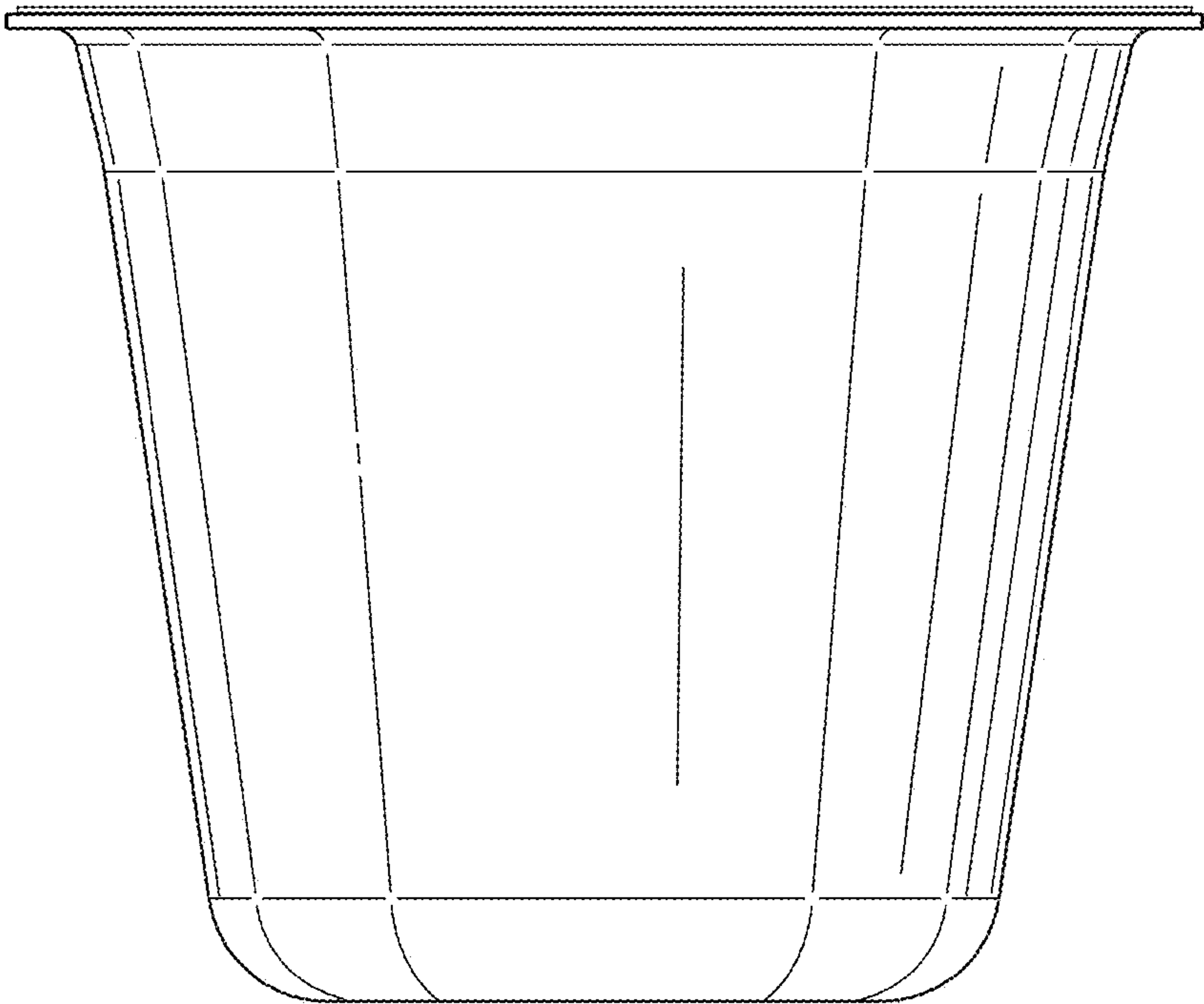

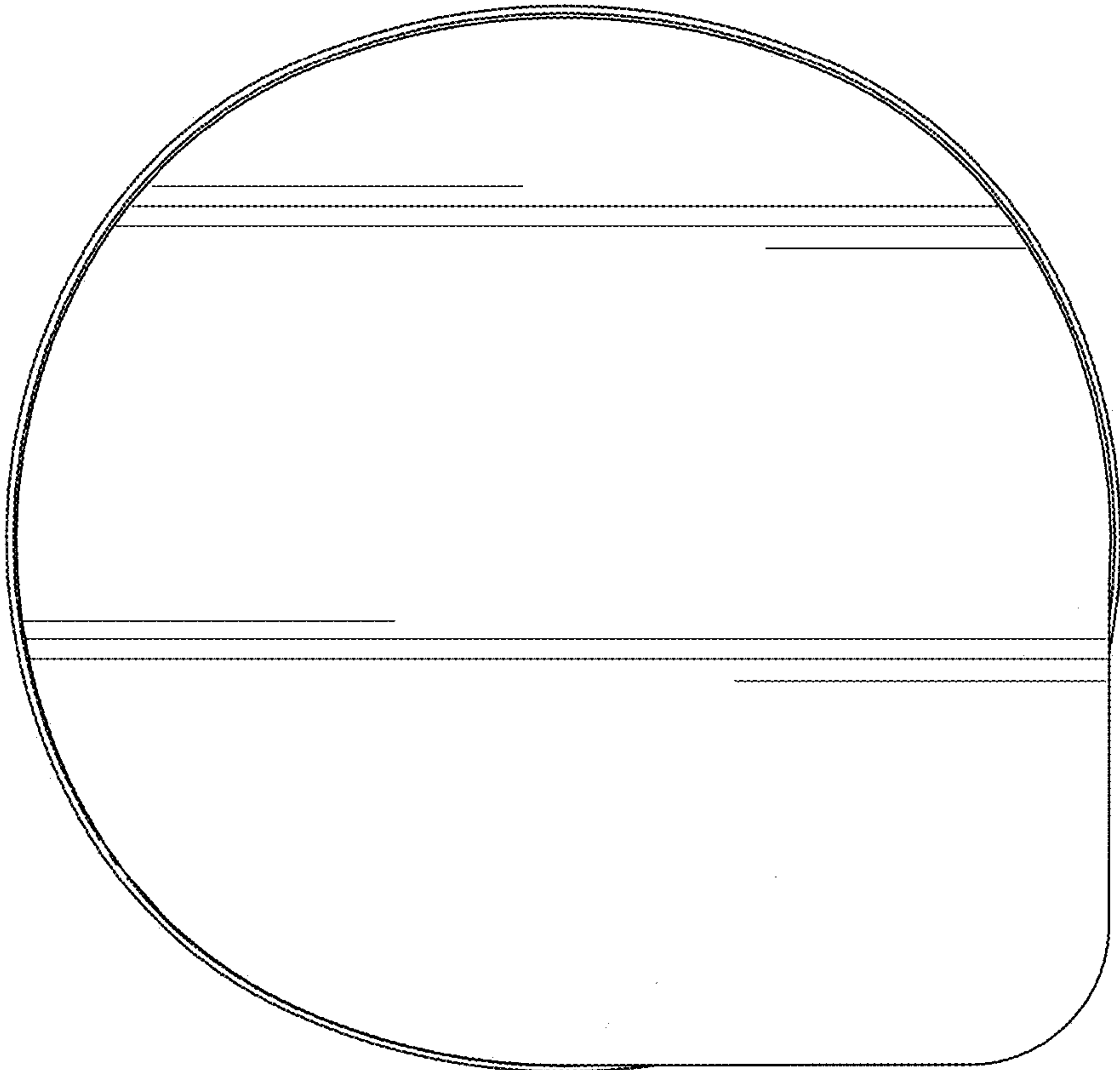

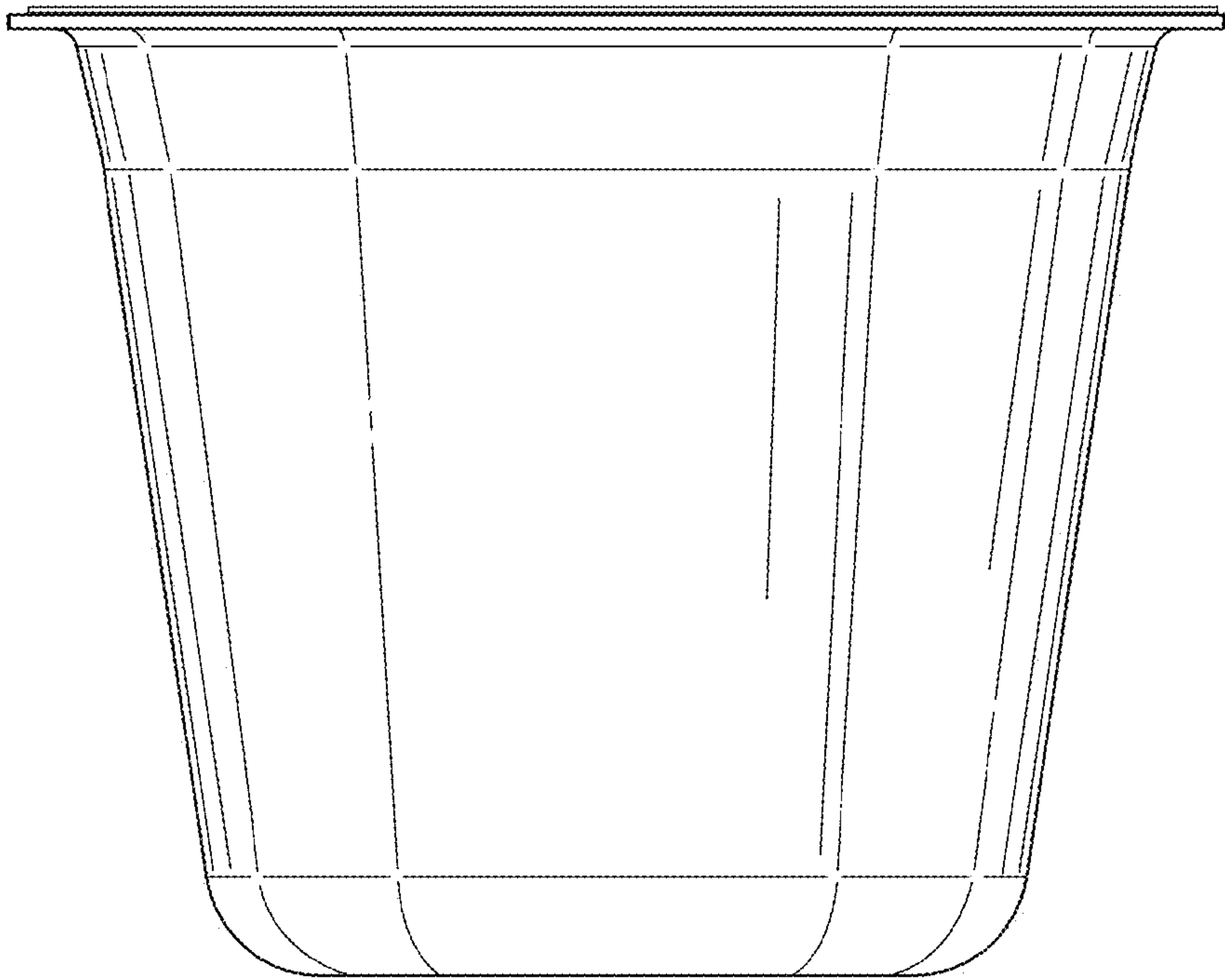

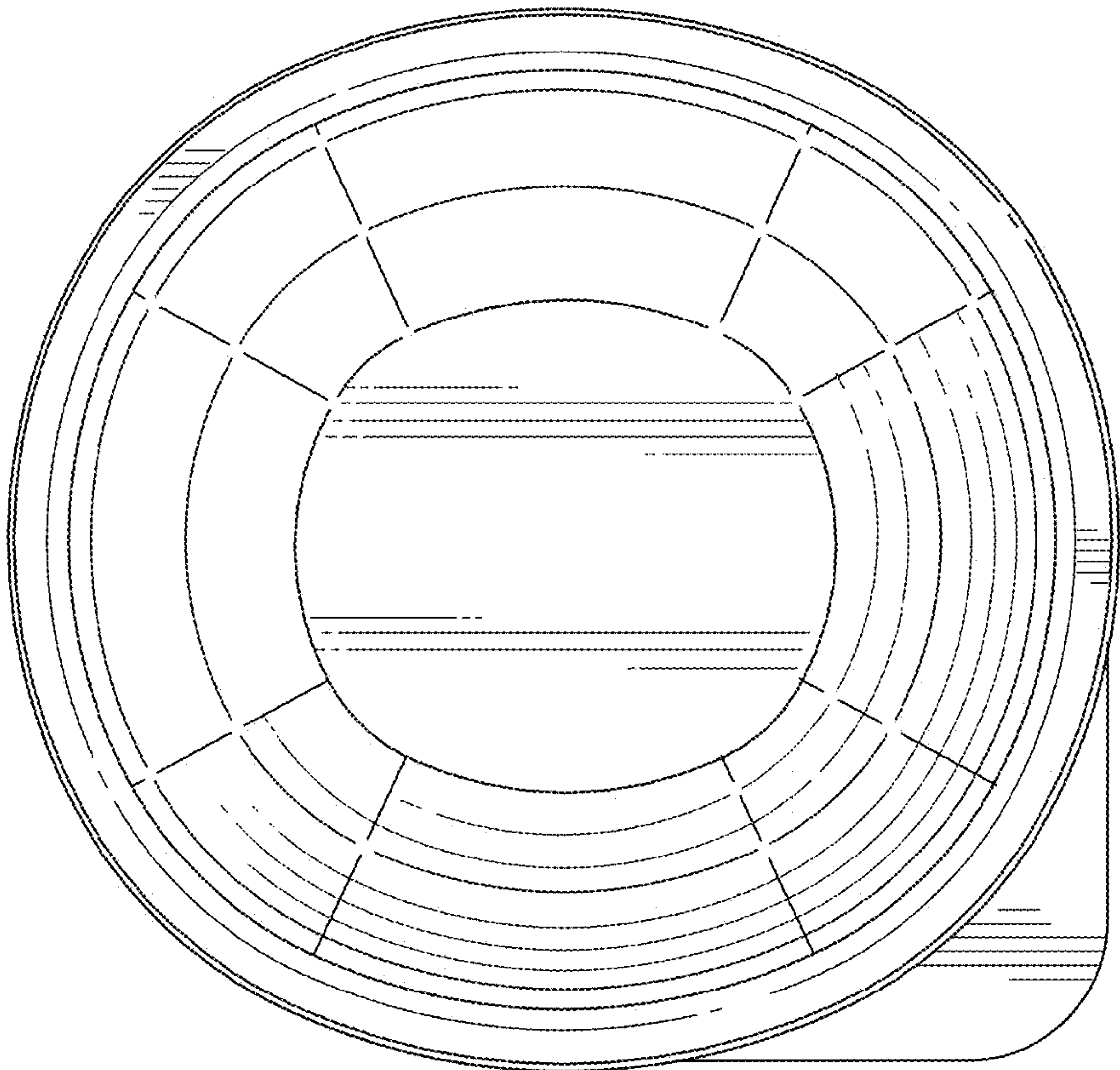

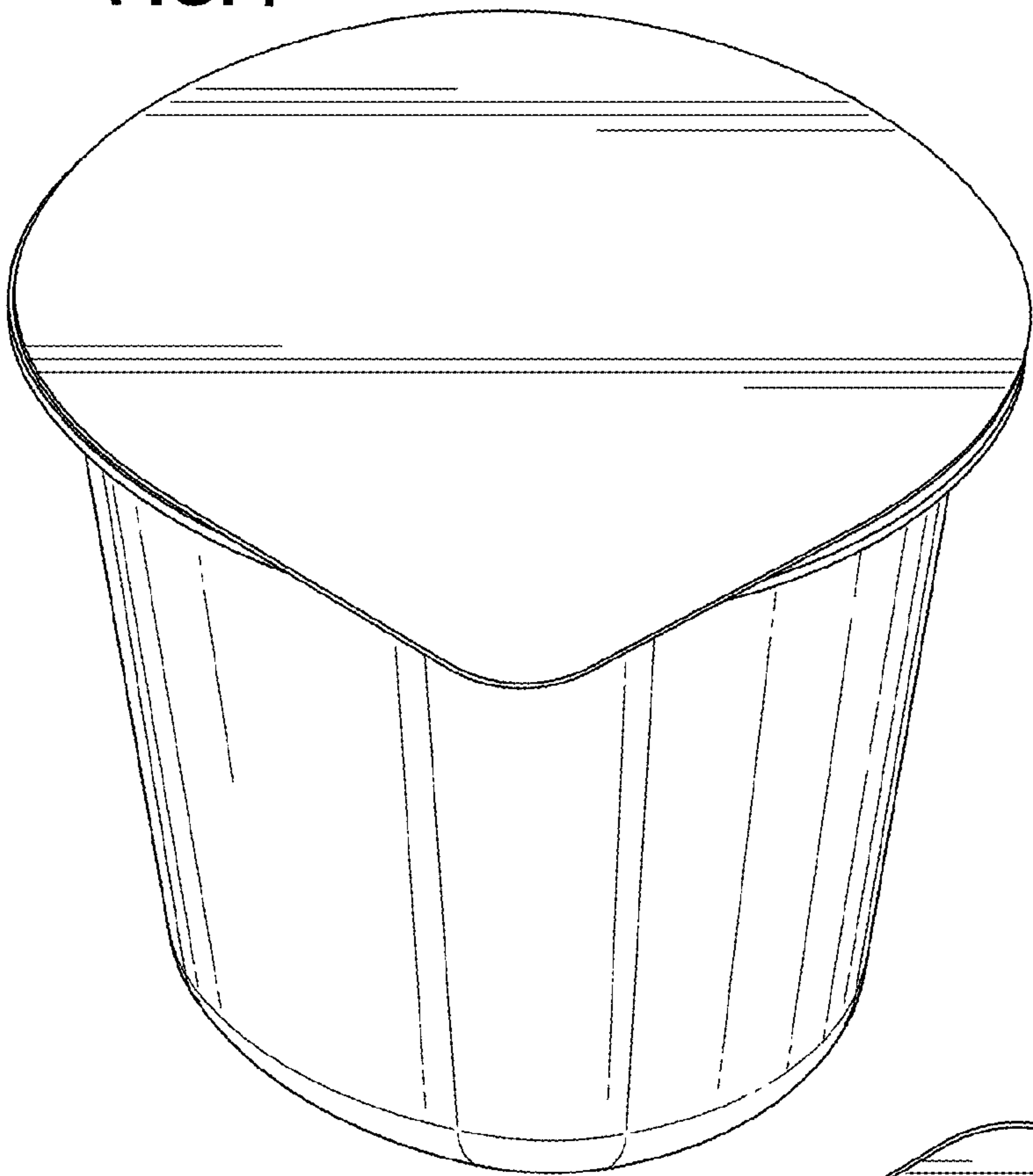

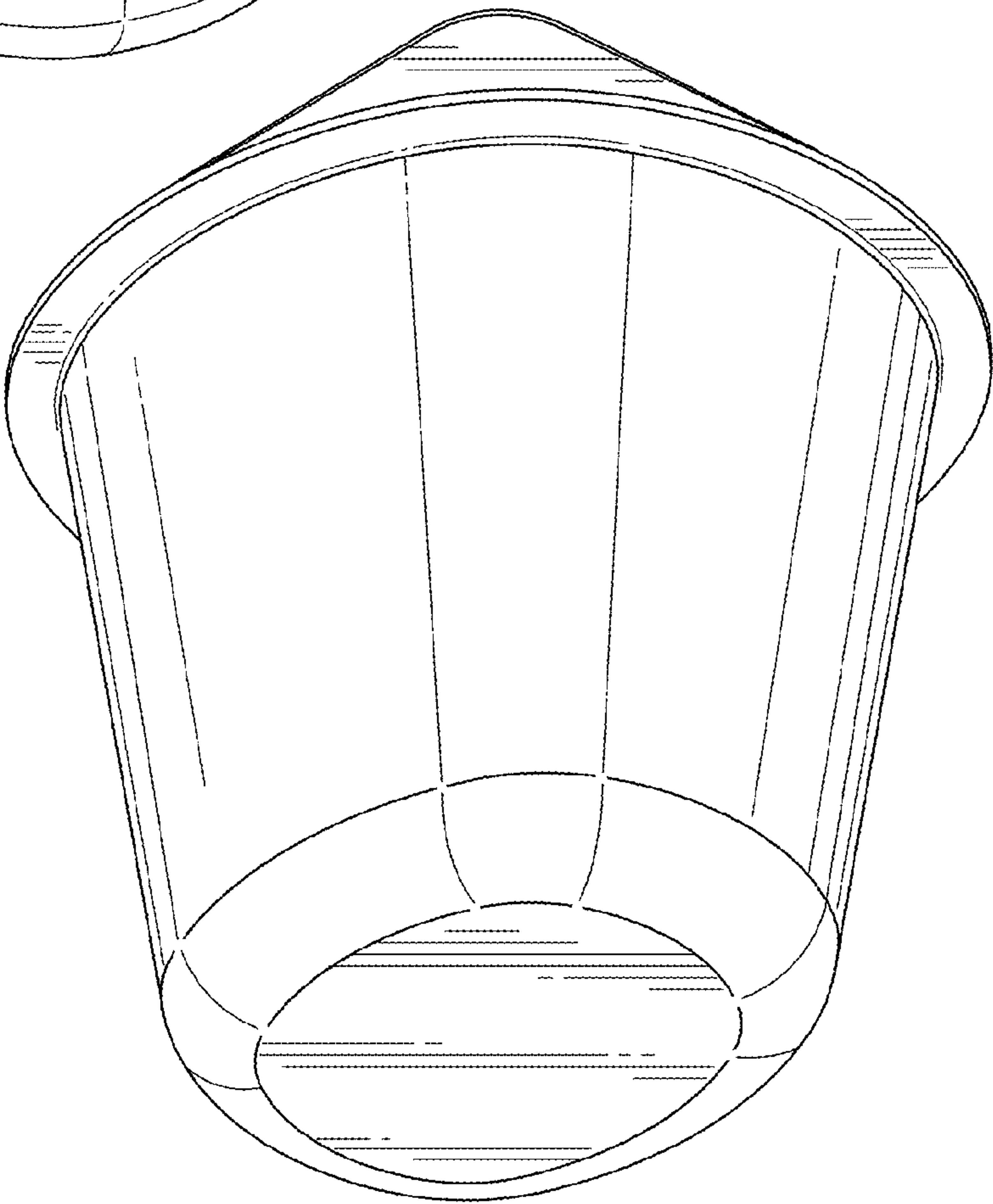

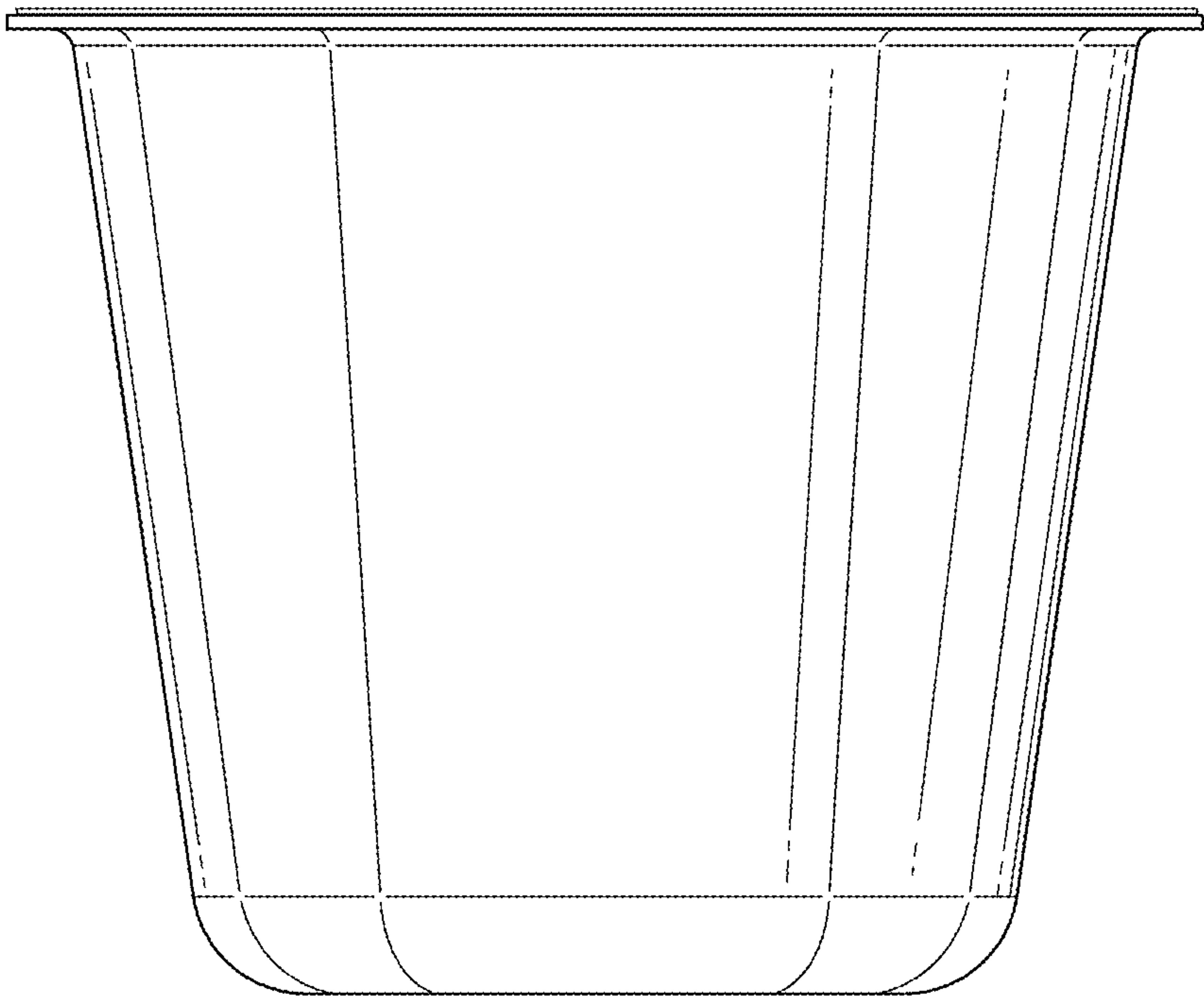

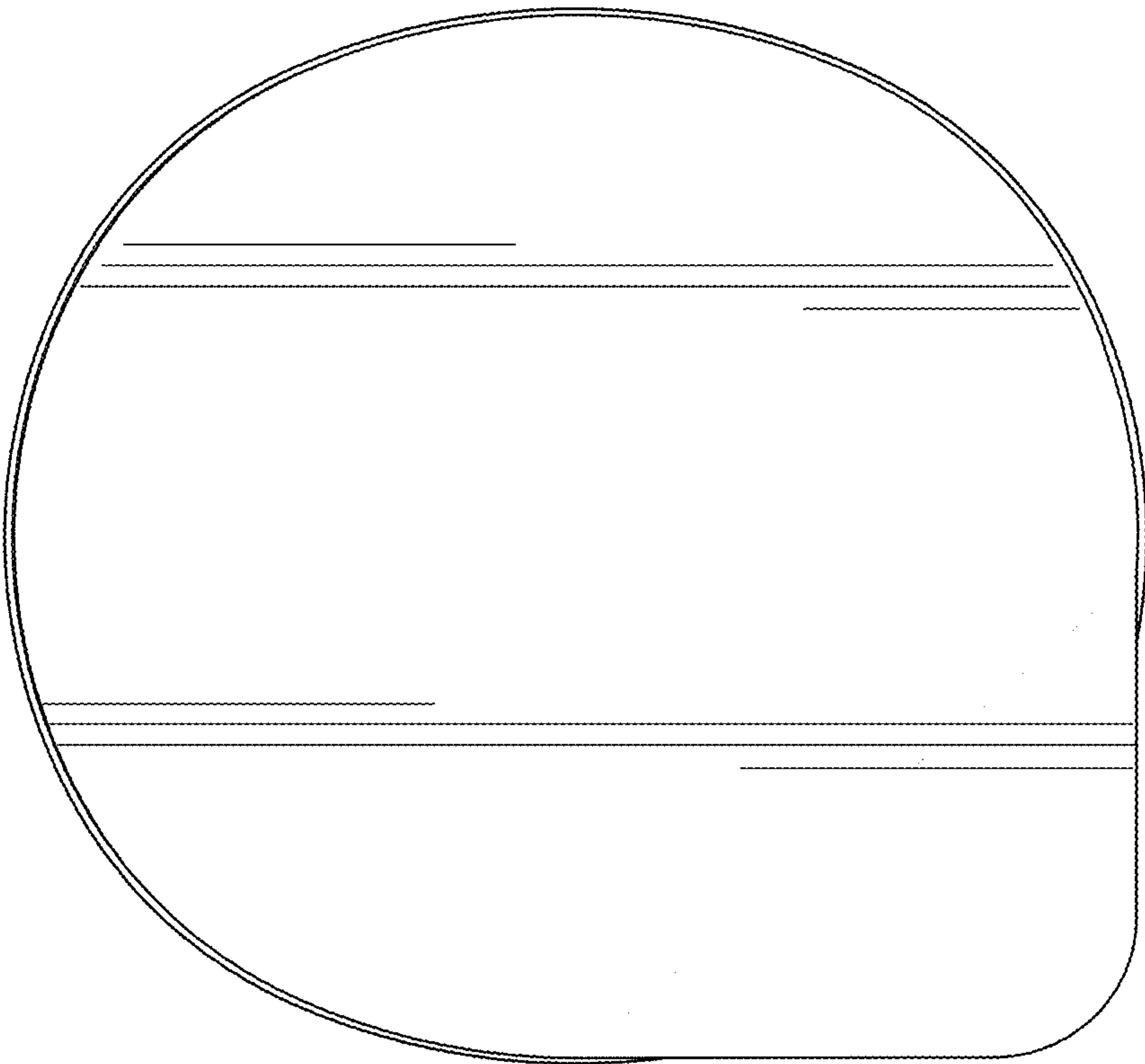

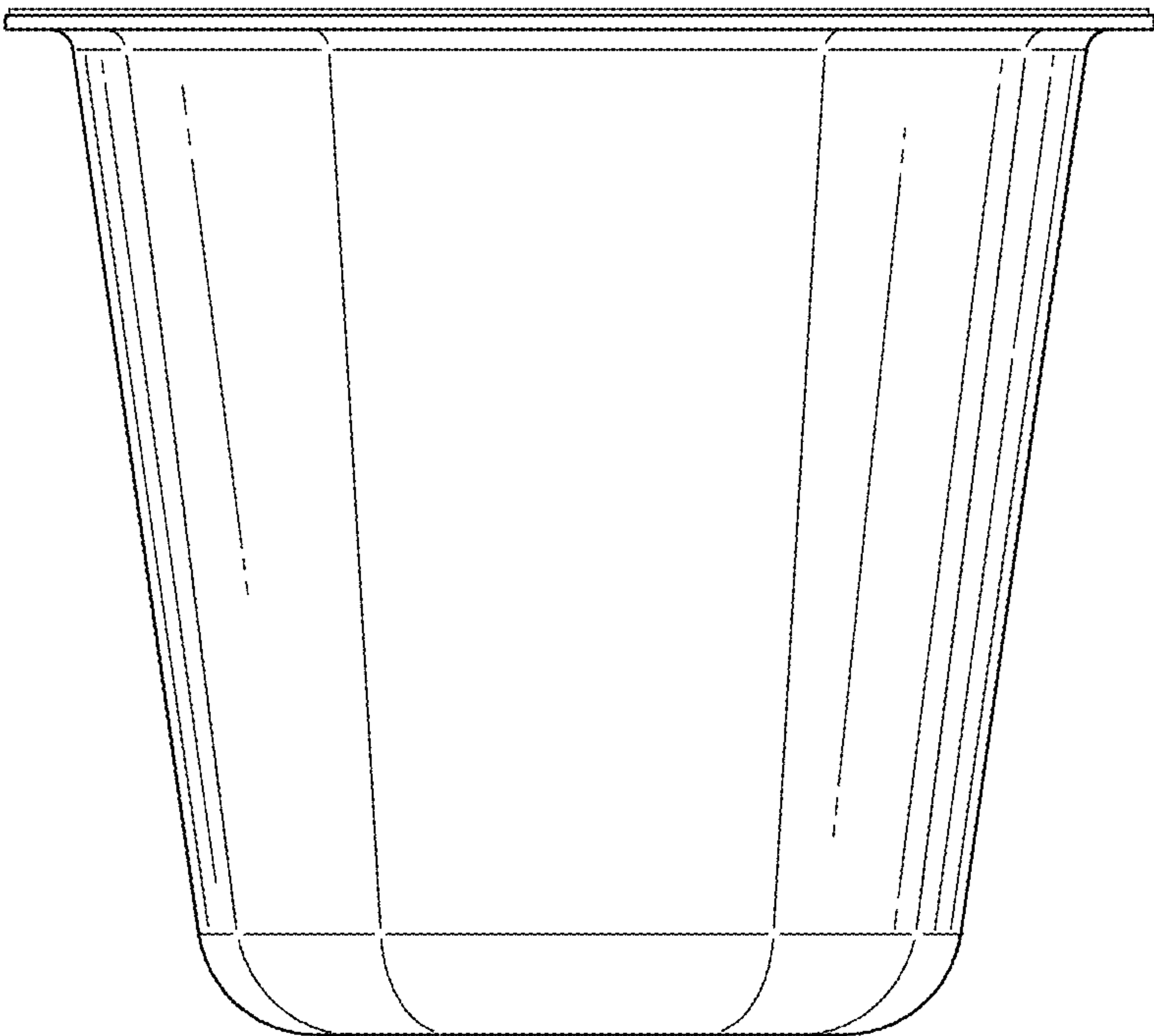

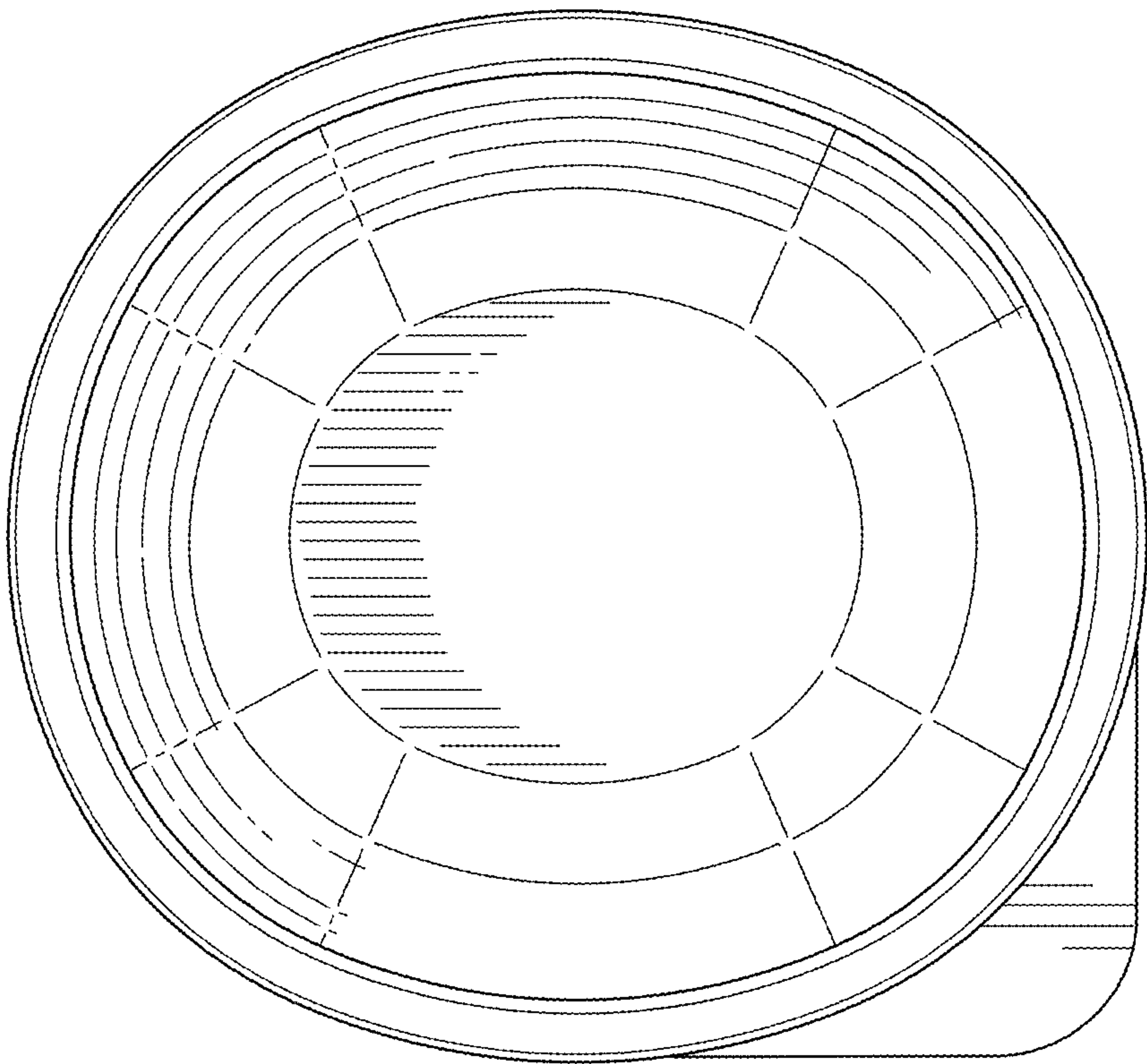

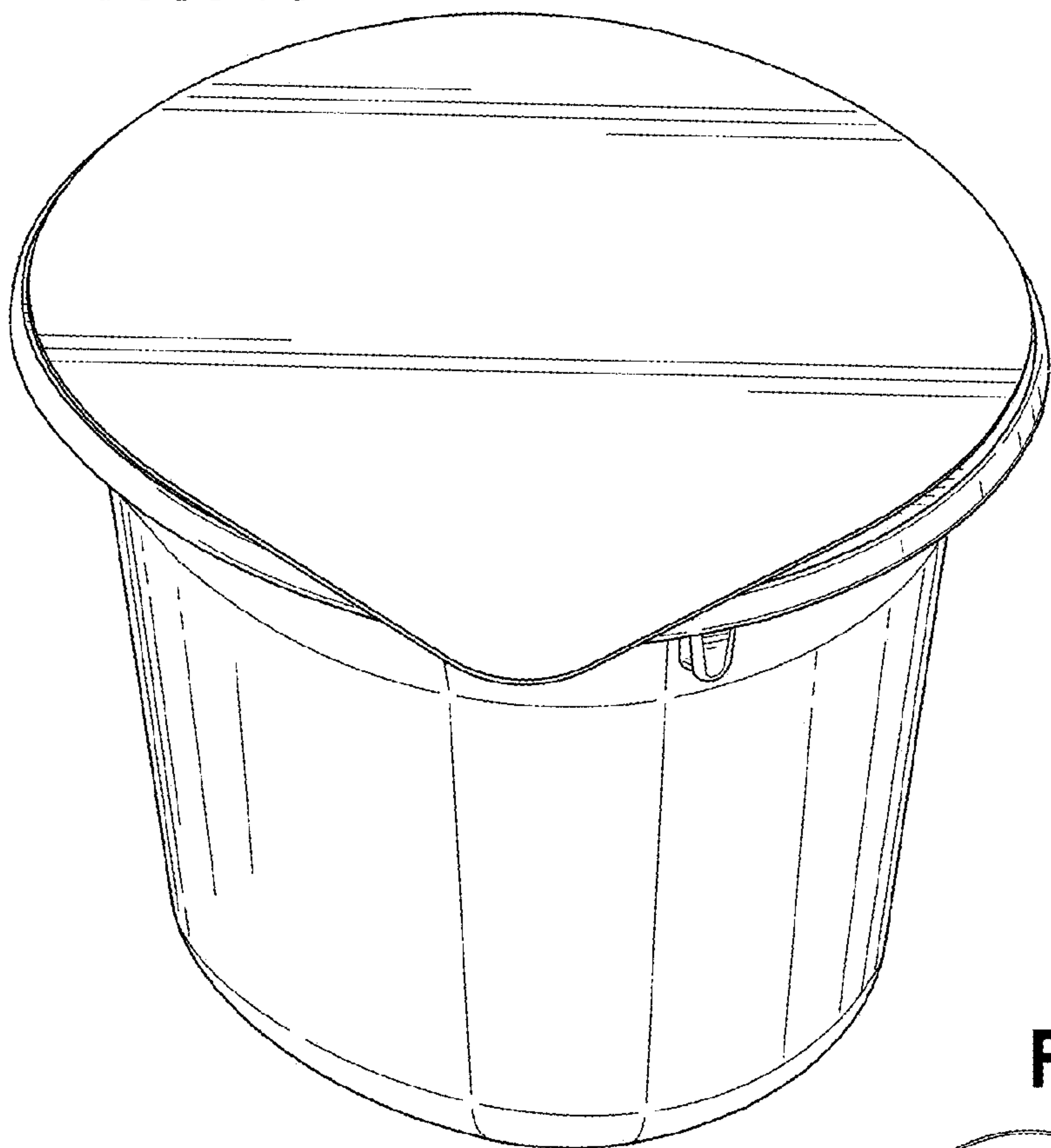

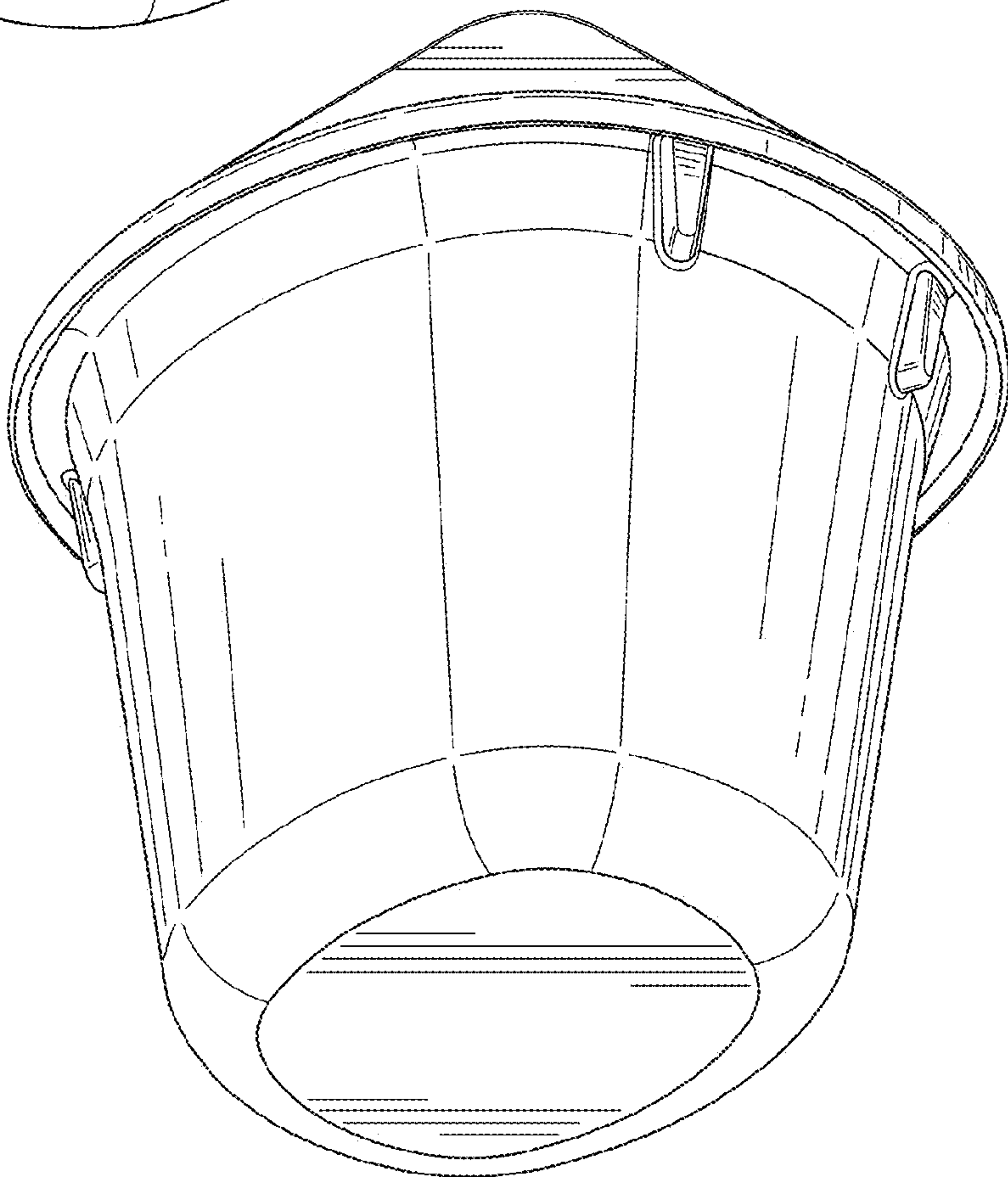

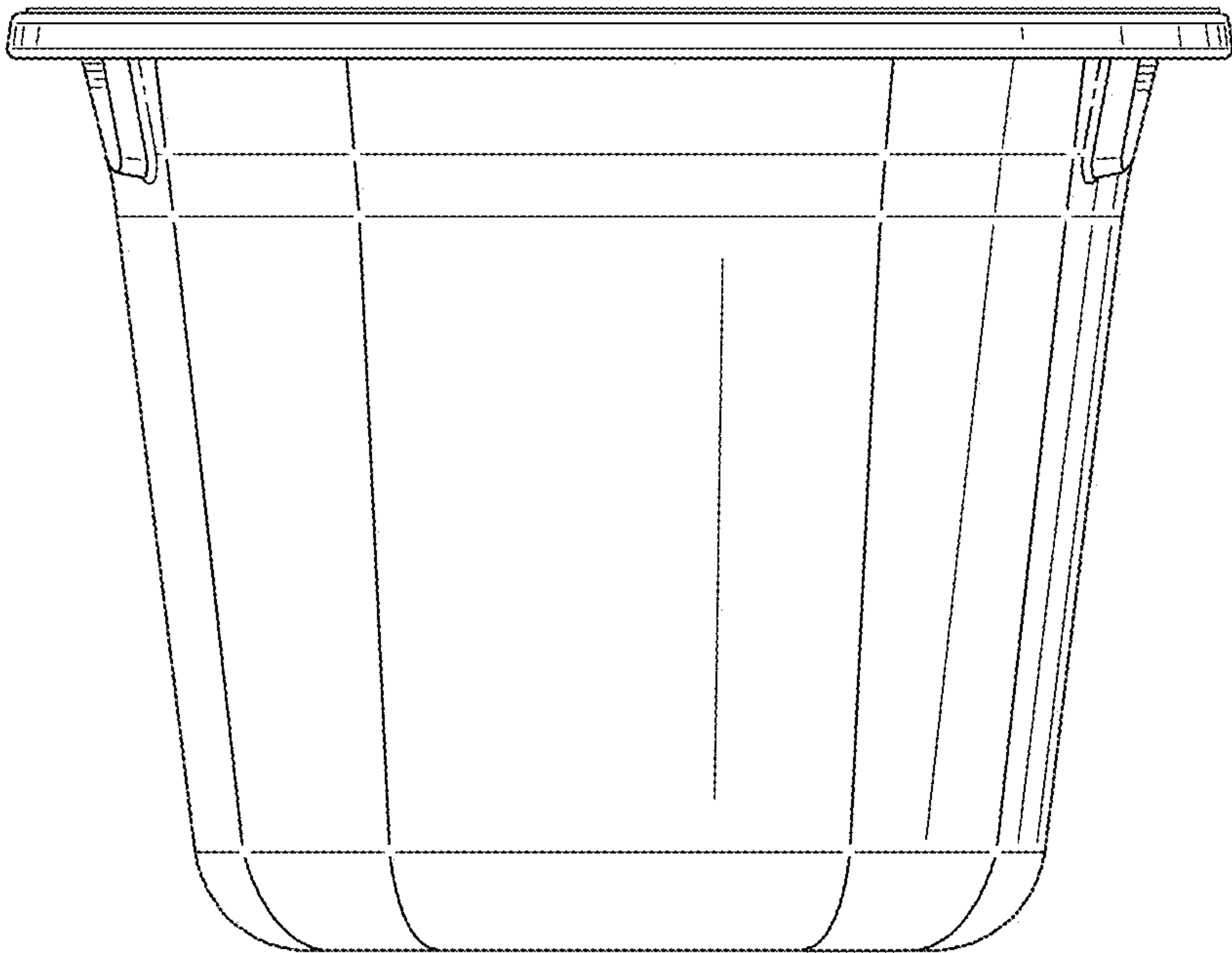

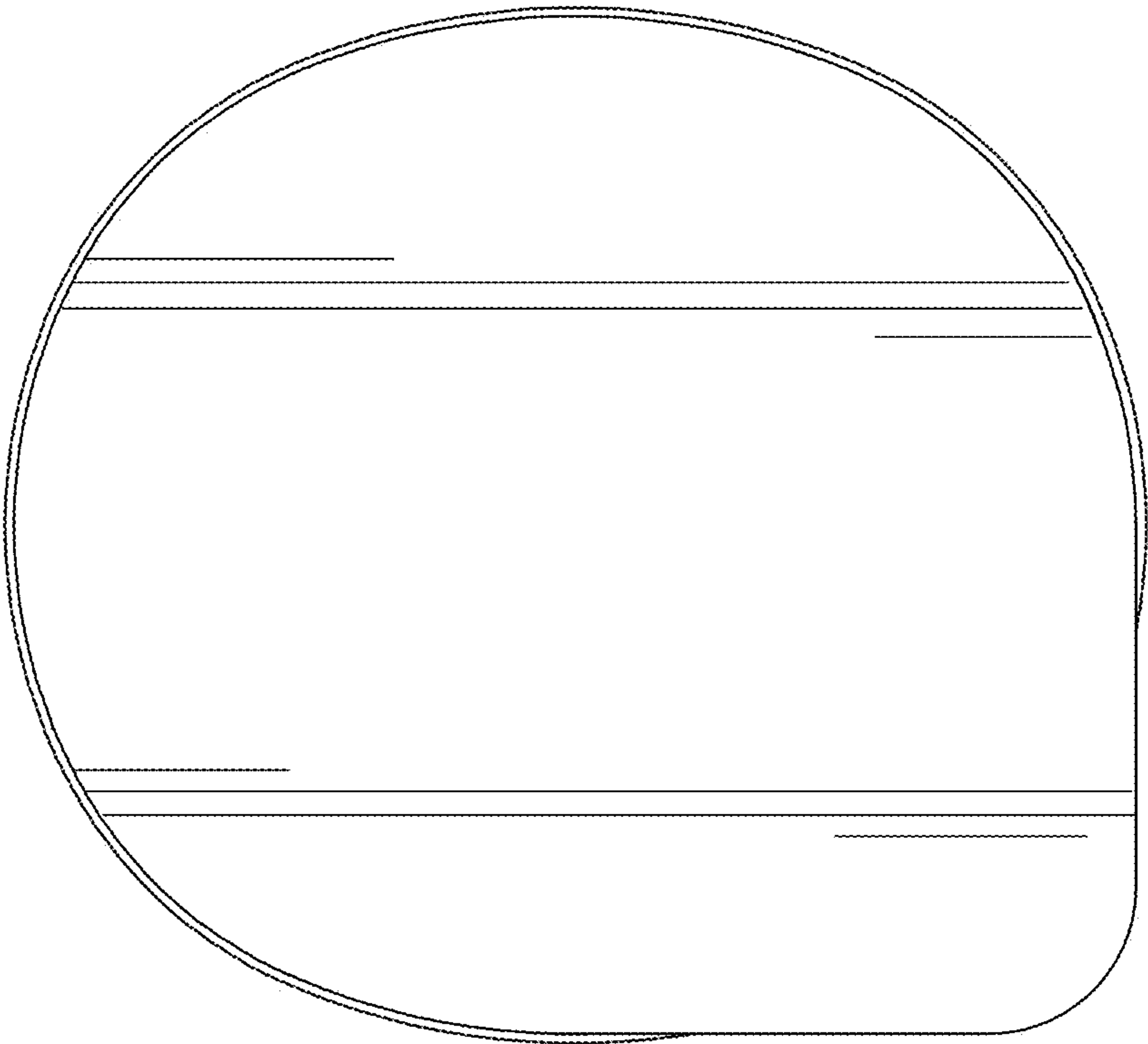

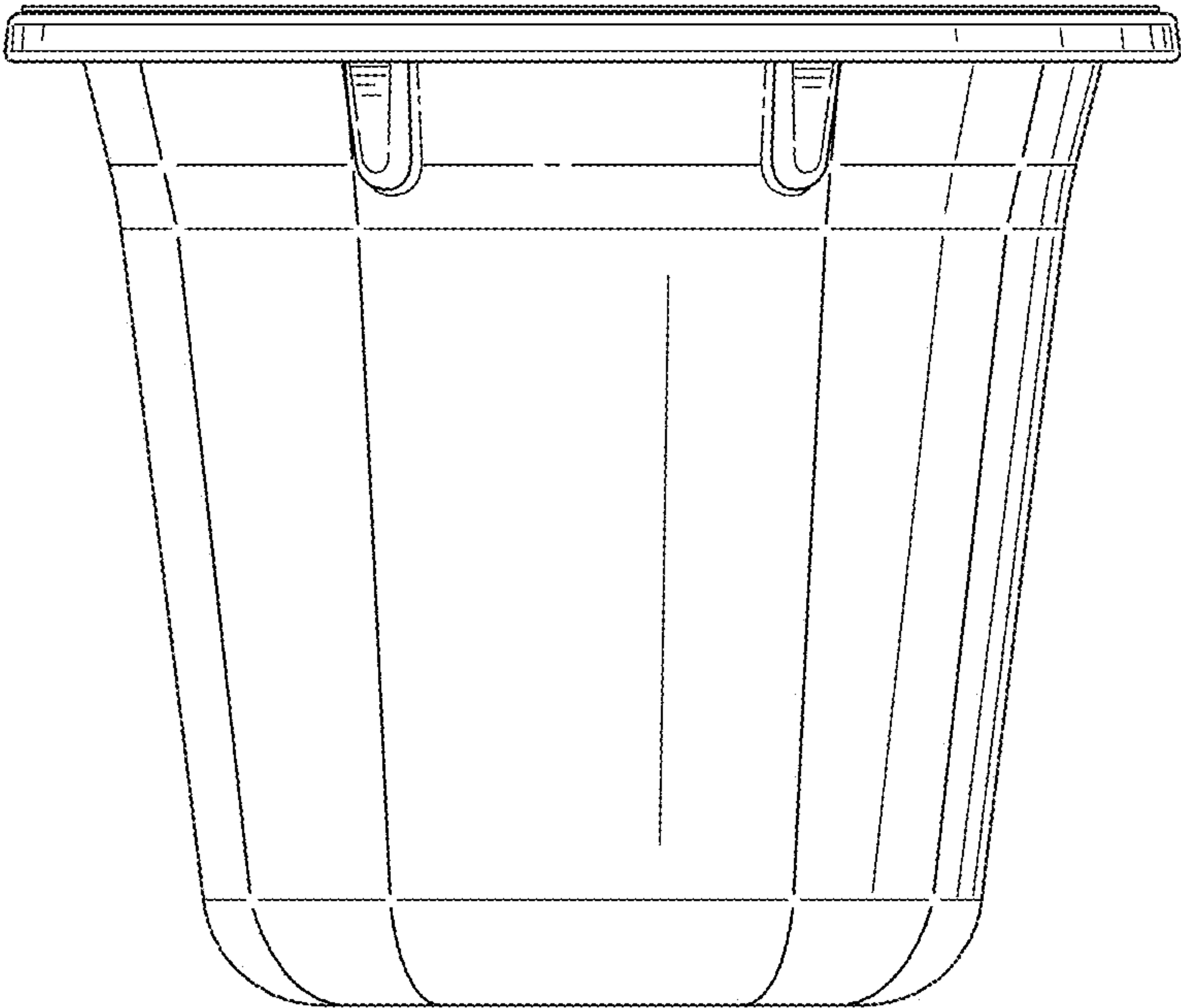

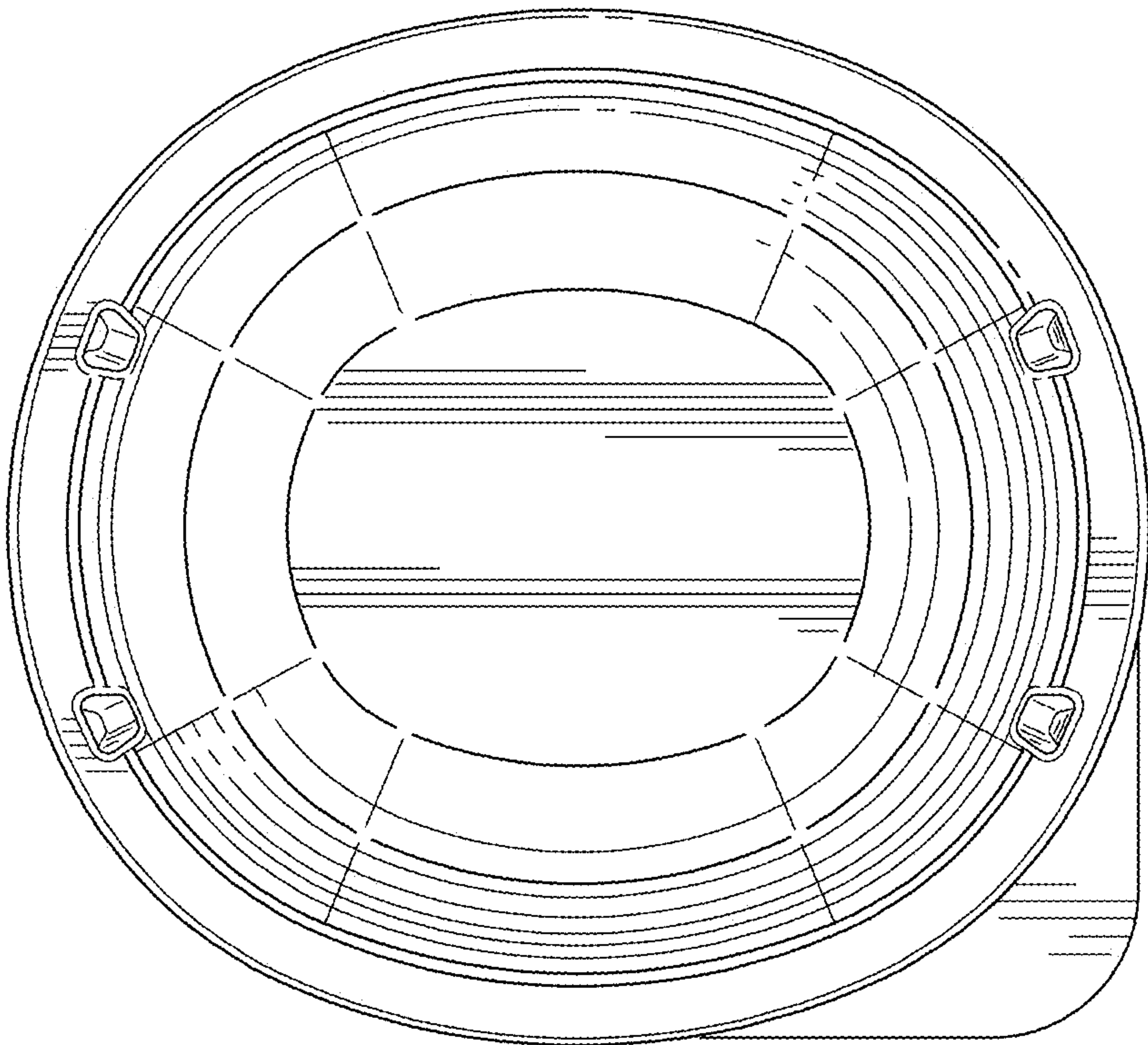

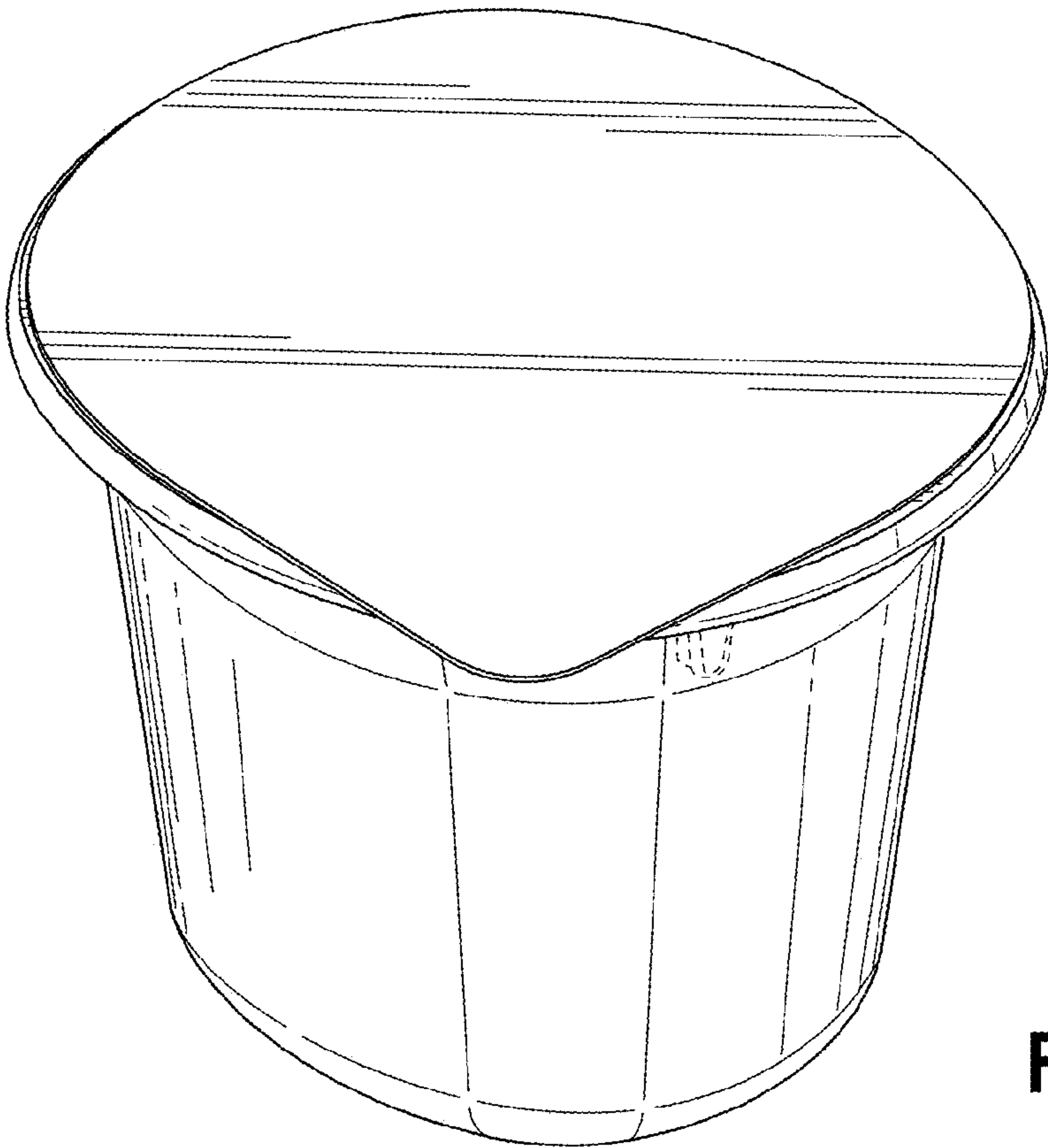

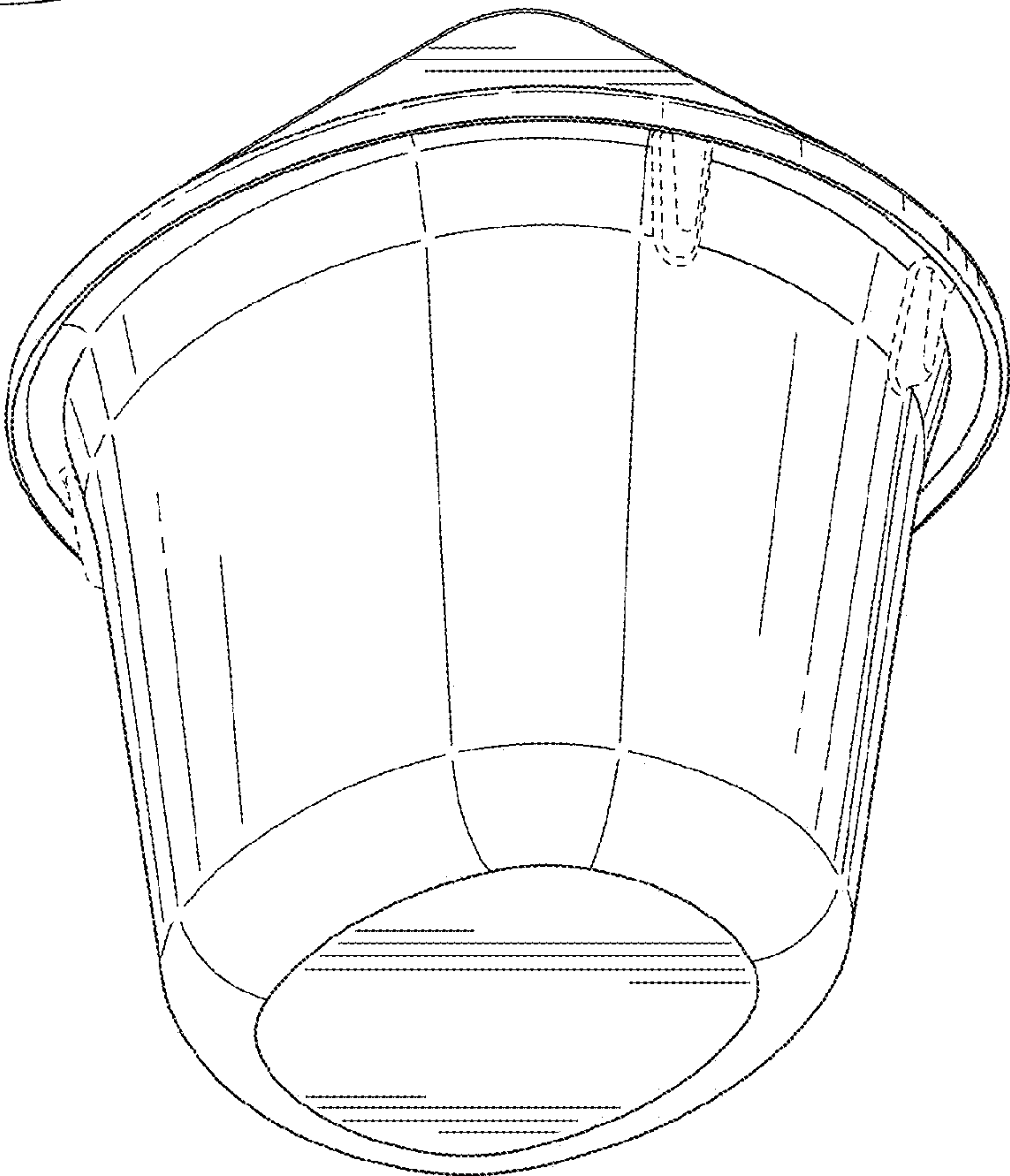

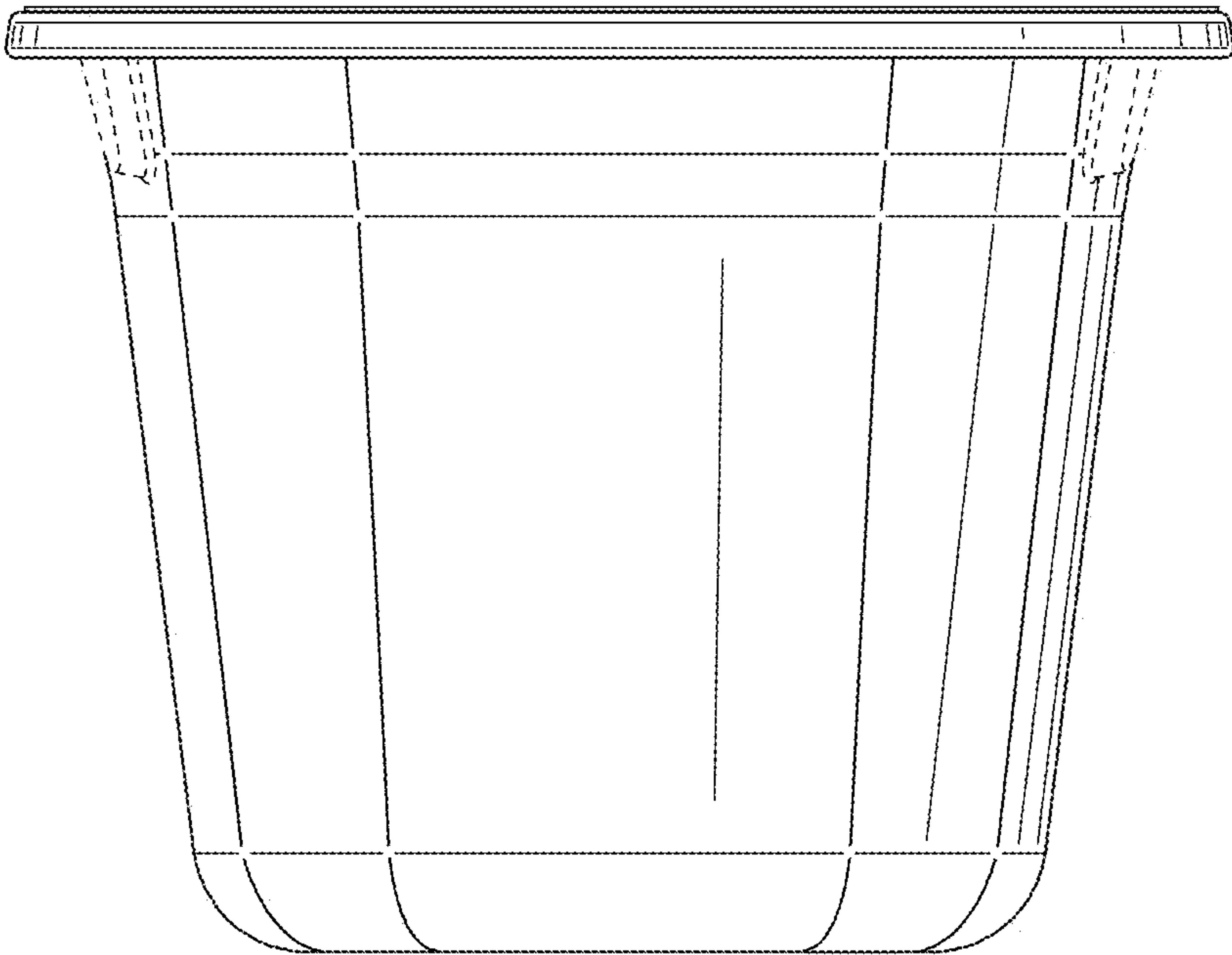

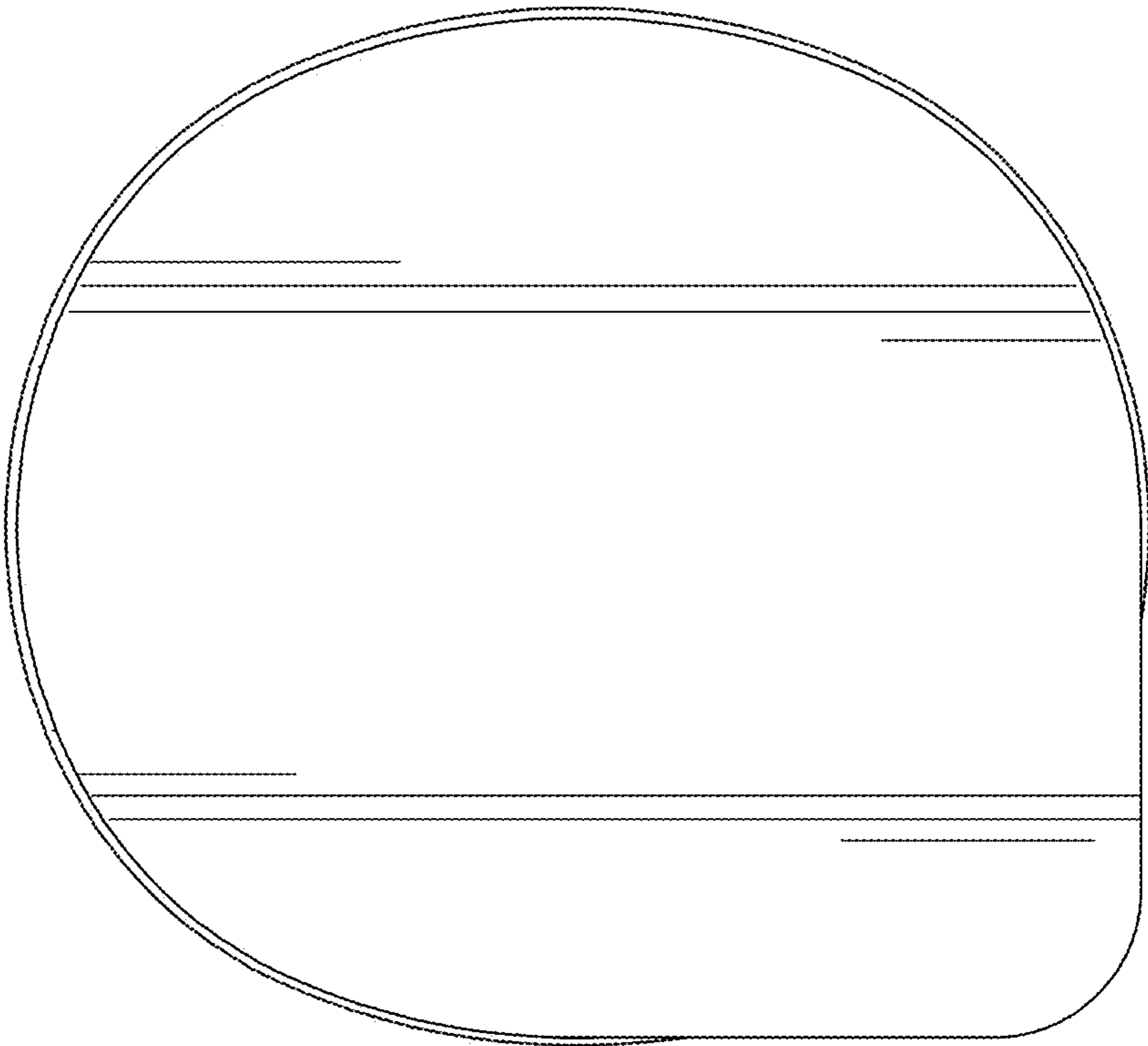

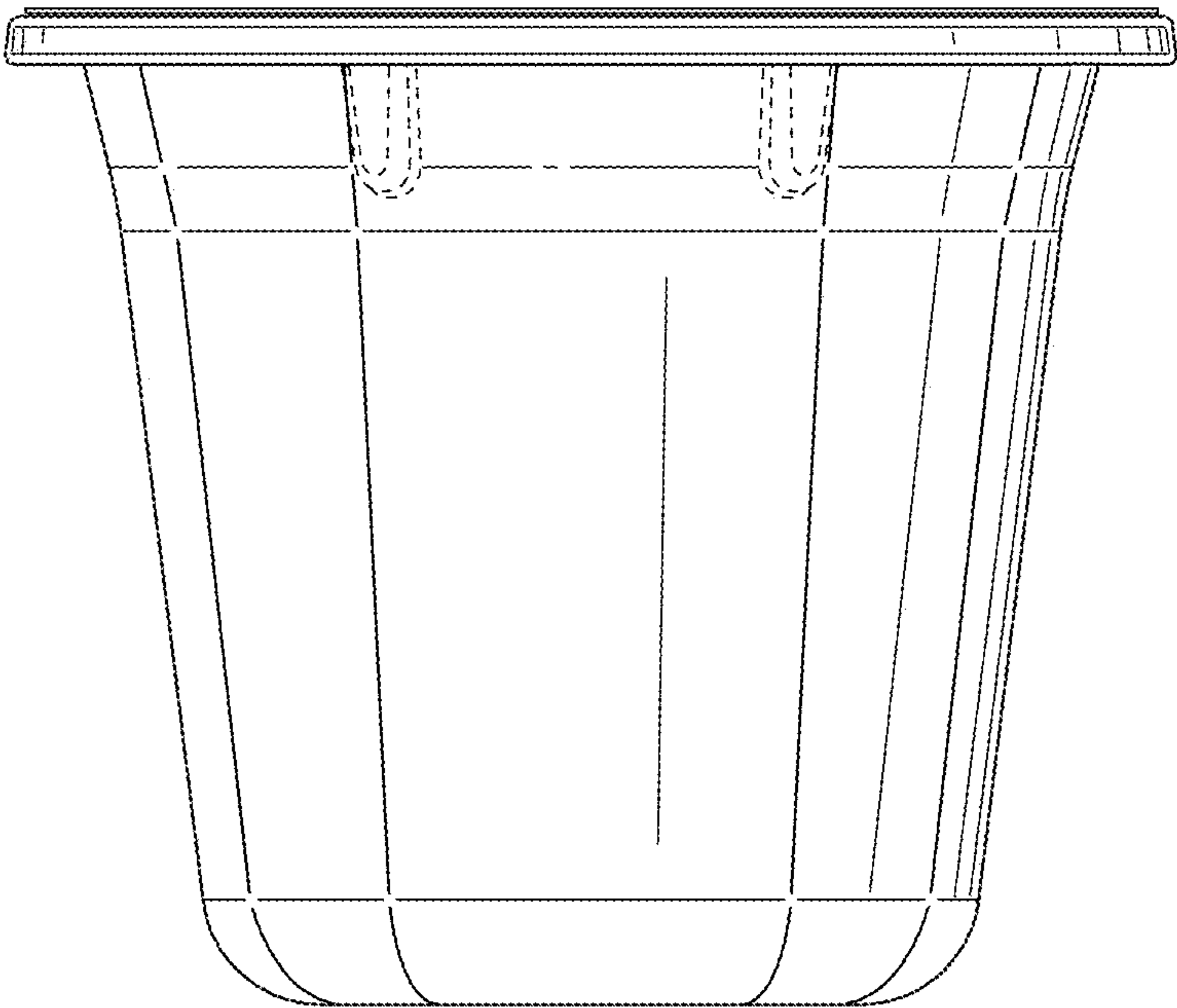
