DESCRIPTION

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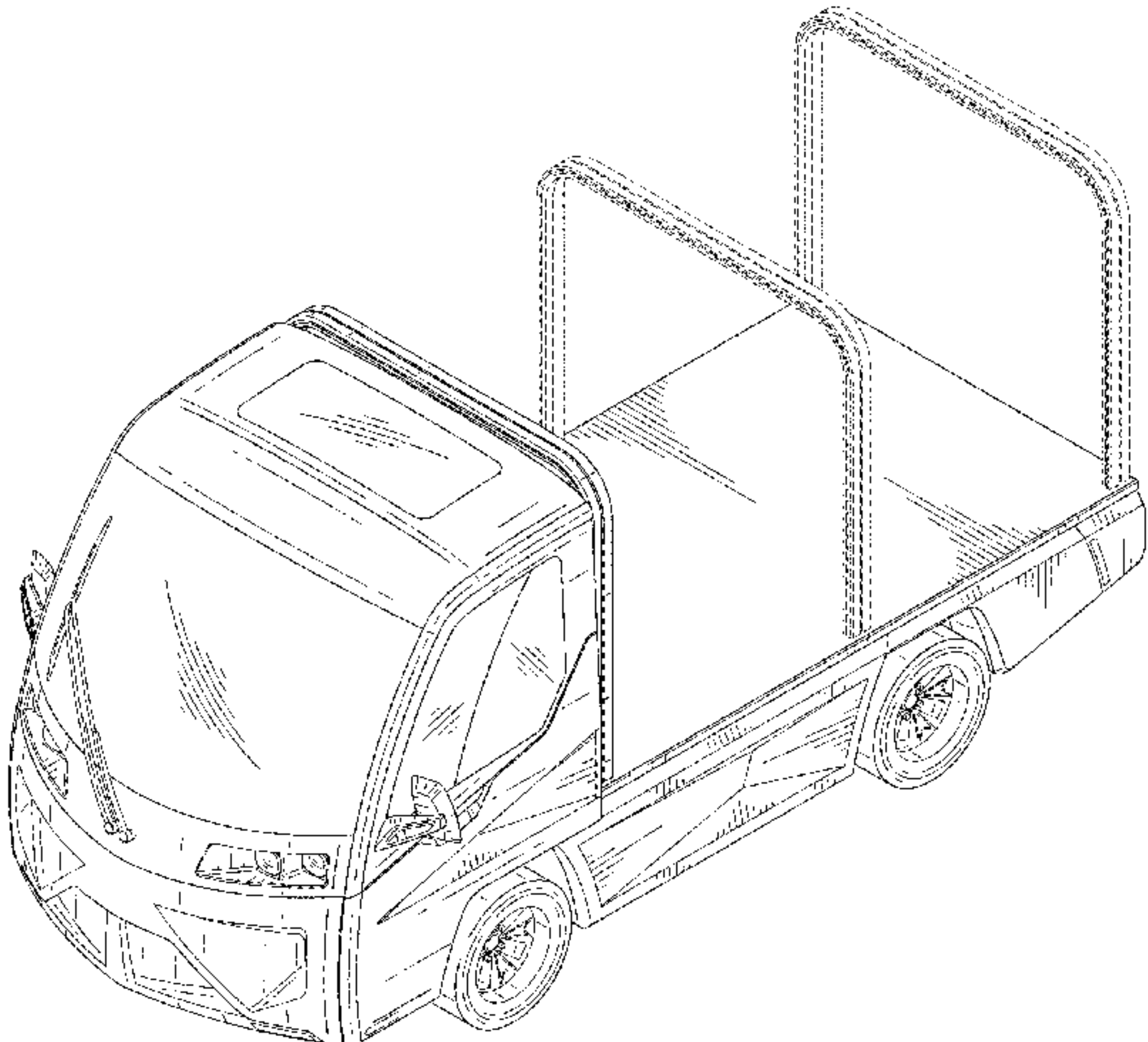


FIG. 17 is a rear view of the third exemplary embodiment of FIG. 15;

Each bottom view of the first through four embodiments of the electric vehicle forms no part of the claimed design.

The broken lines shown in the drawings illustrate unclaimed portions of the electric vehicle and form no part of the claimed design.

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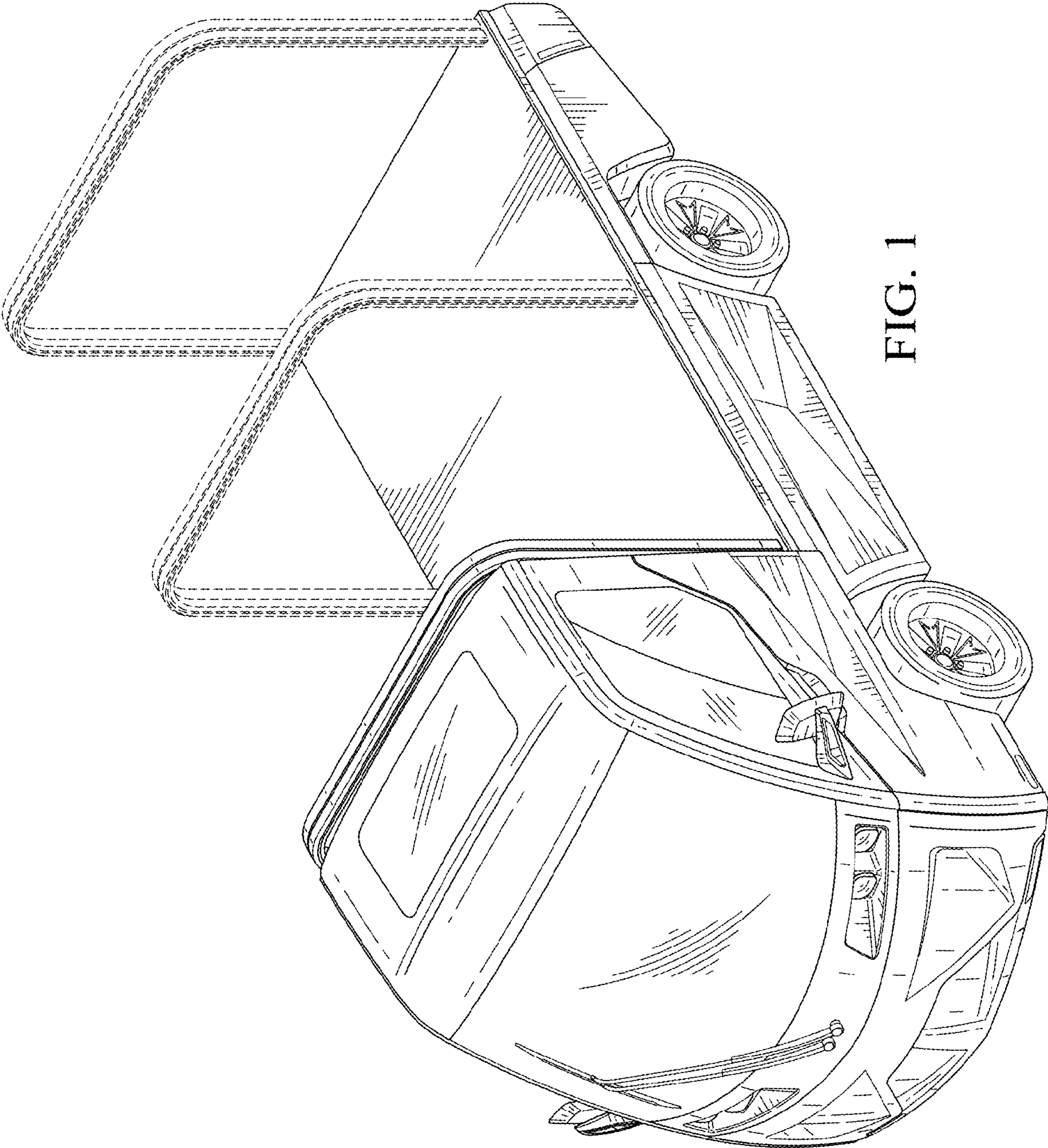

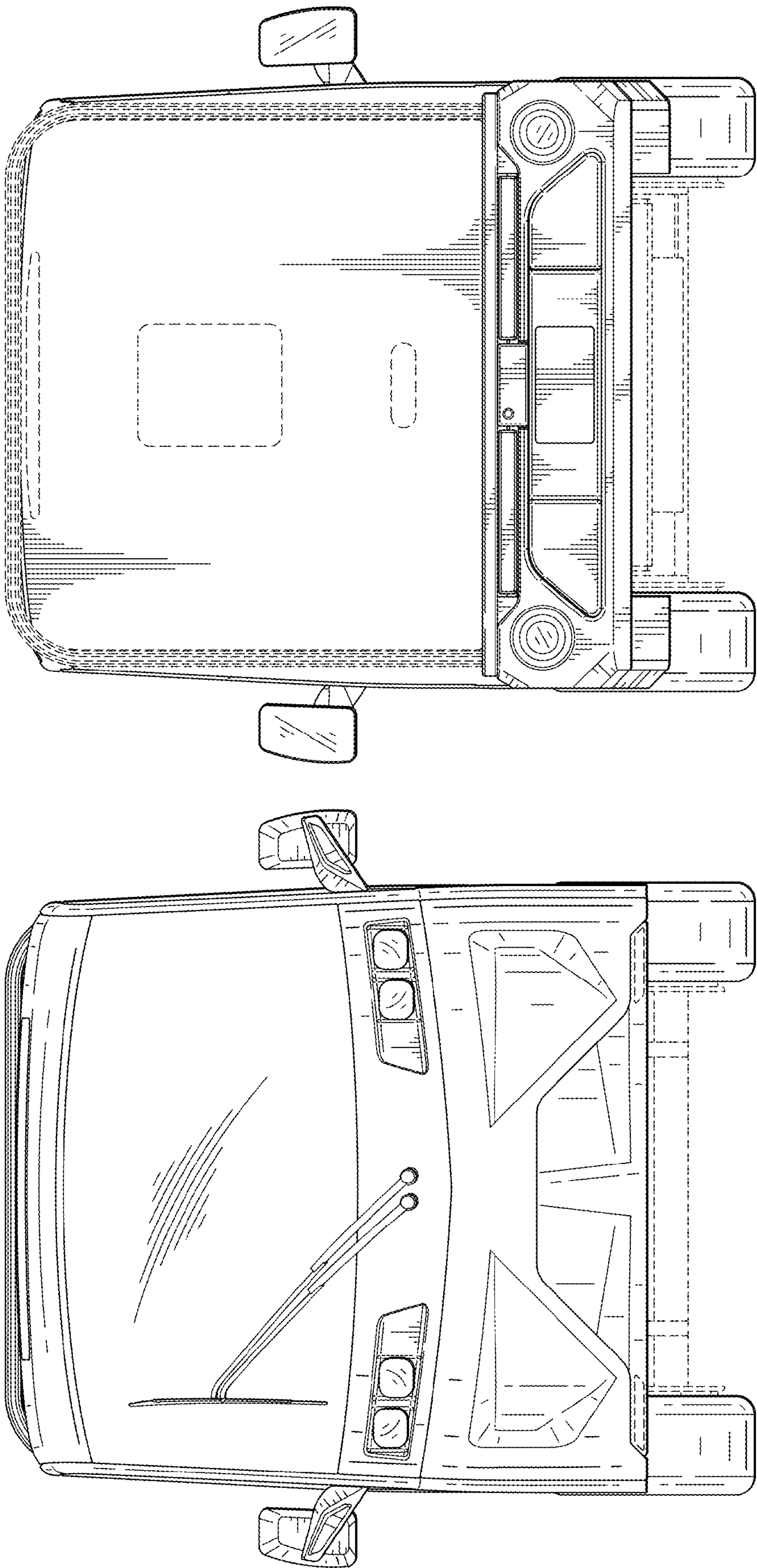

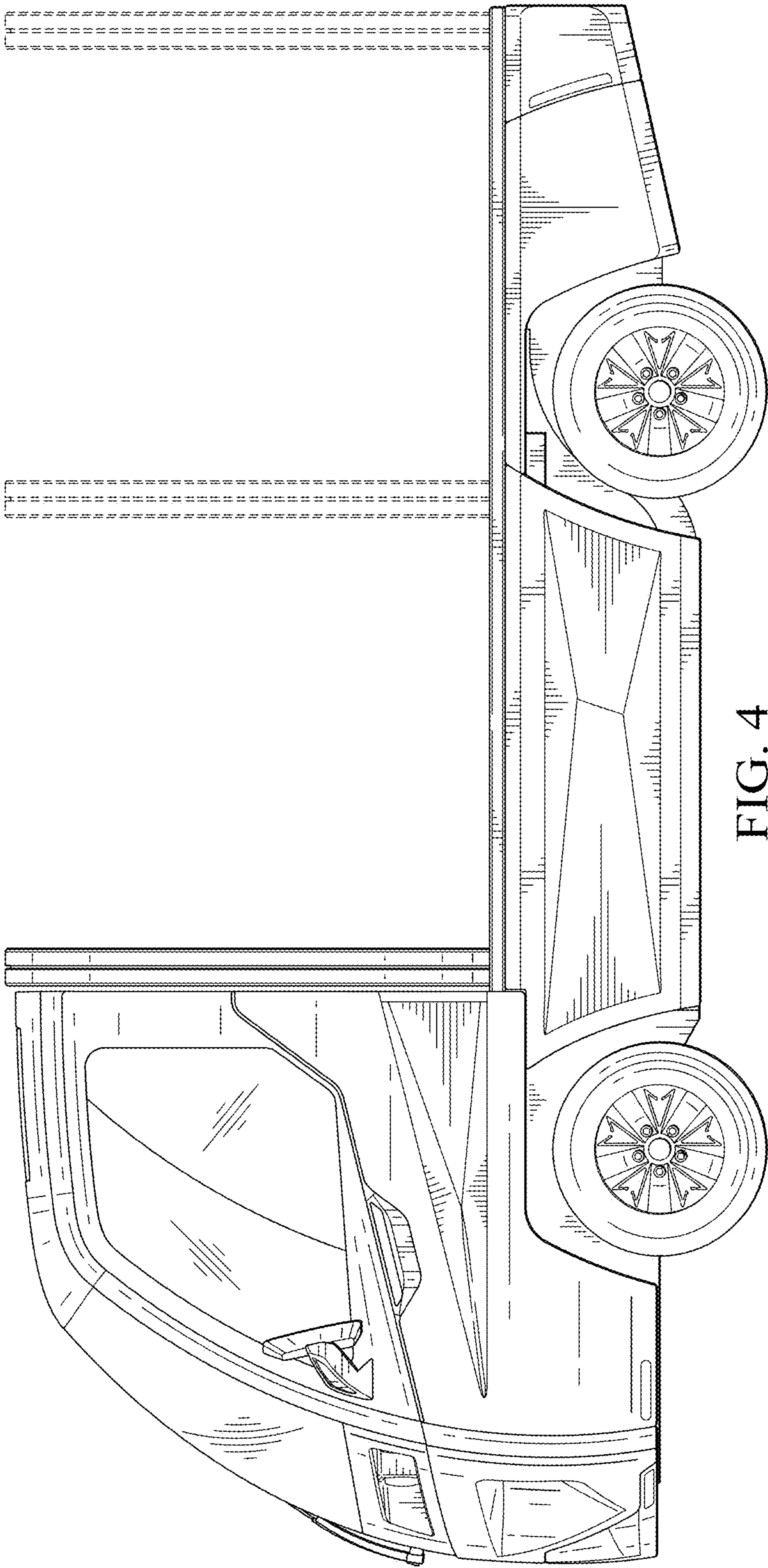

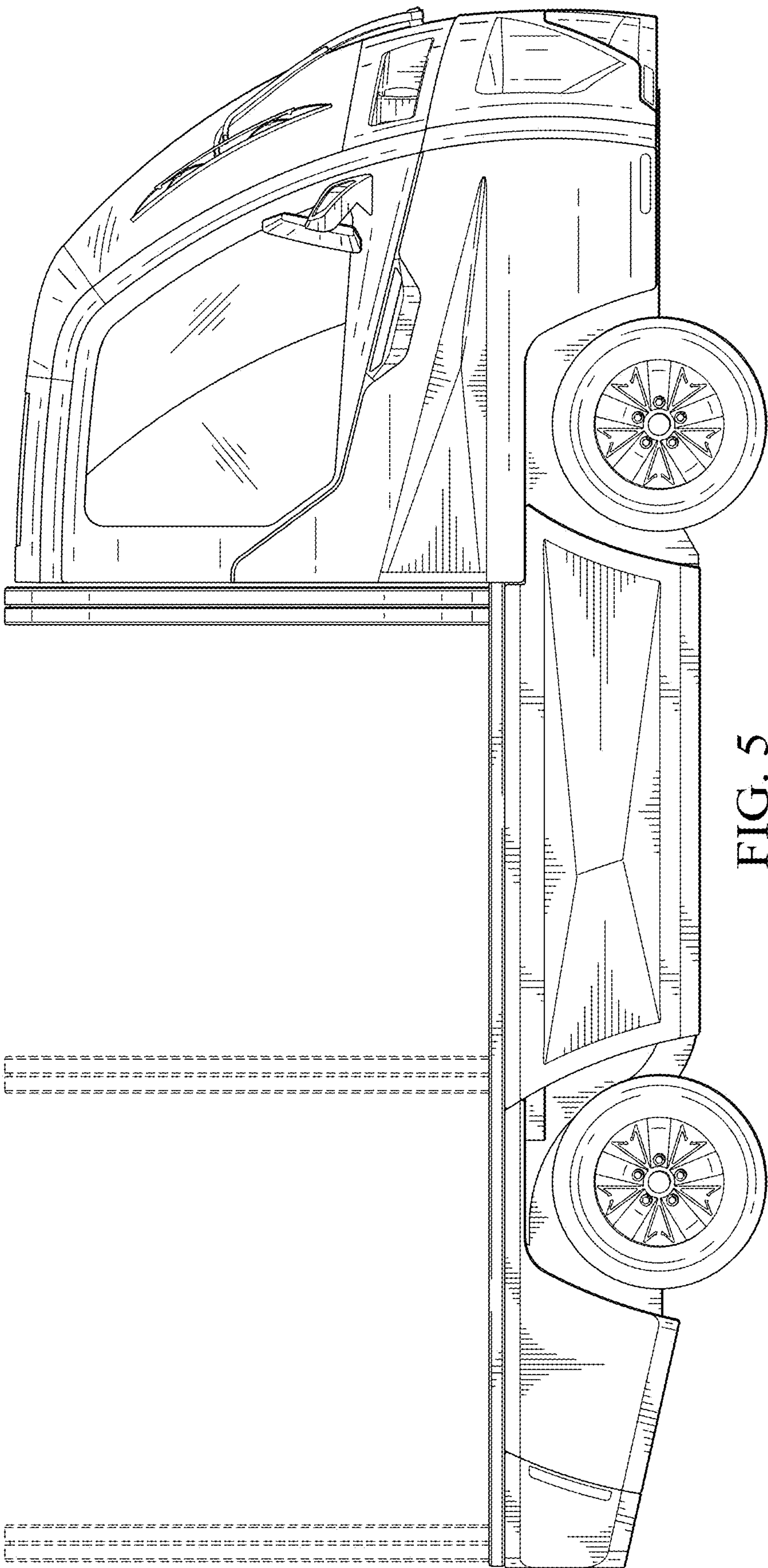

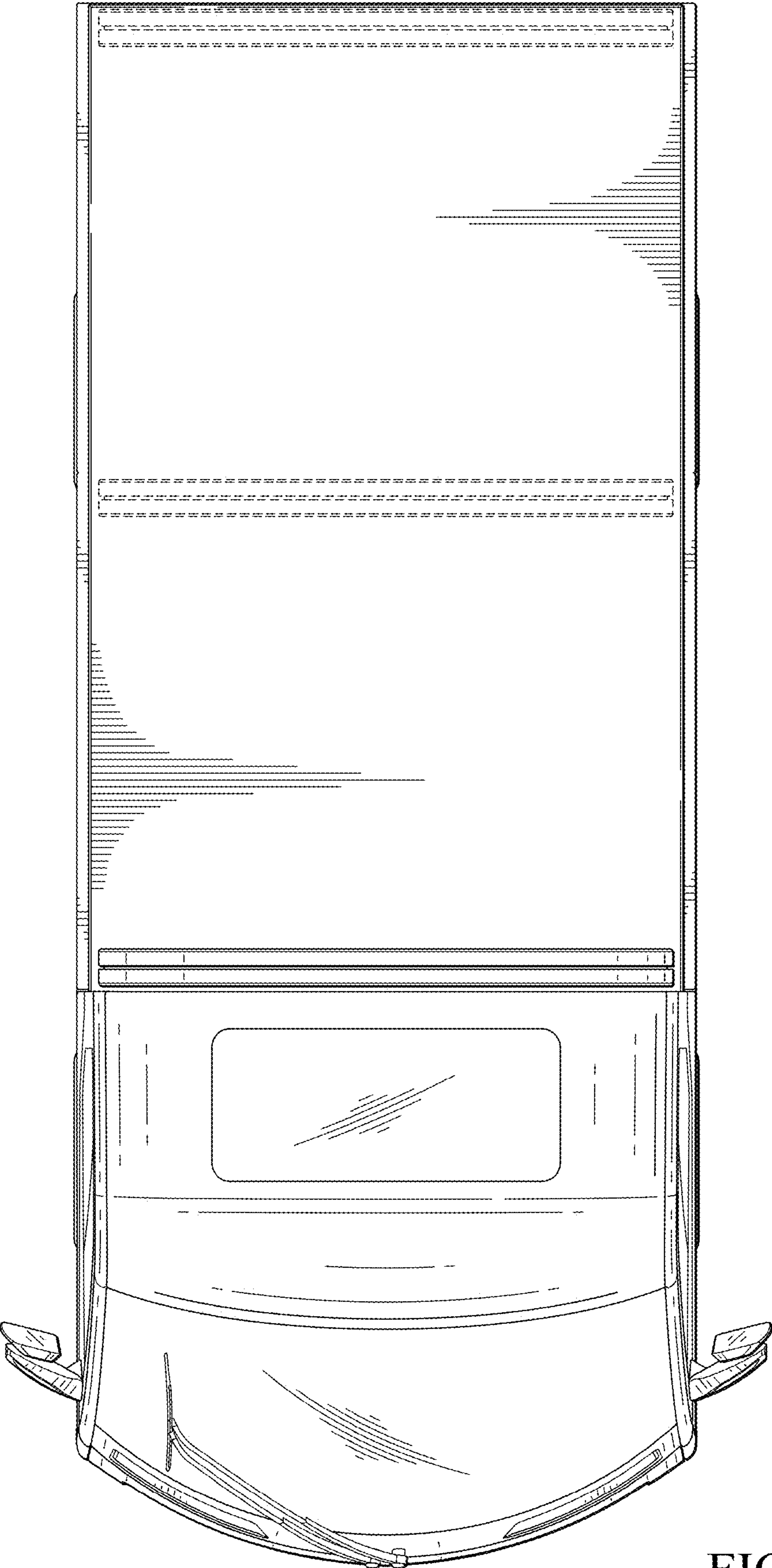

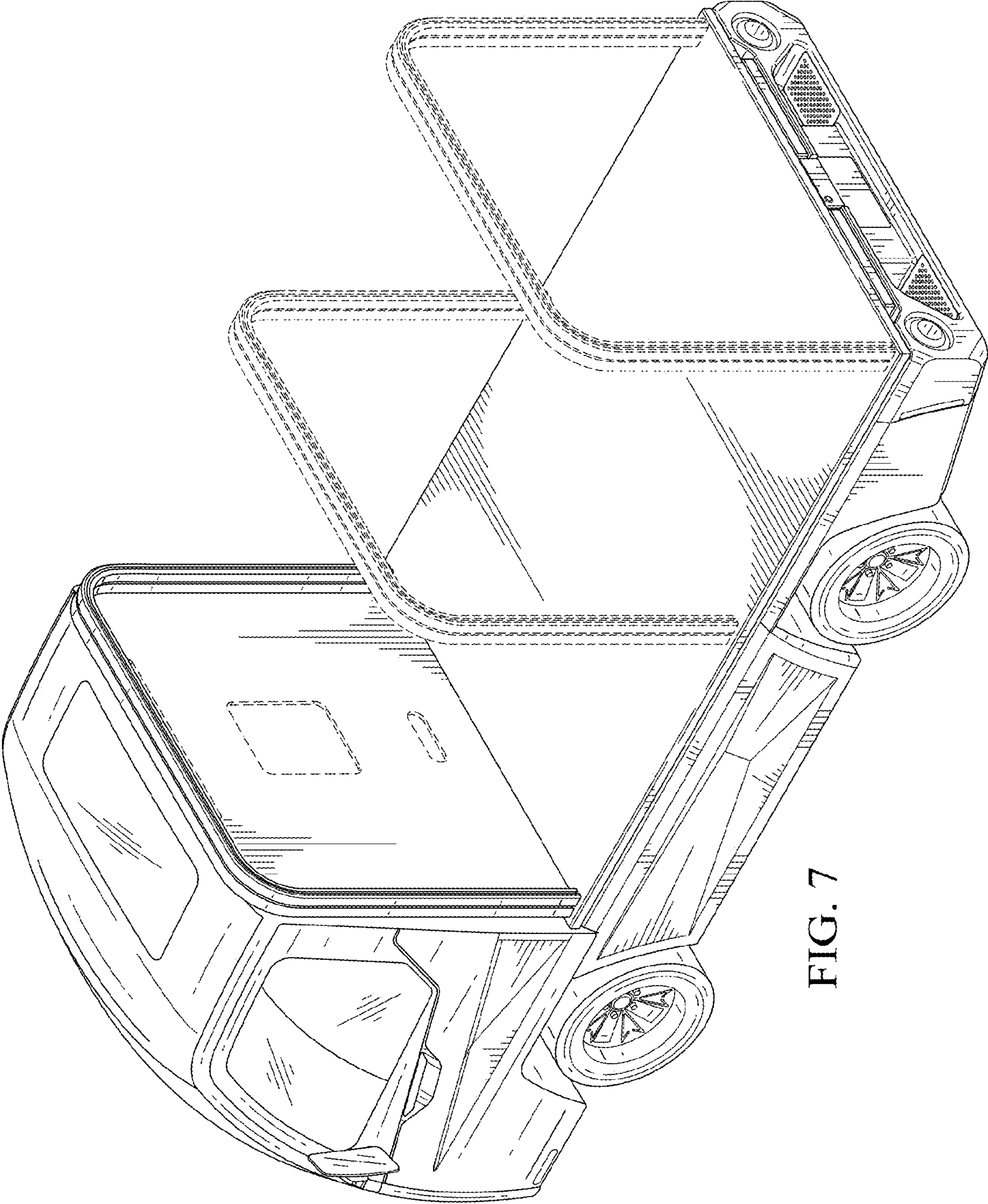

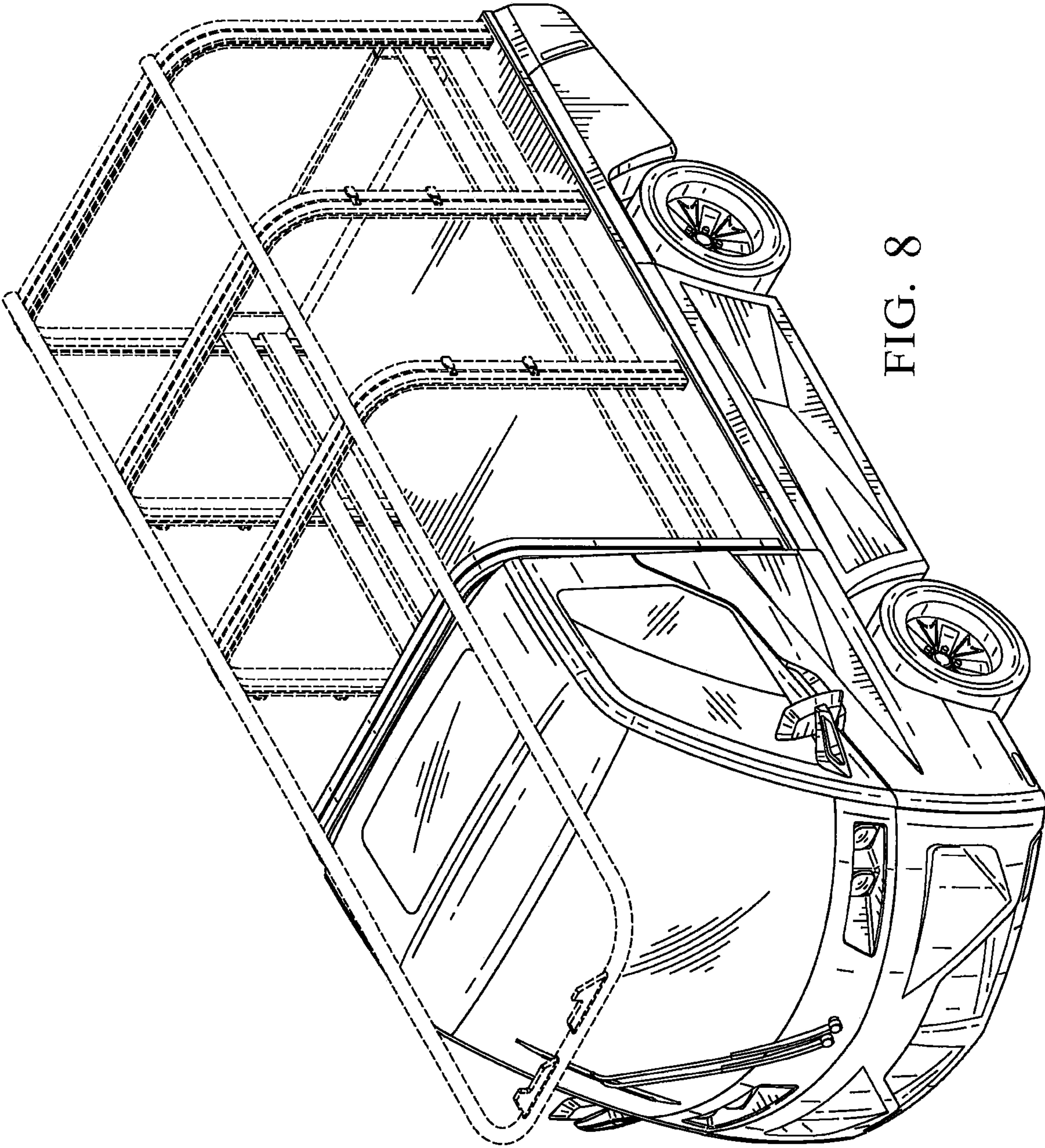

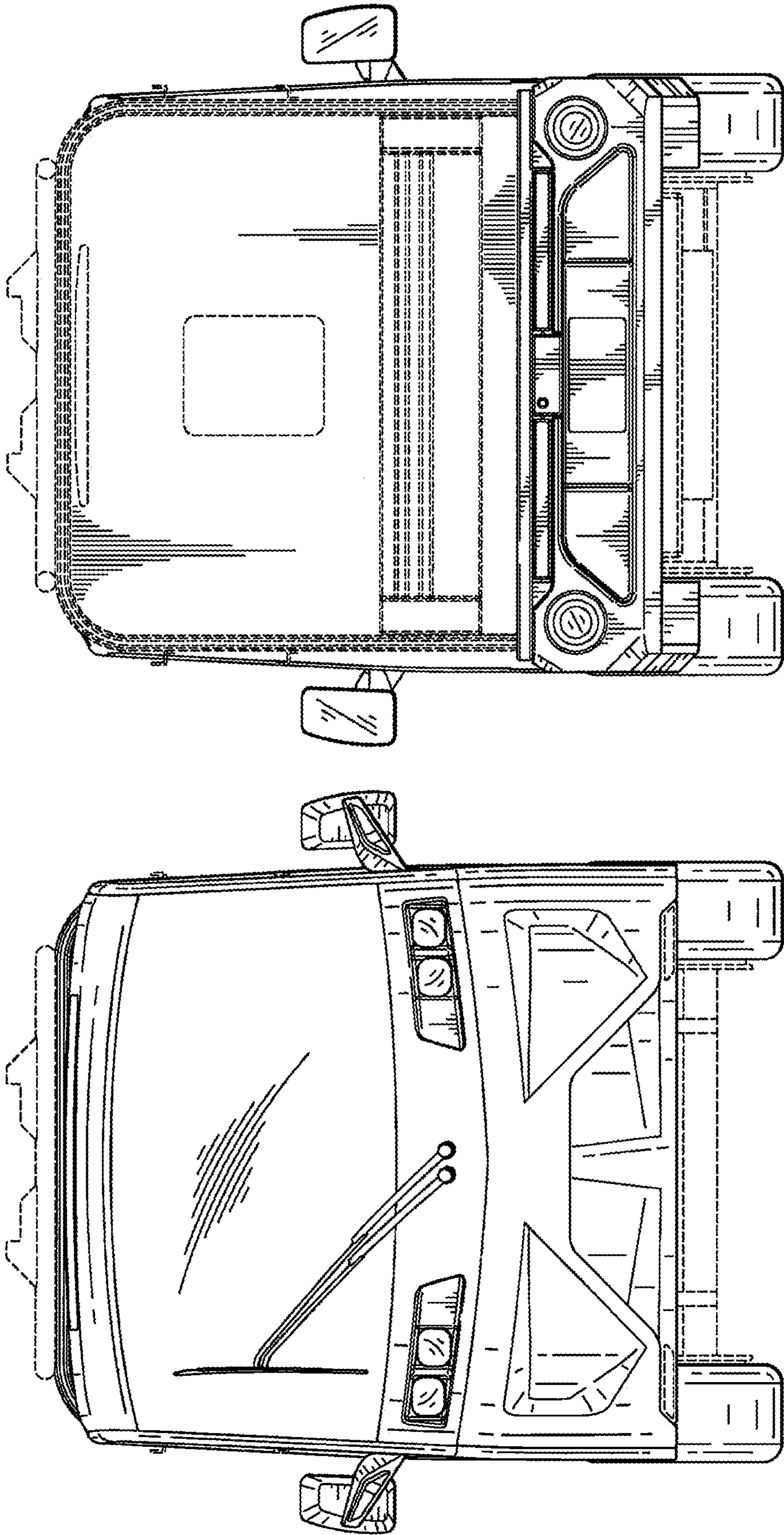

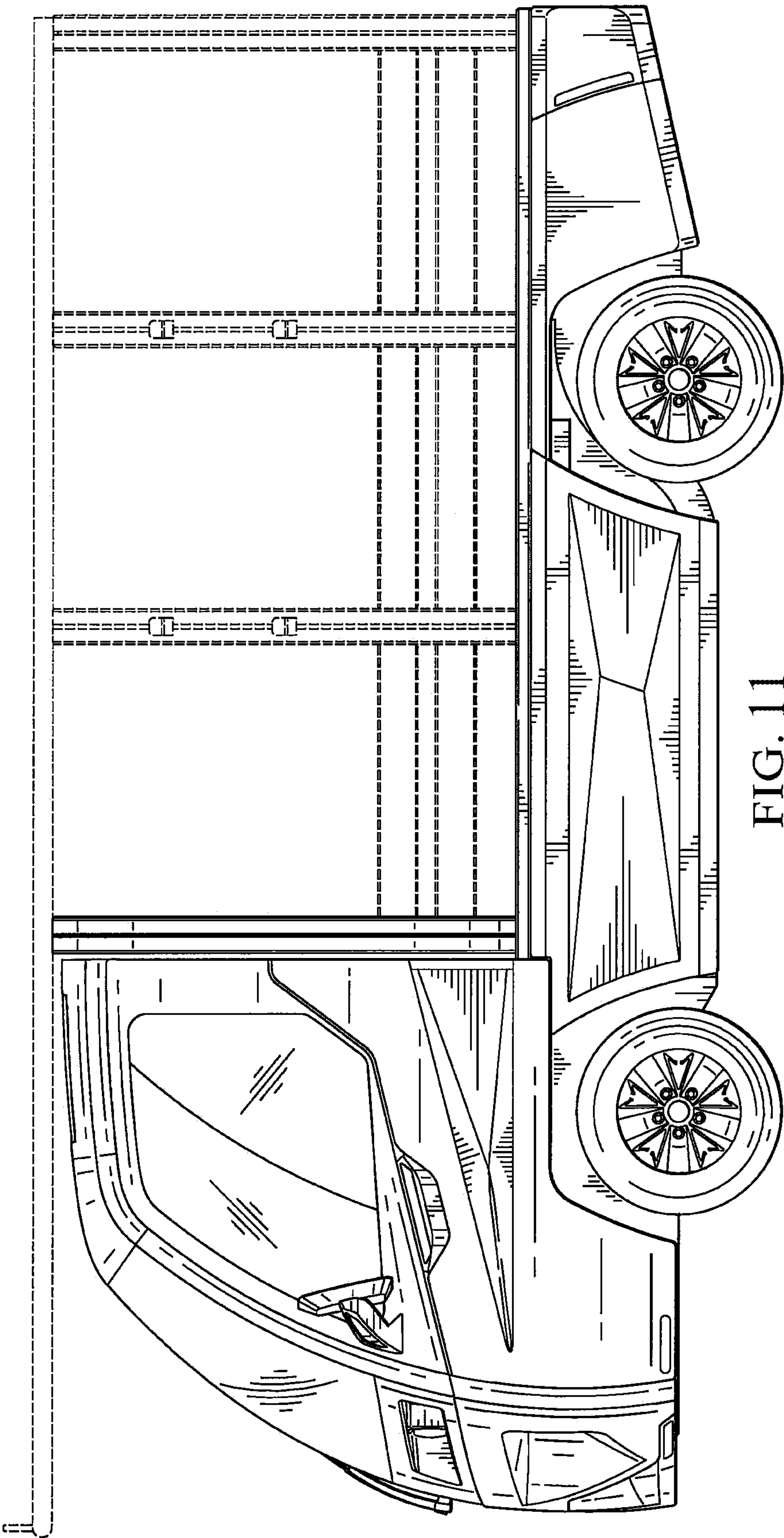

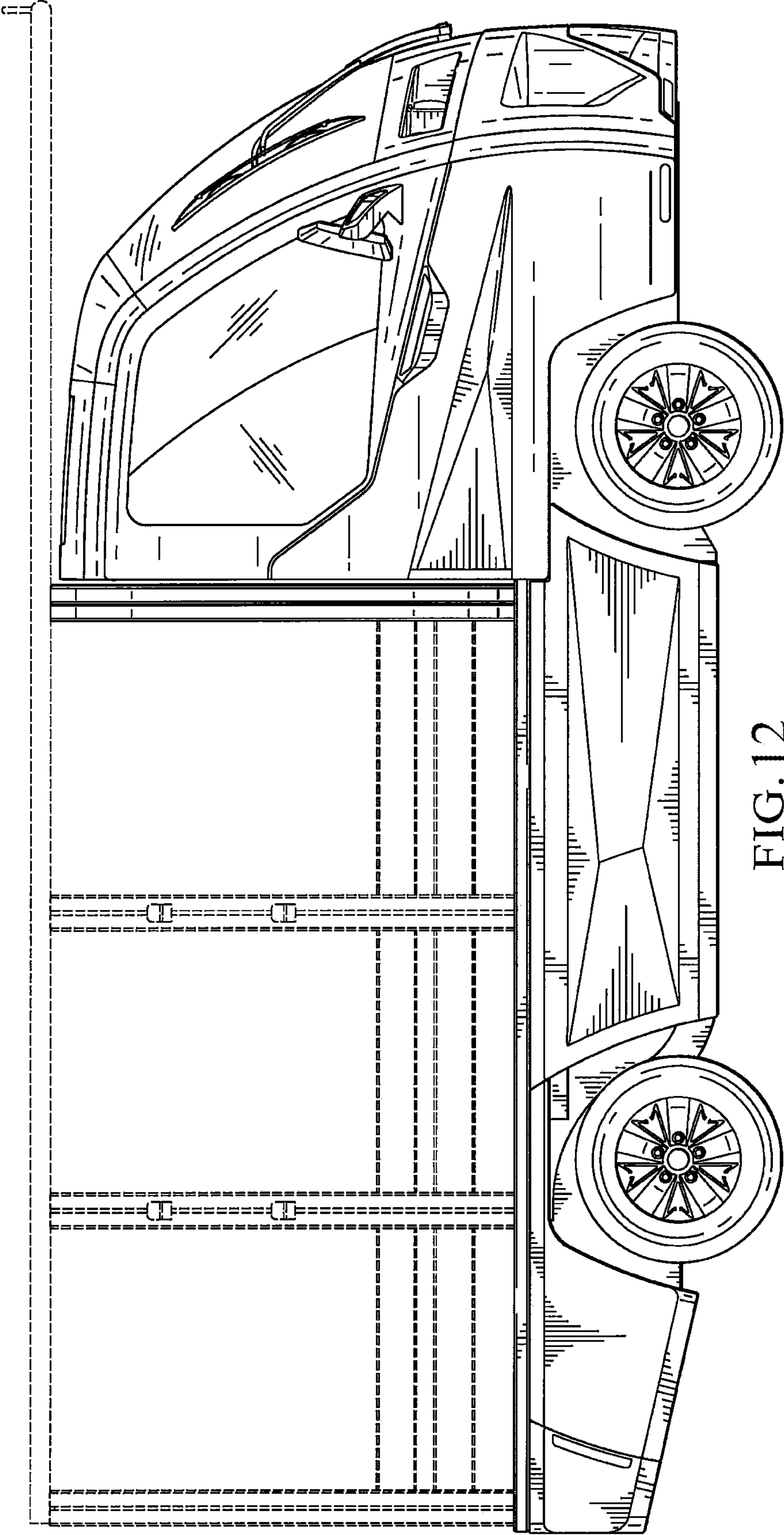

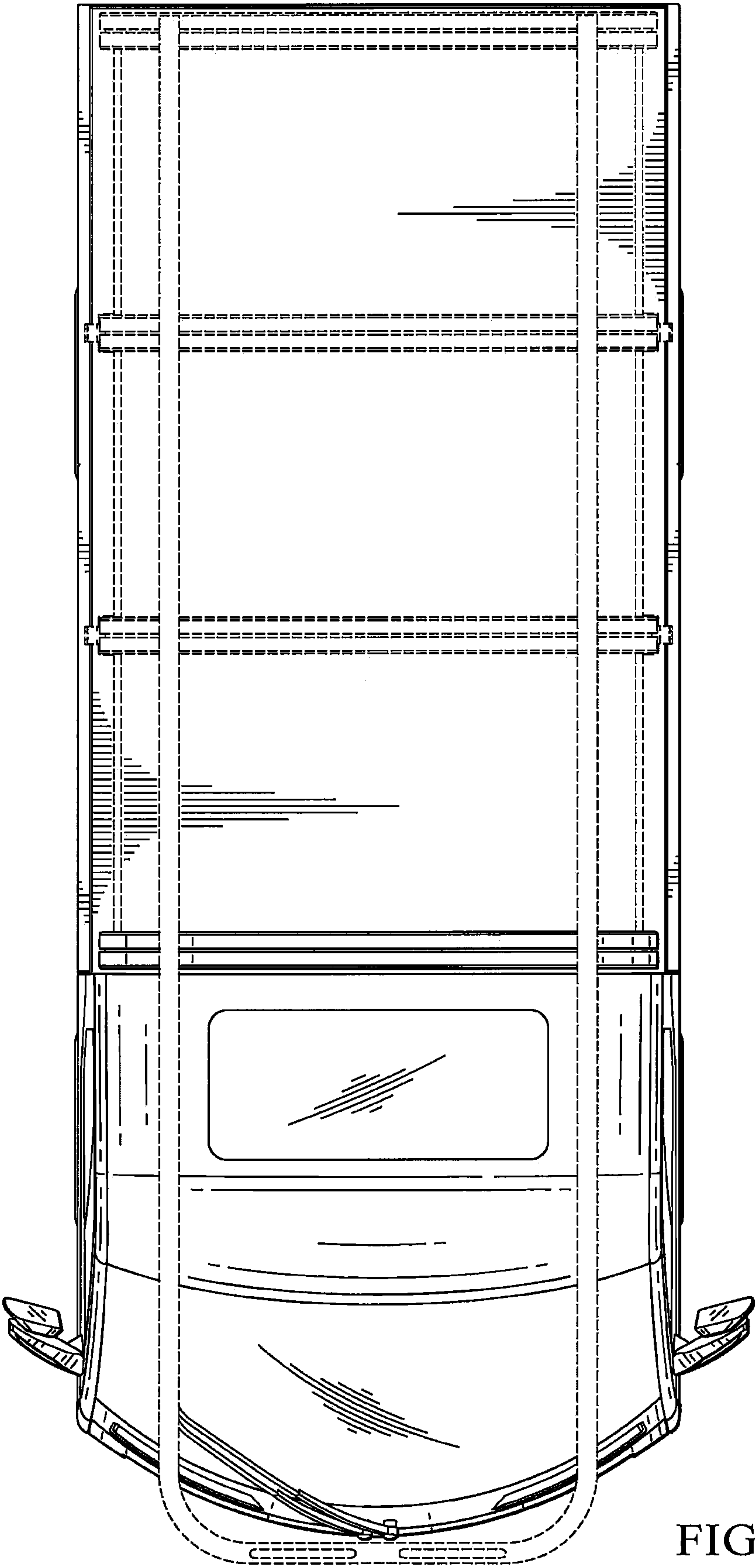

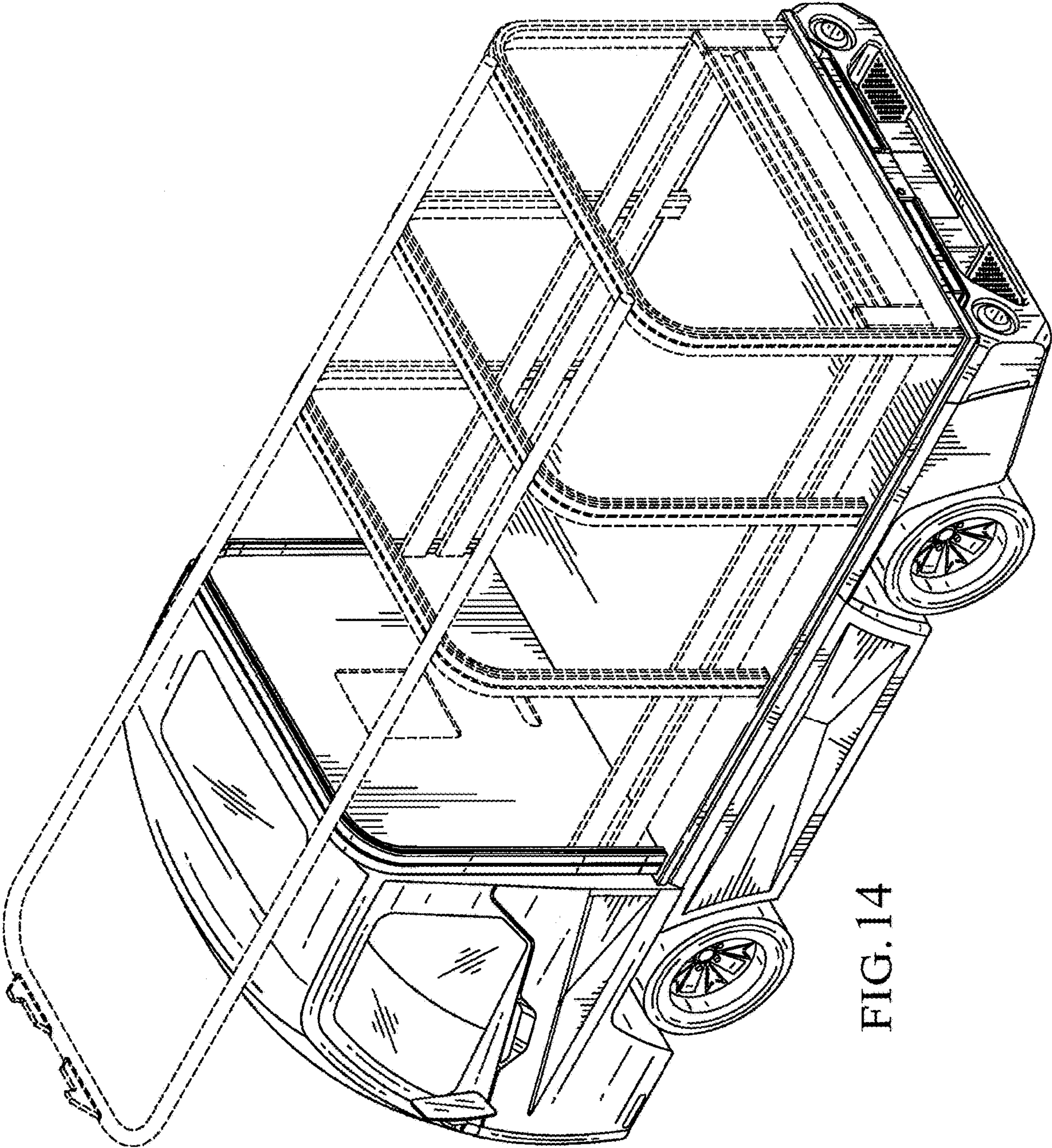

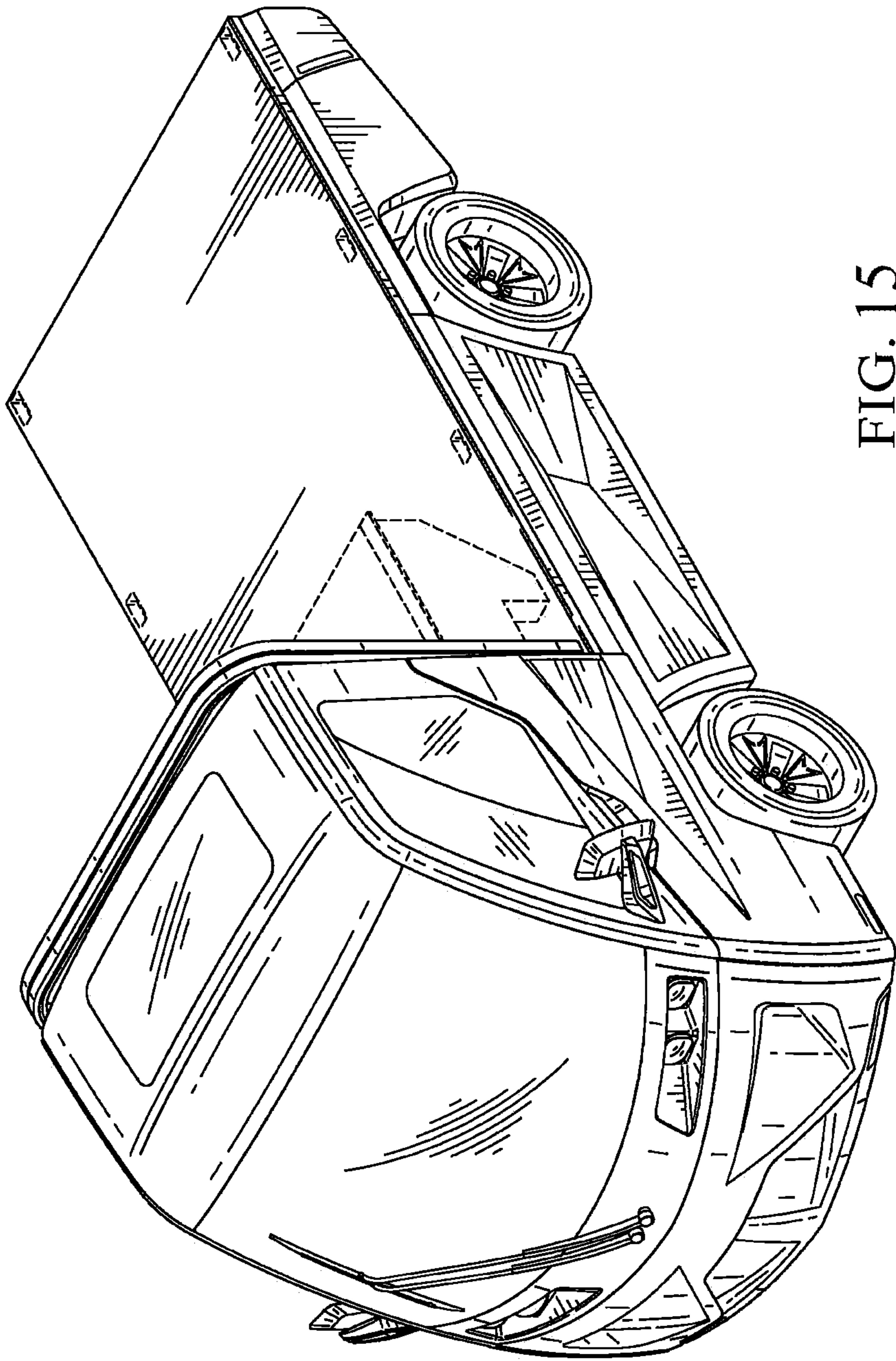

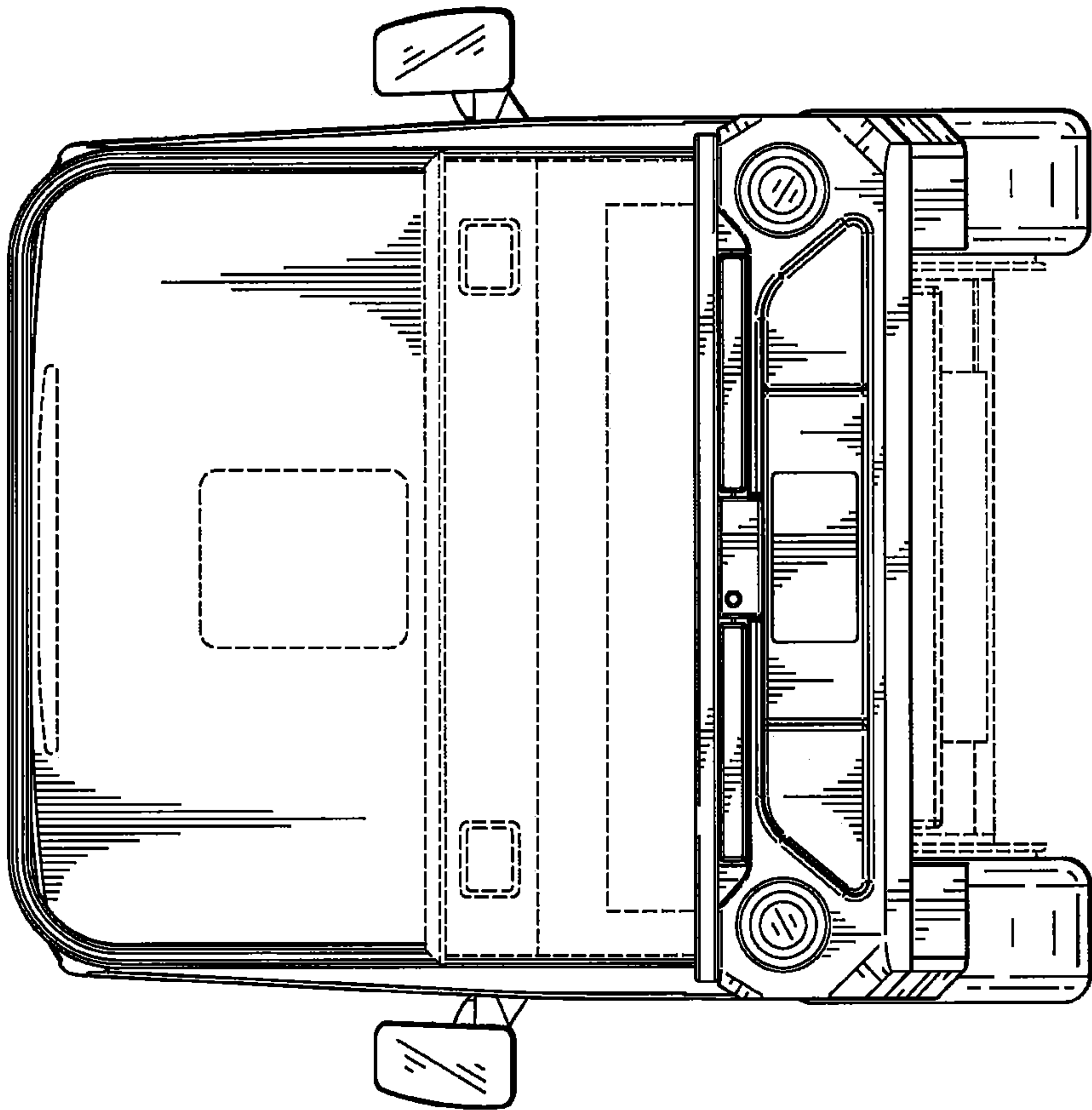

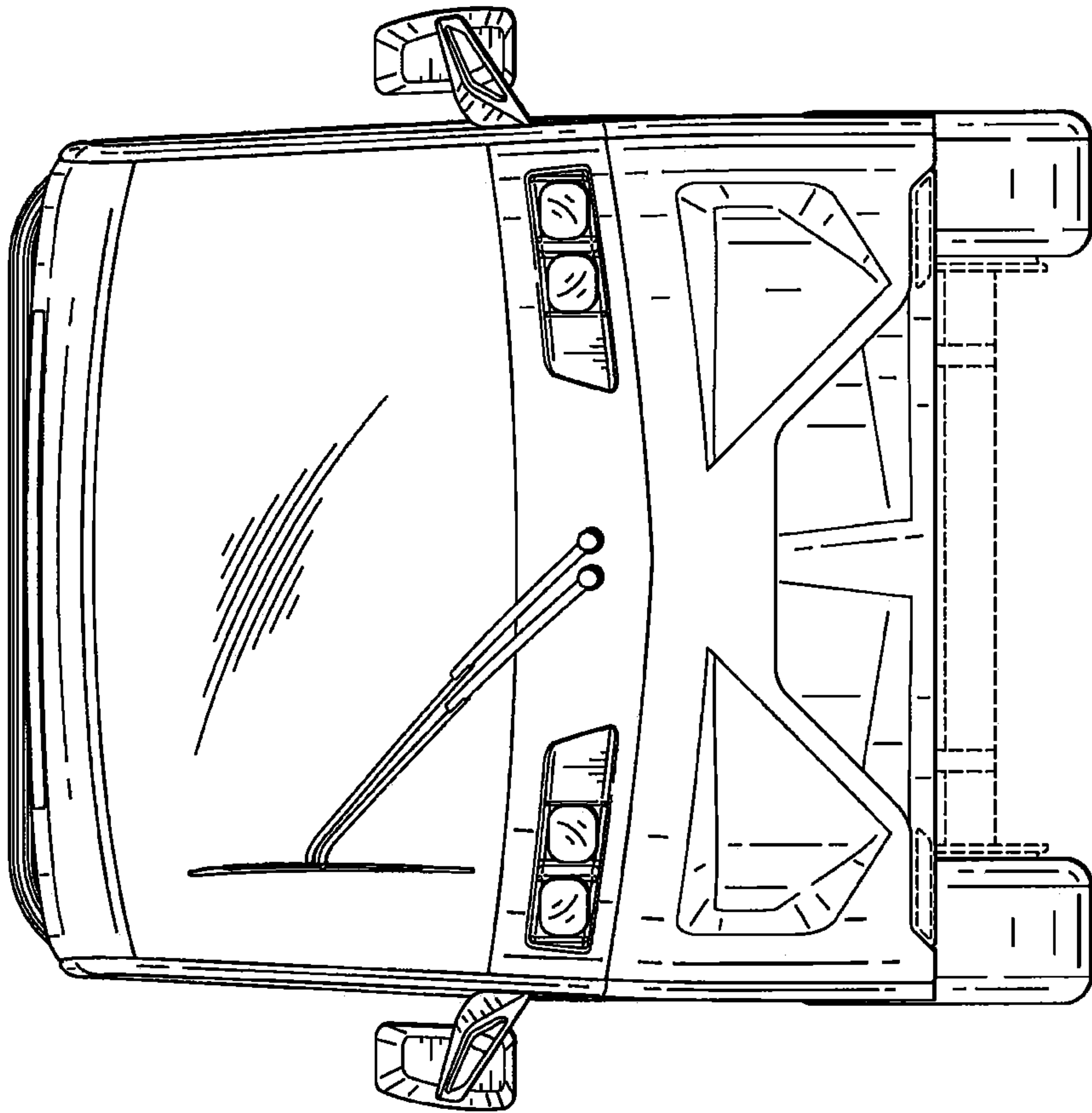

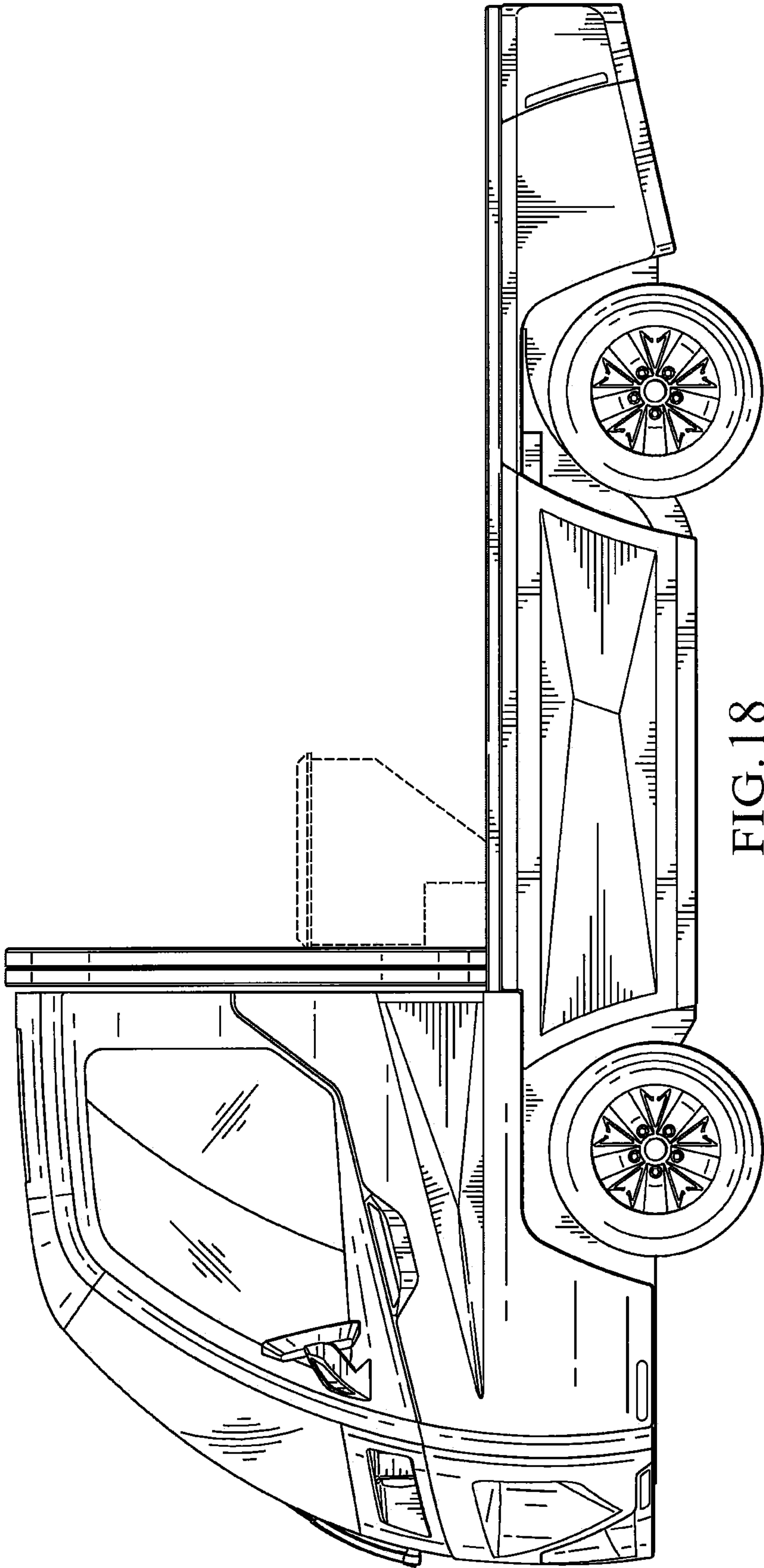

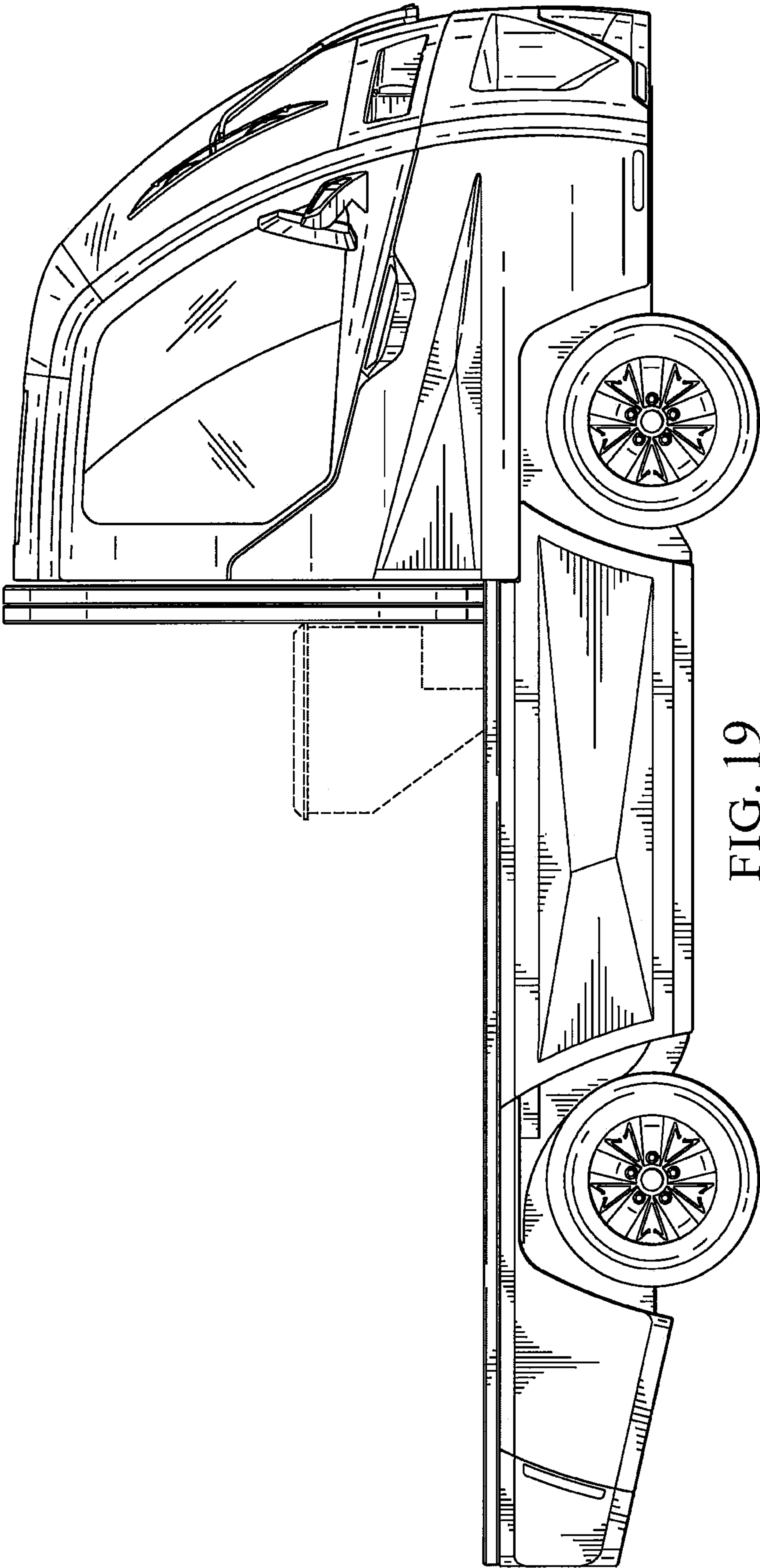

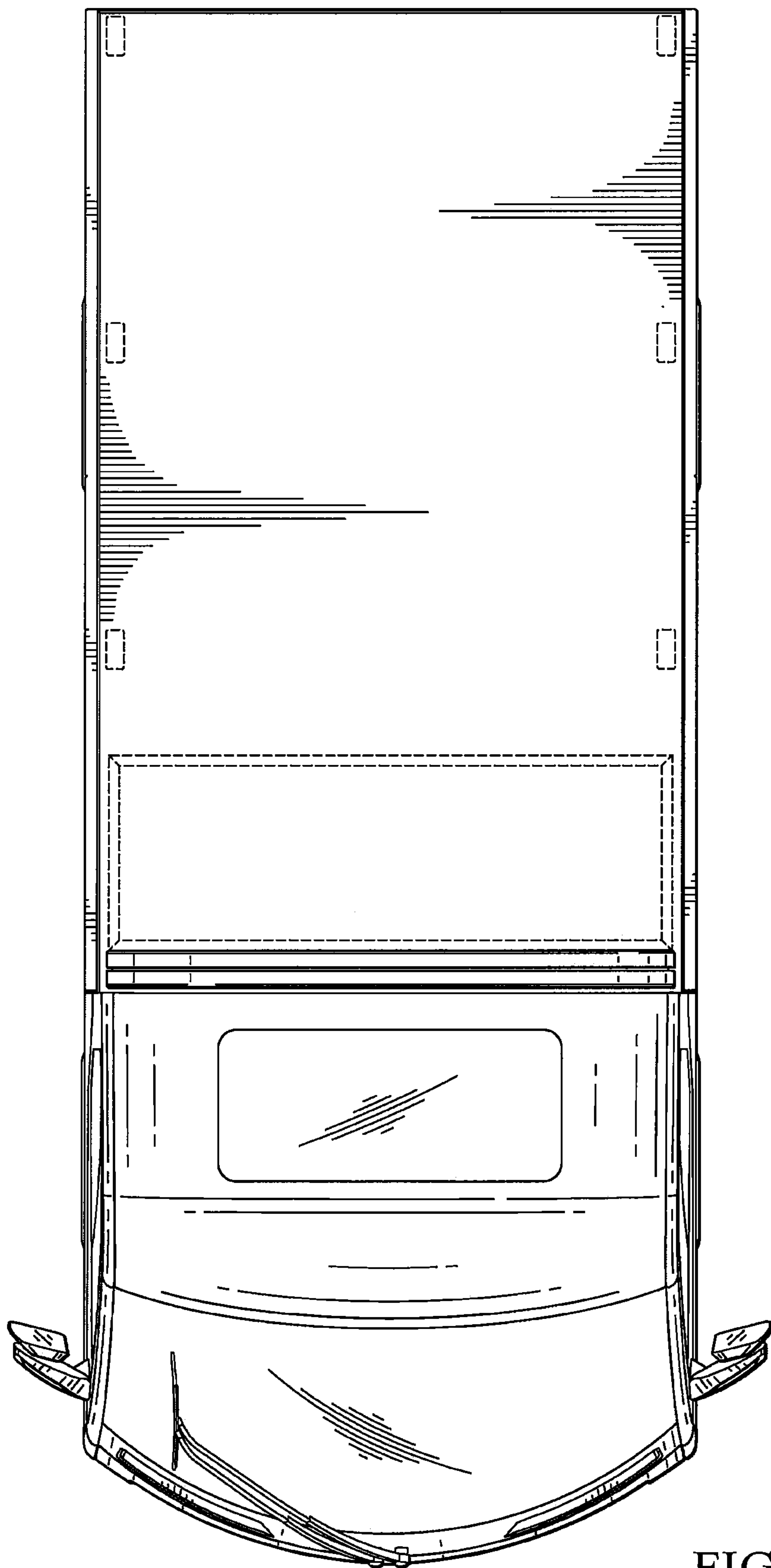

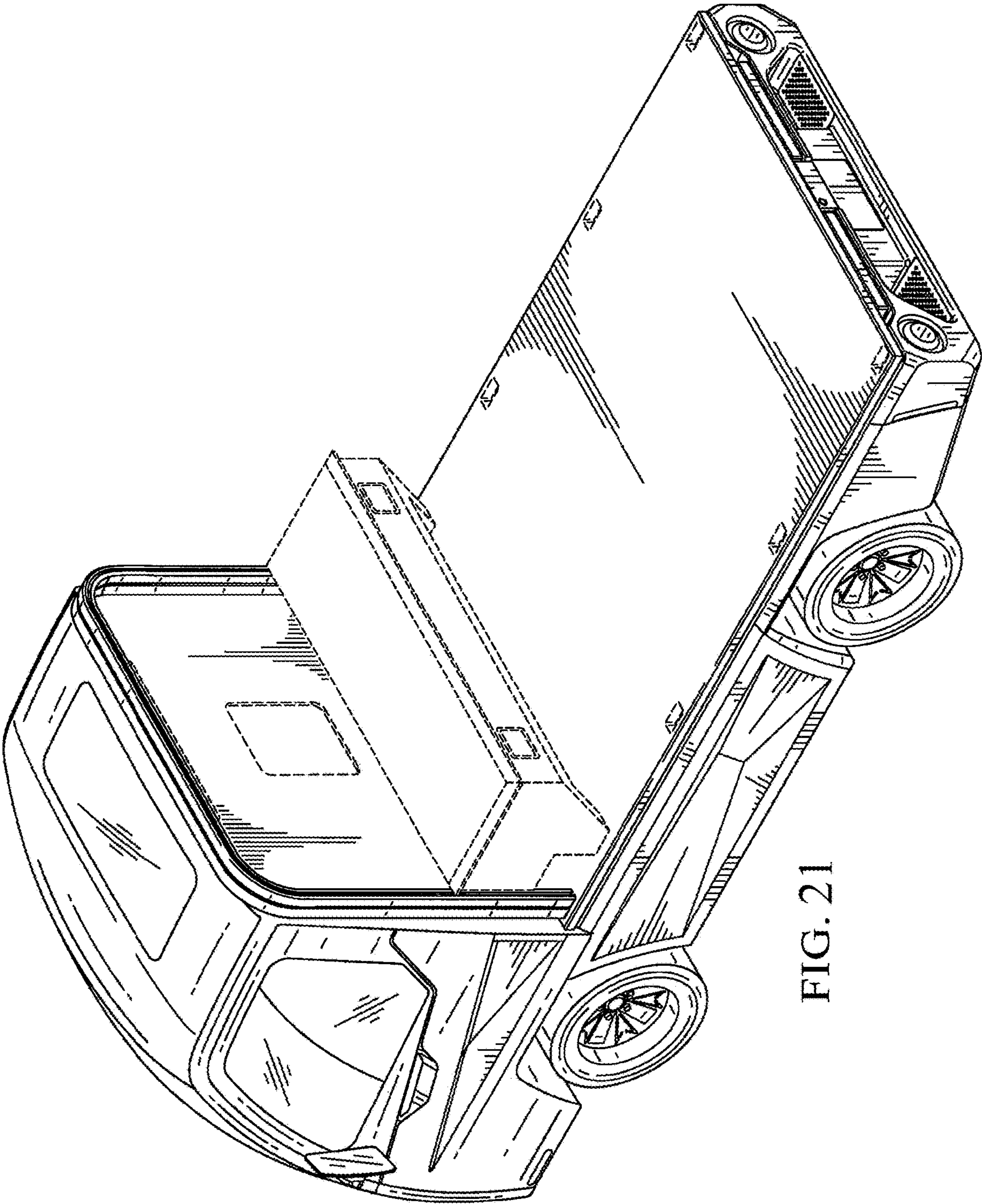

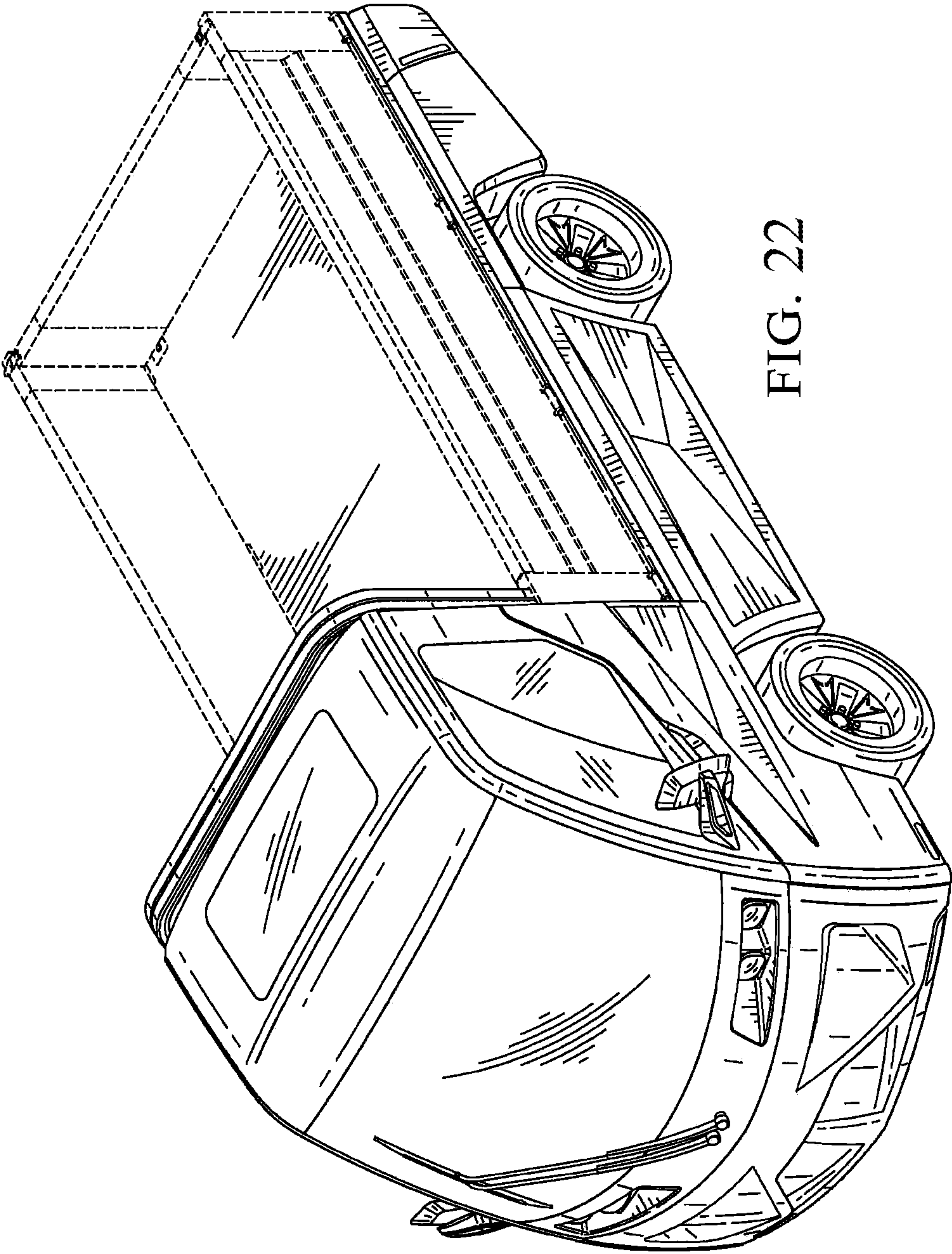

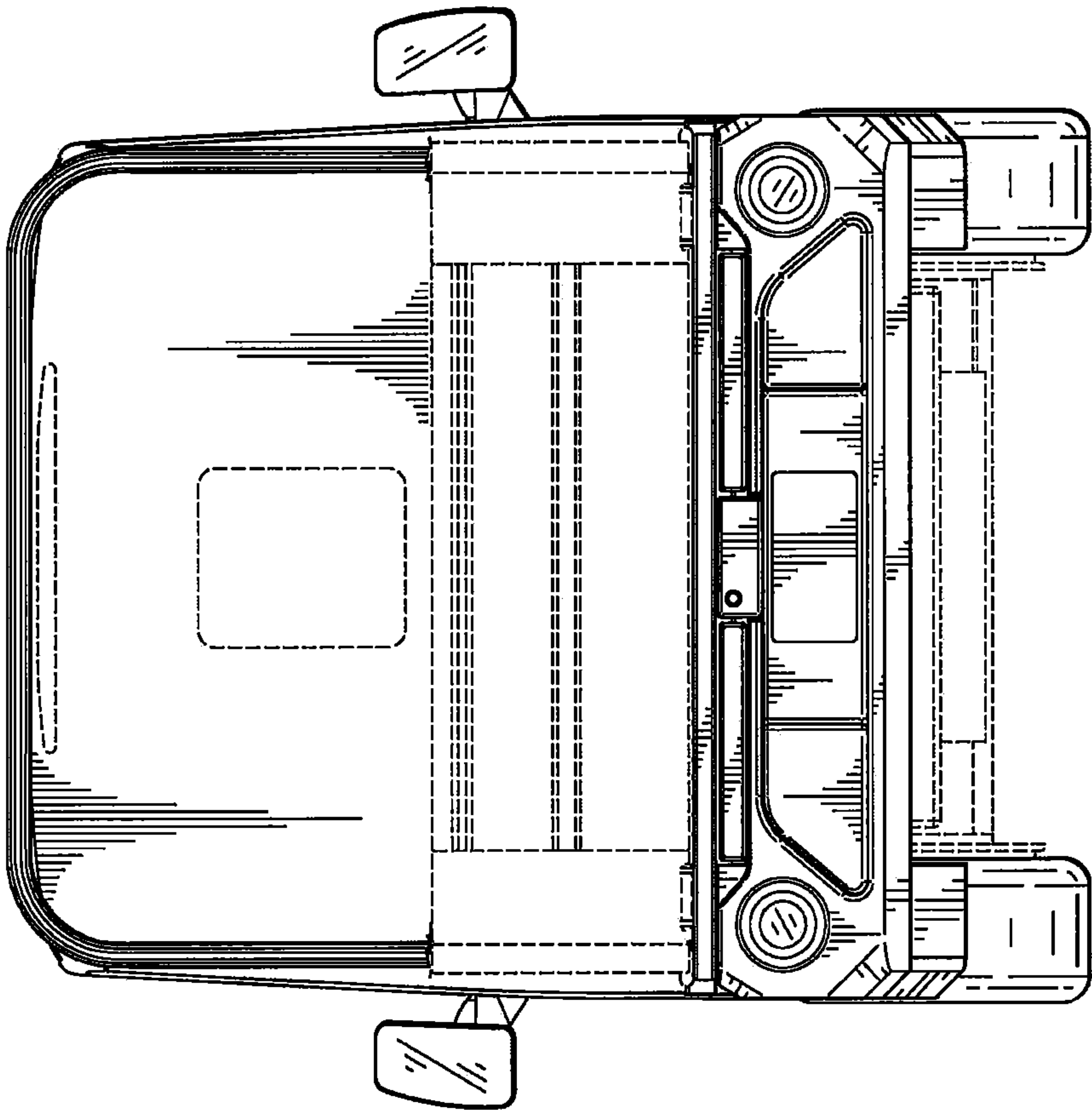

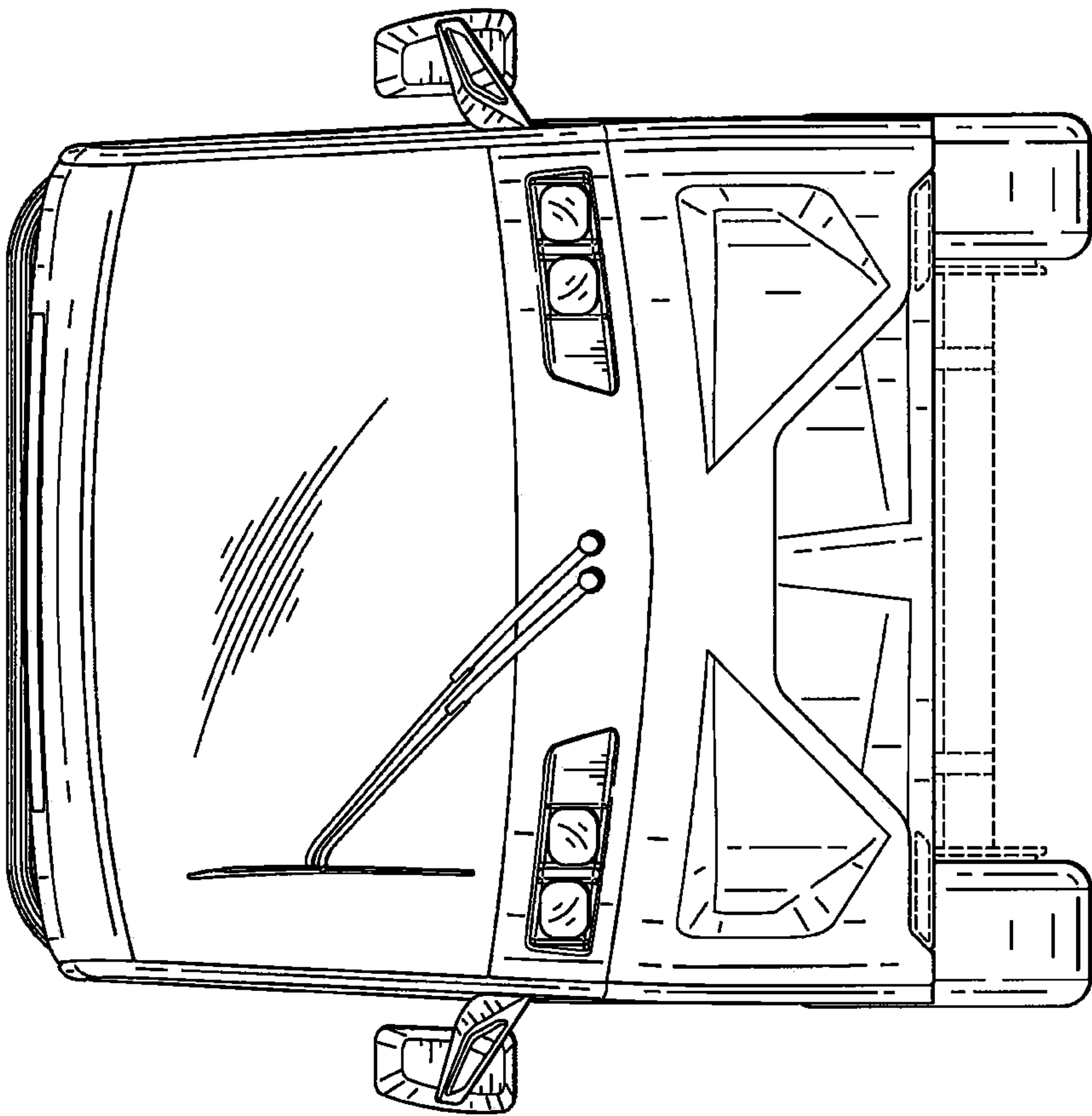

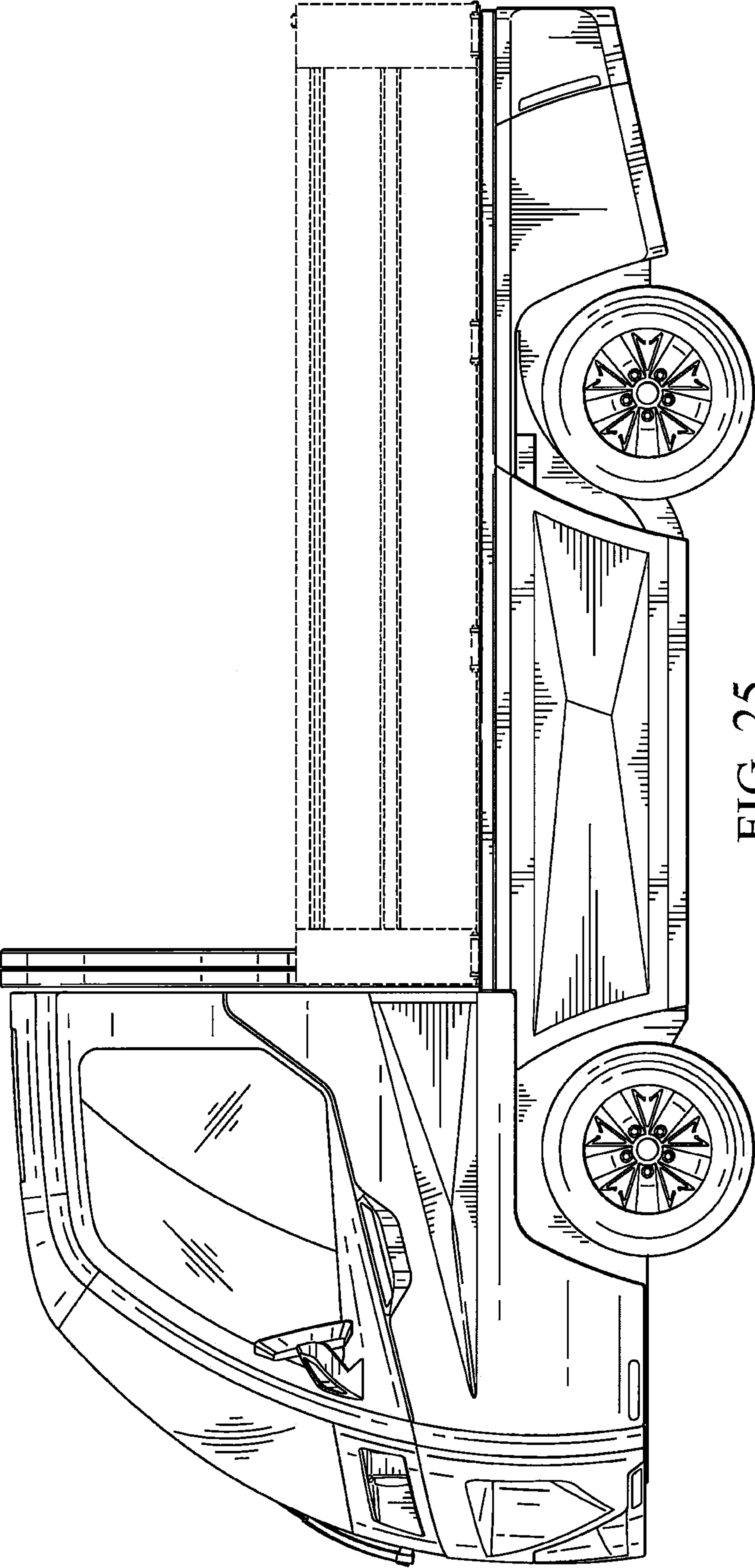

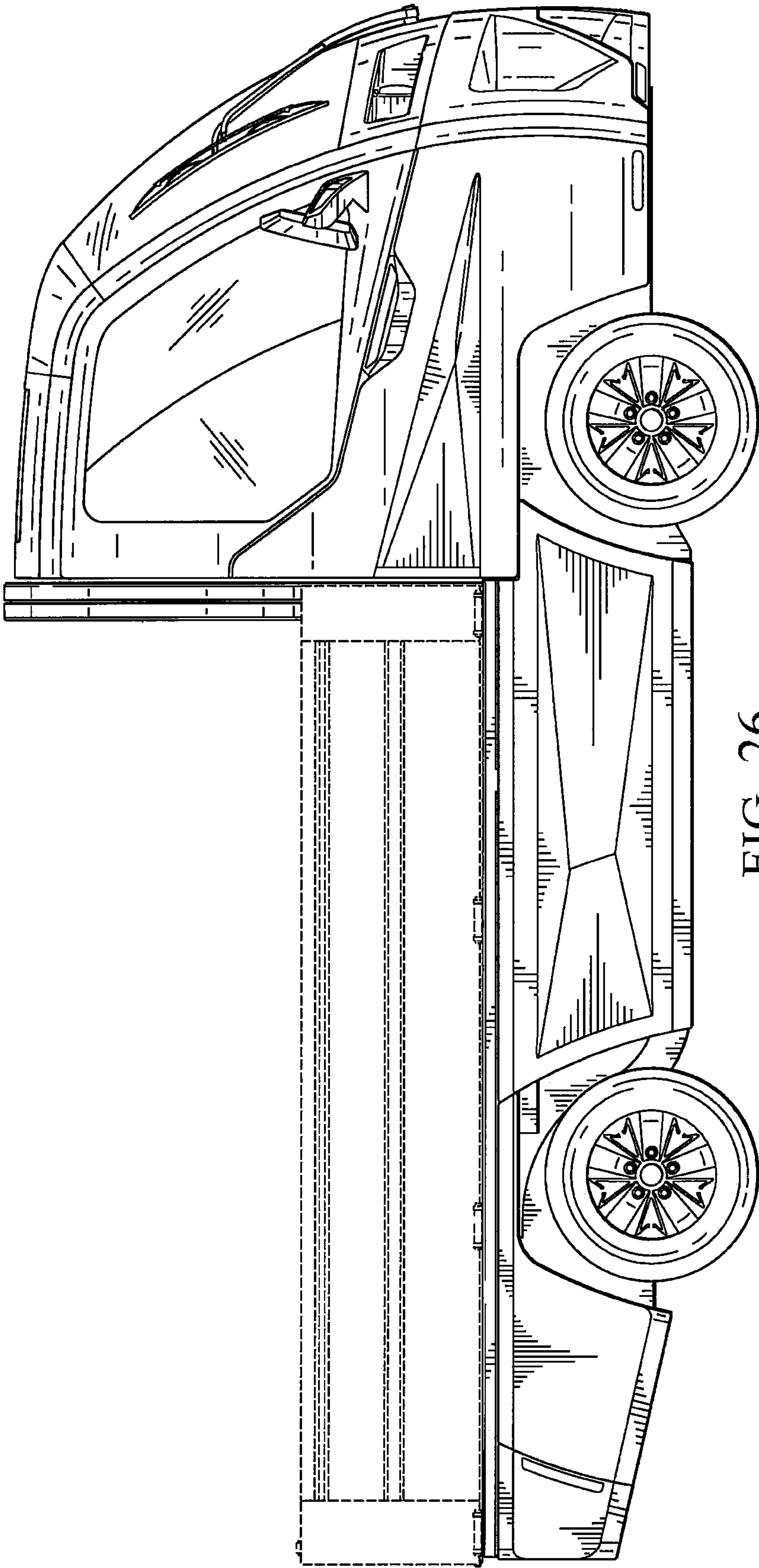

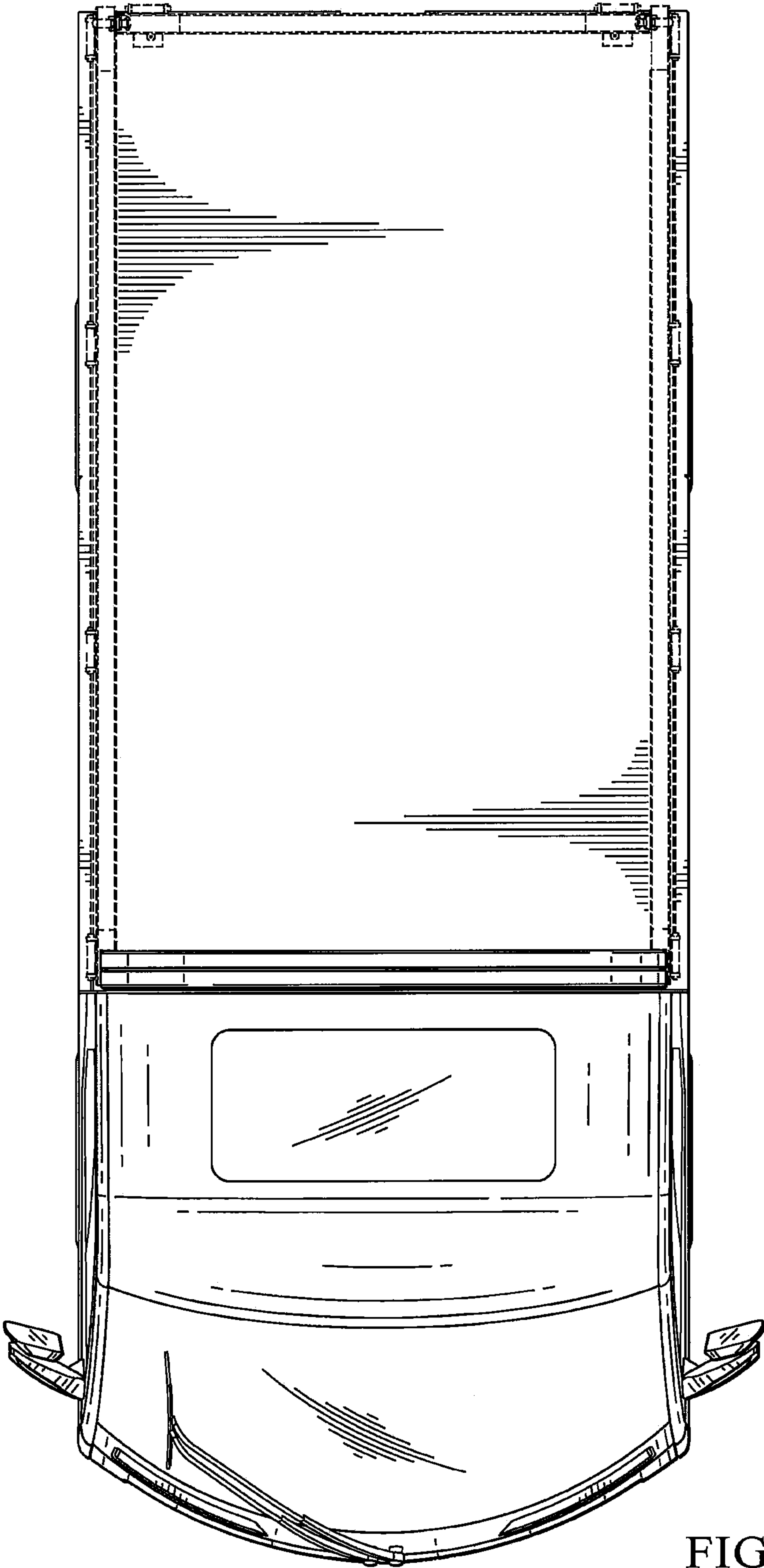

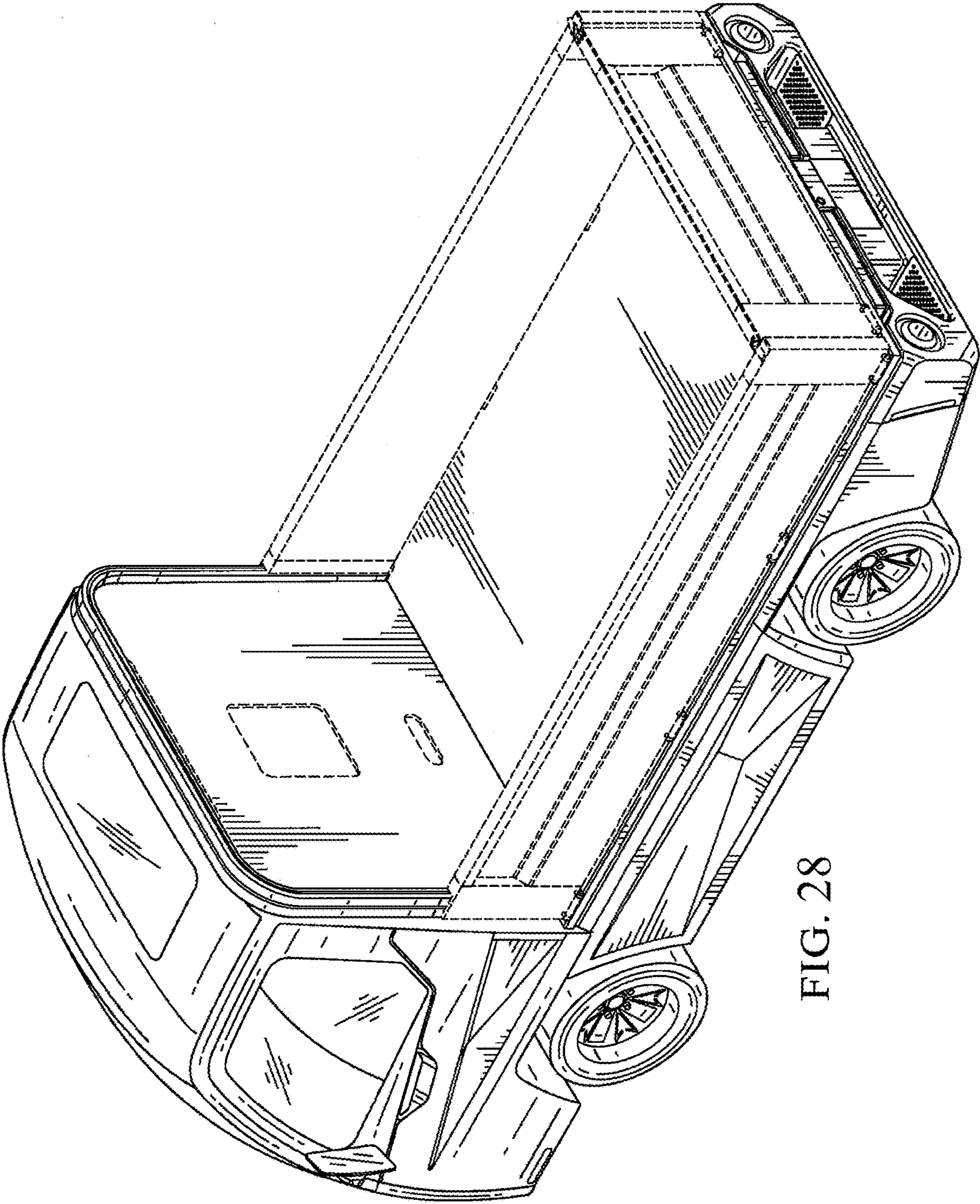
