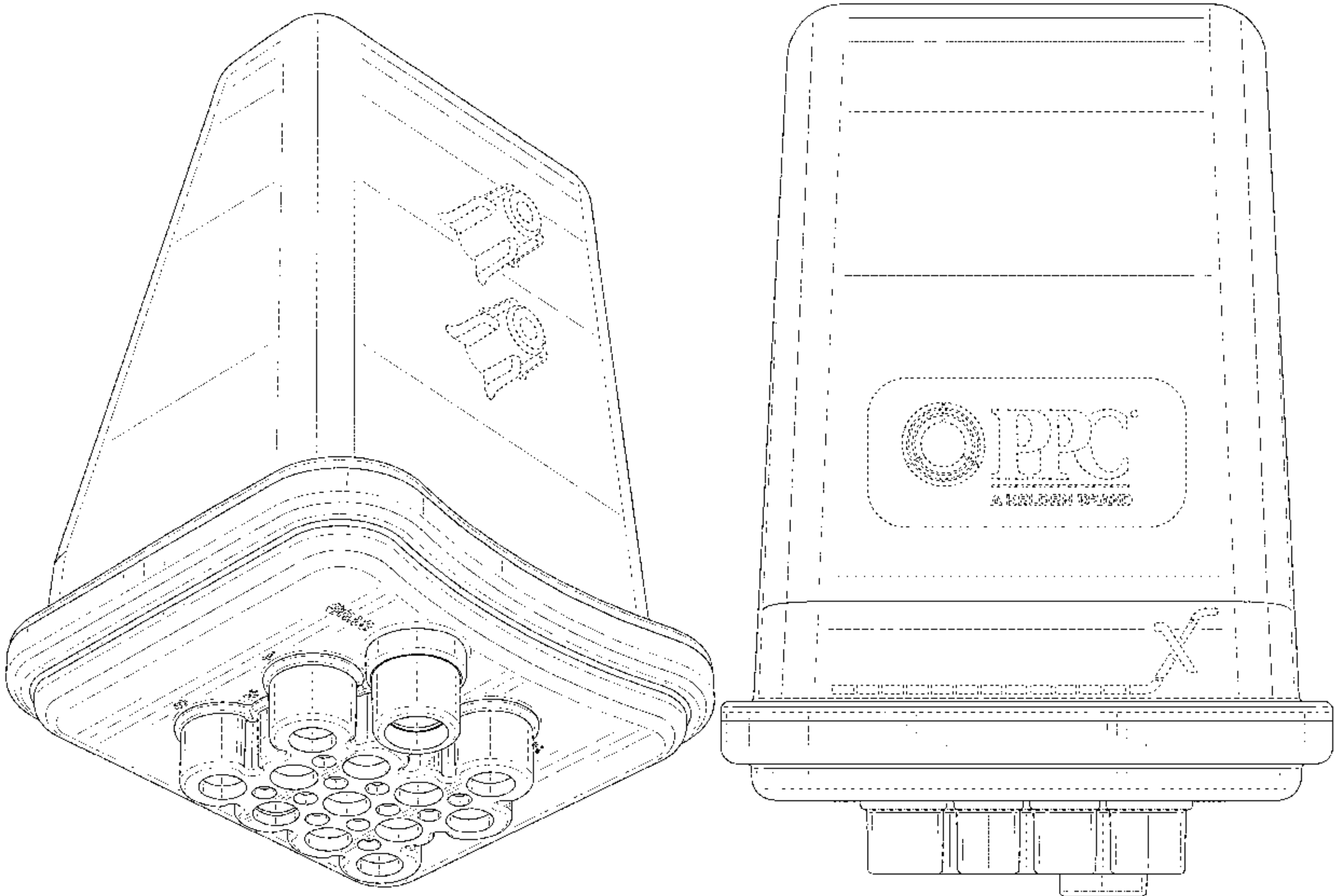
The ornamental design for a network access point (NAP)

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top, right side perspective view of a
network access point (NAP) enclosure;

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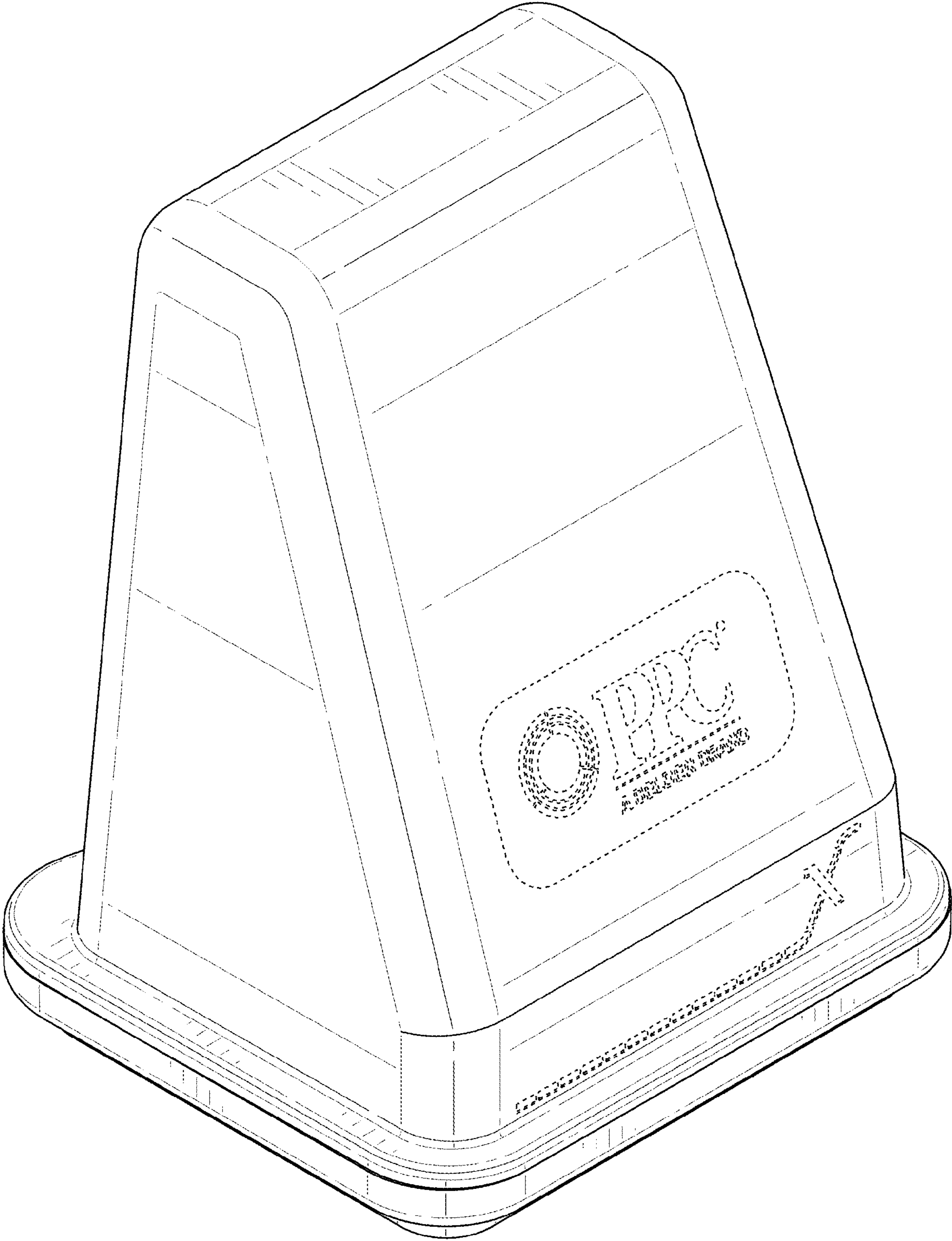

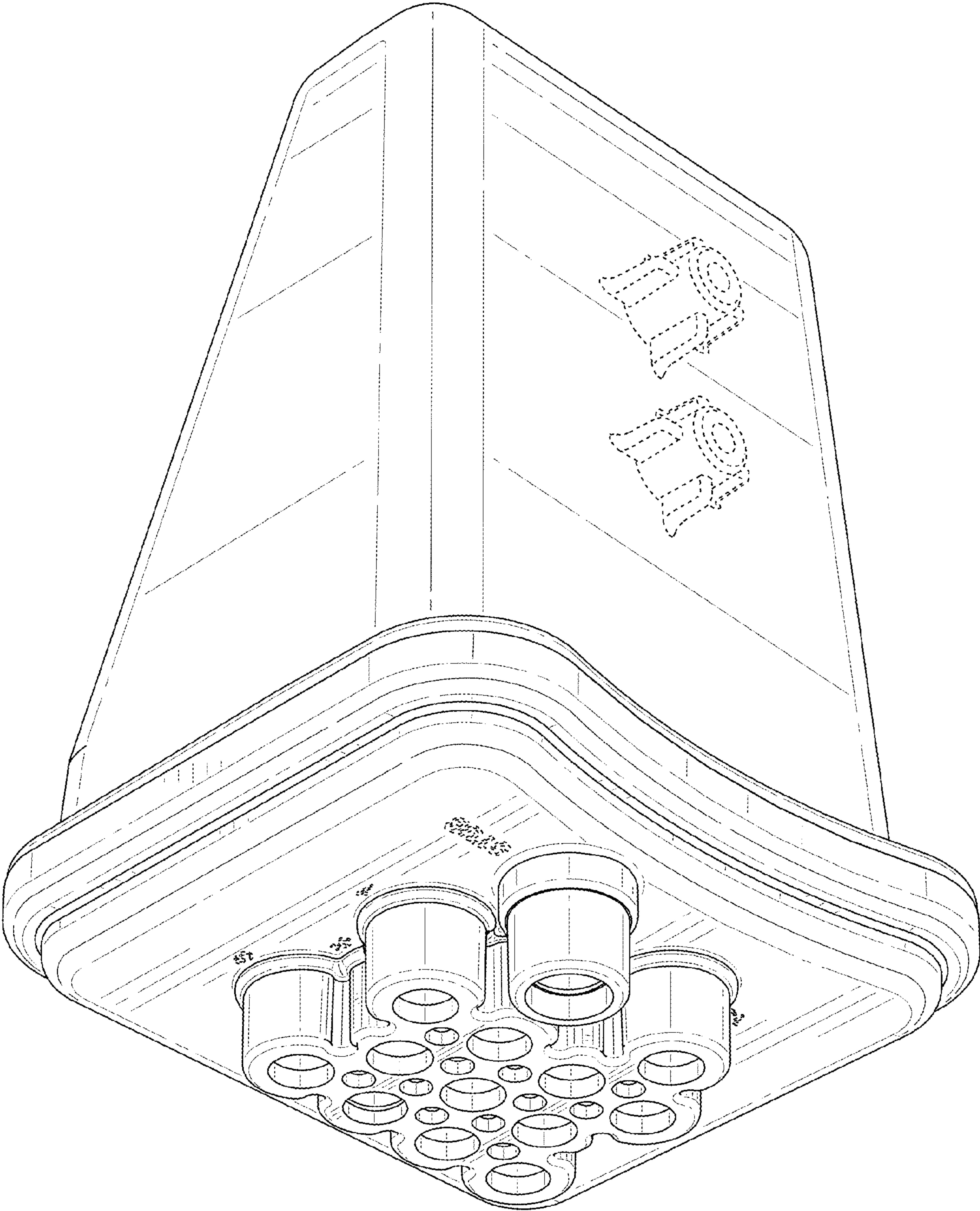

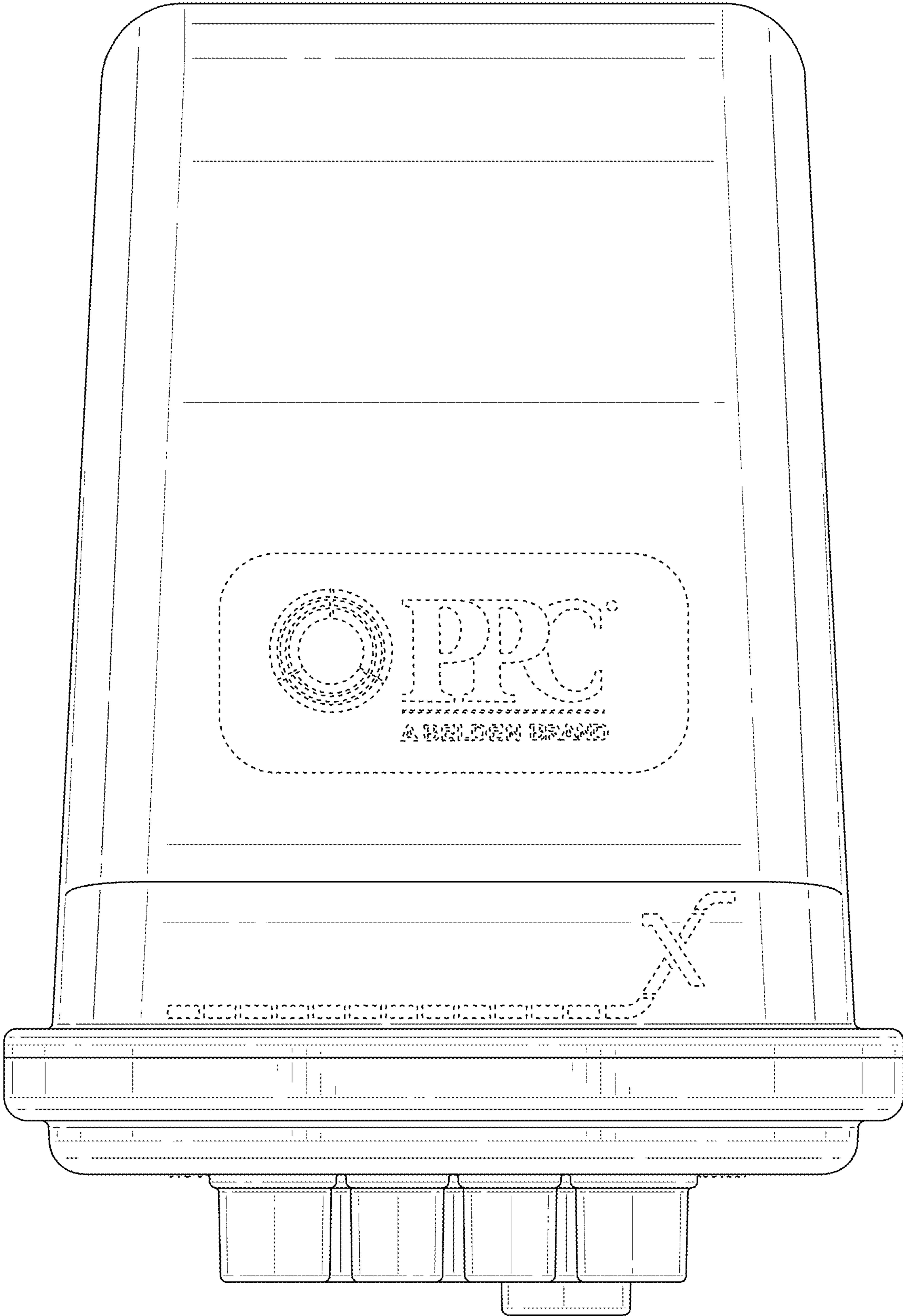

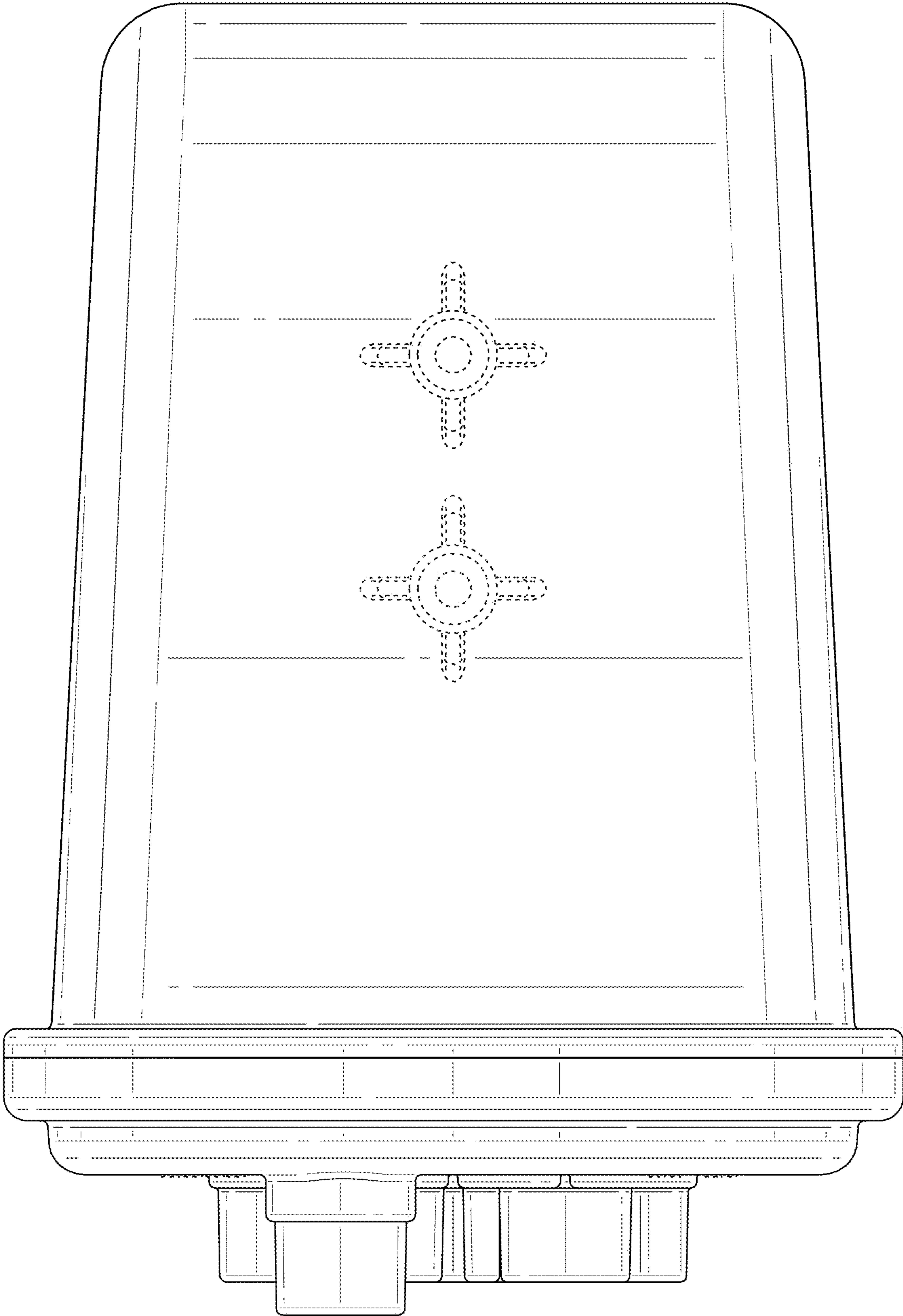

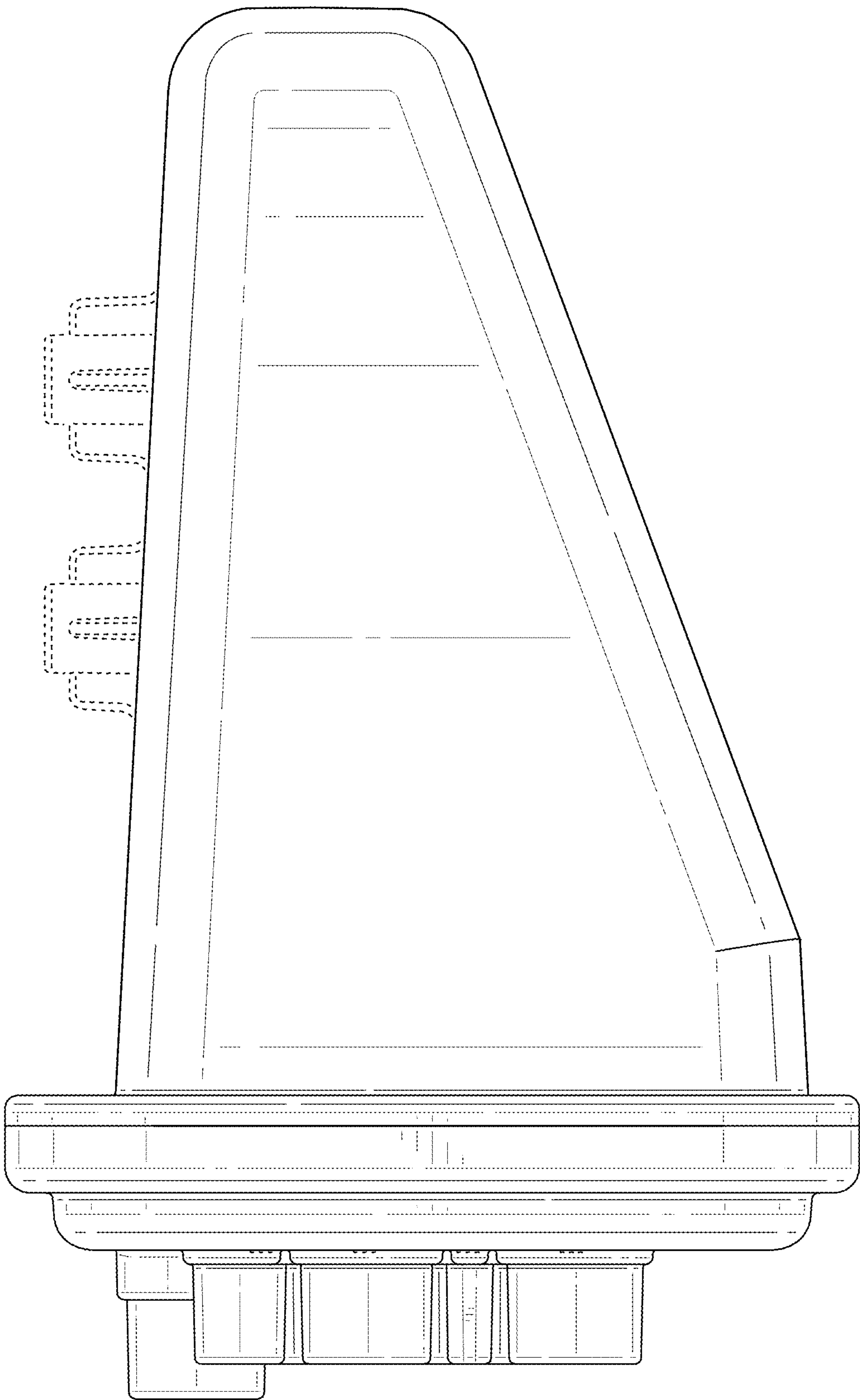

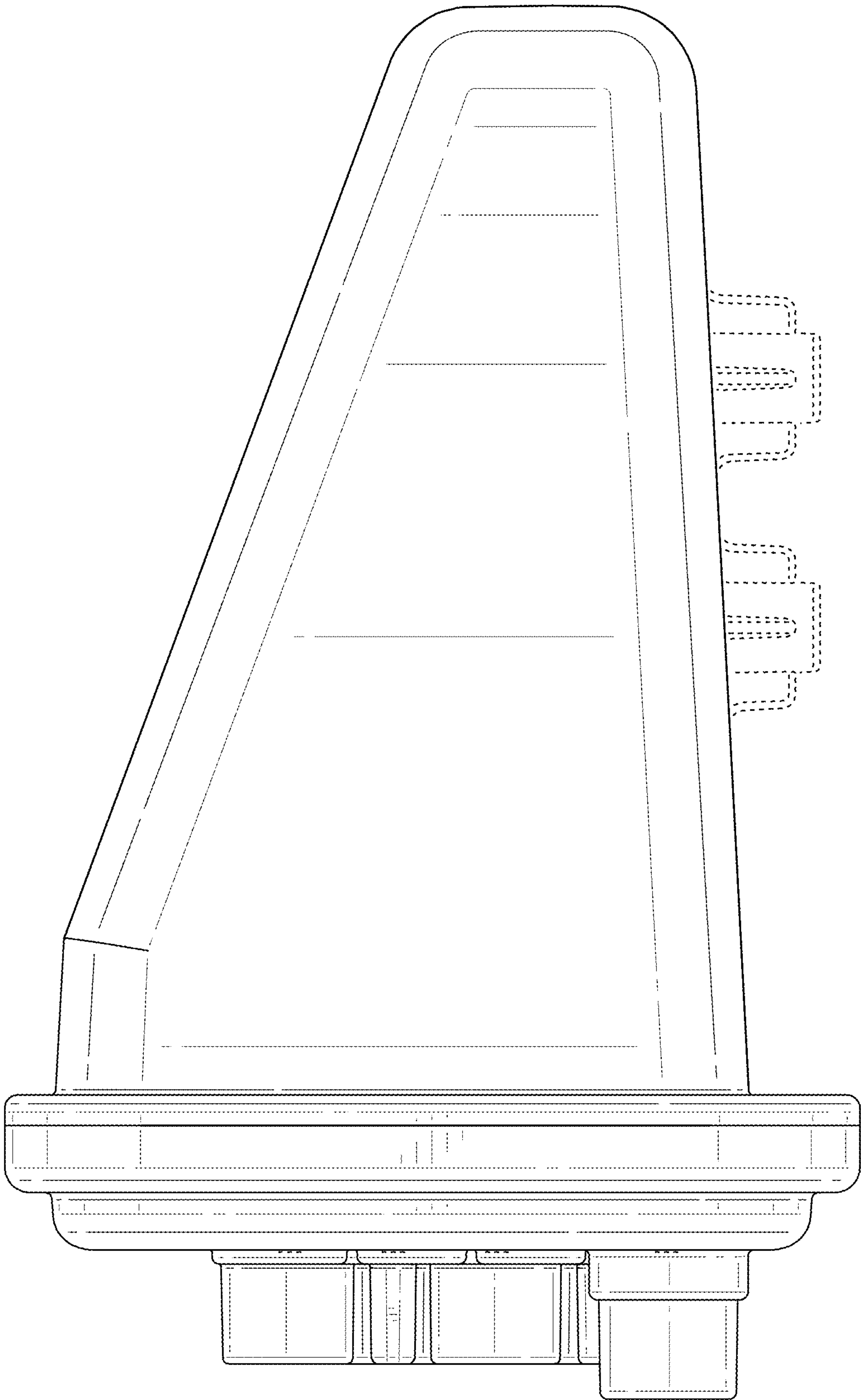

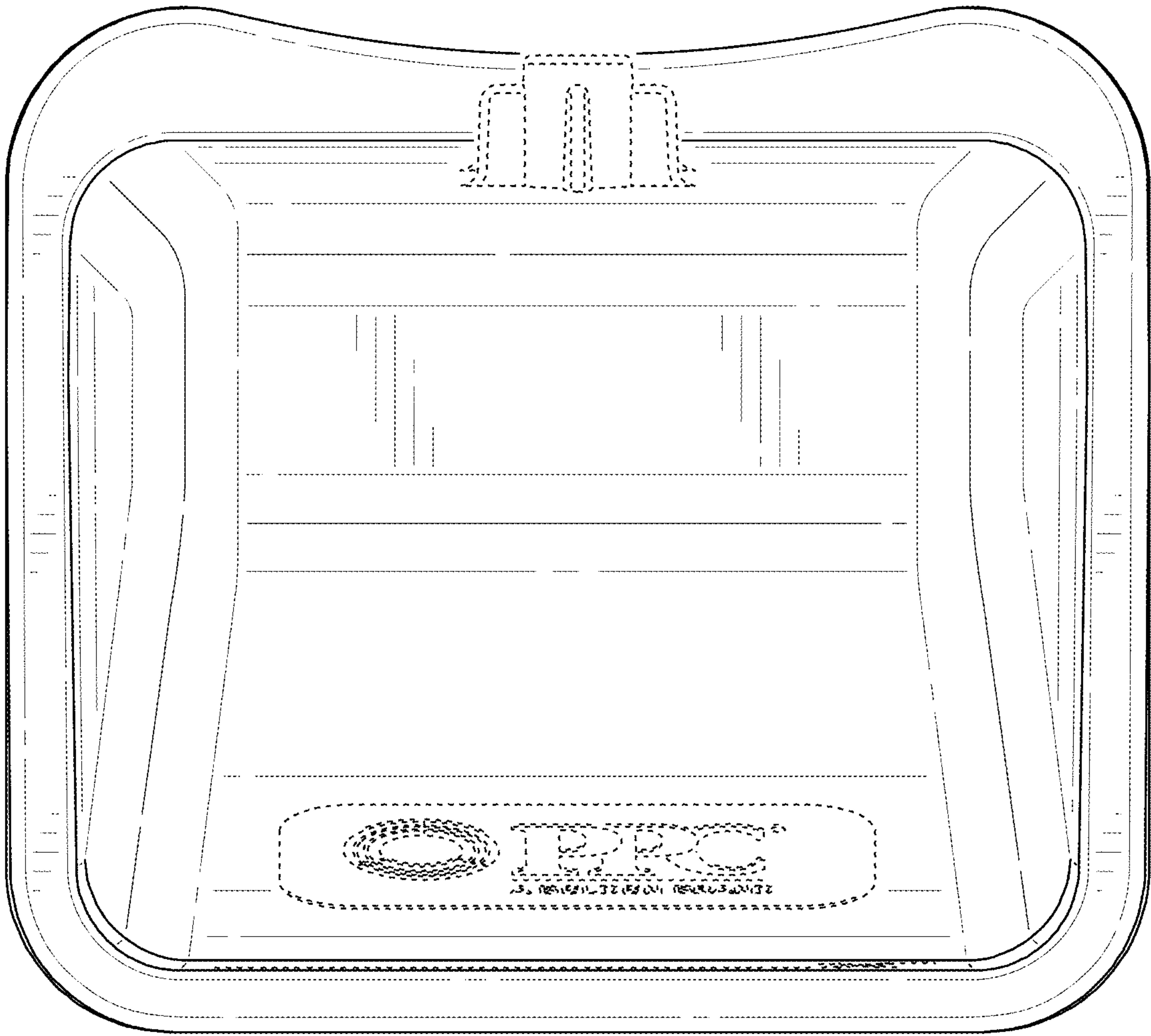

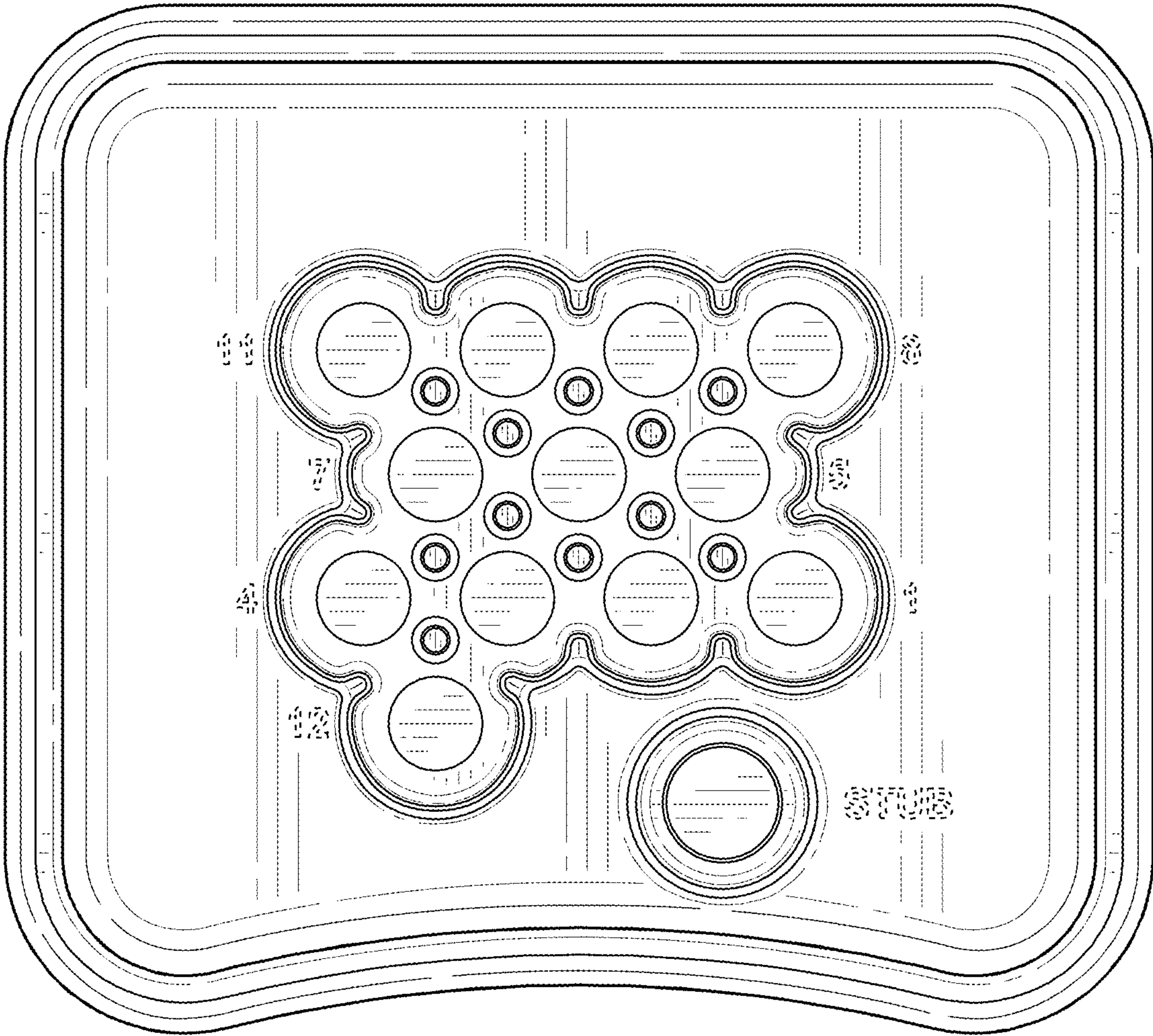

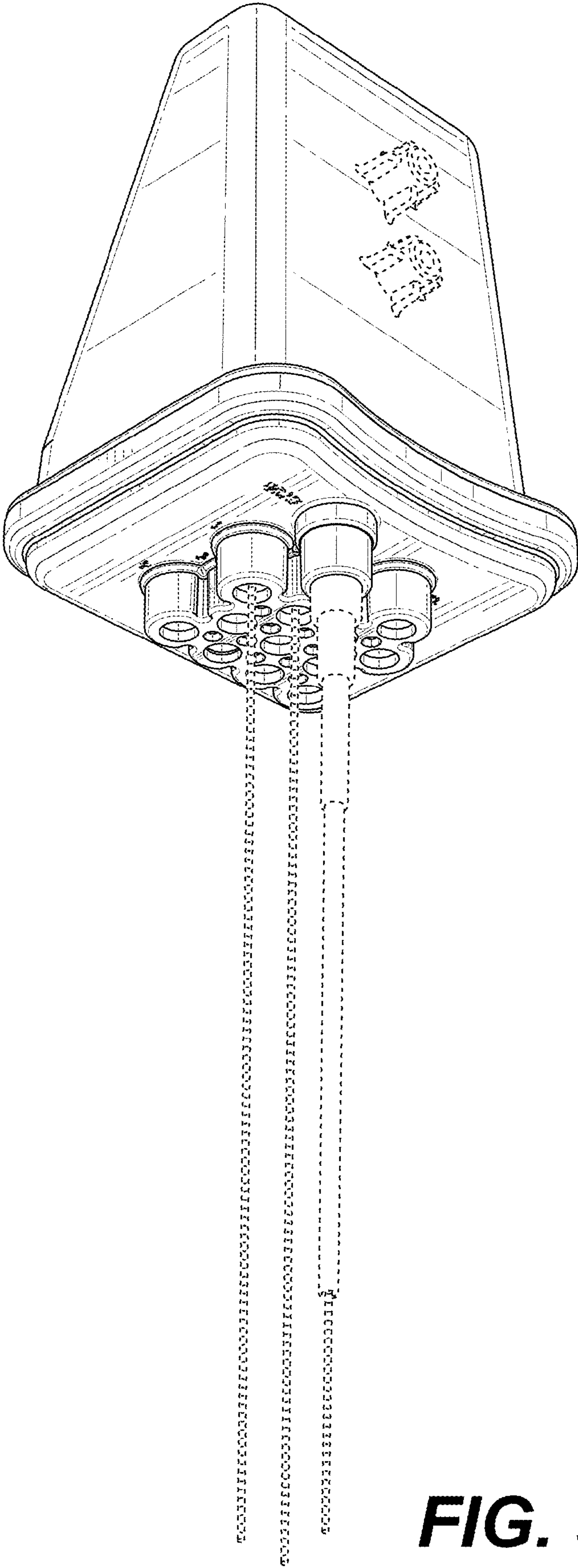
