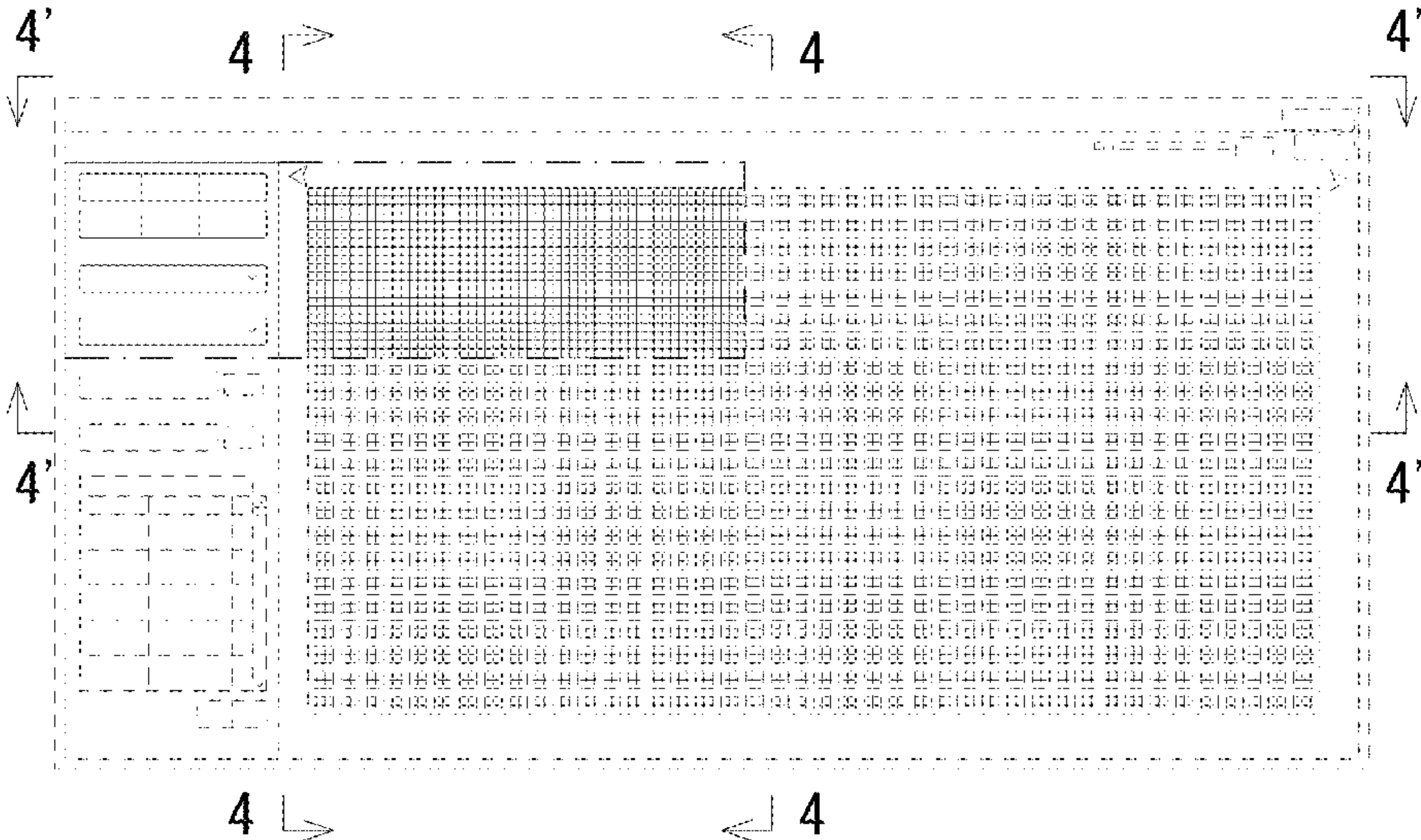
FIG. 1 is the first image in a sequence for a display screen or portion thereof with graphical user interface for a manufacturing process status diagnosis display device showing our new design;

The appearance of the graphical user interface sequentially transitions between the images shown in FIGS. 1-3. The process or period in which one image transitions to another forms no part of the claimed design.

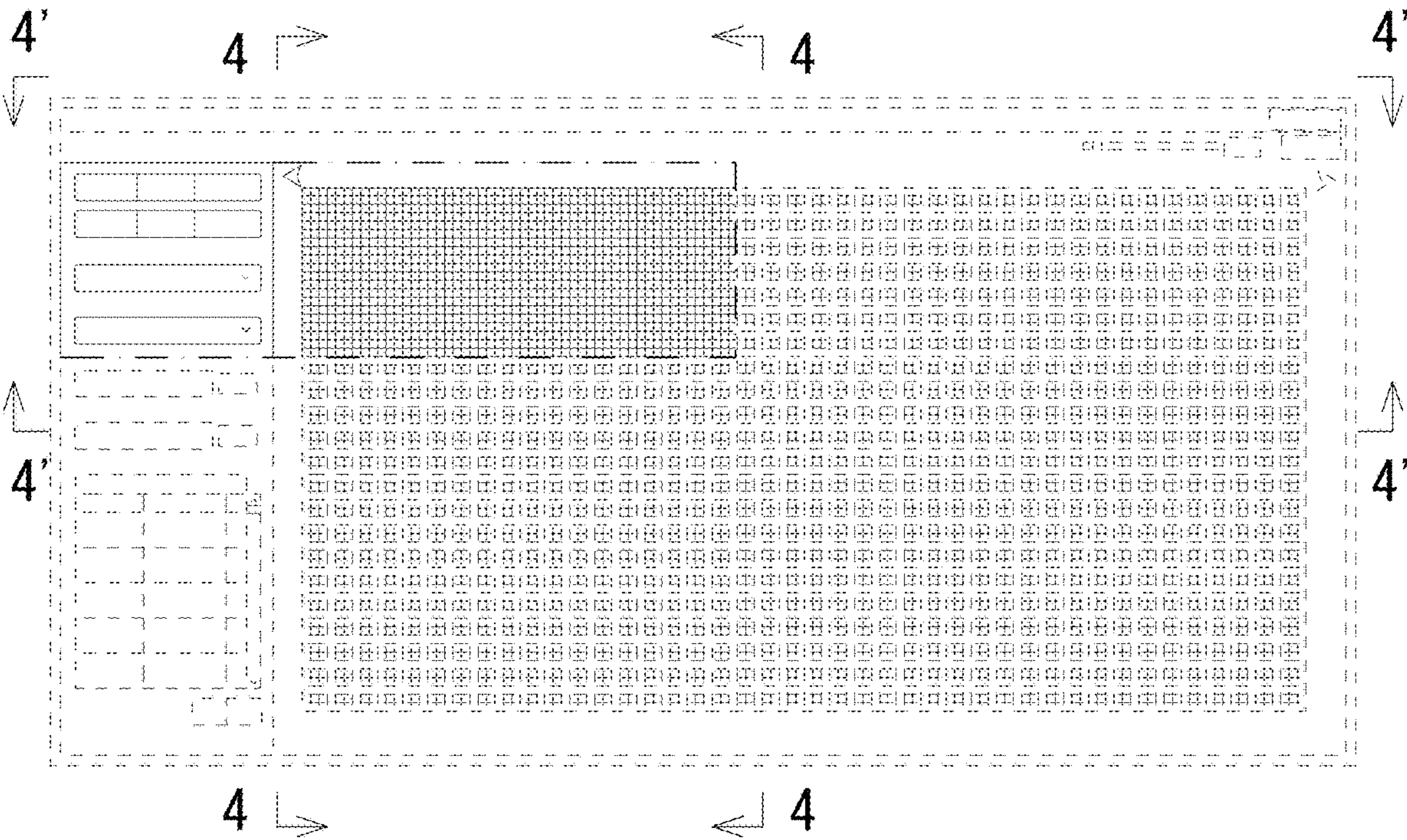

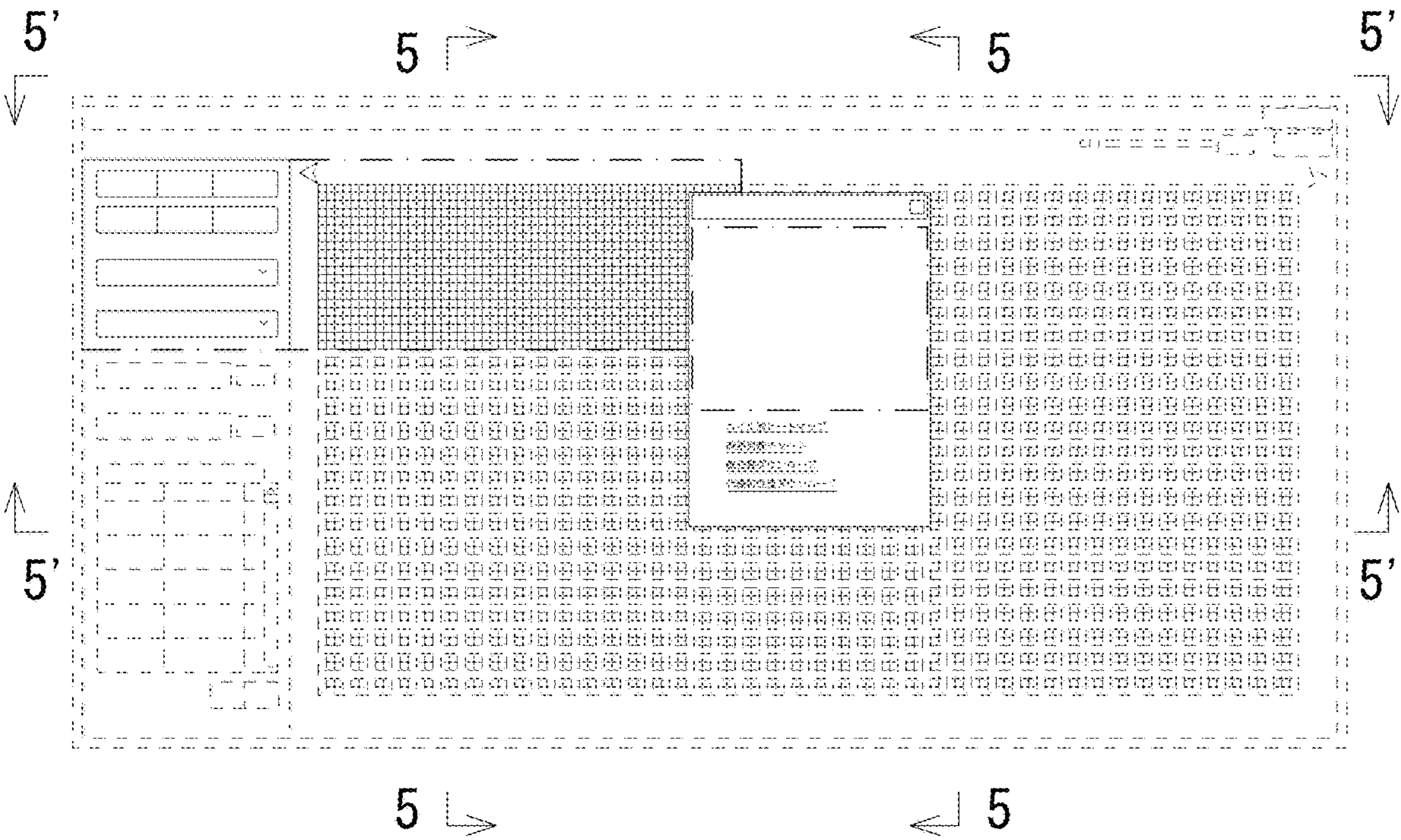

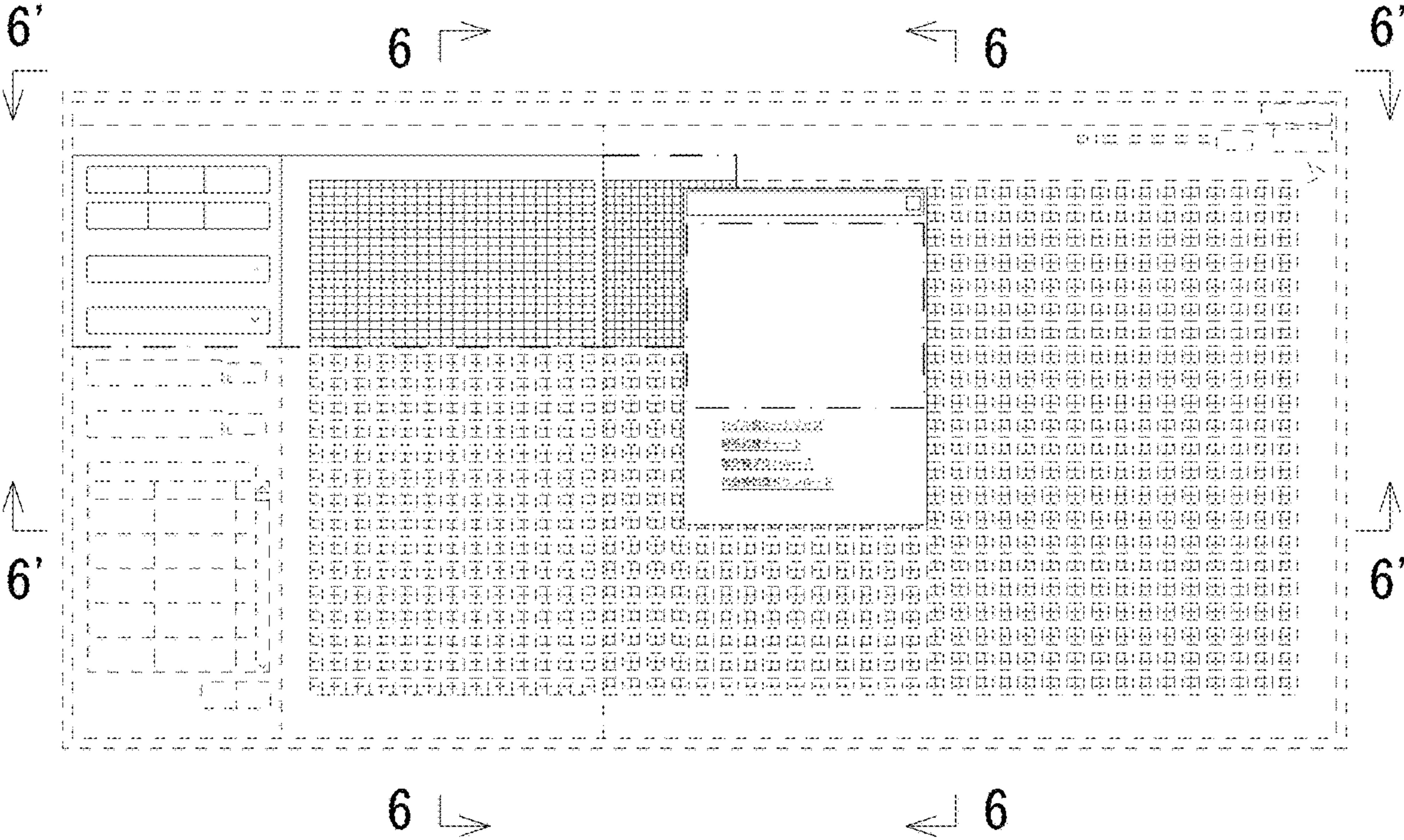

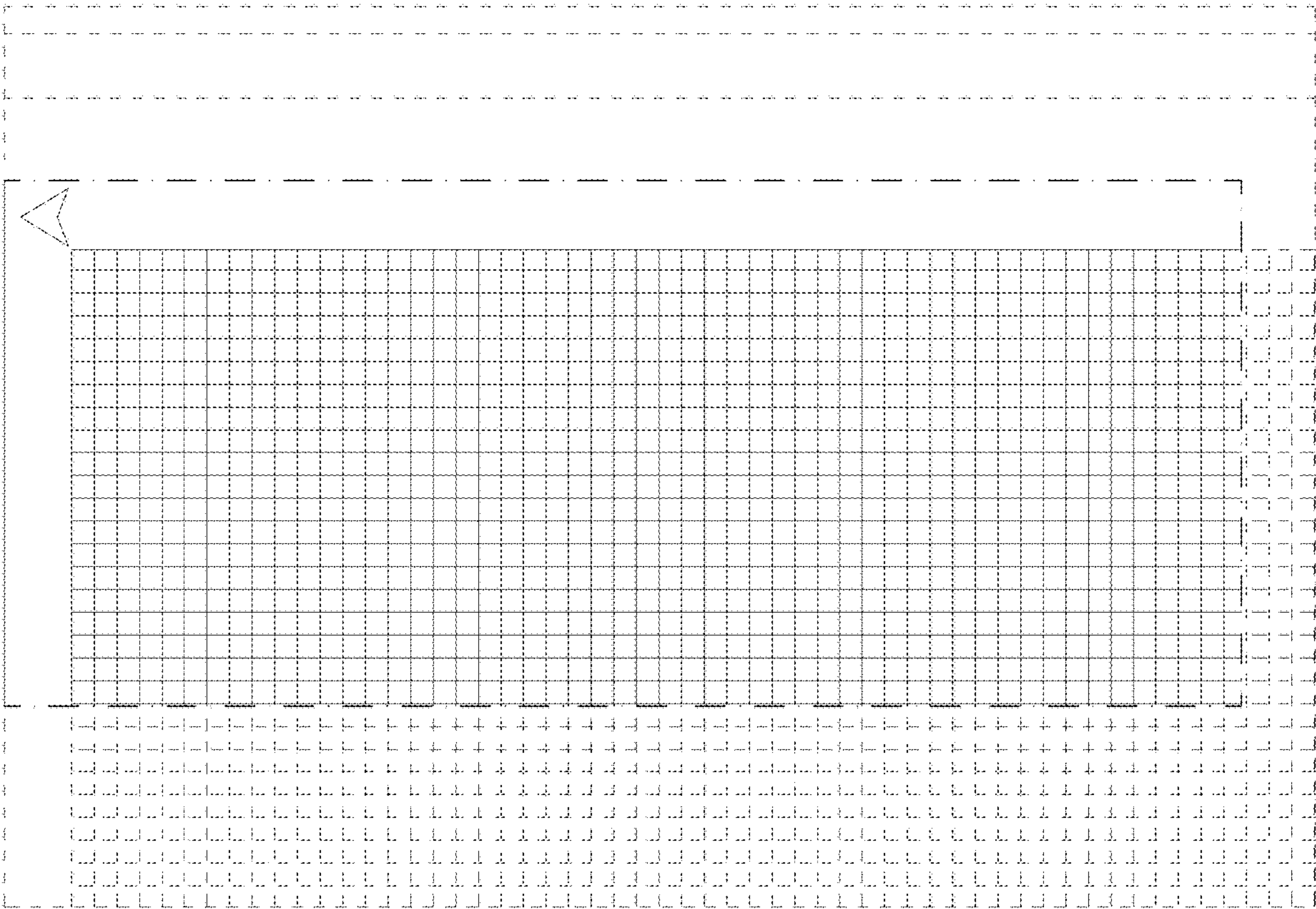

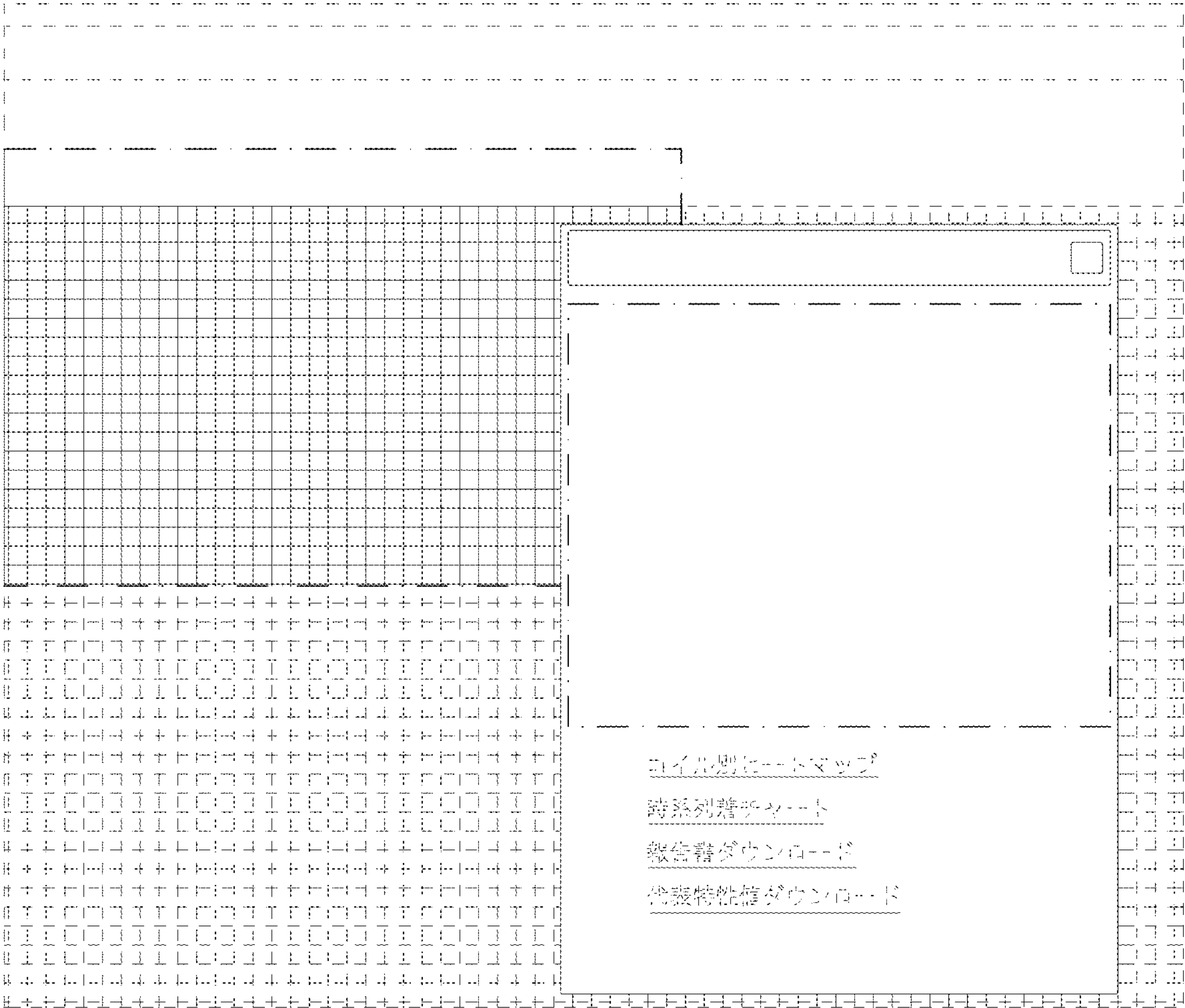
