FIG. 7 is a top plan view of the design of FIG. 1.

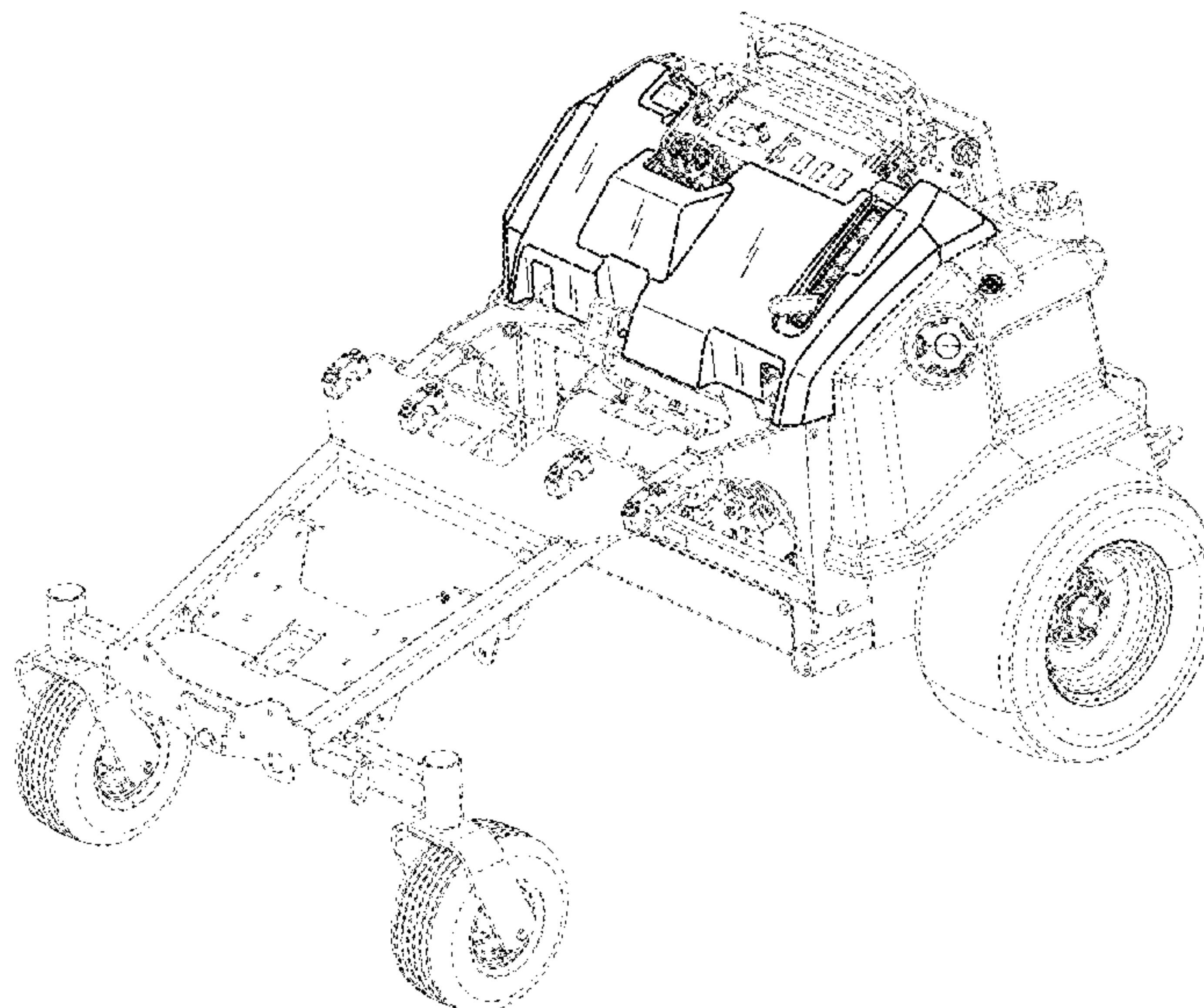
The bottom plan view is omitted as it forms no part of the claimed design and/or is cumulative in view of the remaining figures.

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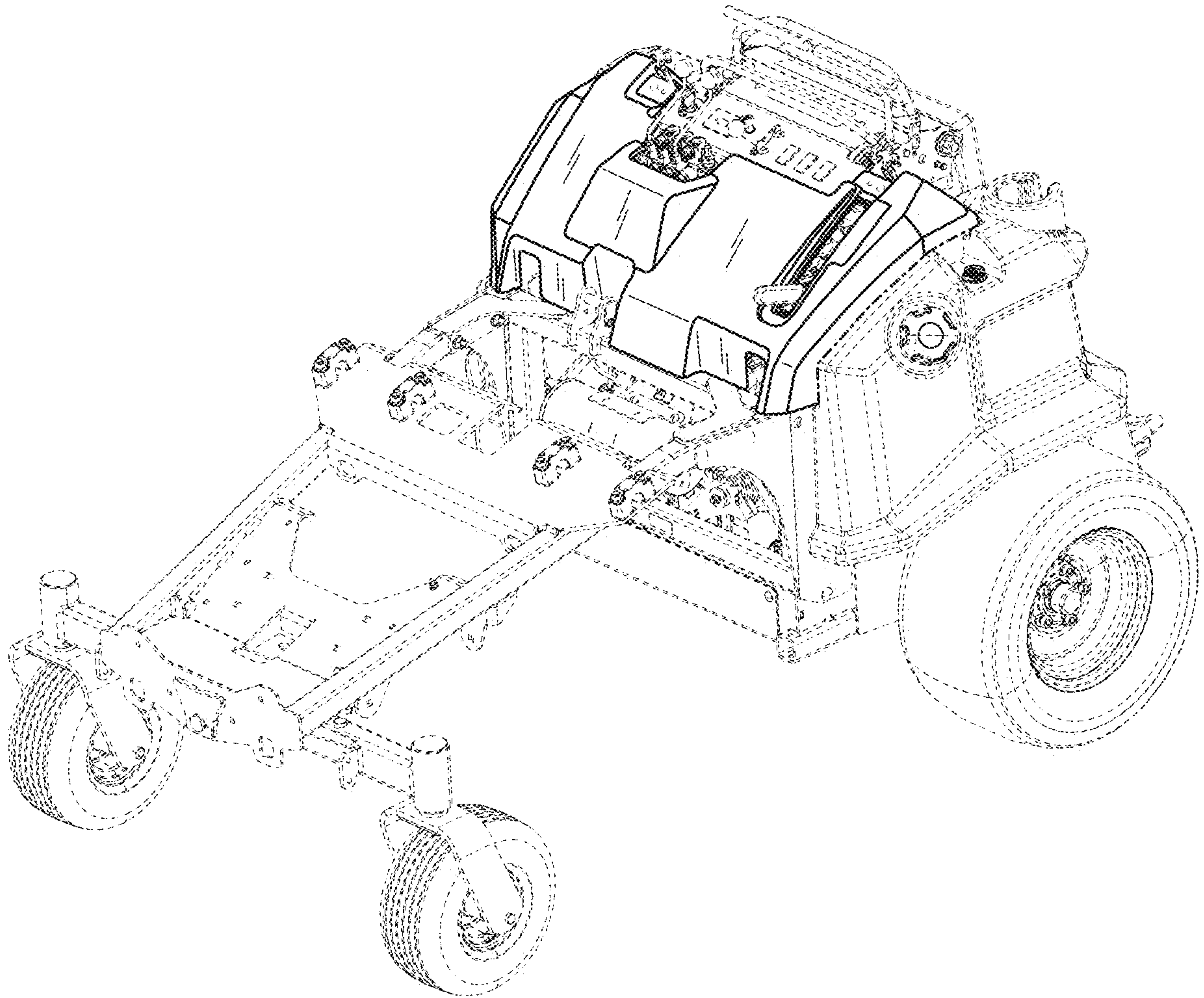

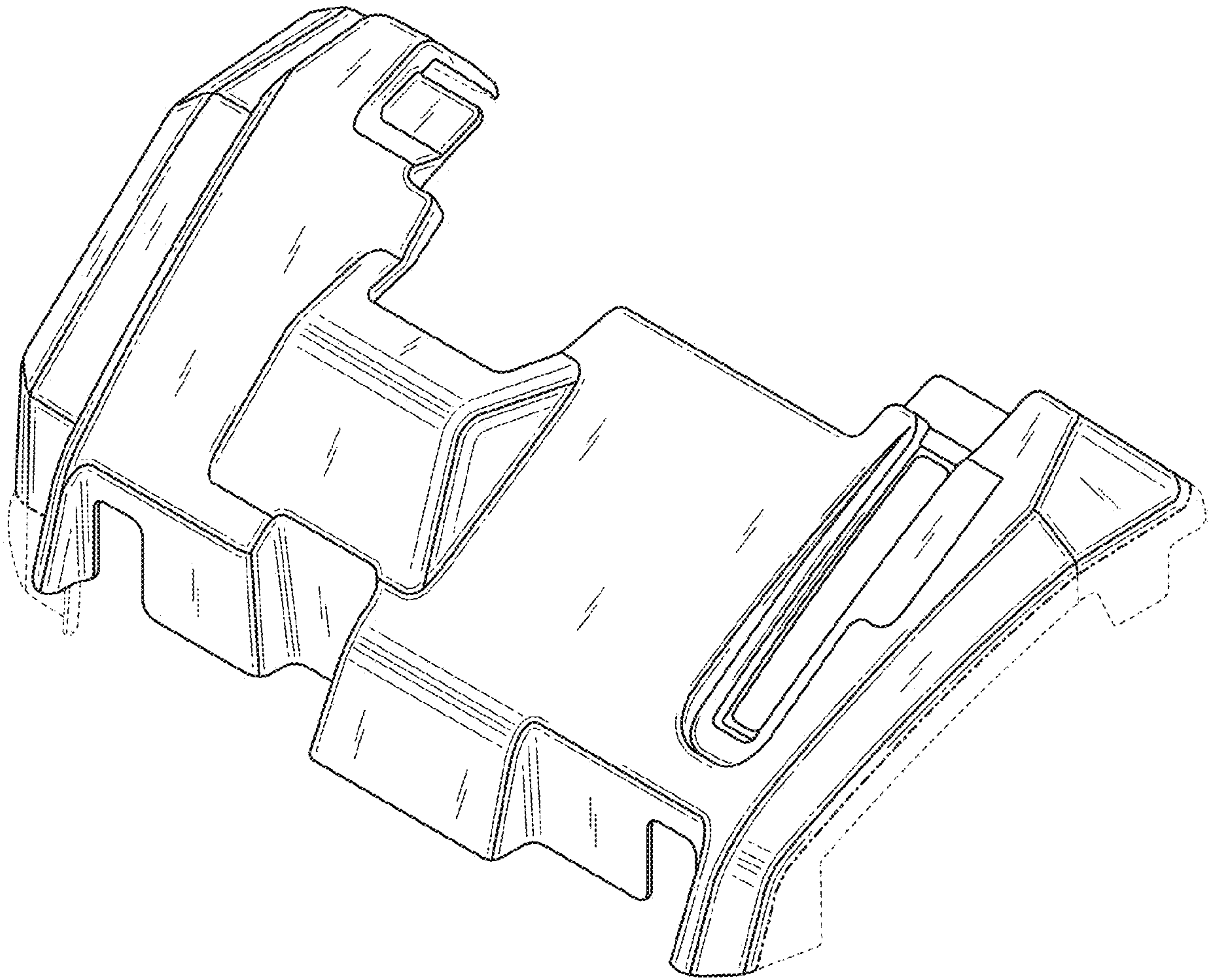

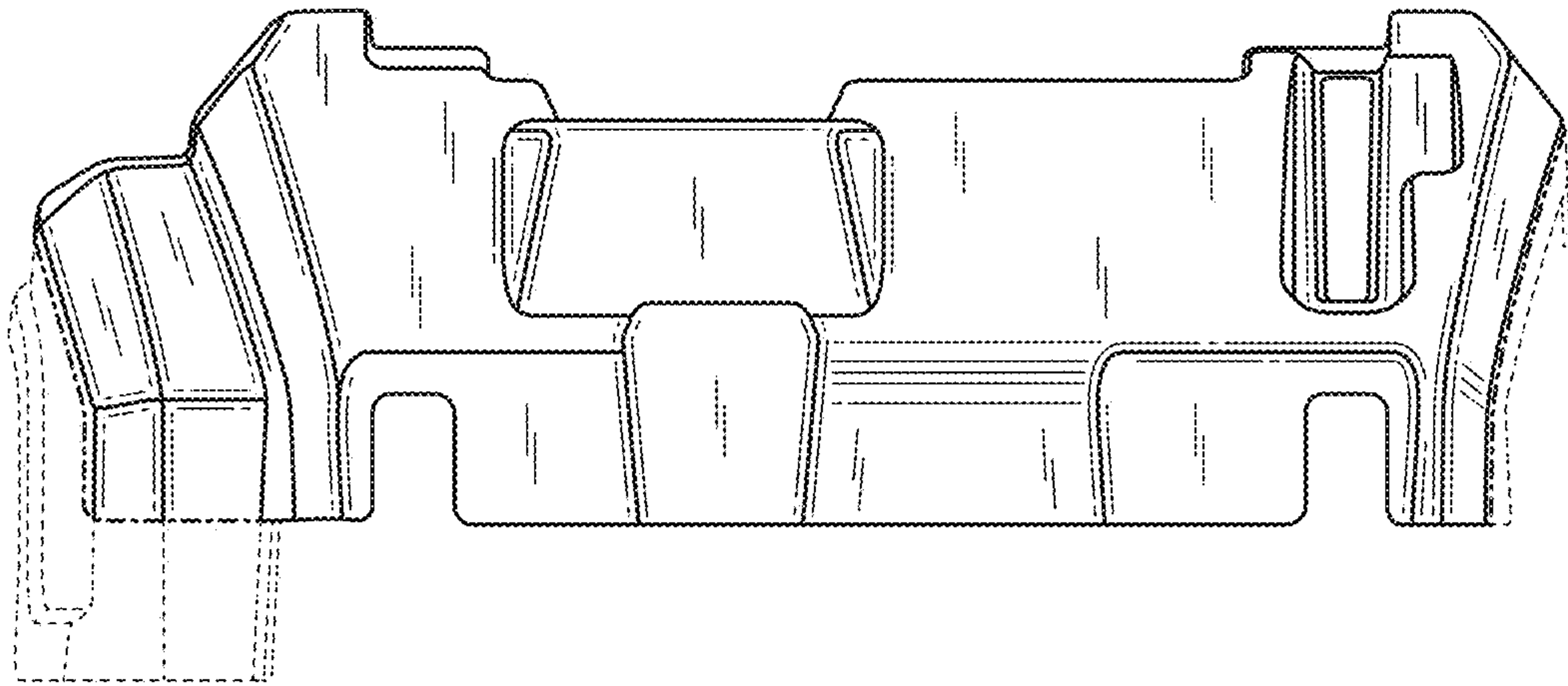

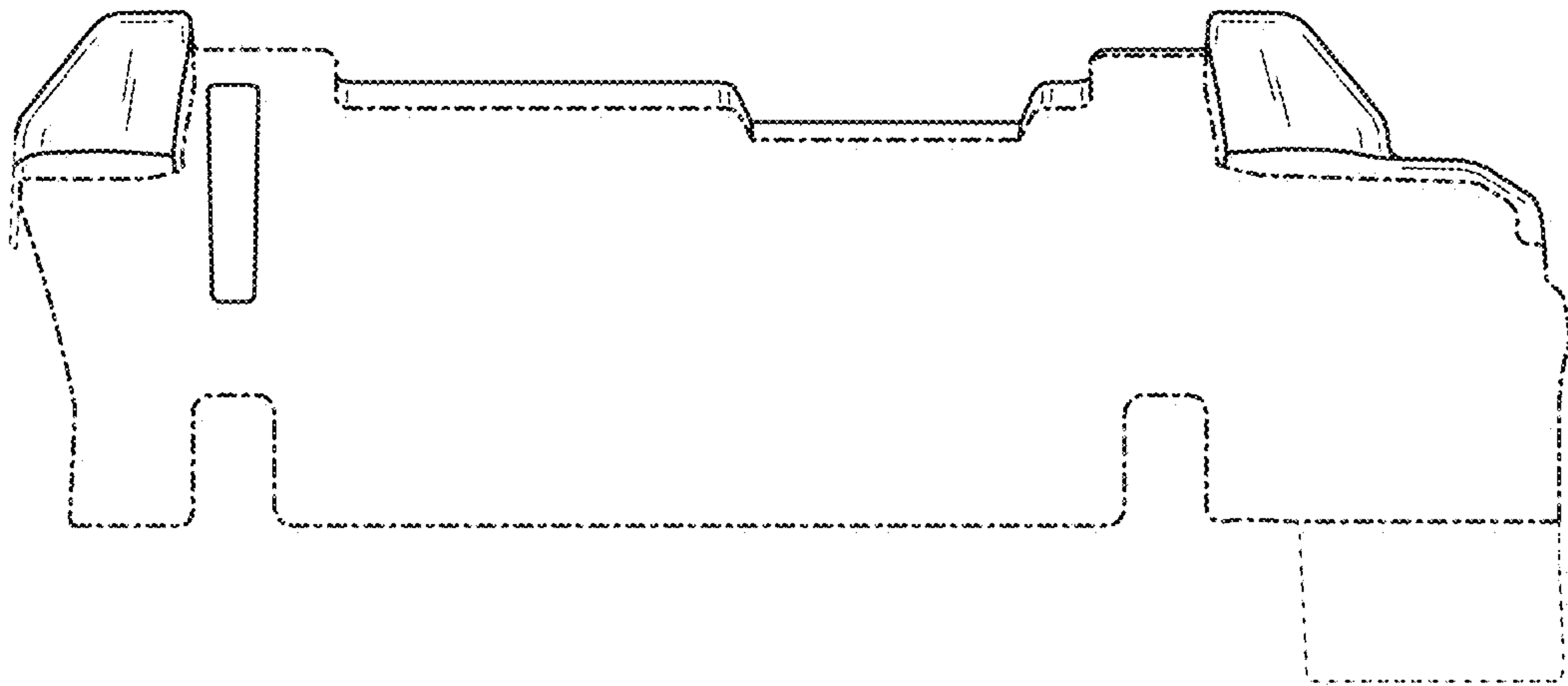

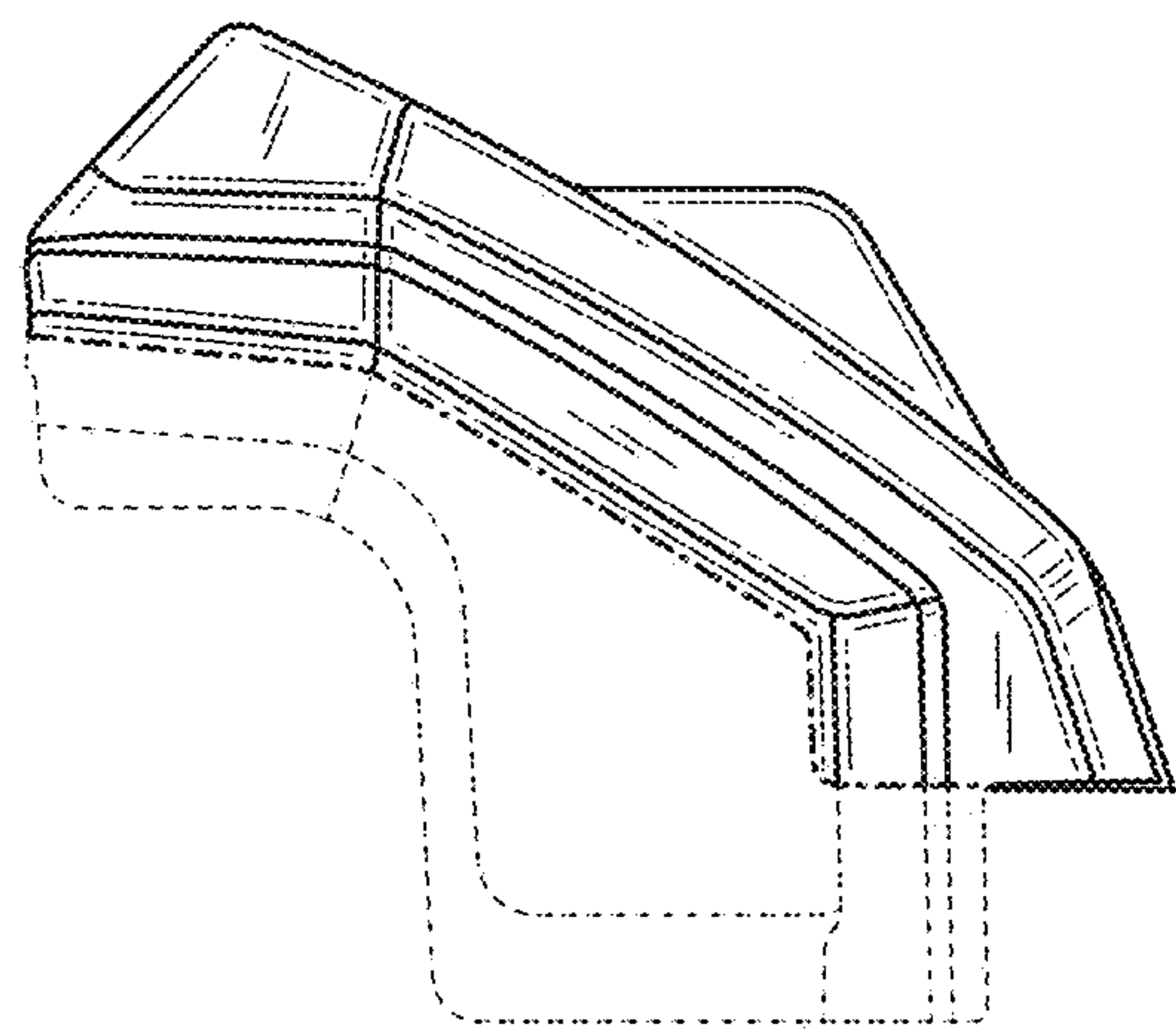

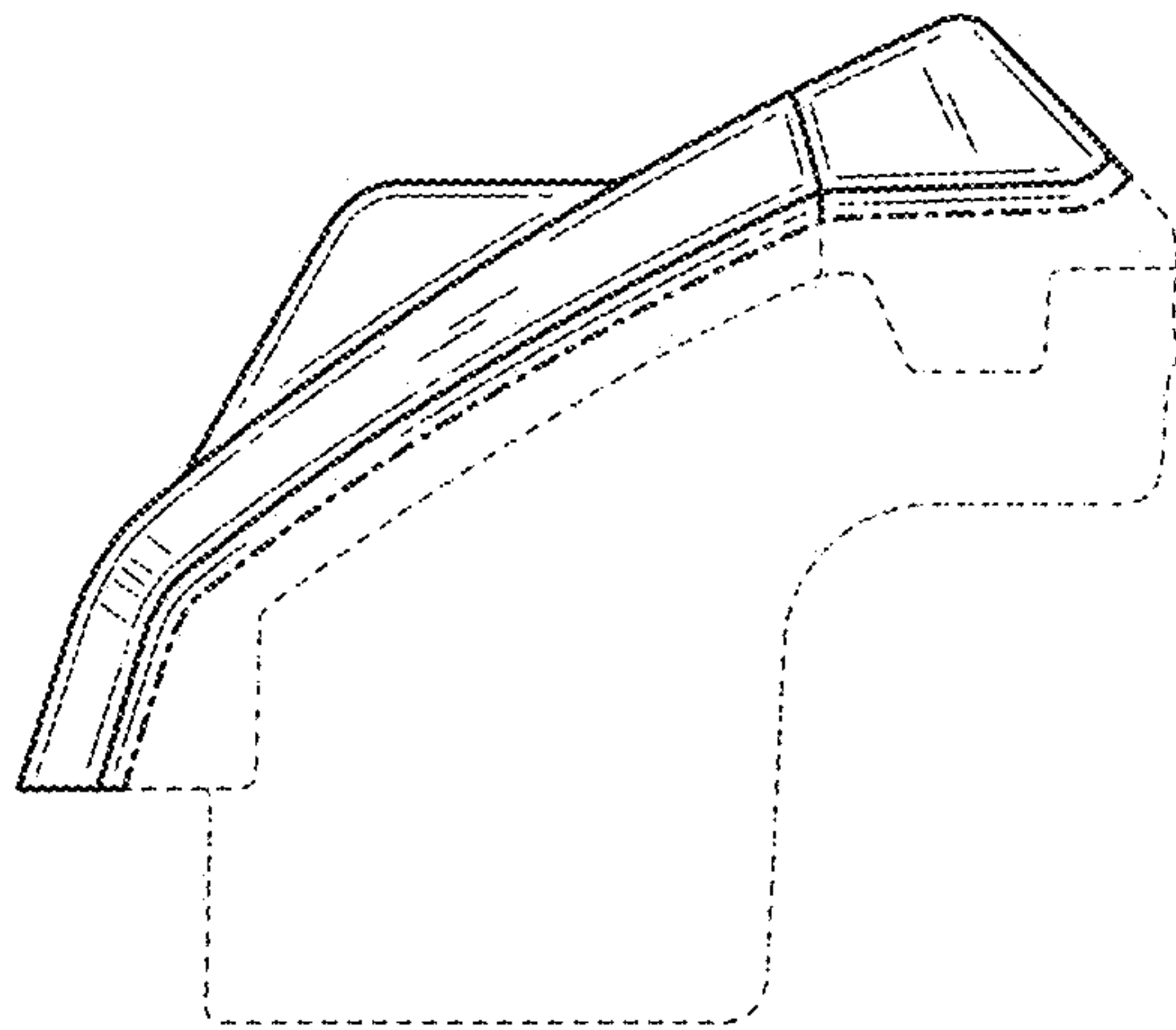

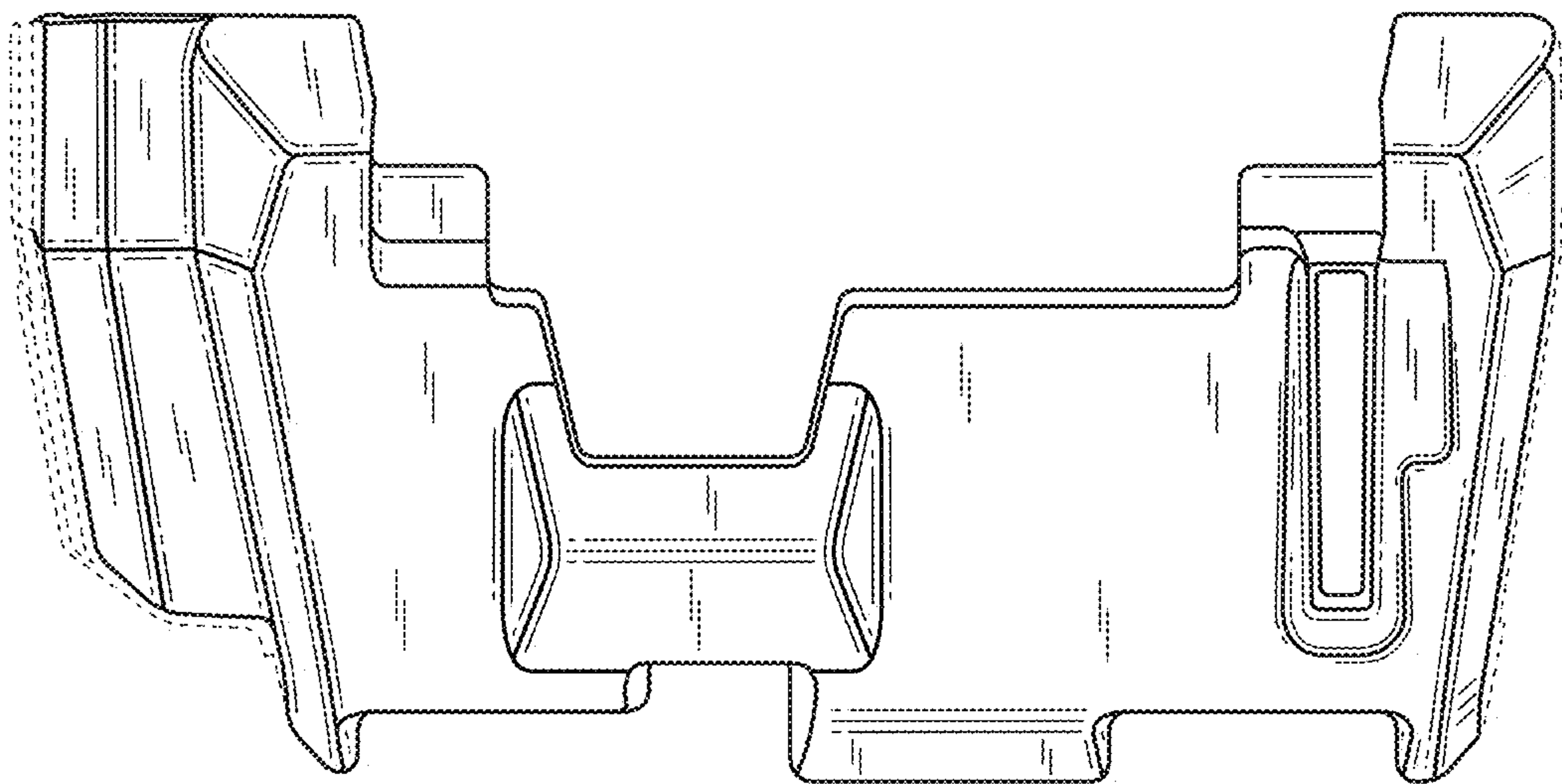
