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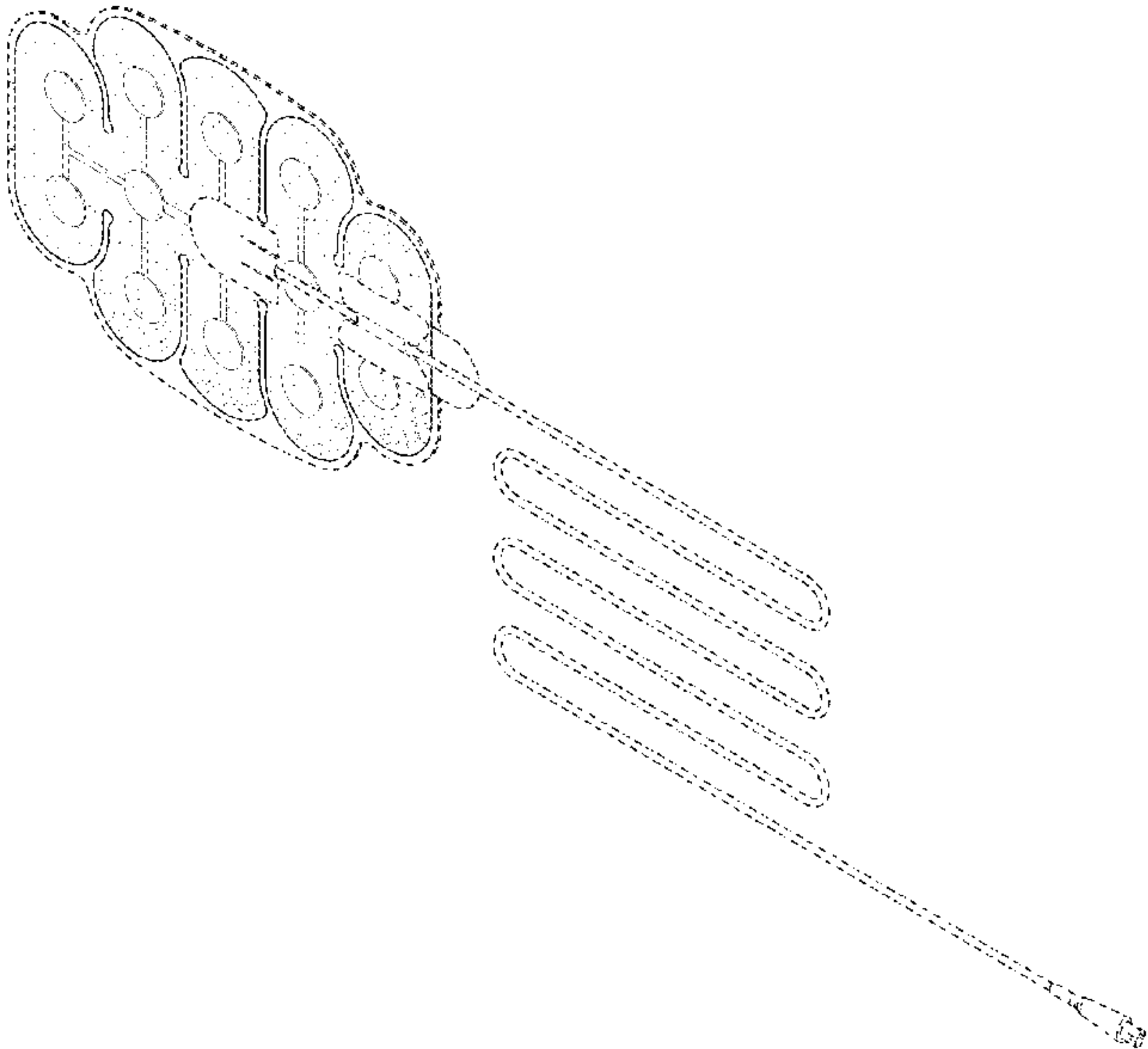
CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an electrode array showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the electrode array of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a front elevation view of the electrode array of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view of the electrode array of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a left side elevation view of the electrode array of FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 6 is a right side elevation view of the electrode array of FIG. 1.
The broken lines, the areas within them, and the unshaded areas bounded by the broken lines and the solid lines depict portions of the electrode array that form no part of the claimed design.

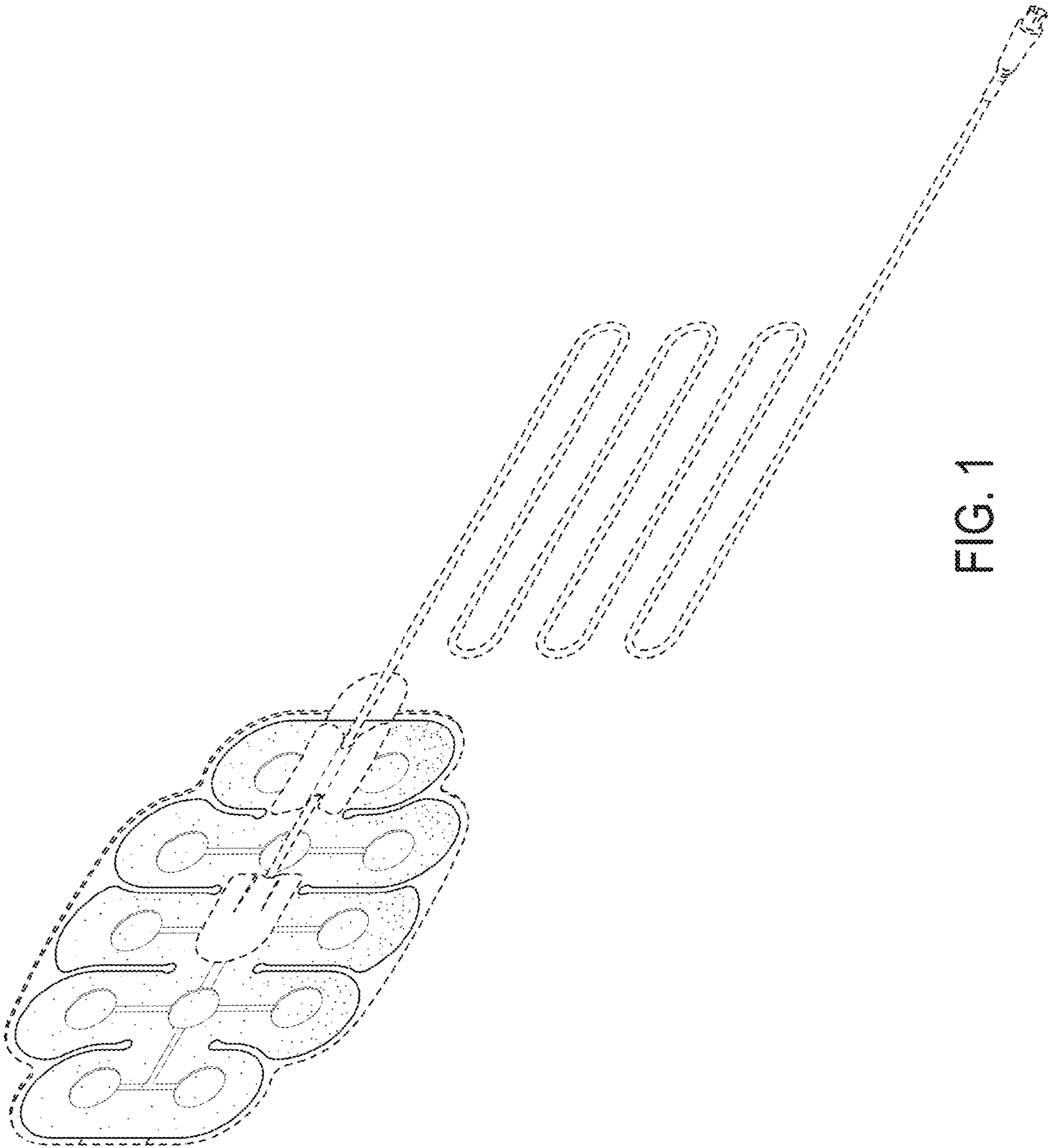

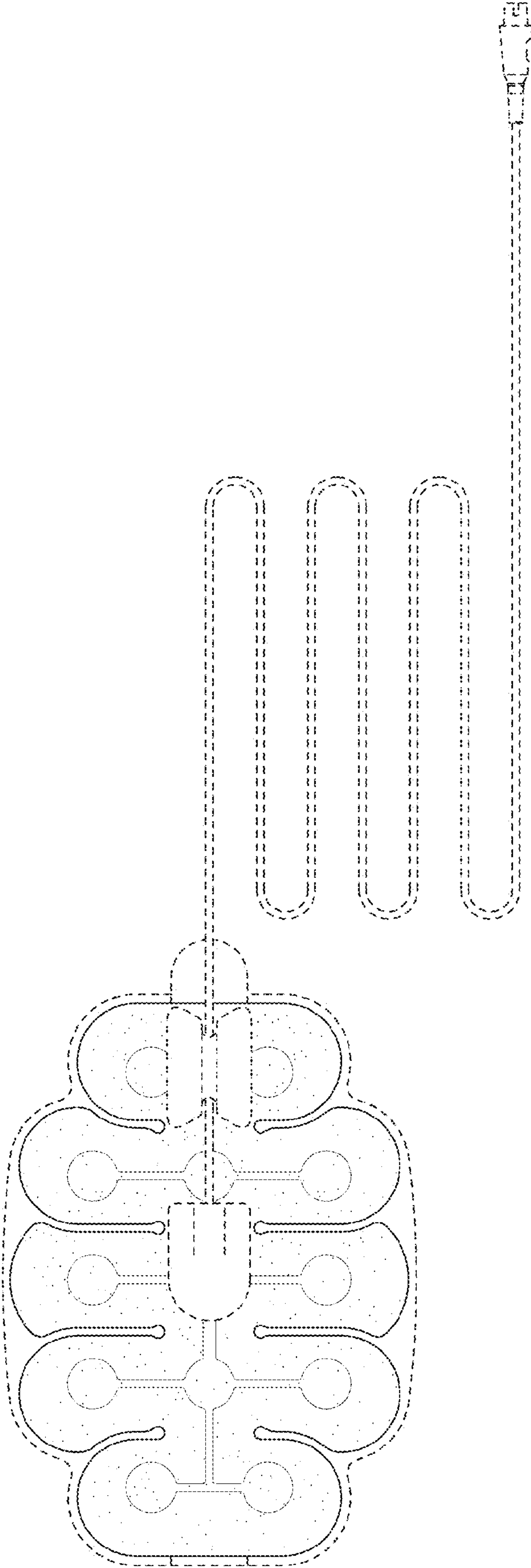

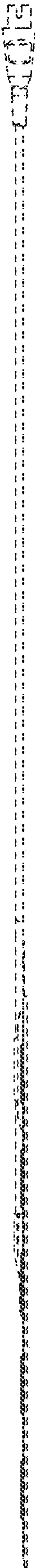

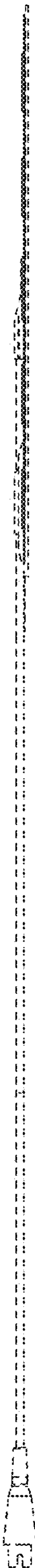

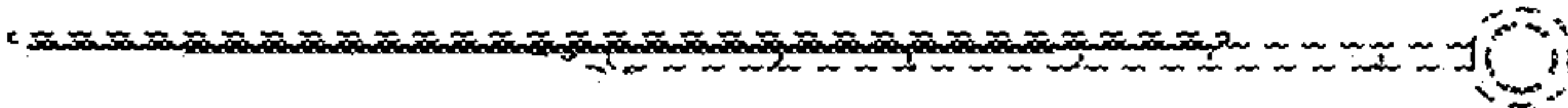

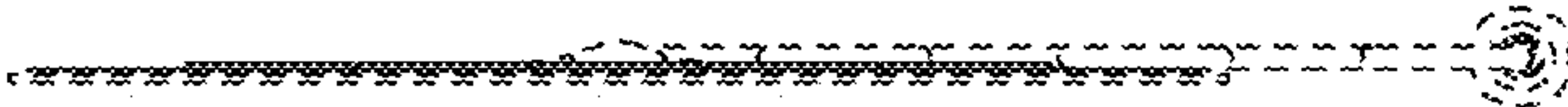
