DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, raised perspective view of a toilet paper dispenser according to the invention;

FIG. 2 is a front view of the toilet paper dispenser of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a rear view of the toilet paper dispenser of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a right side view of the toilet paper dispenser of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a left side view of the toilet paper dispenser of FIG. 1;

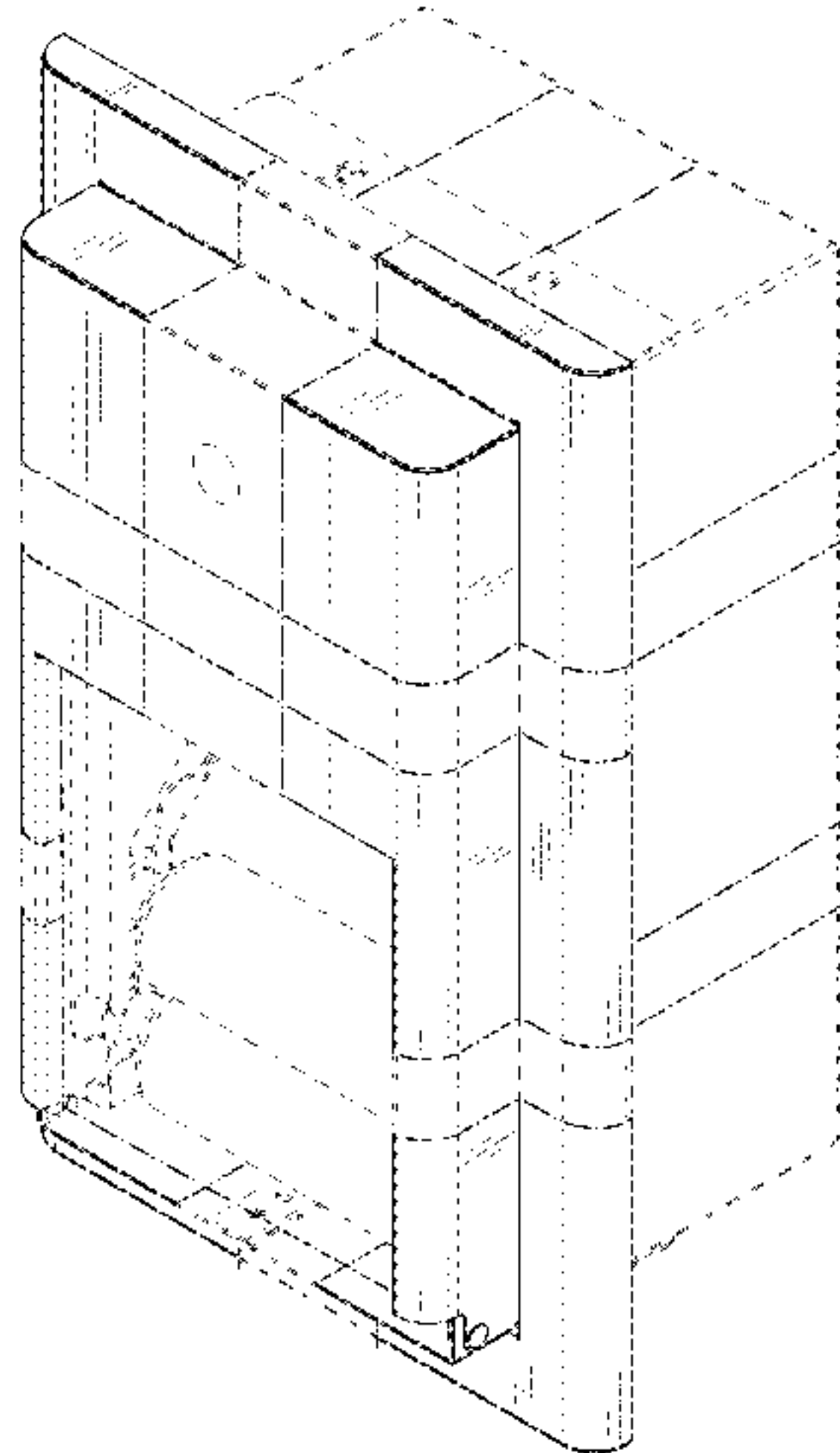
FIG. 6 is a top view of the toilet paper dispenser of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the toilet paper dispenser of FIG. 1.

The broken lines show portions of the toilet paper dispenser that form no part of the claimed design. The dash dot lines immediately adjacent to the claimed areas in the views represent the boundaries of the claimed design. The toilet paper dispenser is shown with symbolic breaks in its width and height. The appearance of any portion of the toilet paper dispenser between the break lines forms no parts of the claimed design.

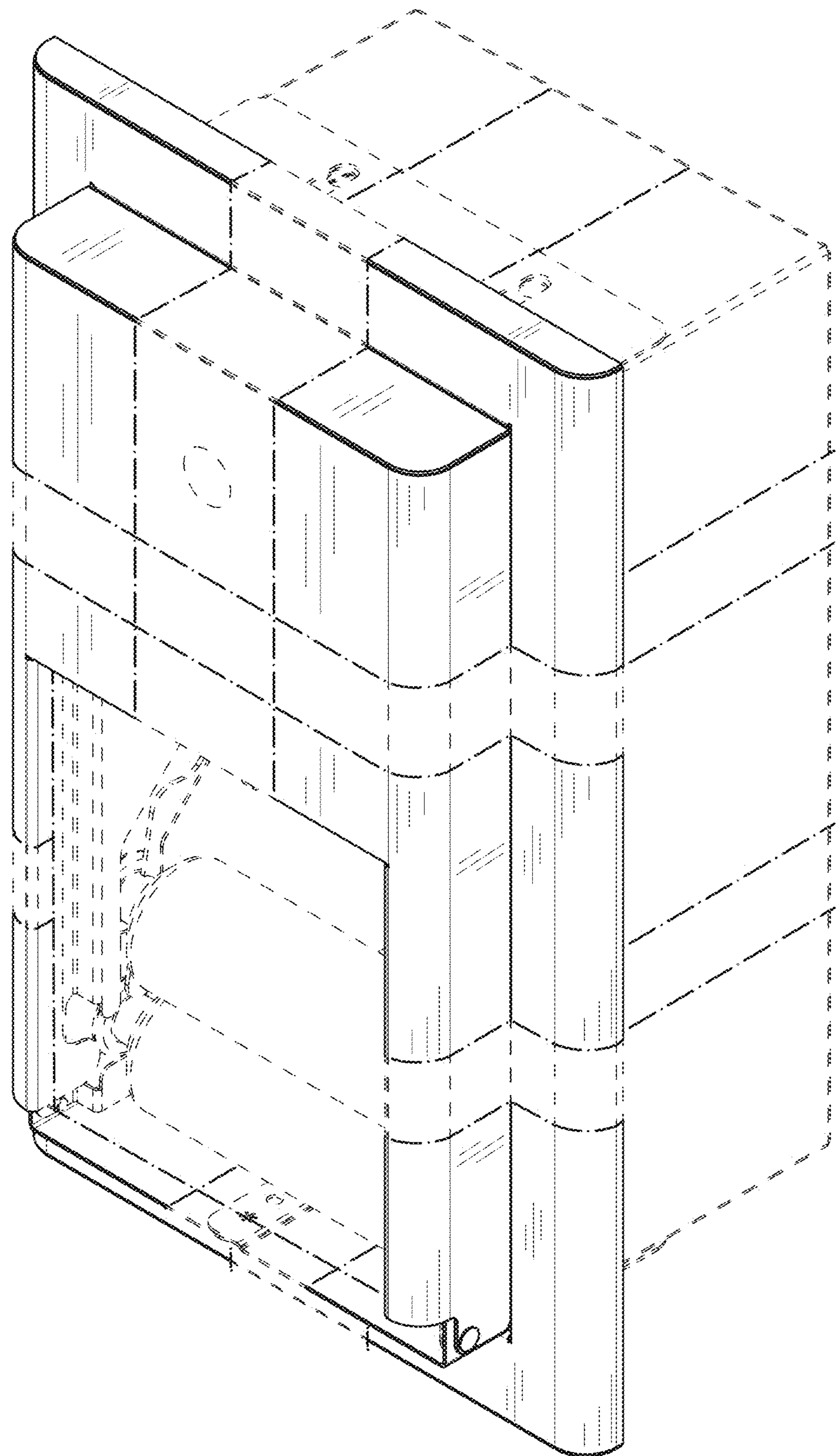

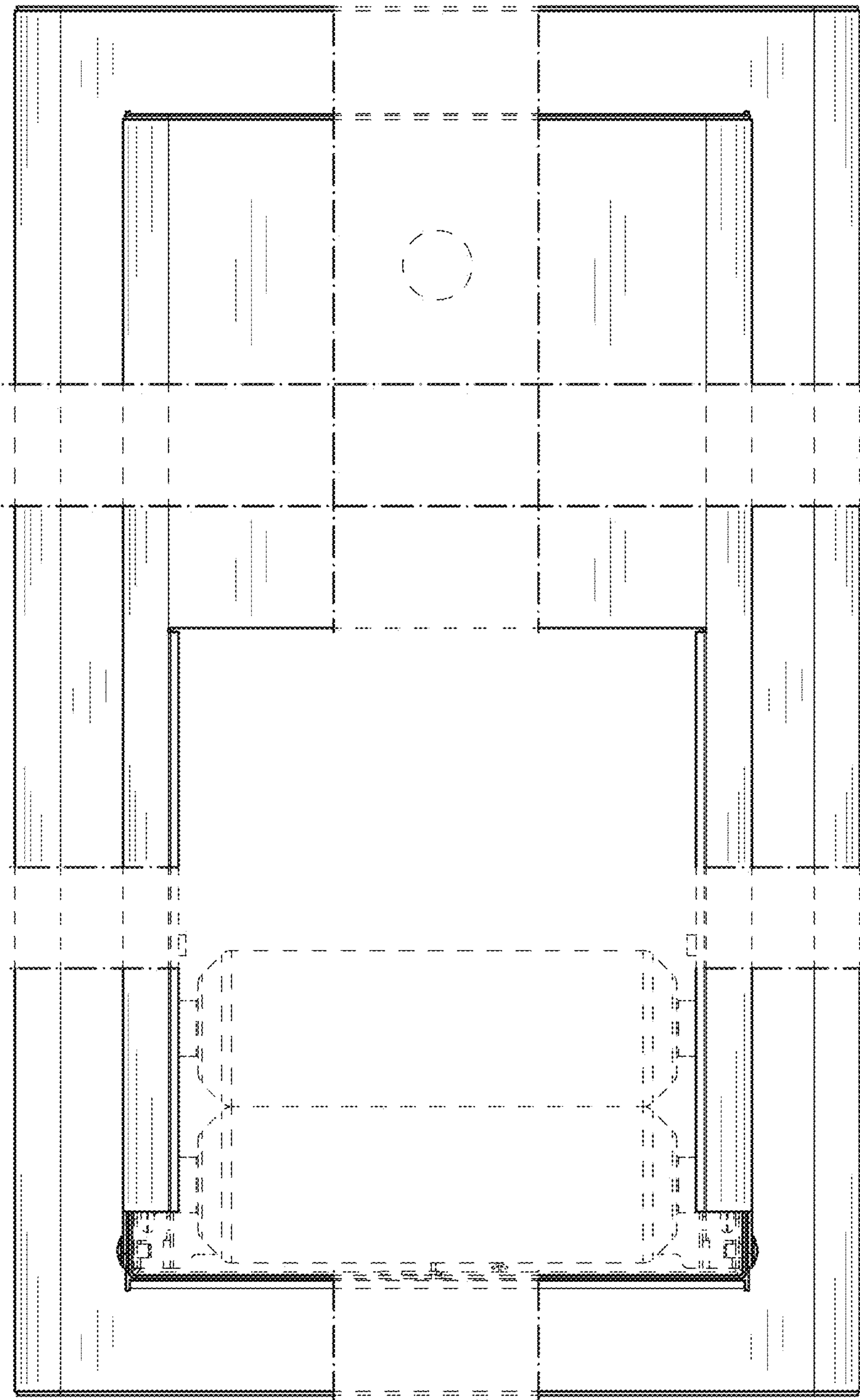

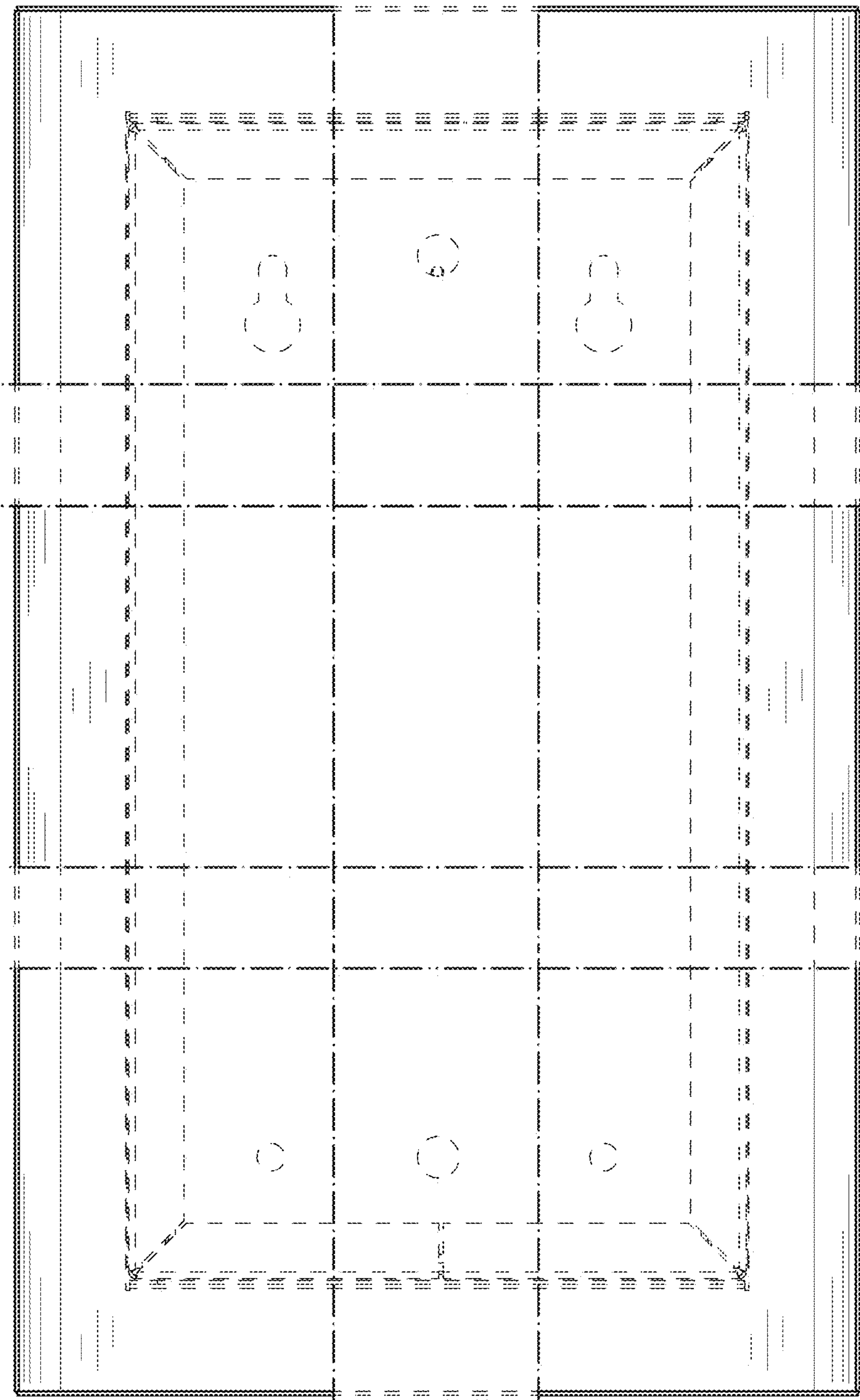

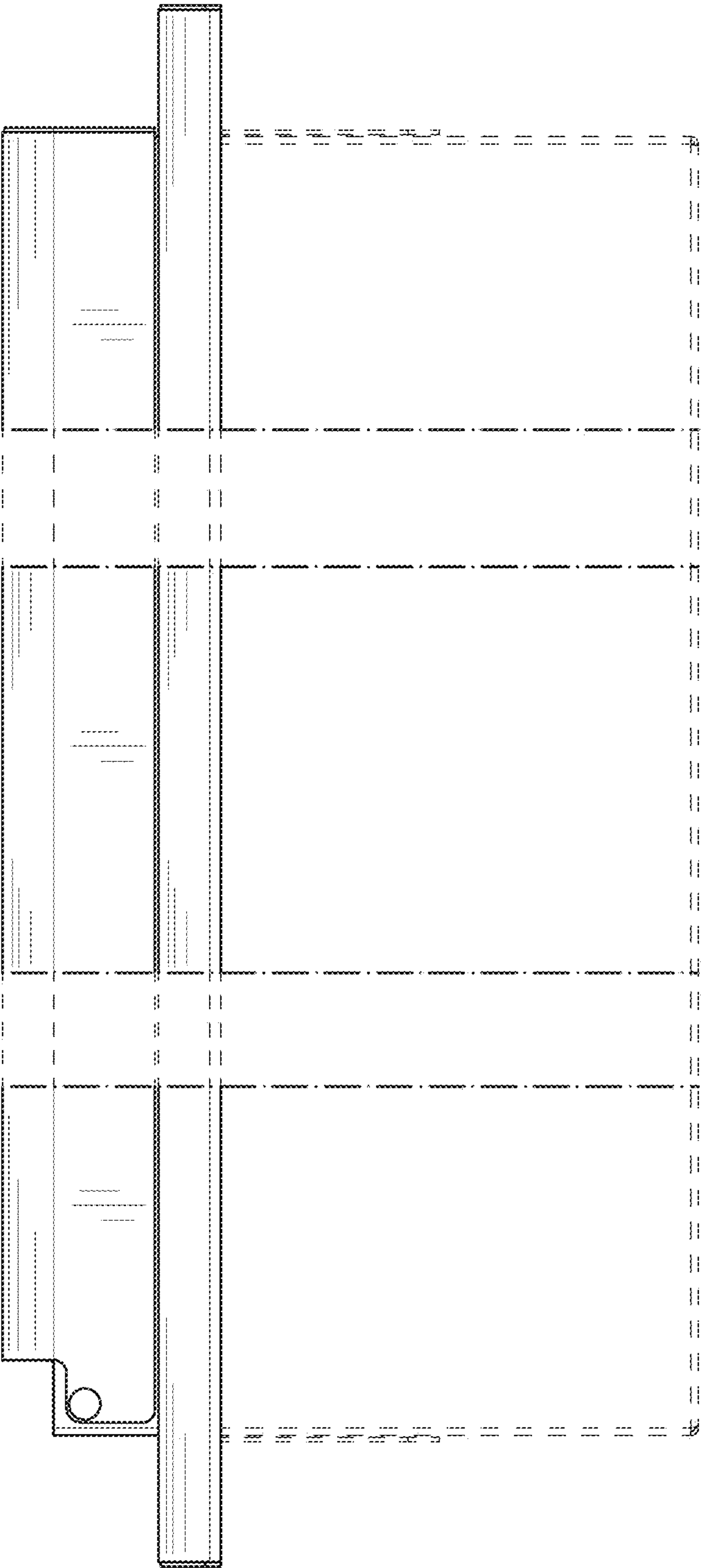

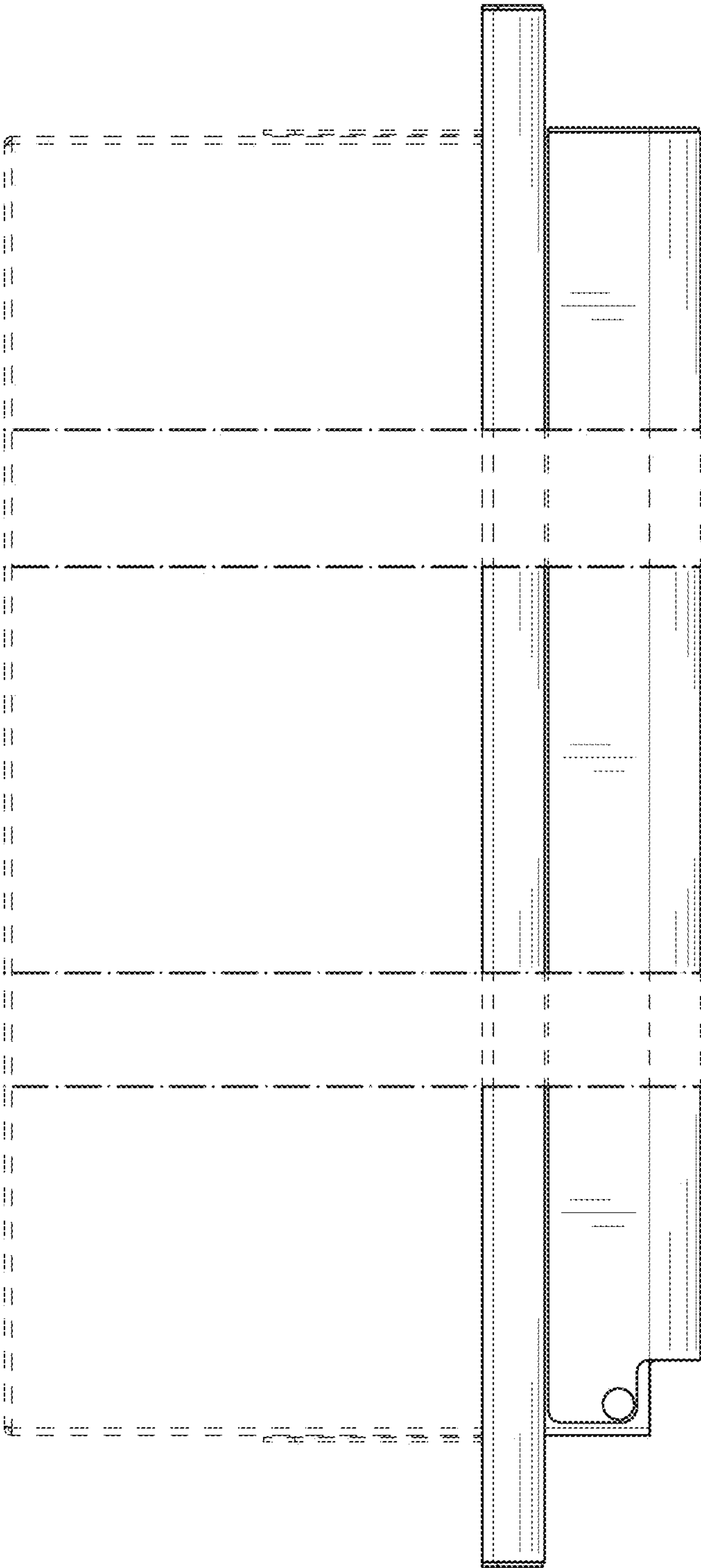

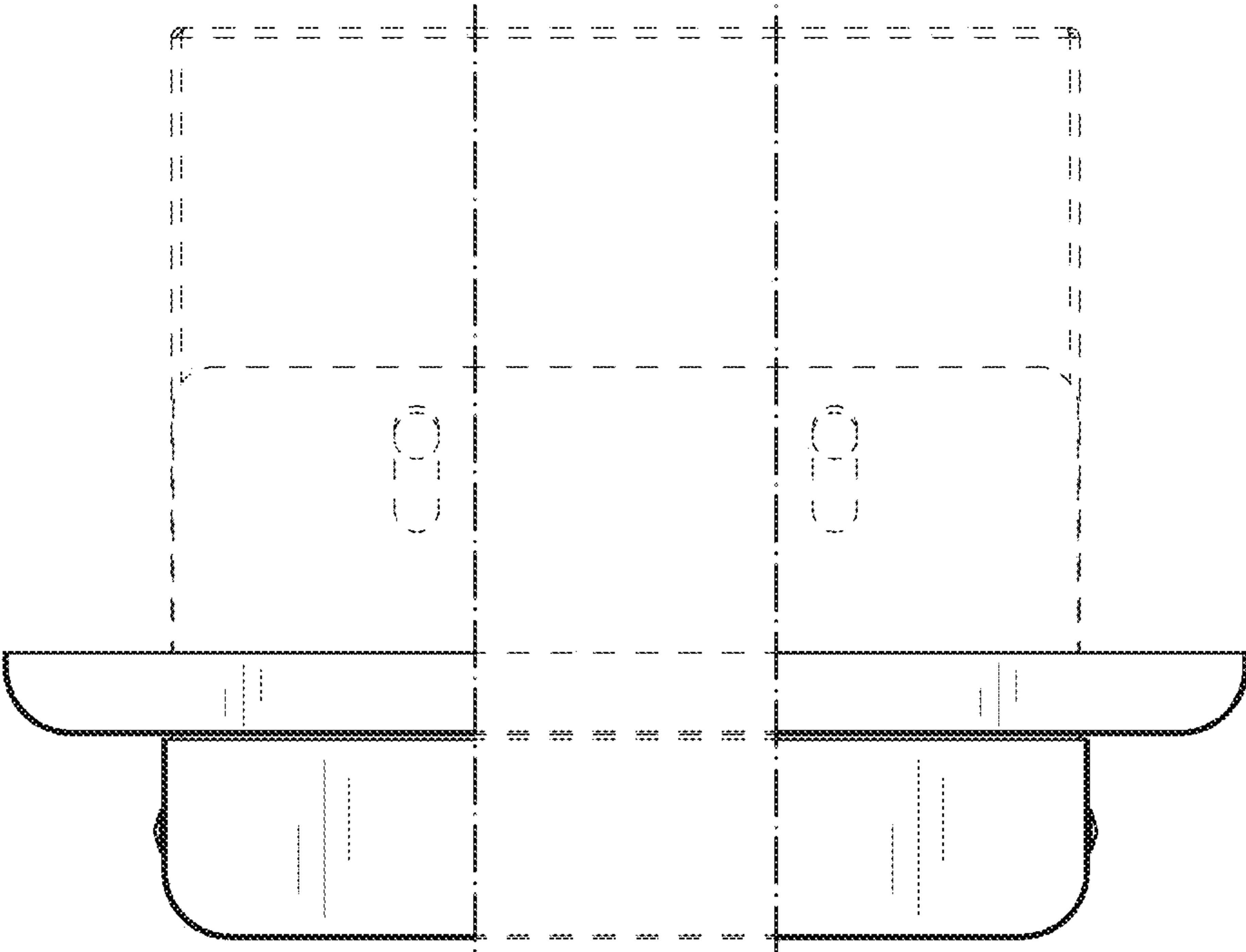

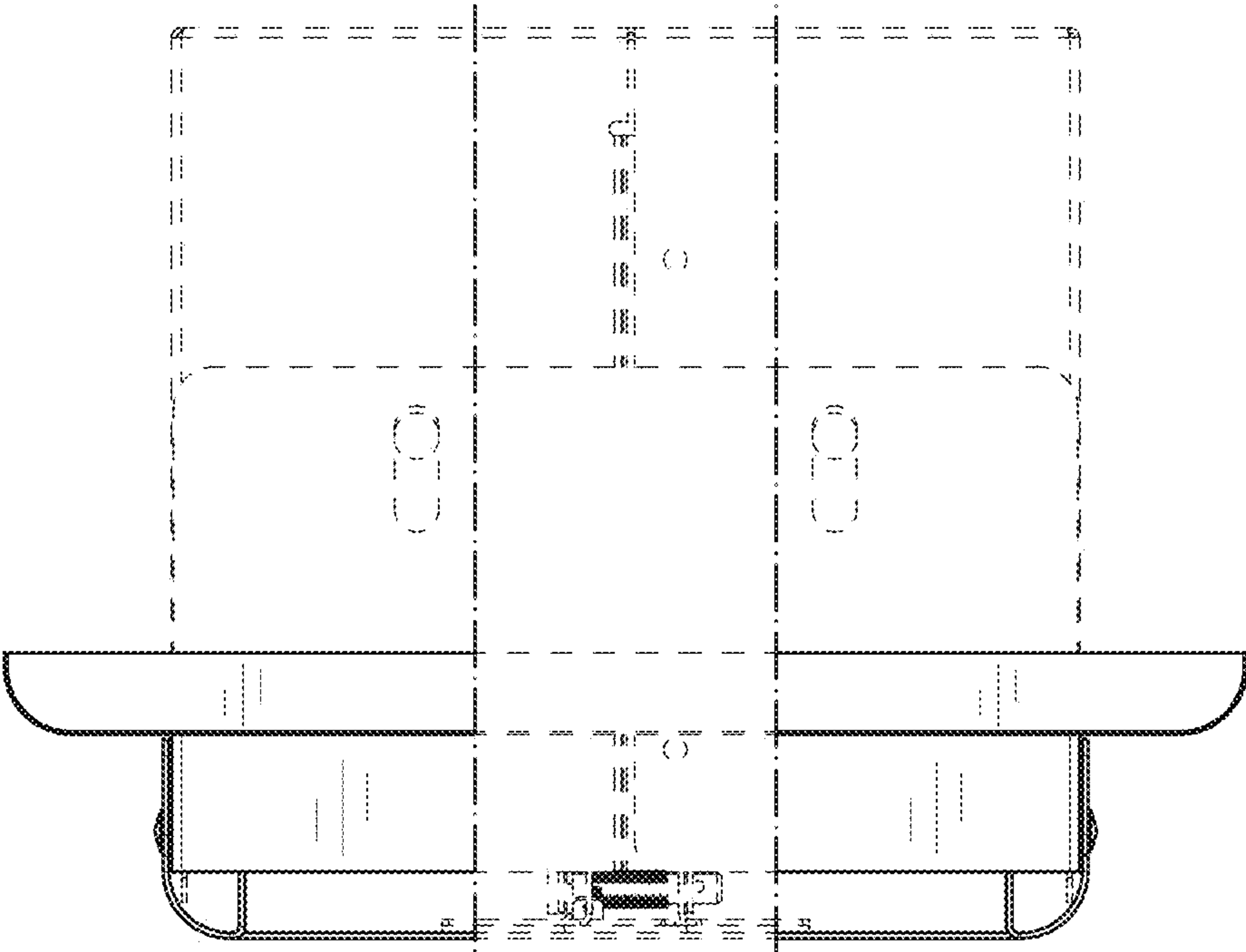
