The ornamental design for an automobile tail light, as shown and described.

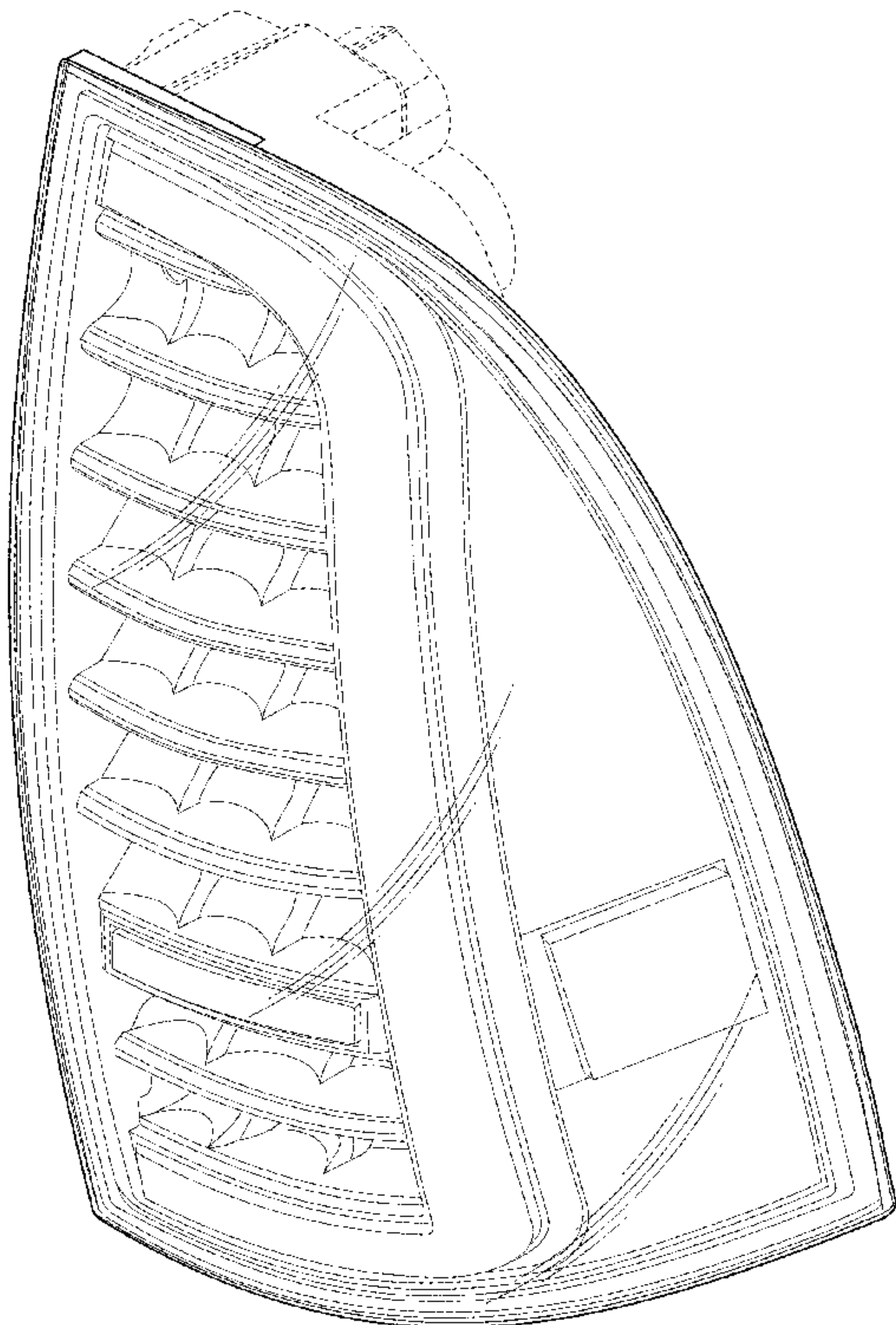
DESCRIPTION

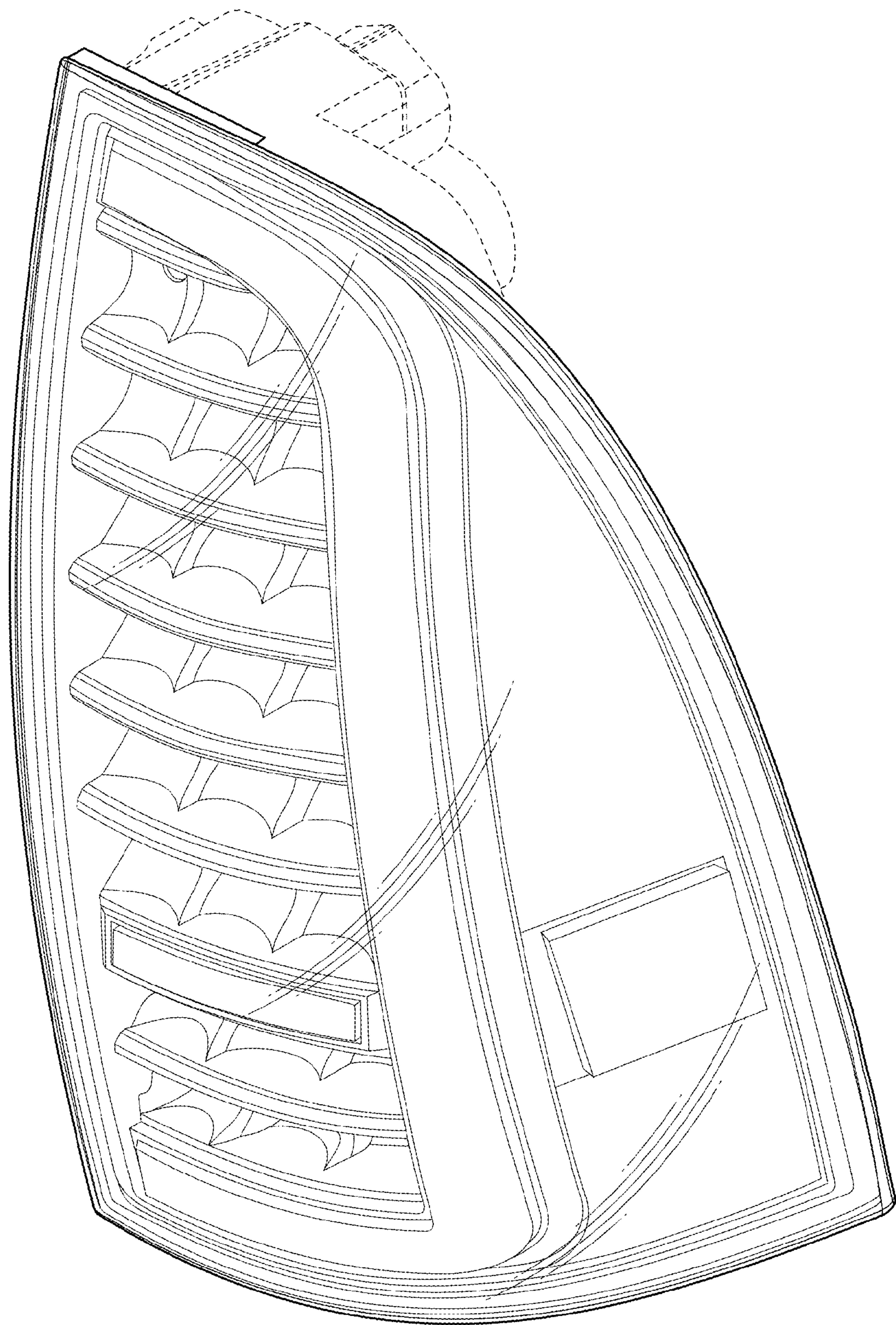

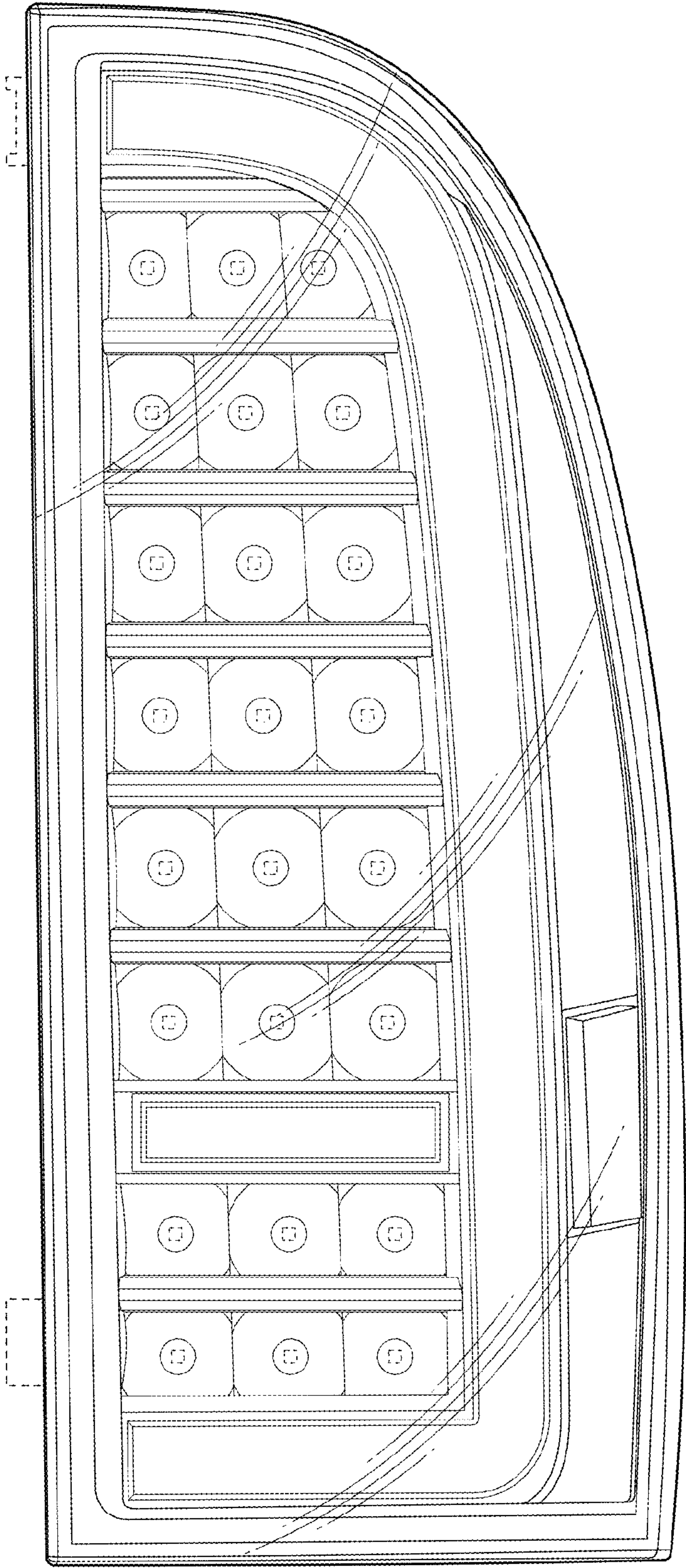

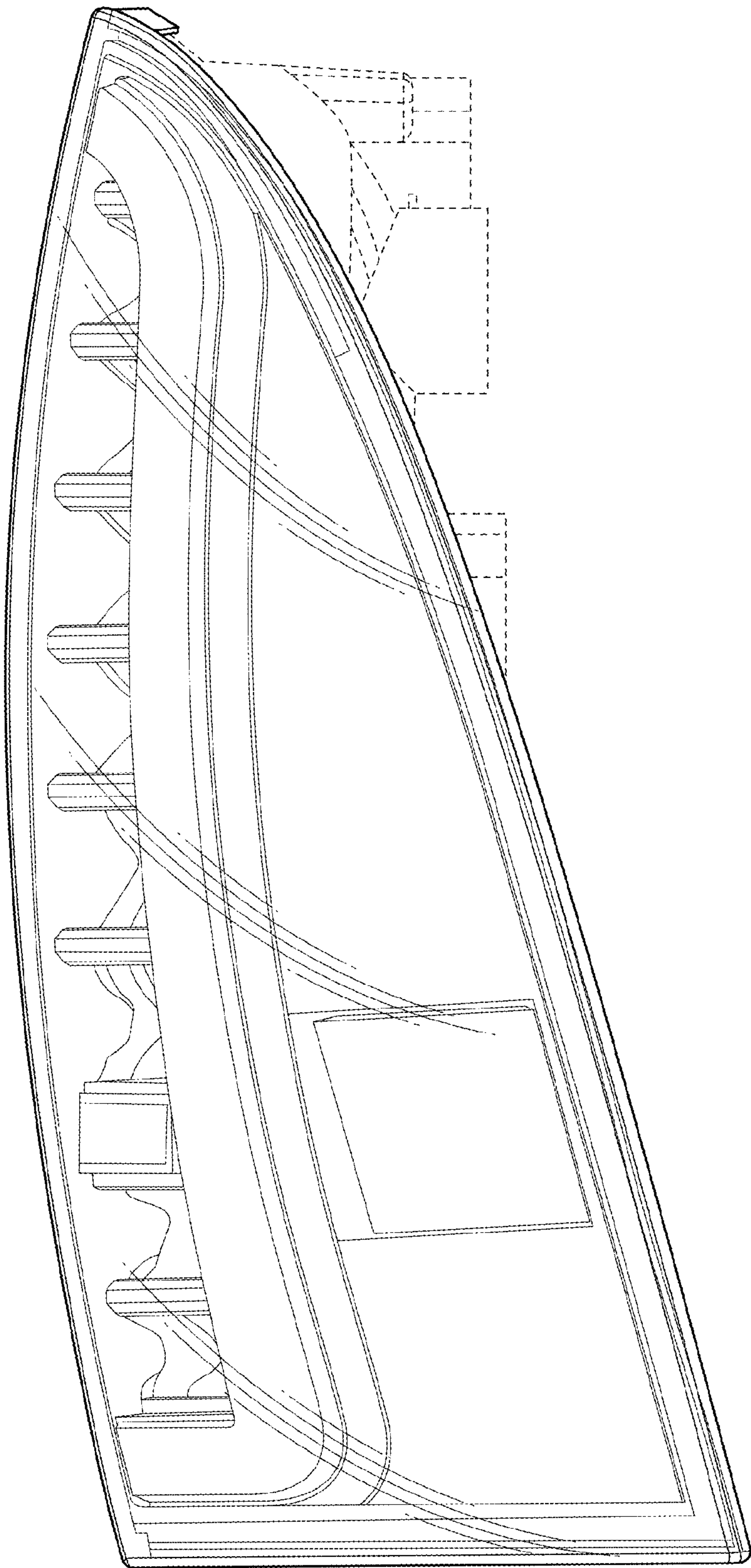

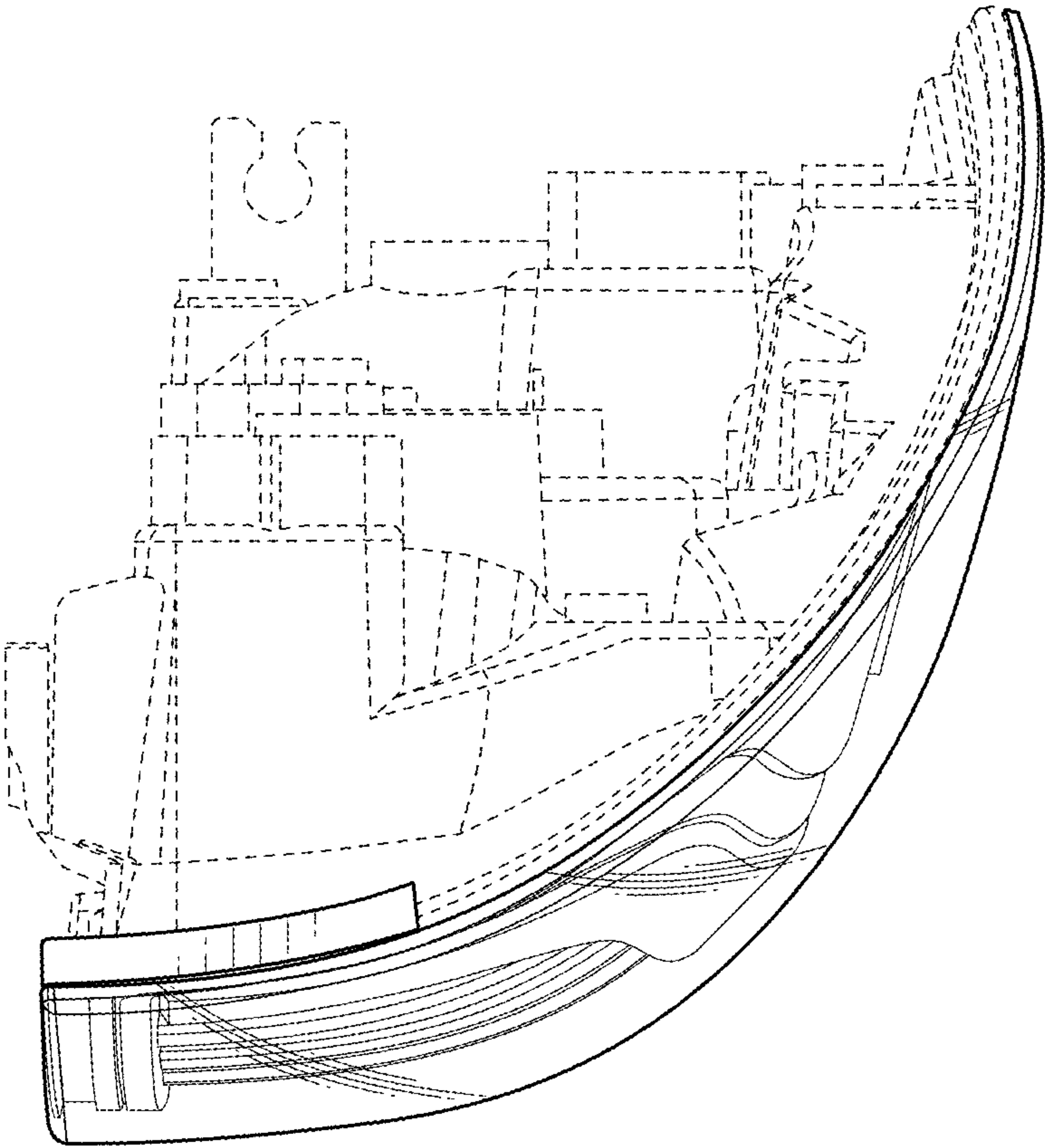
