FIG. 6 is a rear view of the design of FIG. 1.

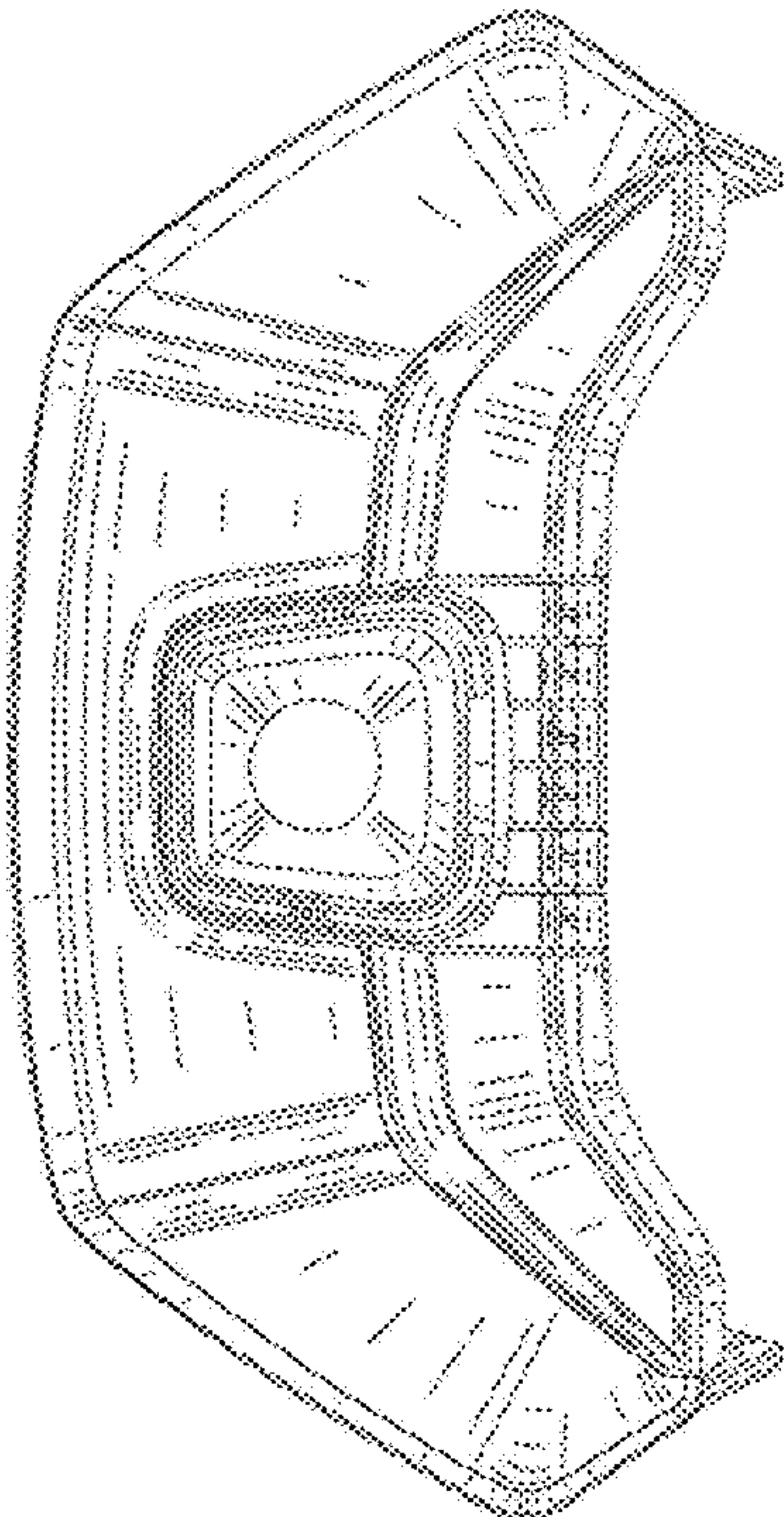
FIG. 7 is a right side view of the design of FIG. 1.

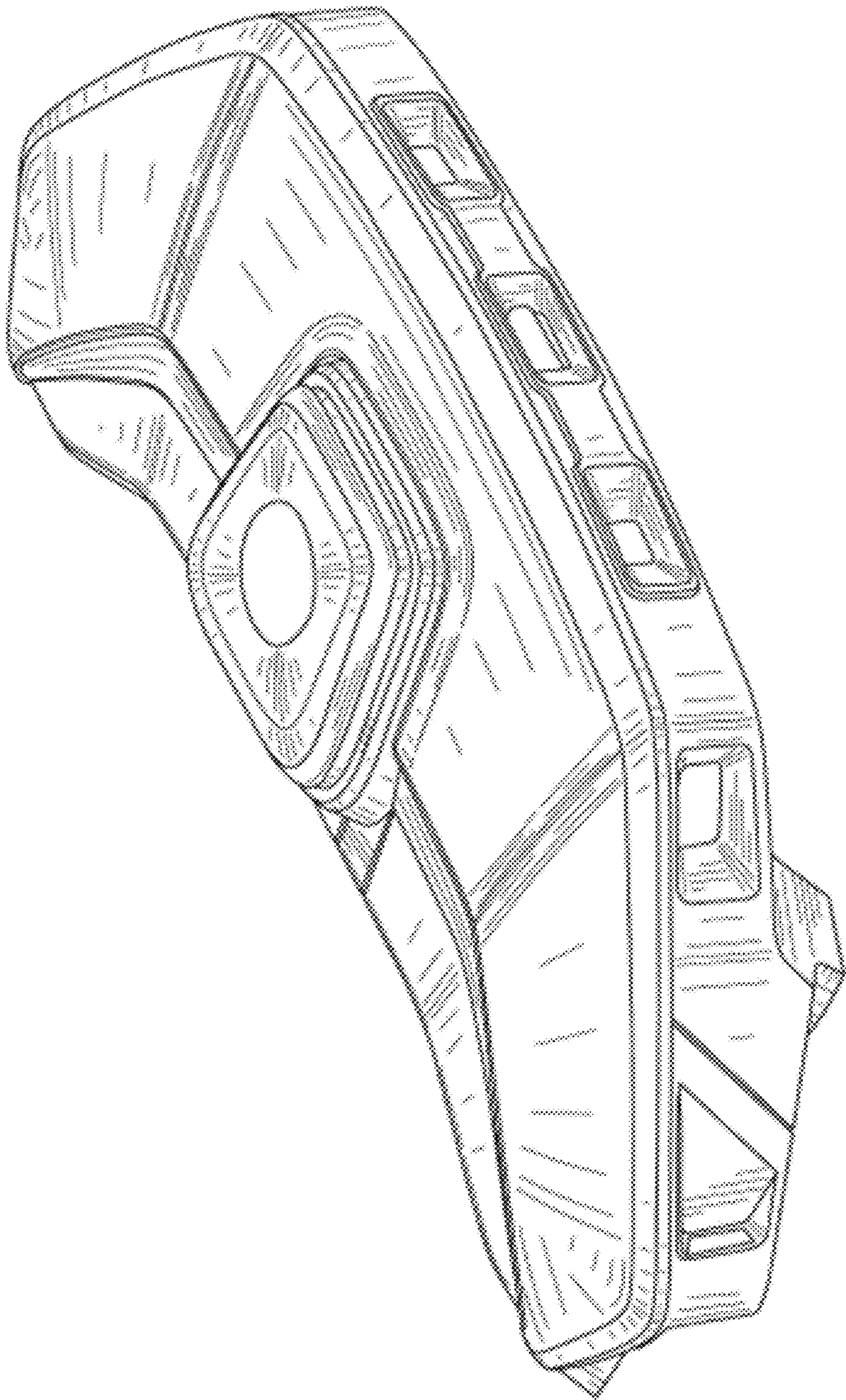

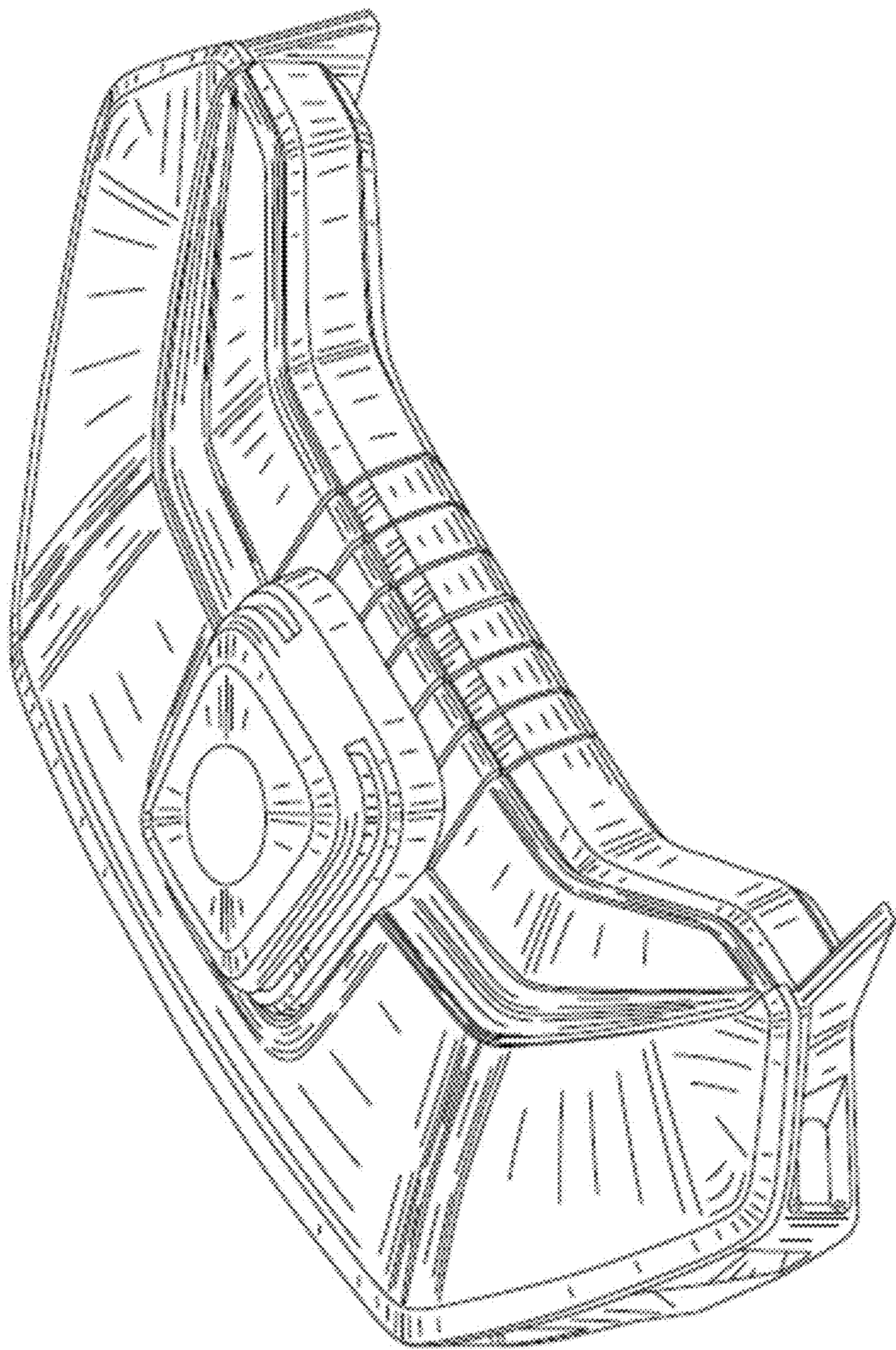

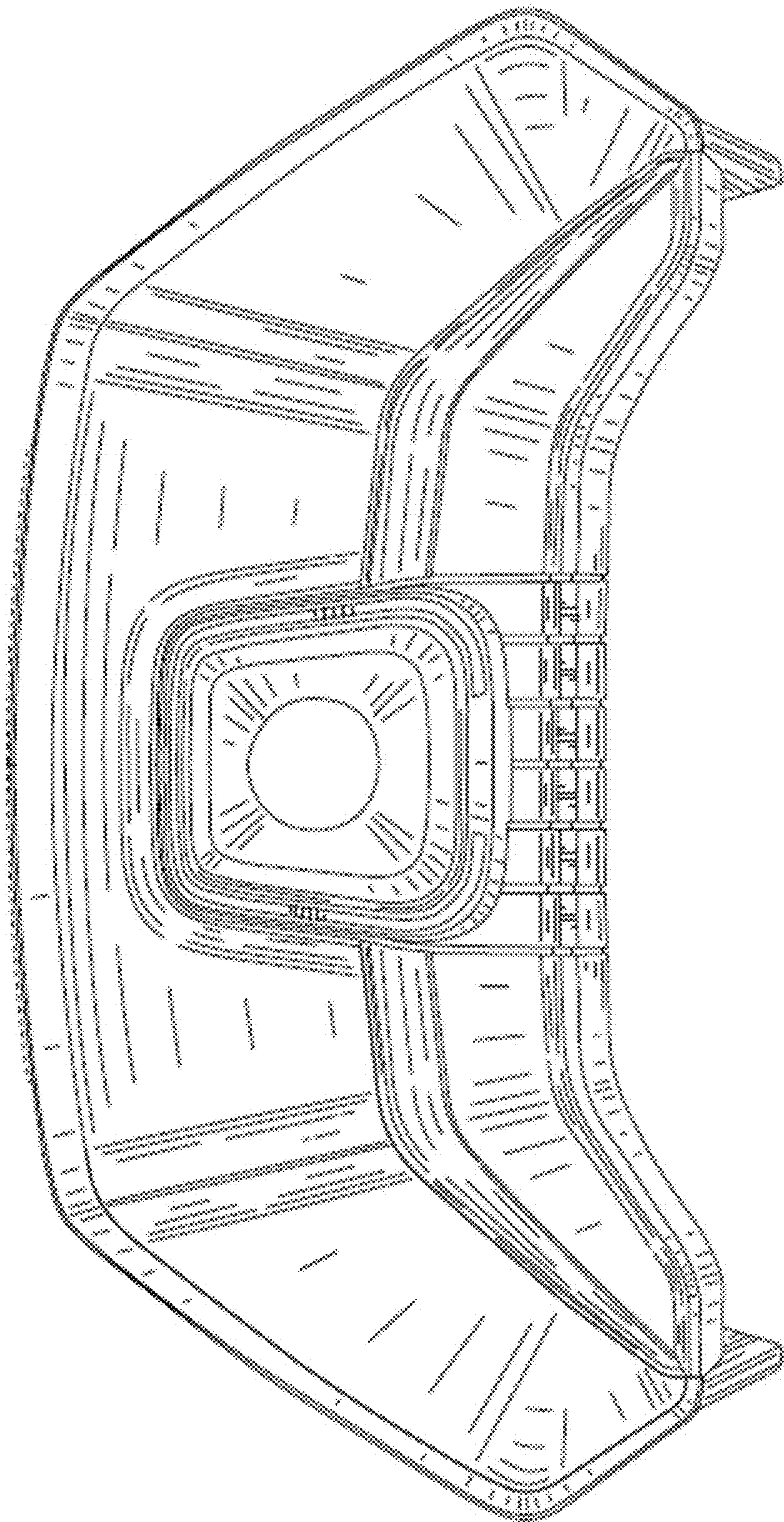

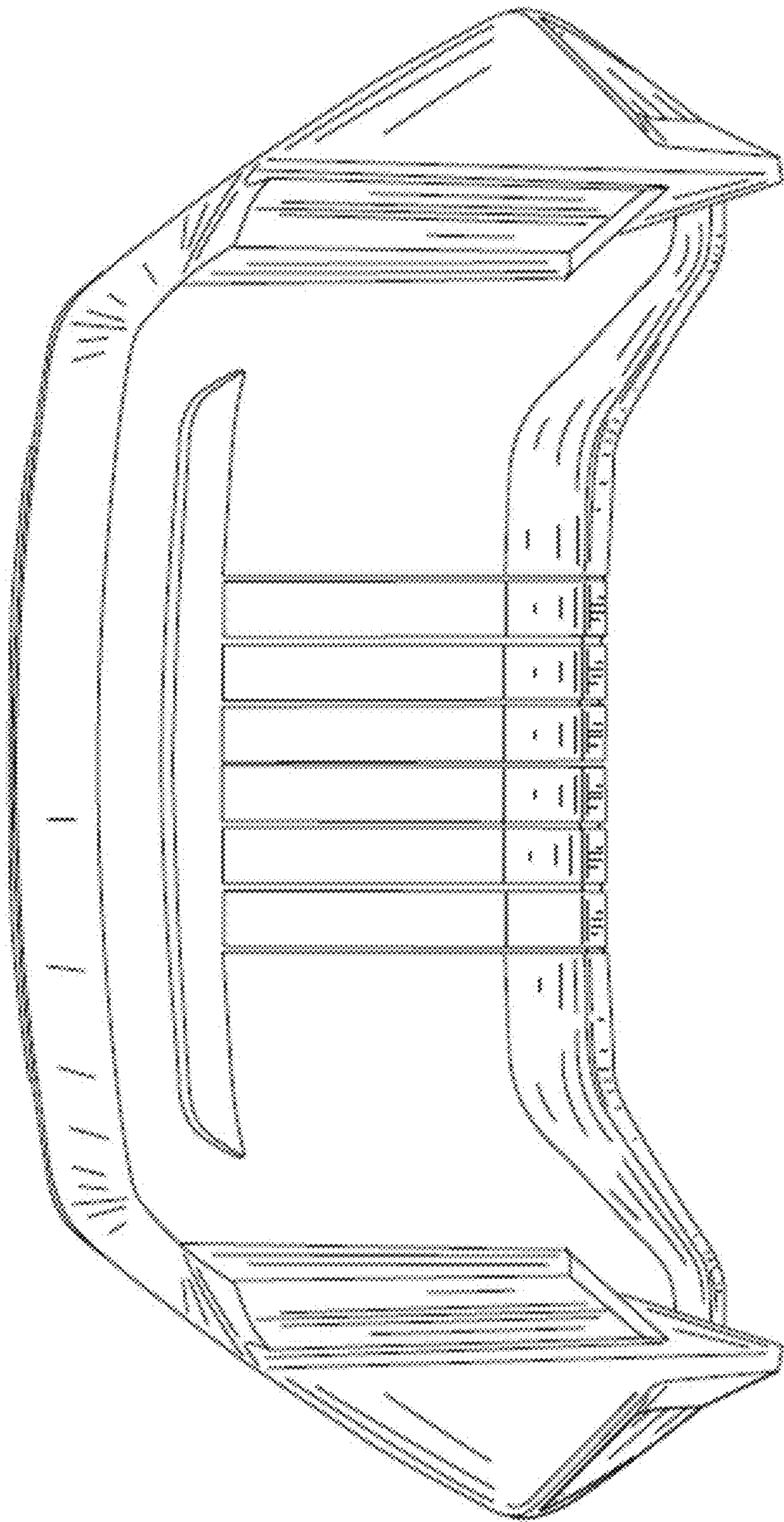

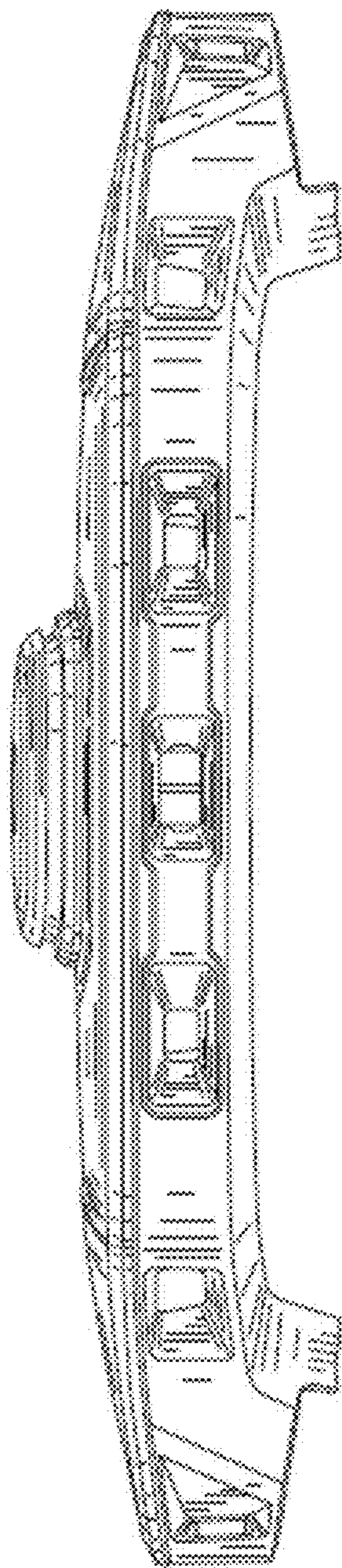

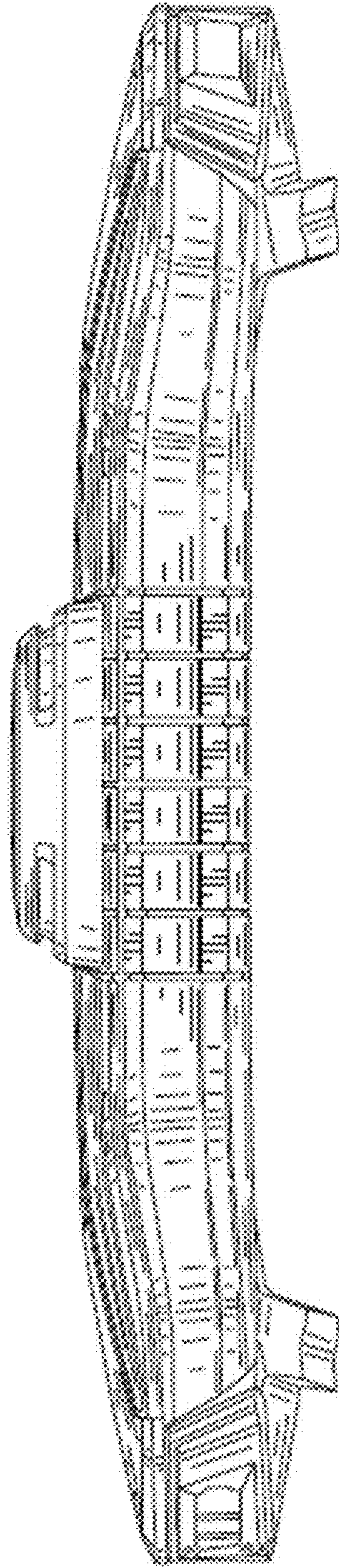

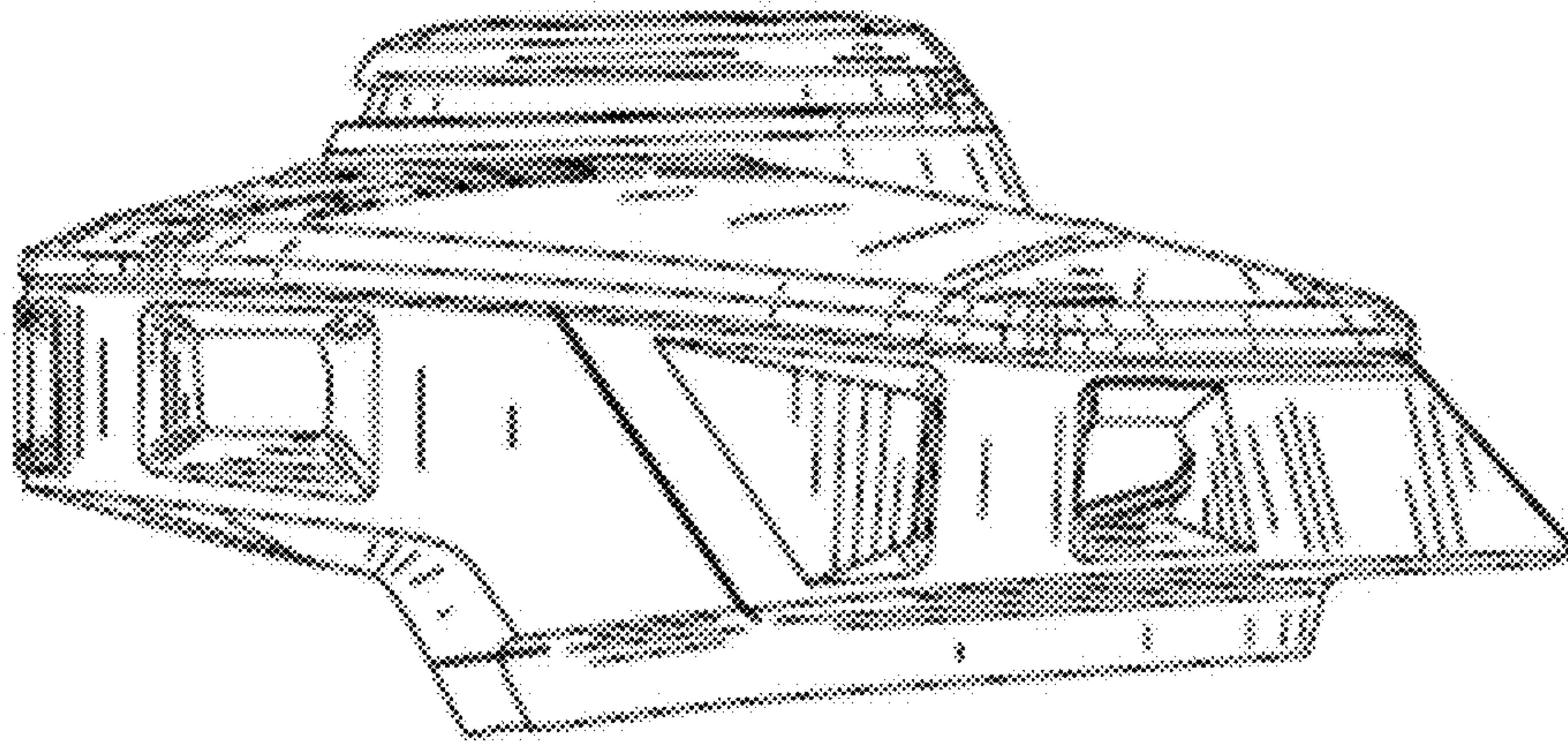

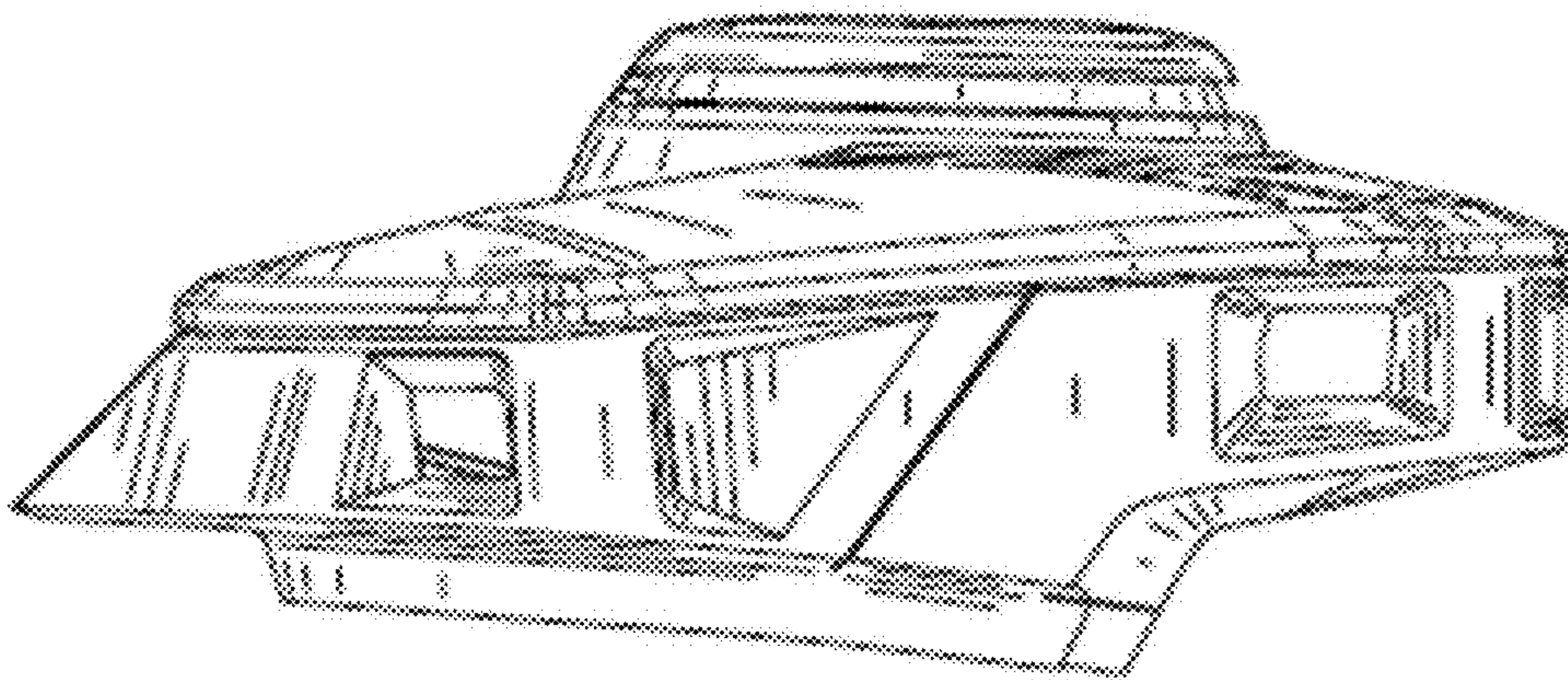

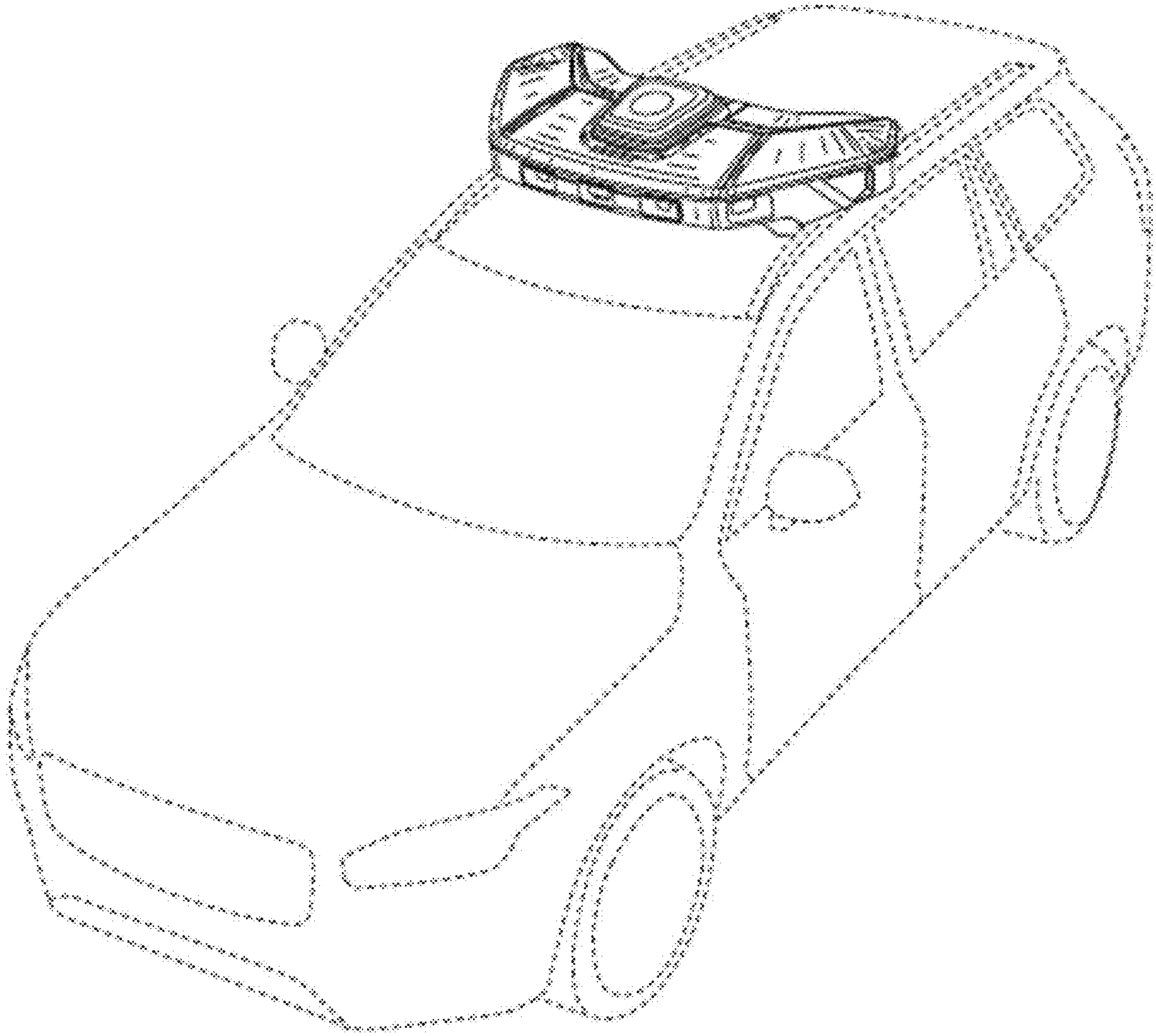
