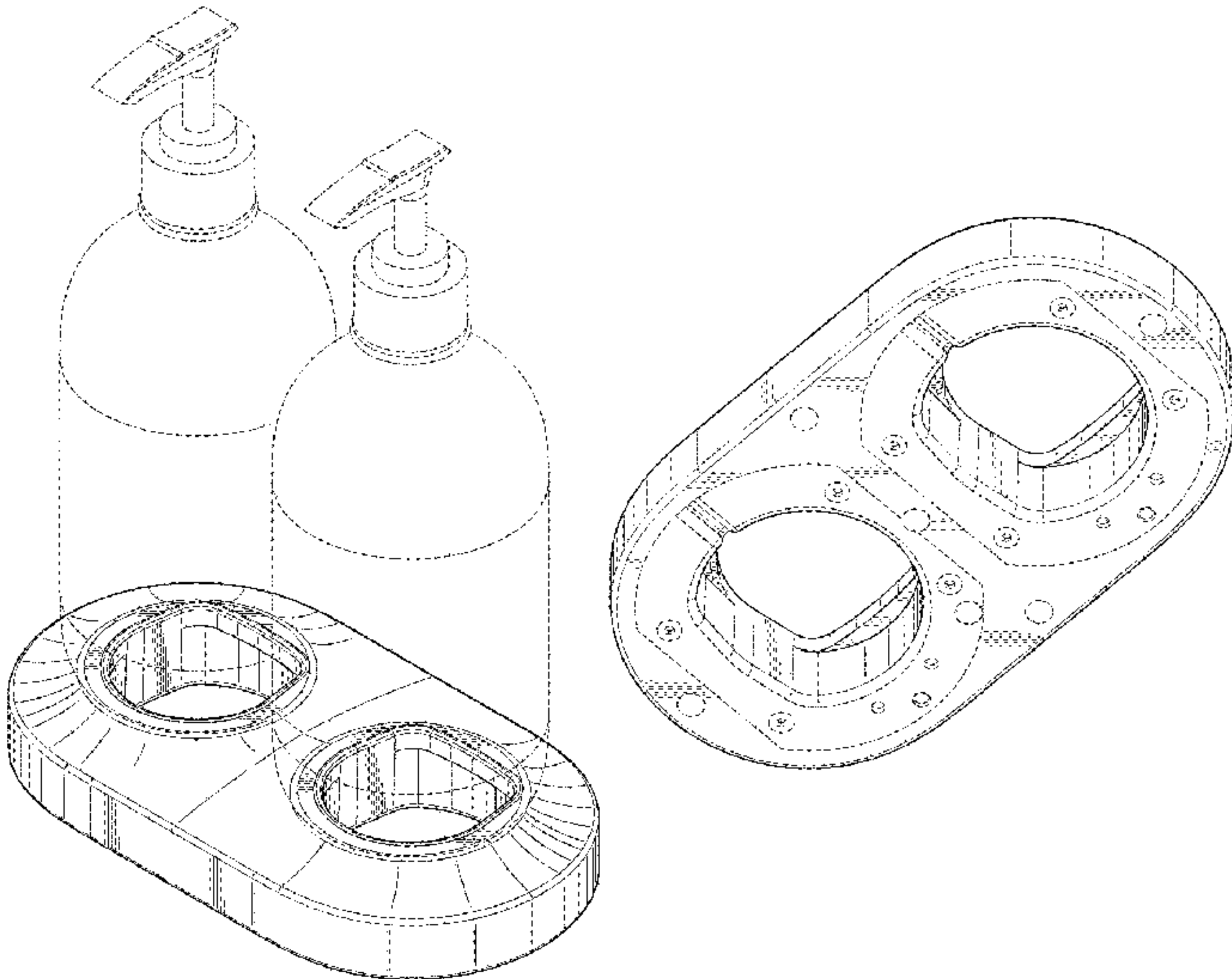
(57) CLAIM

An ornamental design for a bottle stand, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front right top isometric/perspective view of a bottle stand showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is front left bottom isometric/perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof, the rear view being identical thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view, the right side view being identical thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.
The broken lines of the bottle shown in FIG. 1 are shown for environmental aspects that form no part of the claimed design. The broken lines shown in FIGS. 2-4 and 6 illustrate portions of the bottle stand that form no part of the claimed design.

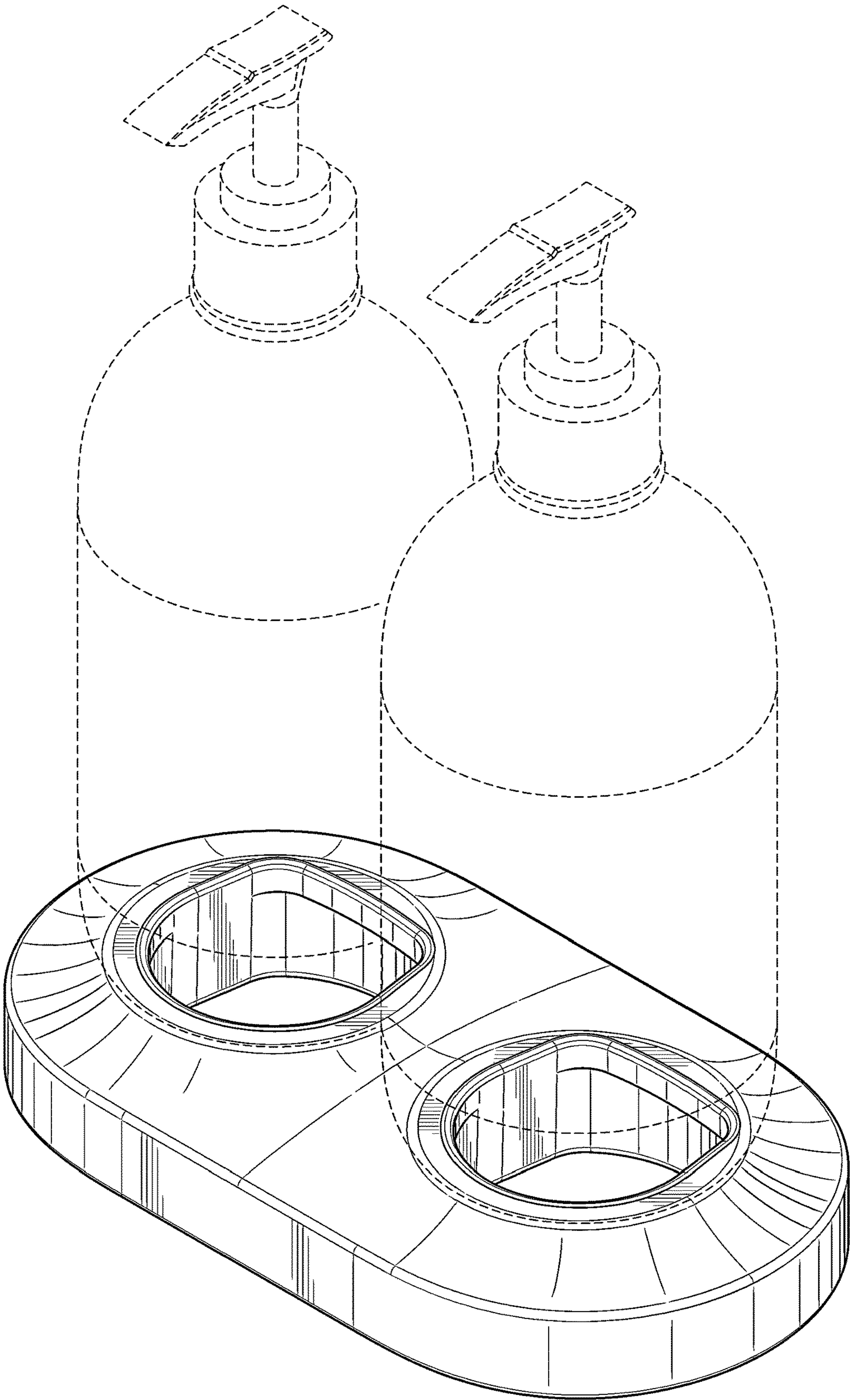

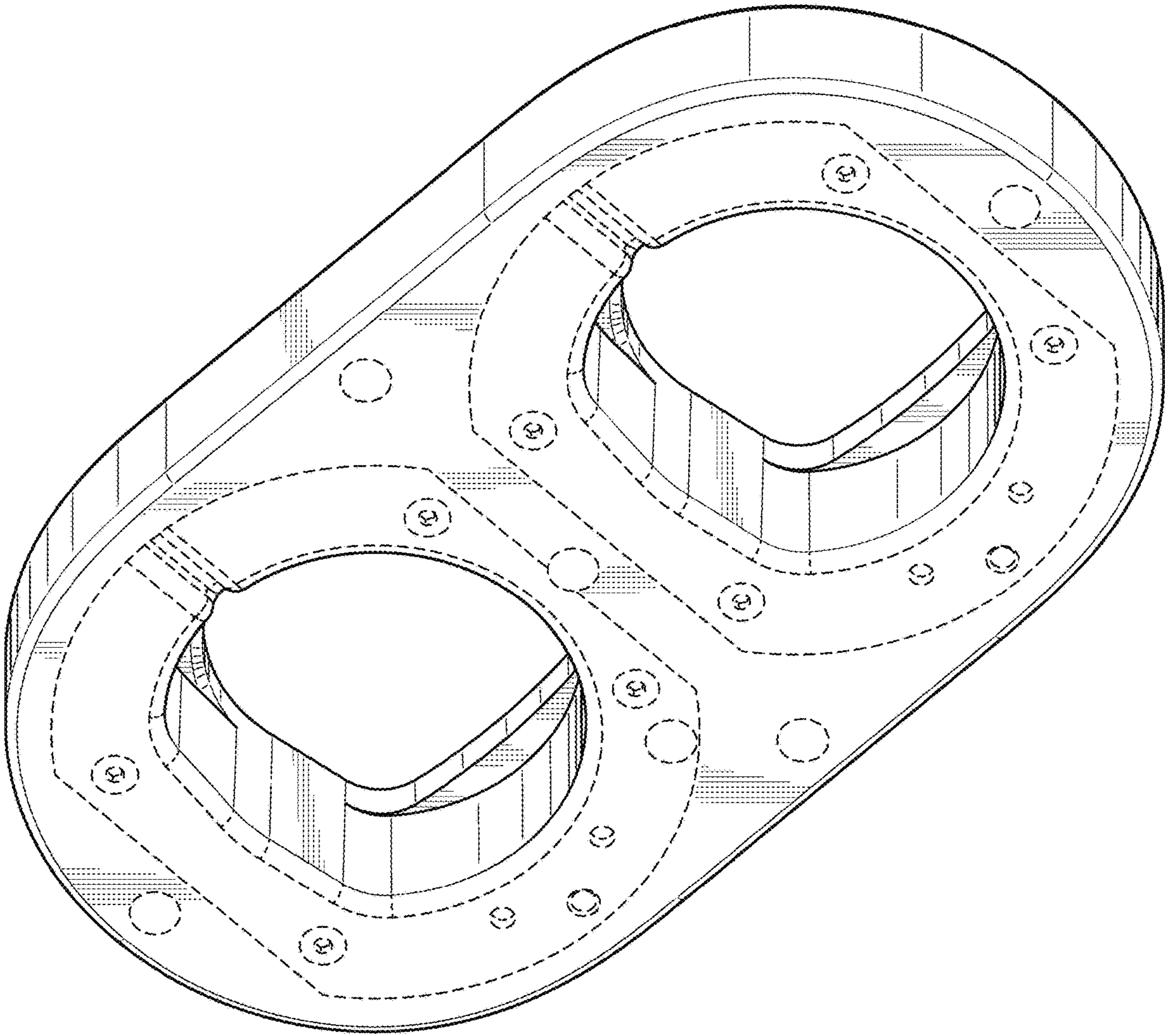

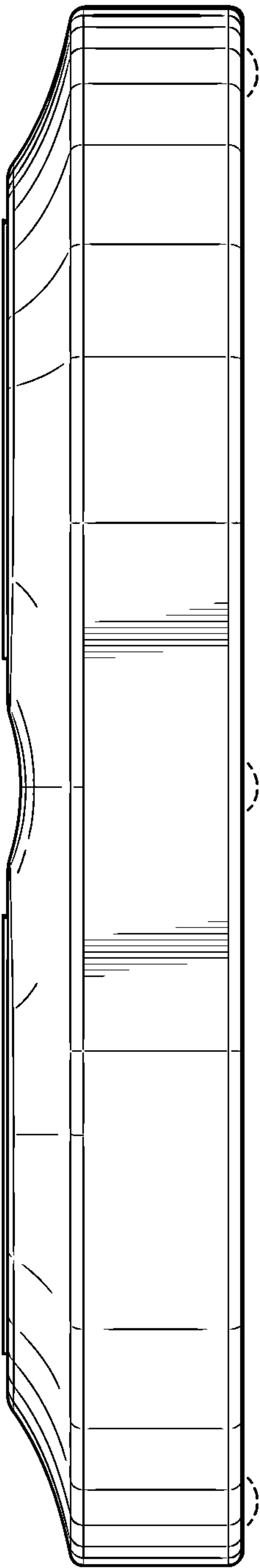

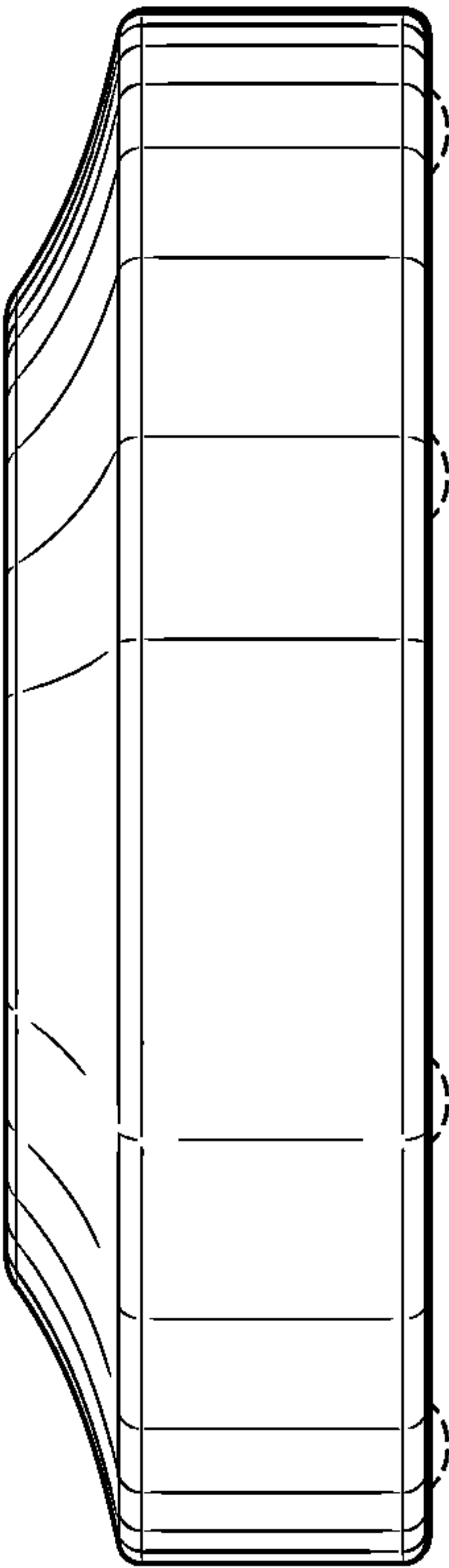

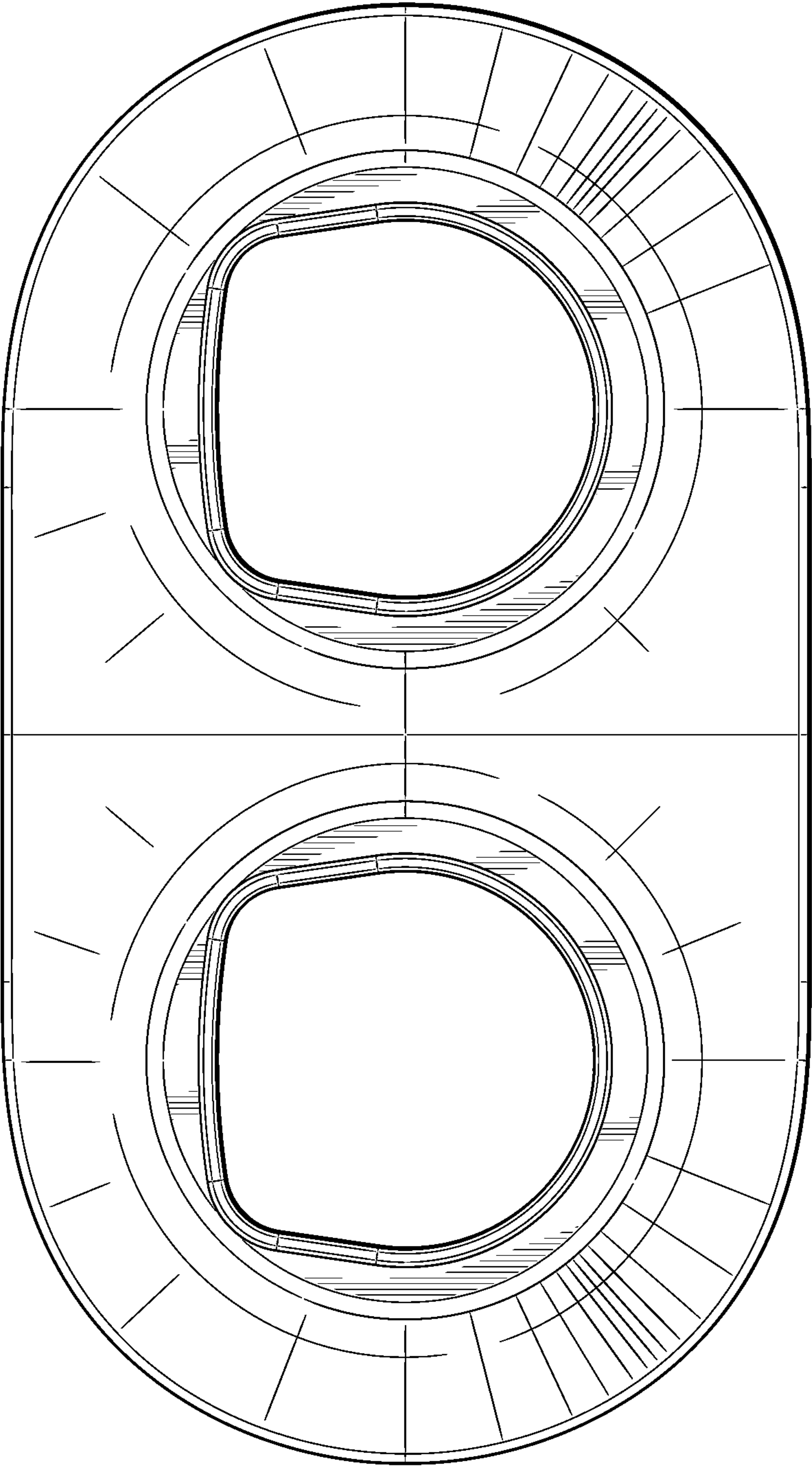

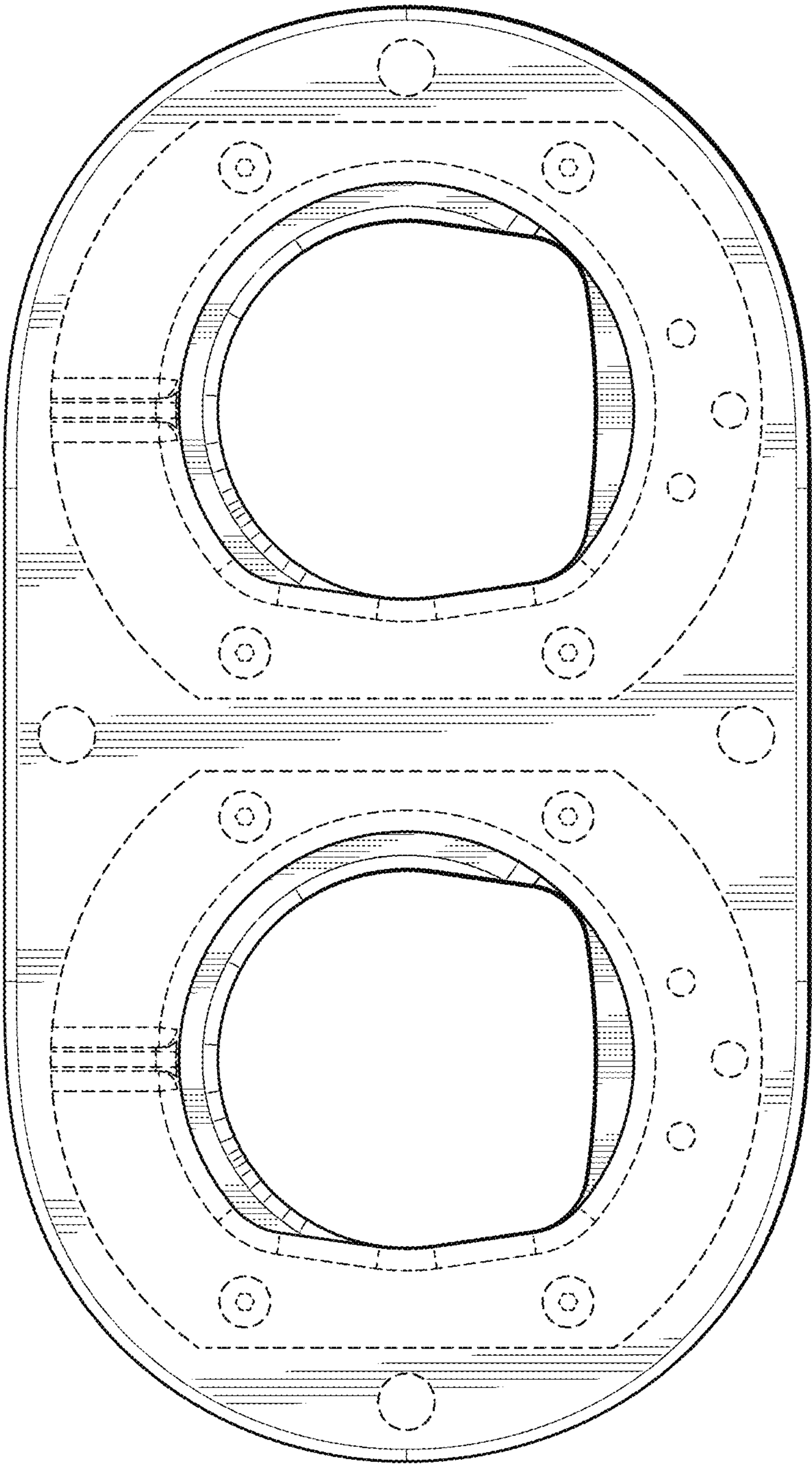
