DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the jig saw of FIG. 1;

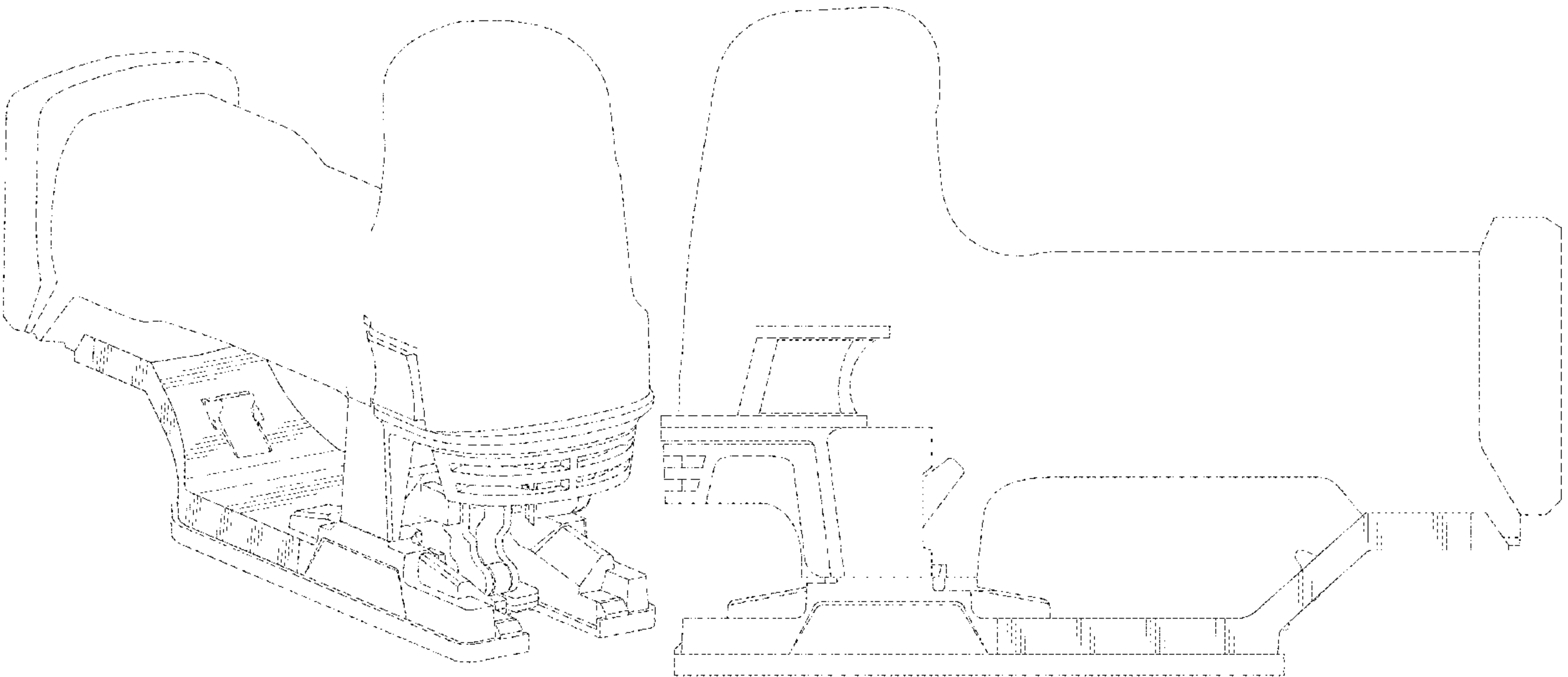
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view of the jig saw of FIG. 1;

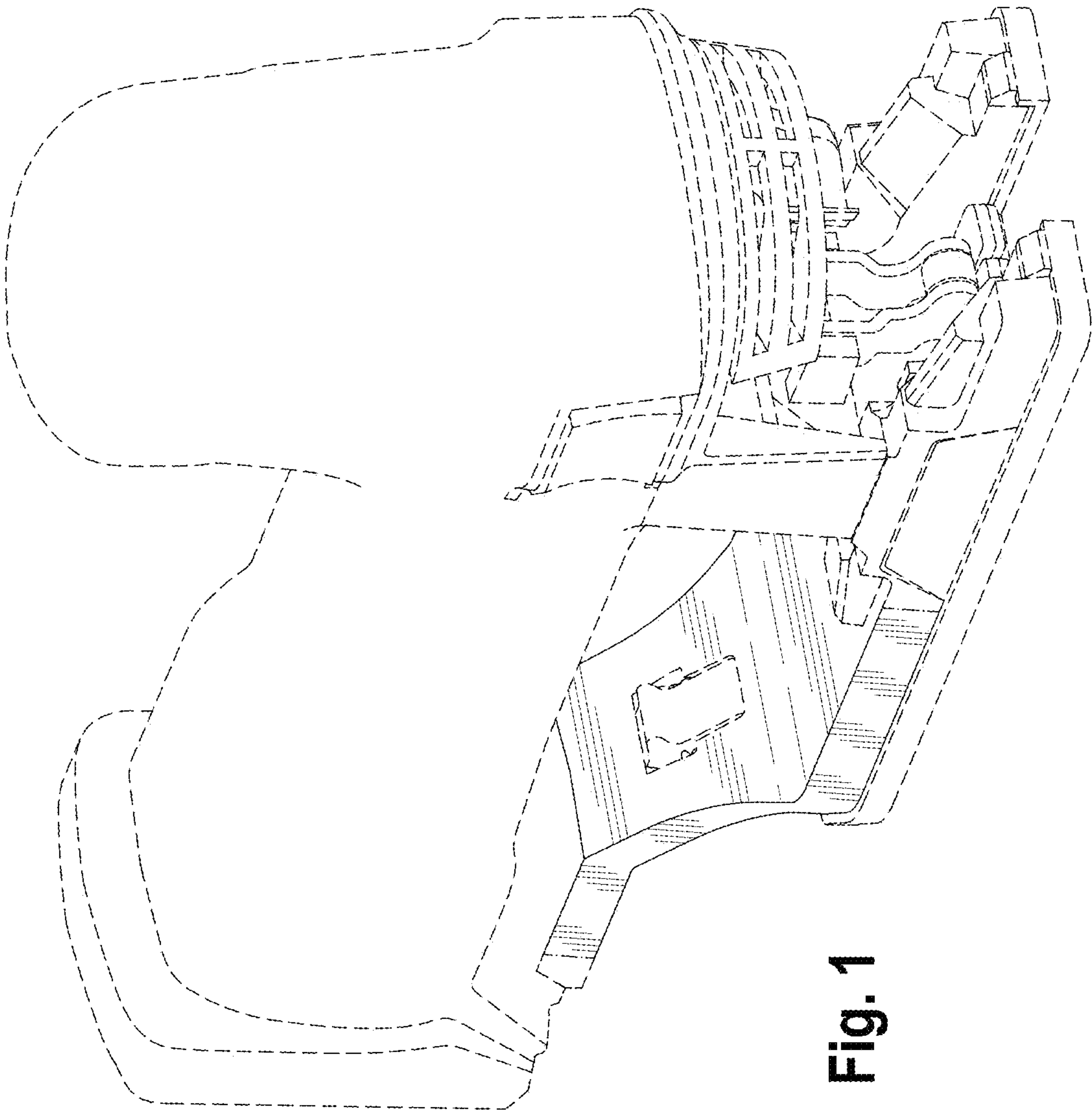

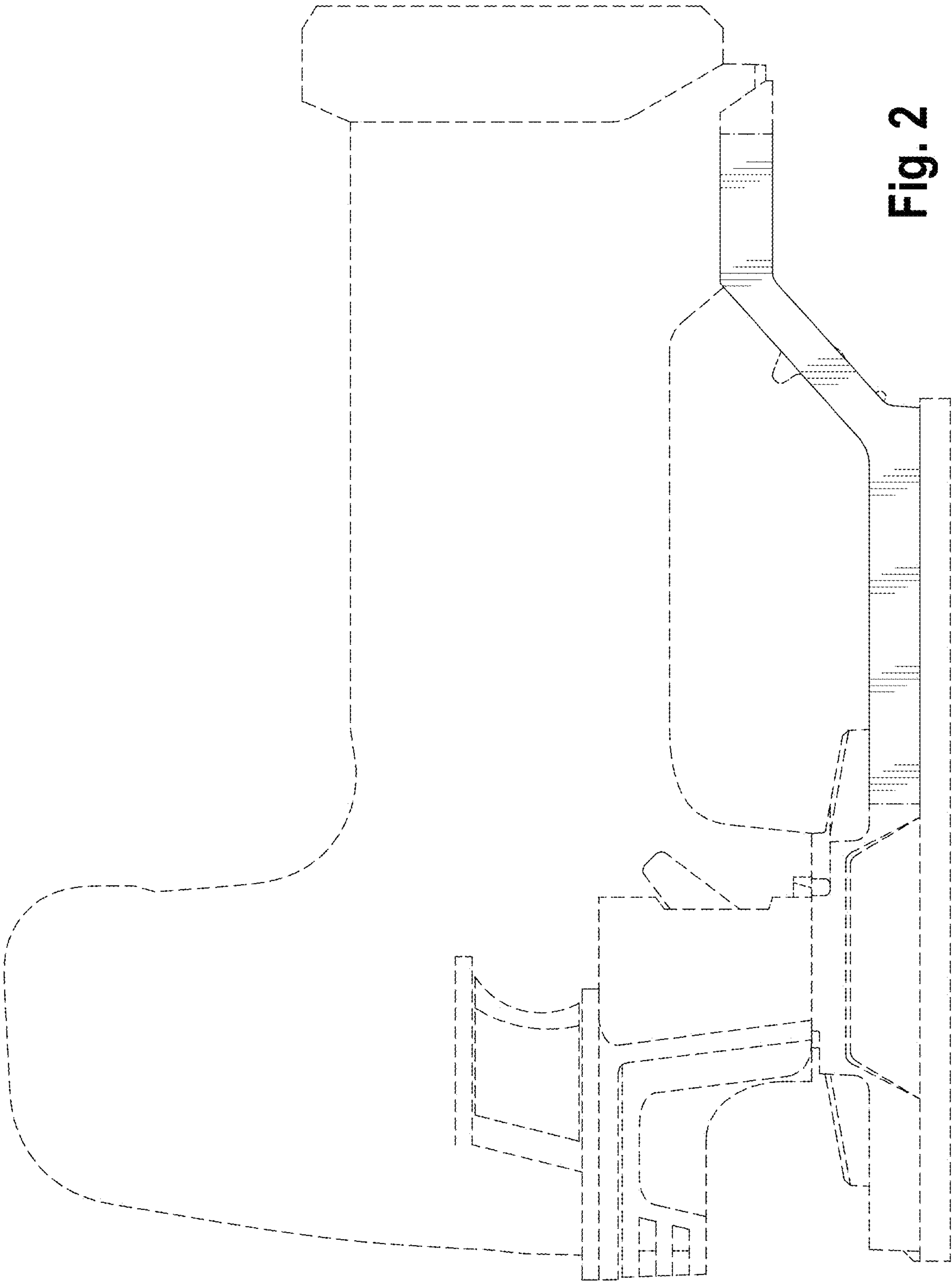

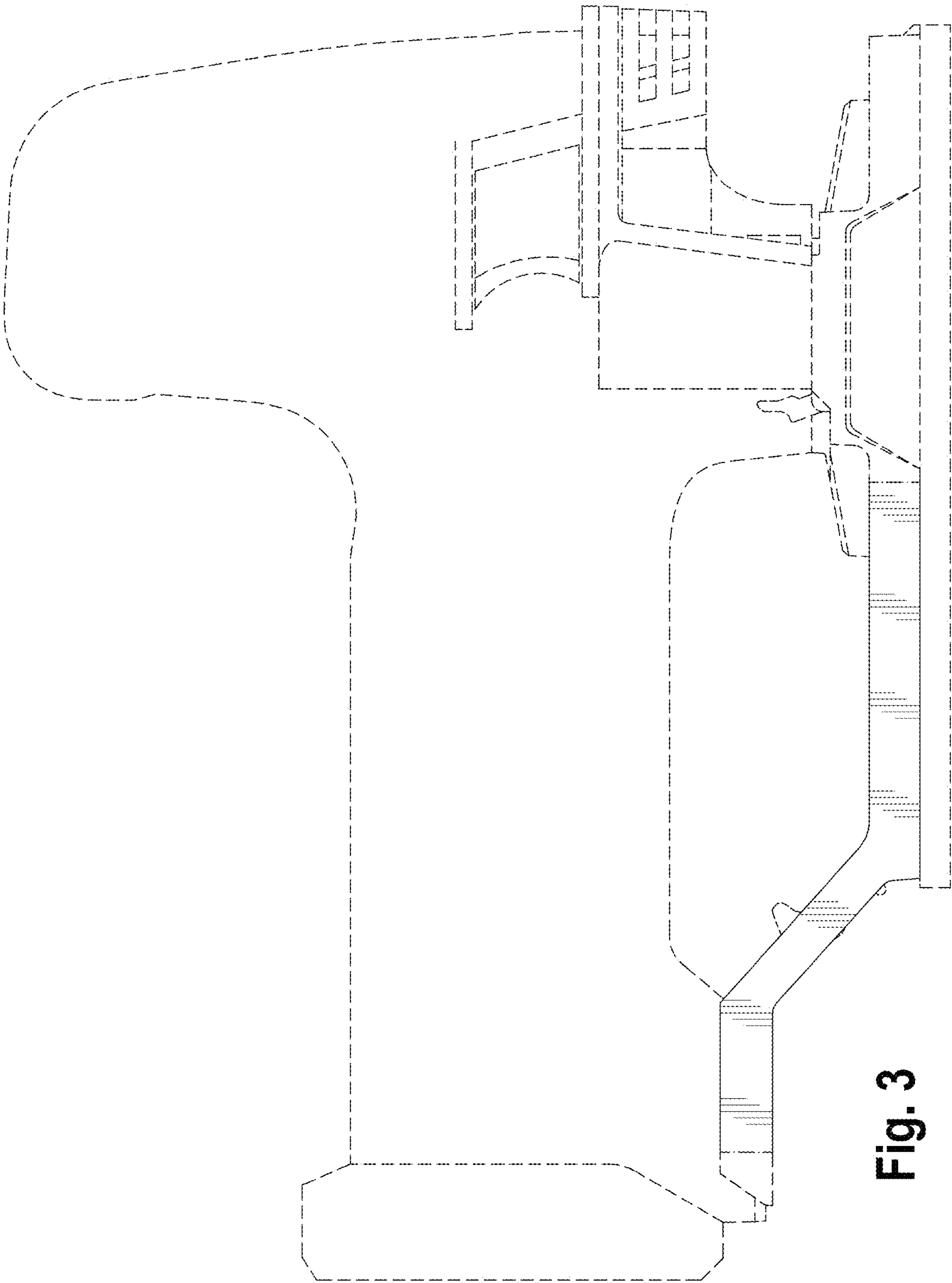

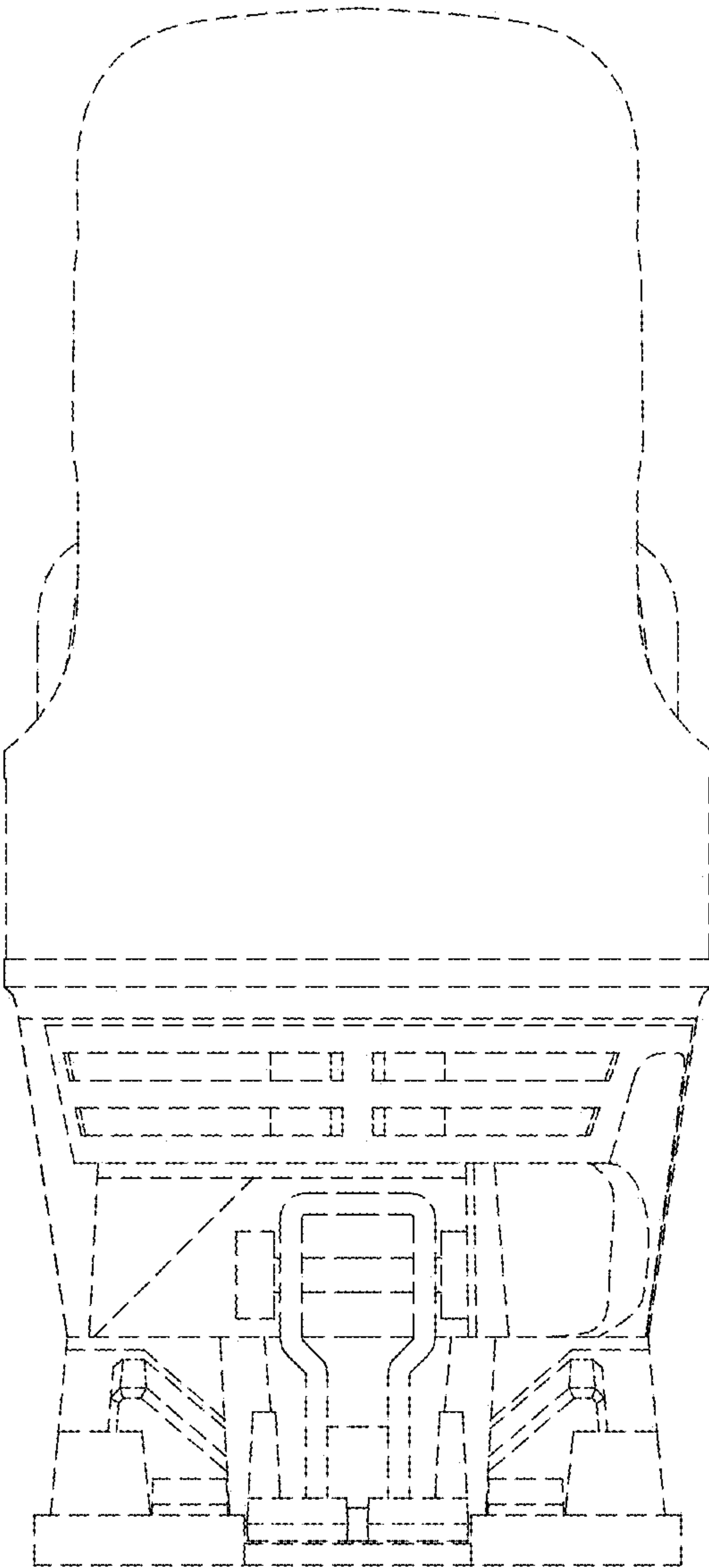

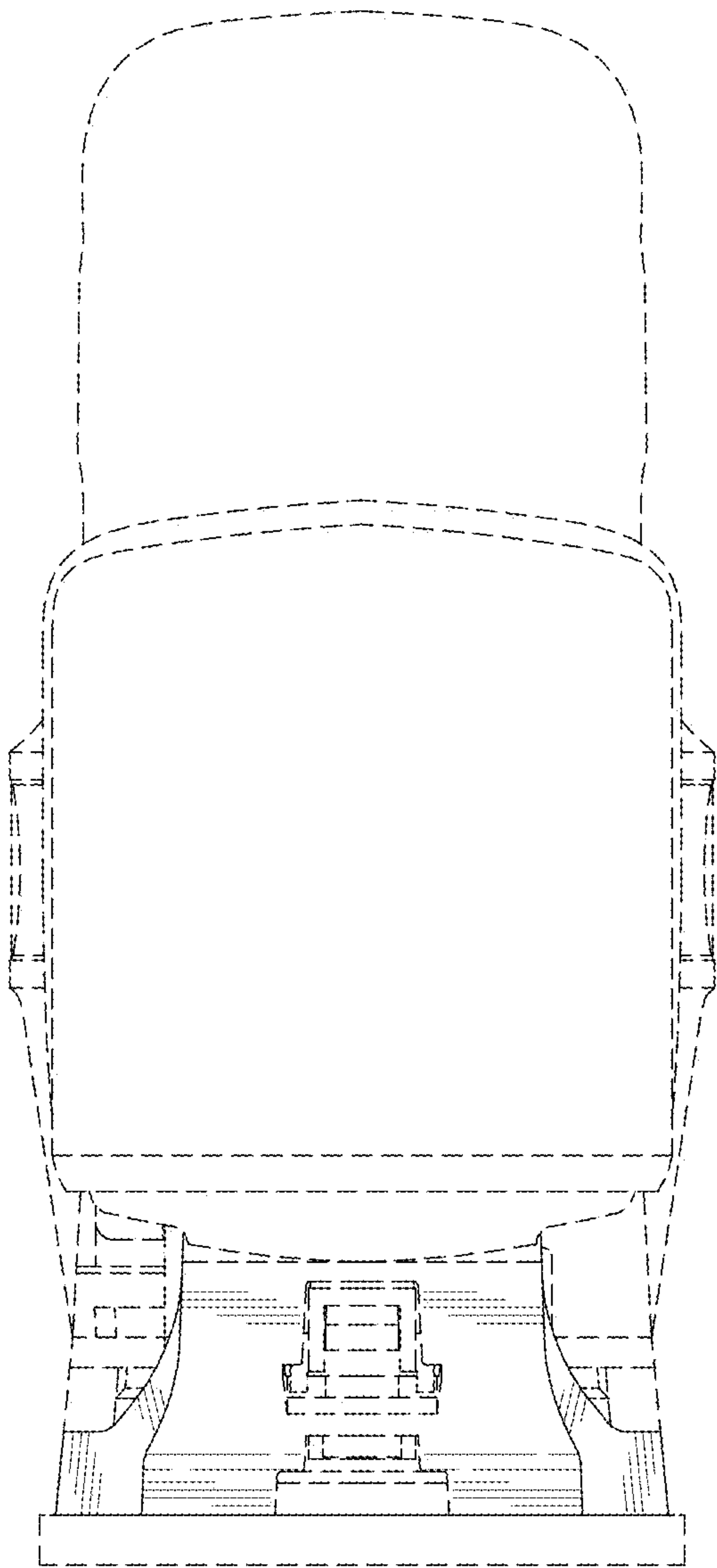

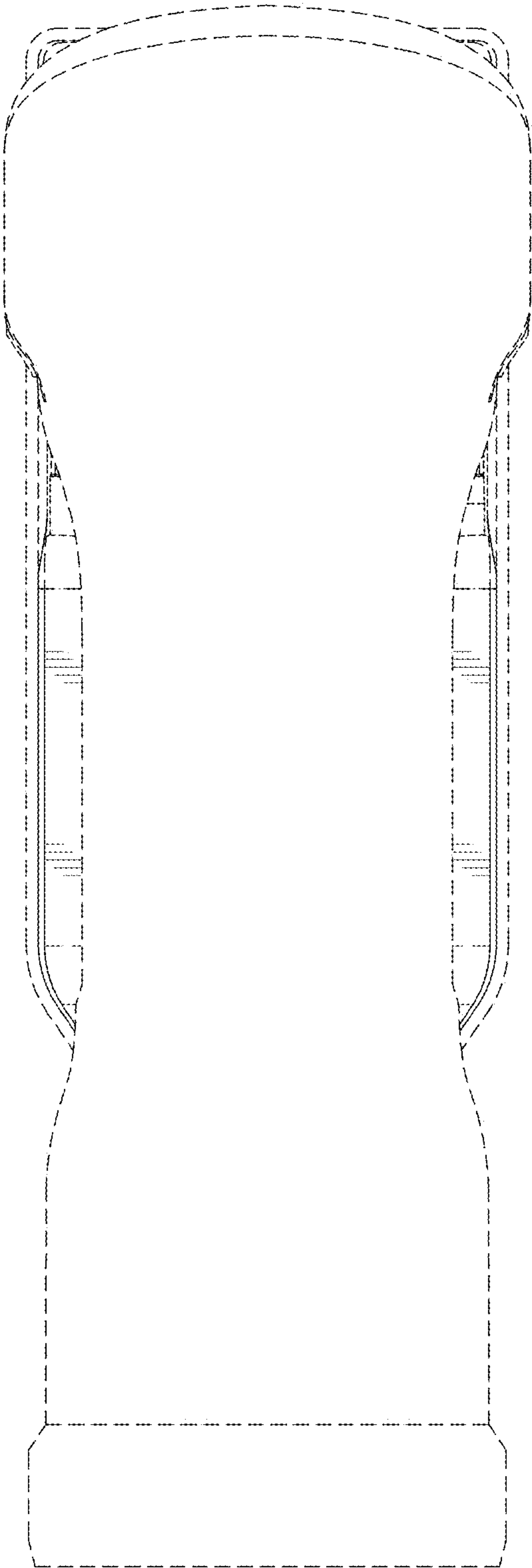

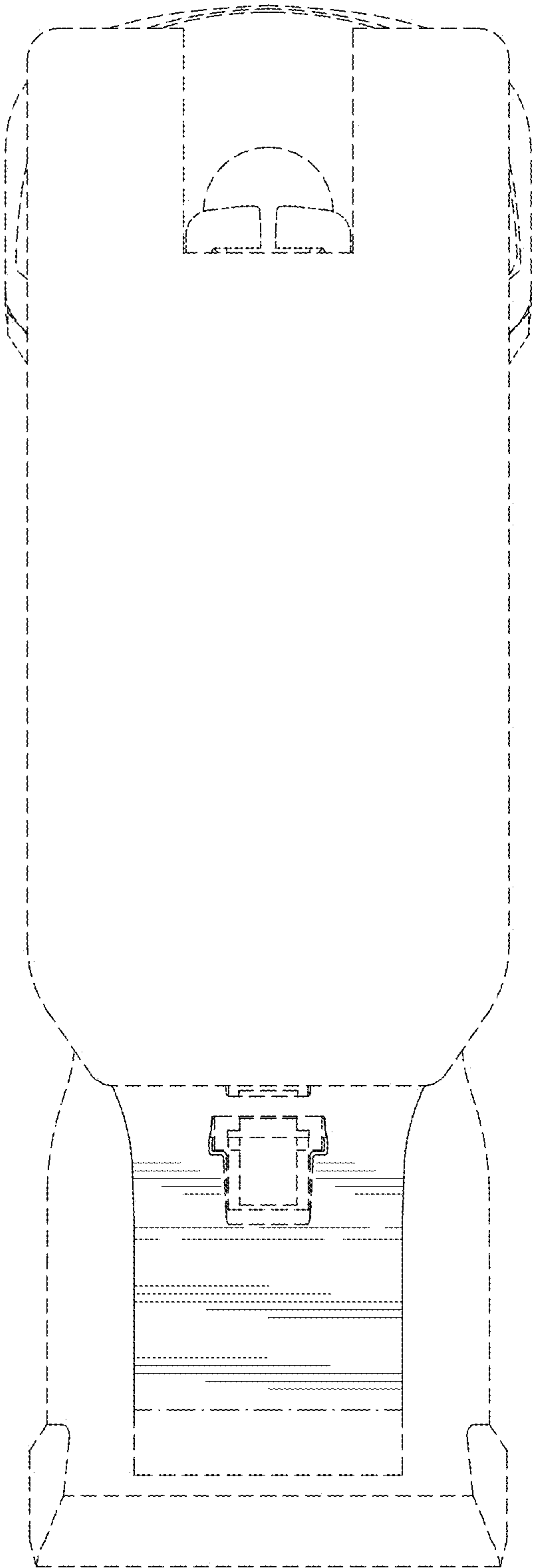
