I claim the ornamental design for a display screen or portion thereof with animated graphical user interface, as shown and described.

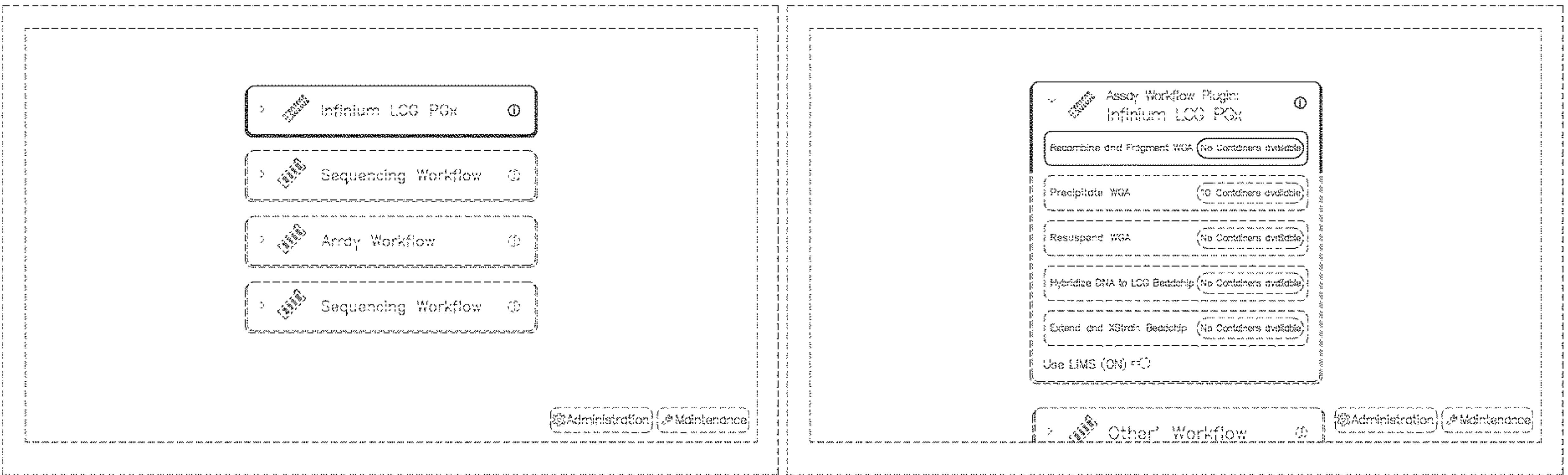
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 depicts a front view of a first image of a display screen or portion thereof with animated graphical user interface; and, FIG. 2 shows a front view of a second image thereof. The outermost broken lines in each figure illustrate a display screen or portion thereof of the animated graphical user interface. The remaining broken lines, including all text and numerals shown, illustrate portions of the graphical user interface. None of the broken lines form part of the claimed design.

The claimed design includes animated graphical user interface features. The appearance of the images sequentially transitions between the images shown in FIGS. 1-2. The process or period in which one image transitions to another forms no part of the claimed design.

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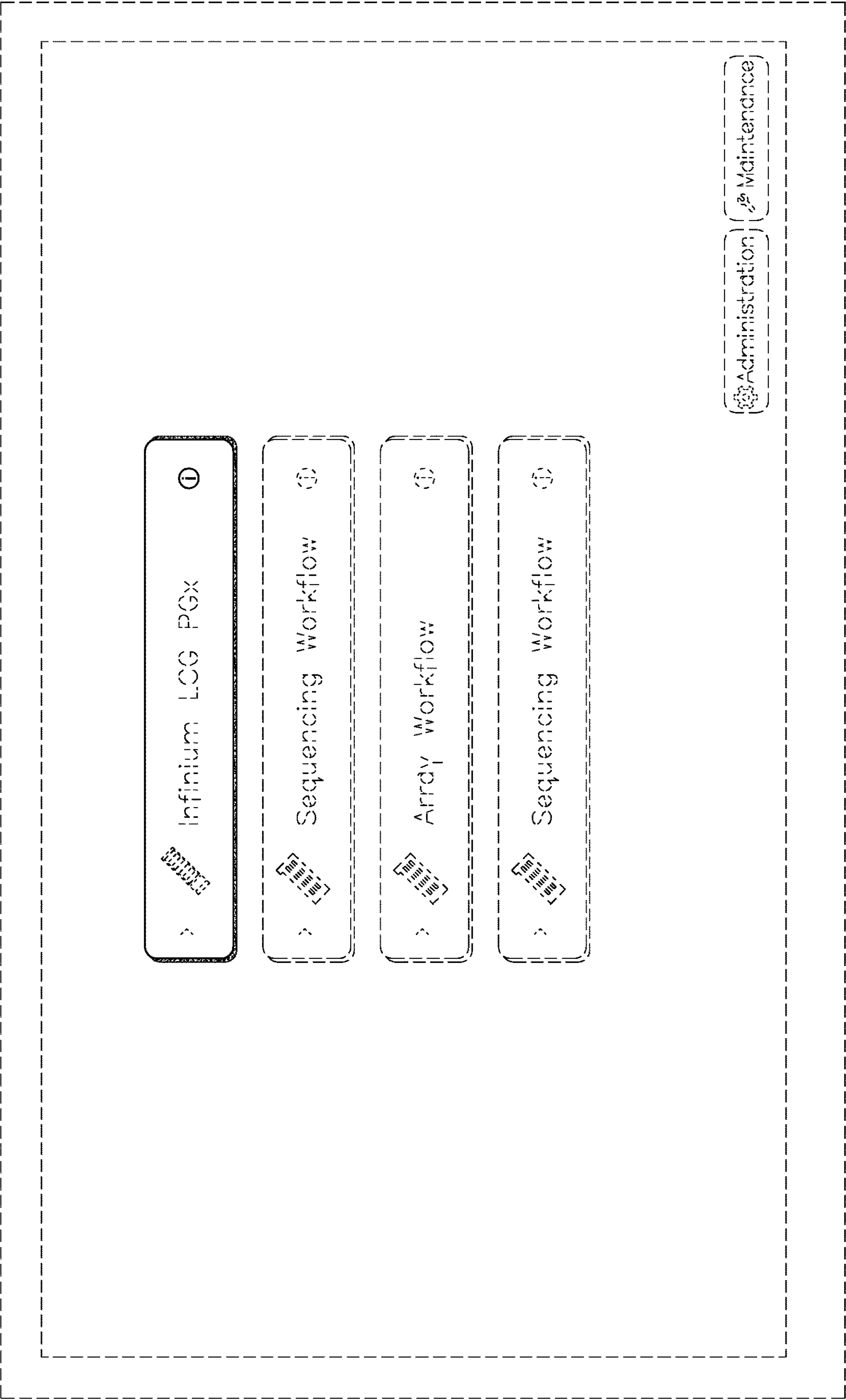

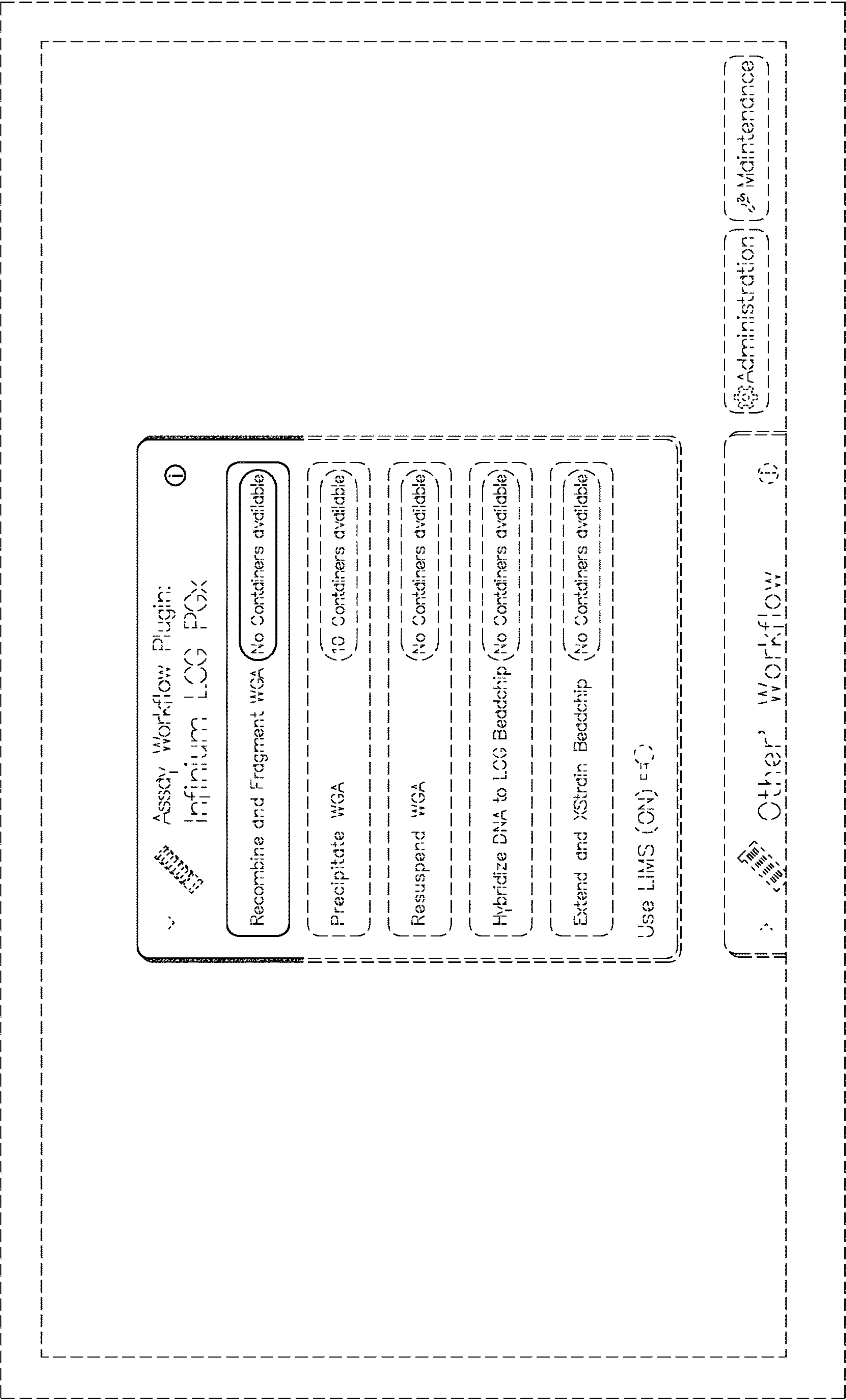
