DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a loudspeaker showing the new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is an opposite side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 8A is a partial enlarged view according to the broken rectangle 8A denoted in FIG. 1, showing that the grille illustrated by stippling in FIGS. 1 and 6 is in broken lines;

FIG. 8B is a partial enlarged view according to the broken rectangle 8B denoted in FIG. 1, showing that the grille illustrated by stippling in FIGS. 1 and 6 is in broken lines;

FIG. 9A is a partial enlarged view according to the broken rectangle 9A denoted in FIG. 1, showing that the grille illustrated by stippling in FIGS. 1 and 6 is in broken lines;

FIG. 9B is a partial enlarged view according to the broken rectangle 9B denoted in FIG. 1, showing that the grille illustrated by stippling in FIGS. 1 and 6 is in broken lines;

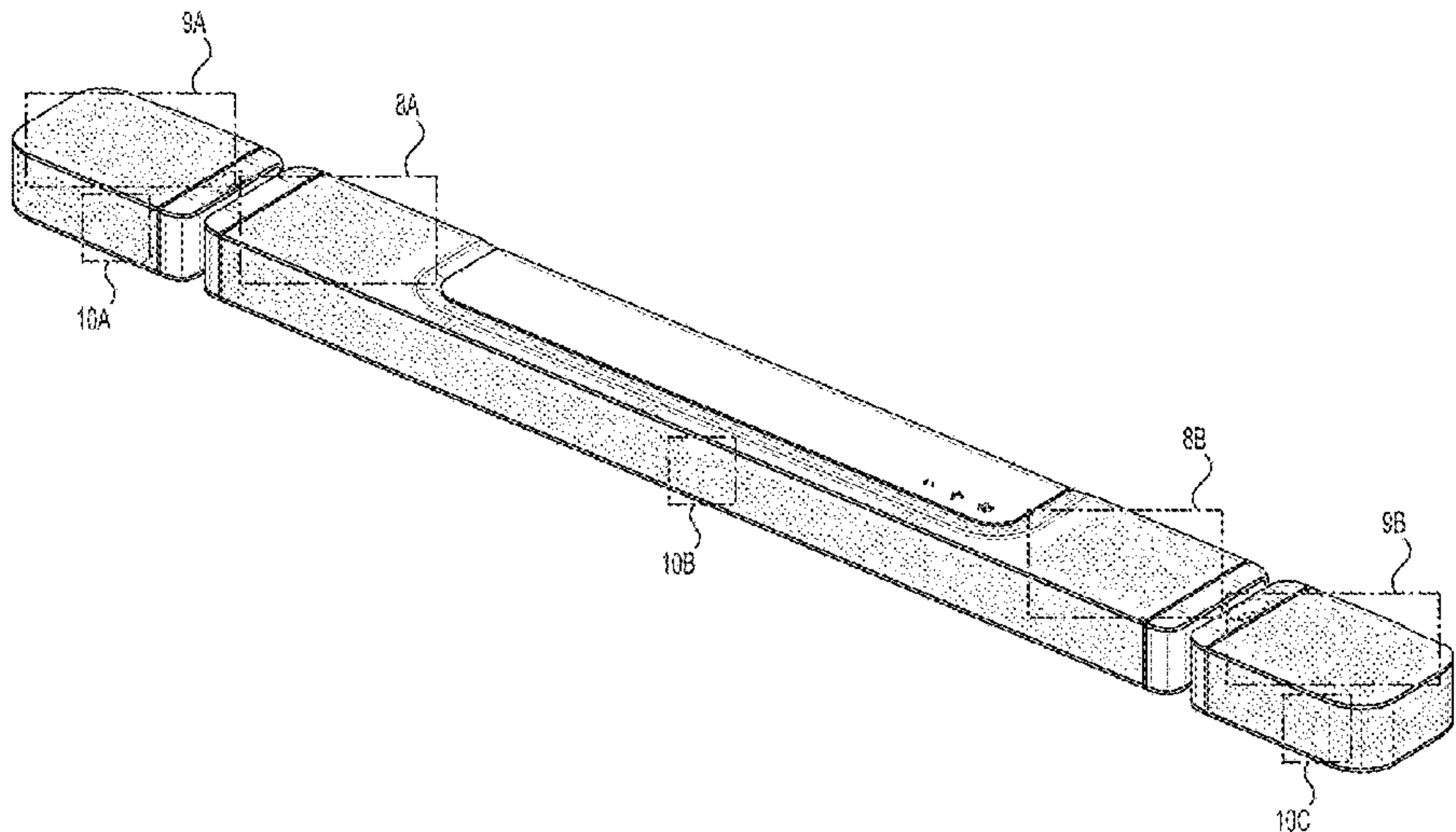
FIG. 10B is a partial enlarged view according to the broken rectangle 10B denoted in FIG. 1, showing that the grille illustrated by stippling in FIGS. 1 and 2 is in broken lines;

FIG. 10A is a partial enlarged view according to the broken rectangle 10A denoted in FIG. 1, showing that the grille illustrated by stippling in FIGS. 1-4 is in broken lines;

FIG. 10C is a partial enlarged view according to the broken rectangle 10C denoted in FIG. 1, showing that the grille illustrated by stippling in FIGS. 1-3 and 5 is in broken lines.

The evenly spaced broken lines in the figures illustrate portions of the loudspeaker that form no part of the claimed design. The dash-dot broken lines in the figures represent the boundaries of the claimed design and form no part of the claimed design. The line shading is provided merely to represent contours of the design and does not connote the character of the surfaces such as any specific texture, material, gloss, translucence, transparency, surface treatment, or surface decoration.

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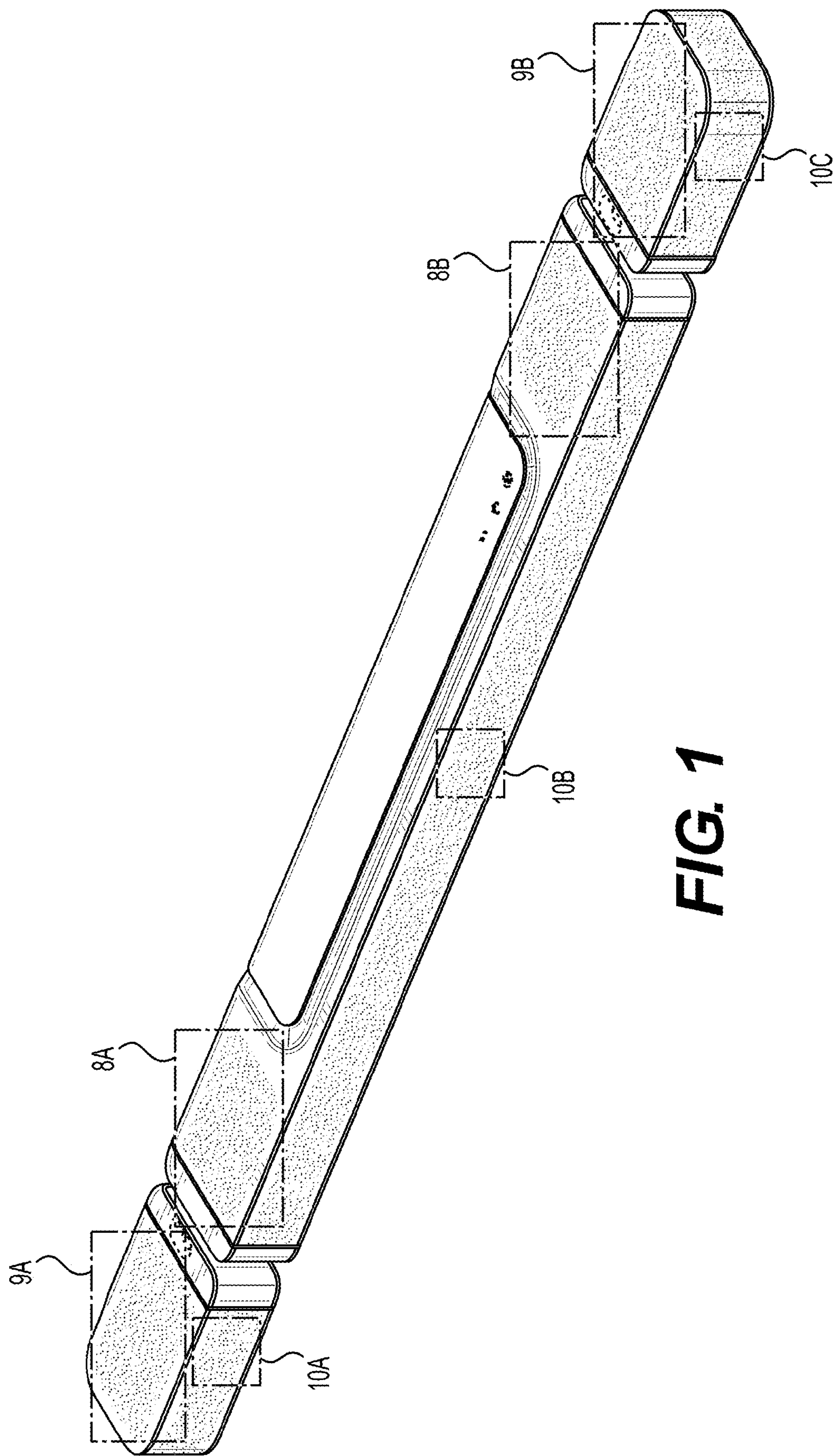

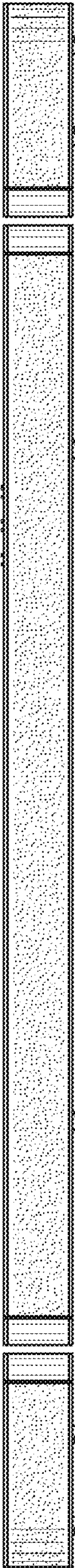

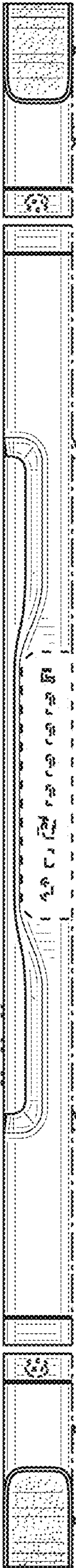

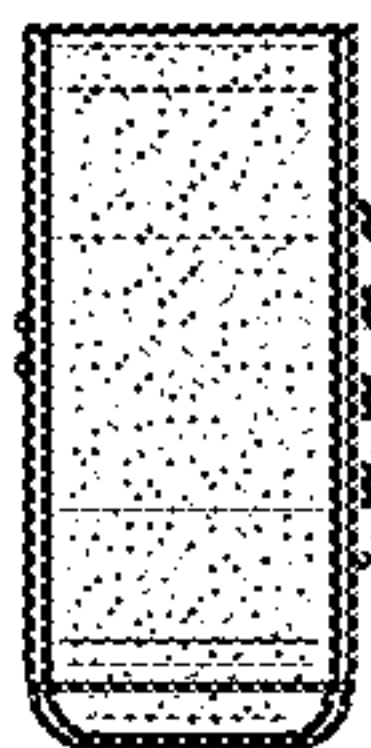

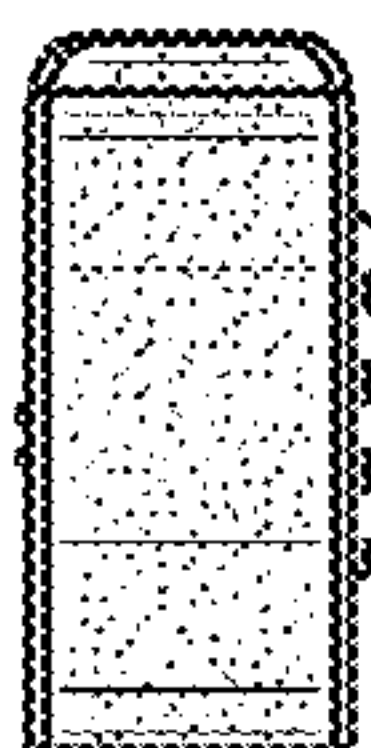

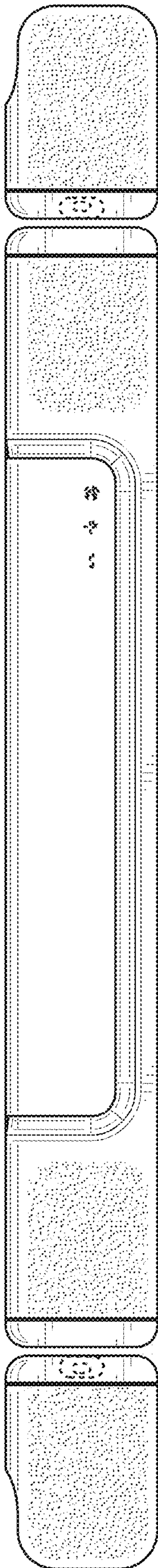

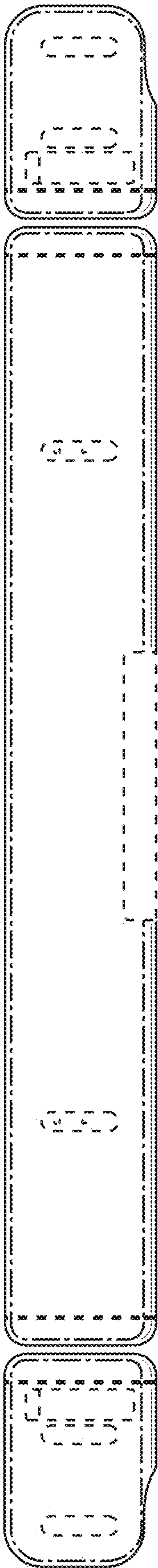

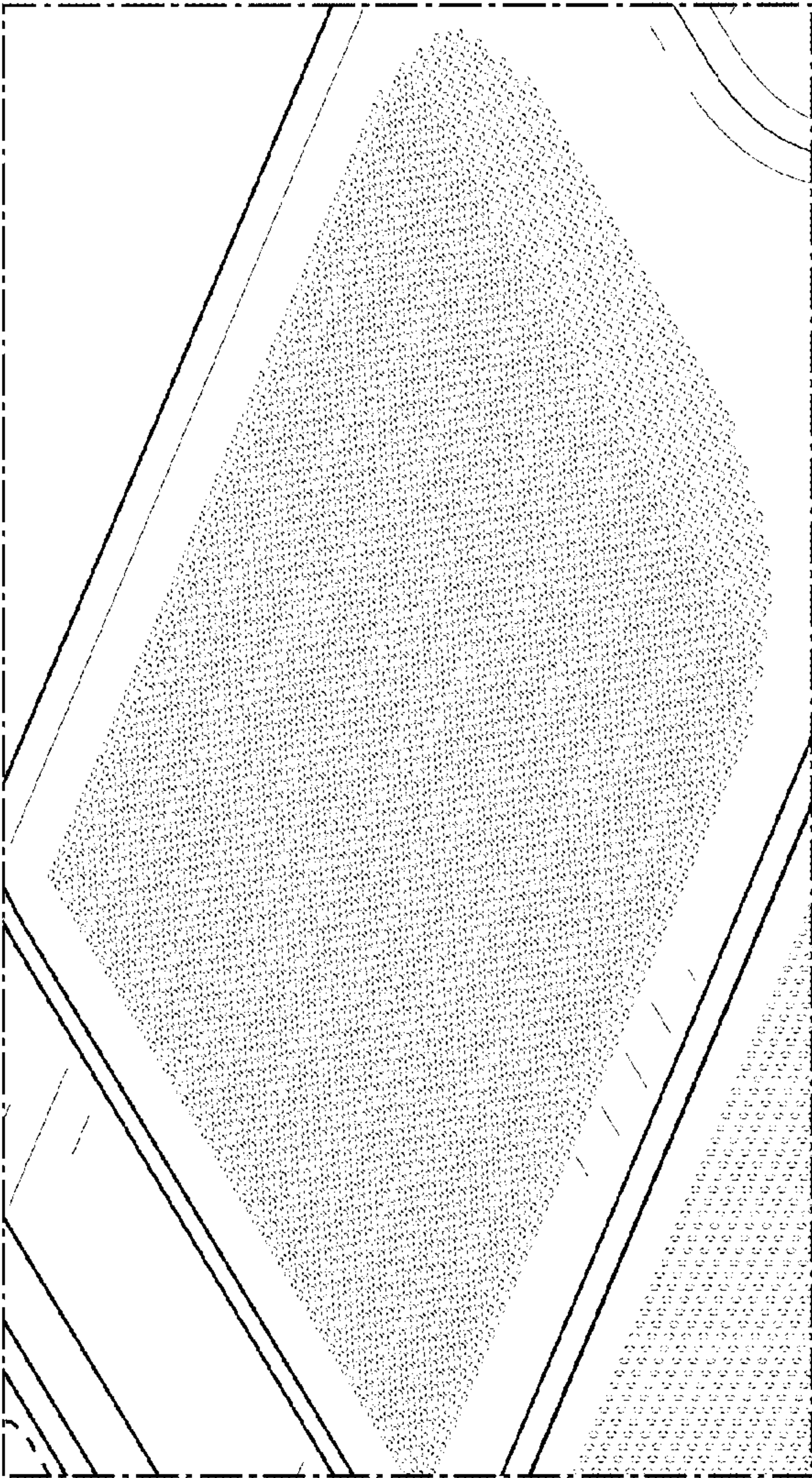
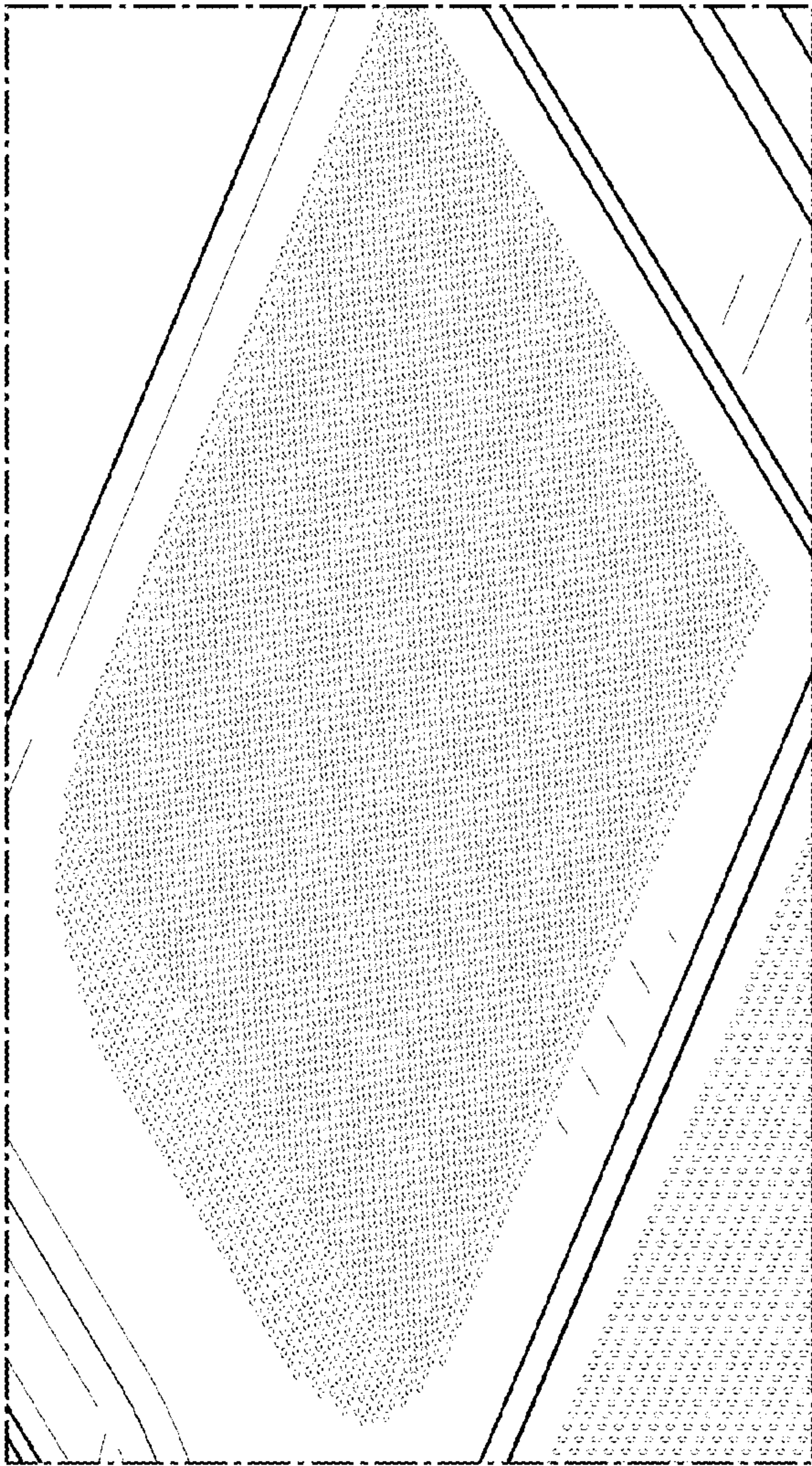

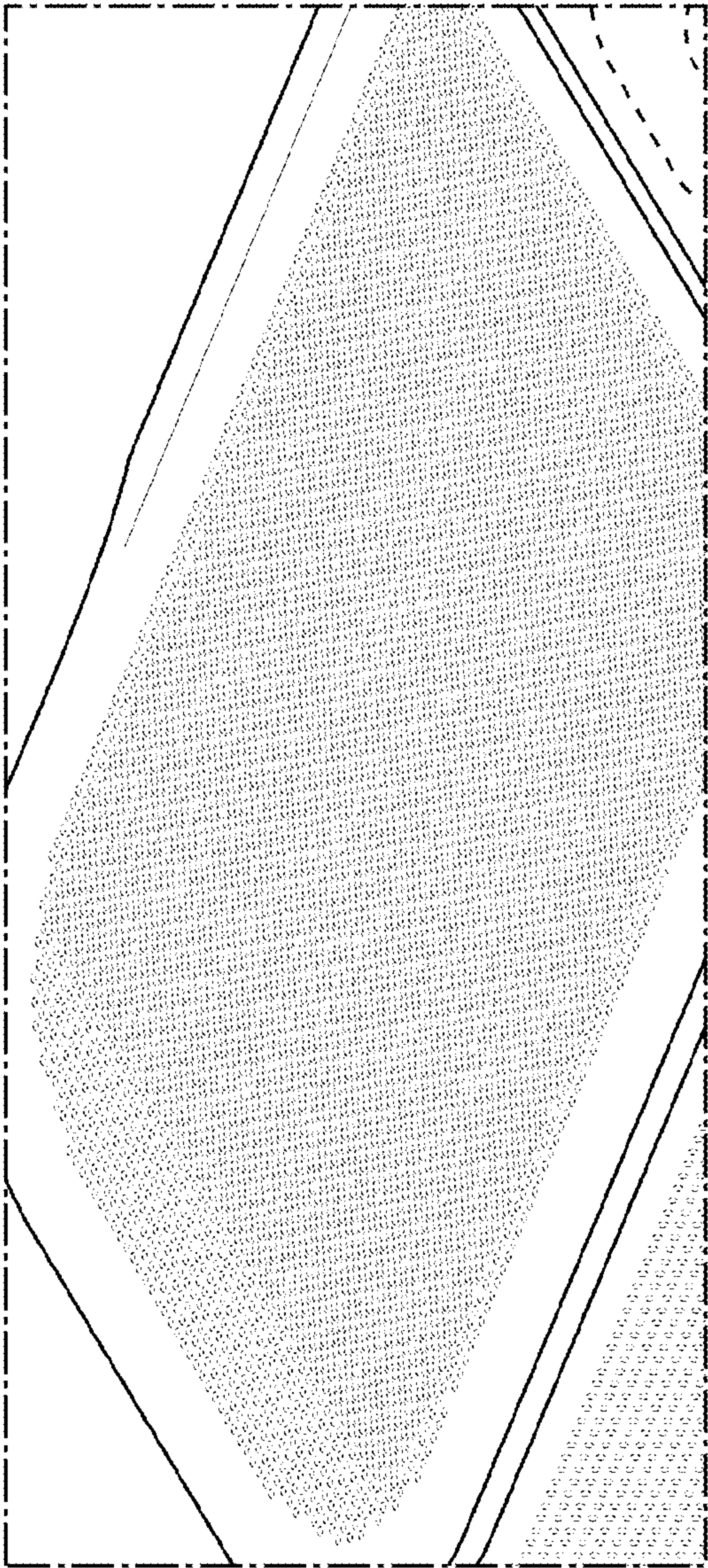

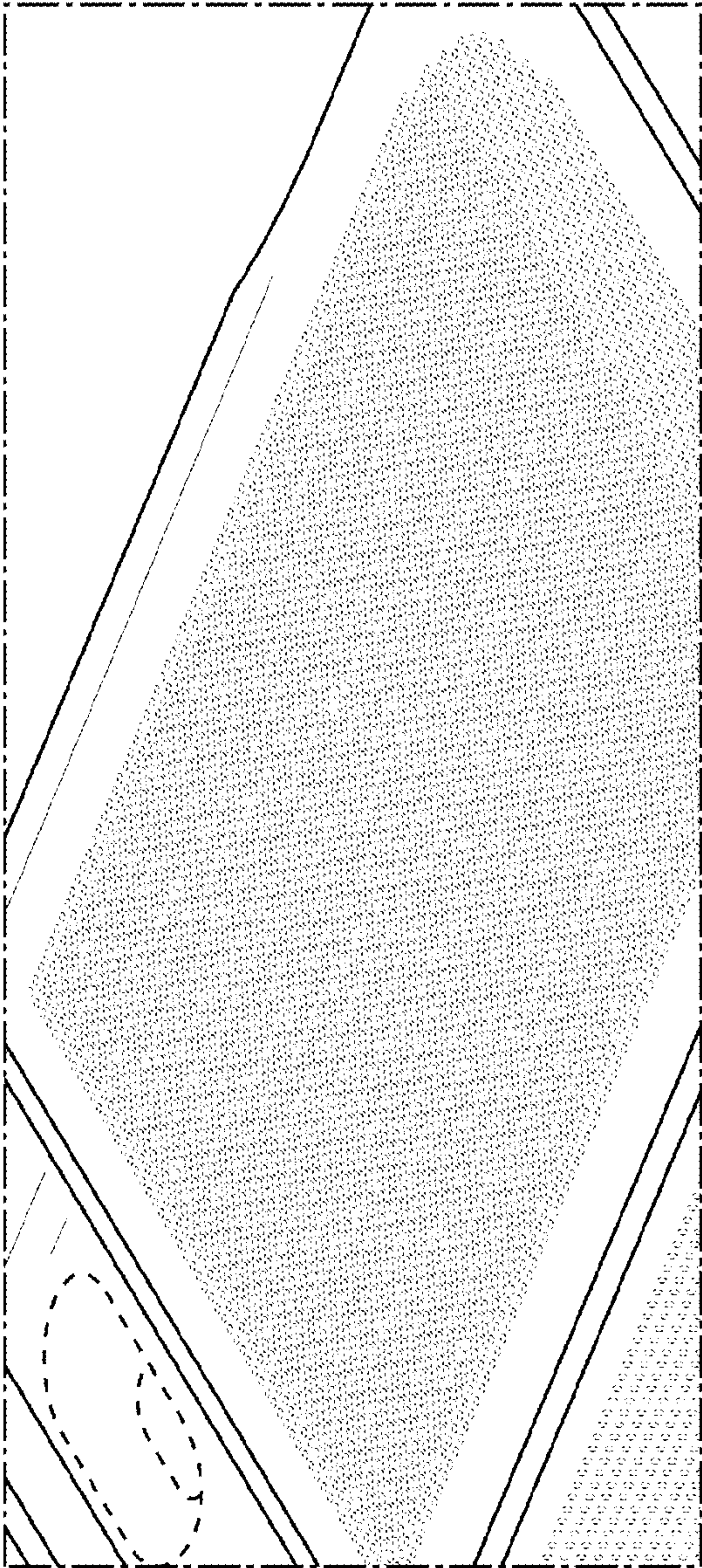

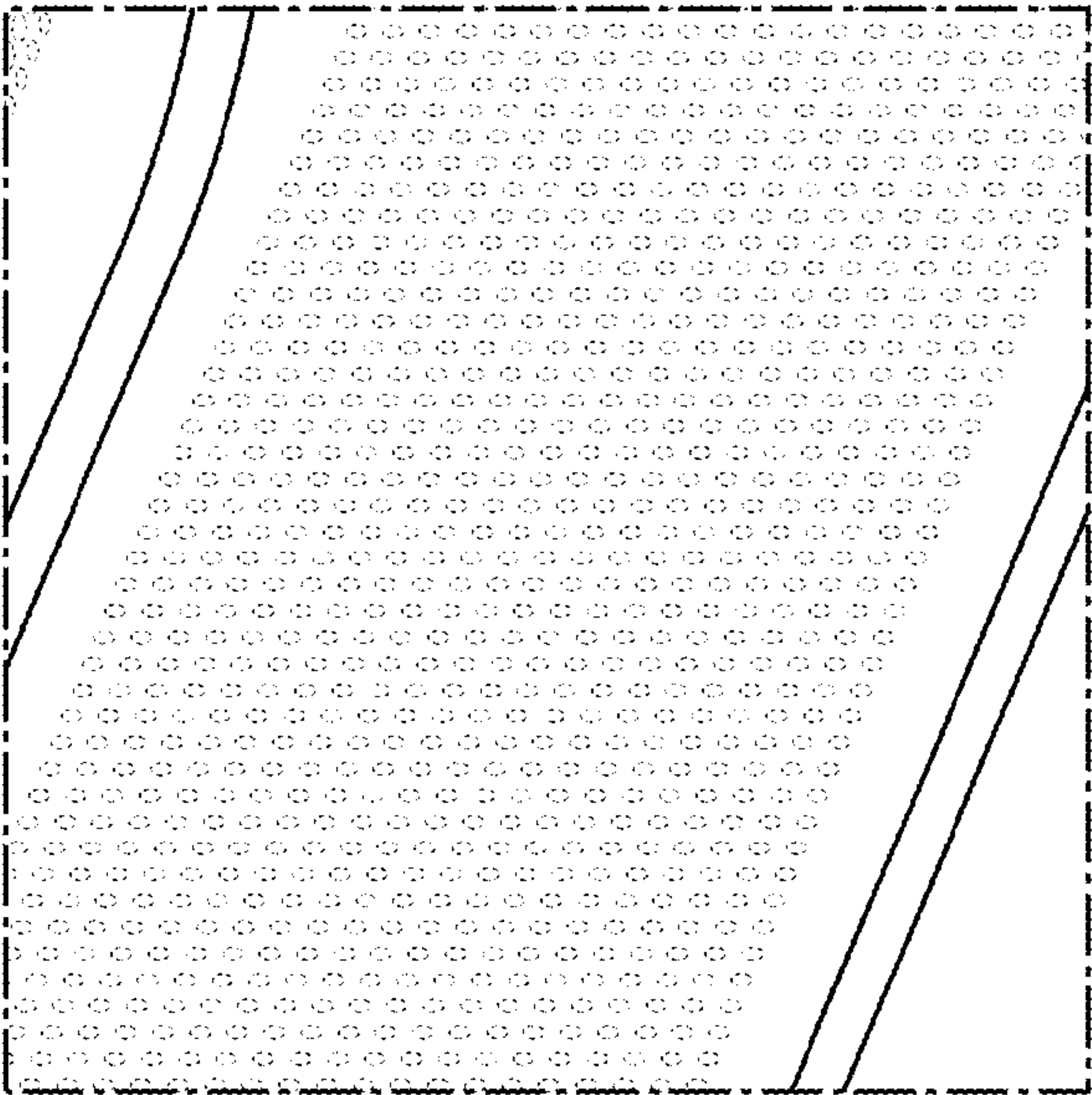

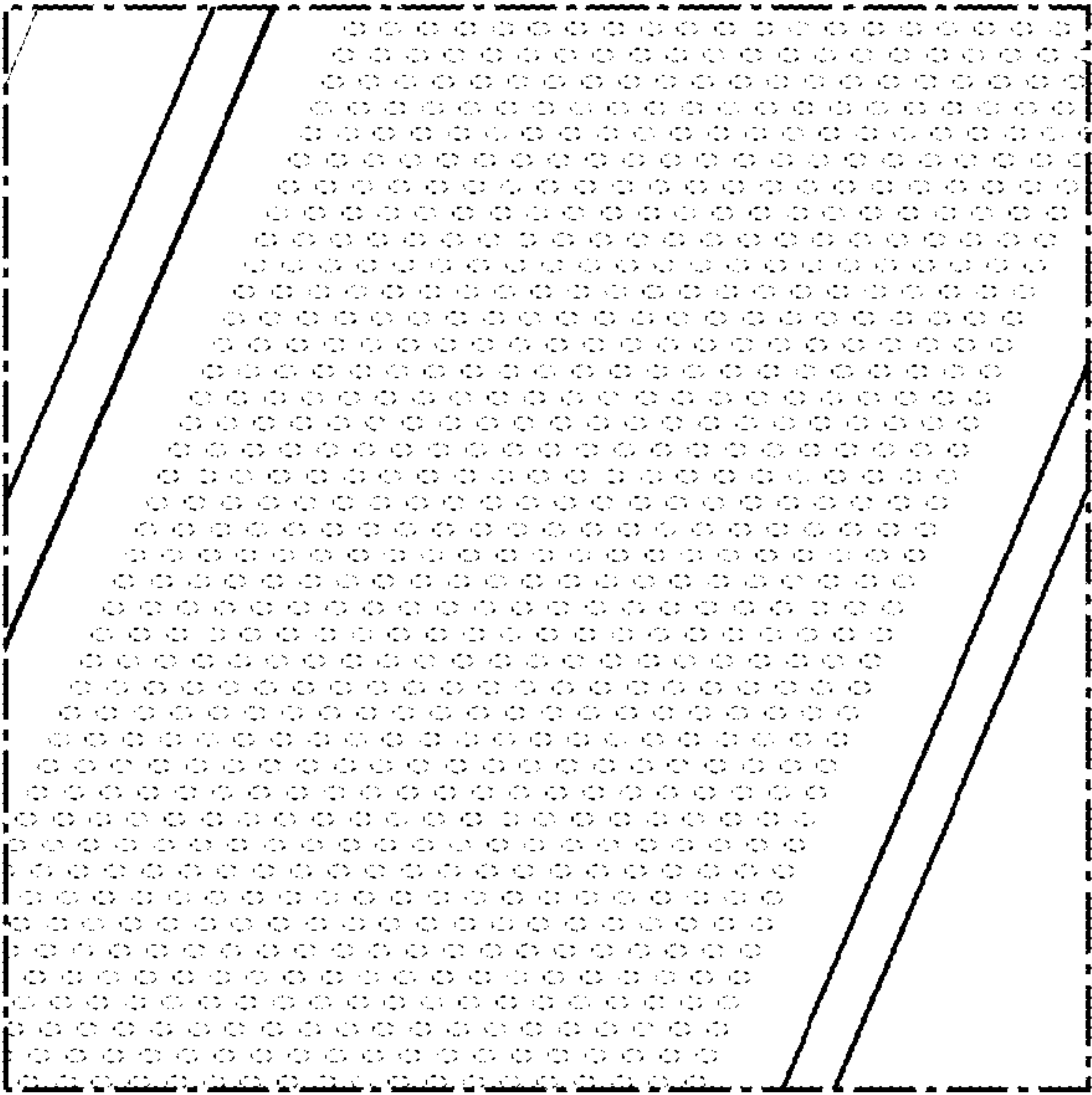

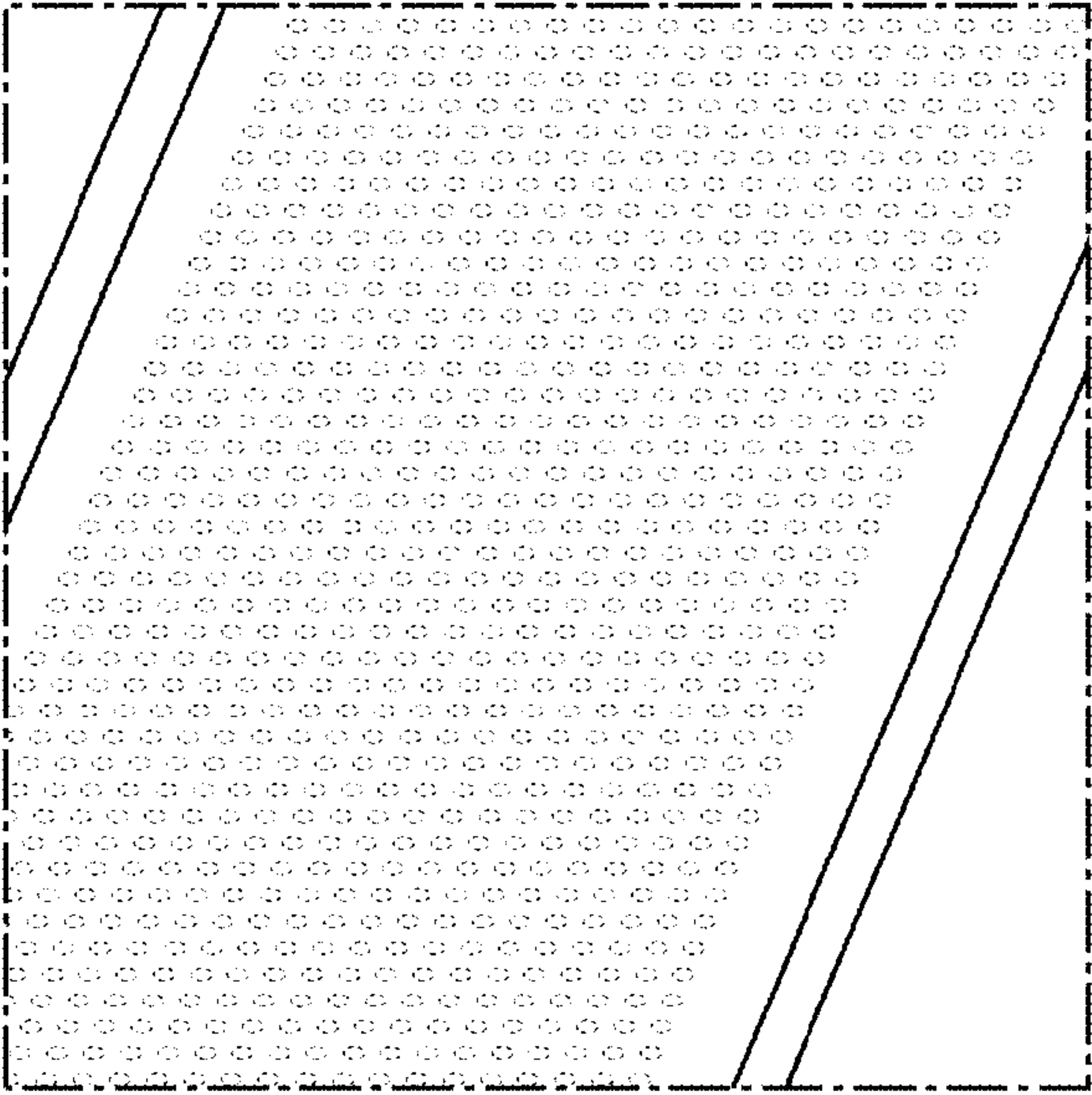
