DESCRIPTION

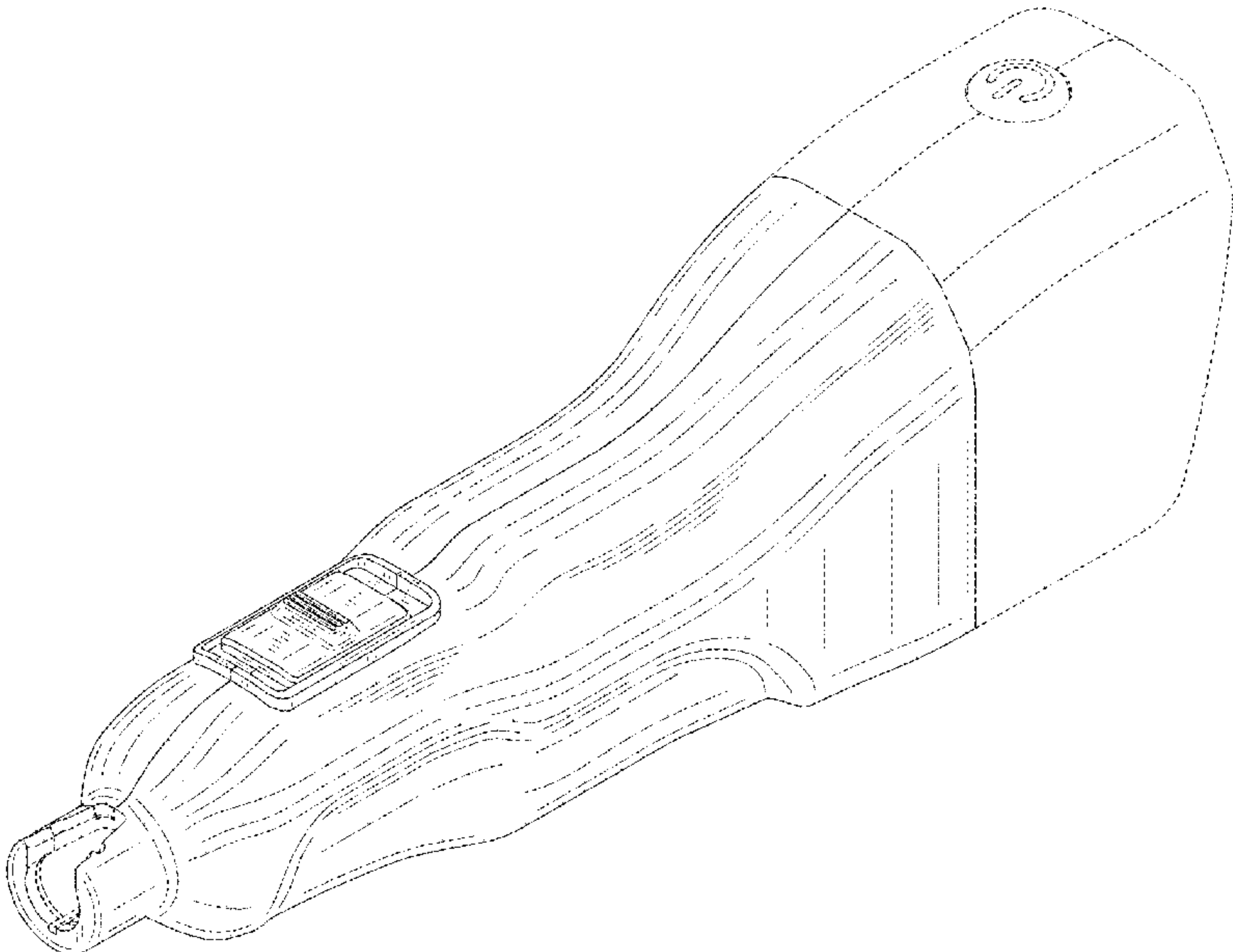

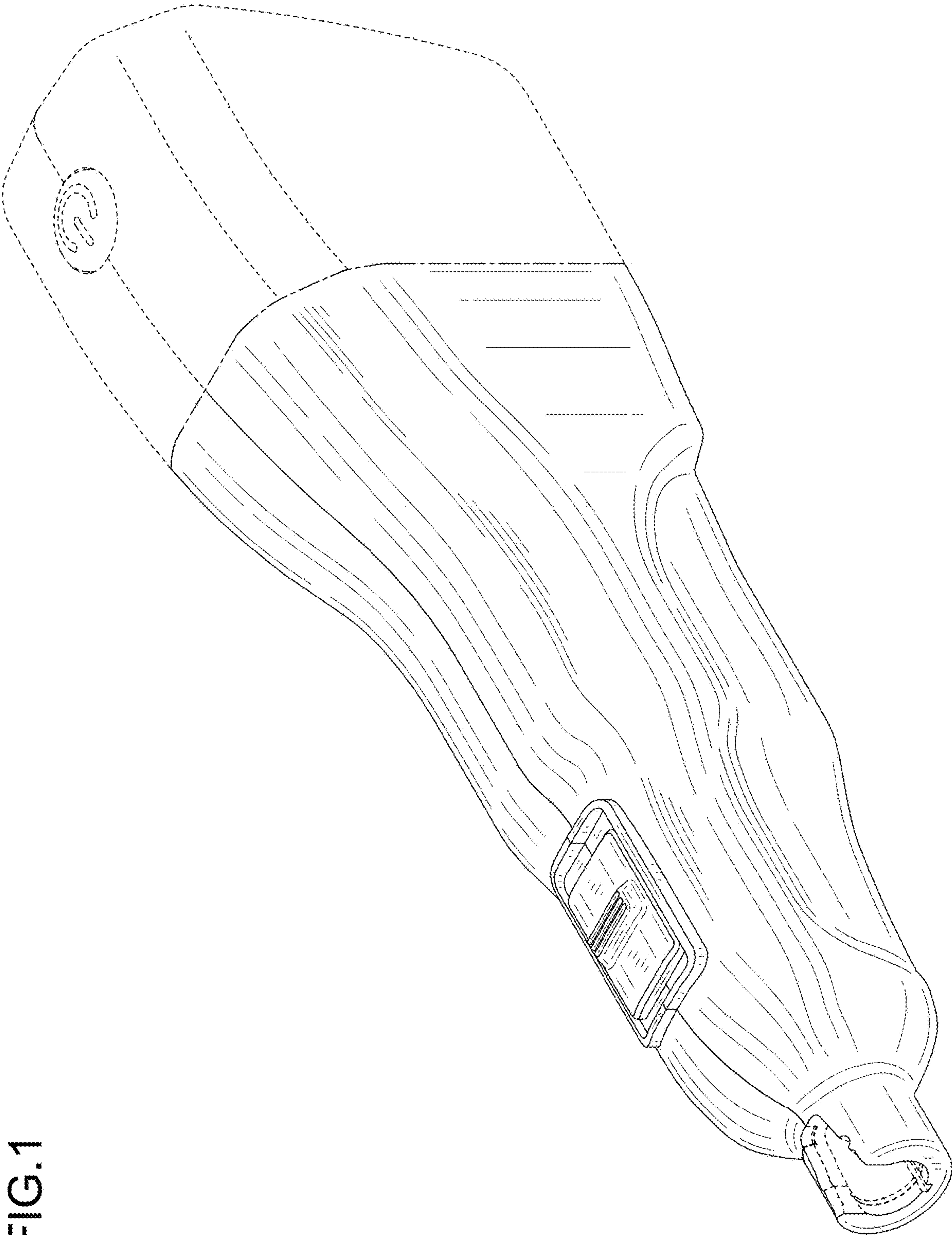

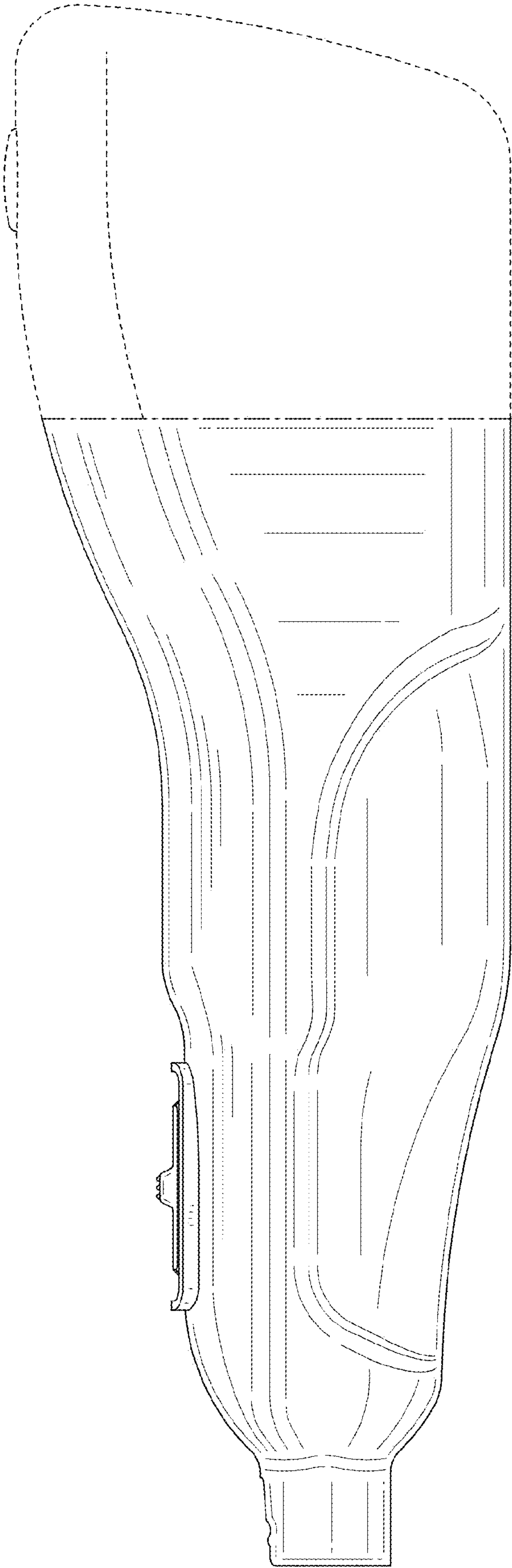

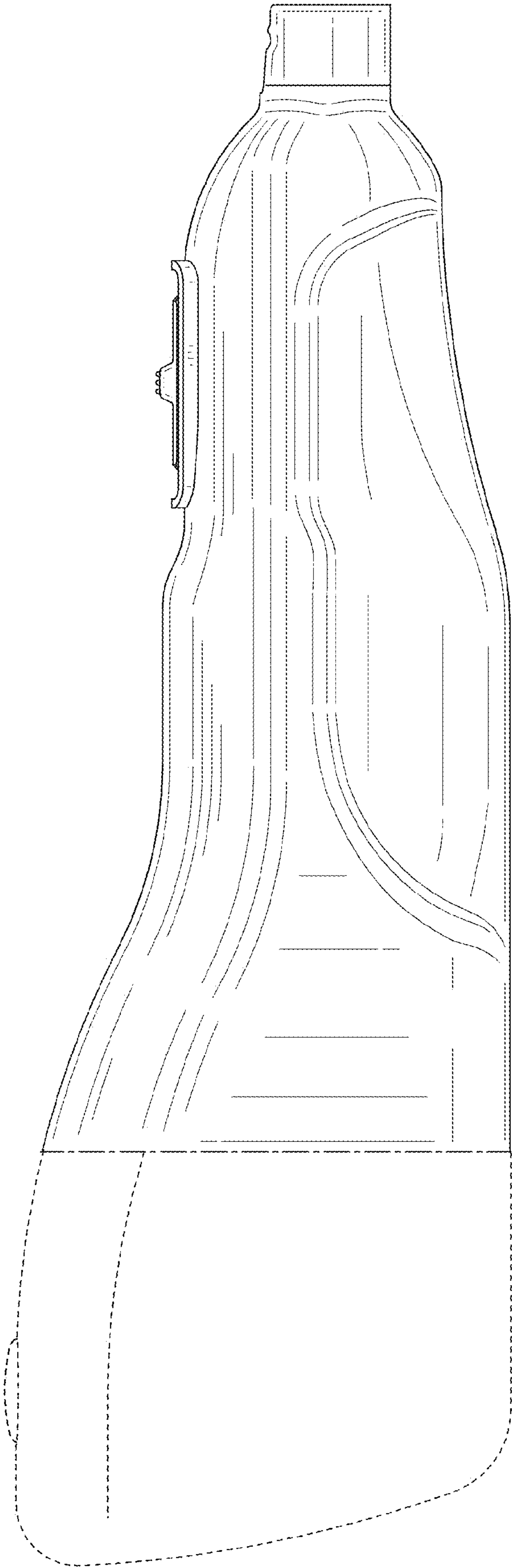

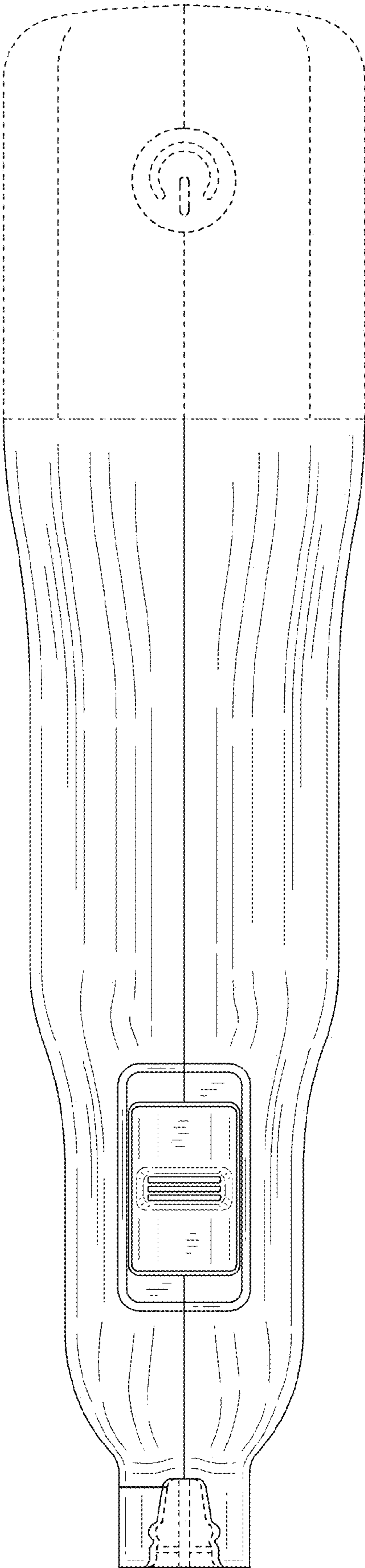
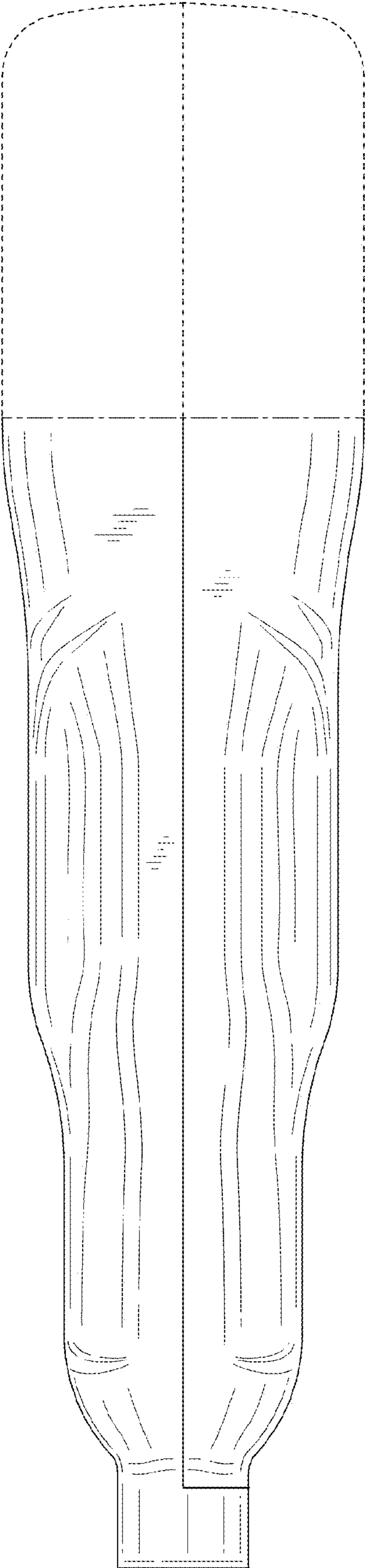

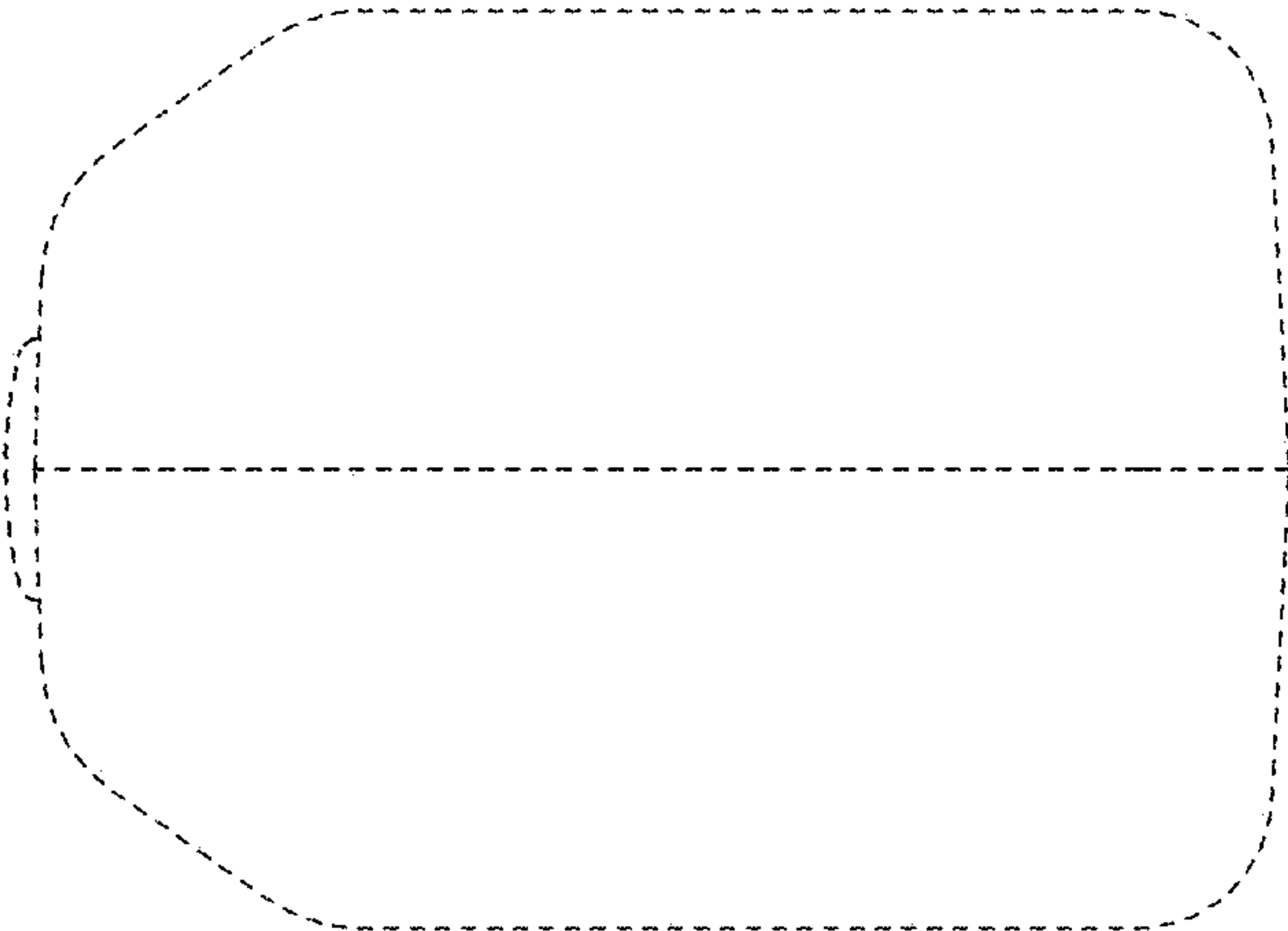

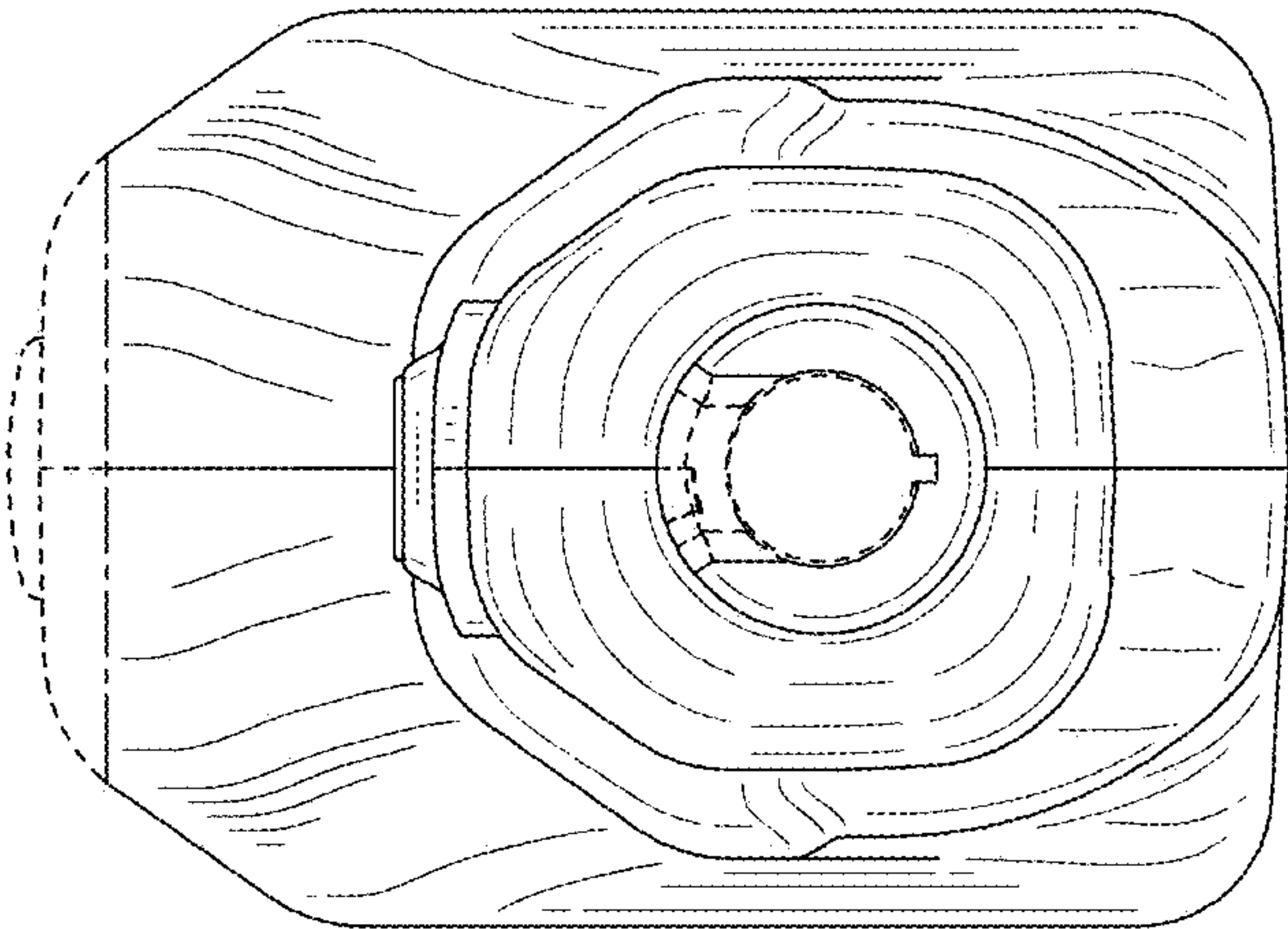

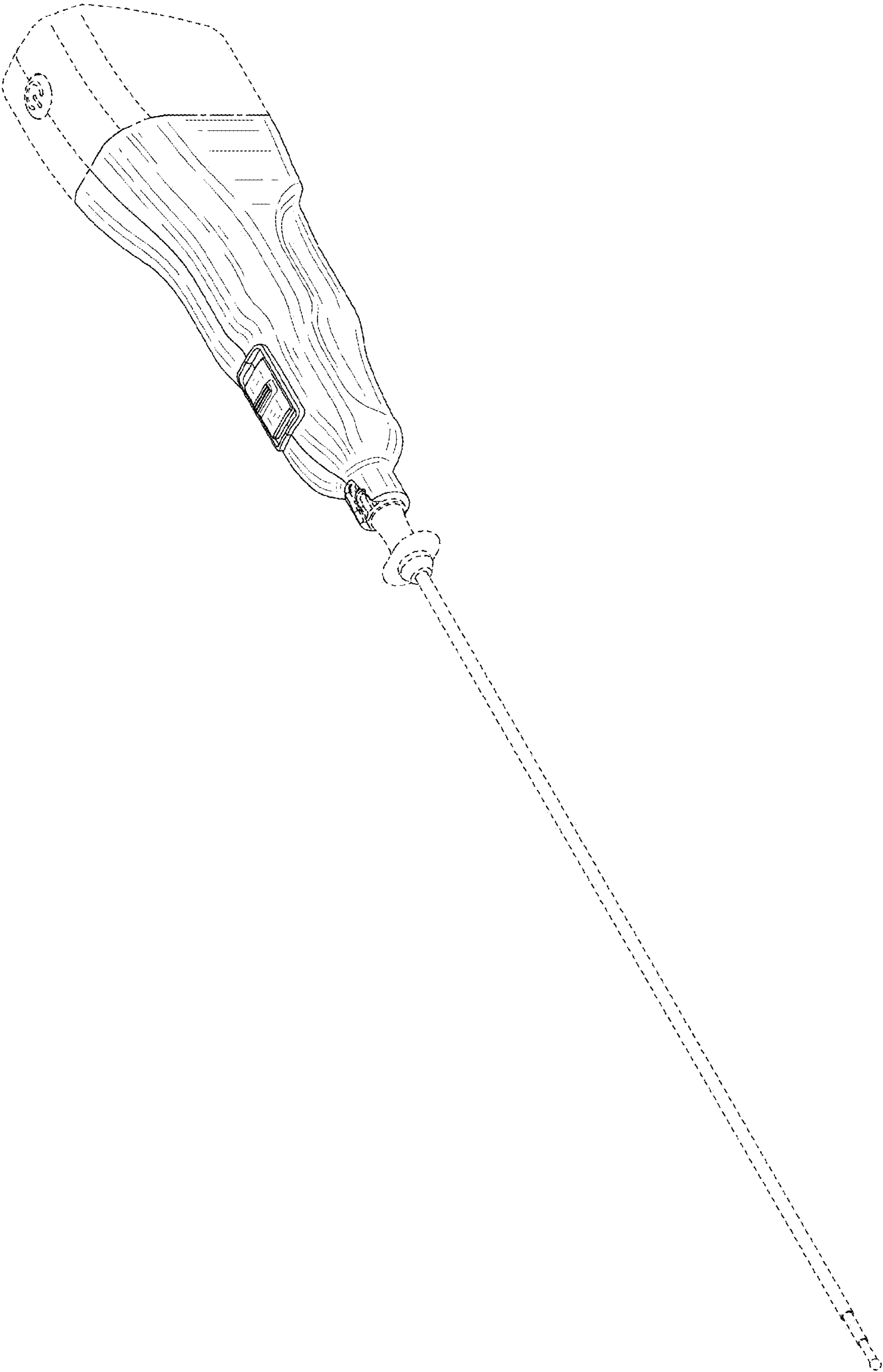
