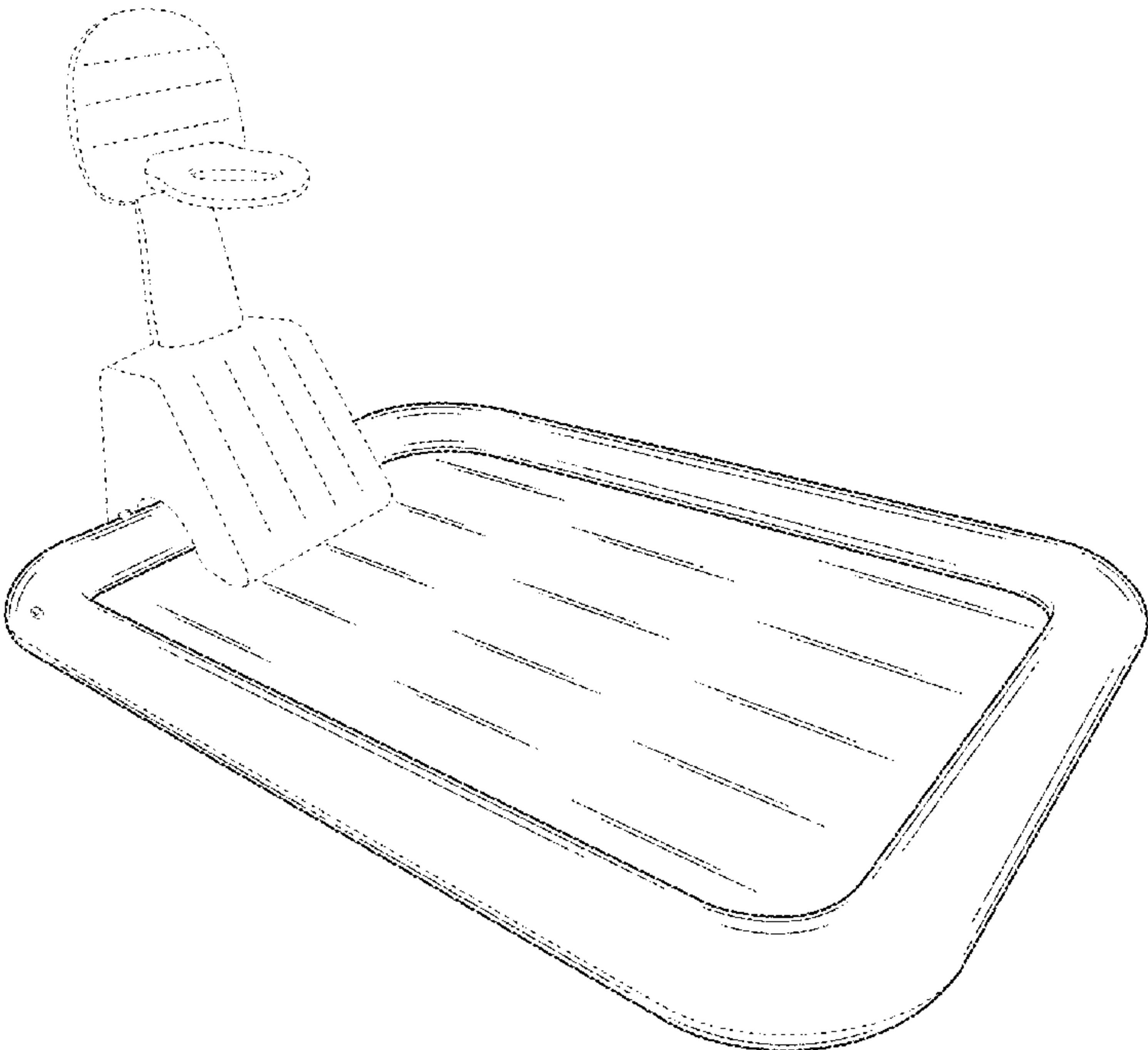
The ornamental design for a recreational pad for spraying water, as shown and described.

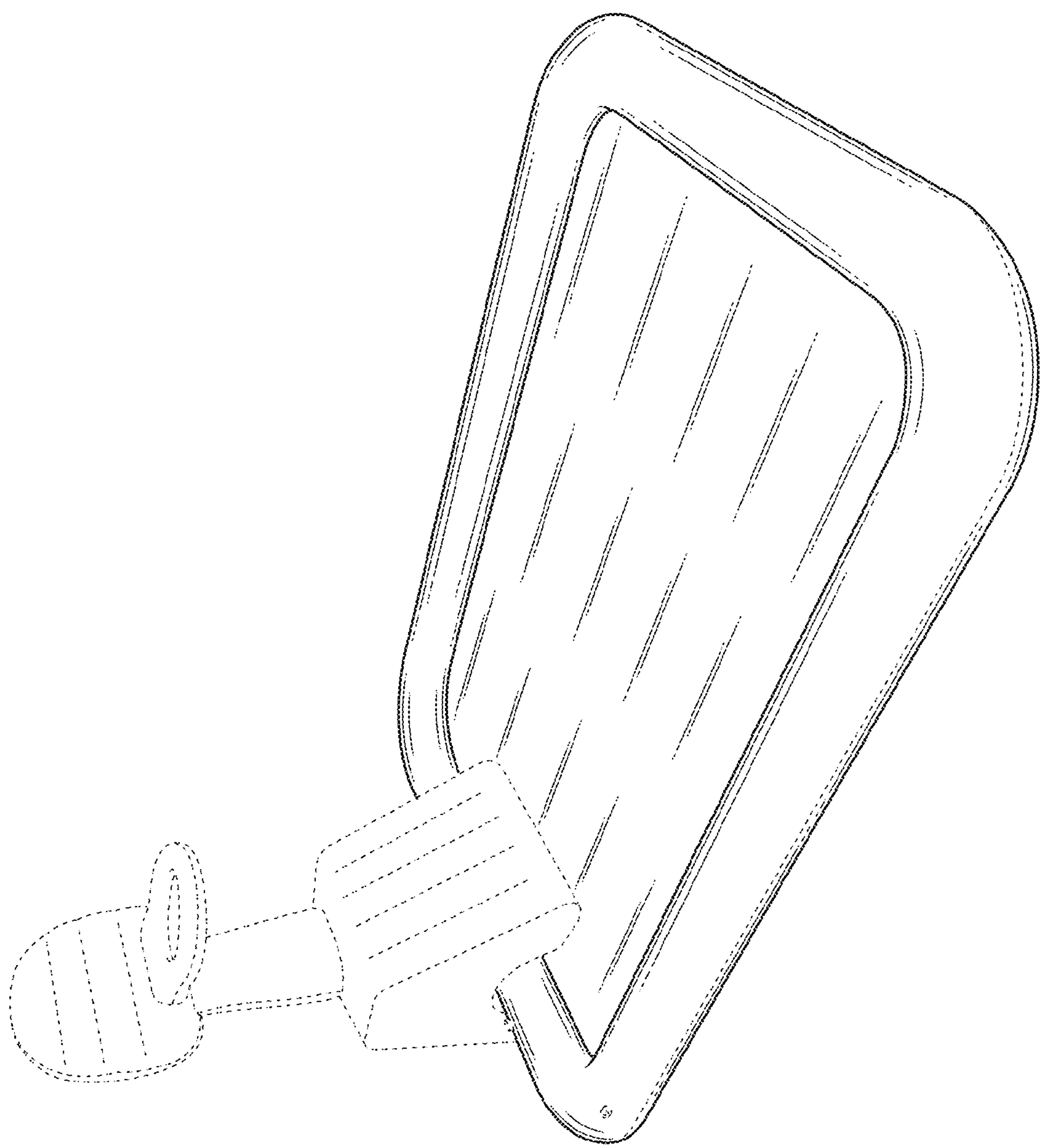

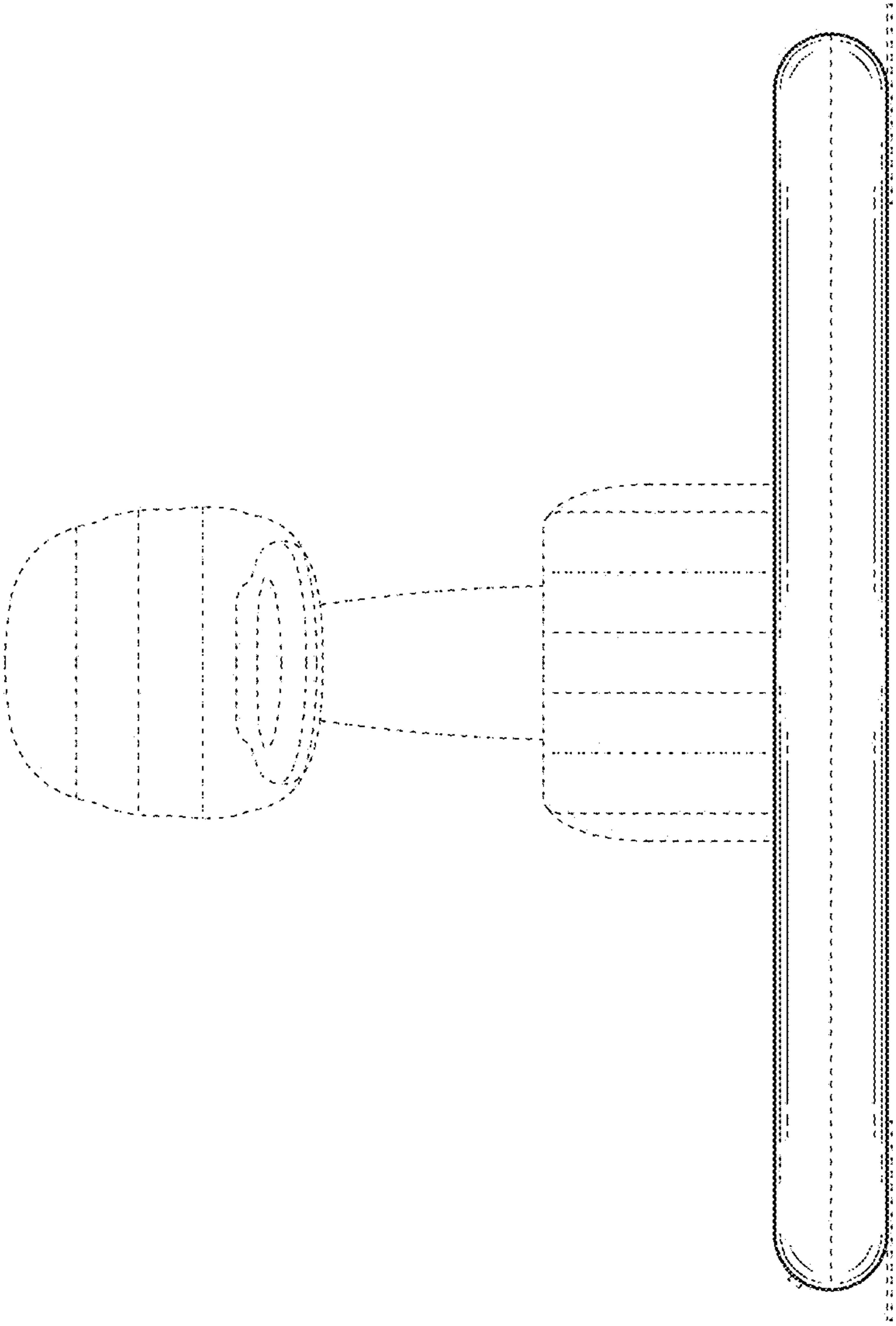

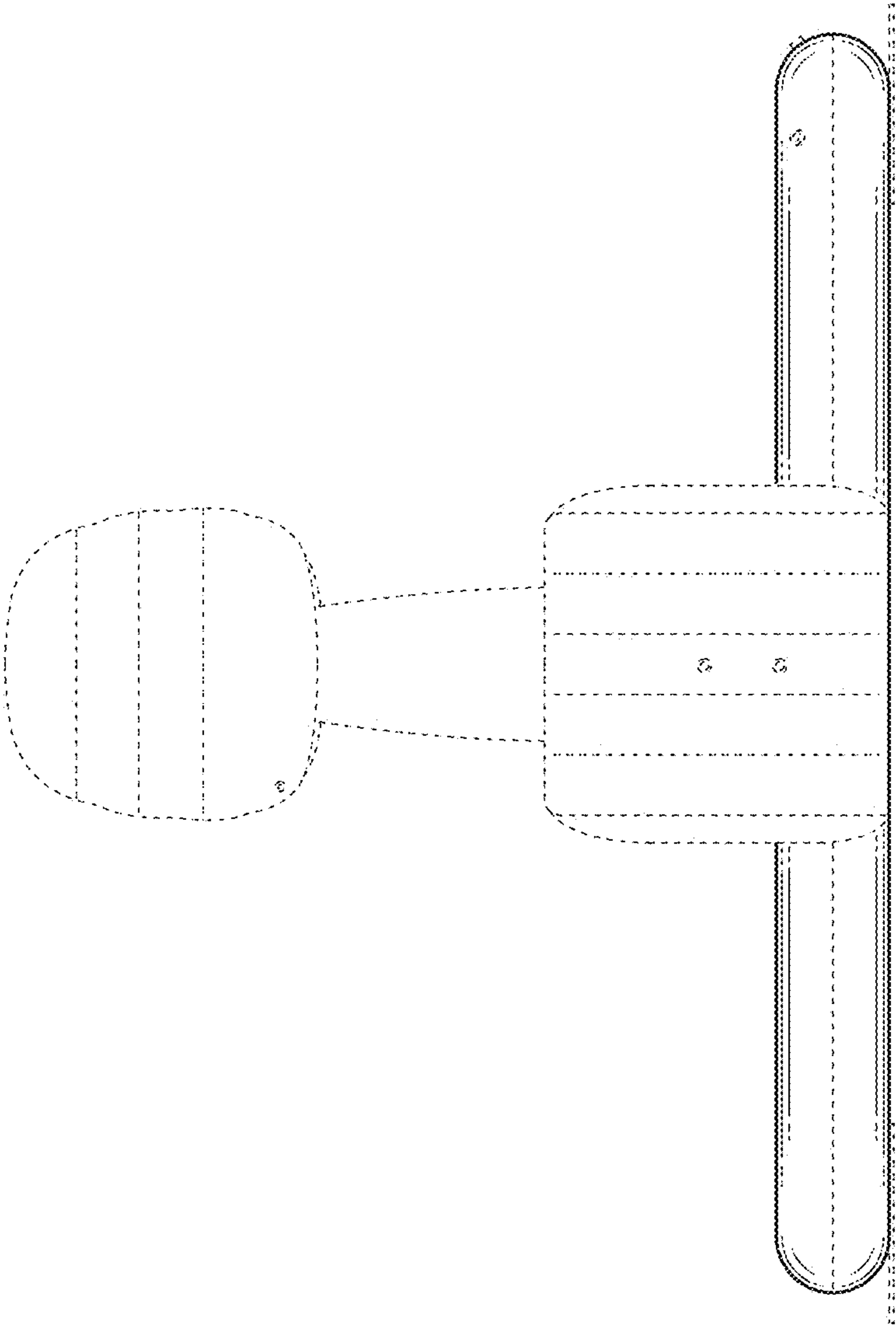

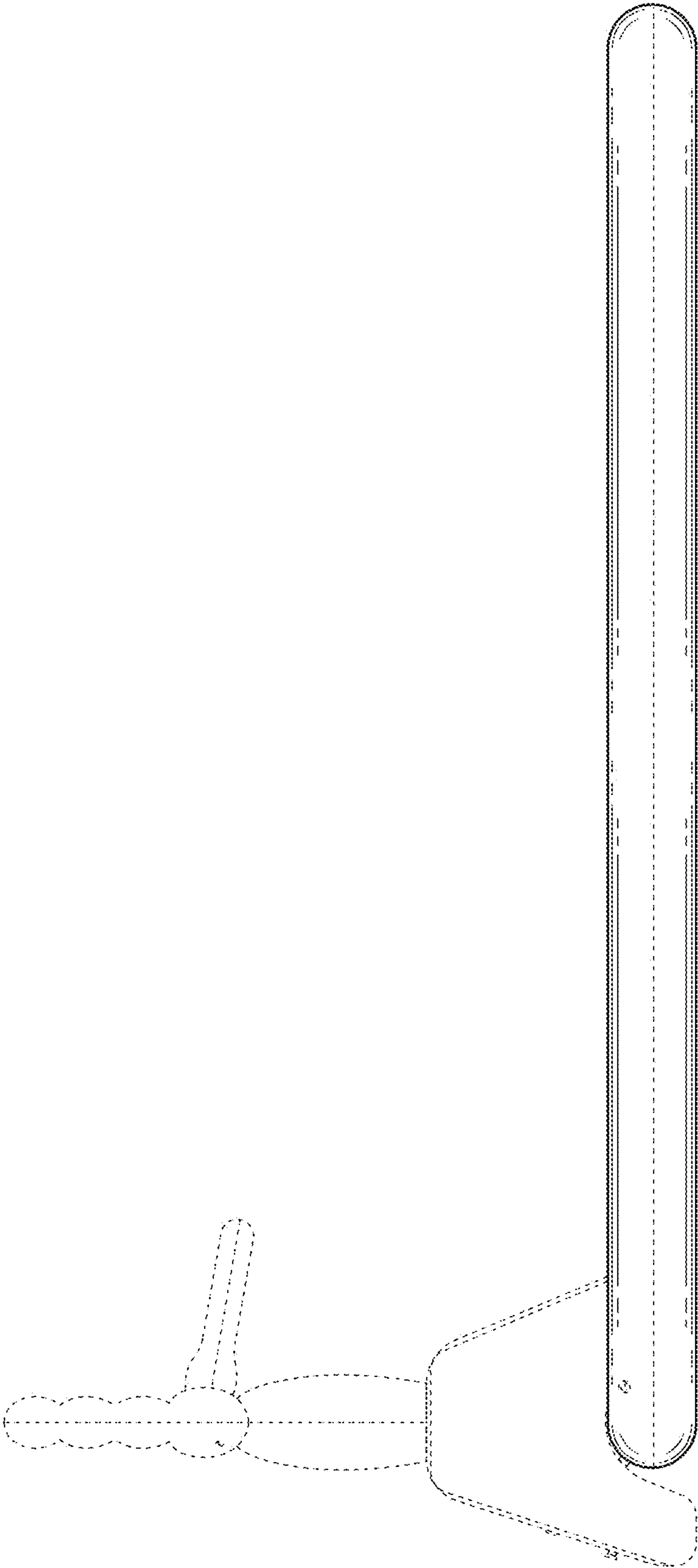

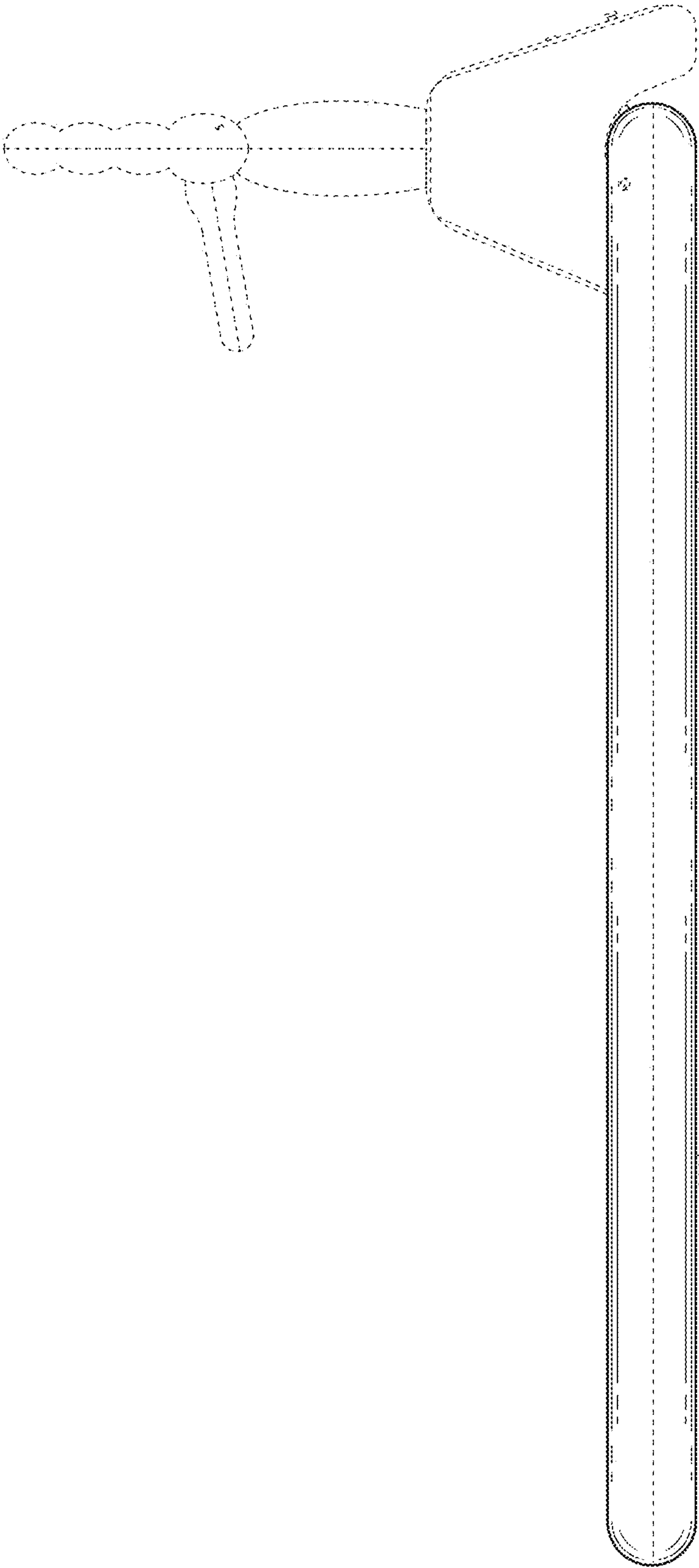

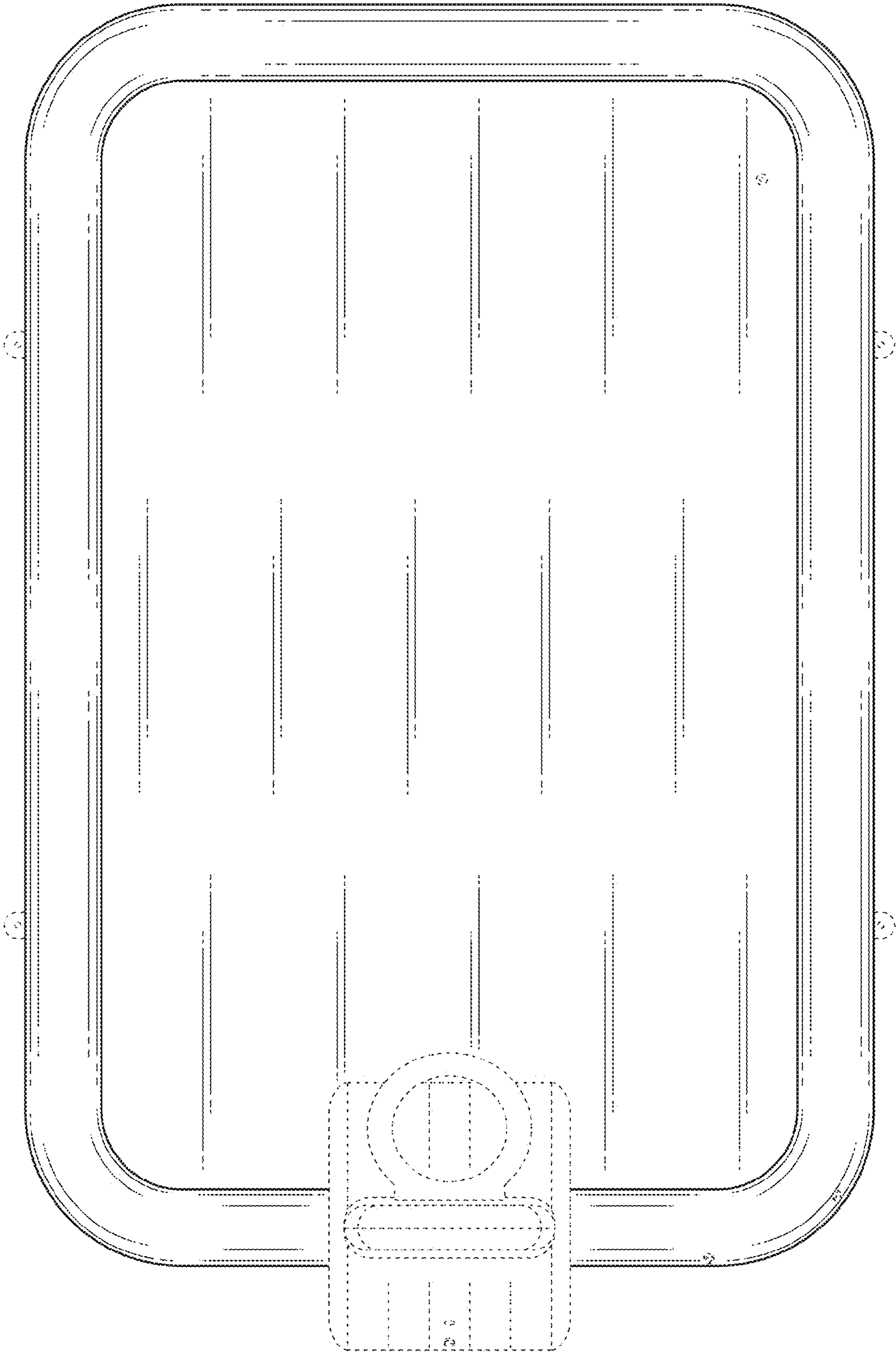

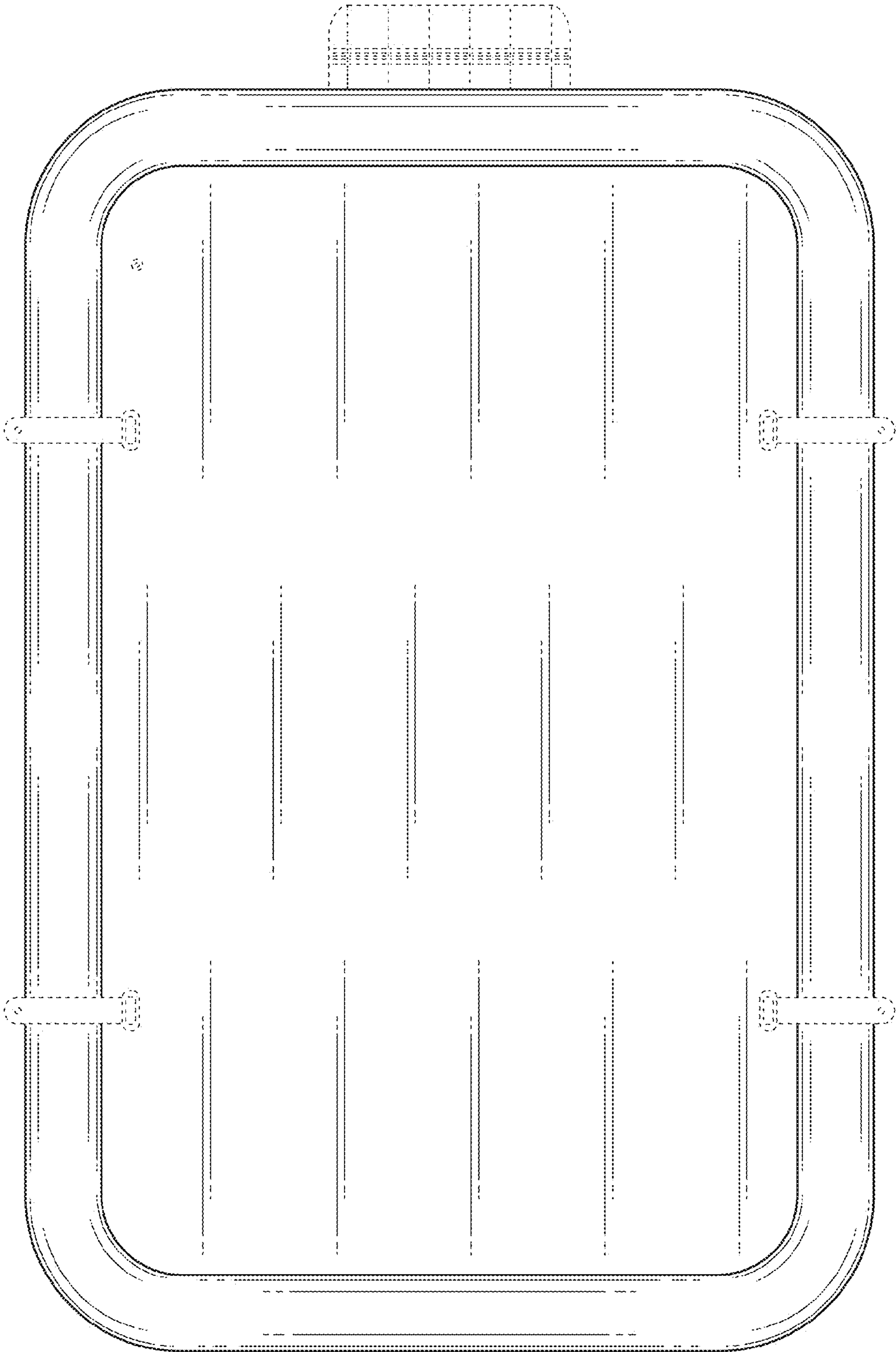
