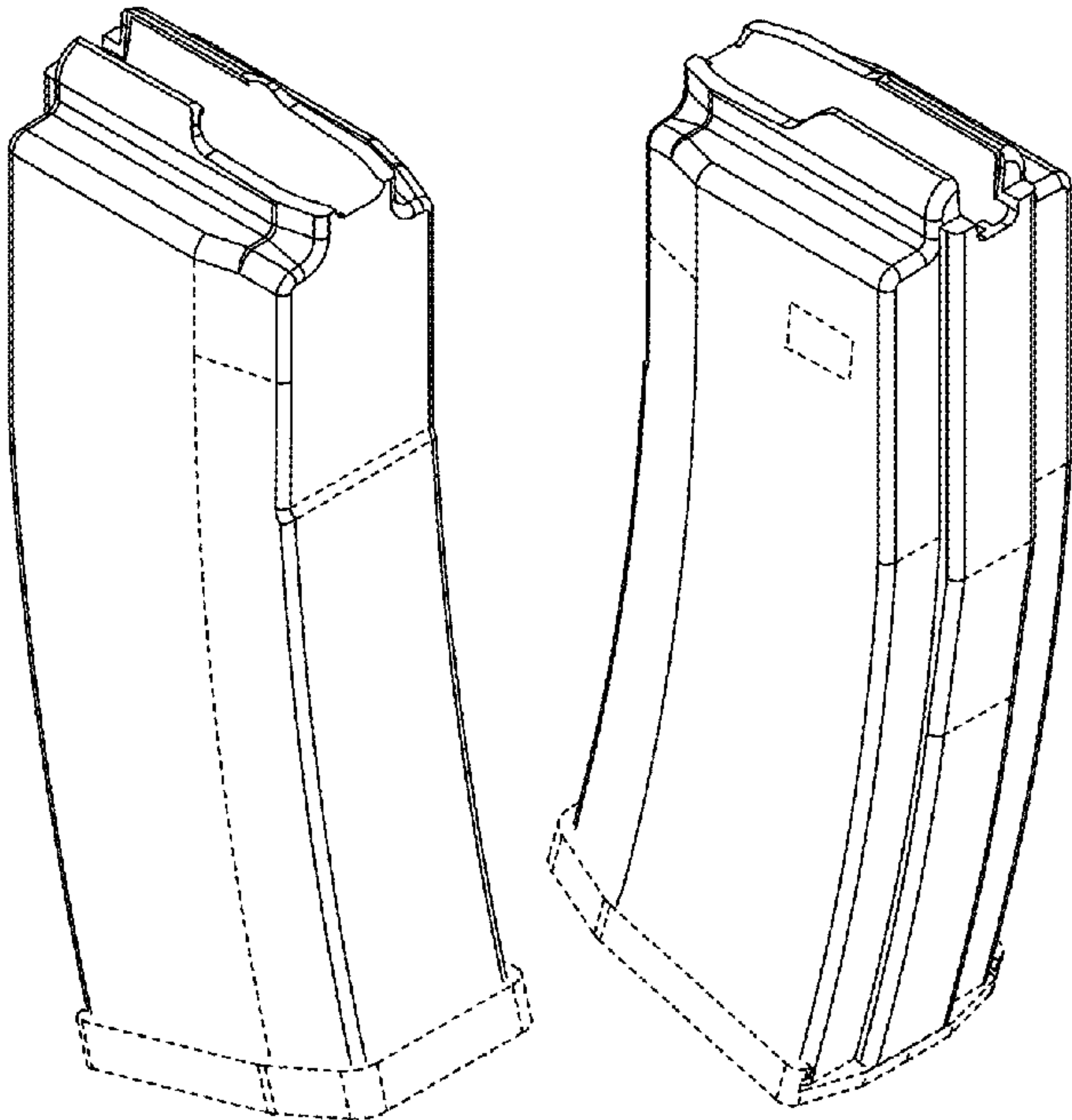
The ornamental design for a detachable magazine for firearms, as shown and described.

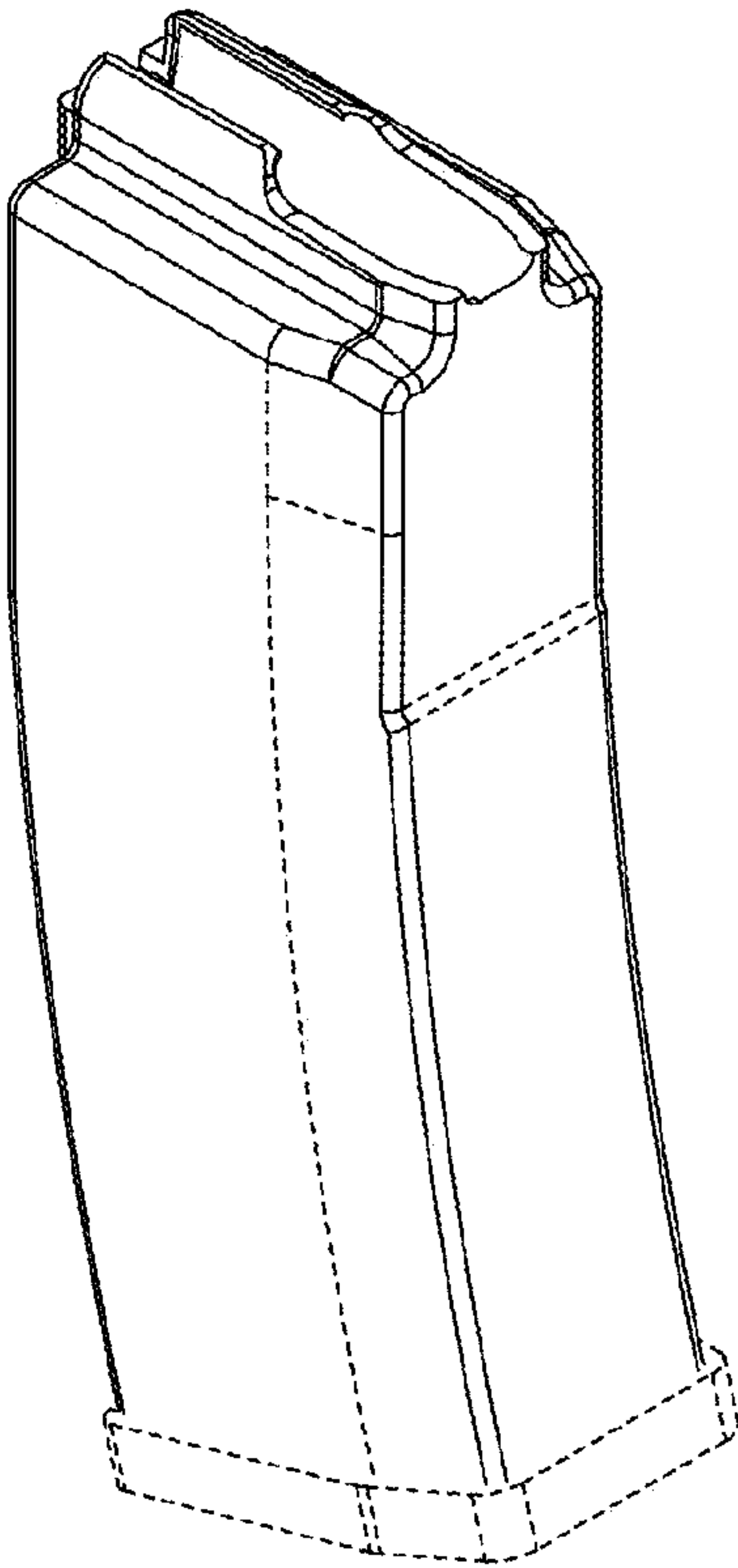

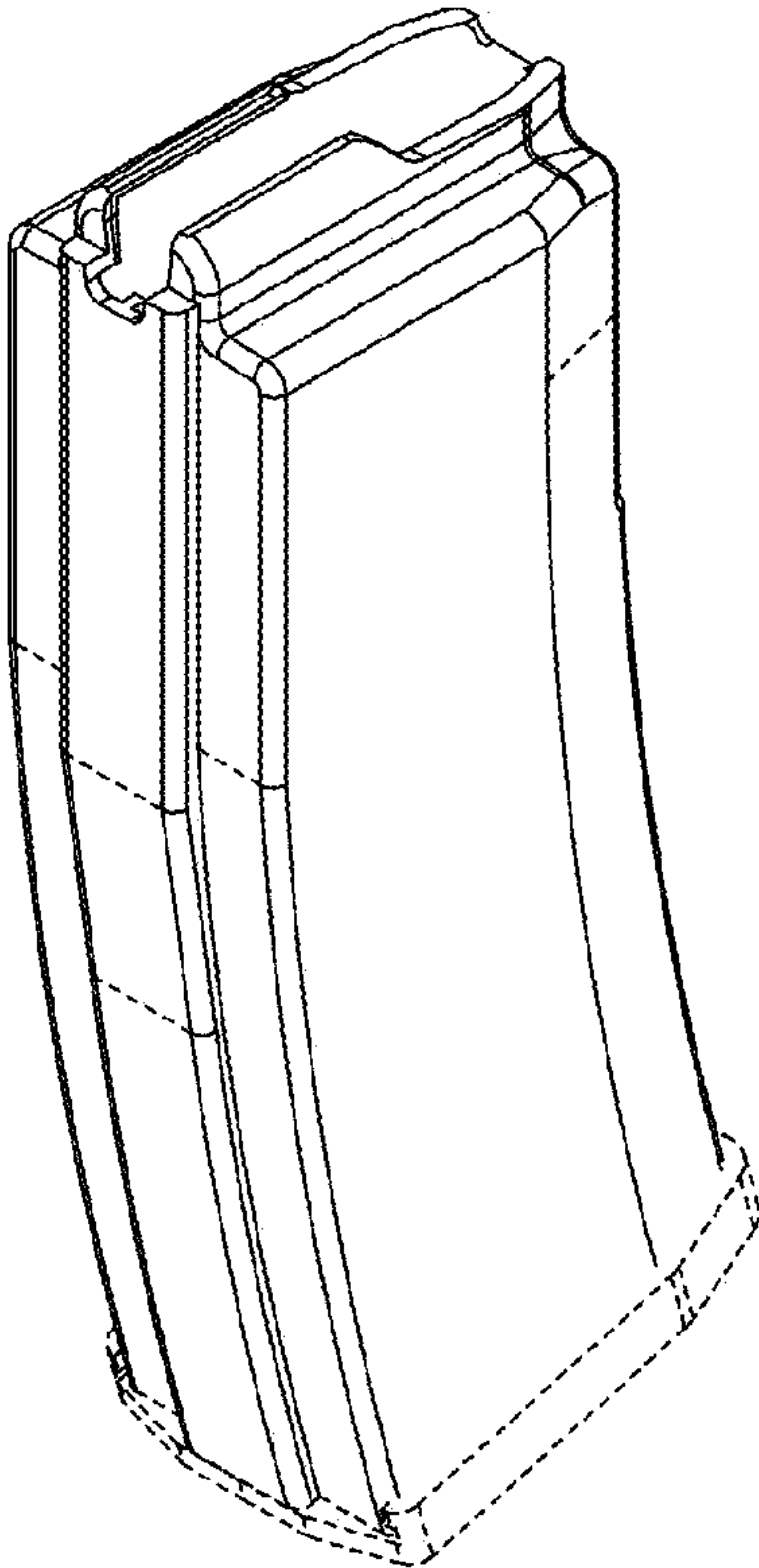

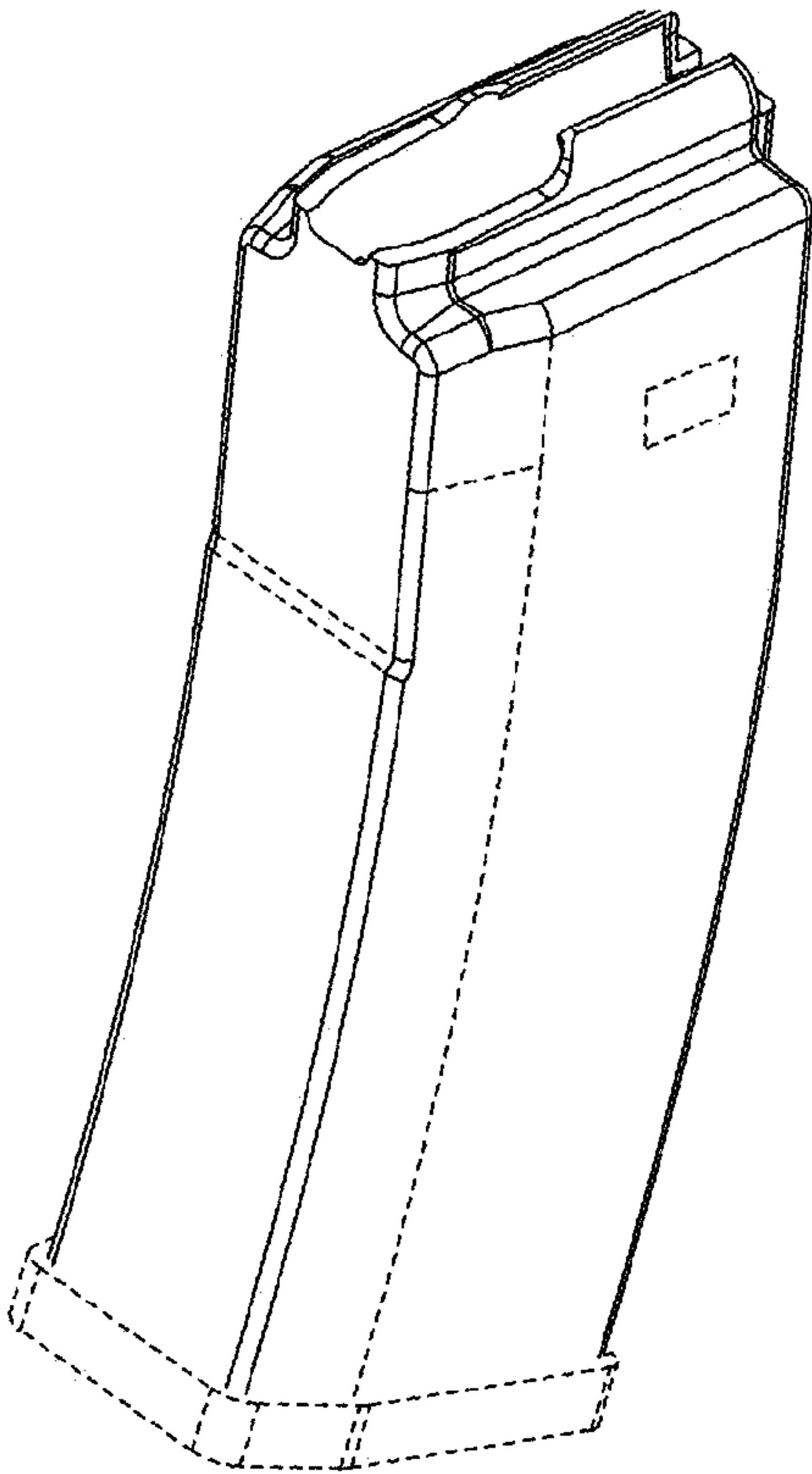

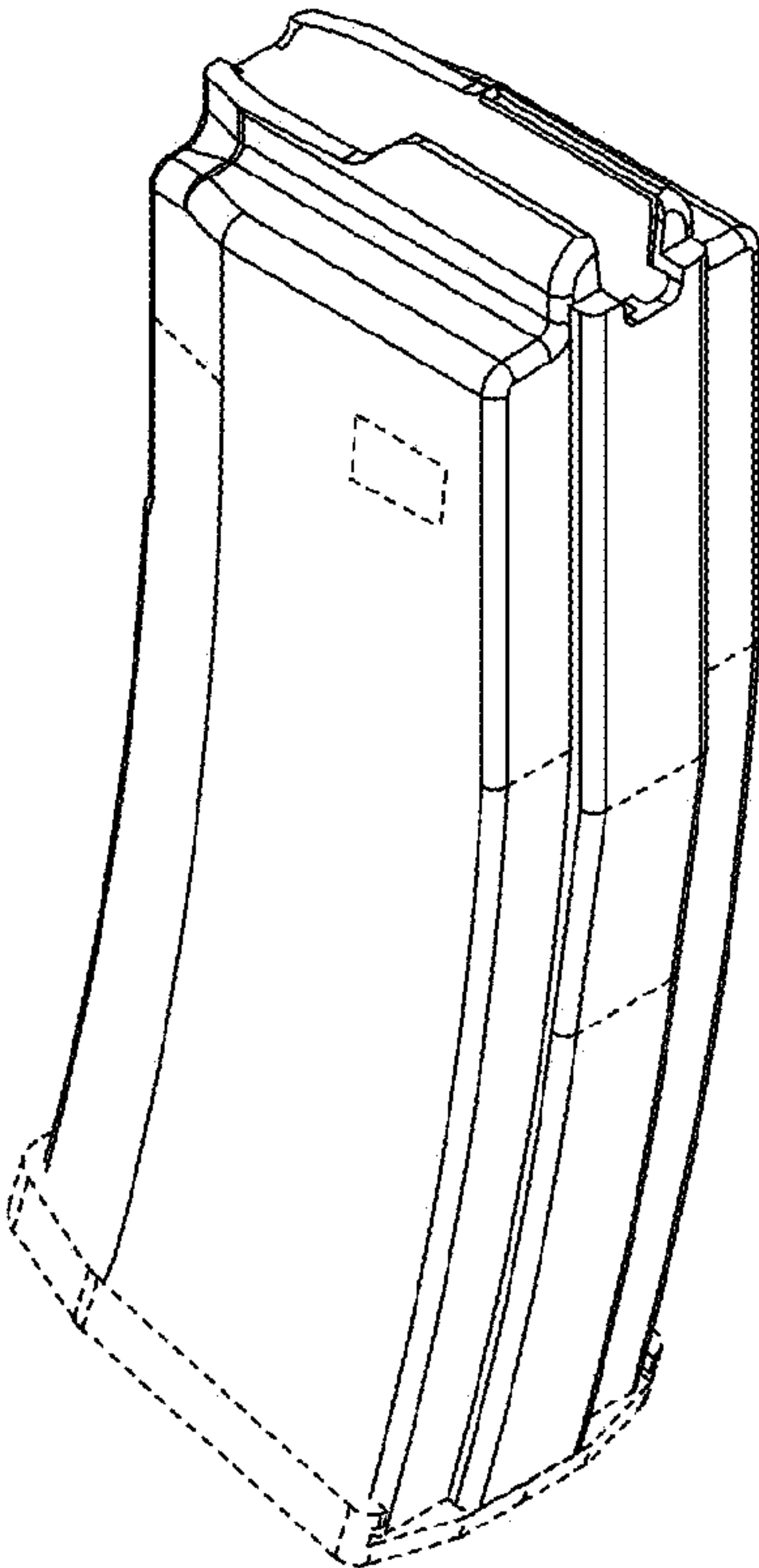

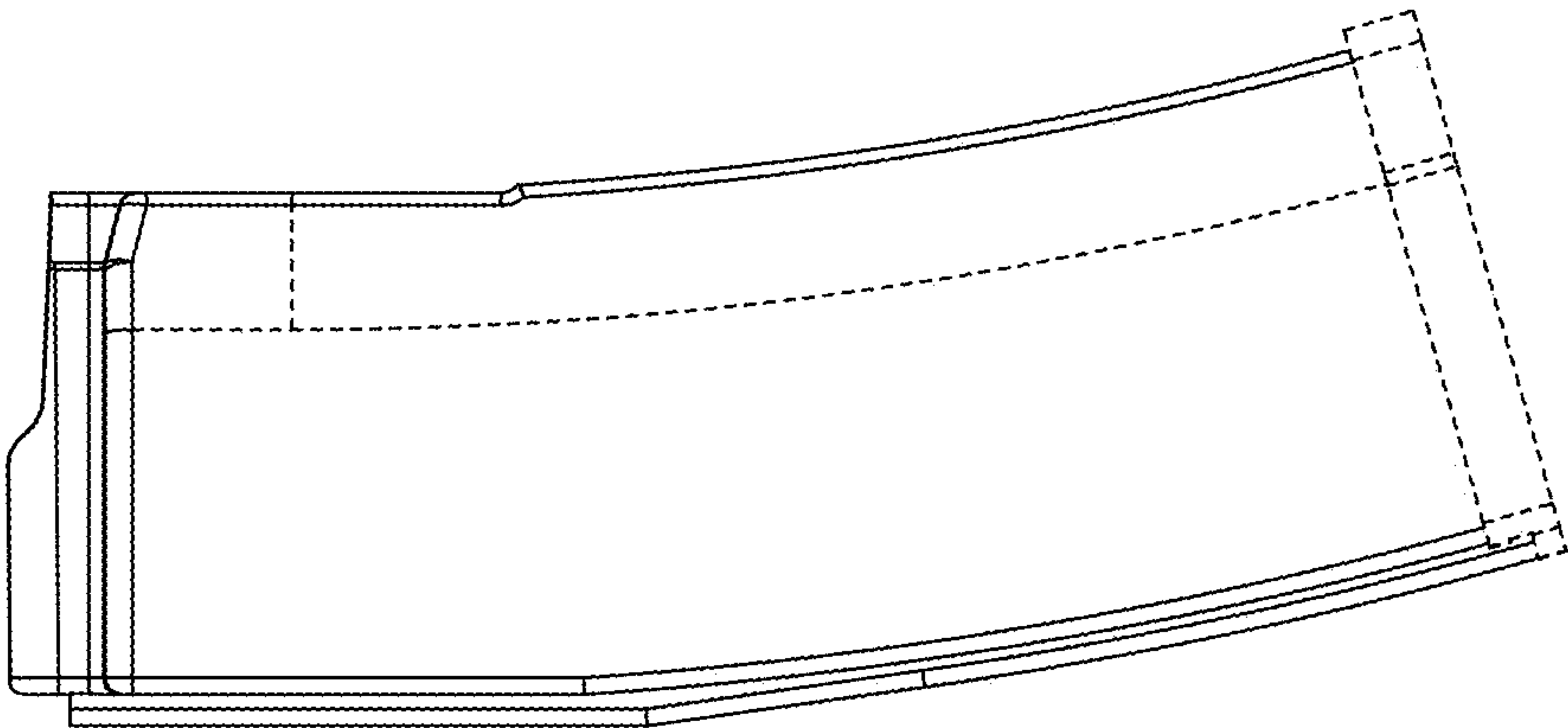

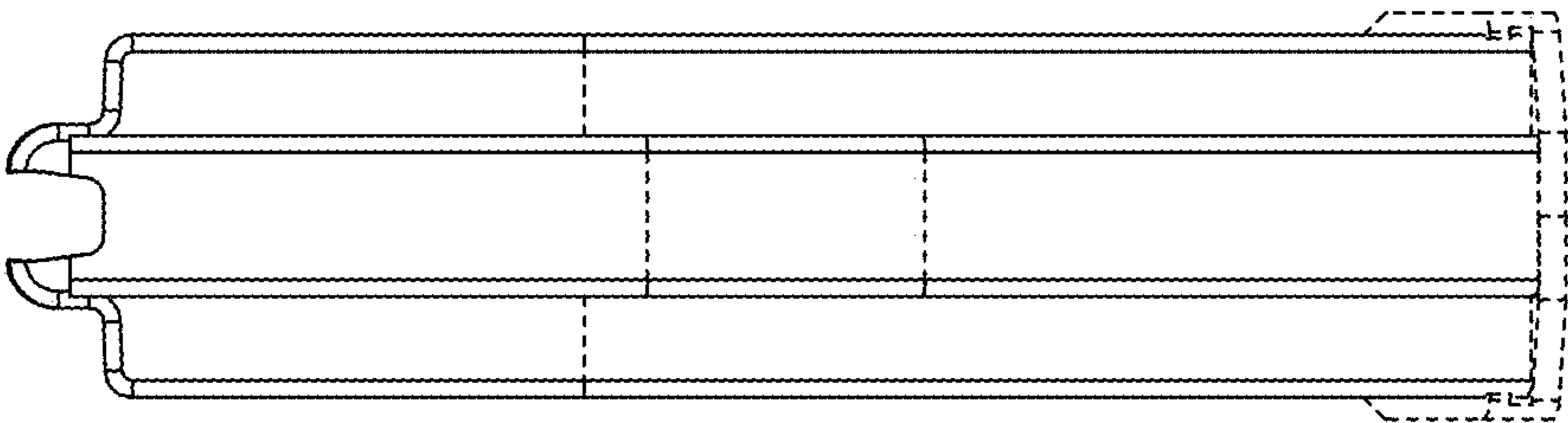

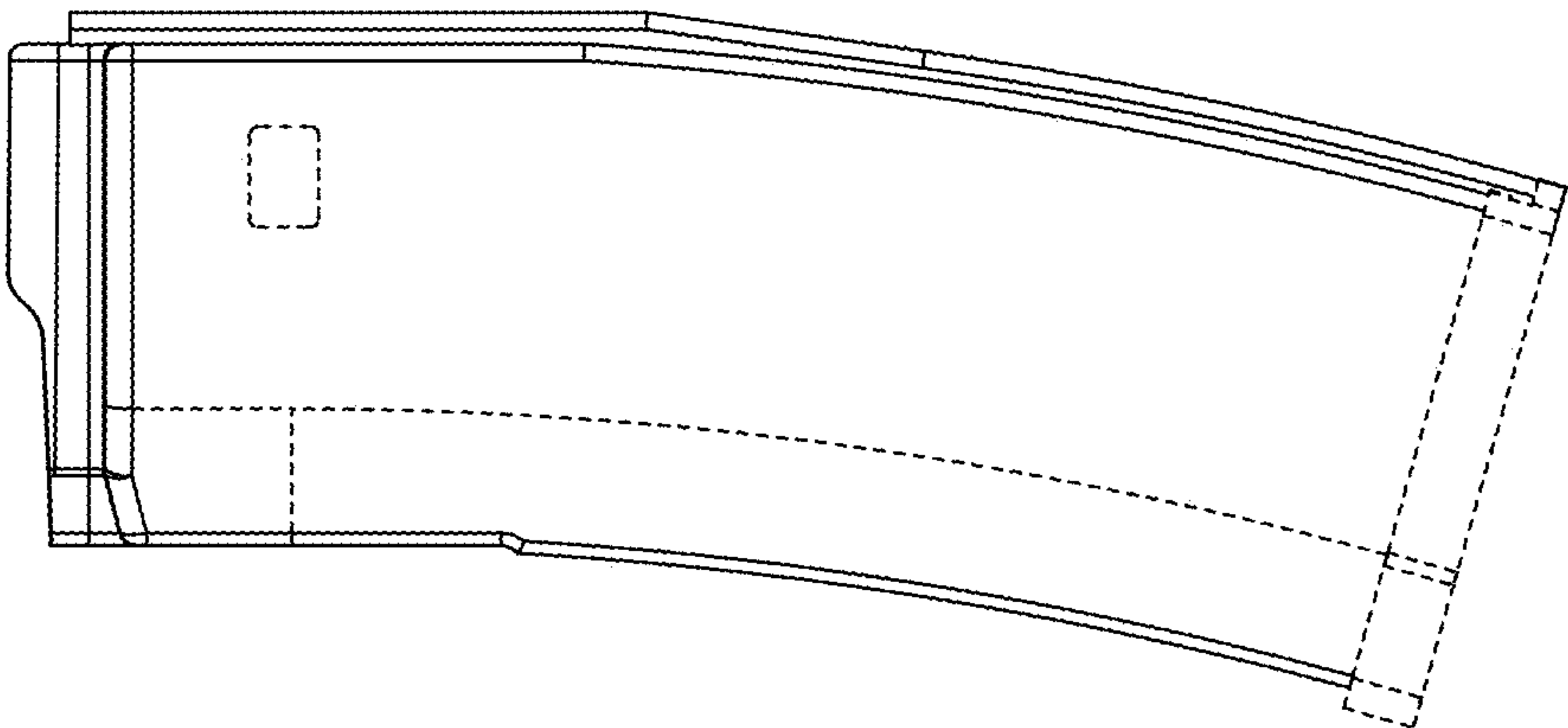

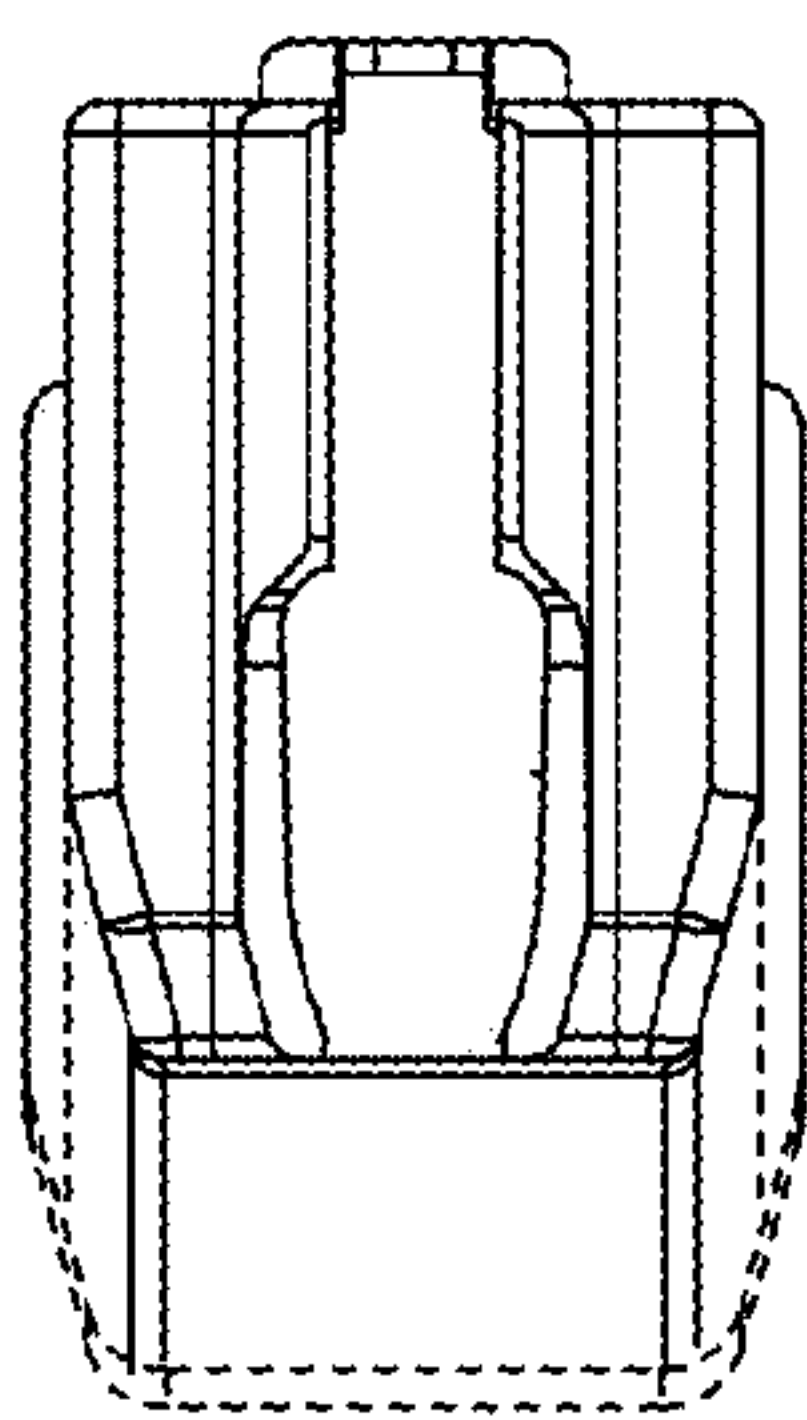

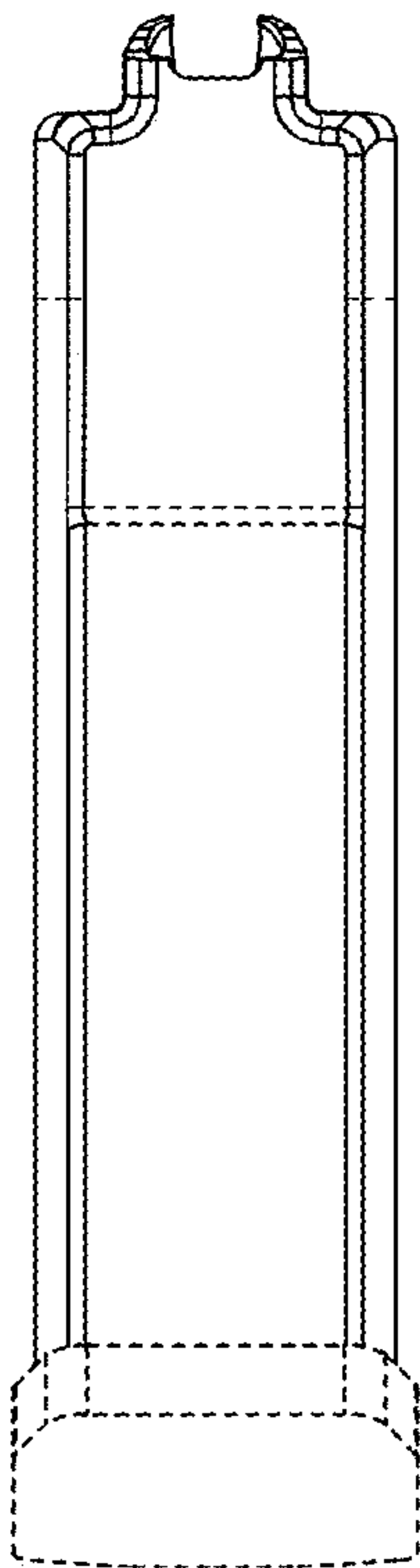

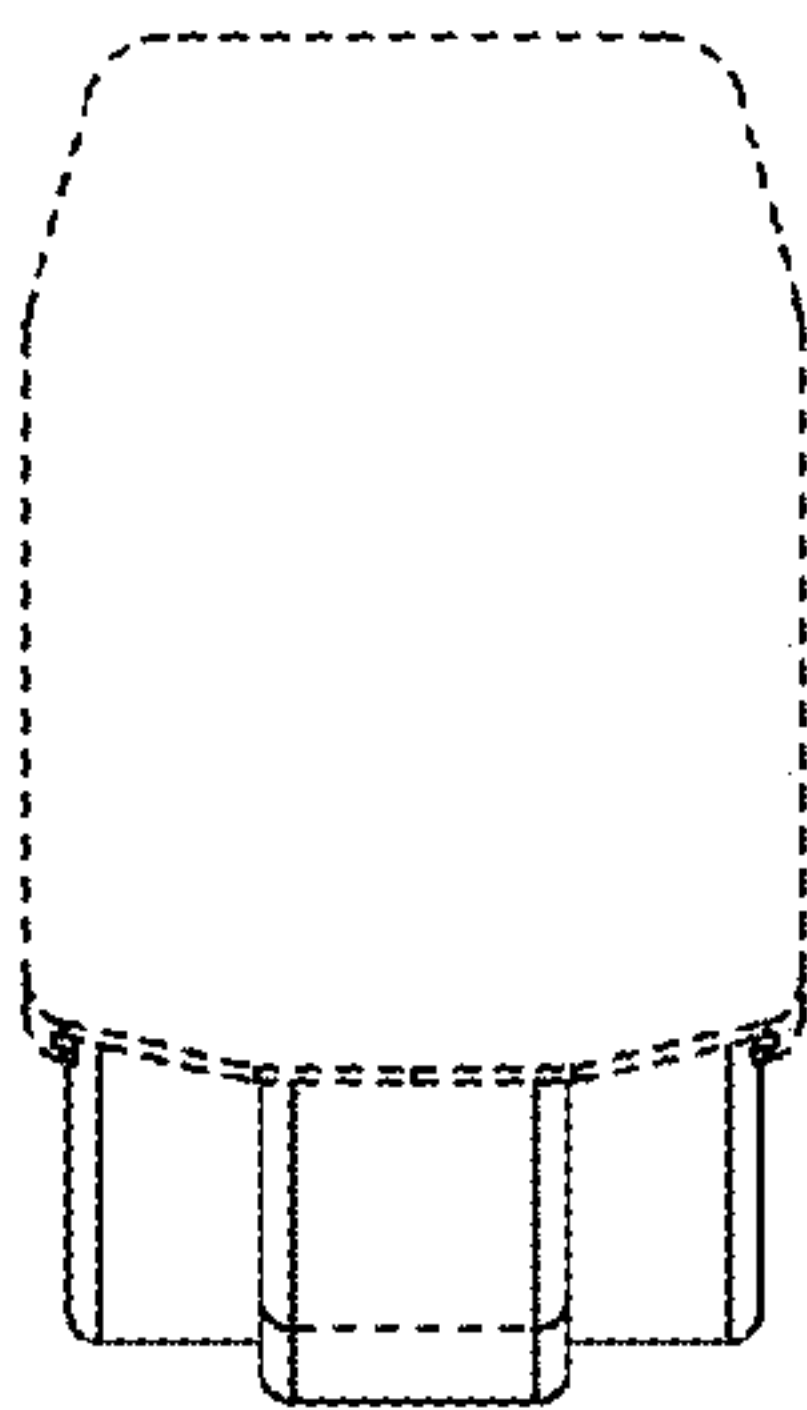
