FIG. 4 is a first side view of the fluid coupling.

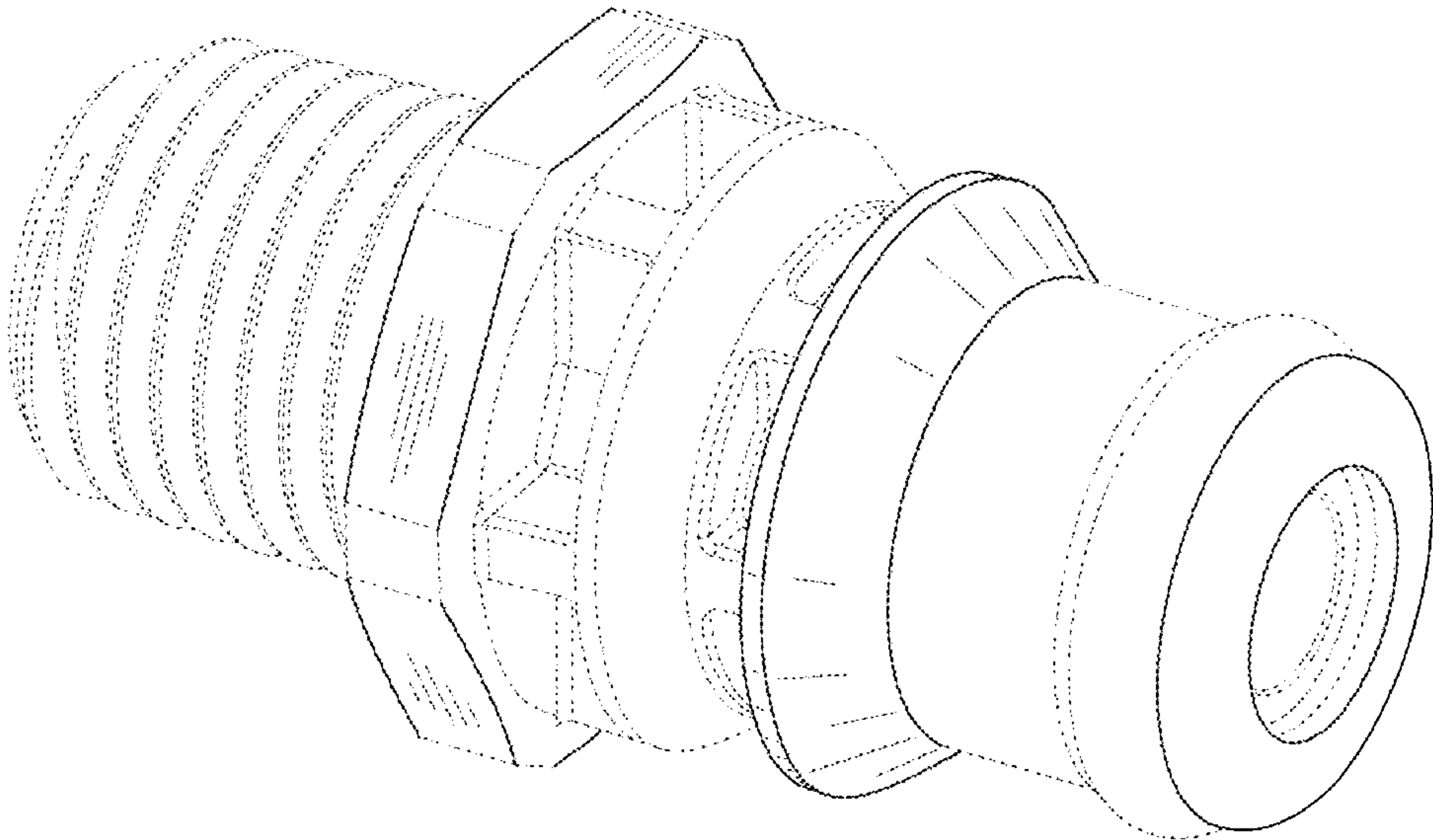
FIG. 5 is a second side view of the fluid coupling.

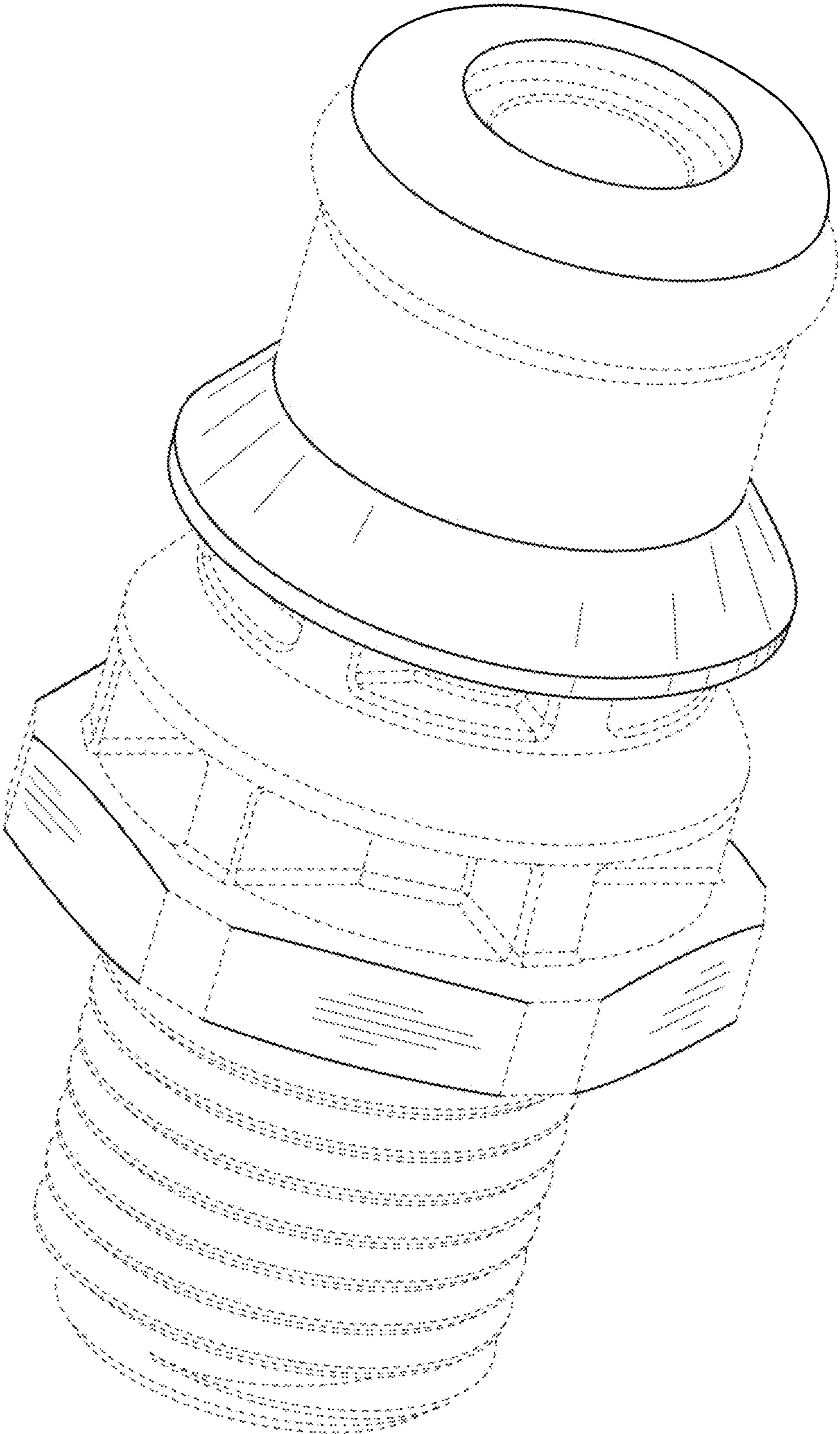

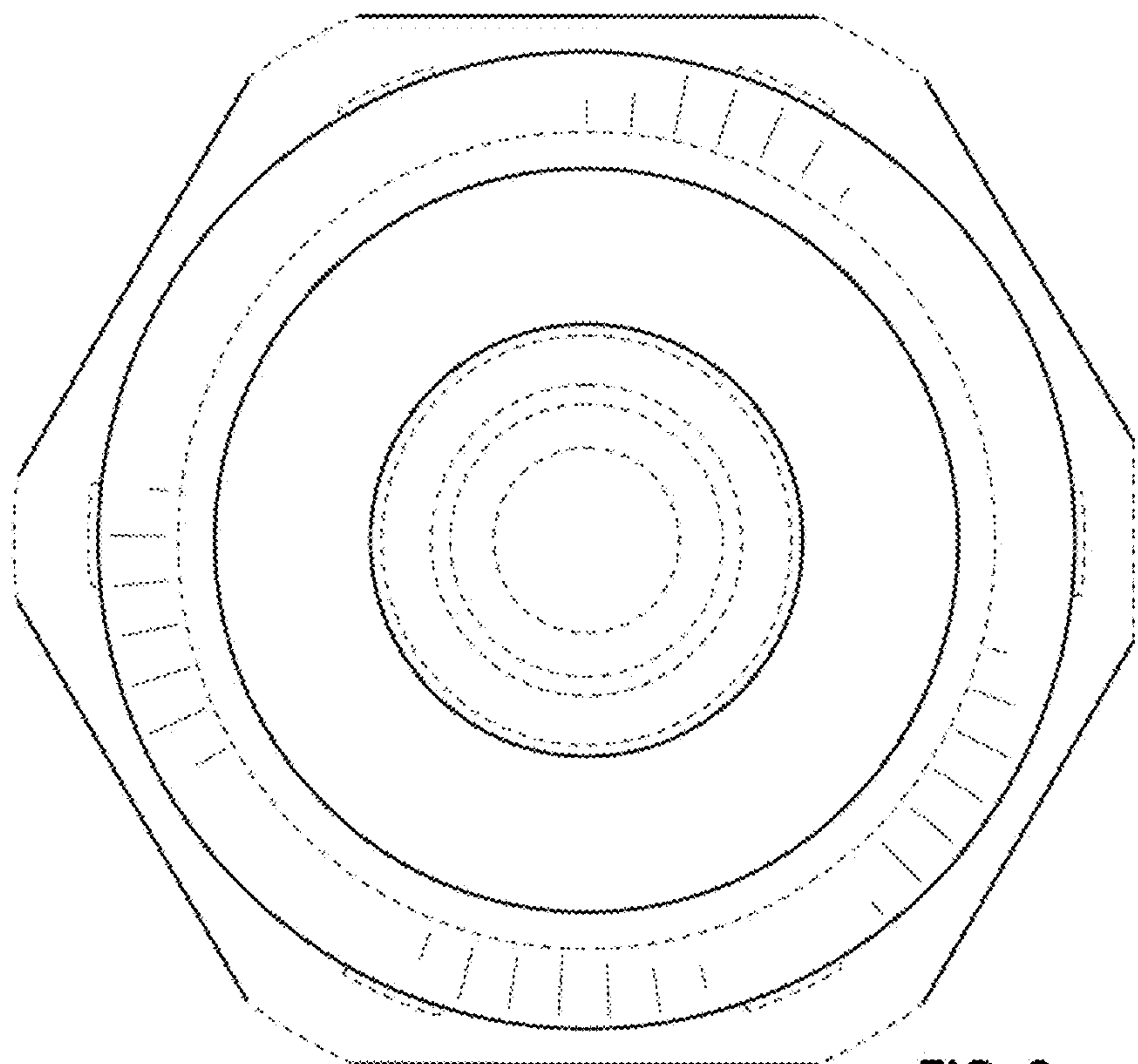

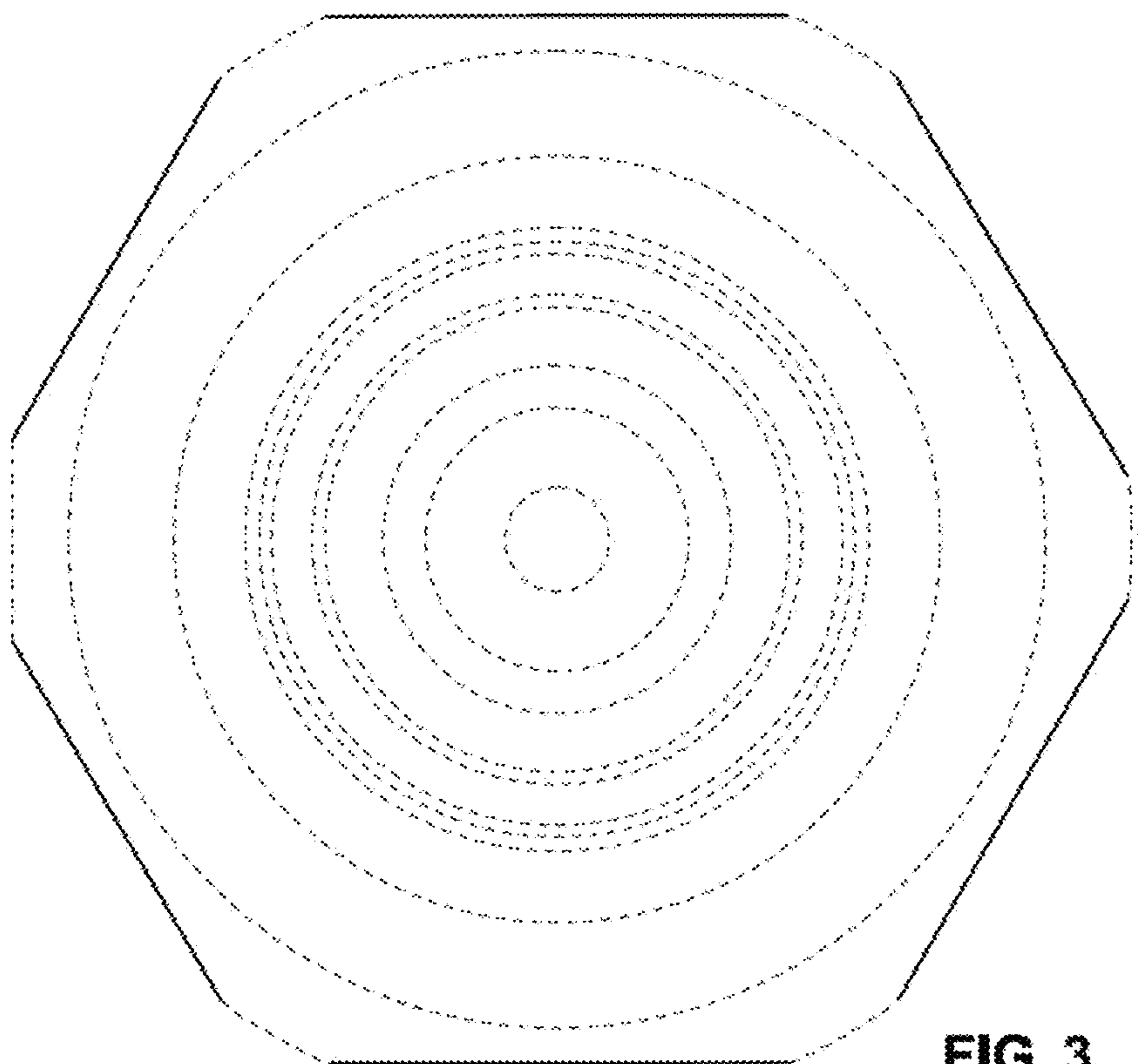

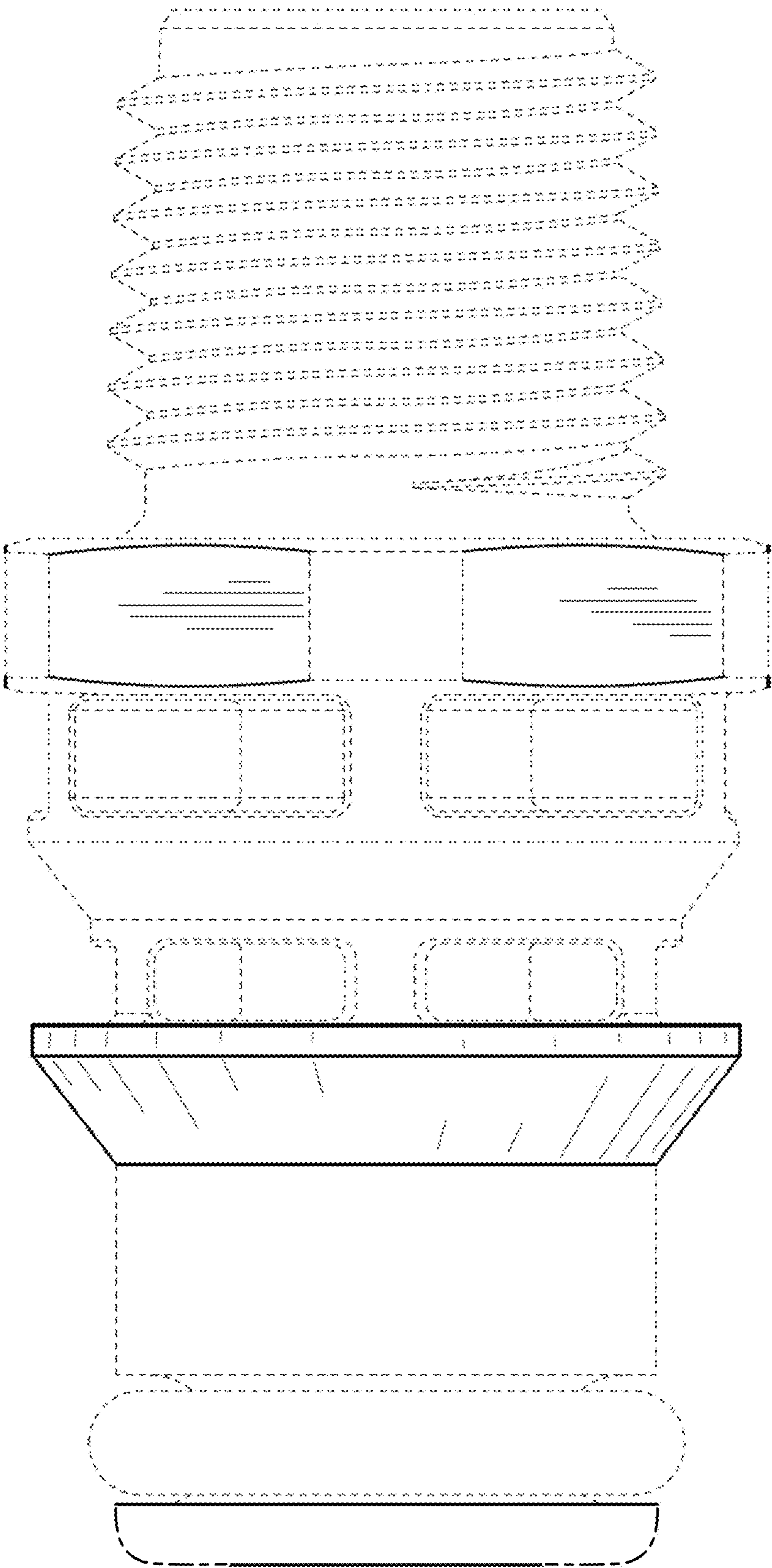

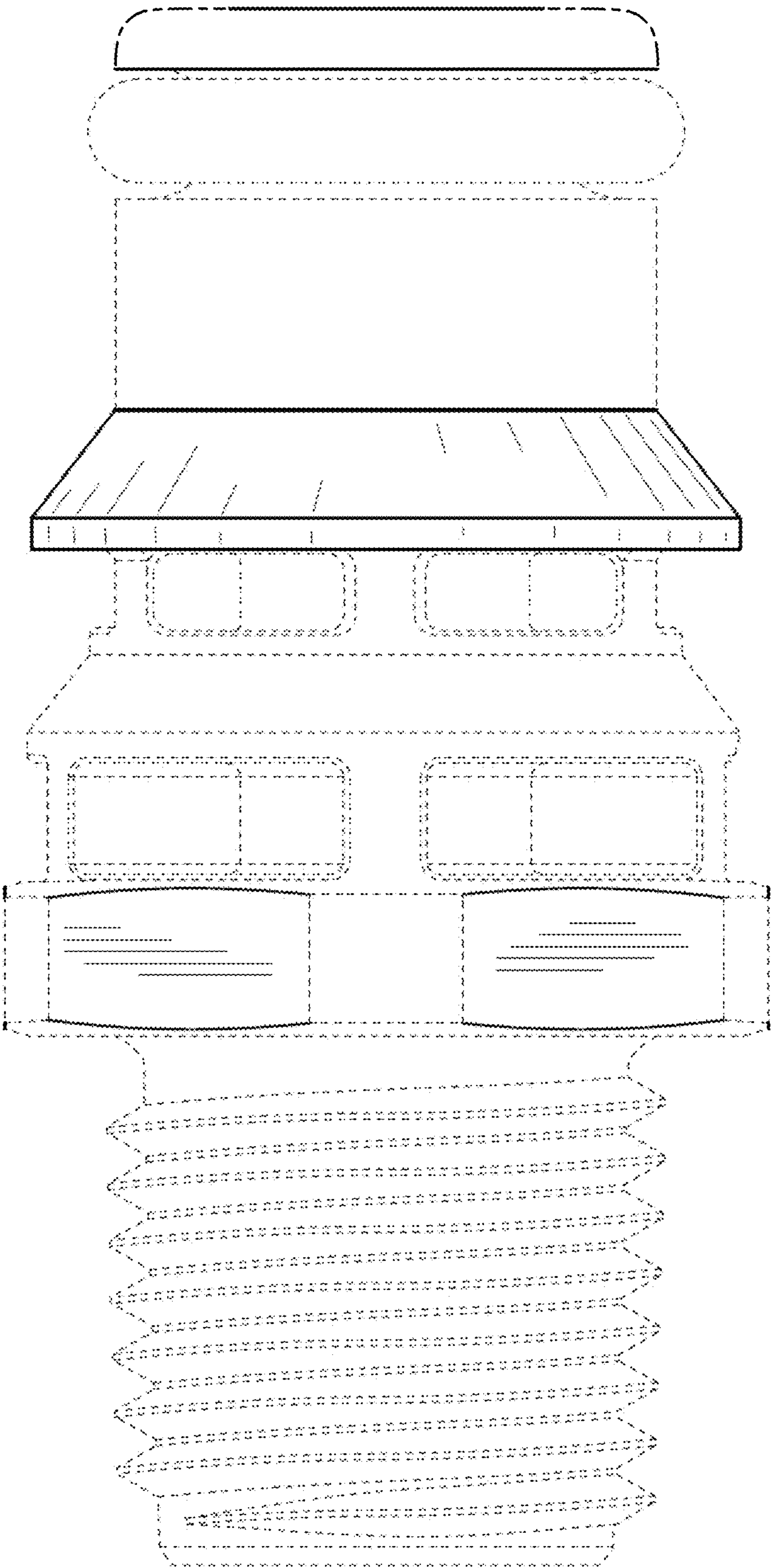

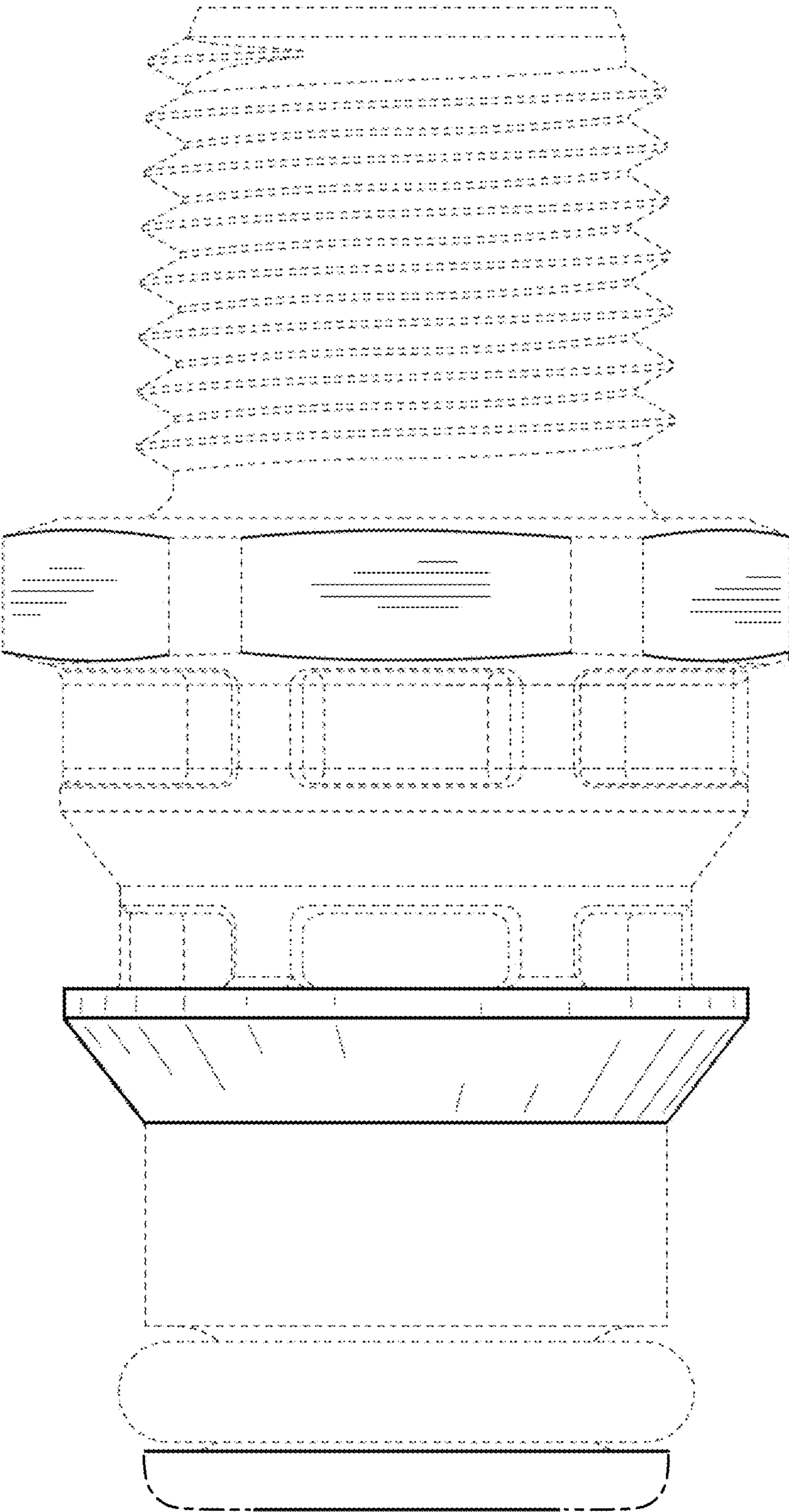

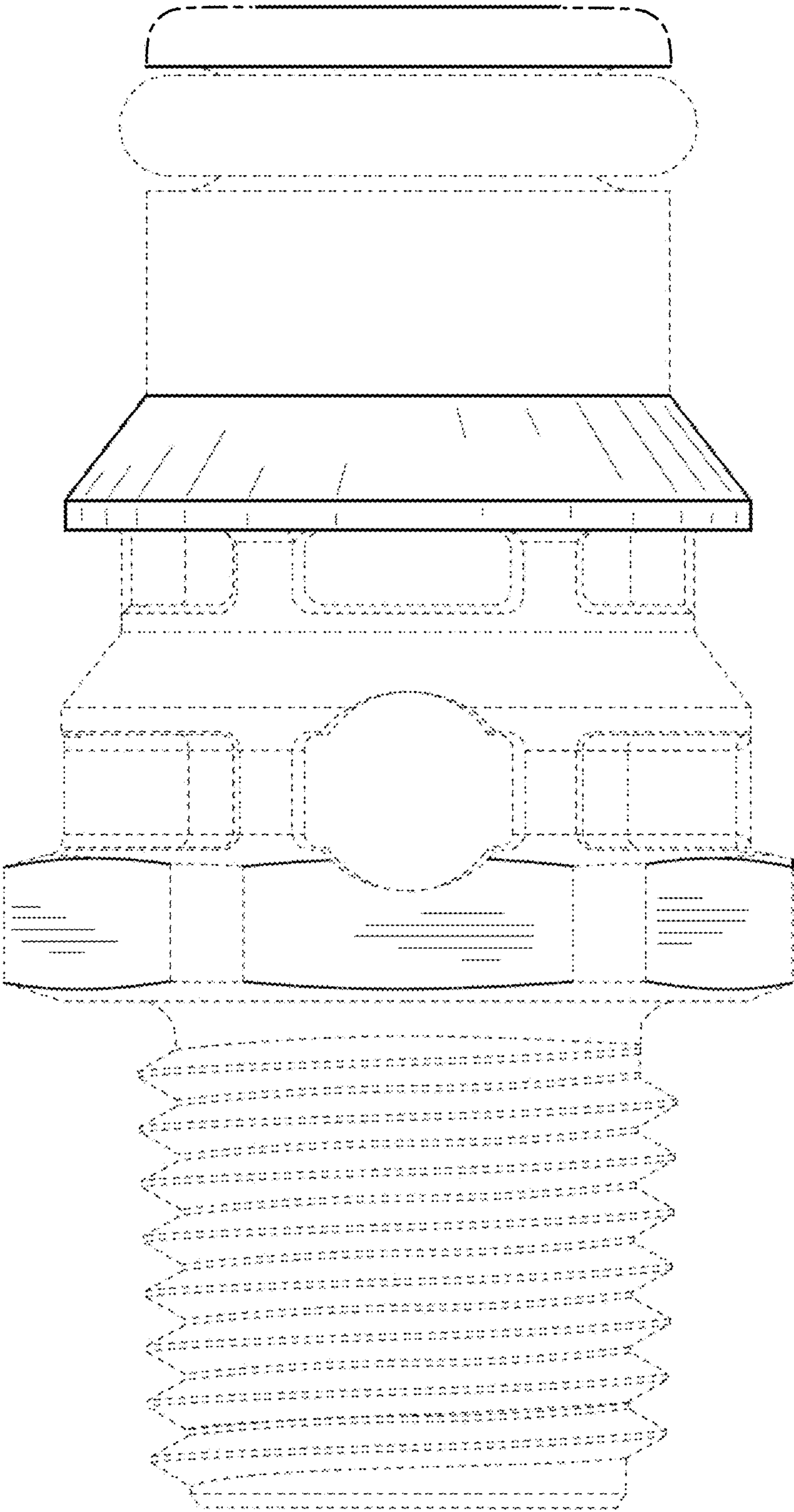
