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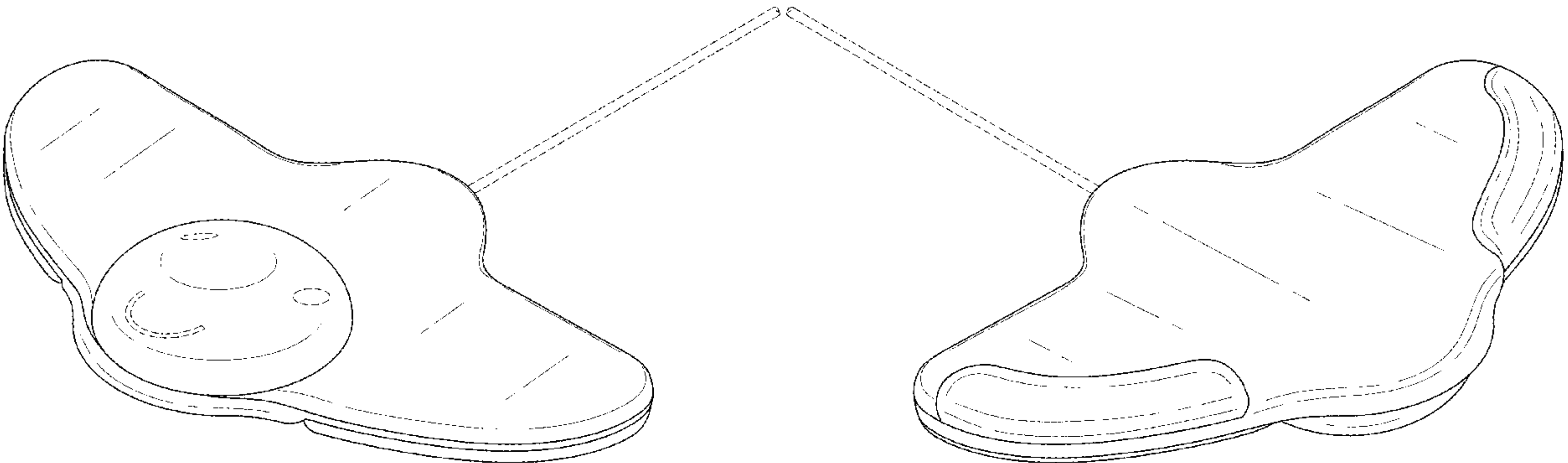
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front top perspective view of the cleaning device showing my design;
FIG. 2 is a front bottom perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is front elevation view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view thereof;

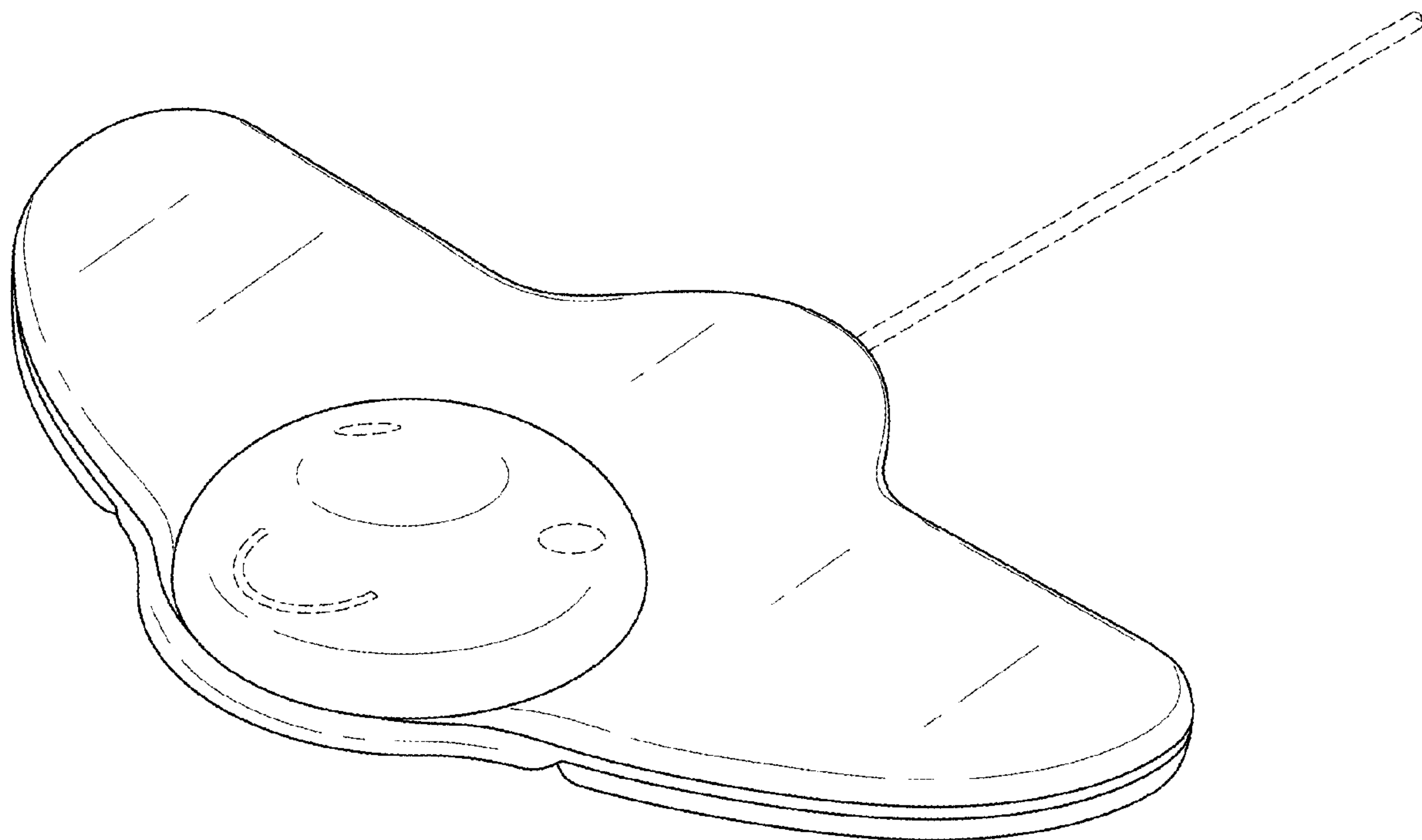

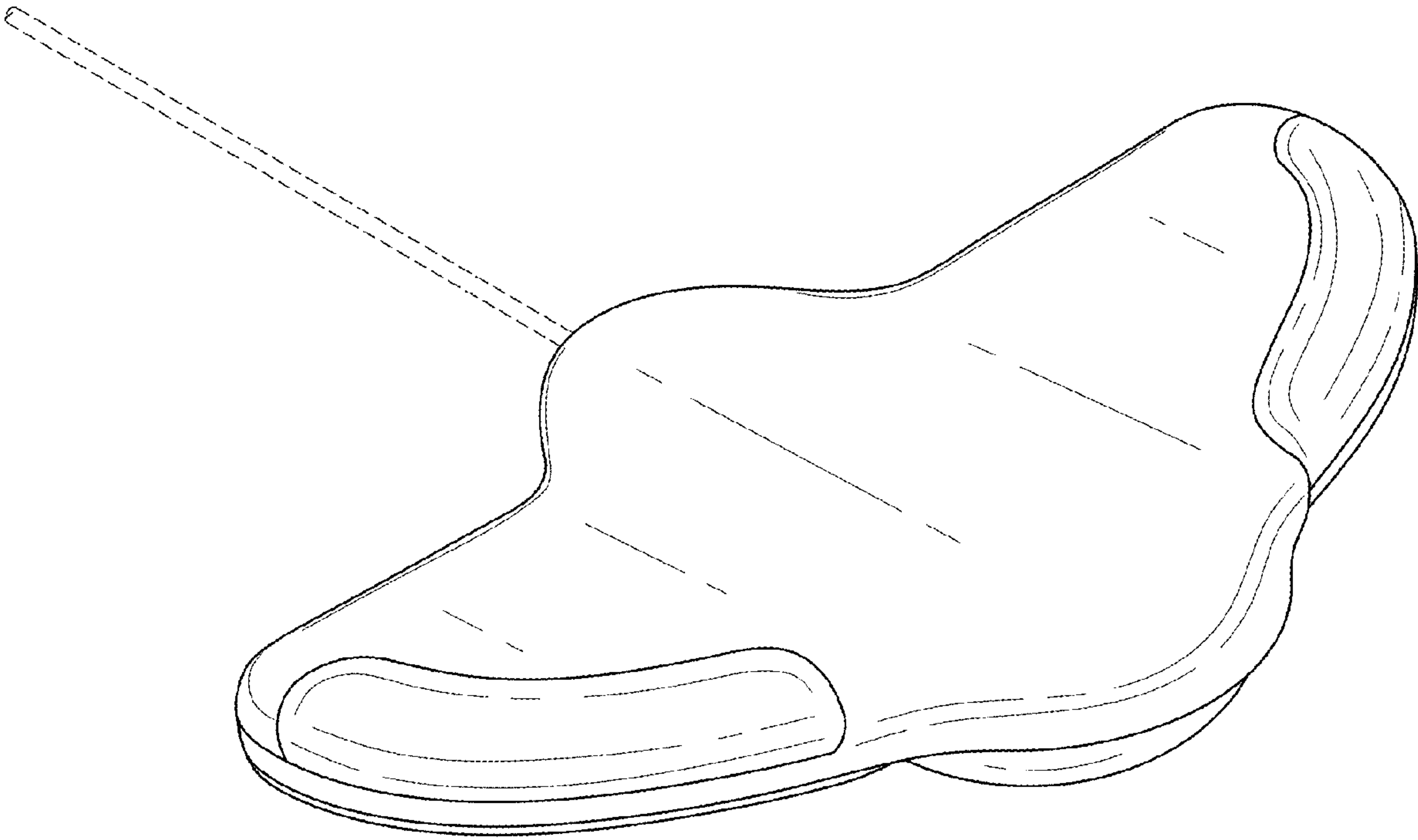

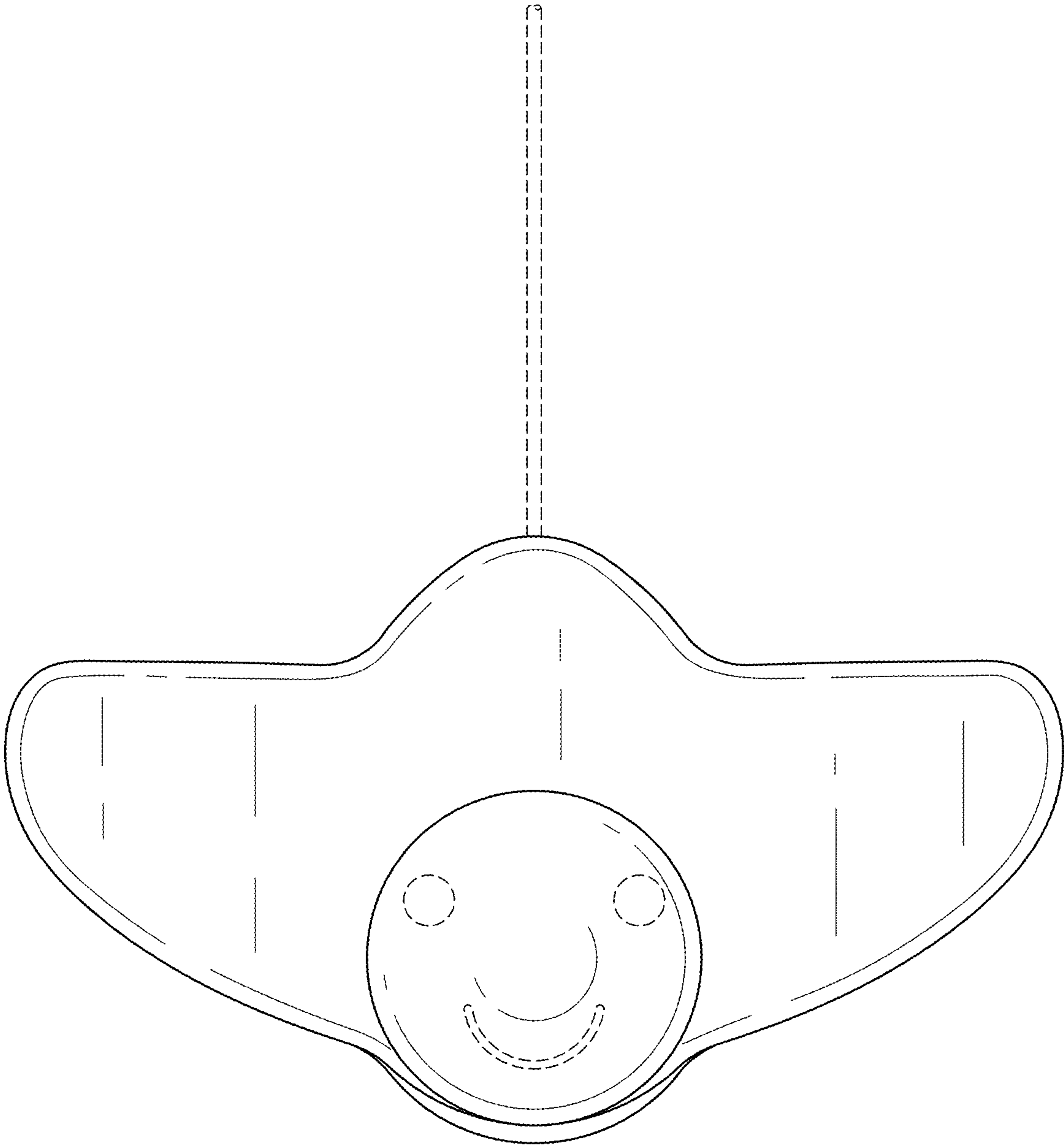

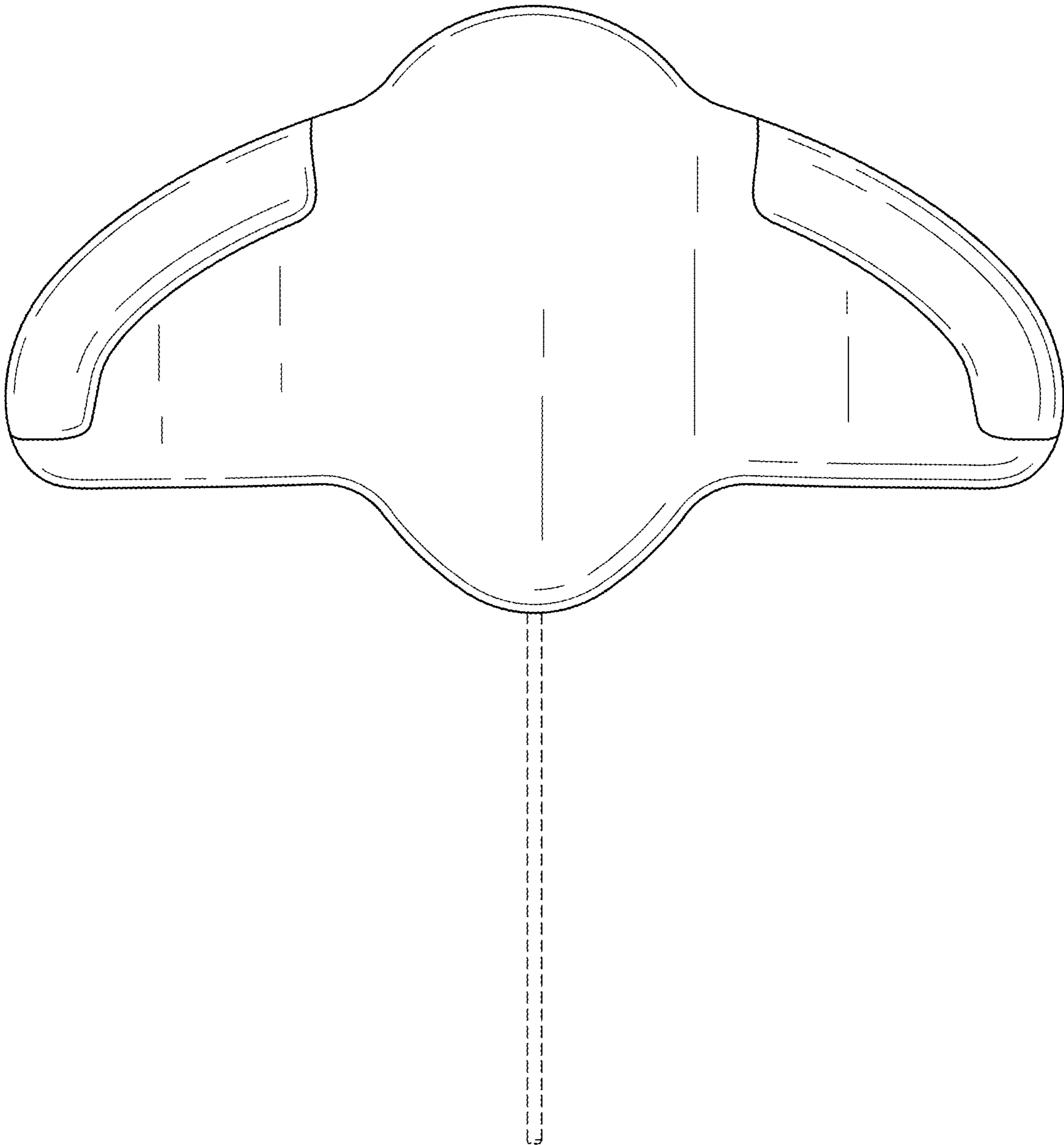

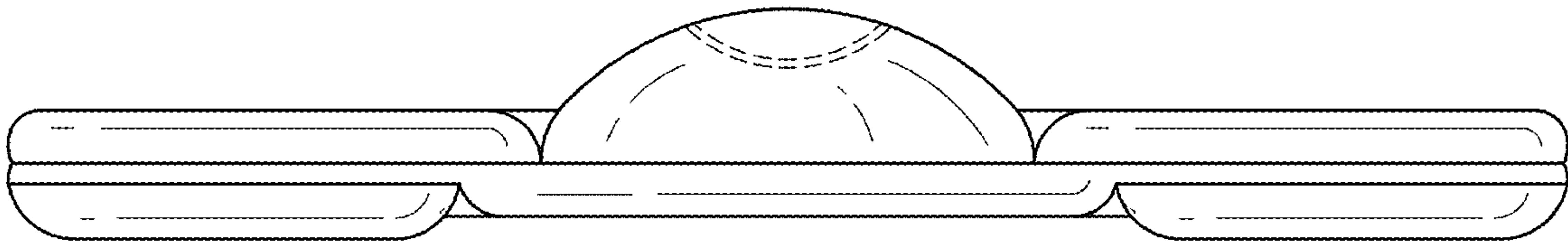

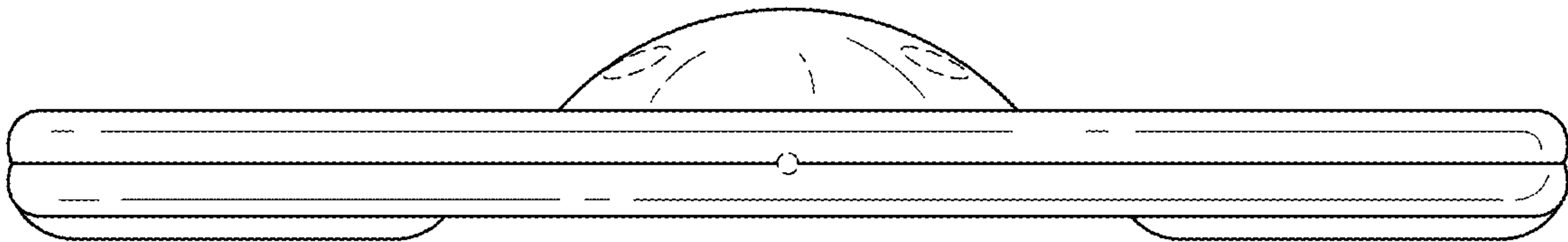

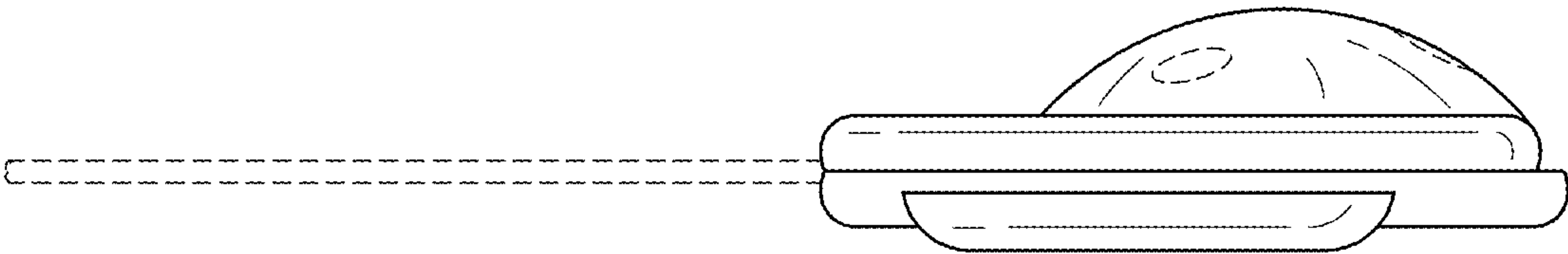

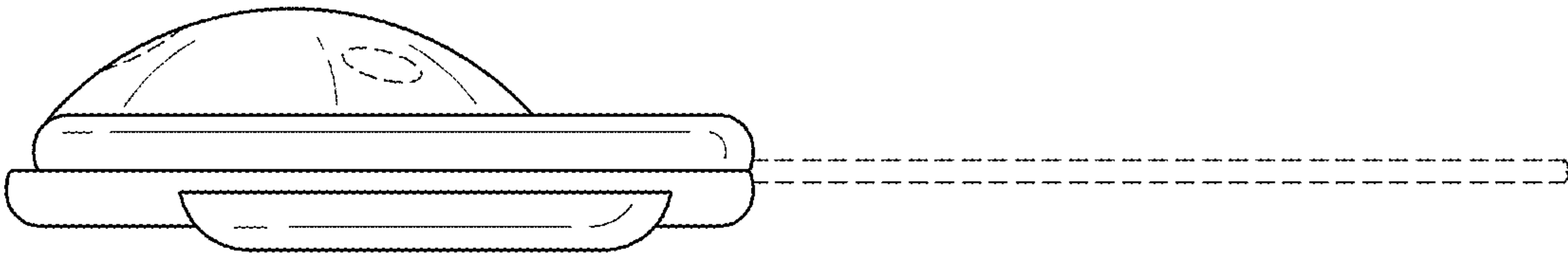
