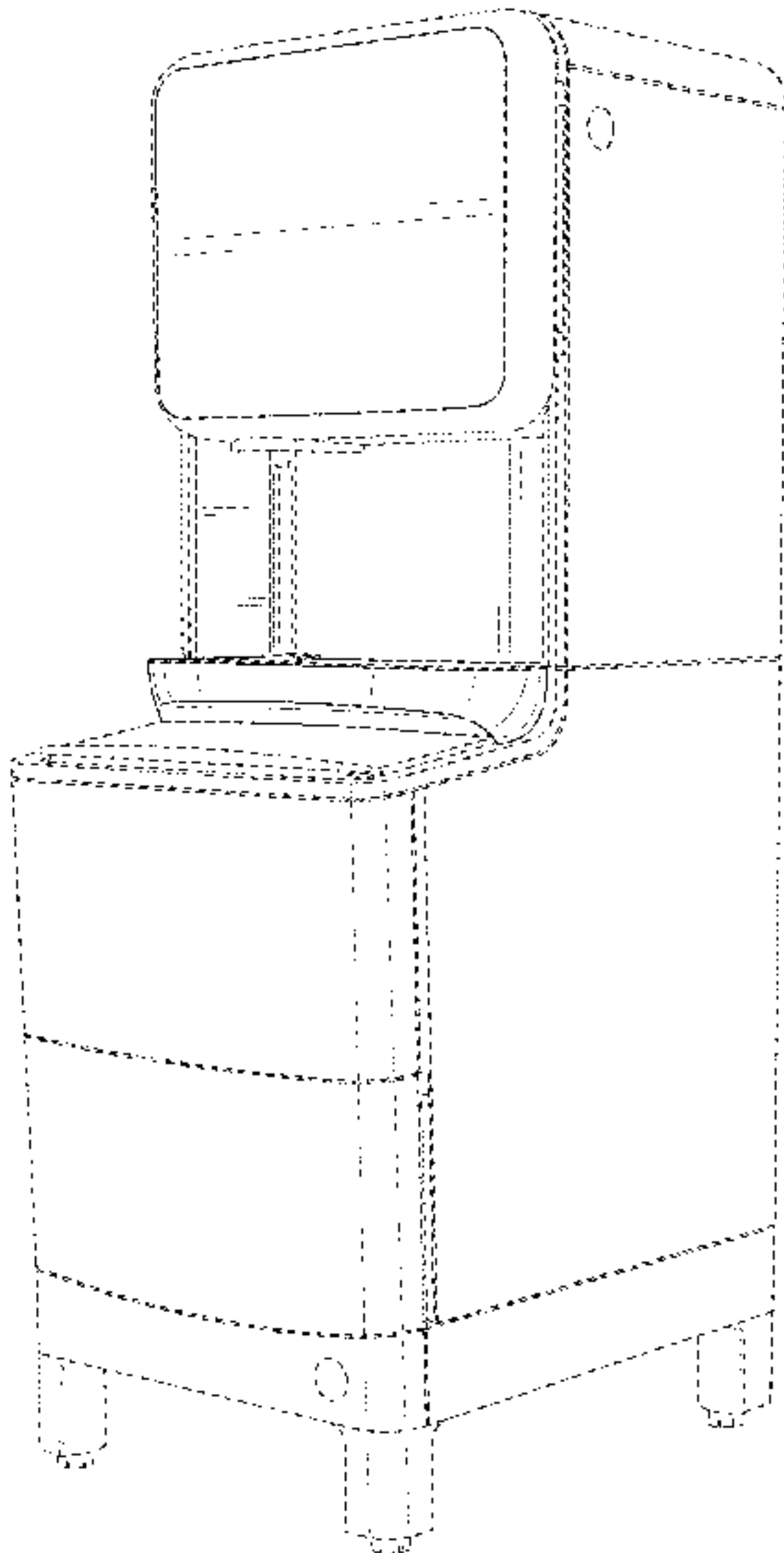
CLAIM

I claim the ornamental design for a beverage dispenser, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a beverage dispenser in accordance with our new design;
FIG. 2 is a second perspective view thereof
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a back elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a first side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a second side elevational view thereof; and,

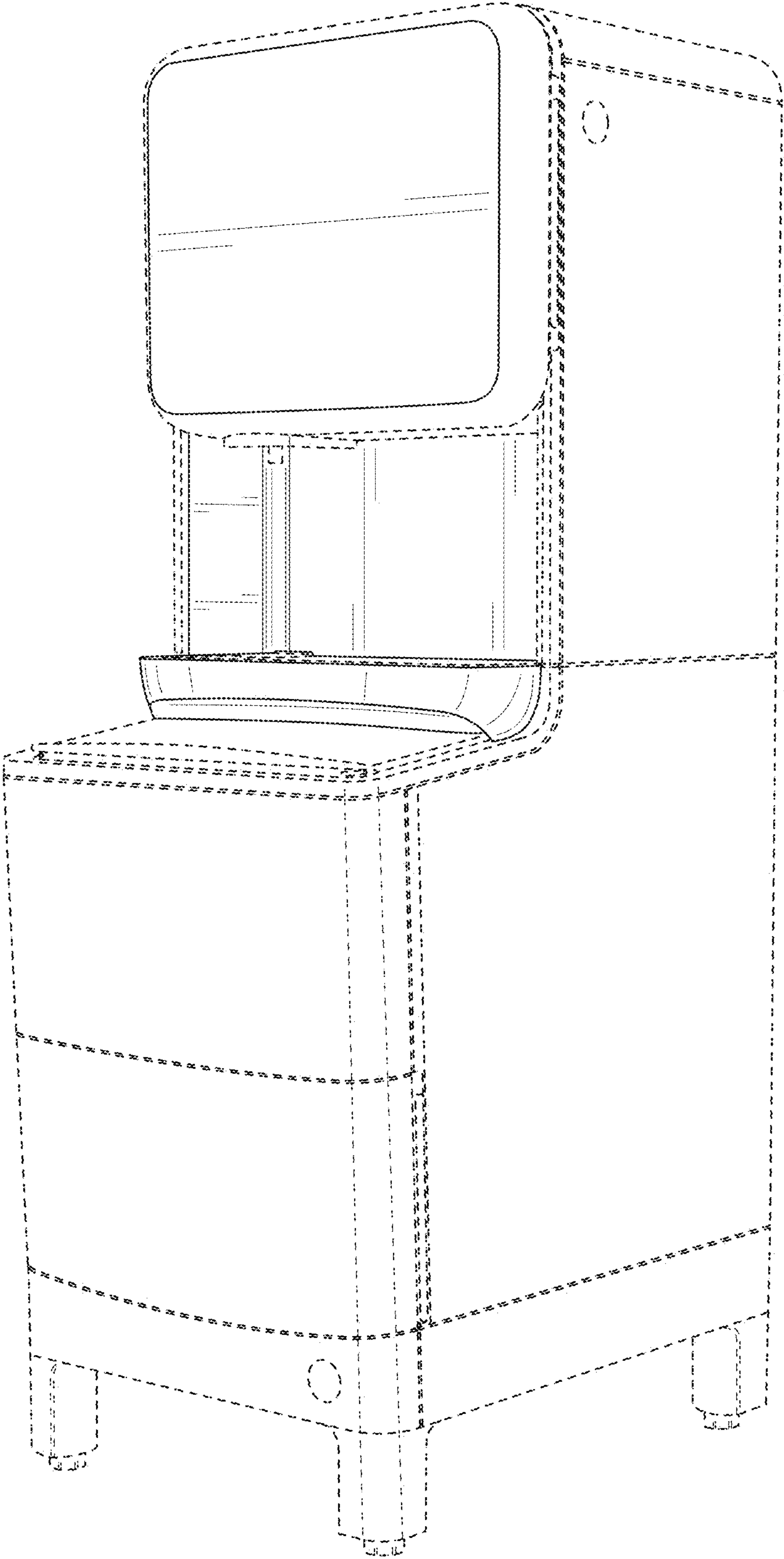

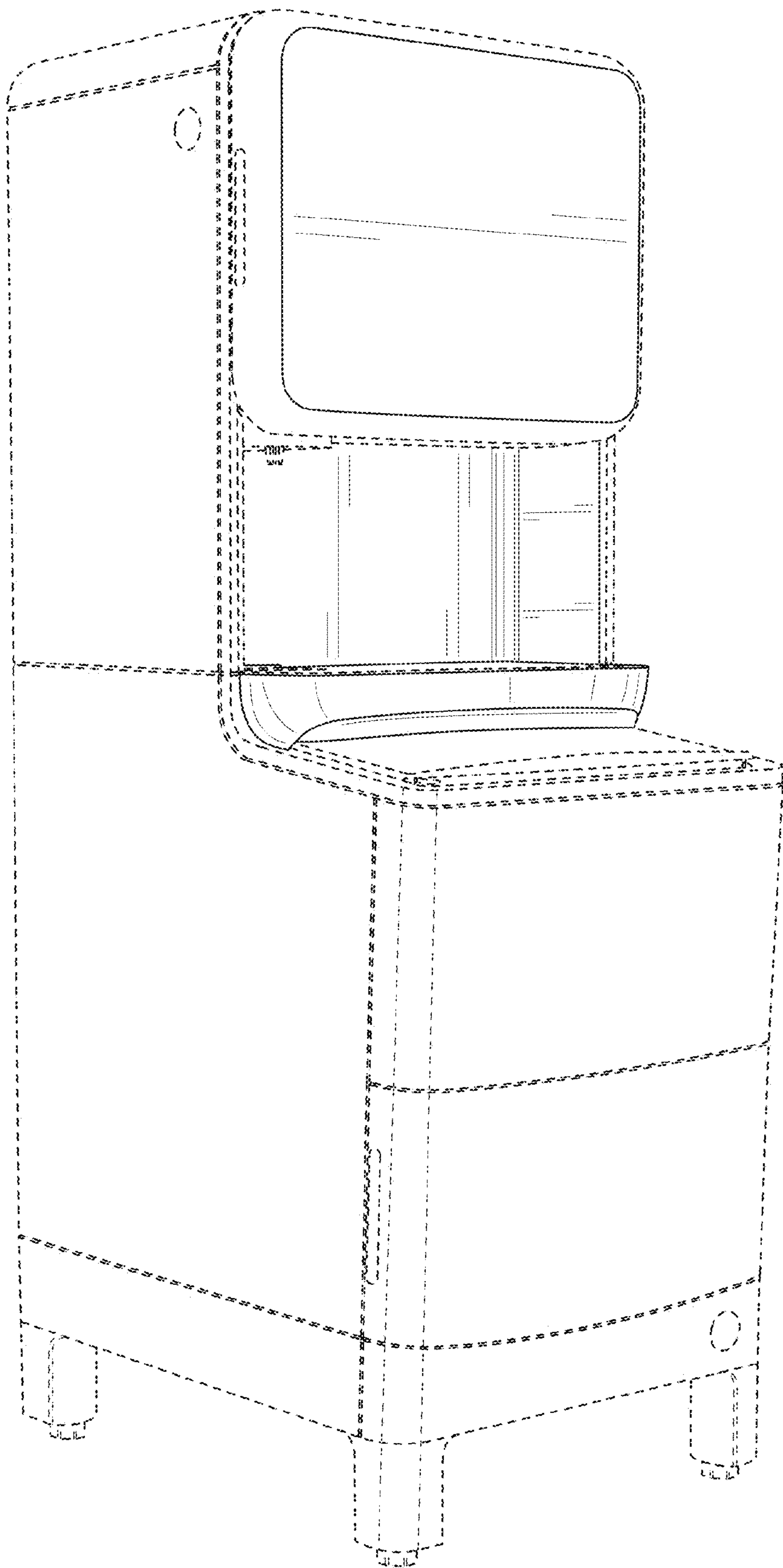

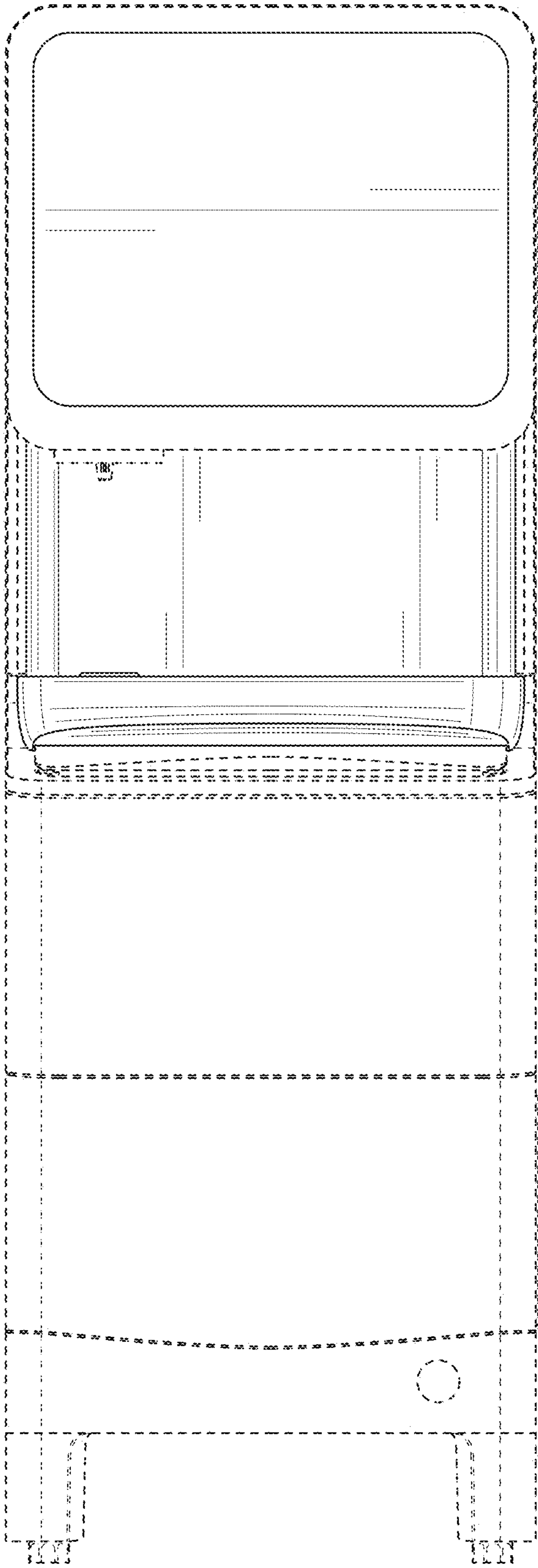

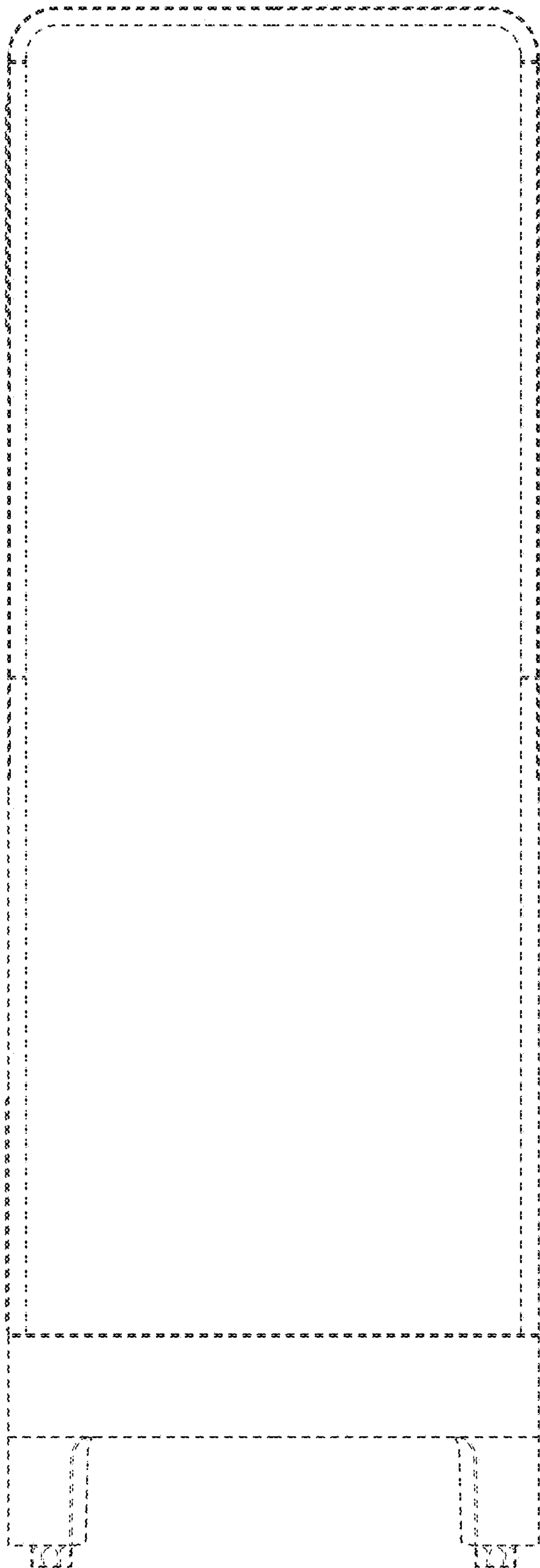

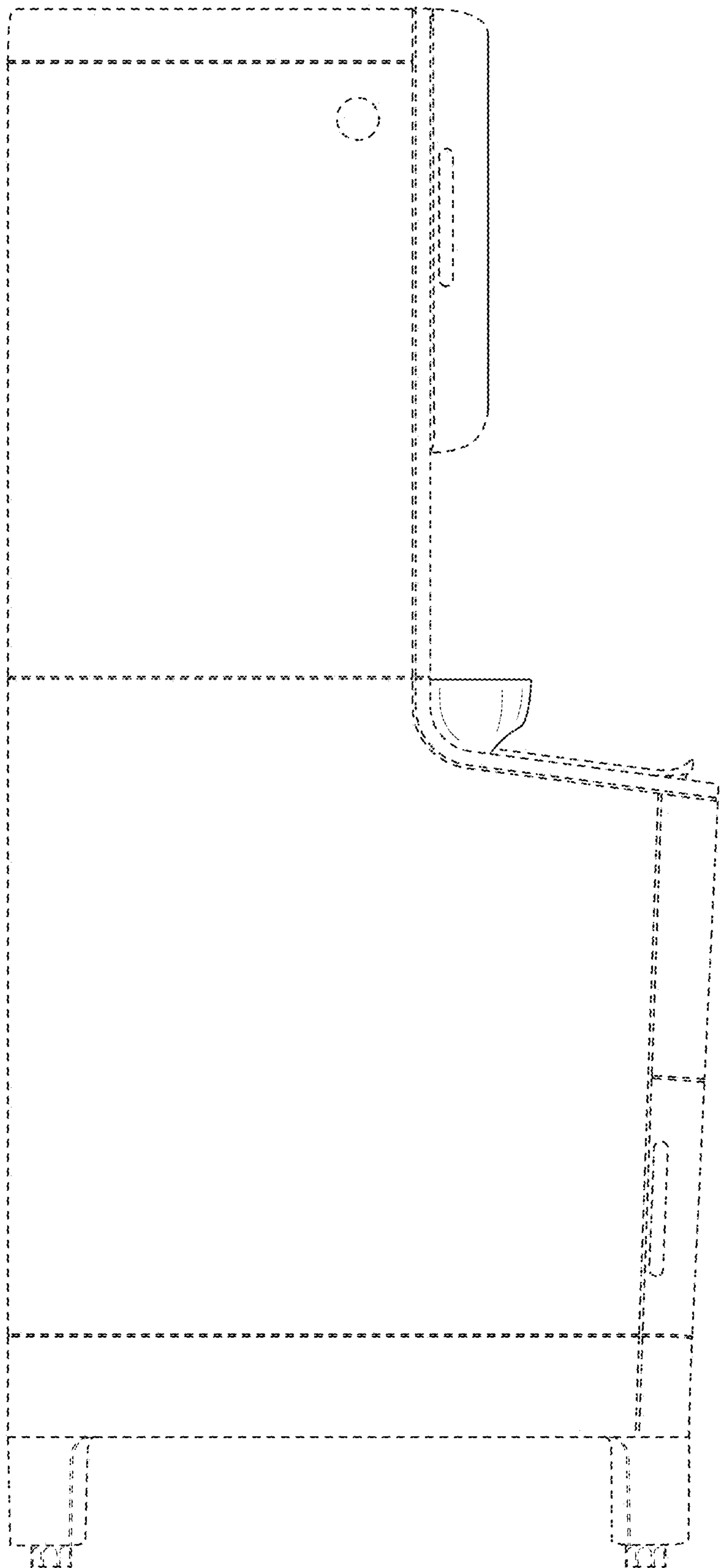

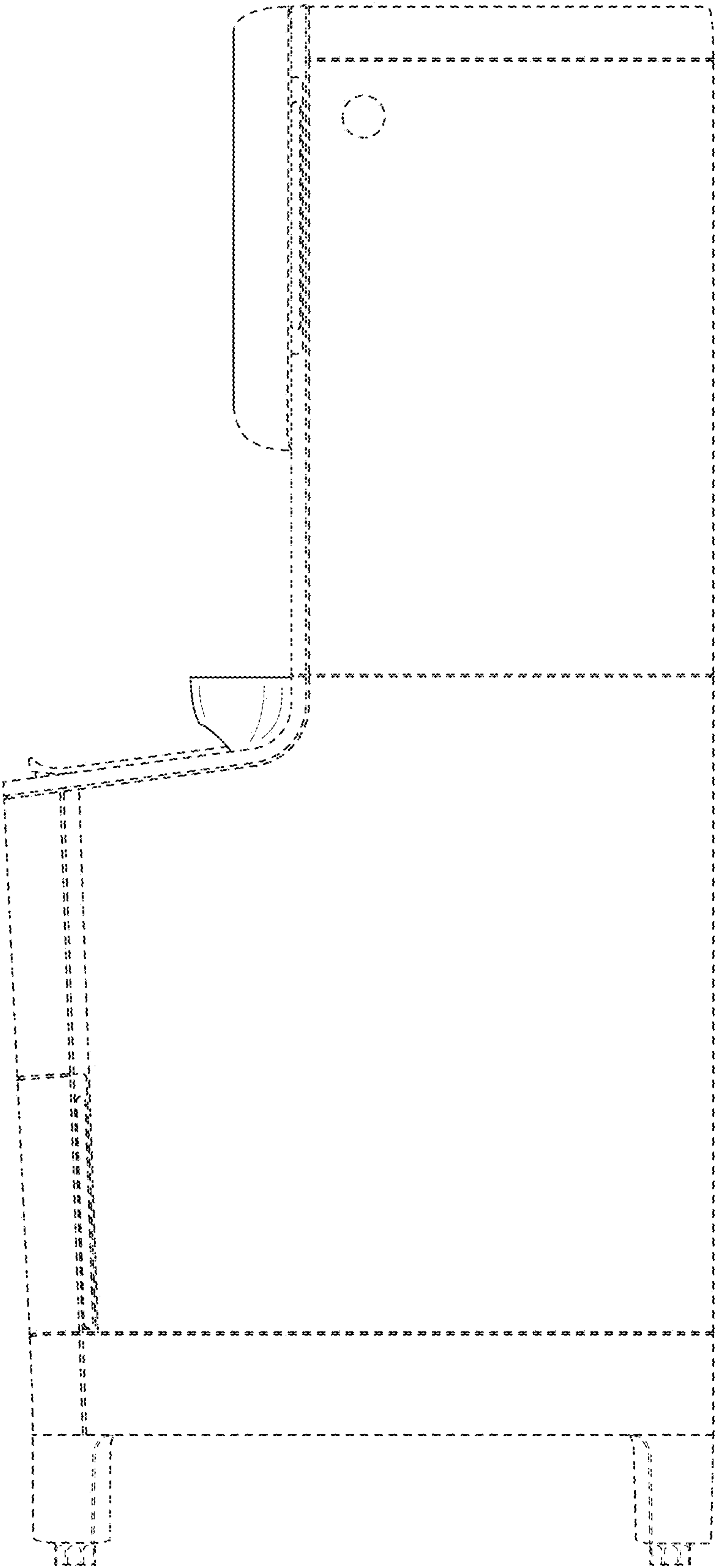

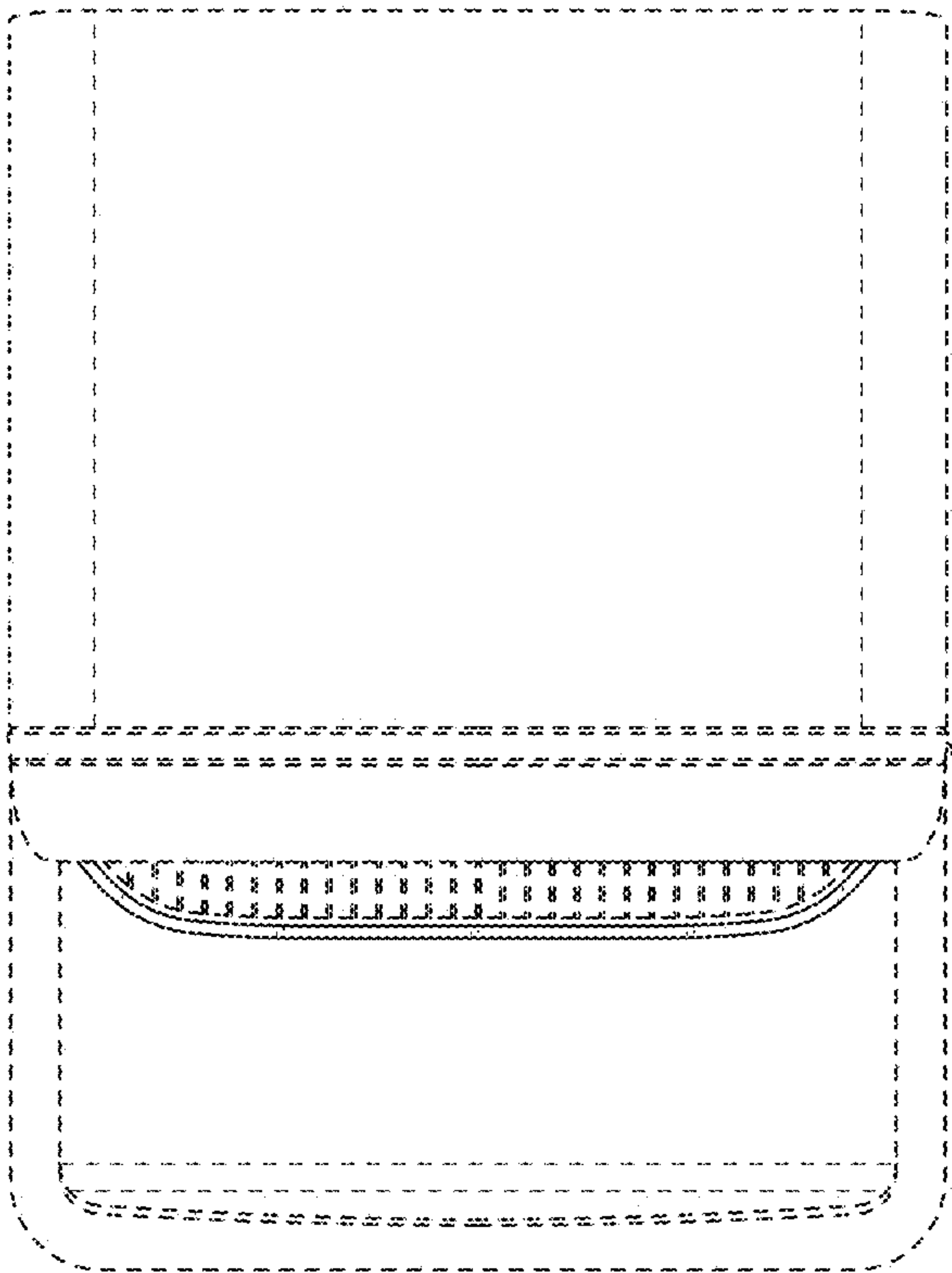
