I claim the ornamental design for a bra, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a bra as shown in a position of use;

FIG. 2 is a front view of the bra;

FIG. 3 is a back view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side view thereof;

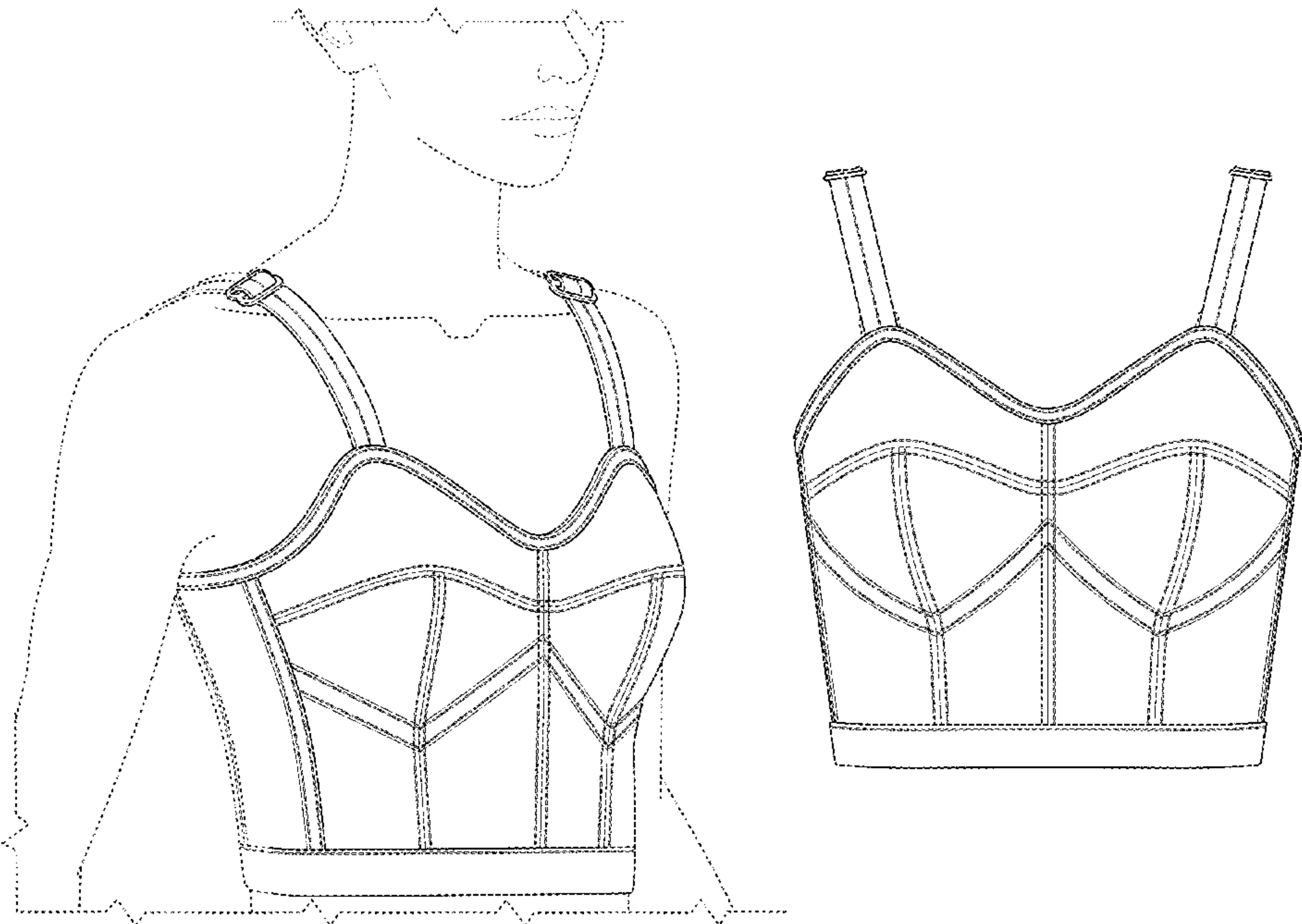
FIG. 6 is a top view thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof.

The broken line outline of the partial human figure in the view of FIG. 1 assists in illustrating how the bra may appear when in a position of use, but forms no part of the claimed design. The thin even length broken lines and thicker even length broken lines depict portions of the bra that form no part of the claimed design.

The ornate oblong shaped features that run in a trajectory forming broken lines along the front surfaces of the bra do form a part of the claimed design.

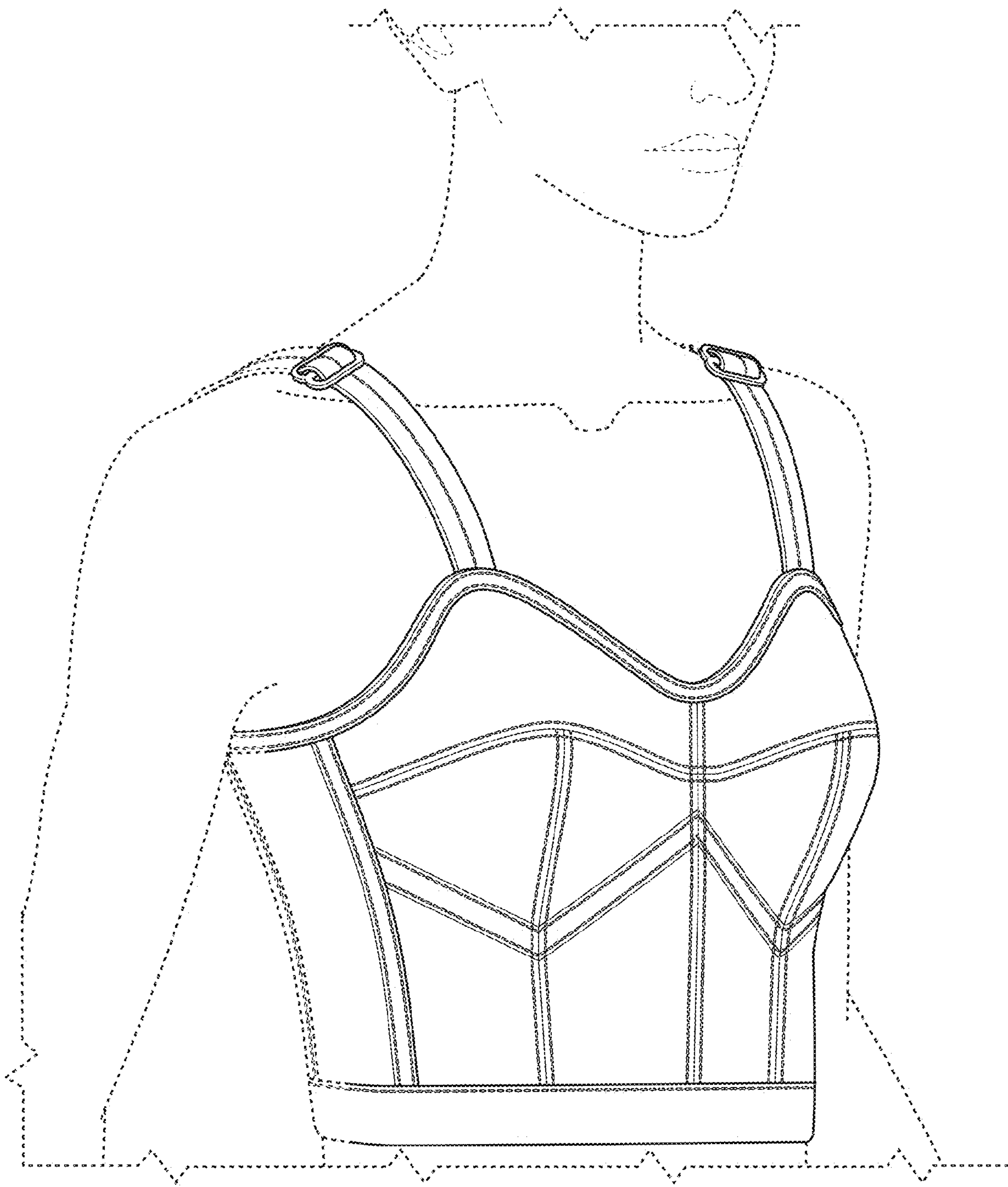

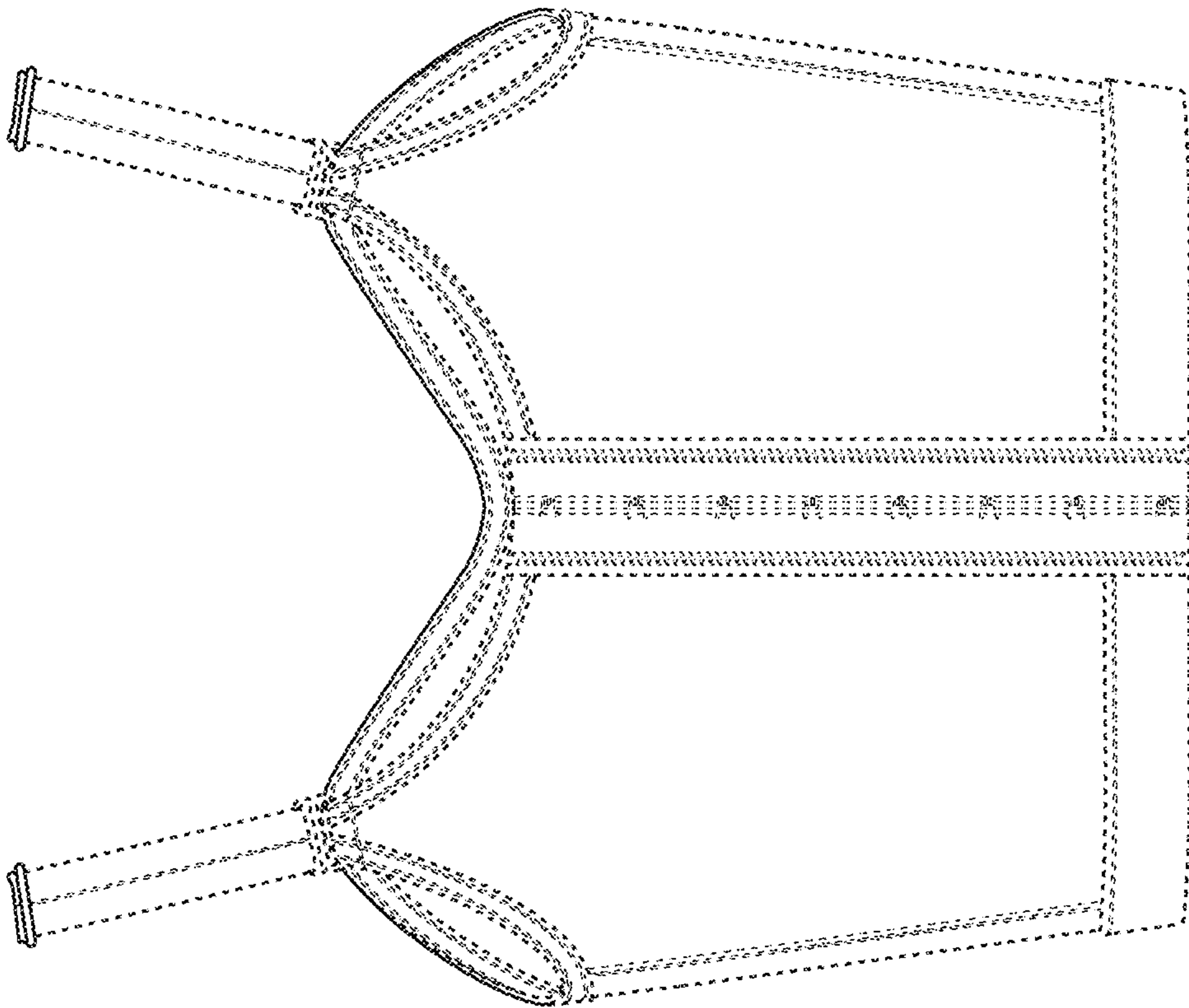

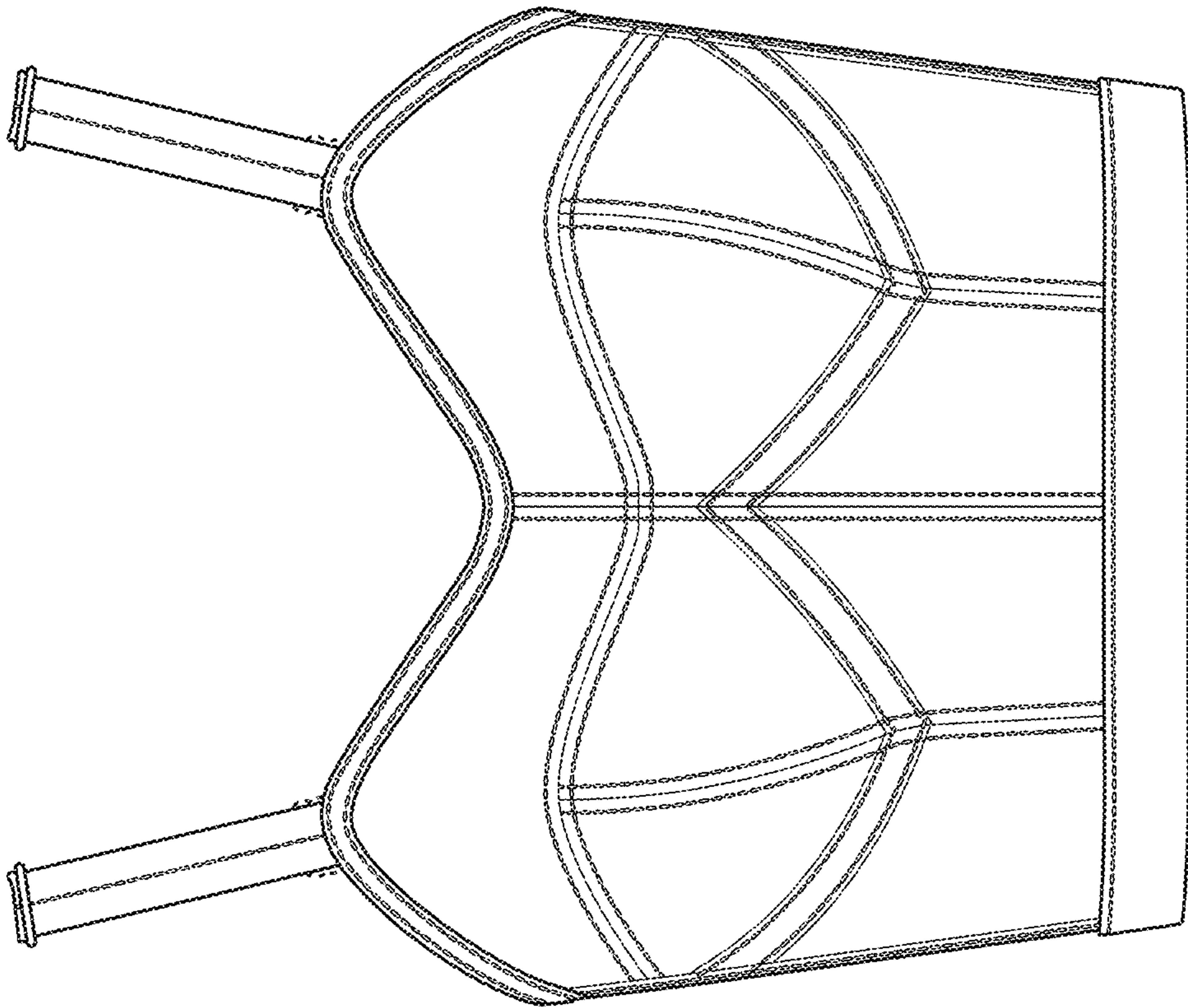

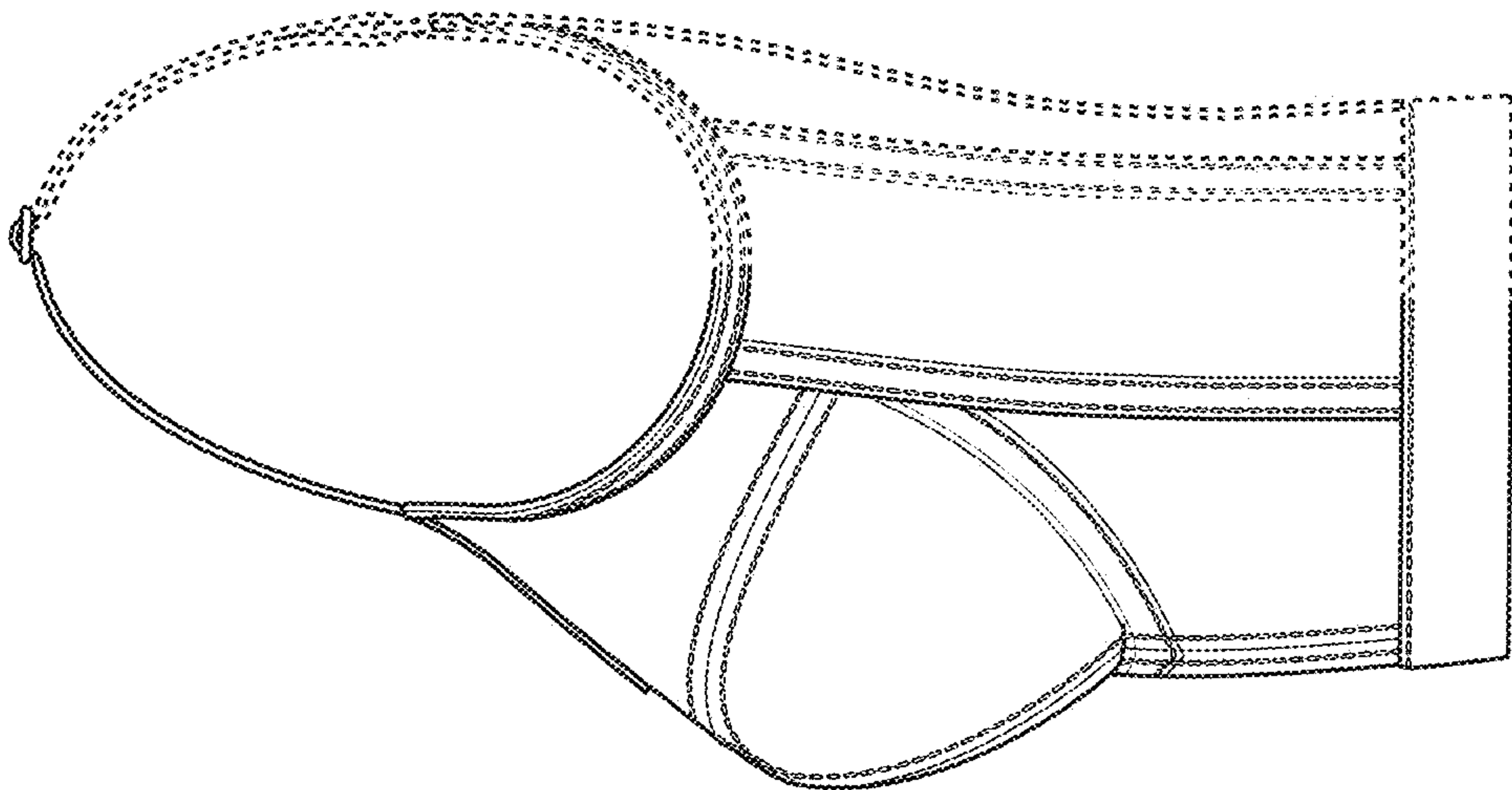

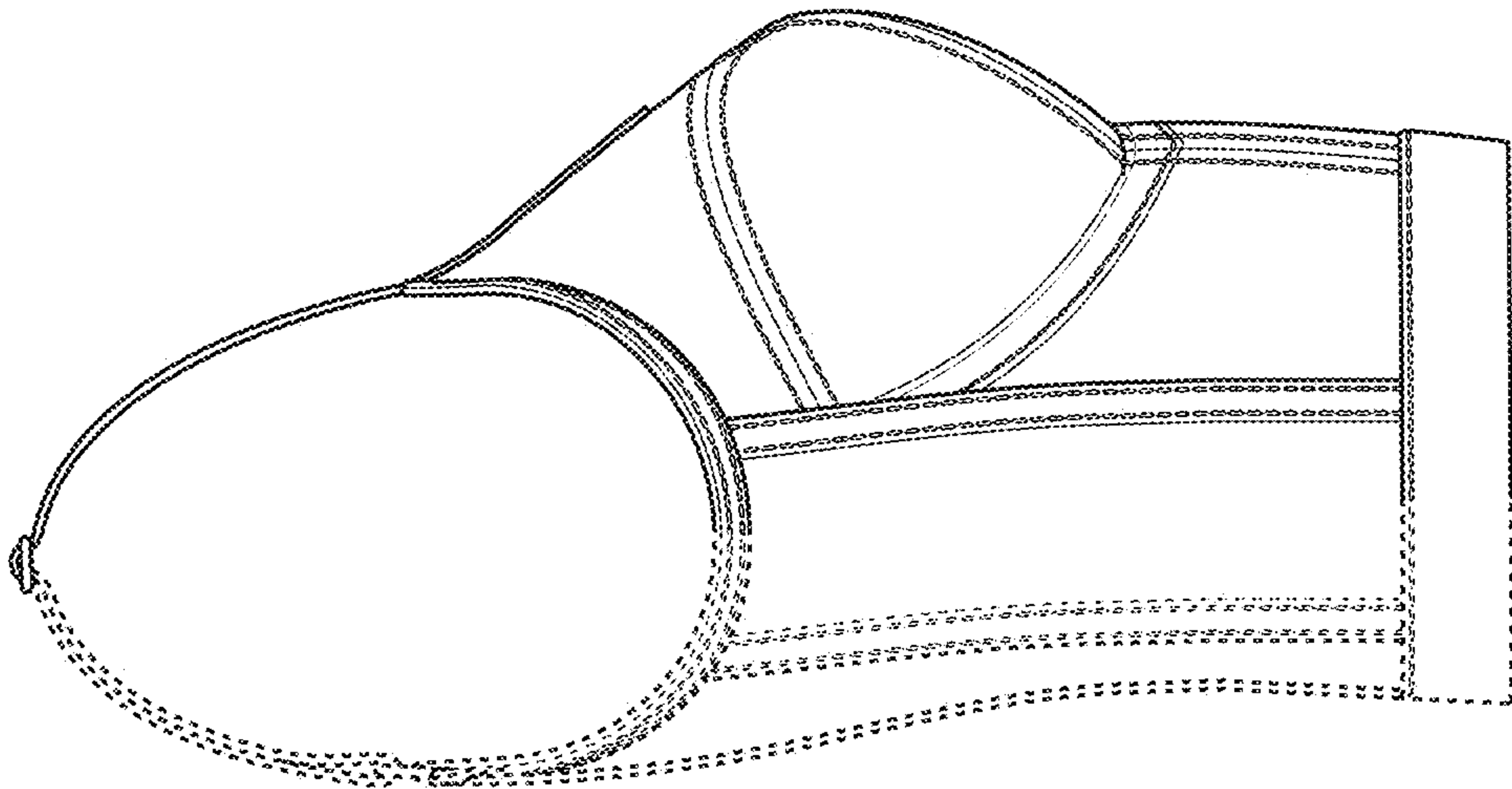

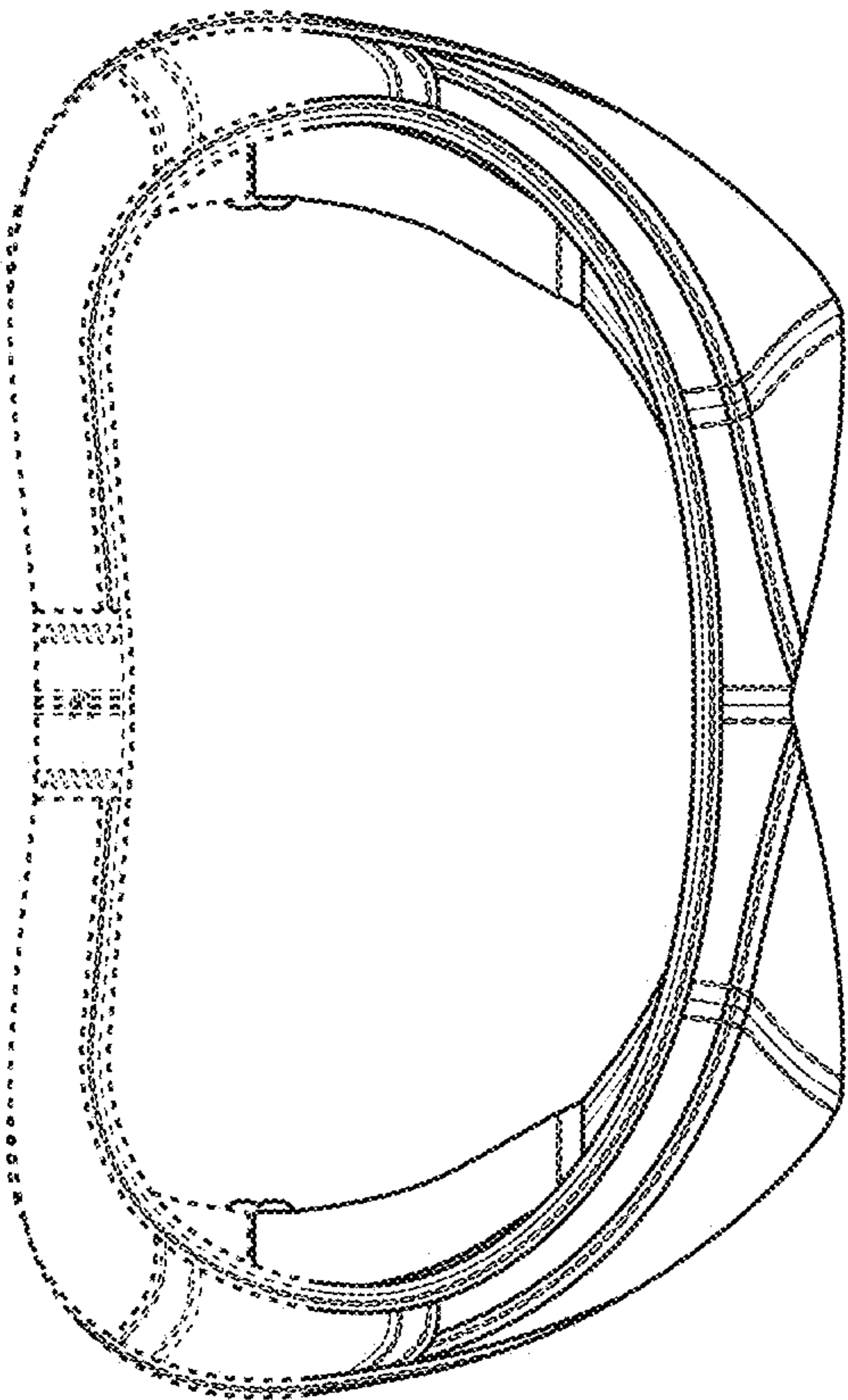

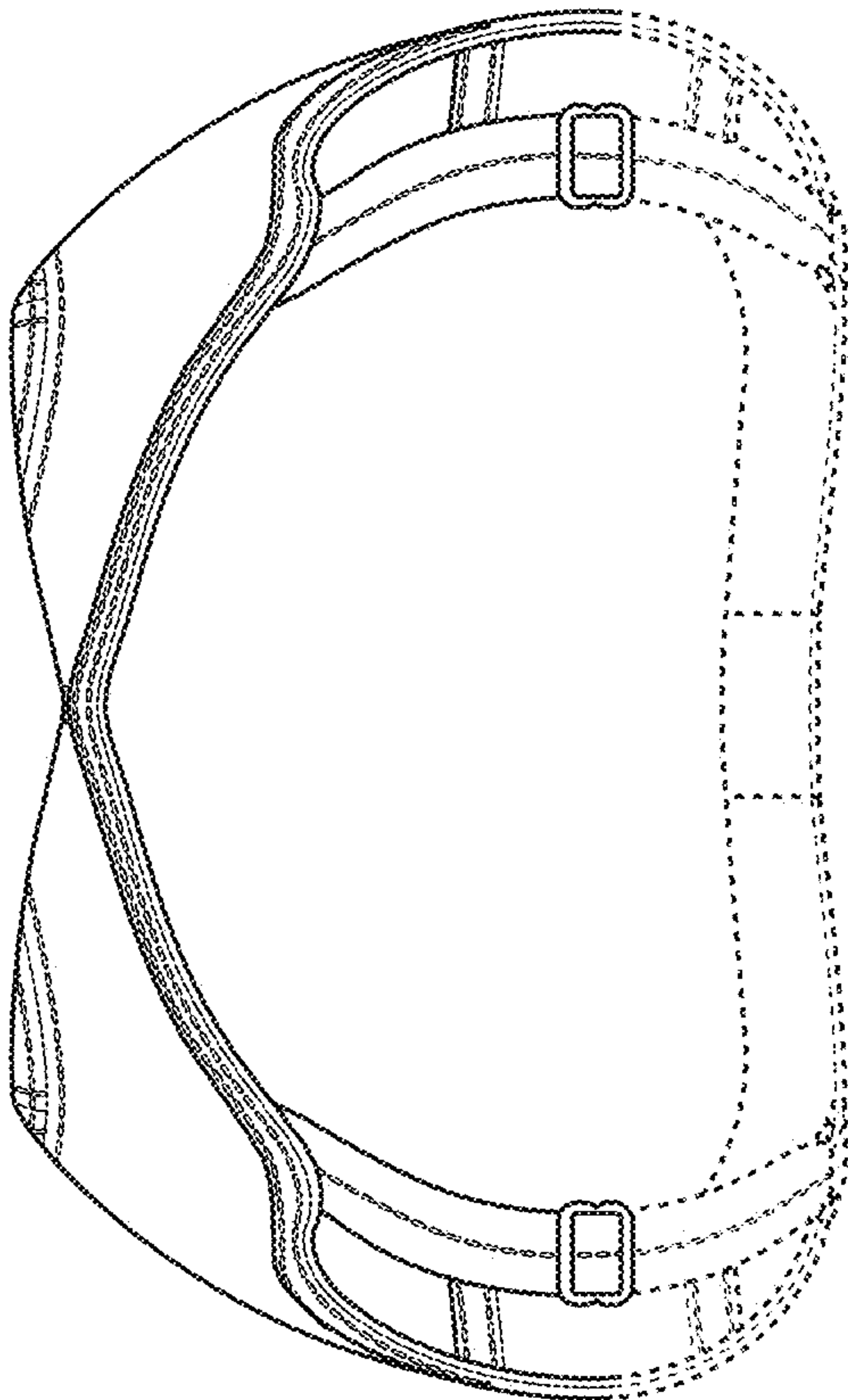
