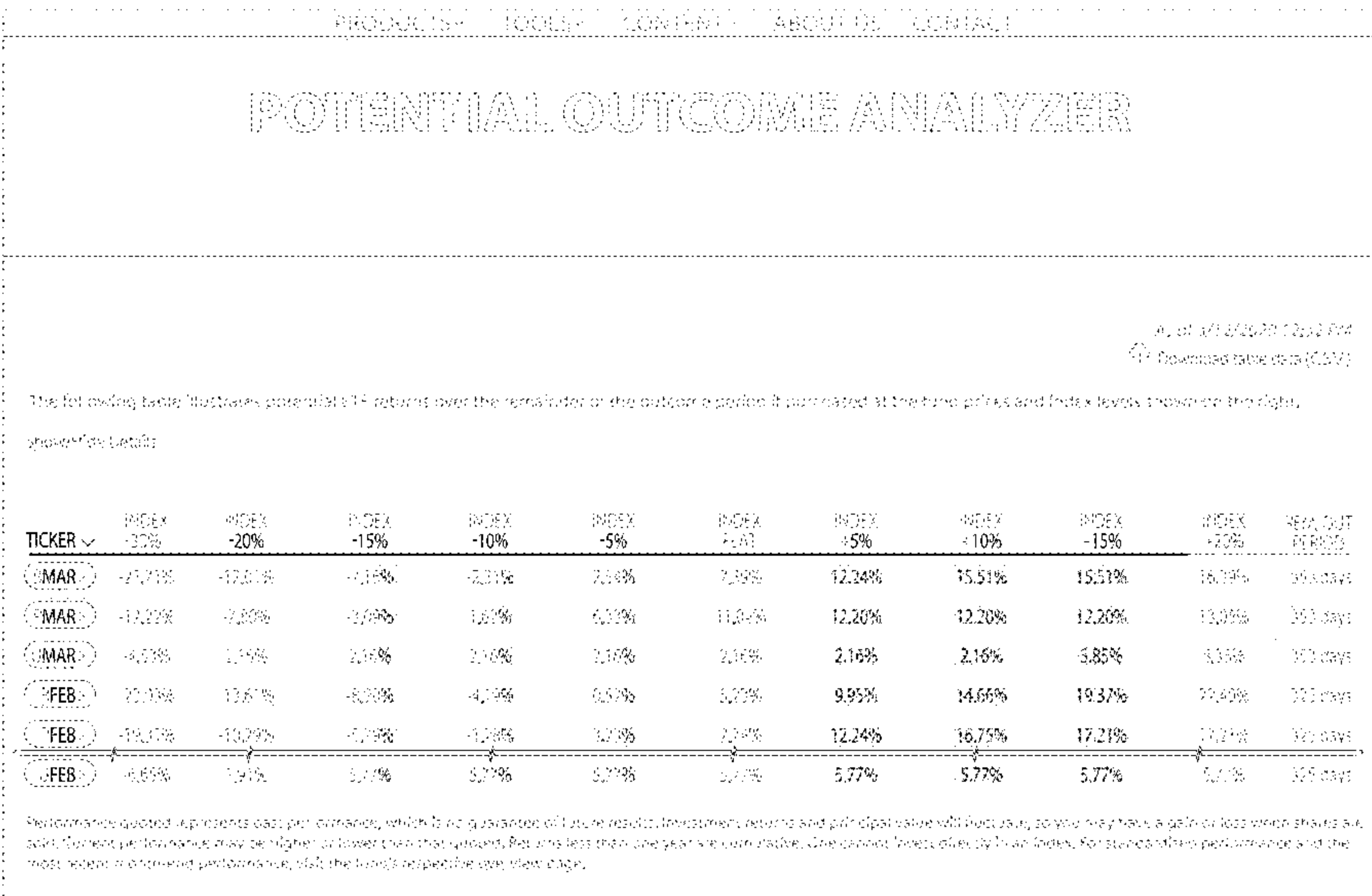
DESCRIPTION
