FIG. 3 is a front elevation view of FIG. 1, the rear elevation view being identical;

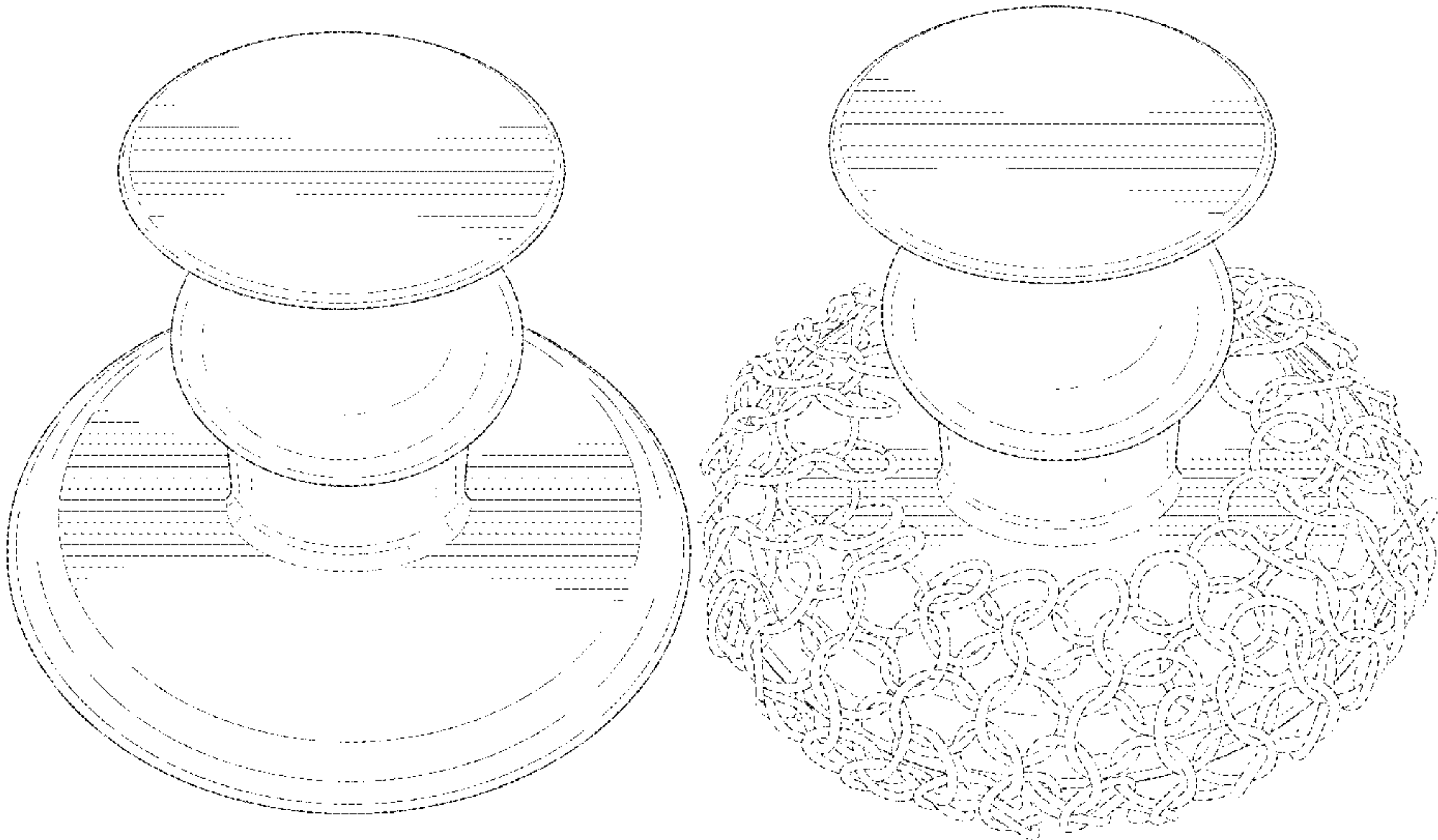
FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view thereof, the left side elevation view being identical;

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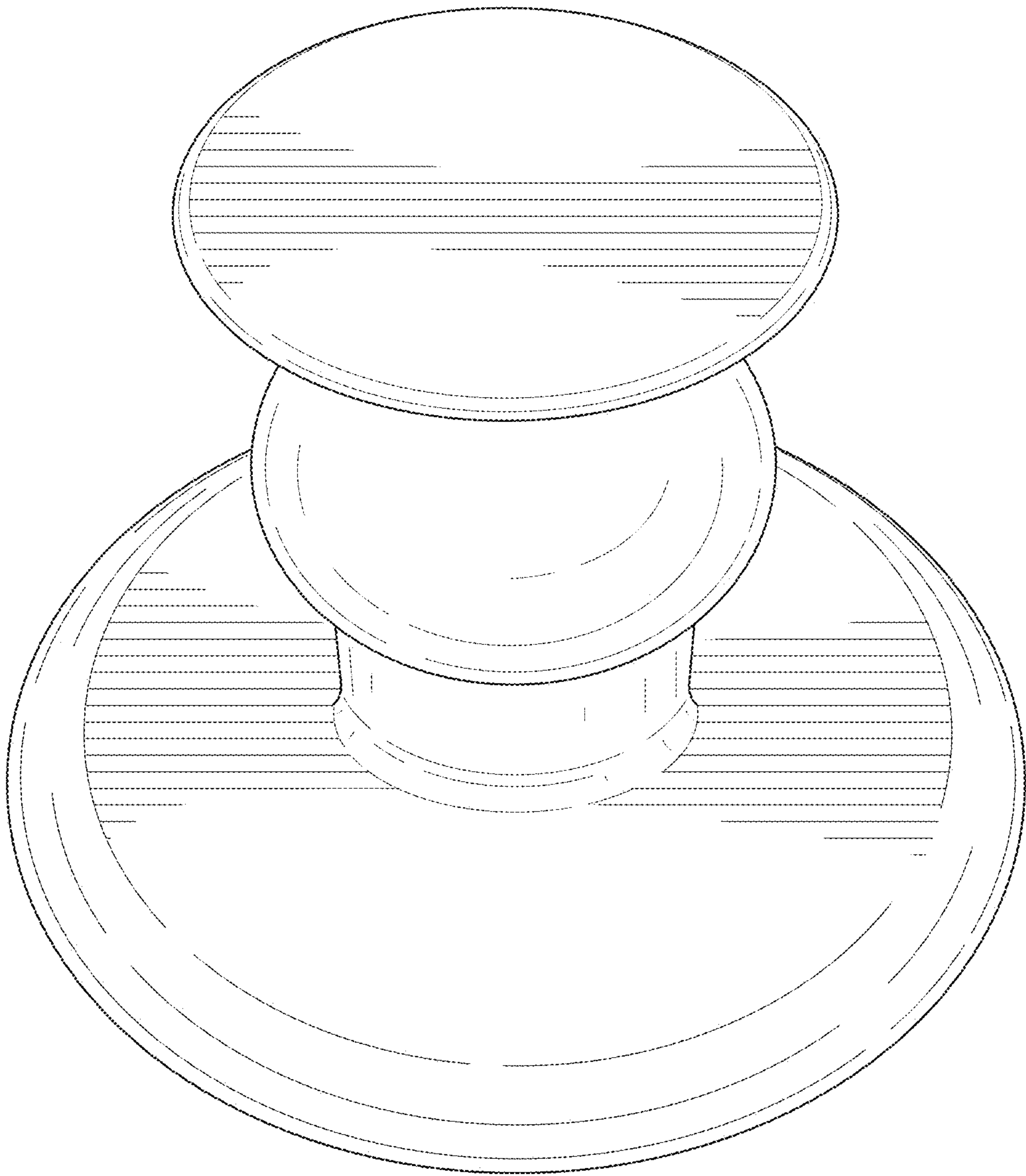

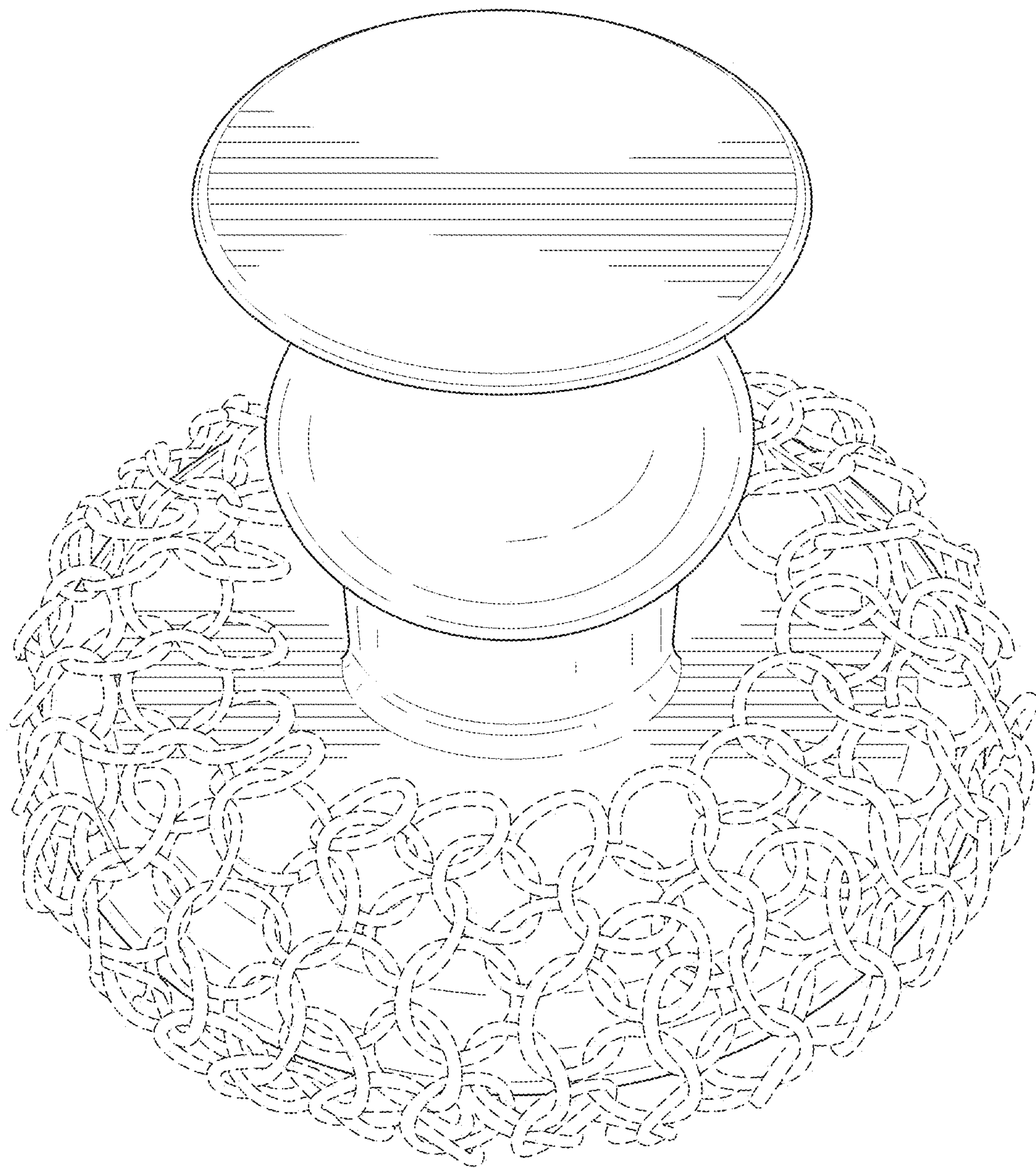

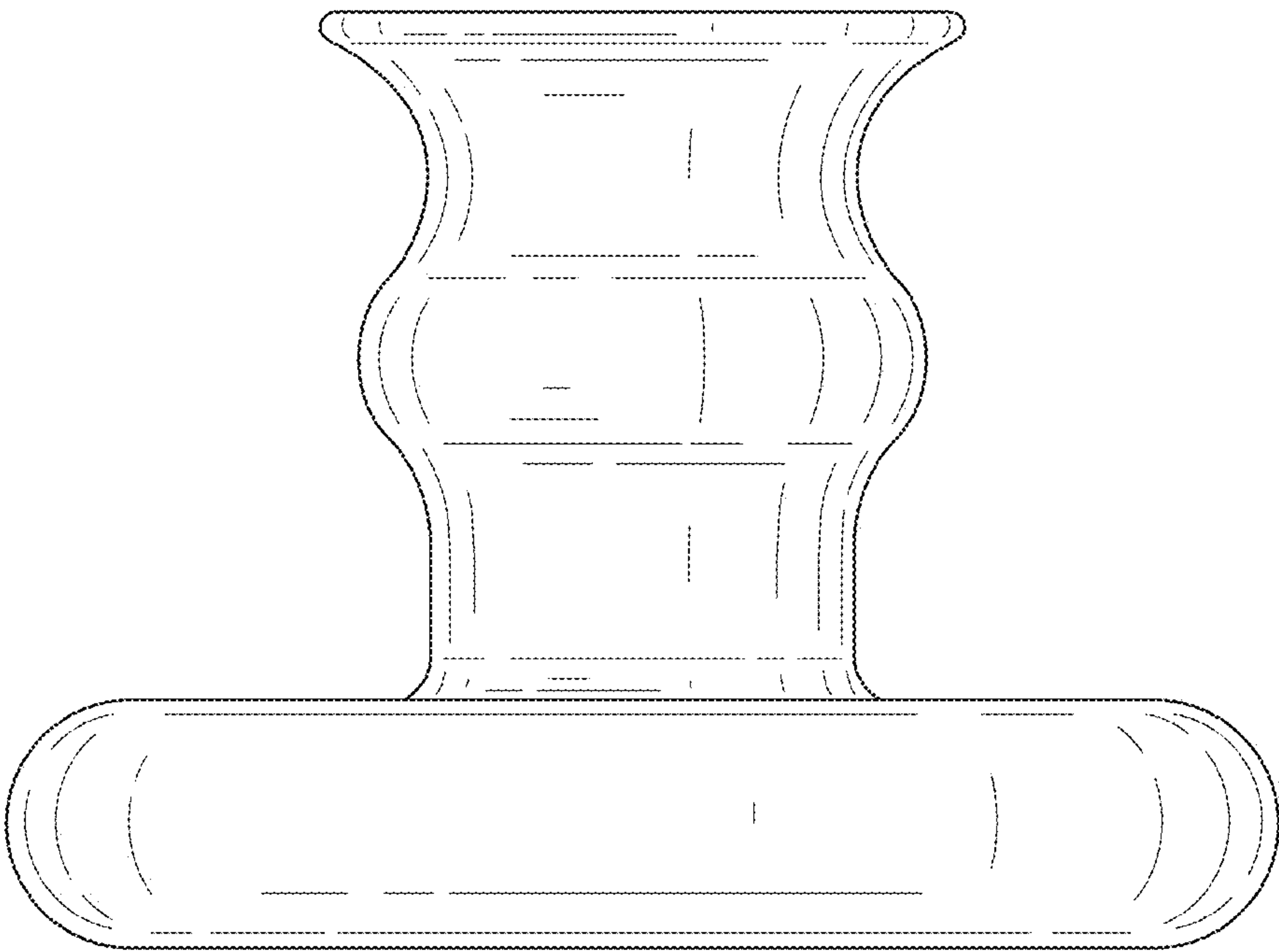

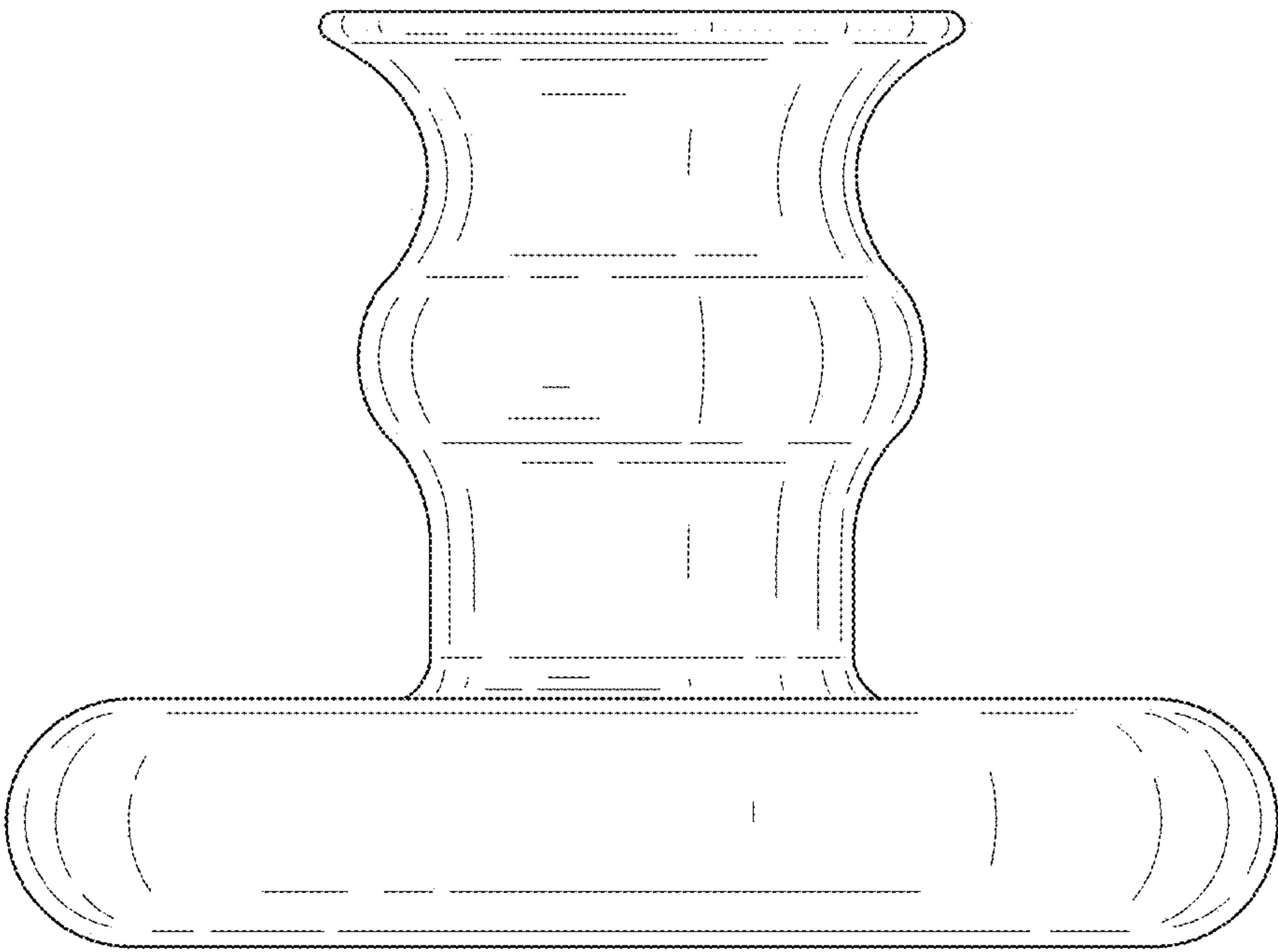

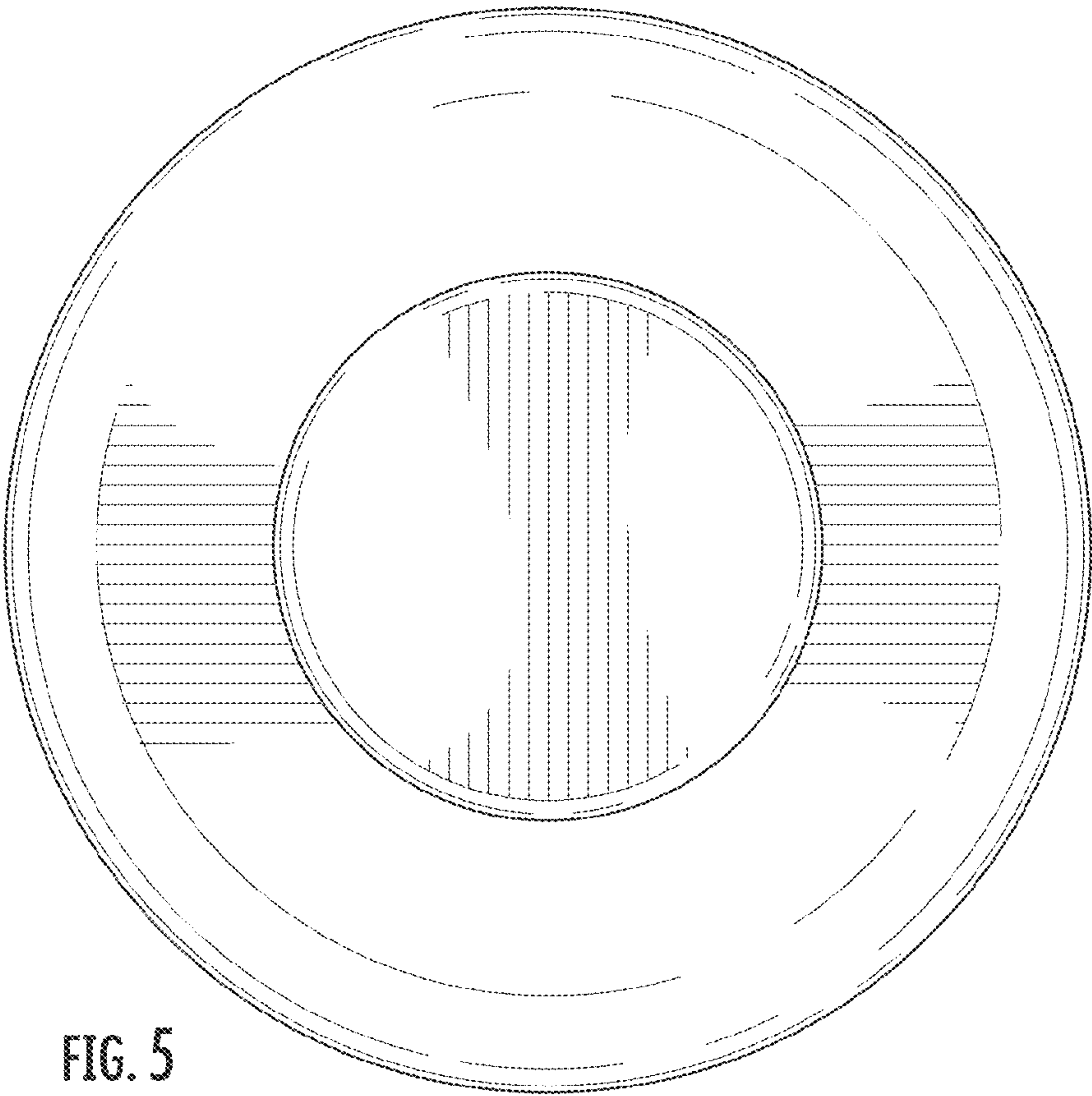

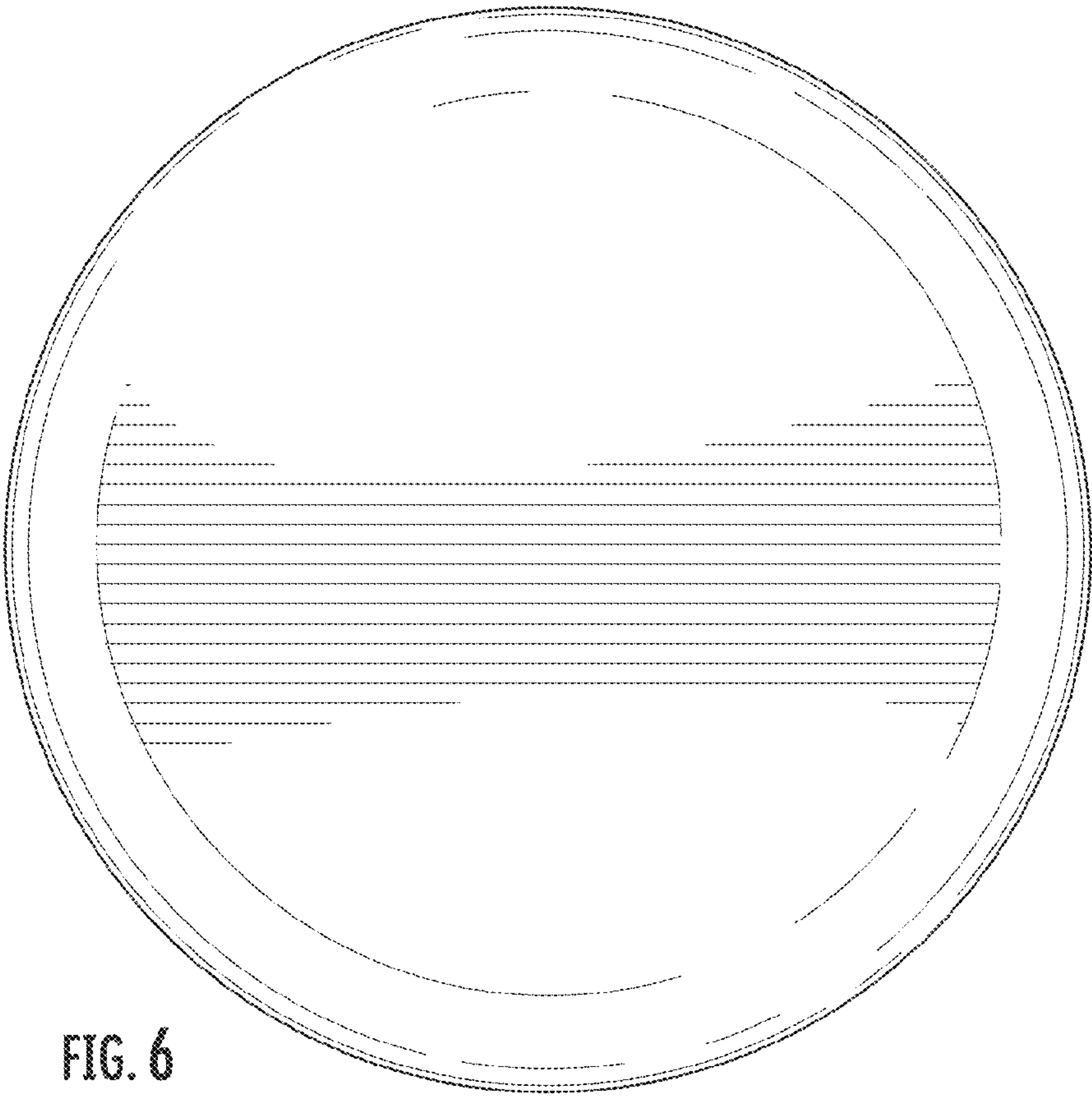
