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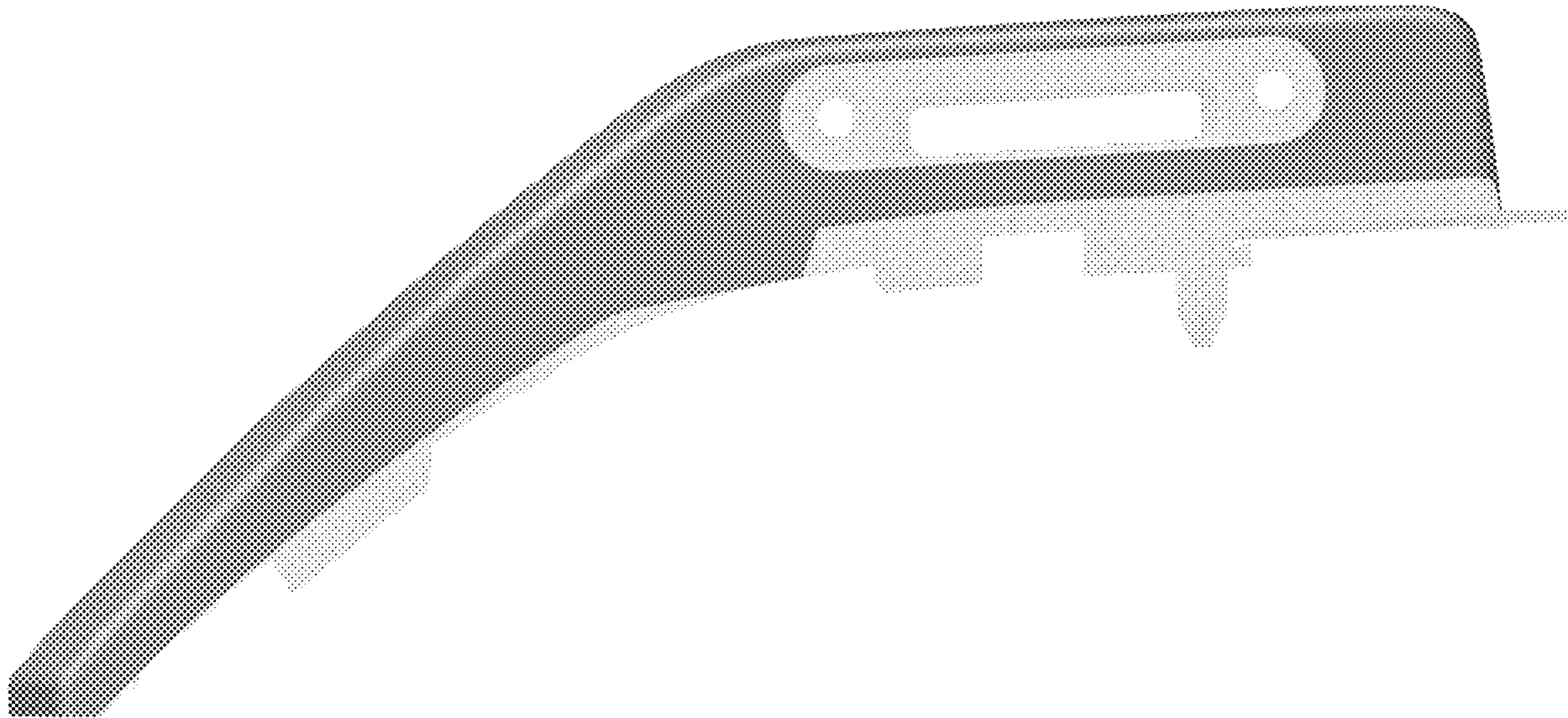
(57) CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a vehicle trail sight, showing our new design;  
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is a top, front and left side perspective view thereof; and,

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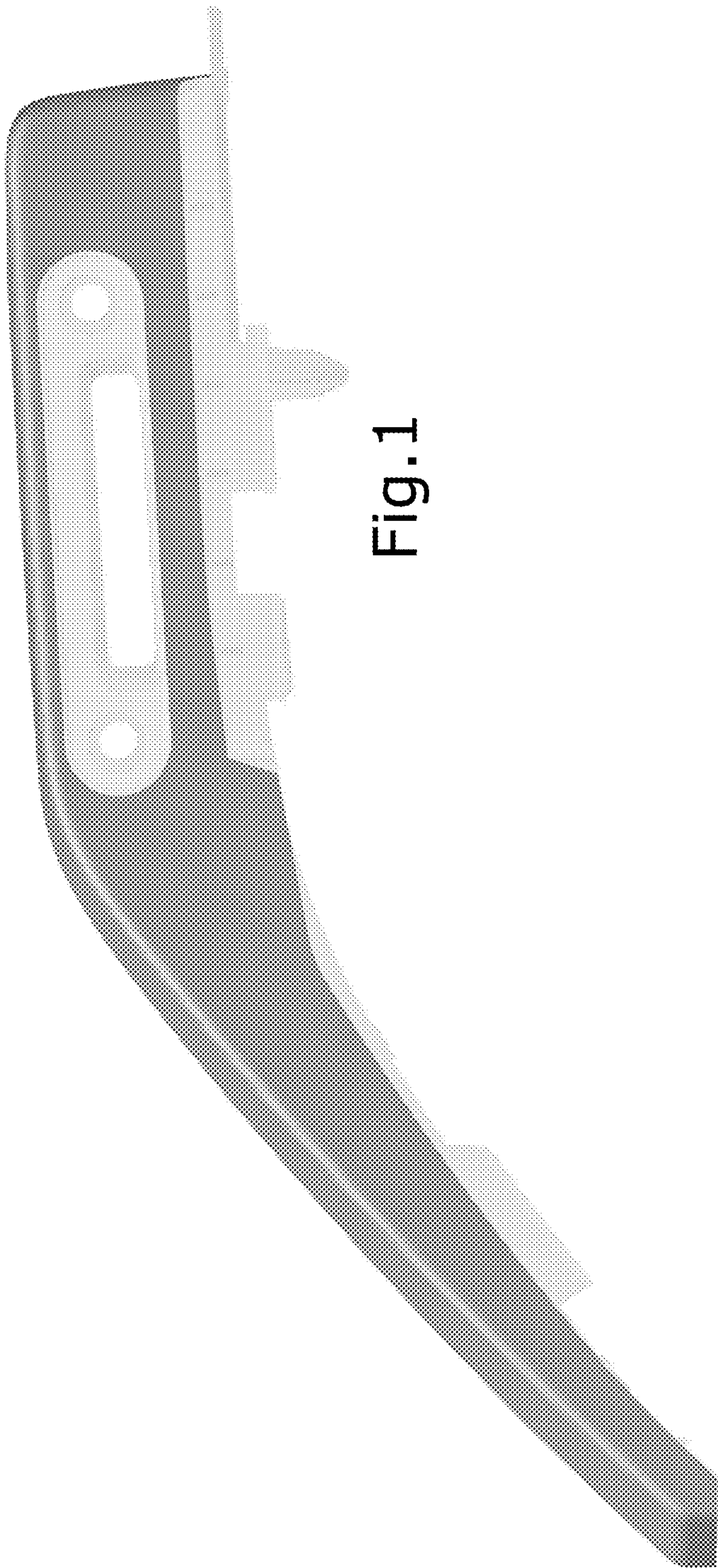

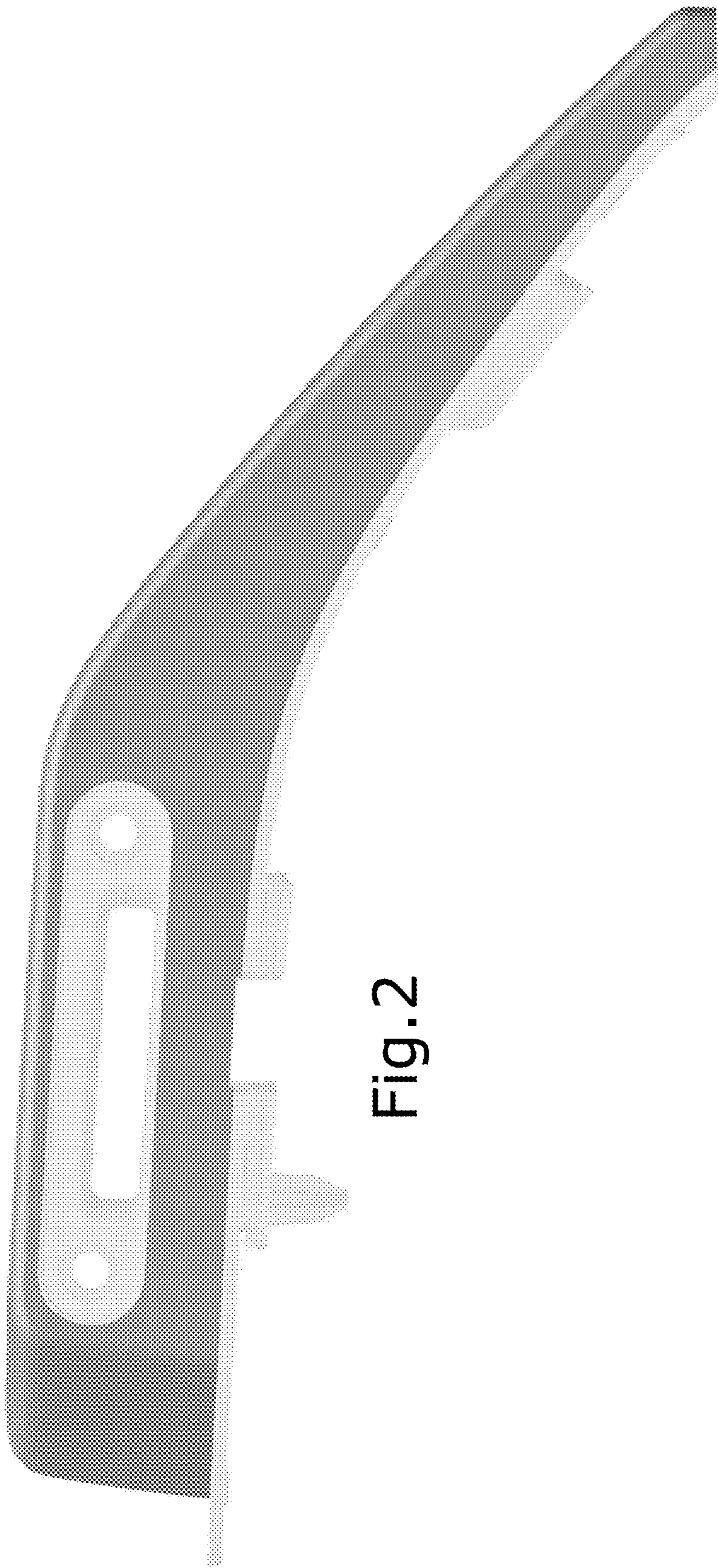

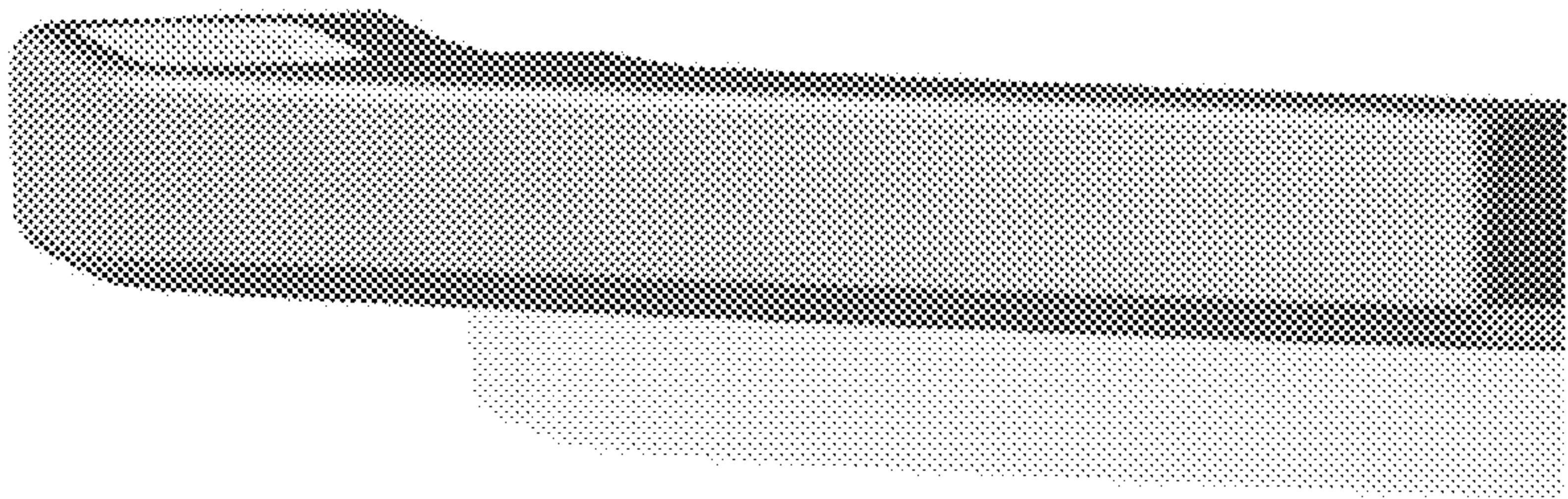

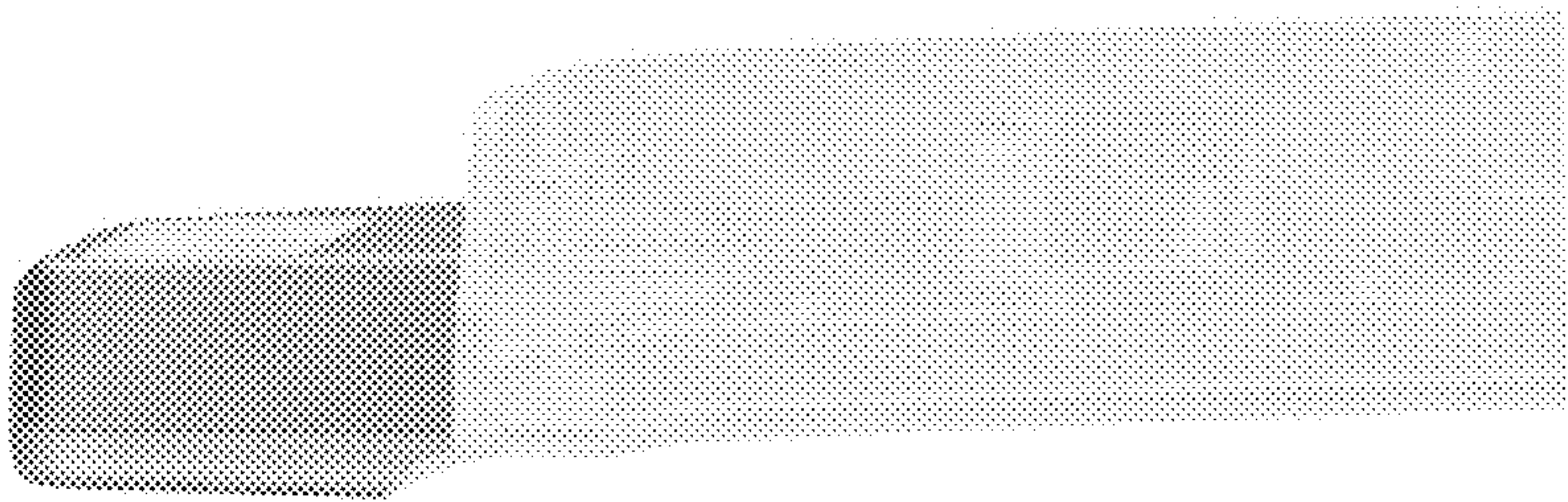

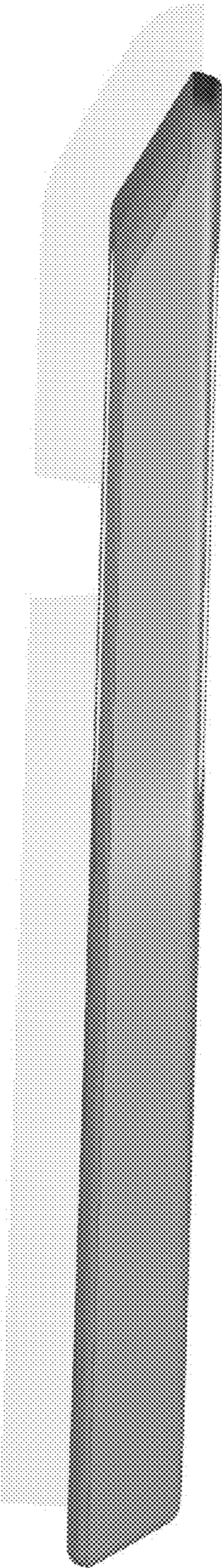

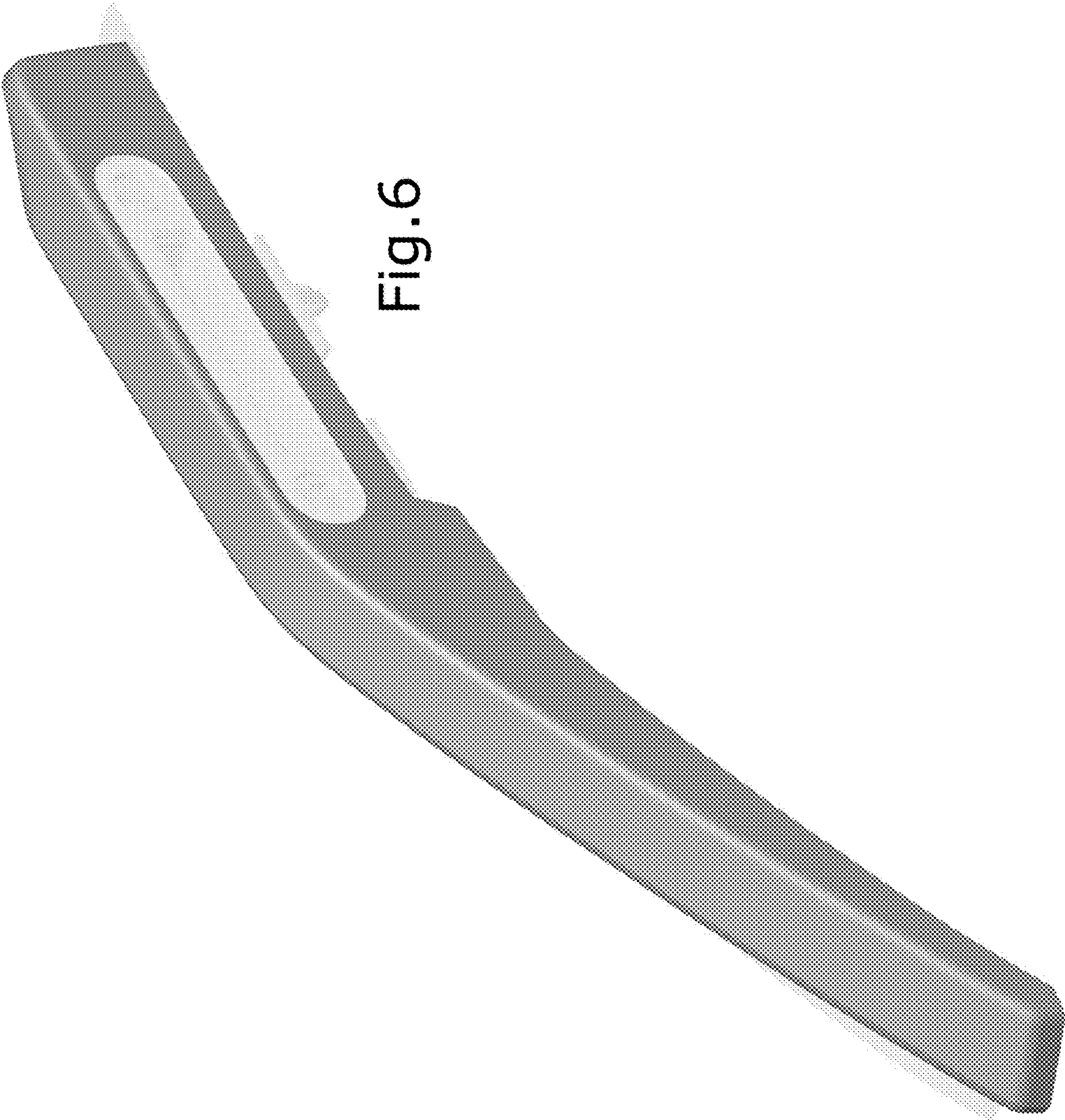

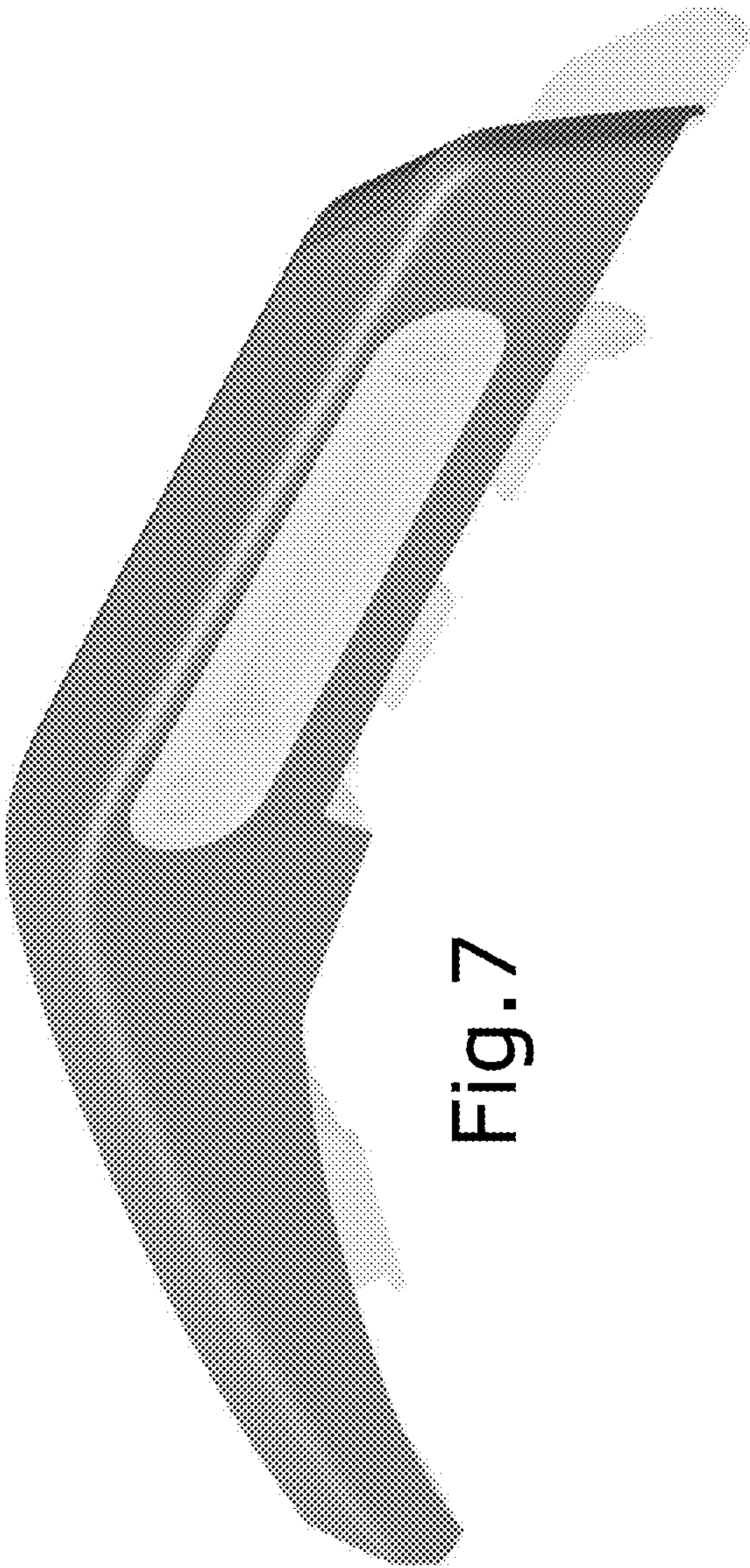
