FIG. 3 is a front side view of the battery pack with the terminal cap keying feature of FIG. 10.

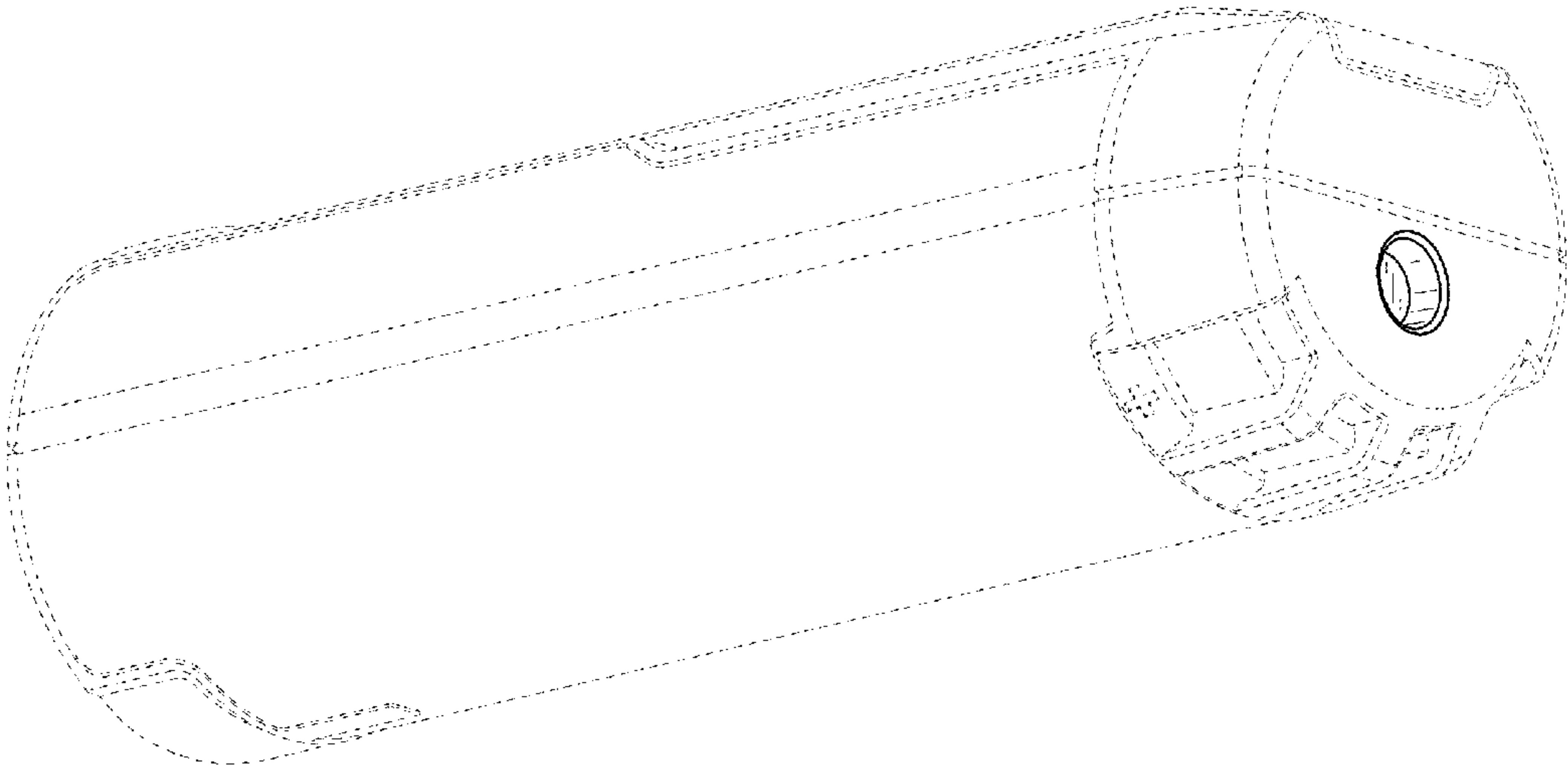
FIG. 4 is a first perspective view of a battery pack with a terminal cap keying feature according to a fourth embodiment.

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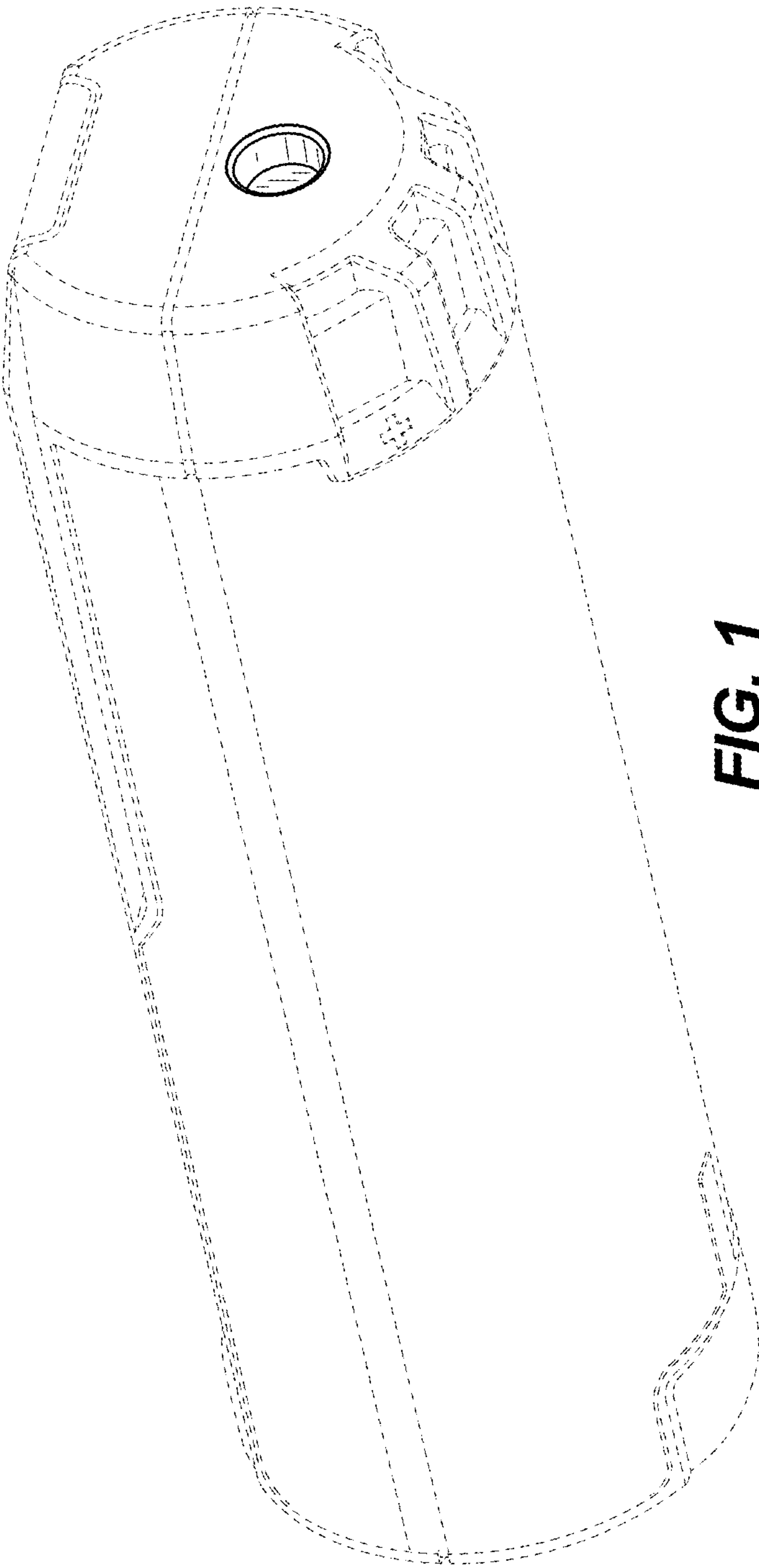
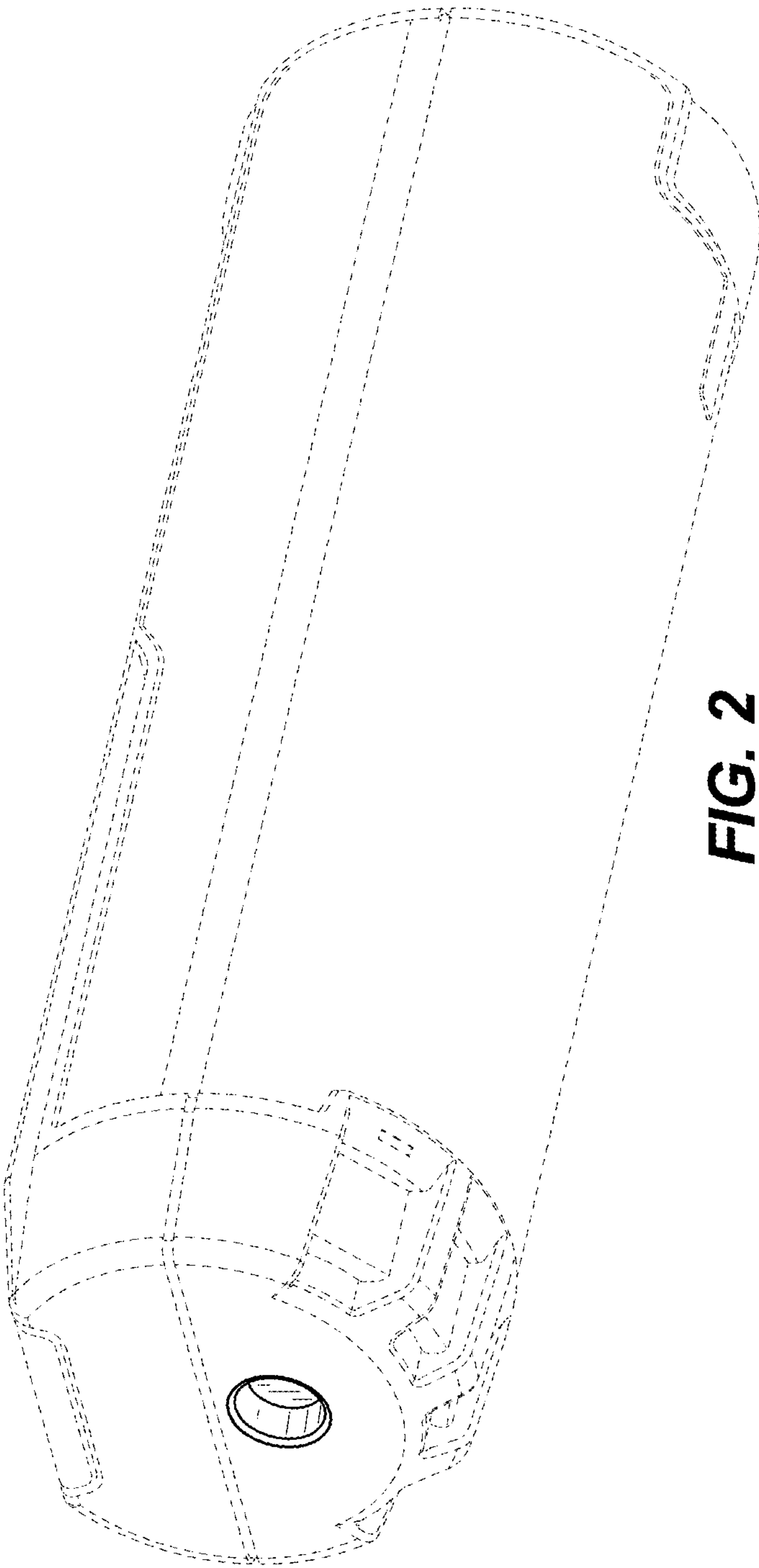

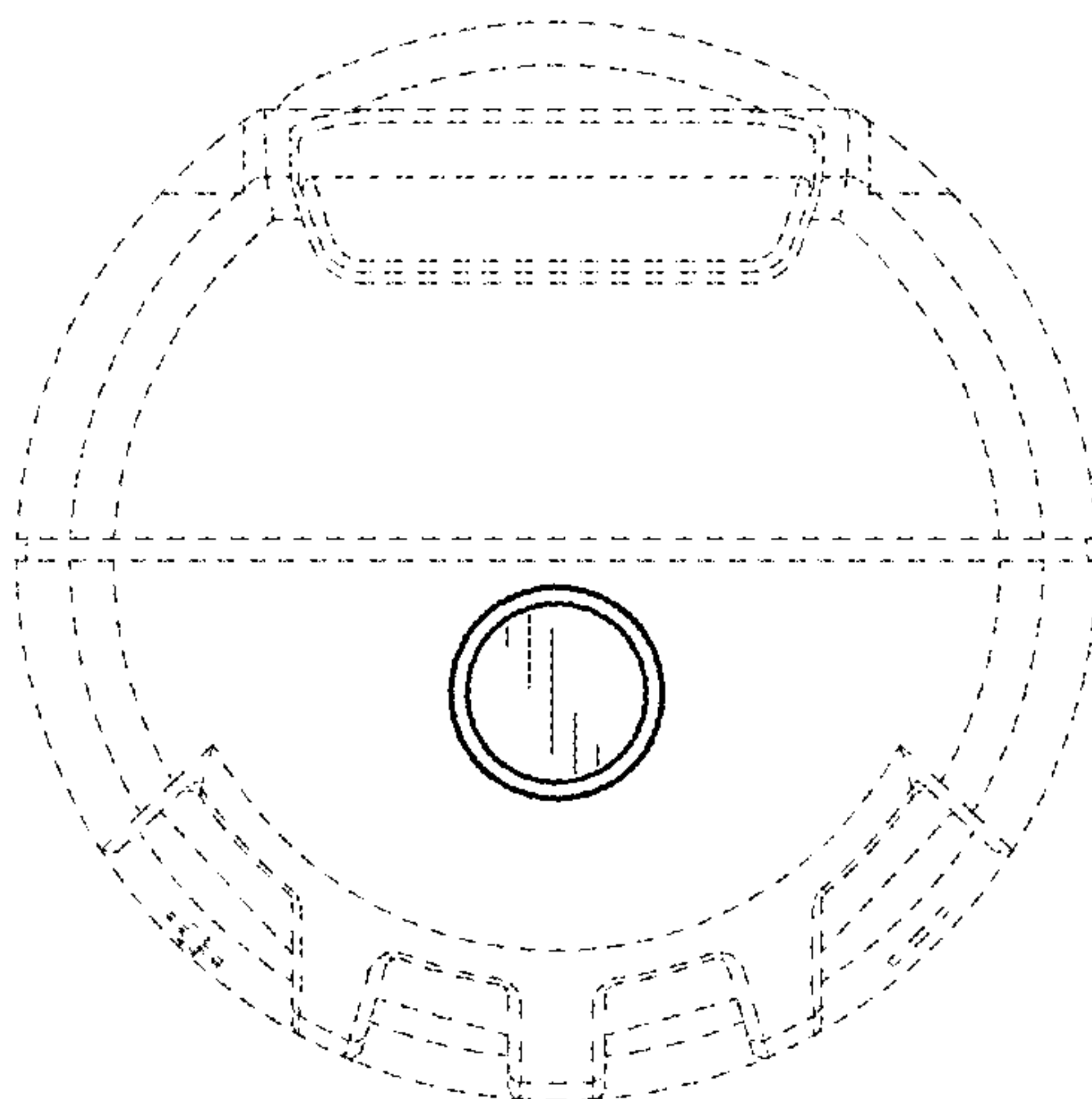

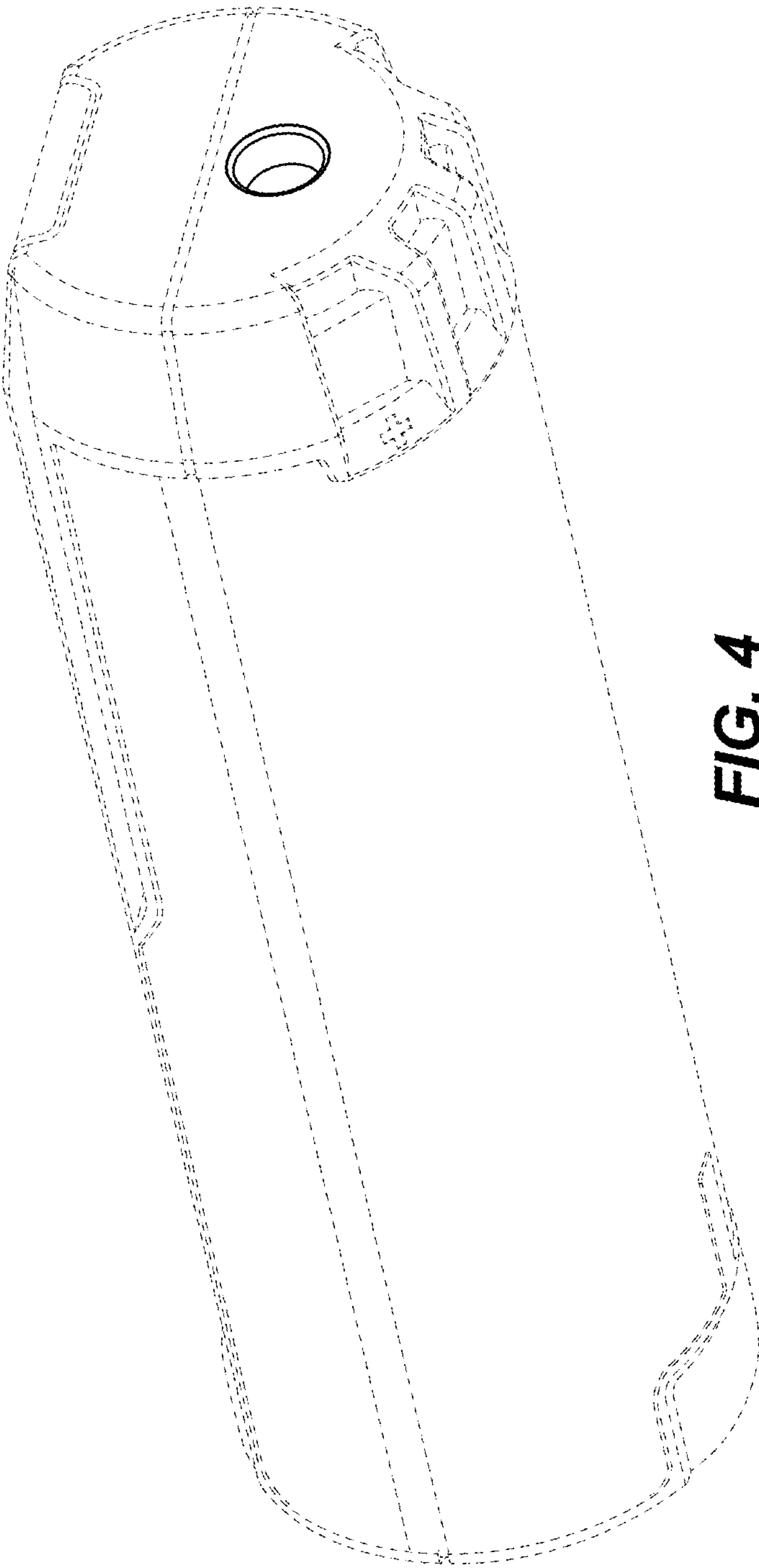
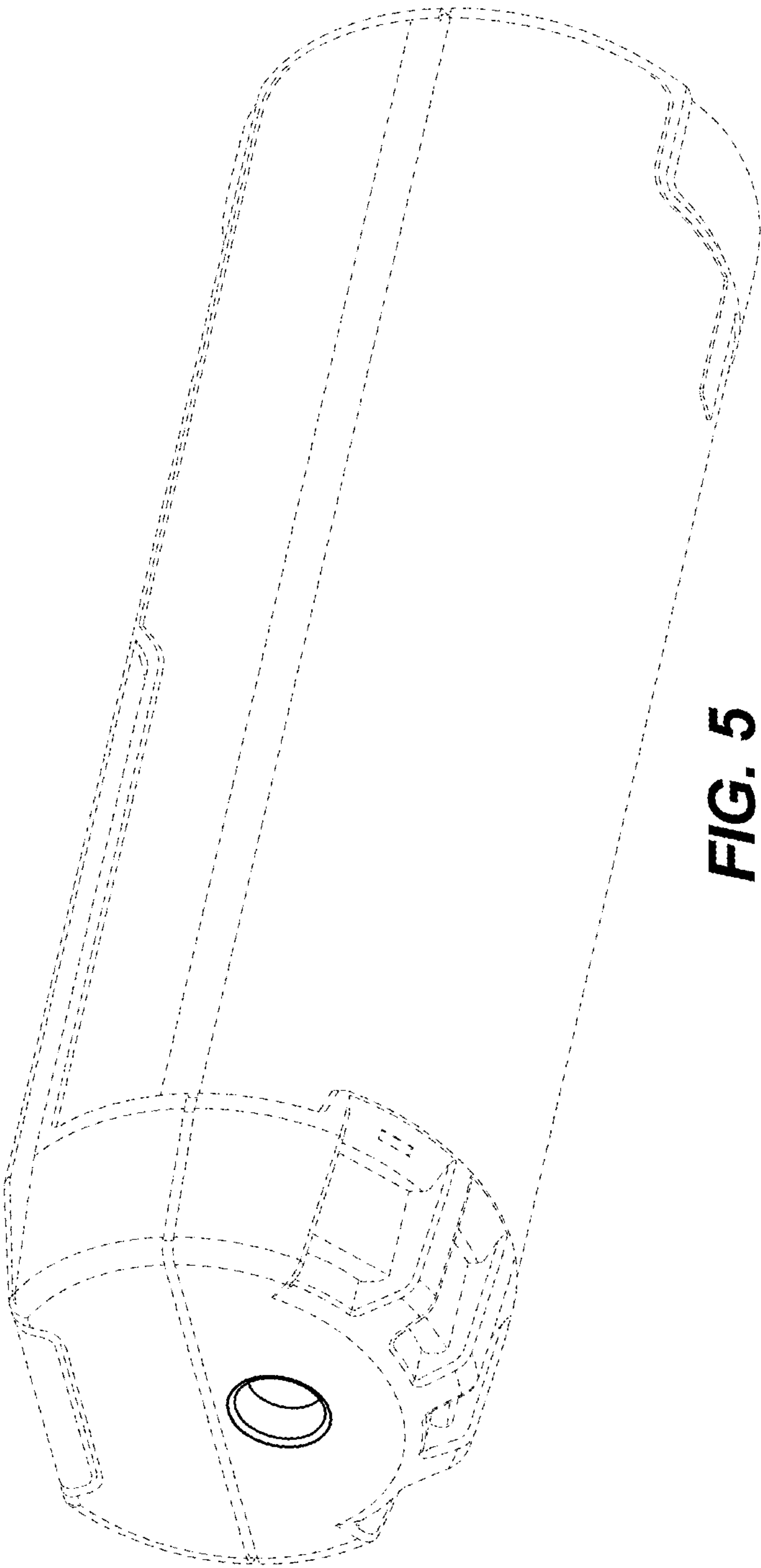

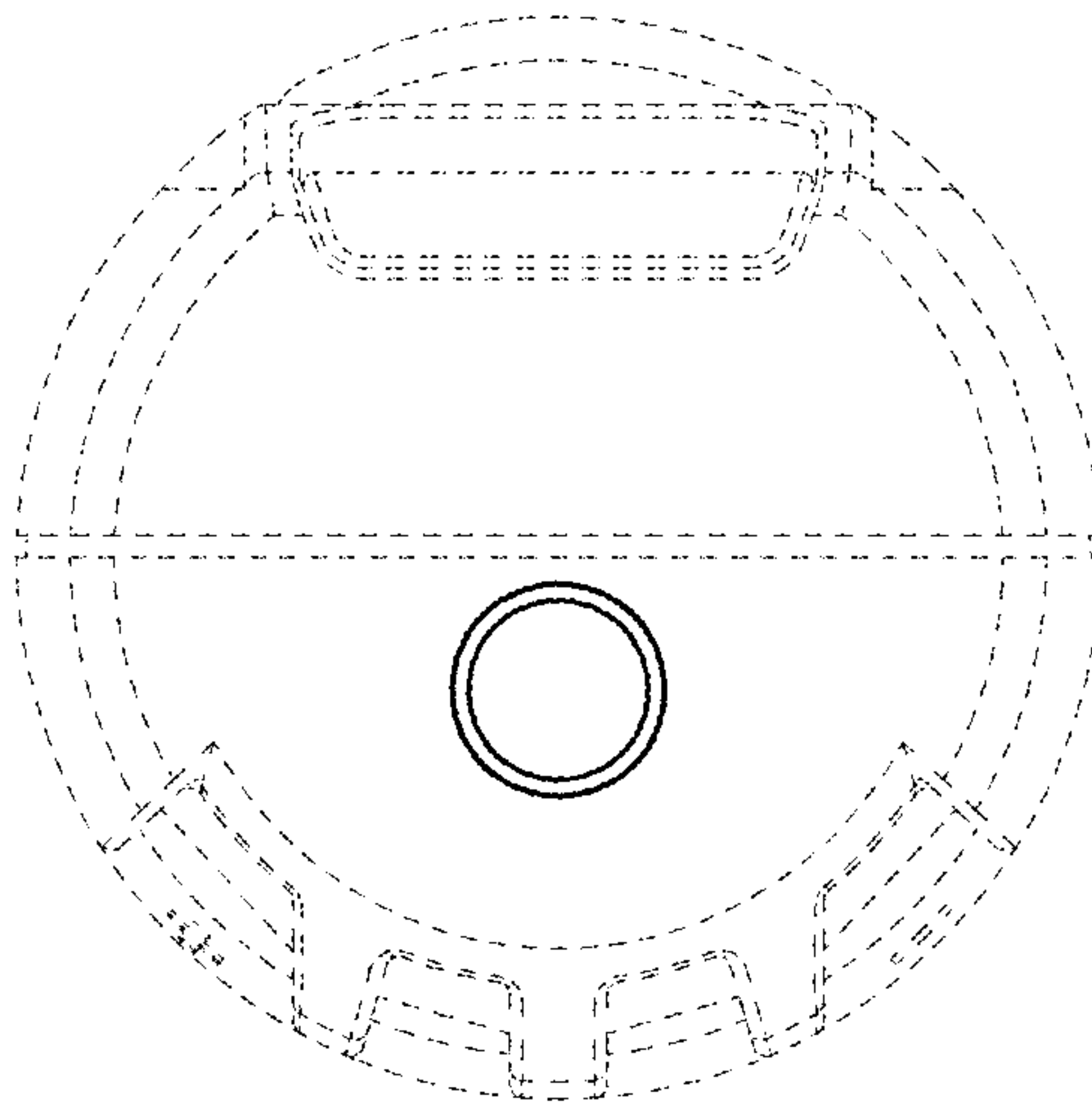
