FIG. 28 is a left side elevation view thereof, the right side elevation view being a mirror image;

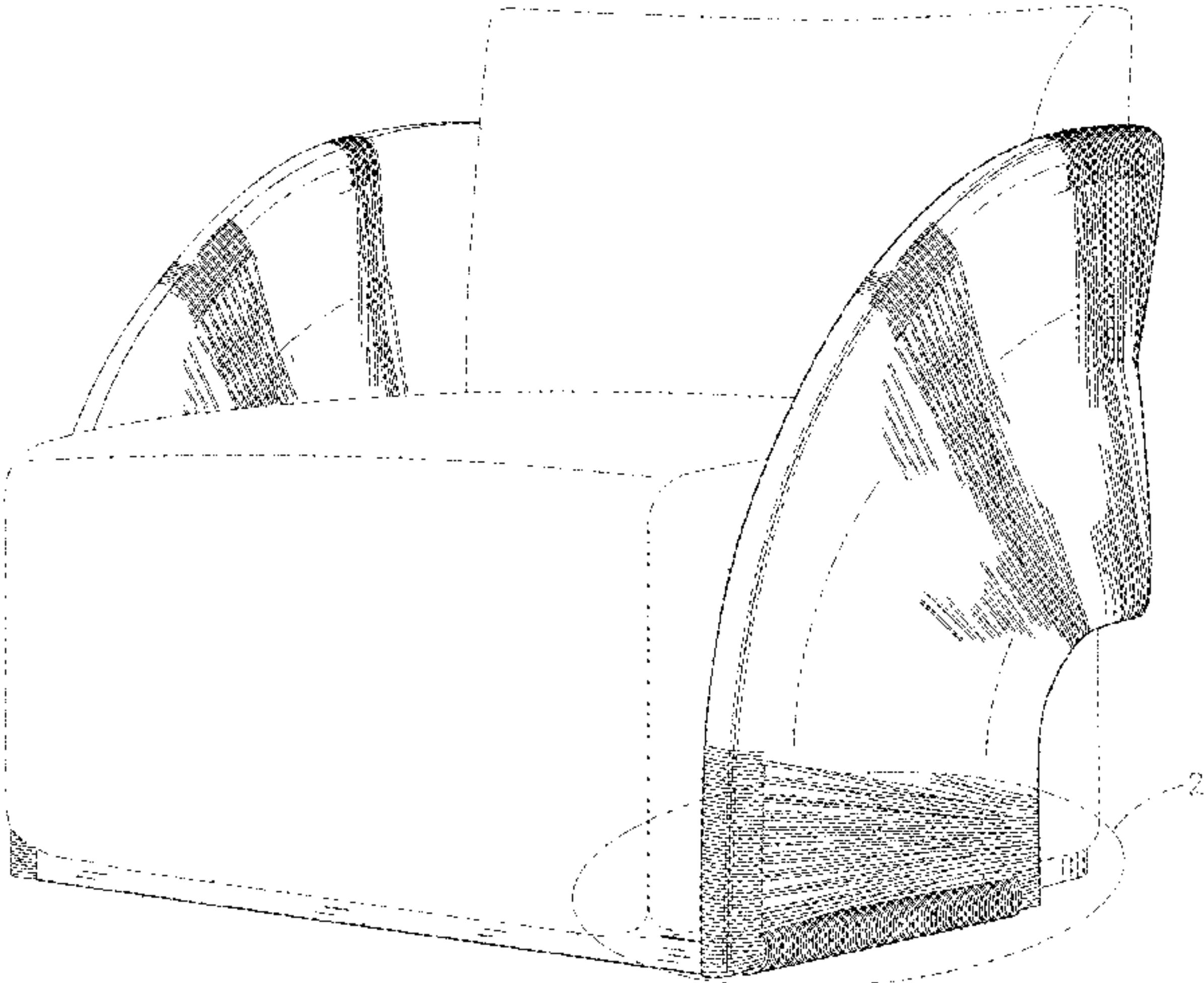
FIG. 29 is a front elevation view thereof; and,

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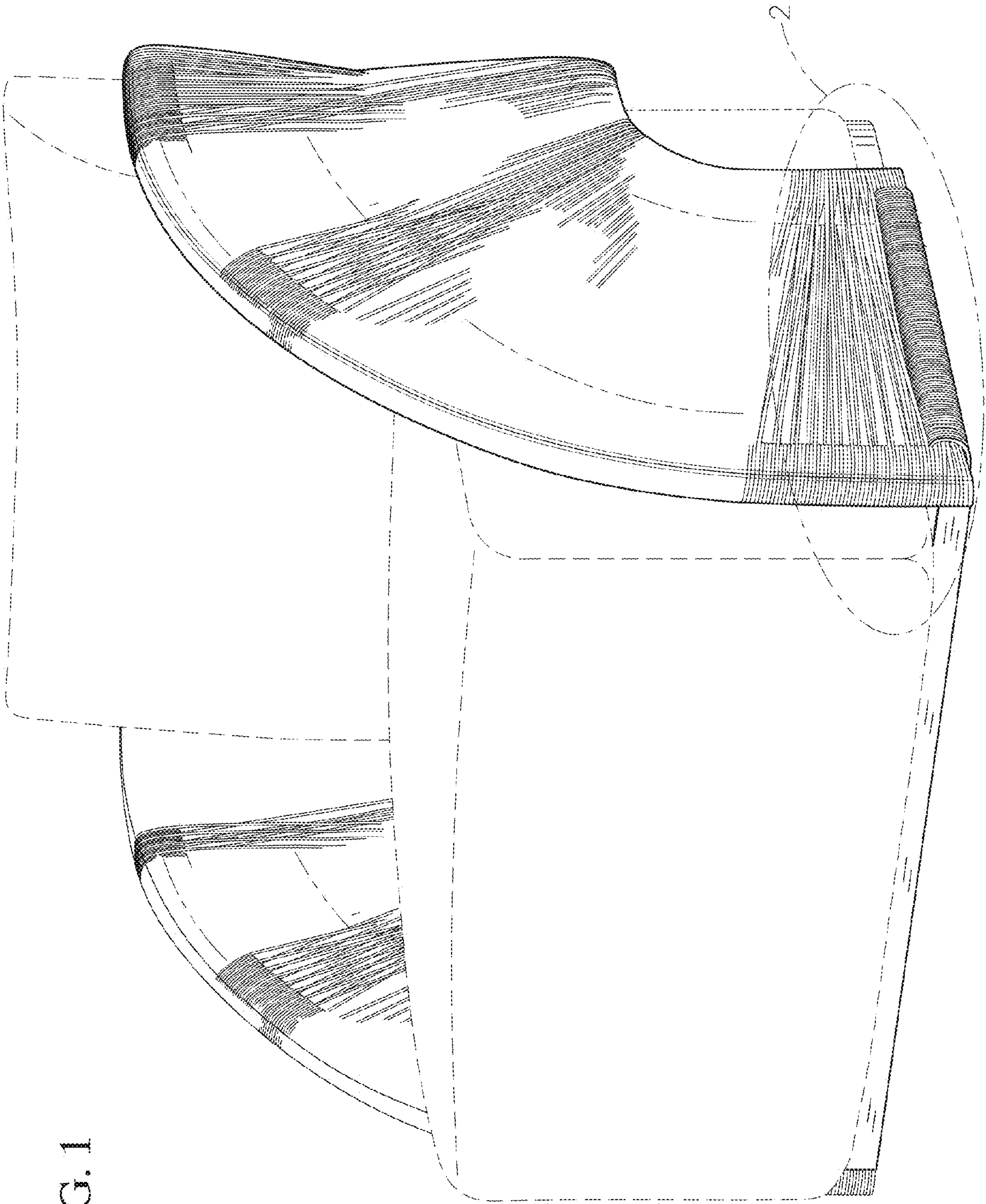
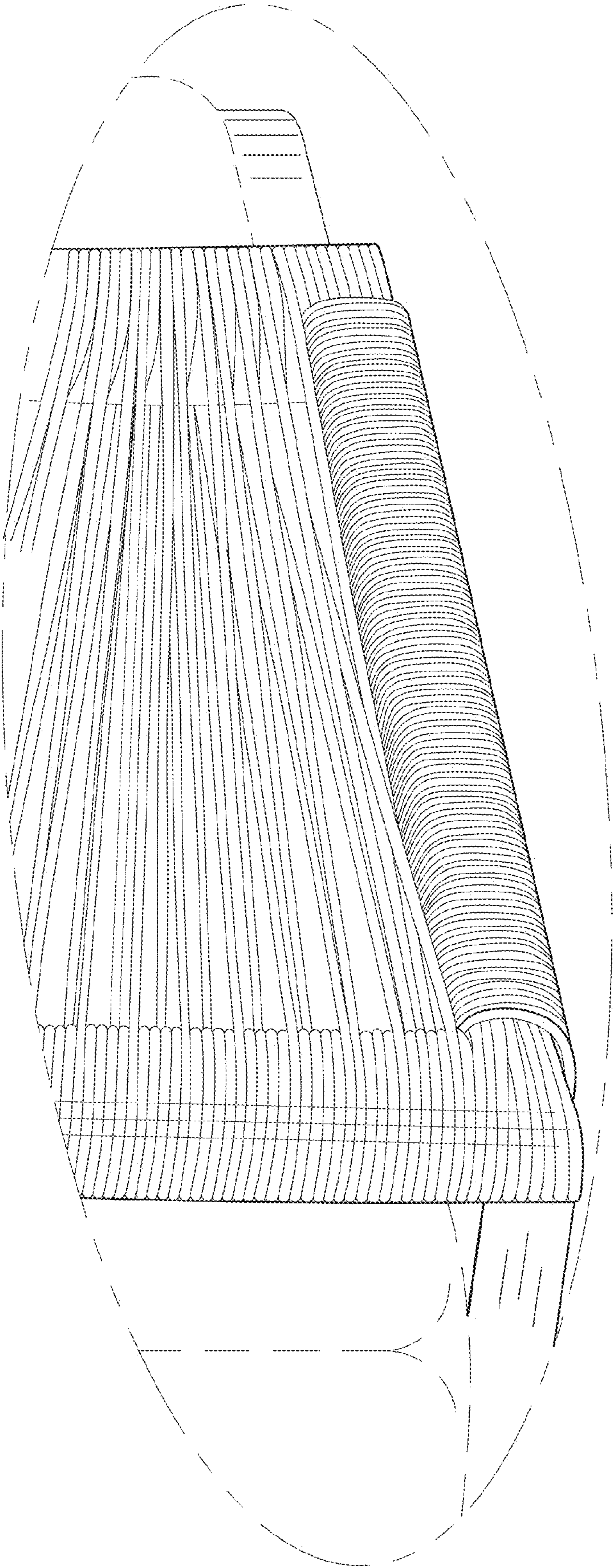

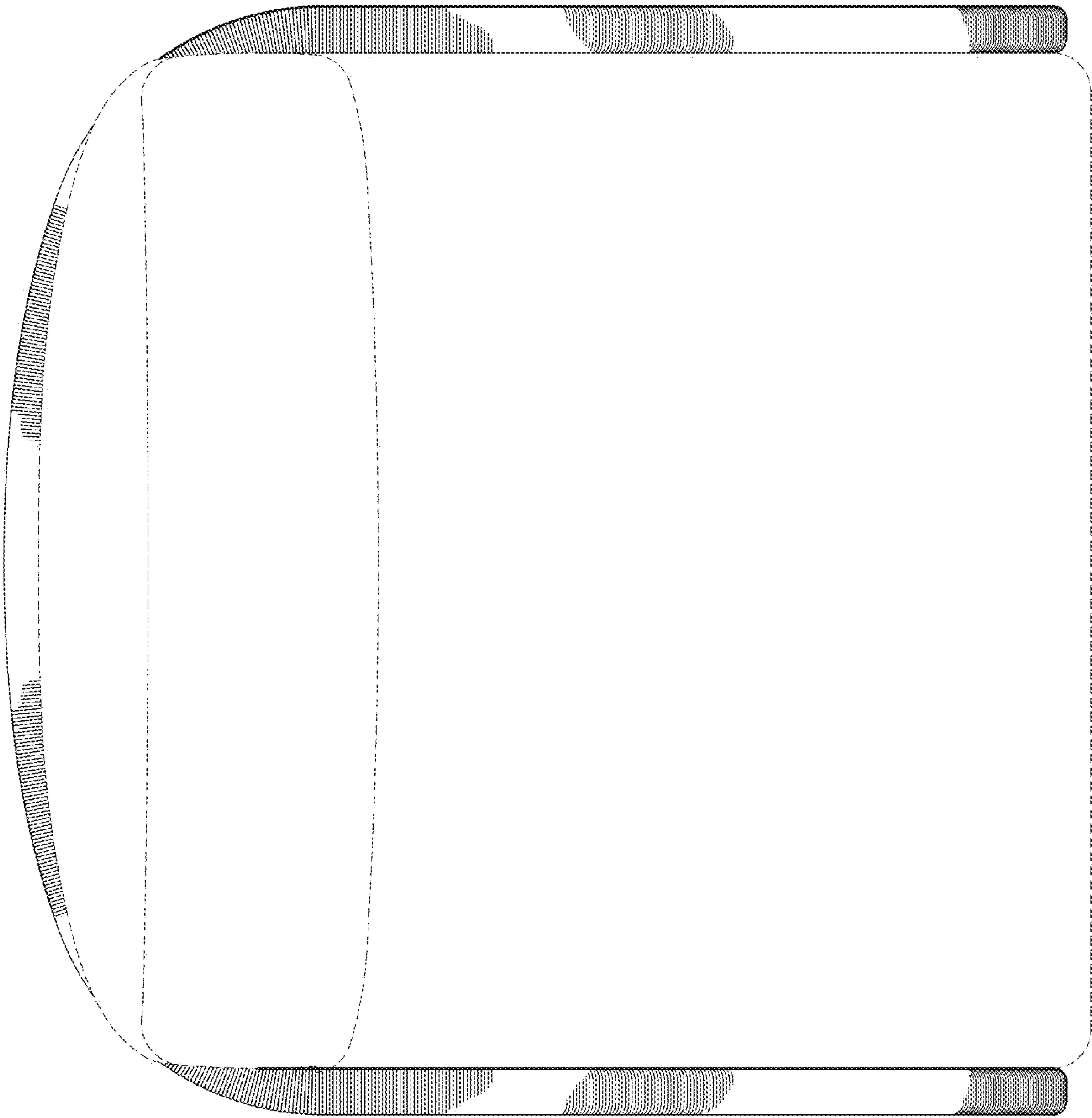

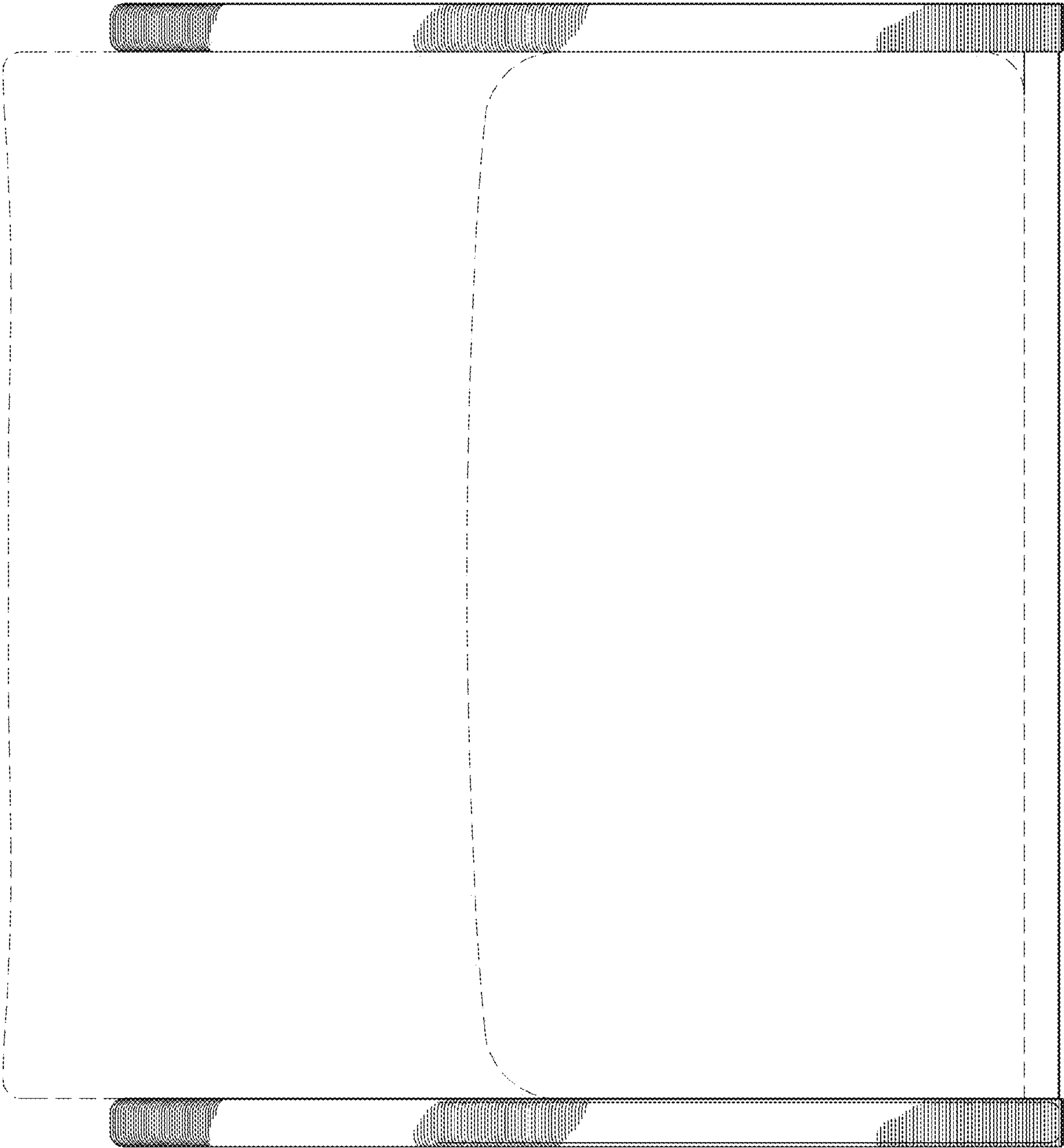
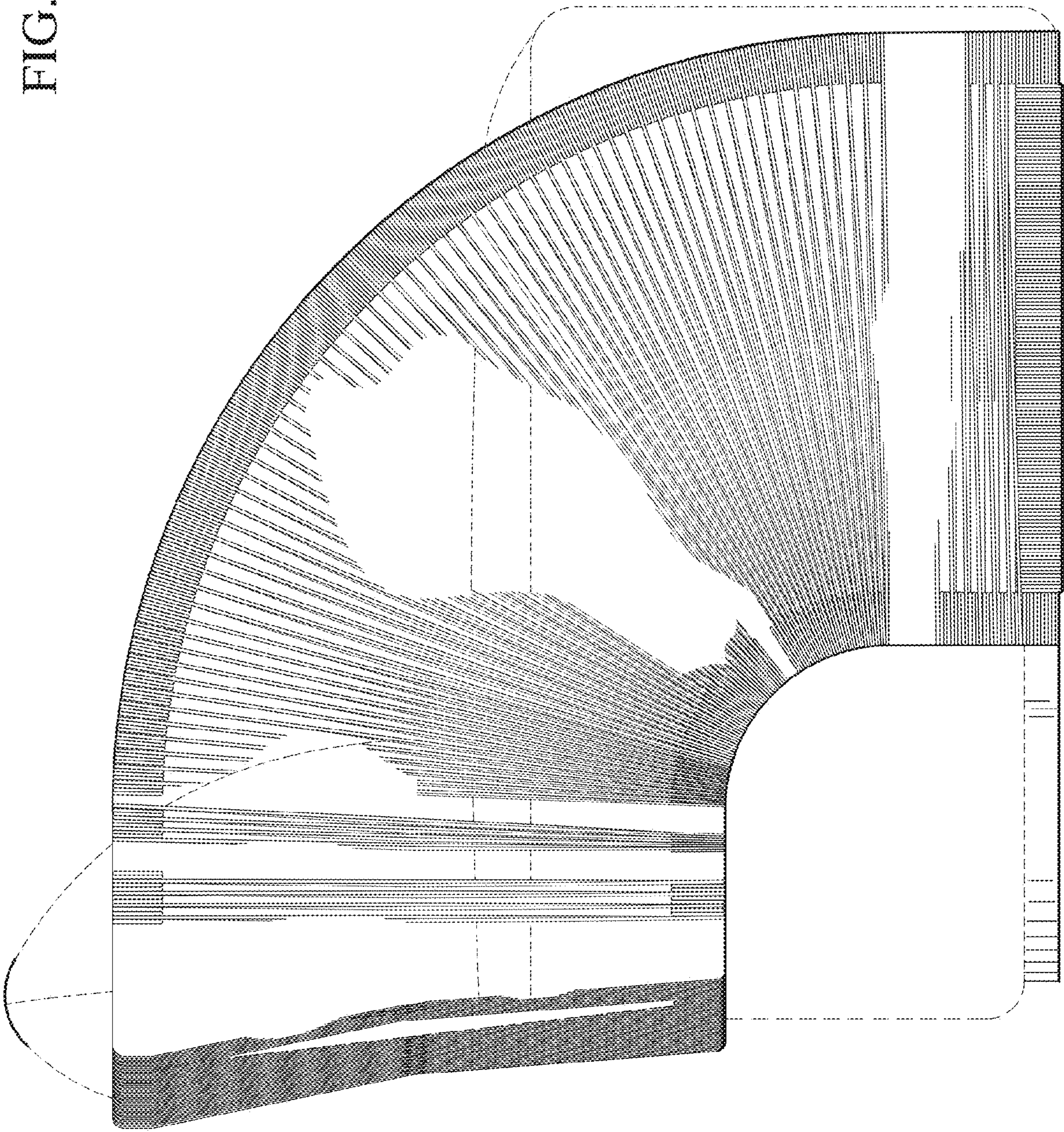

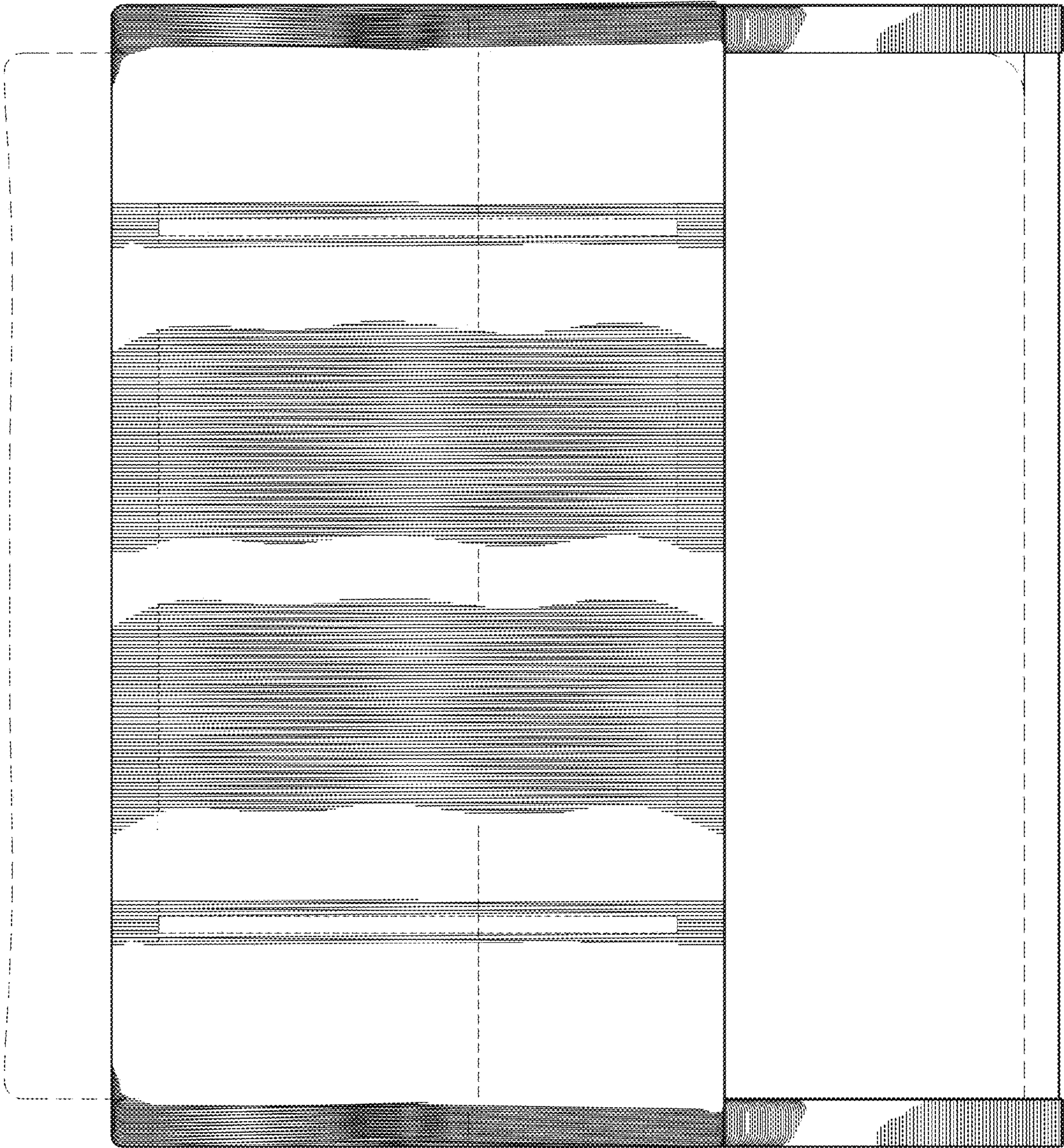

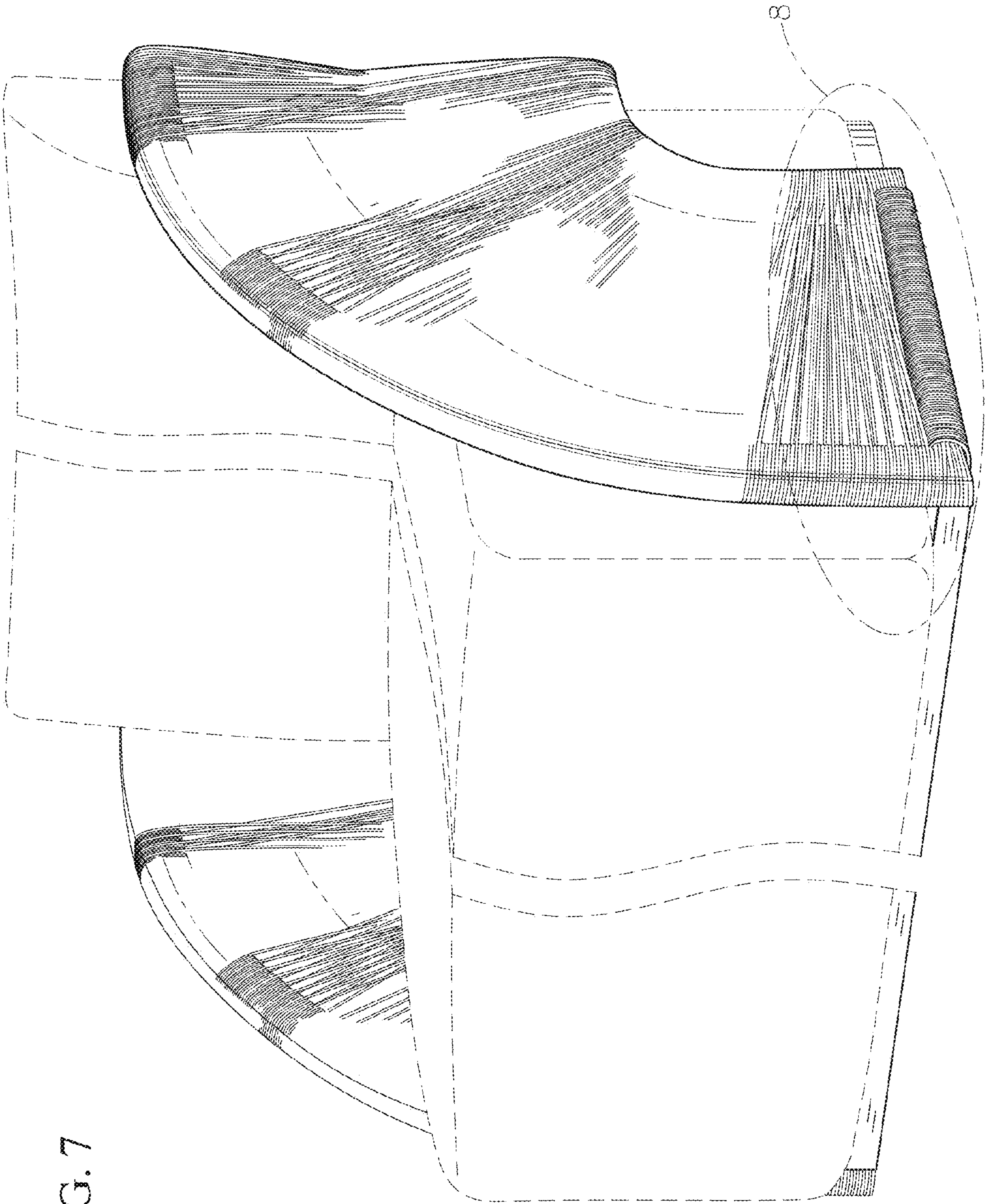
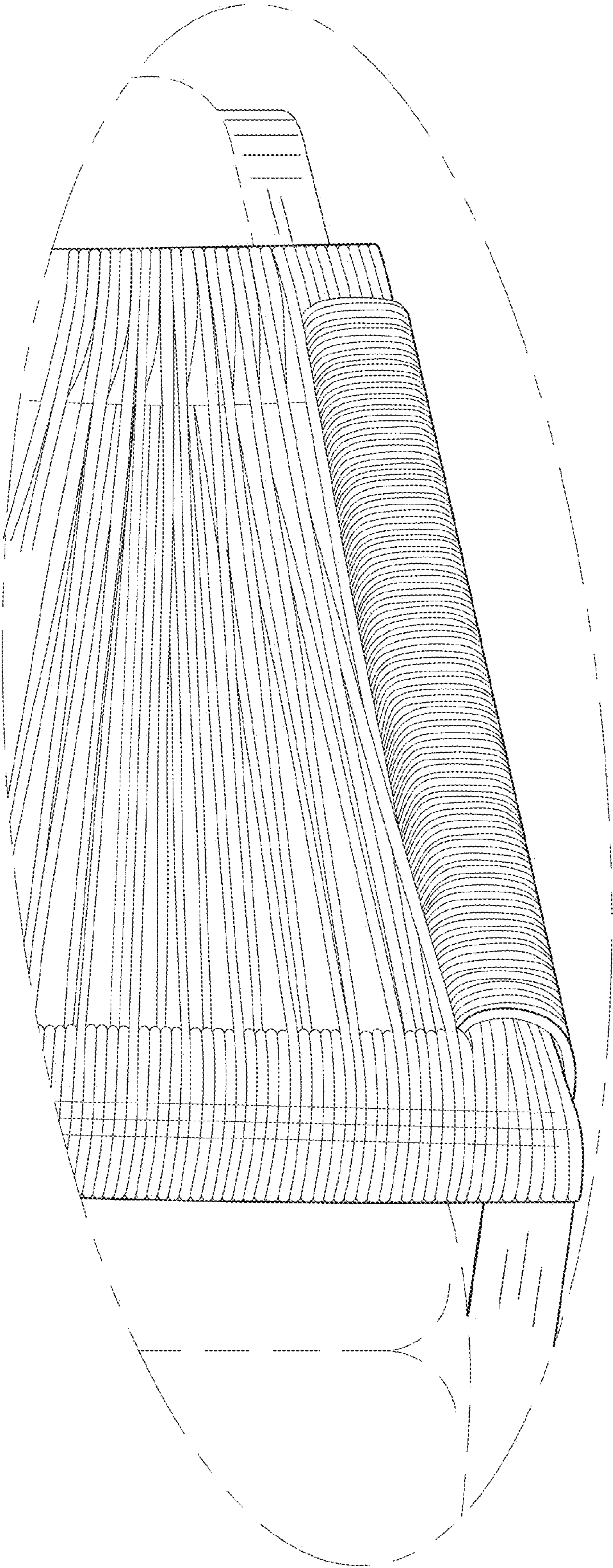

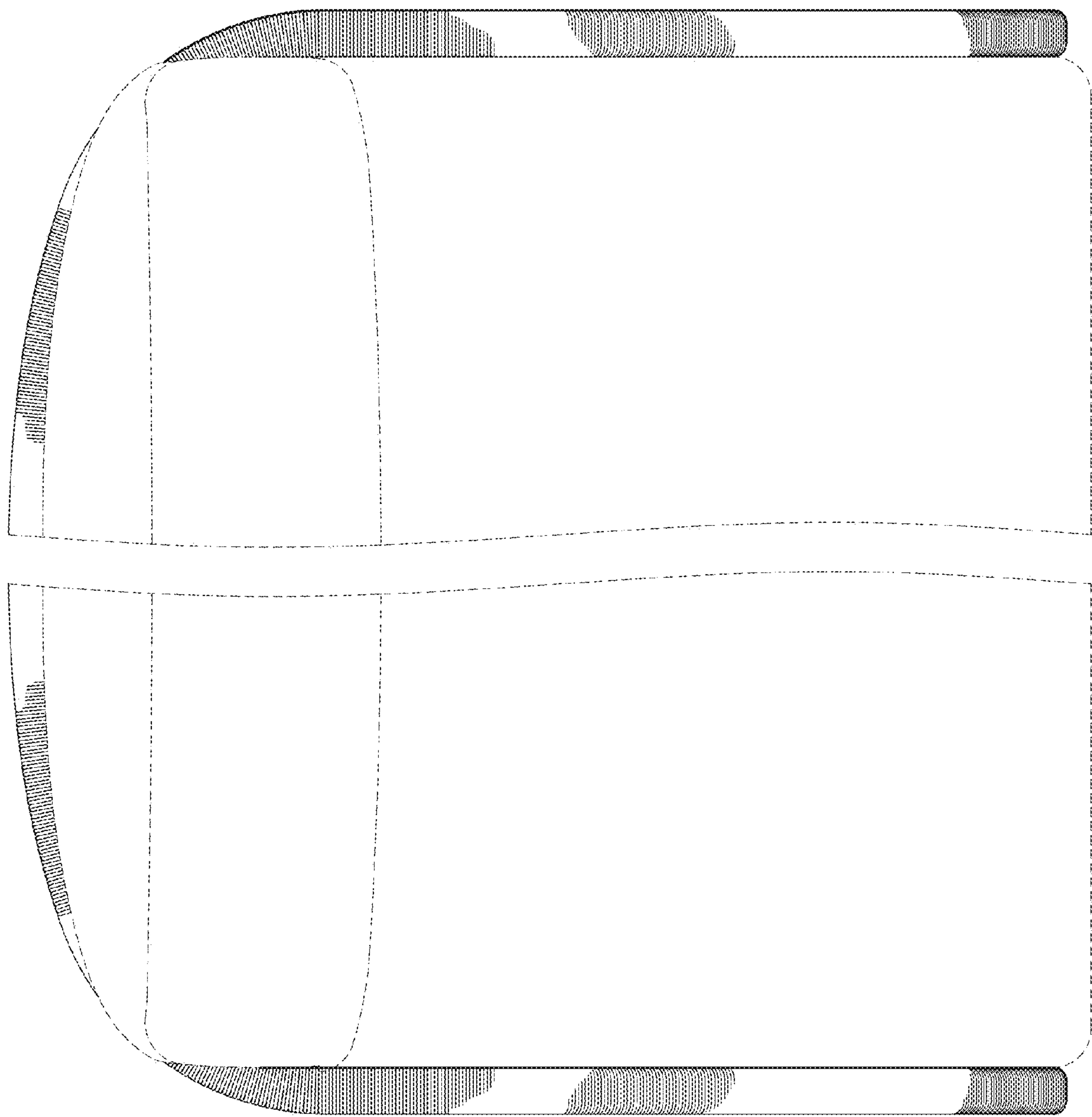

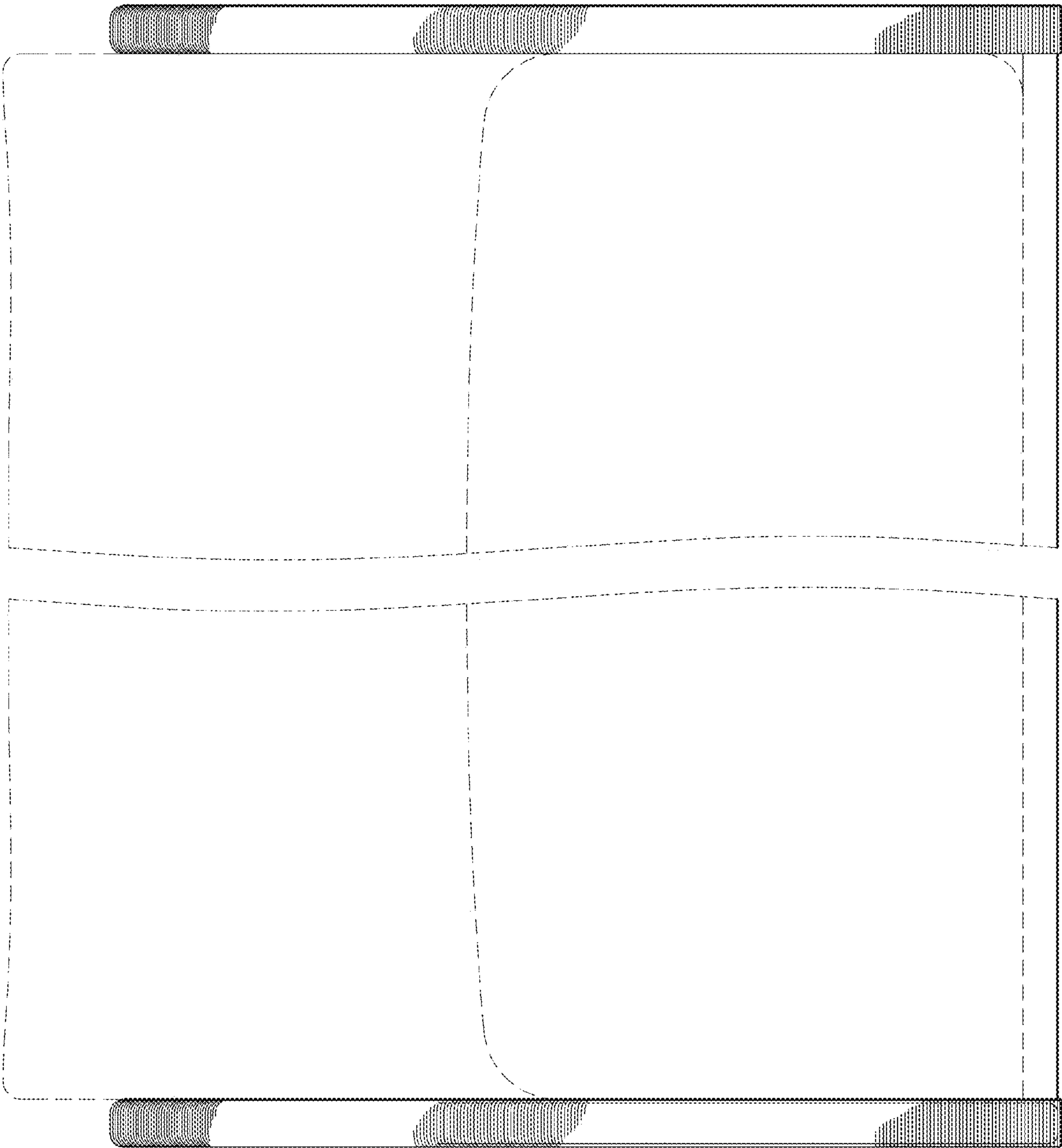
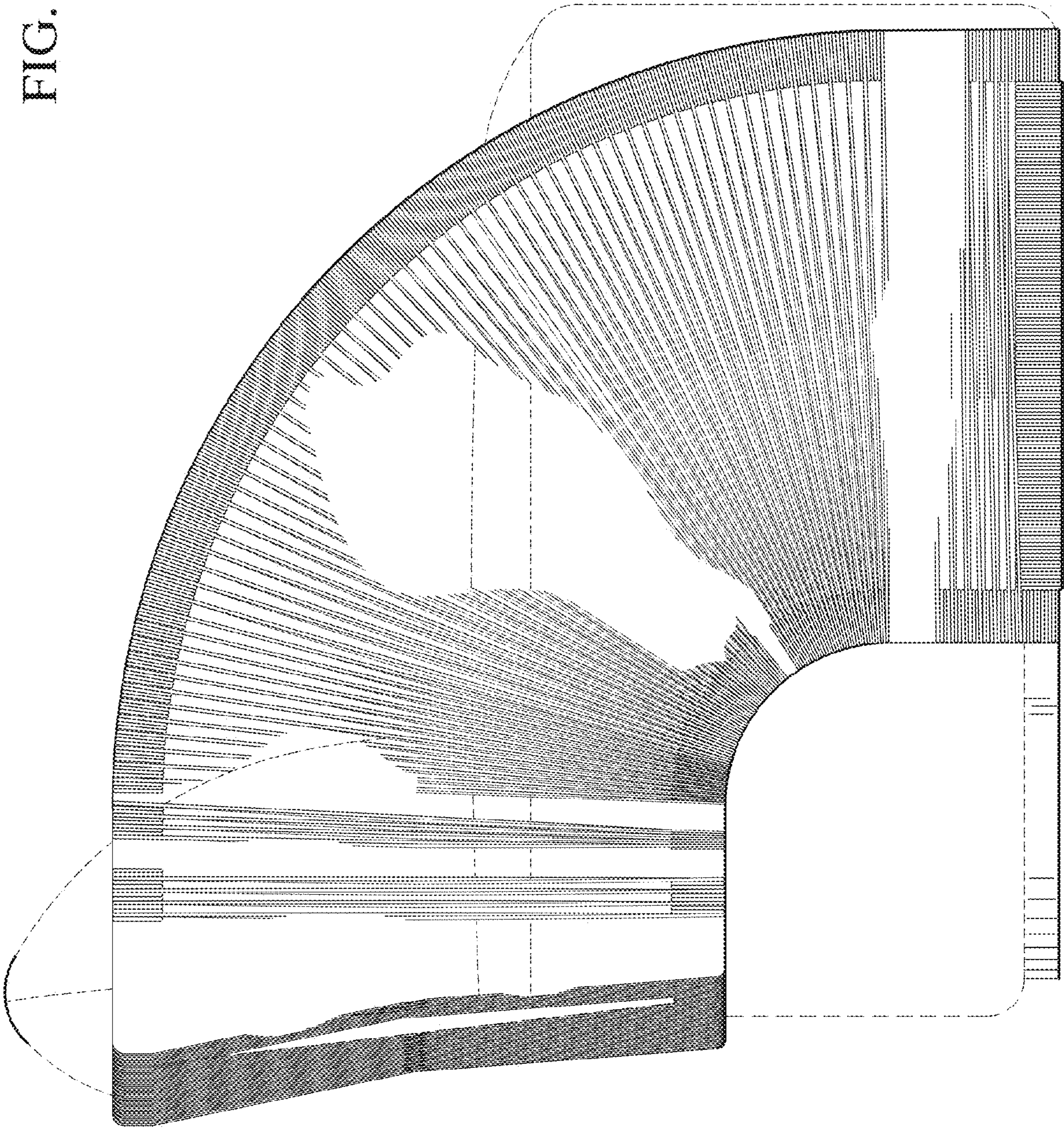

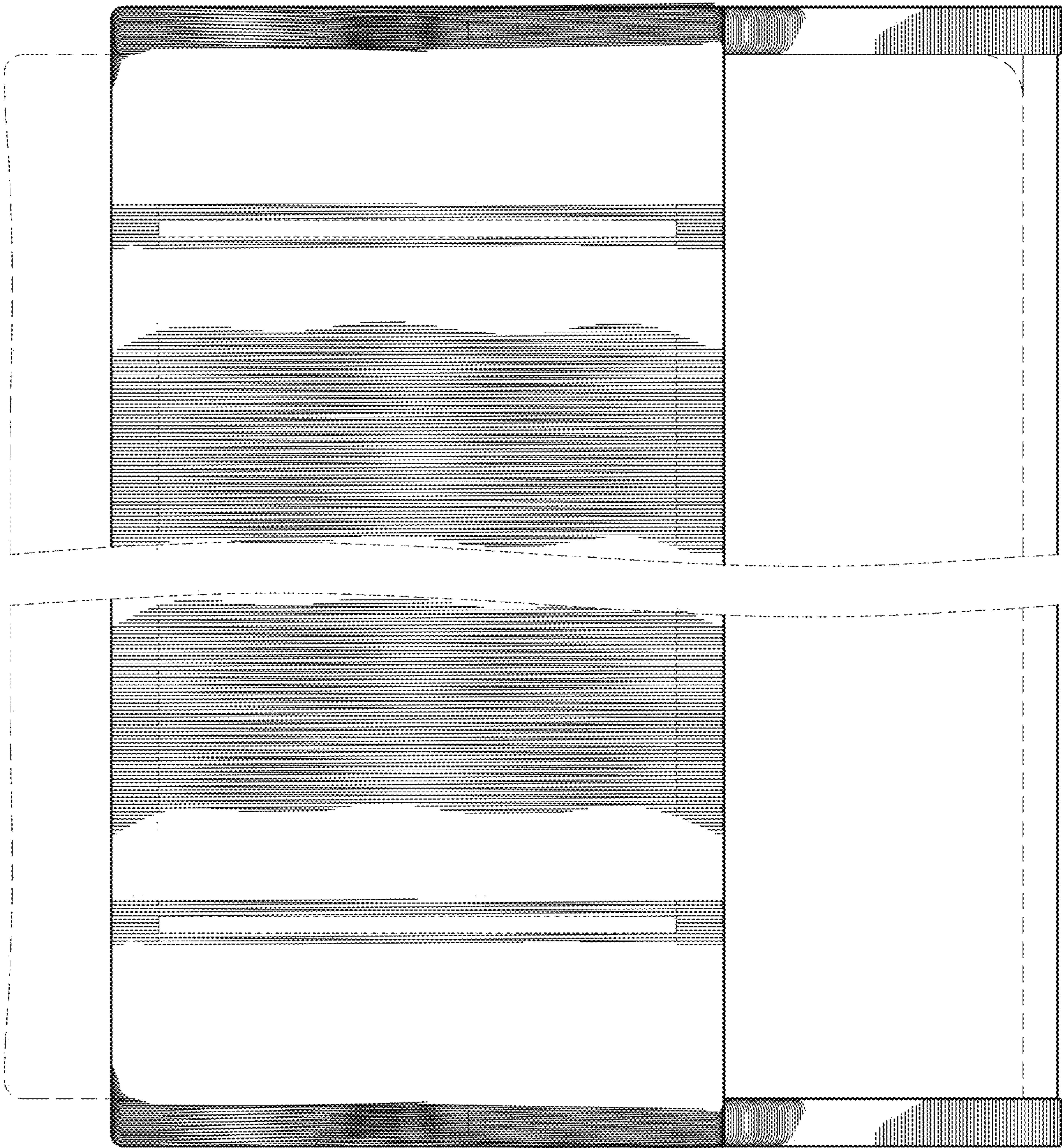

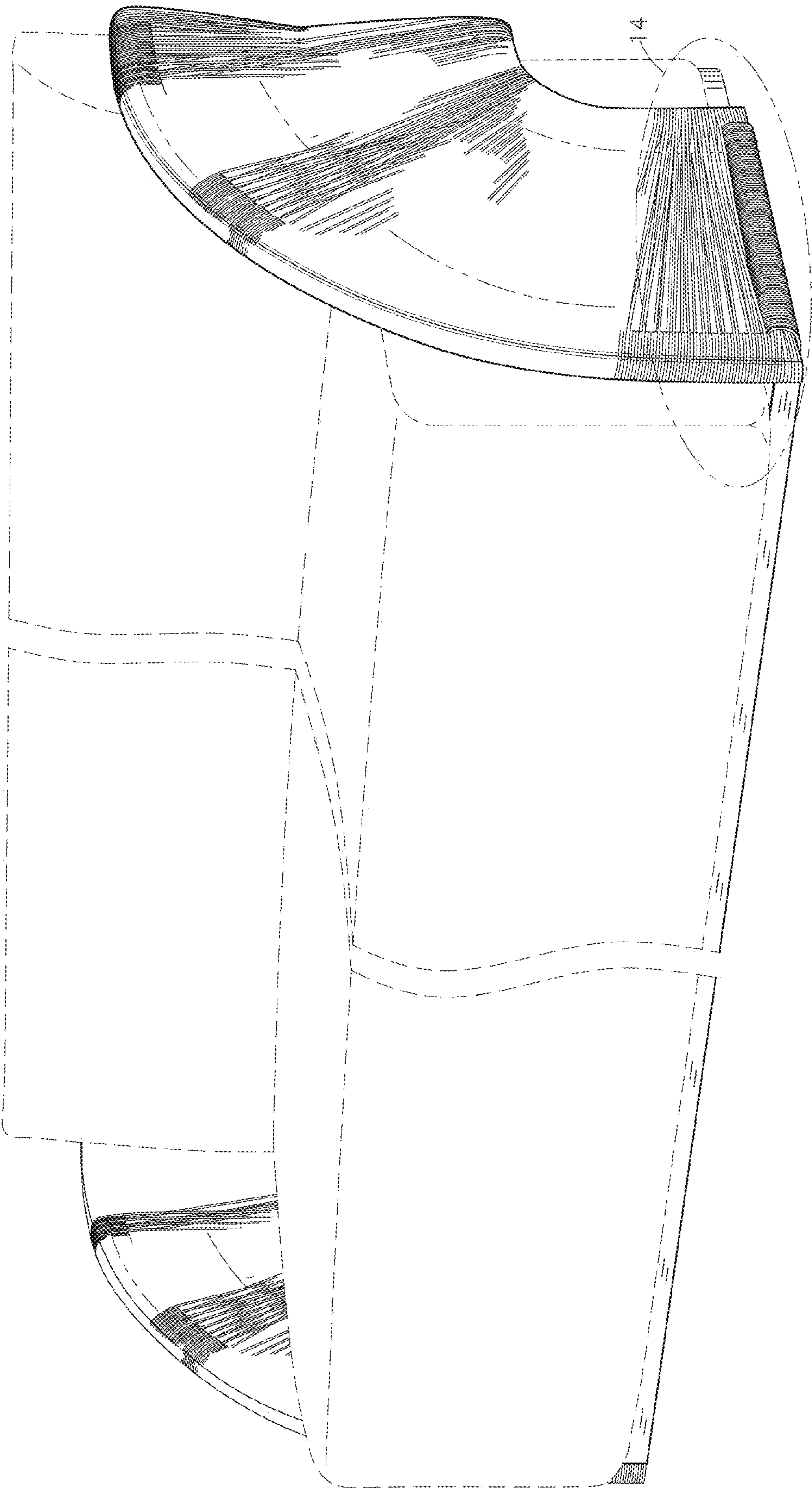

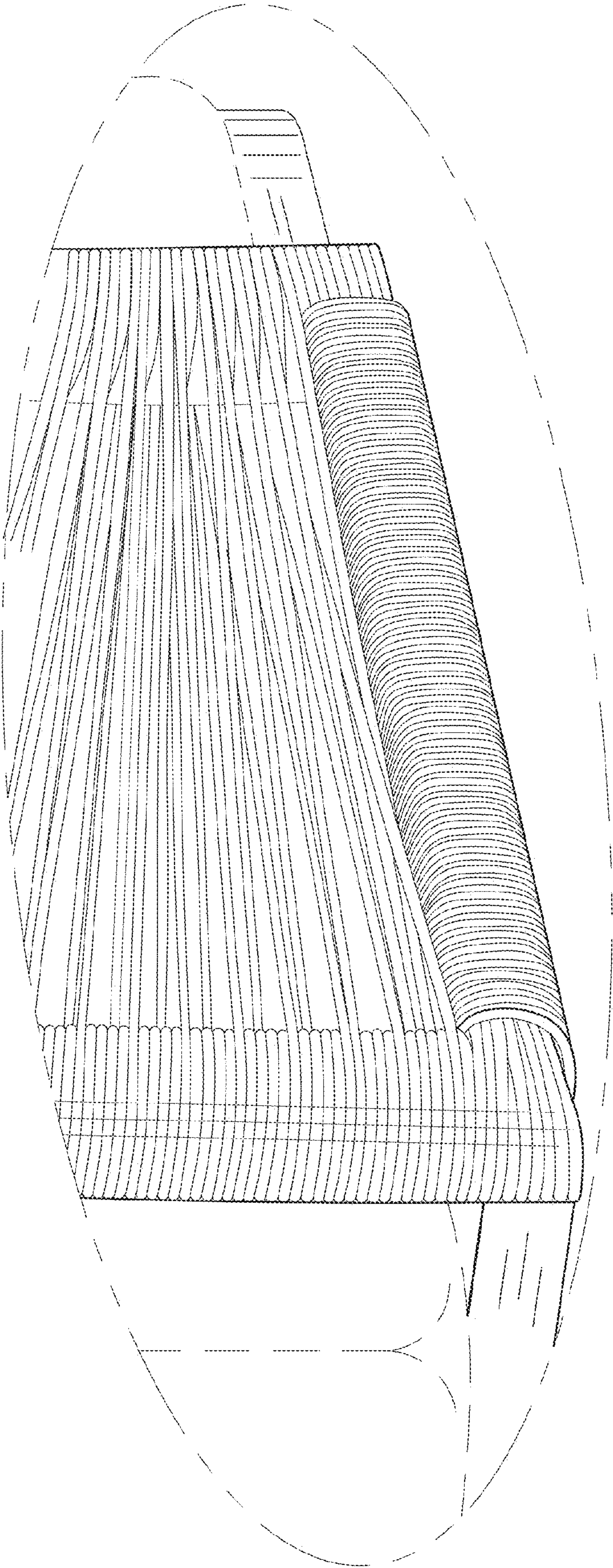

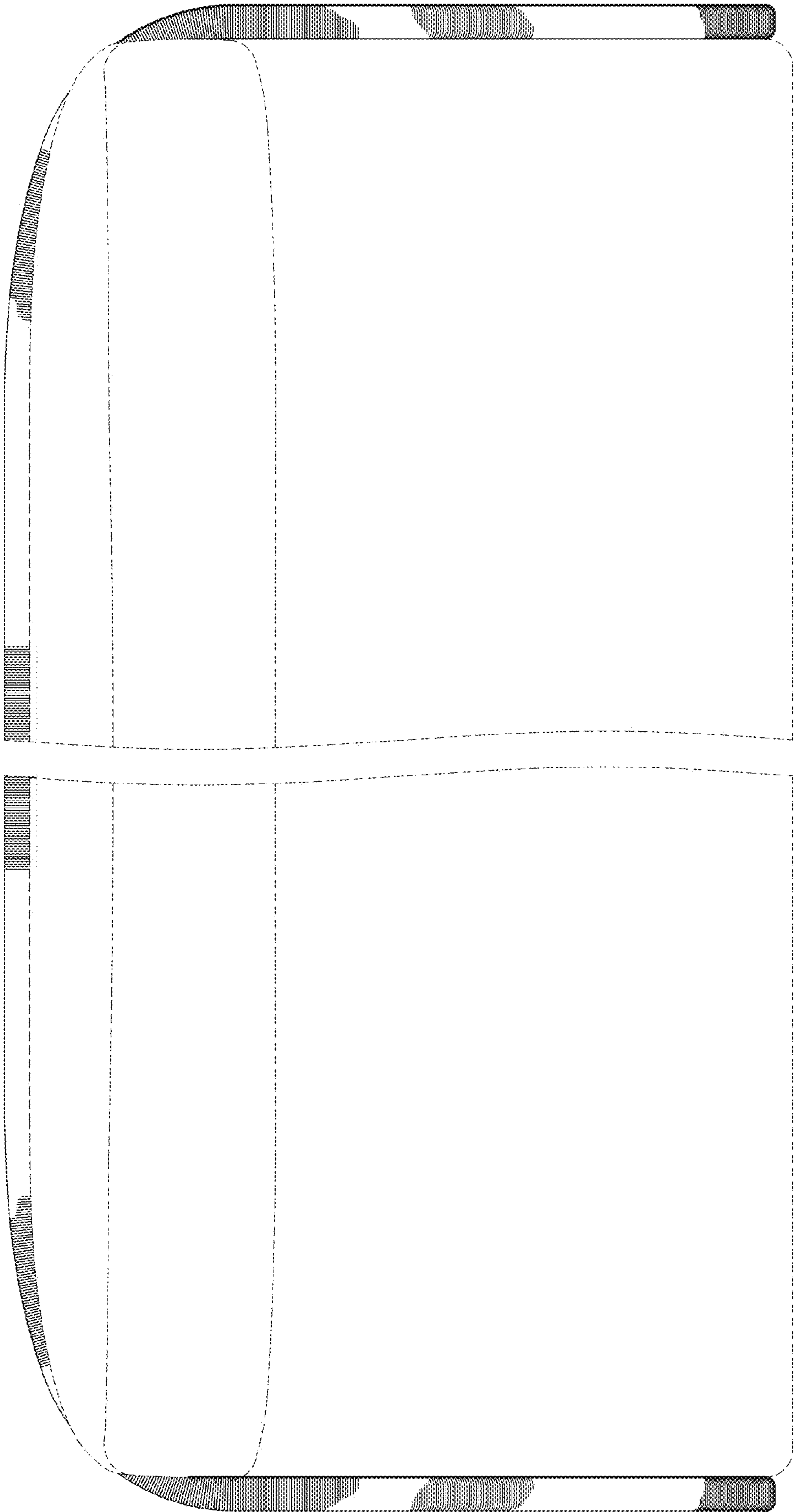

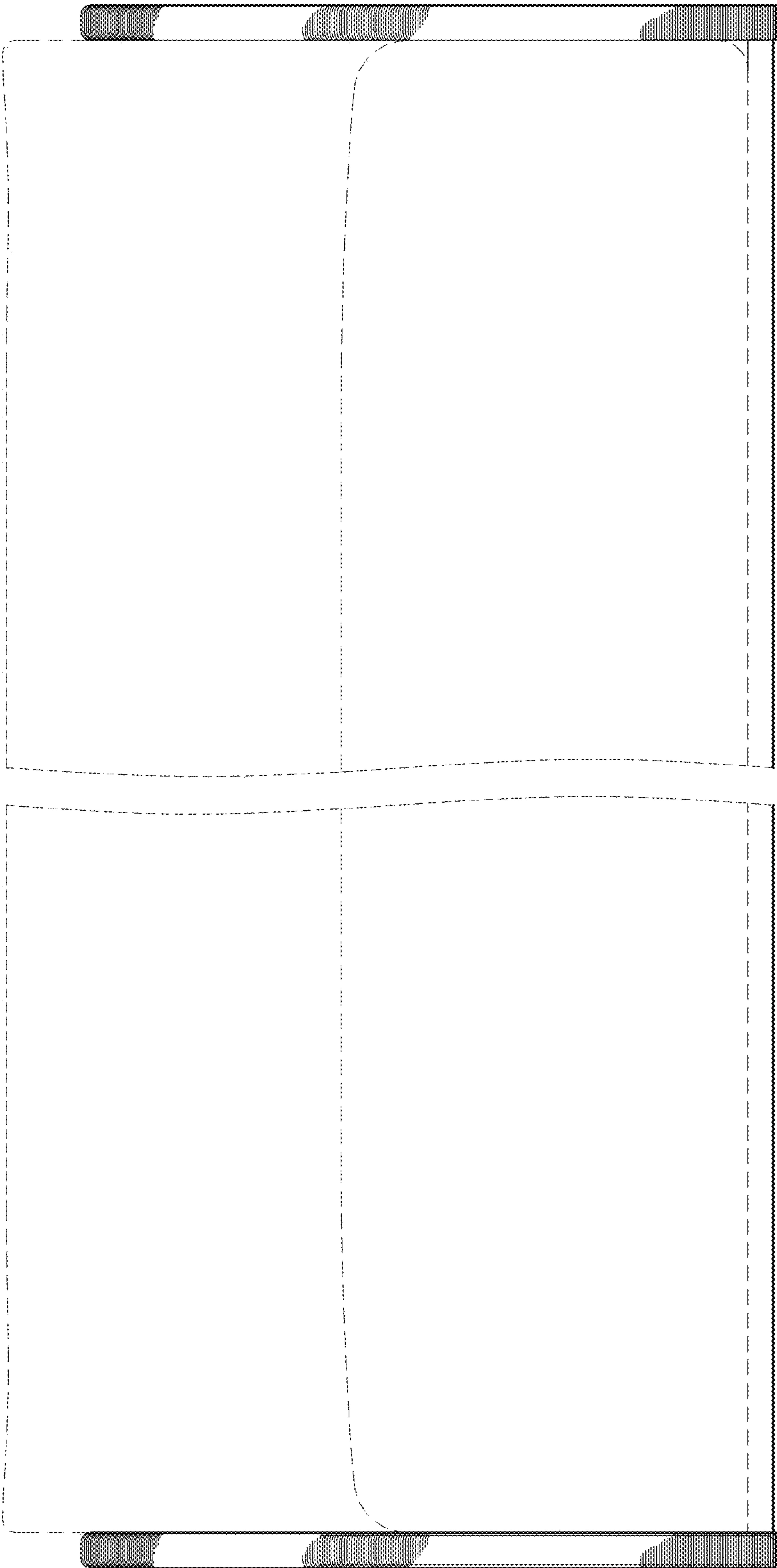

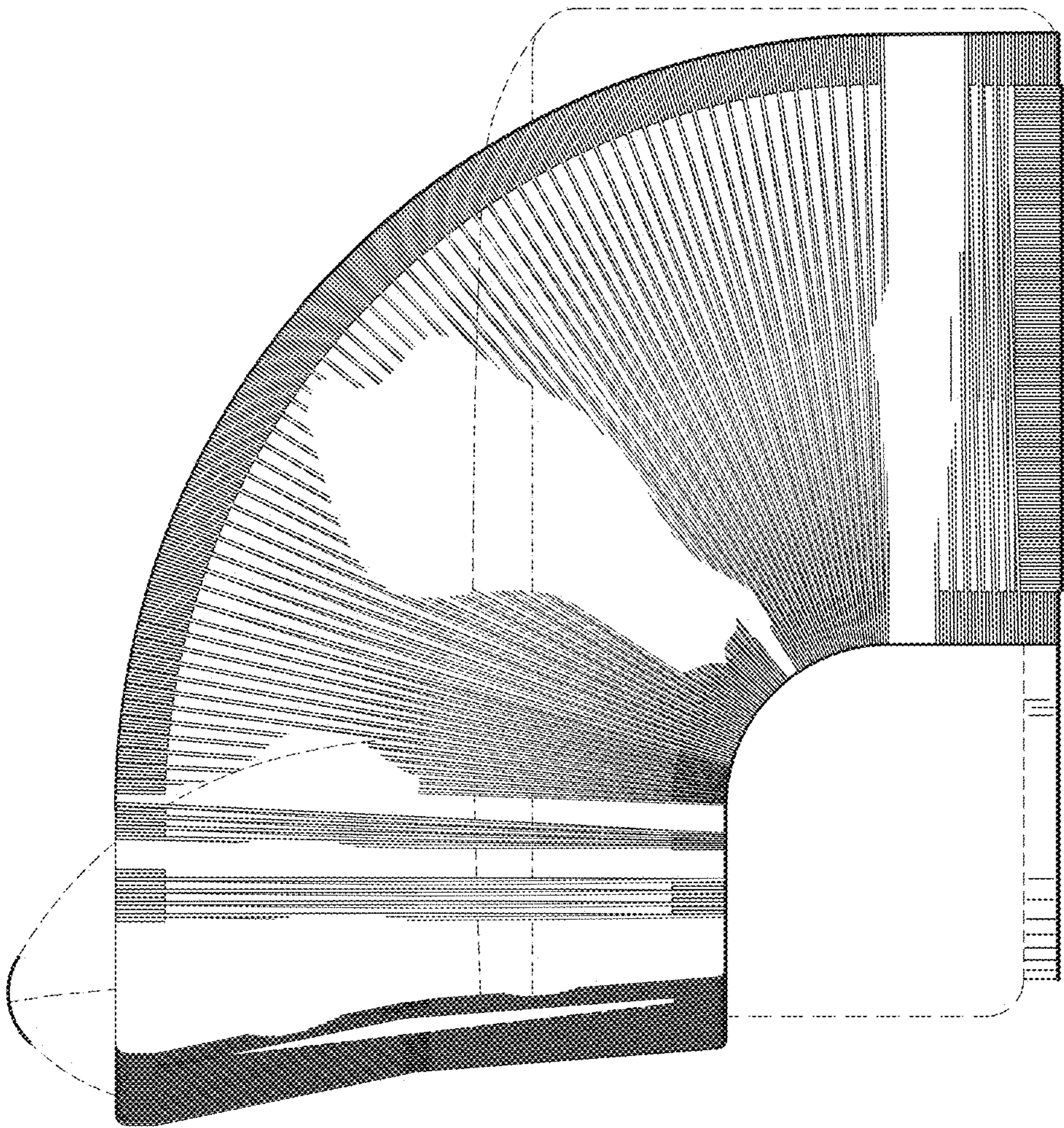
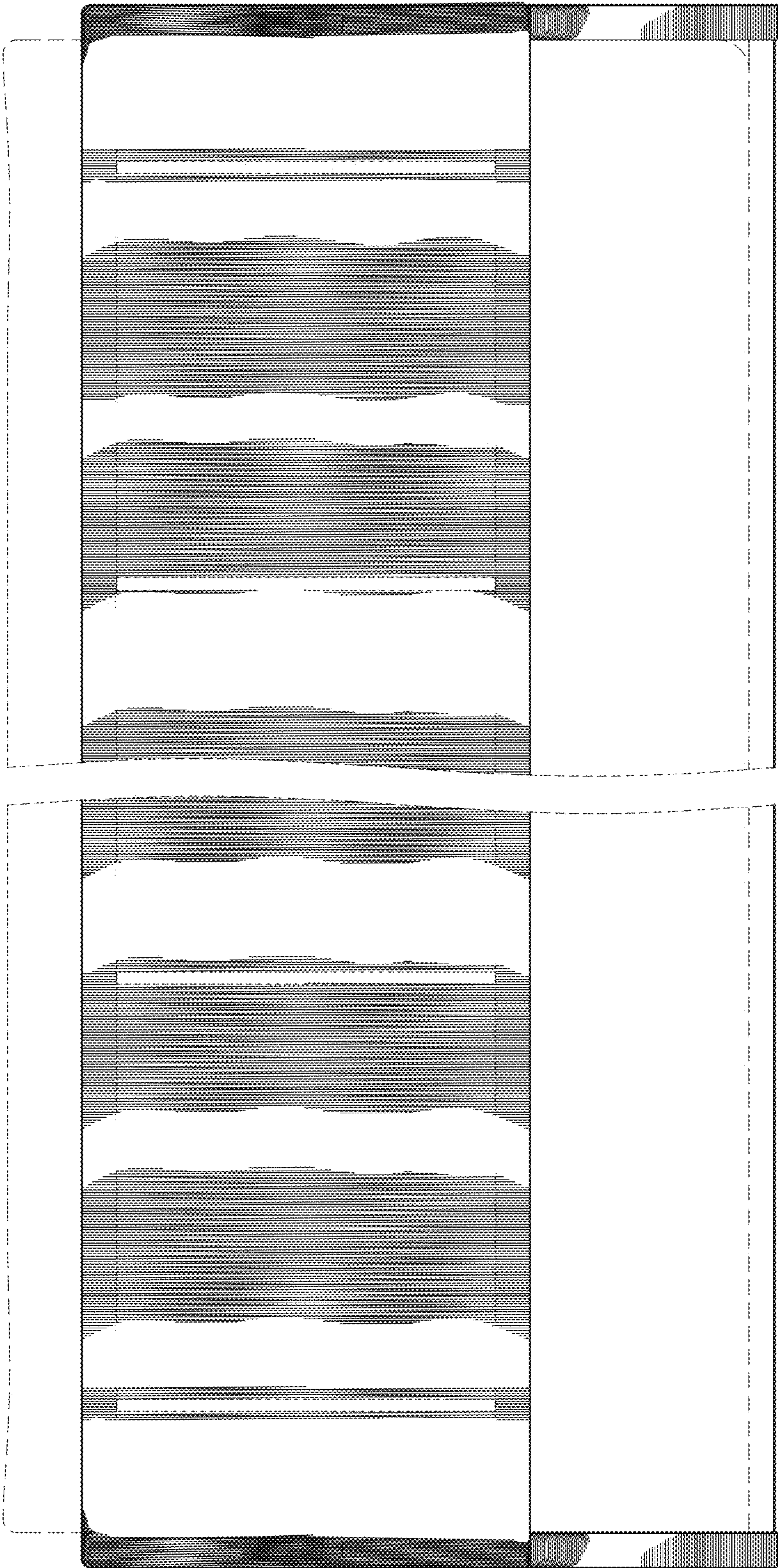

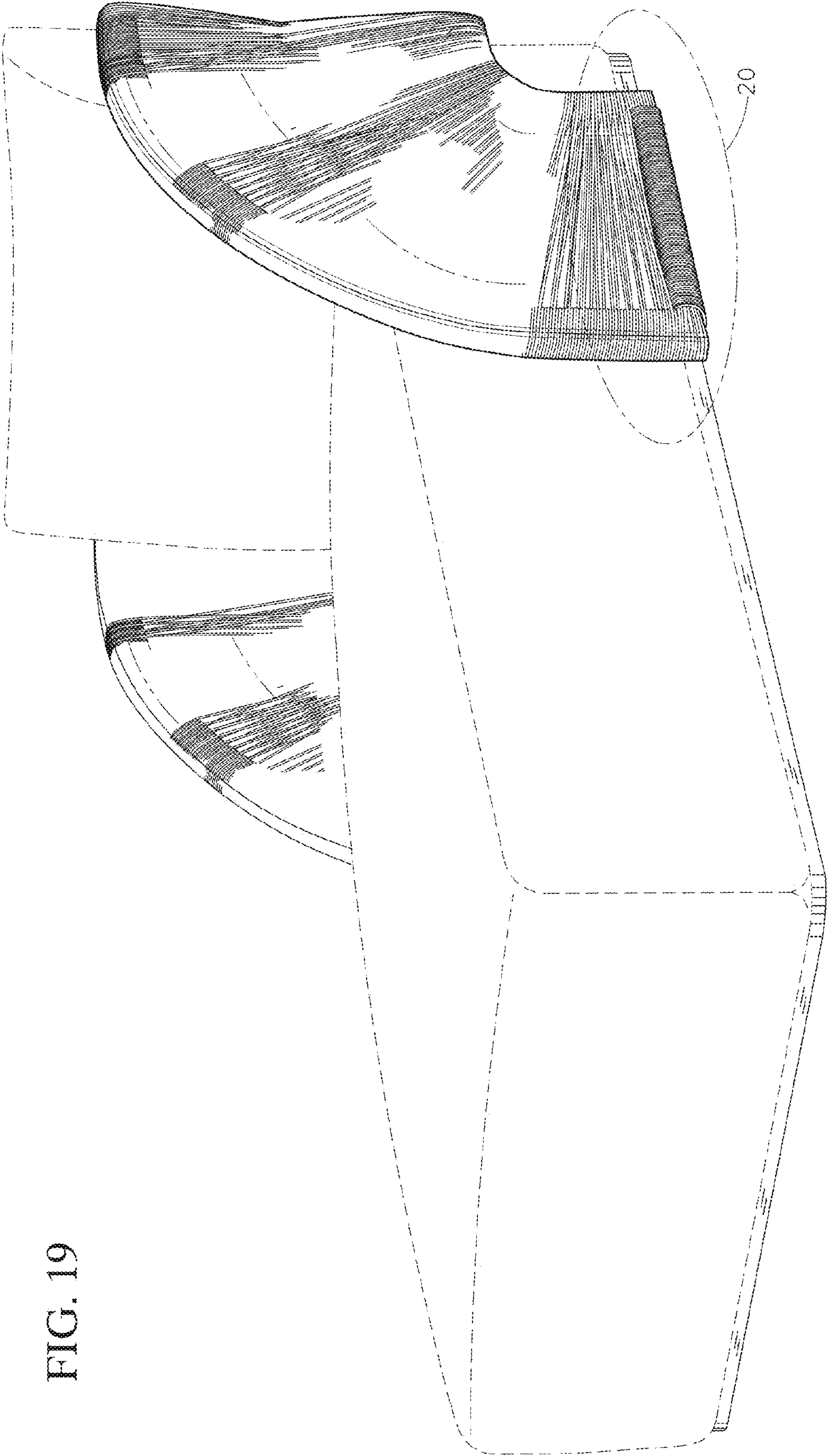

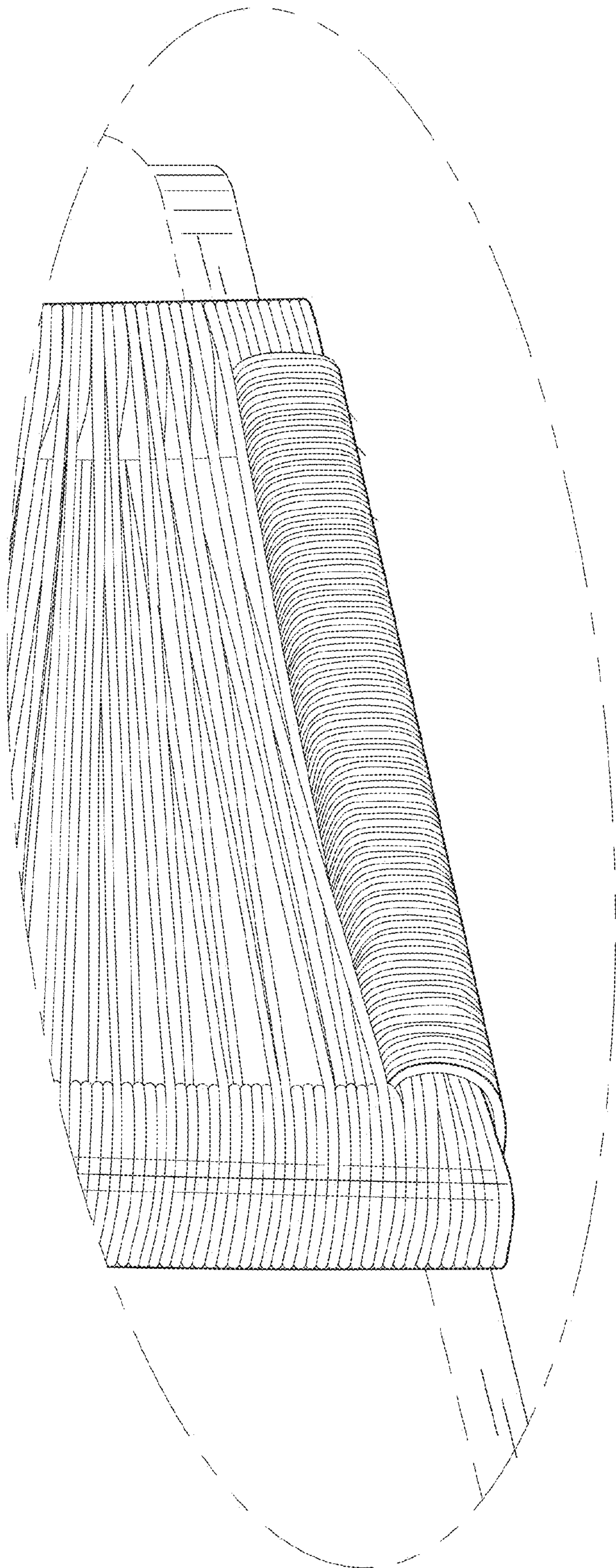

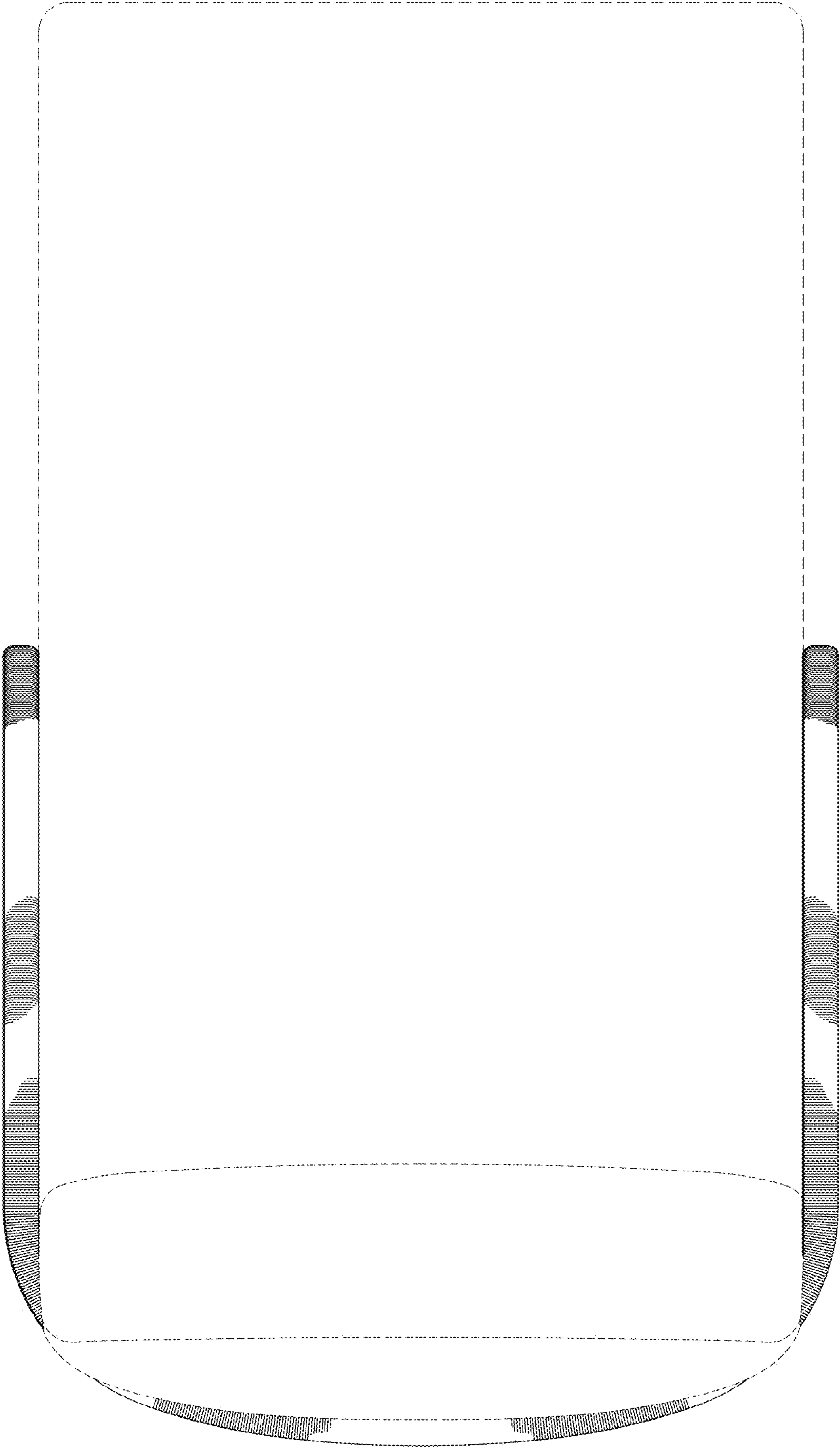

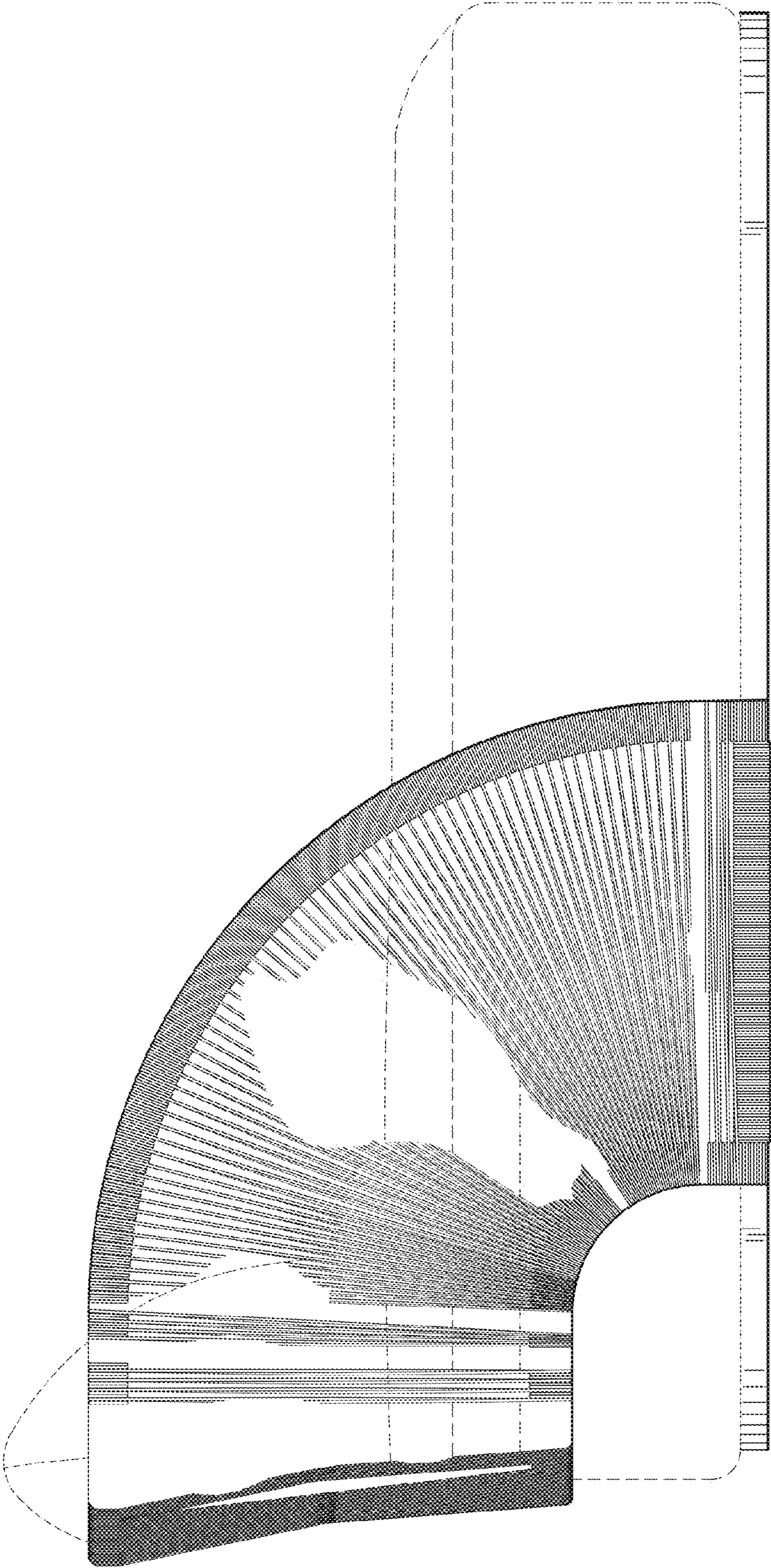

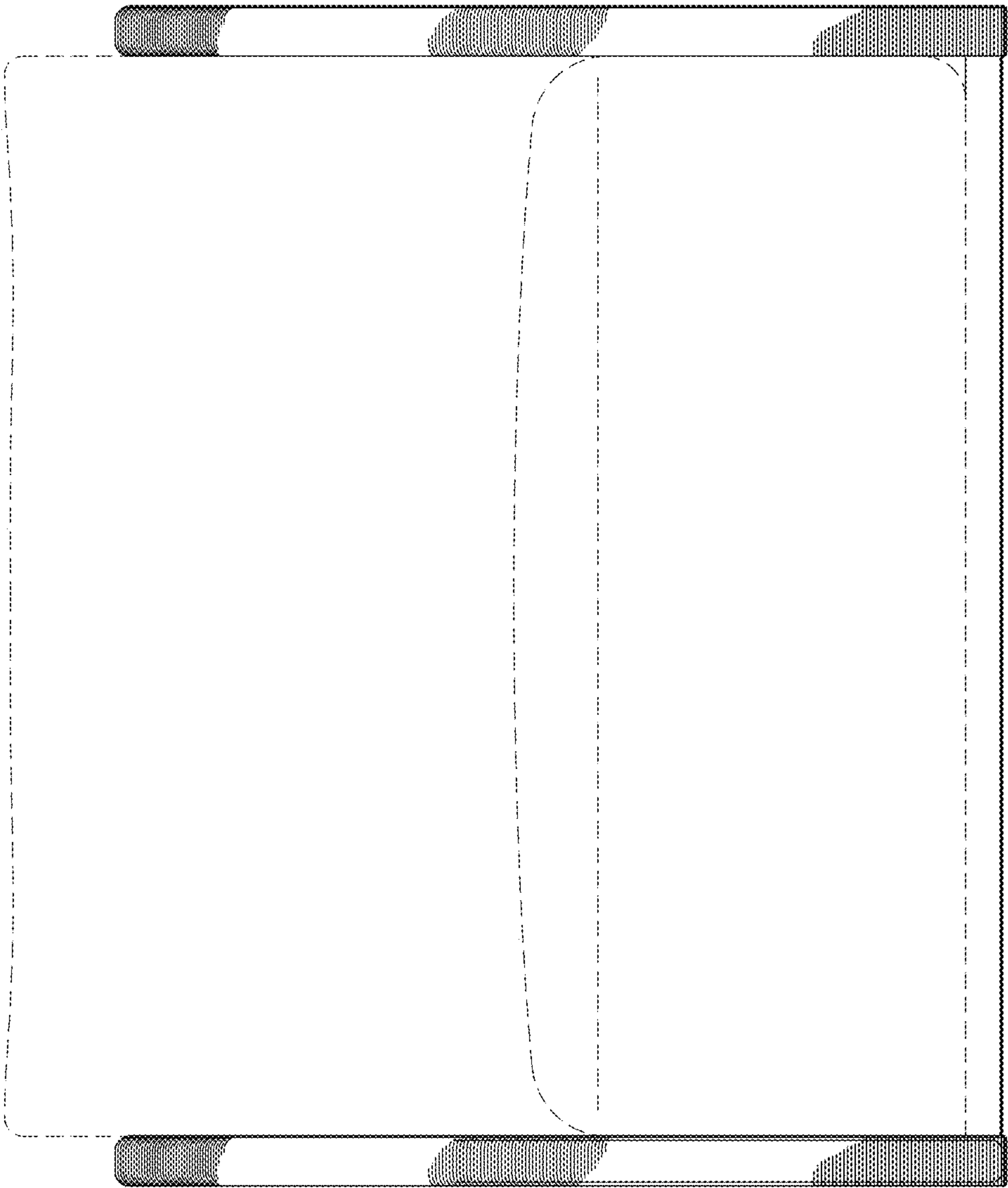
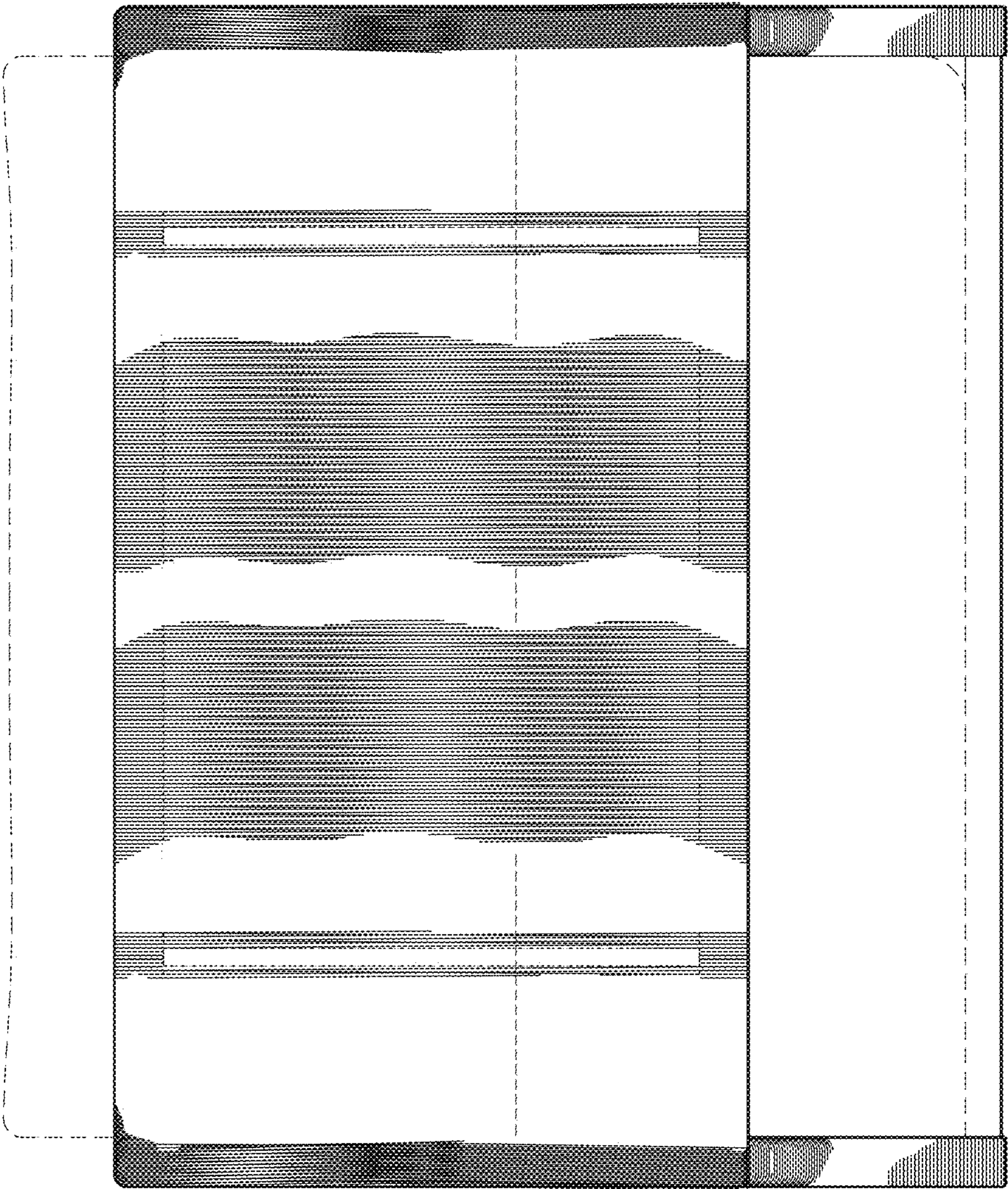

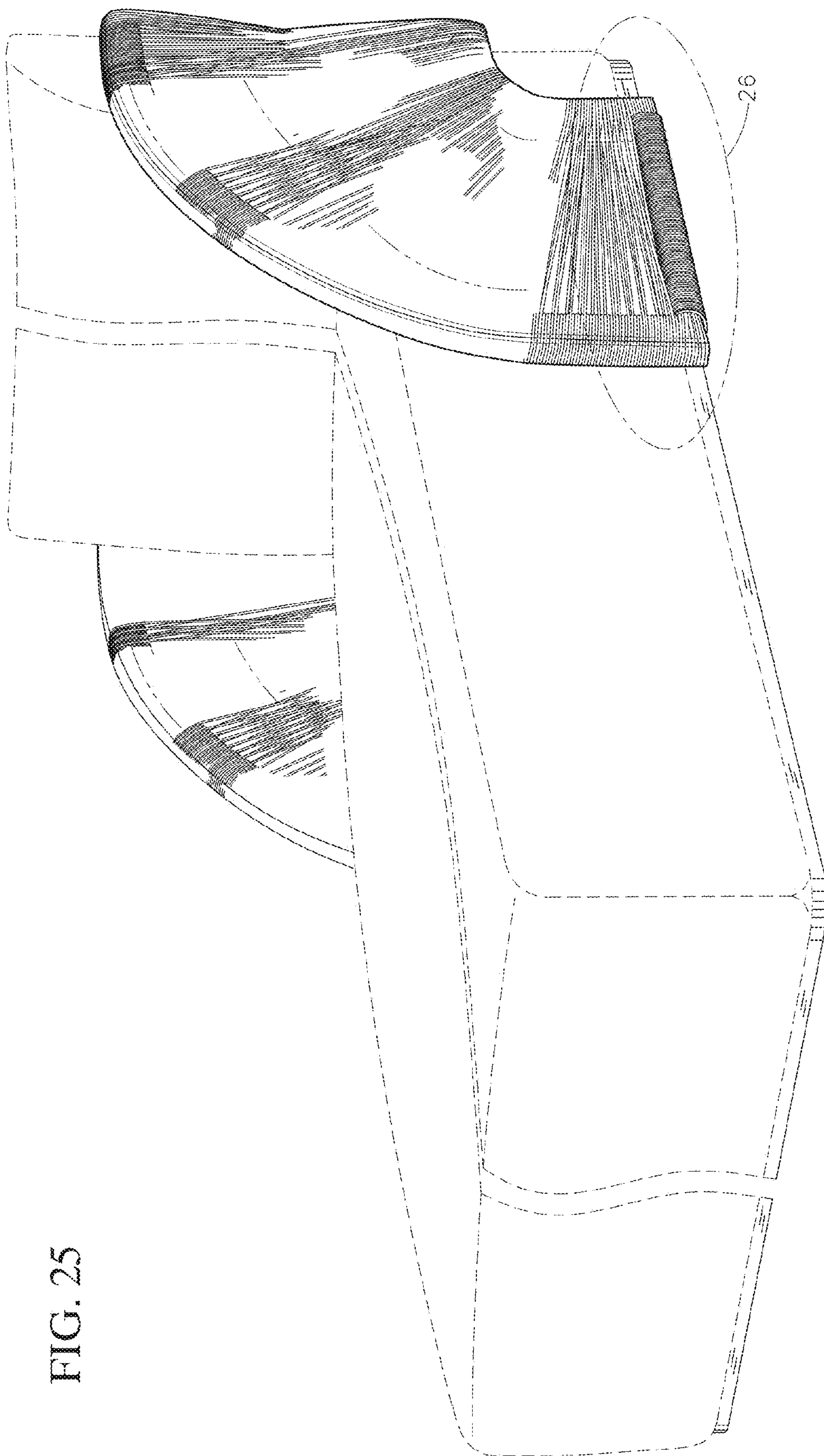

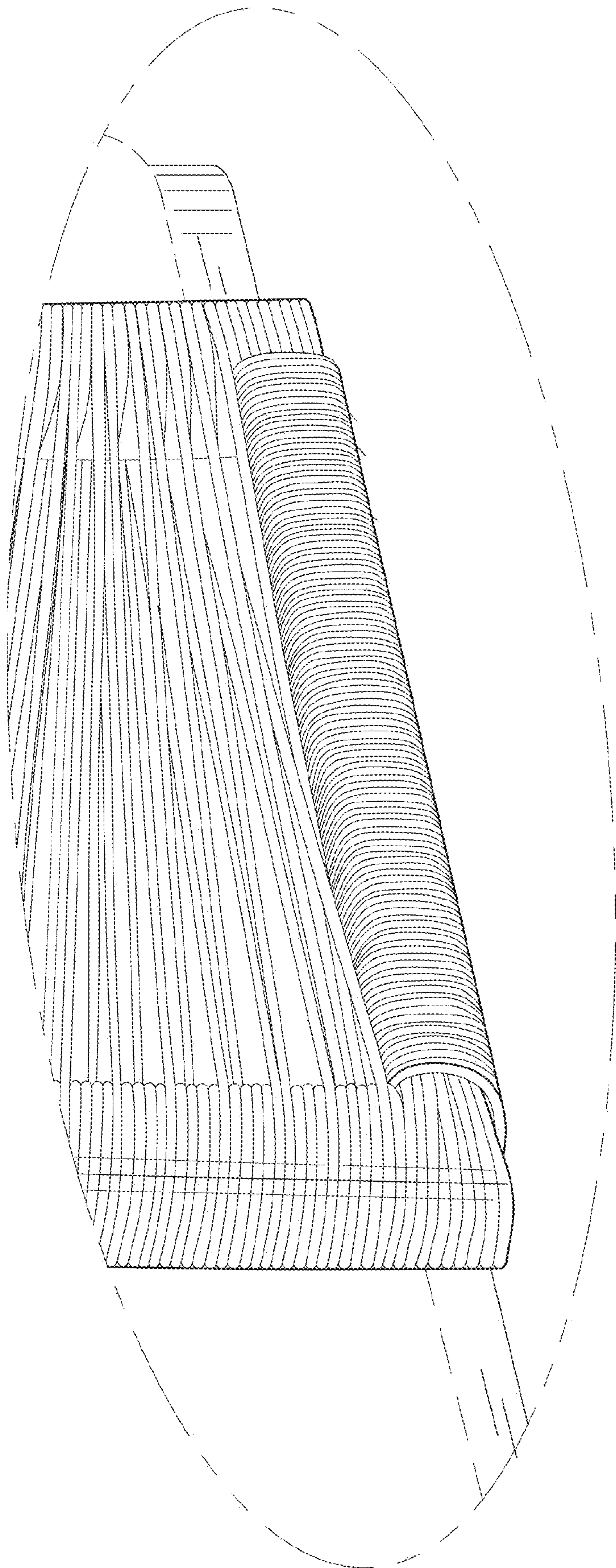

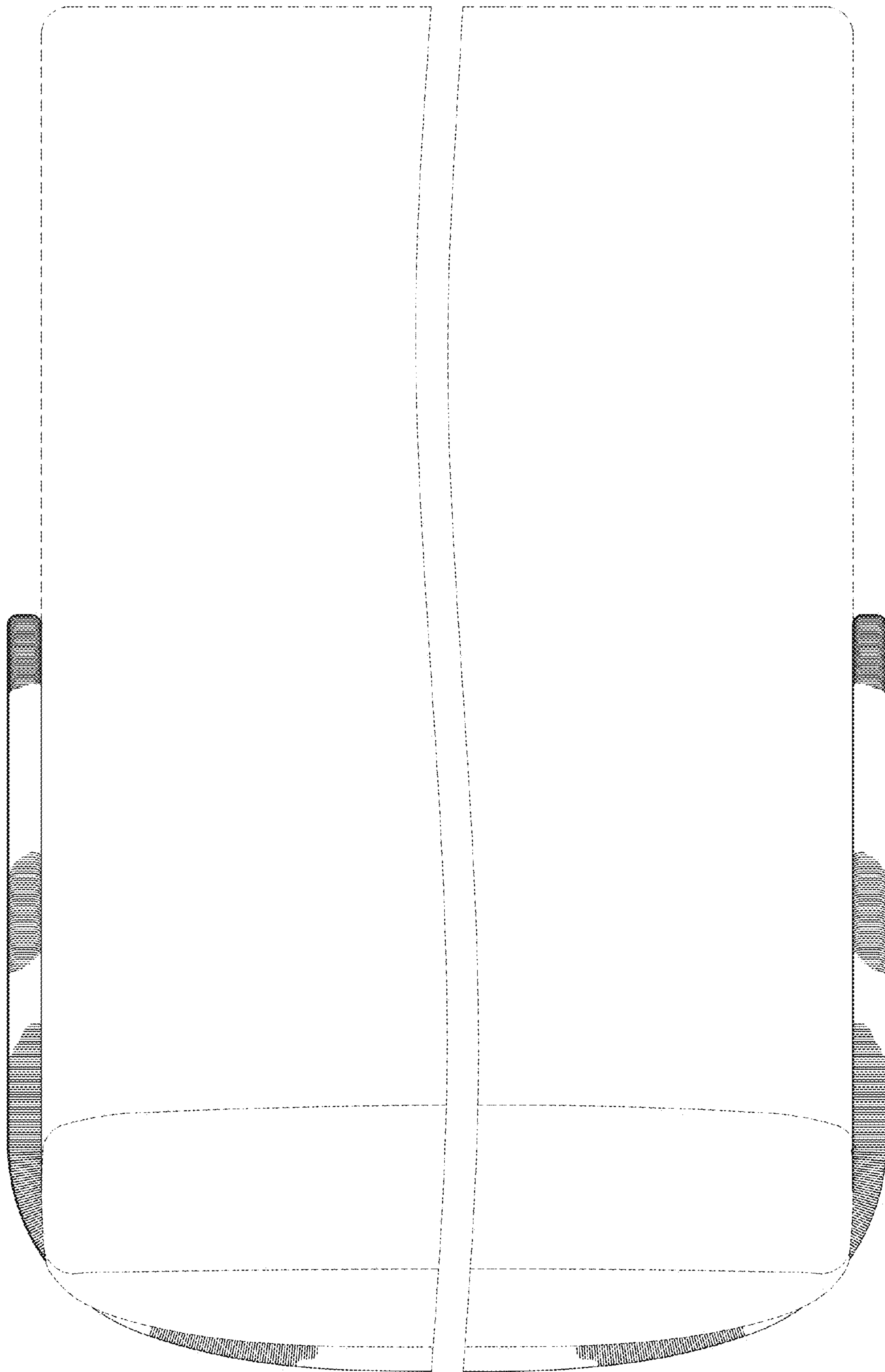

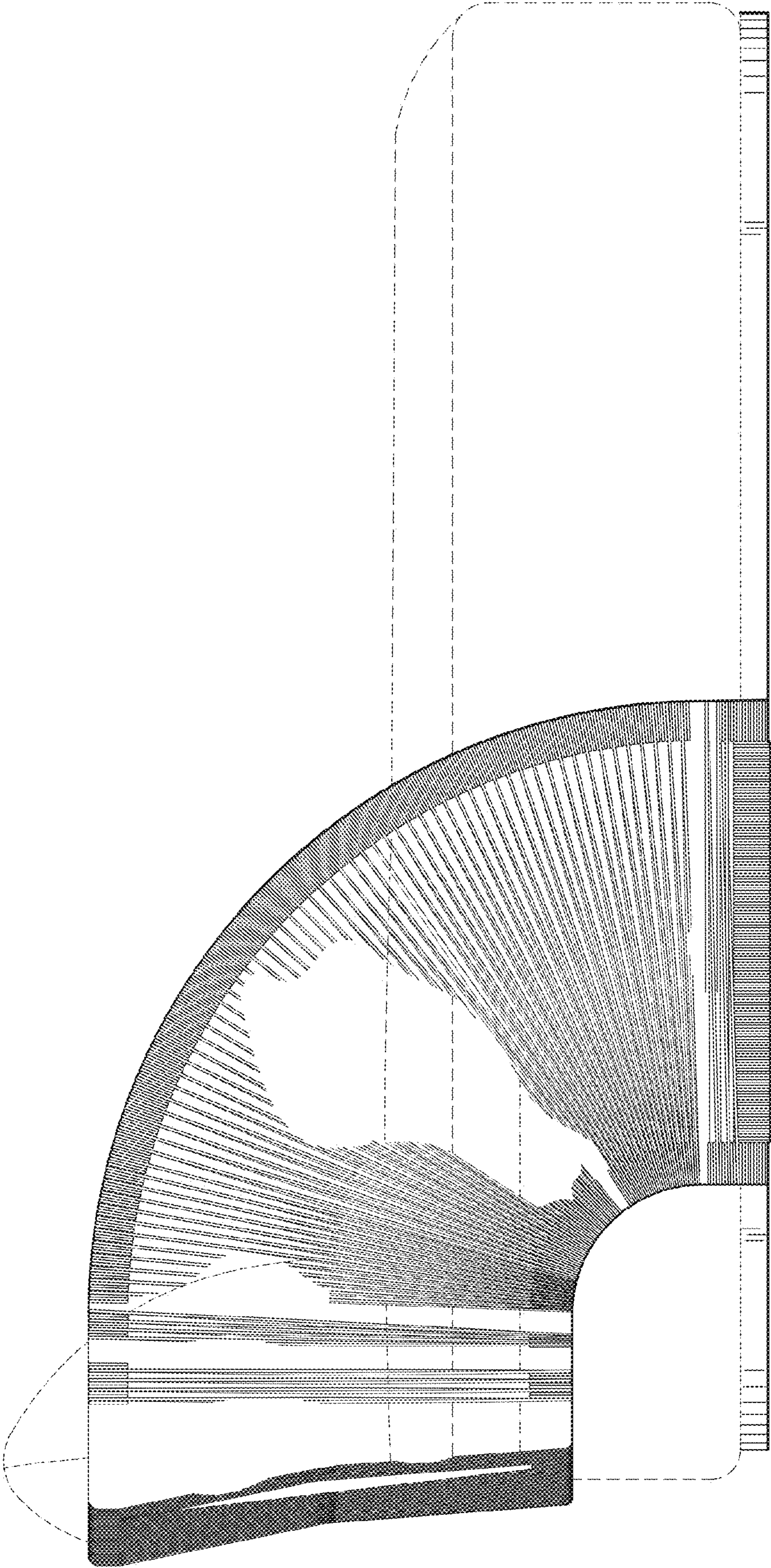

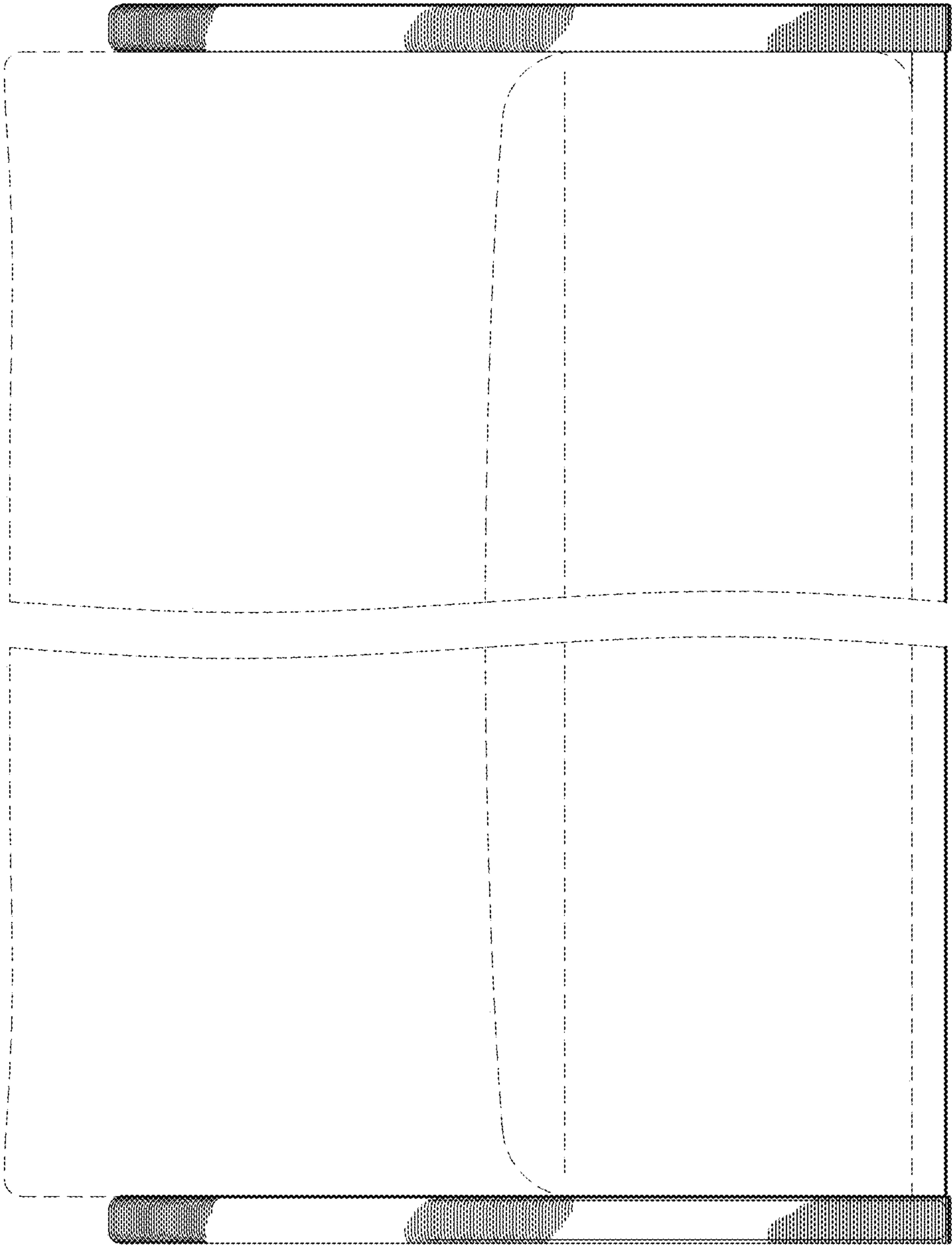
