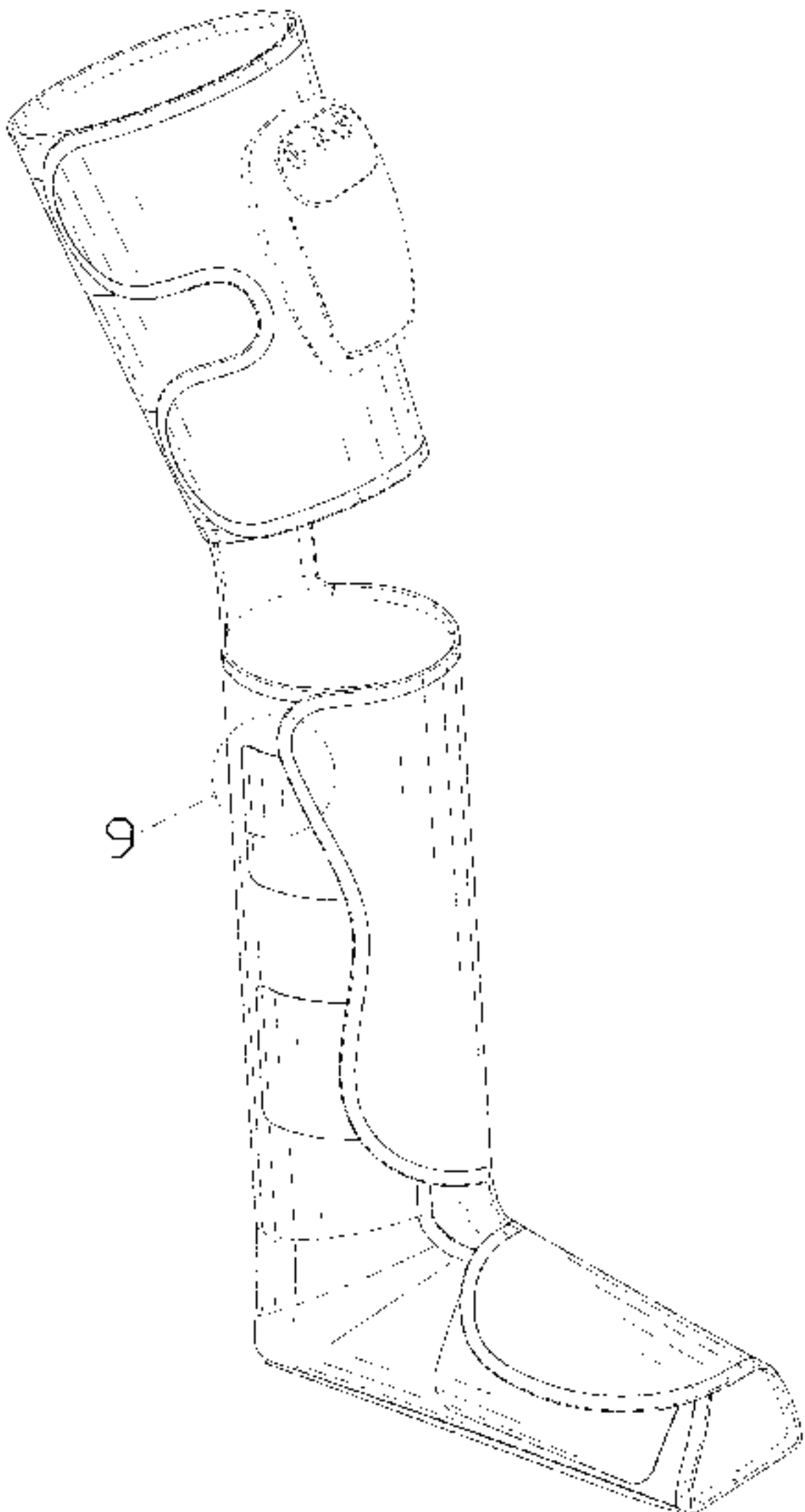
(57) CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a leg massager showing my new design;

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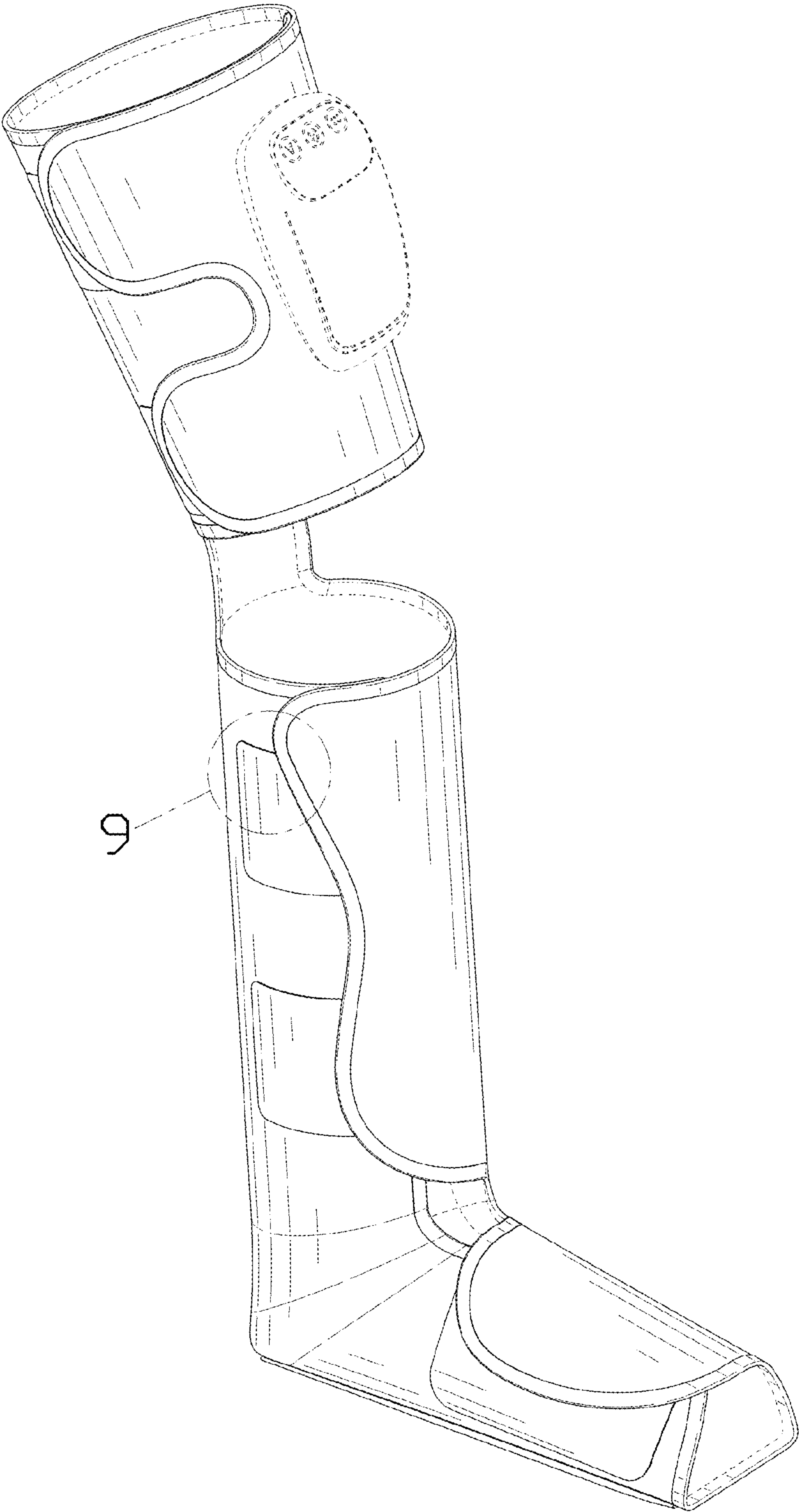

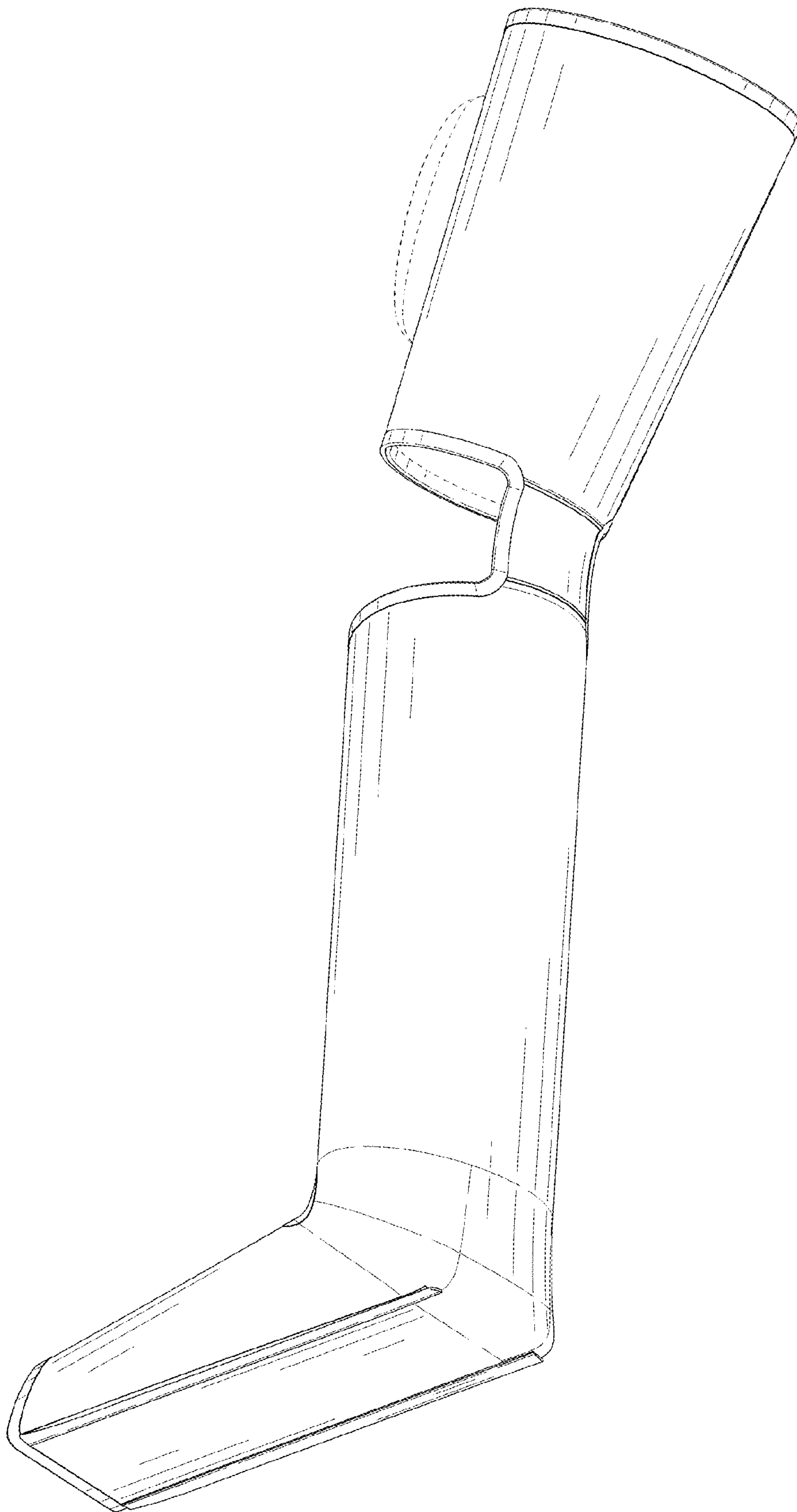

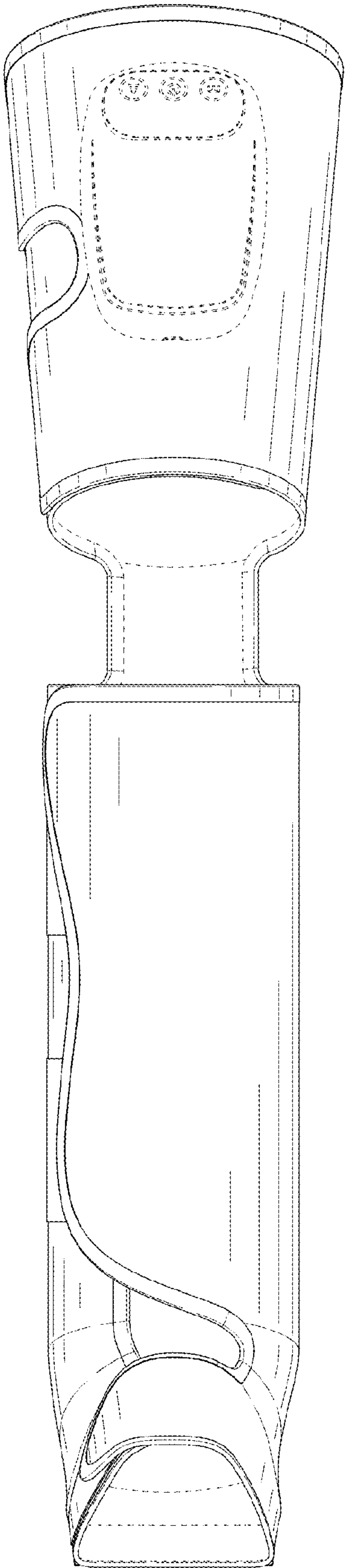

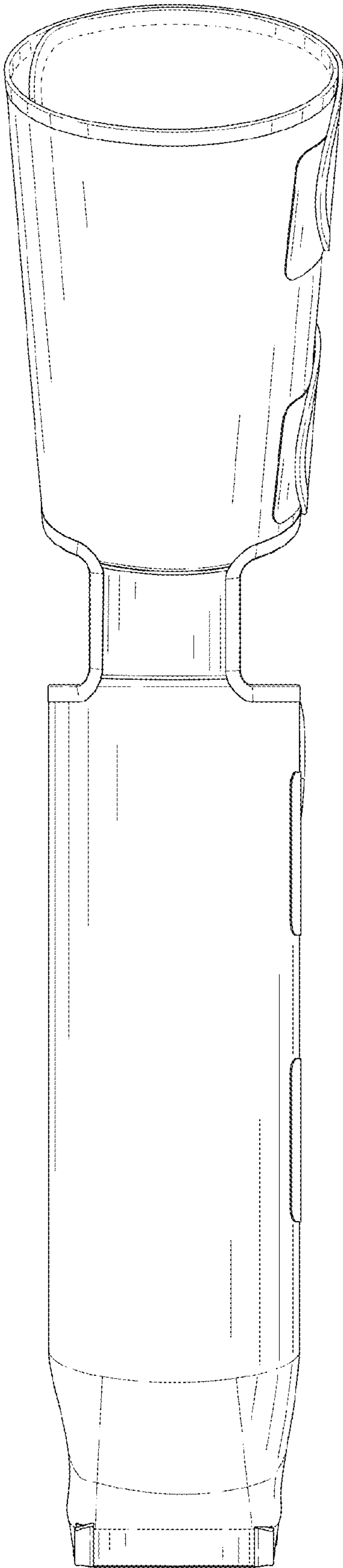

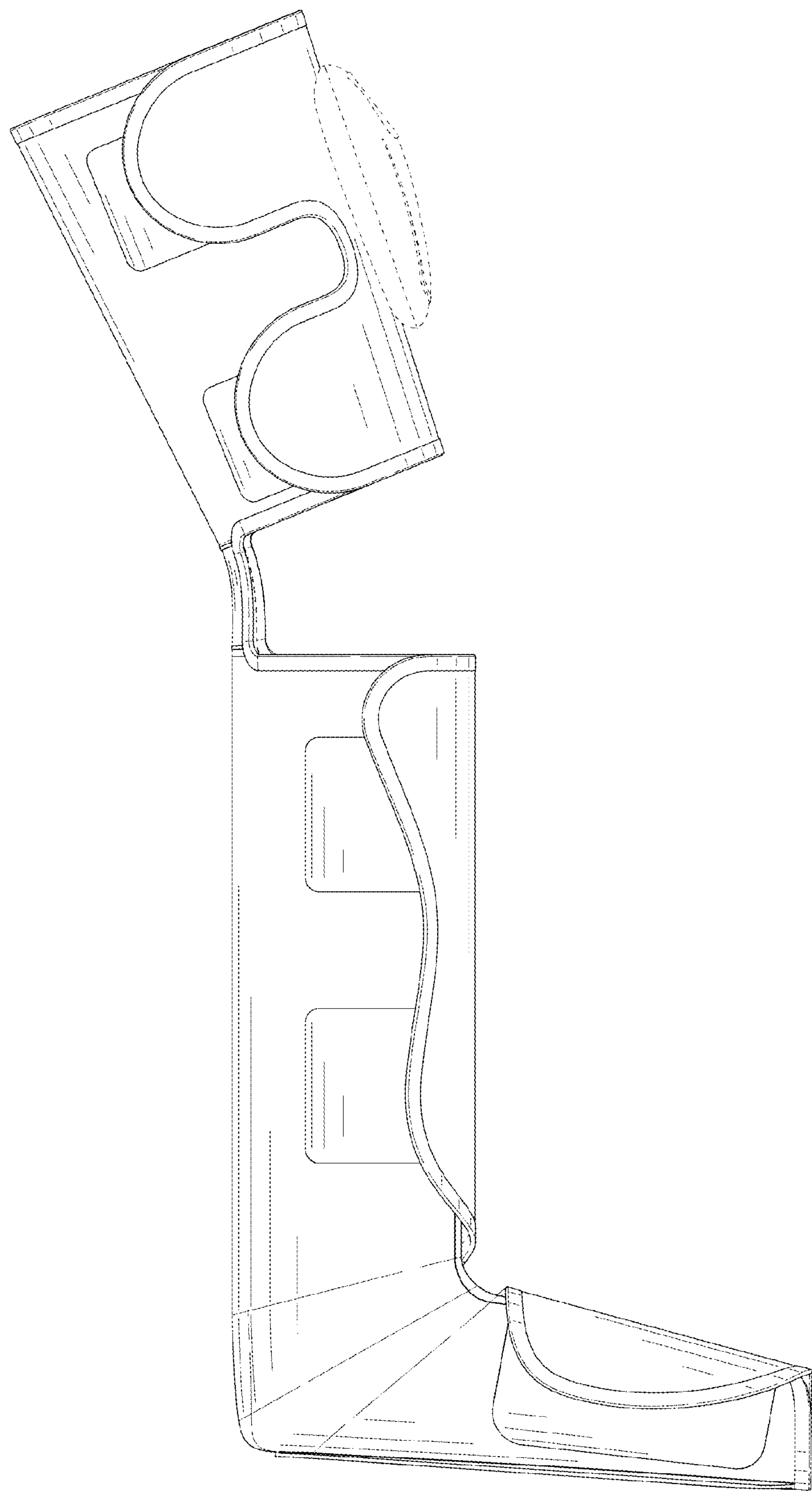

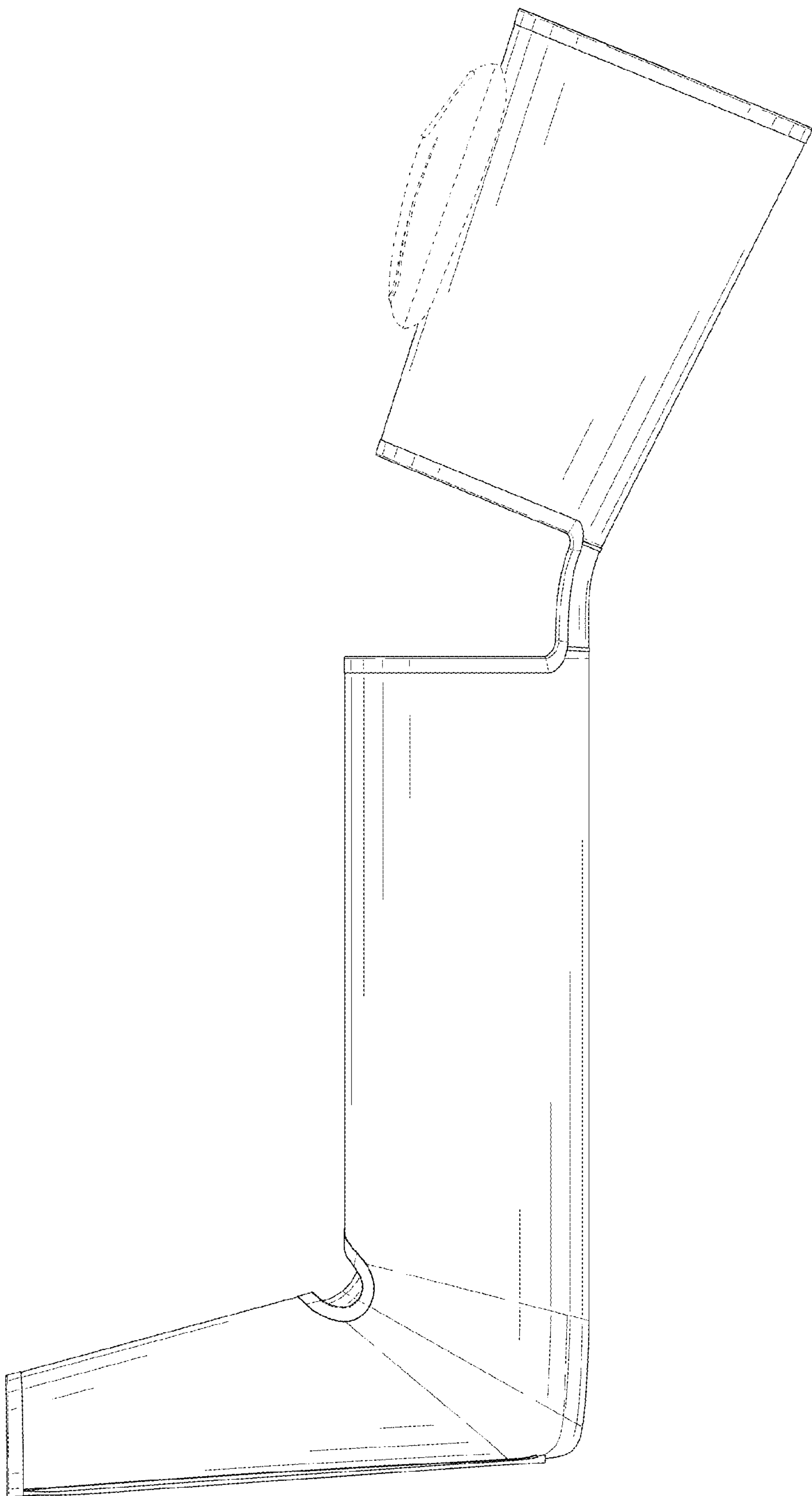

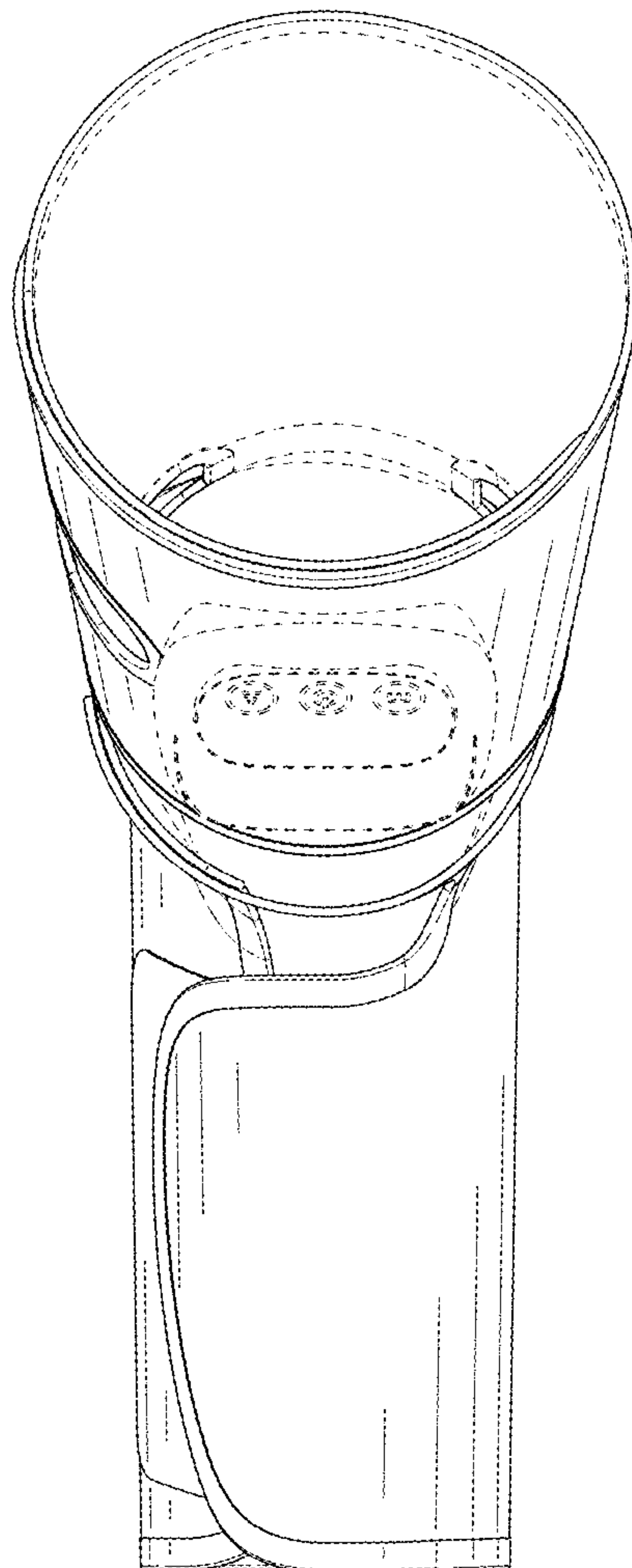

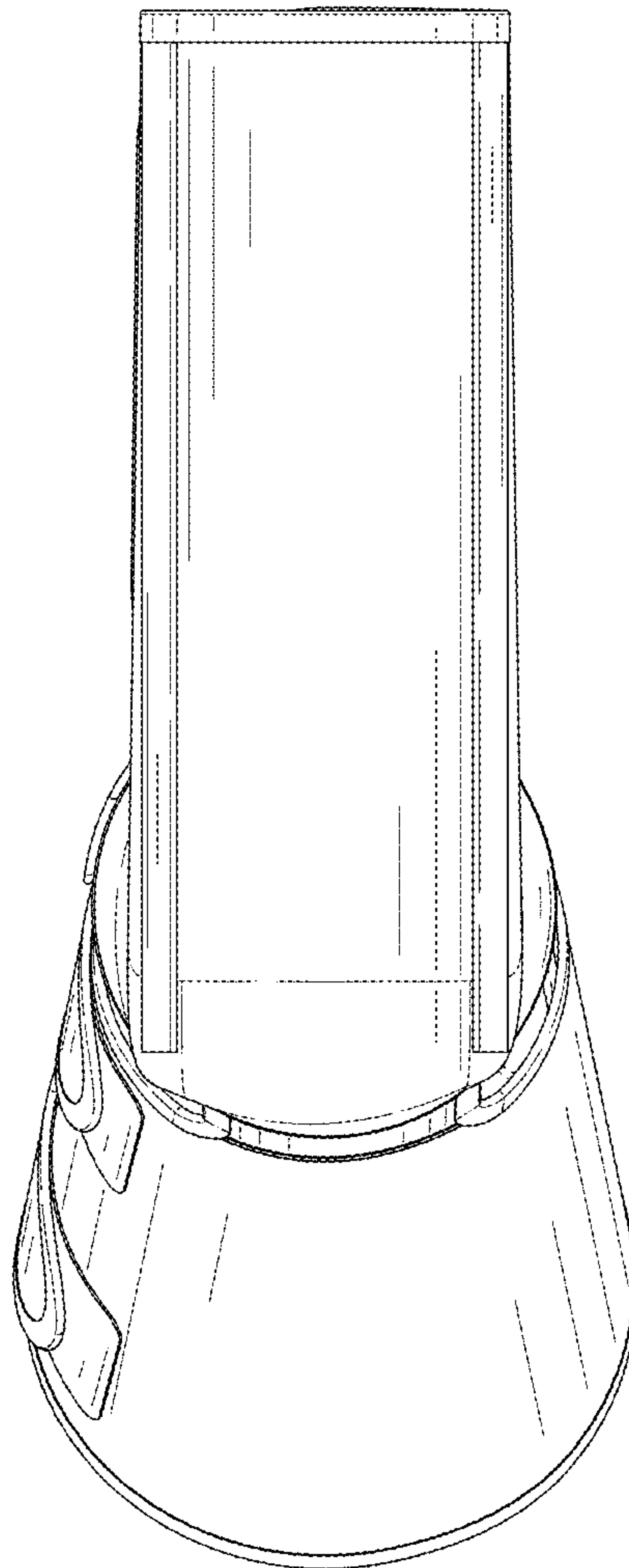

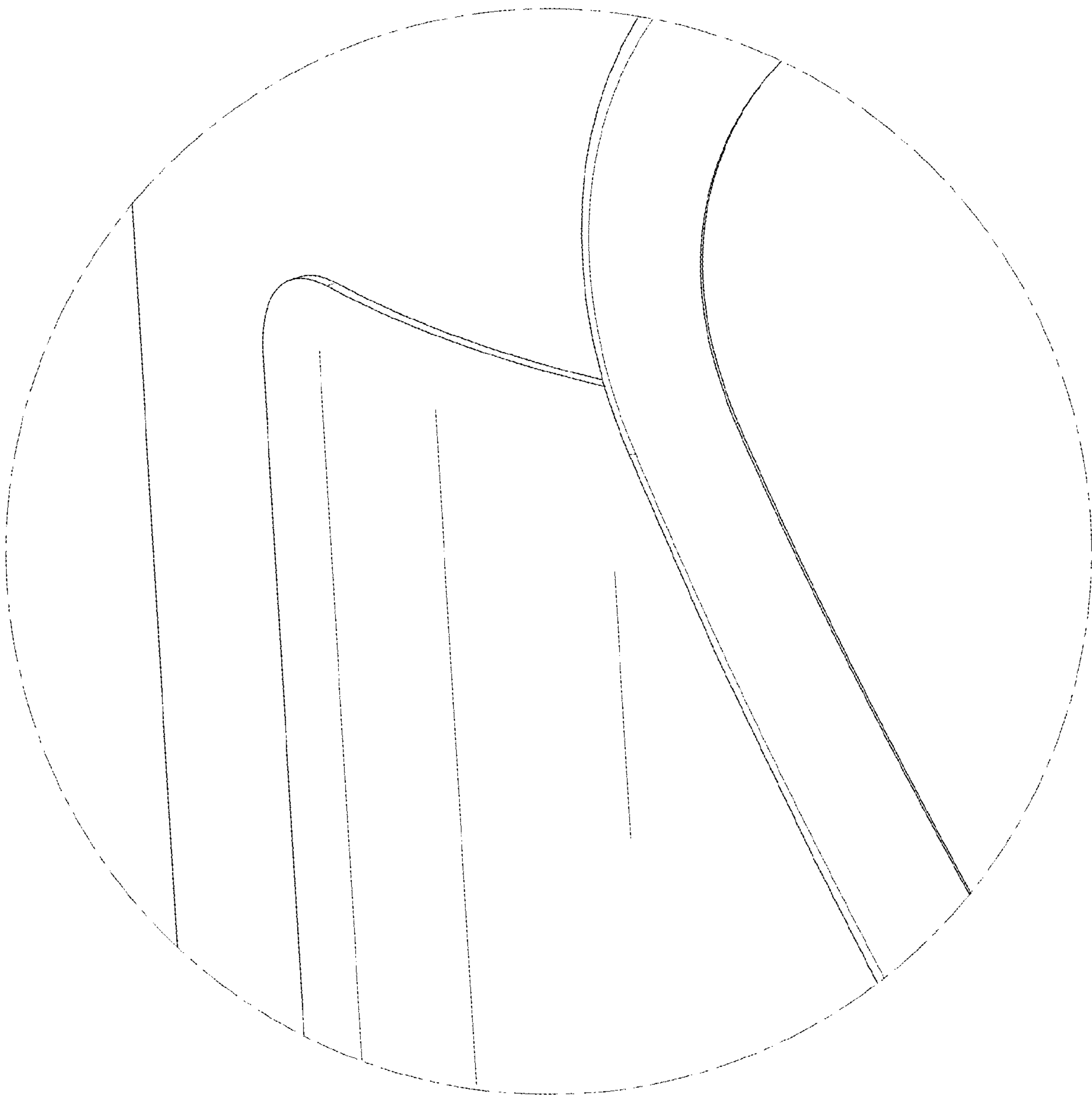
