FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;

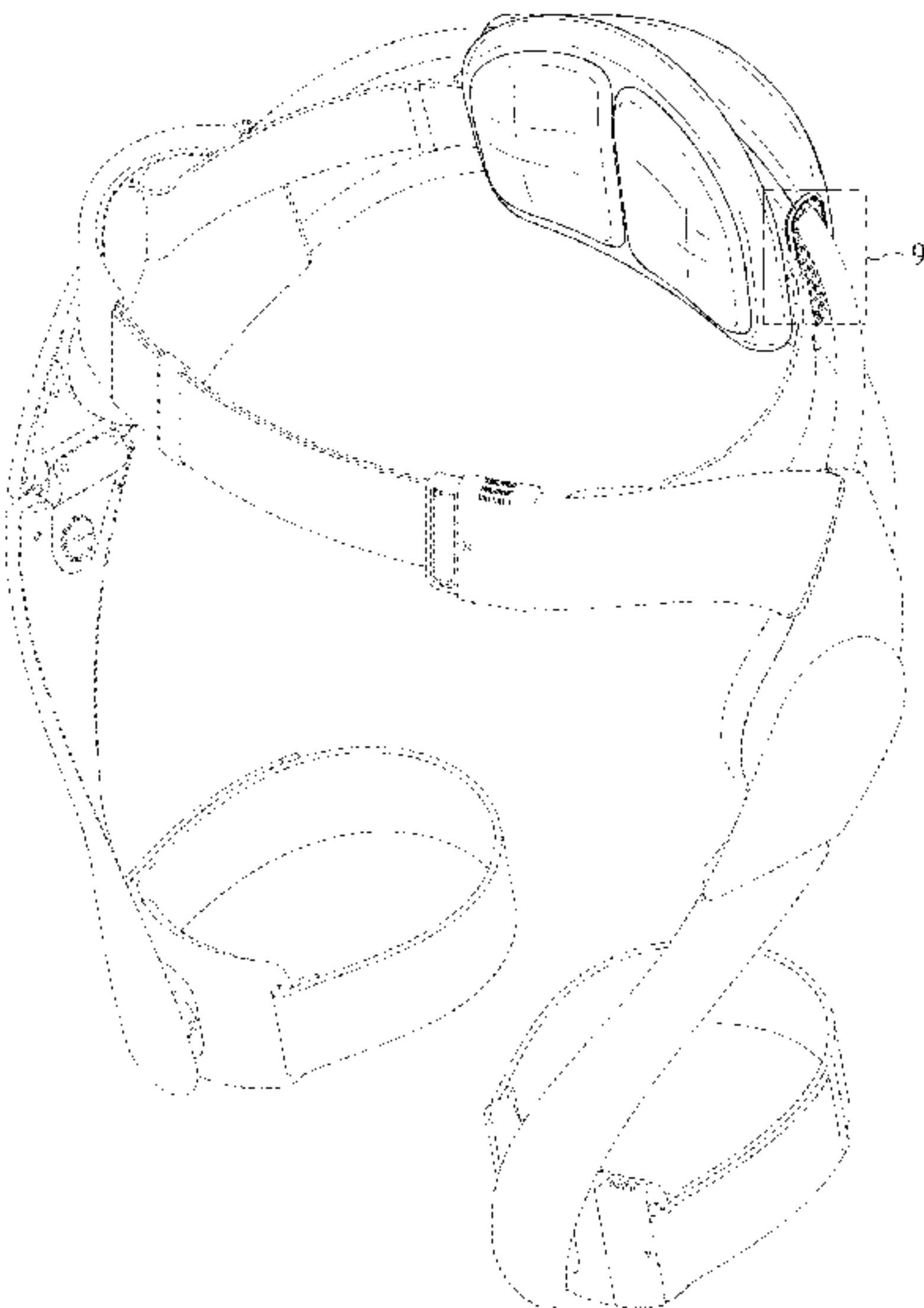
FIG. 8 is a rear perspective view thereof;

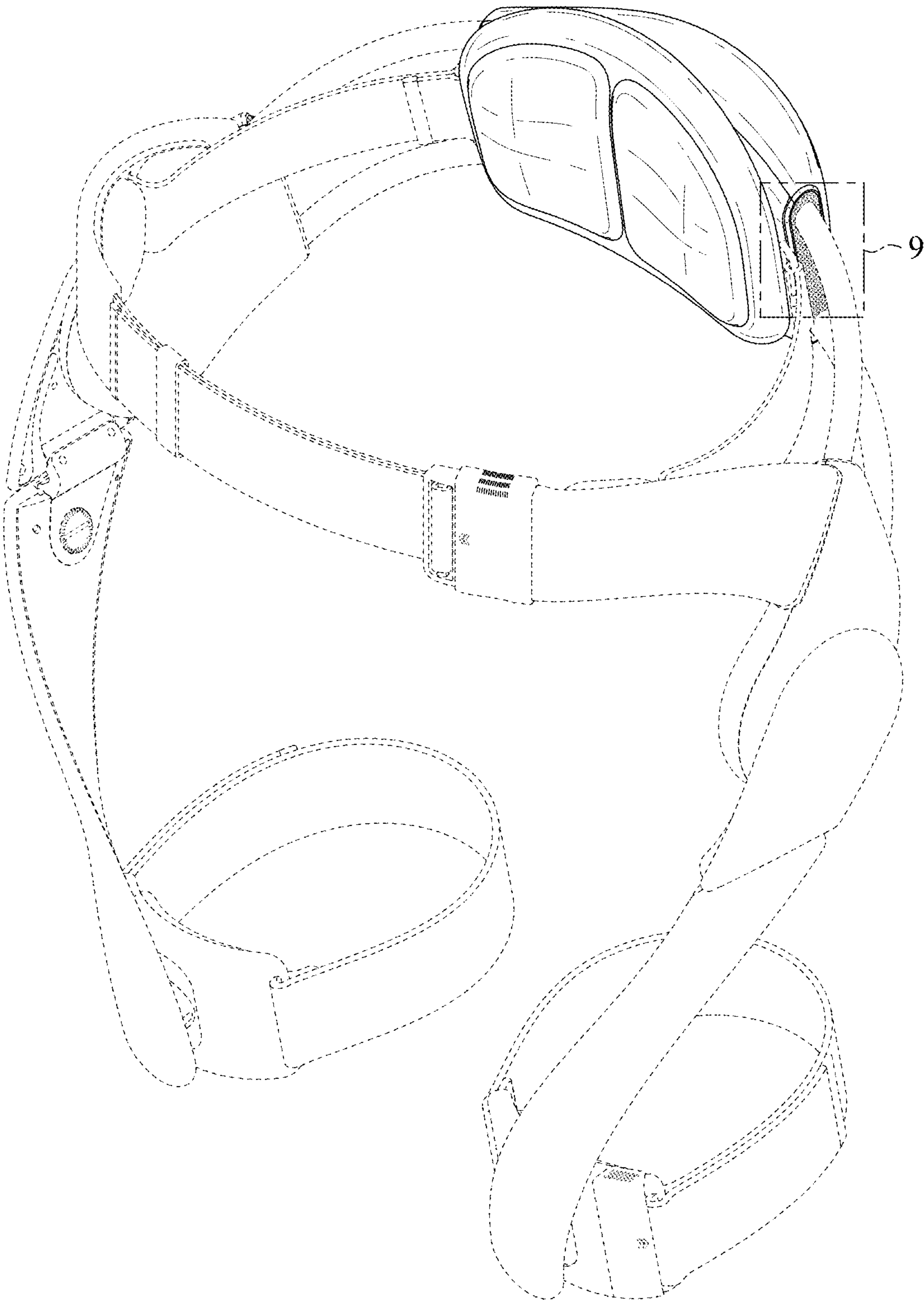

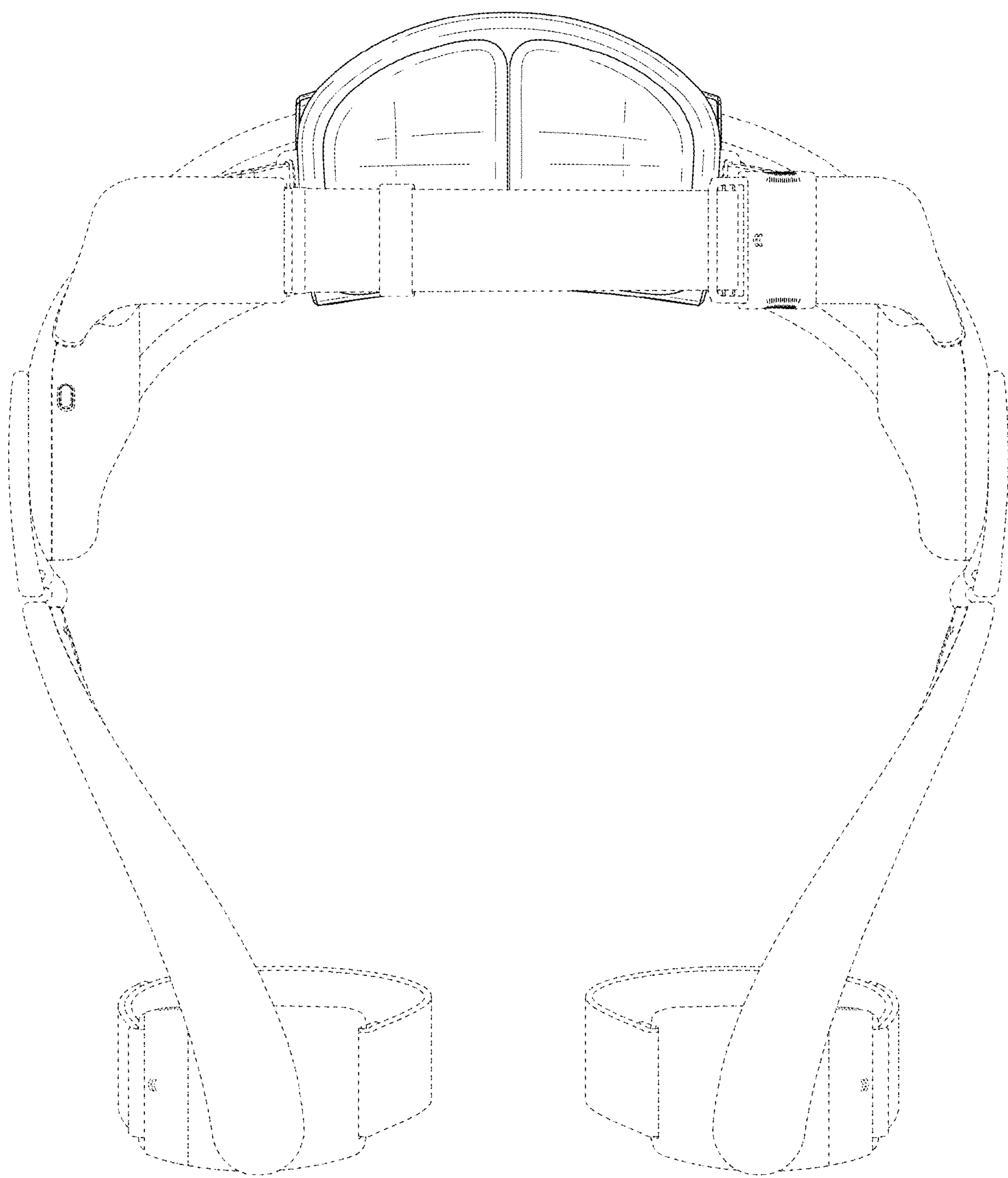

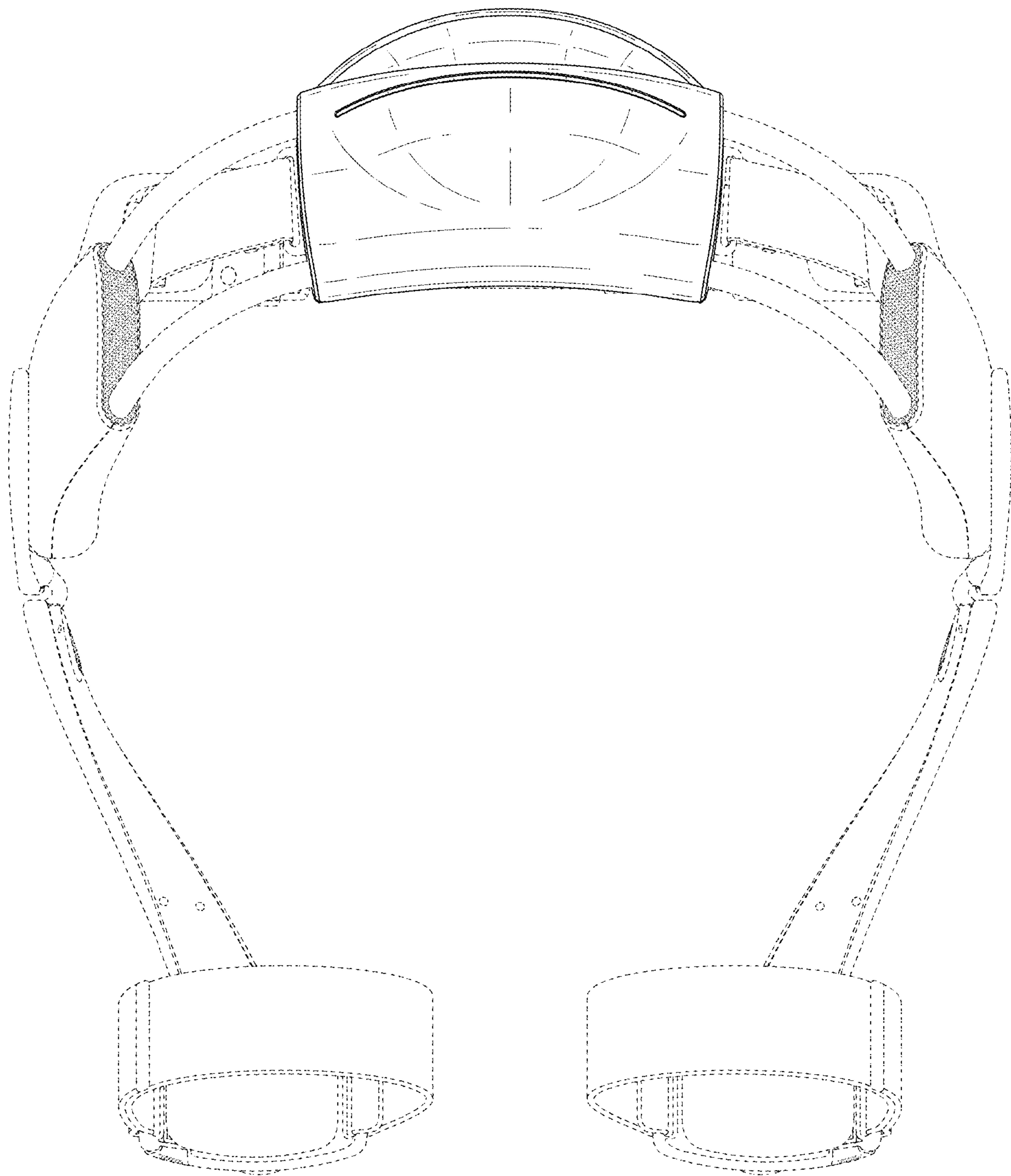

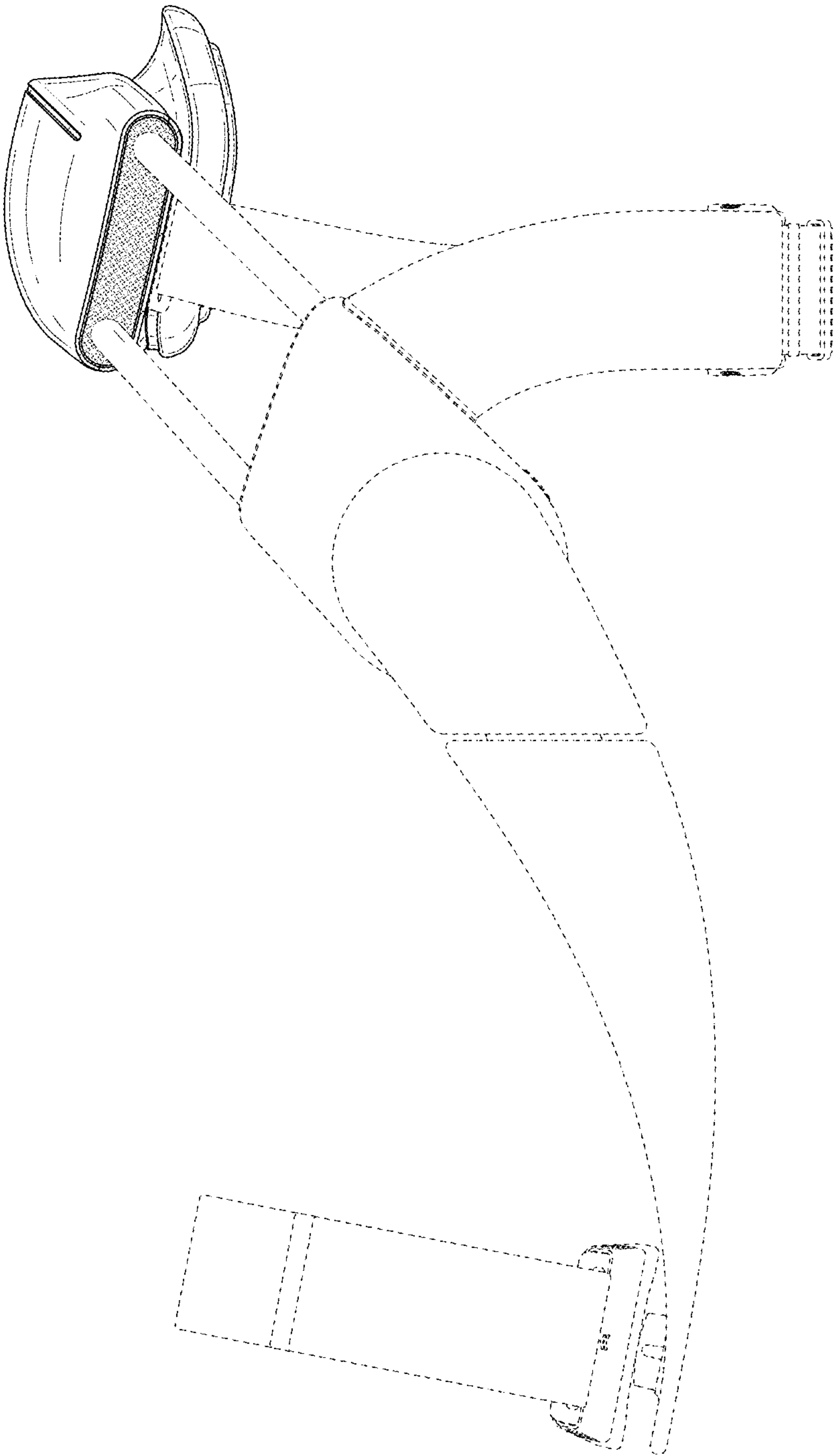

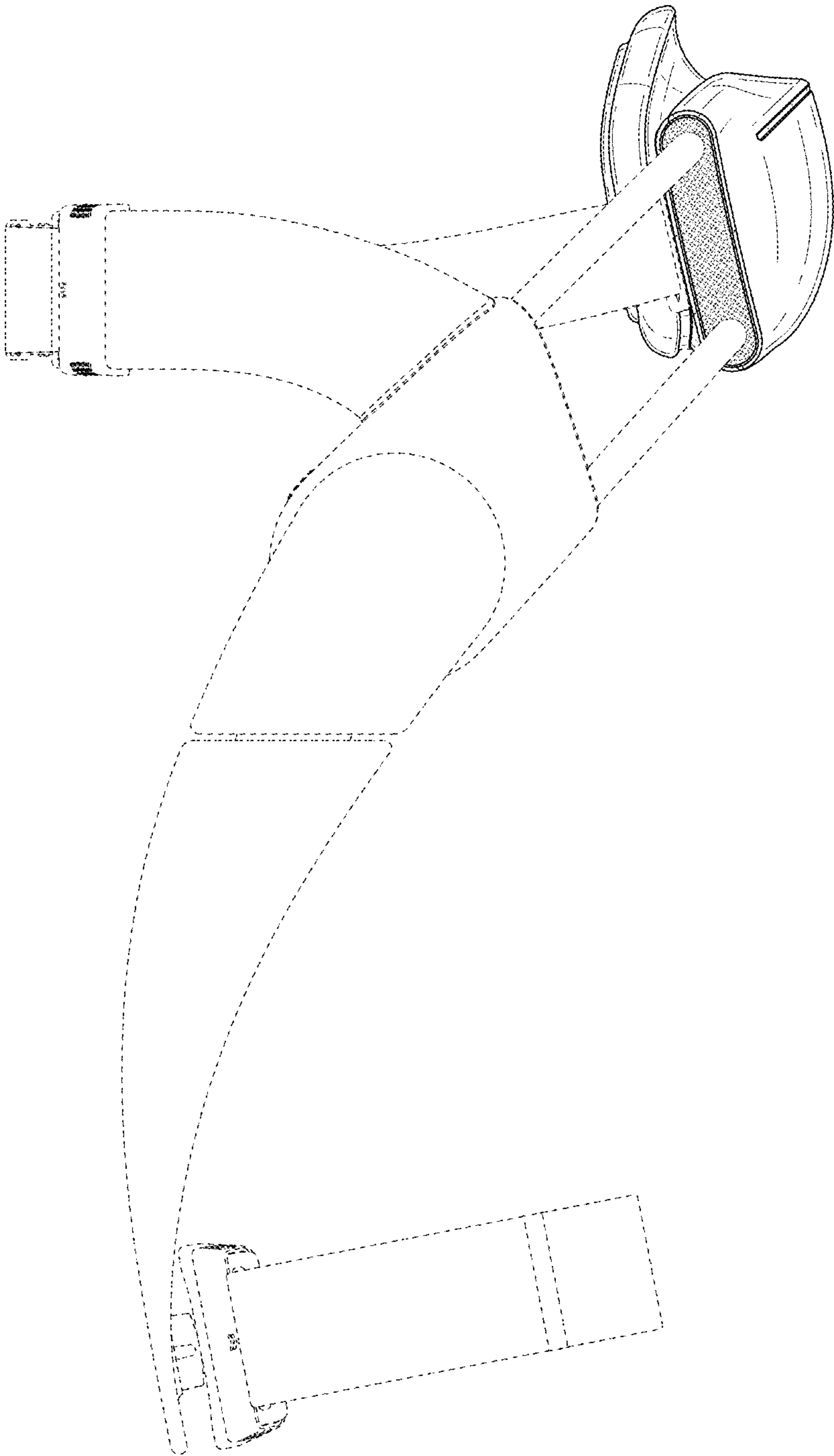

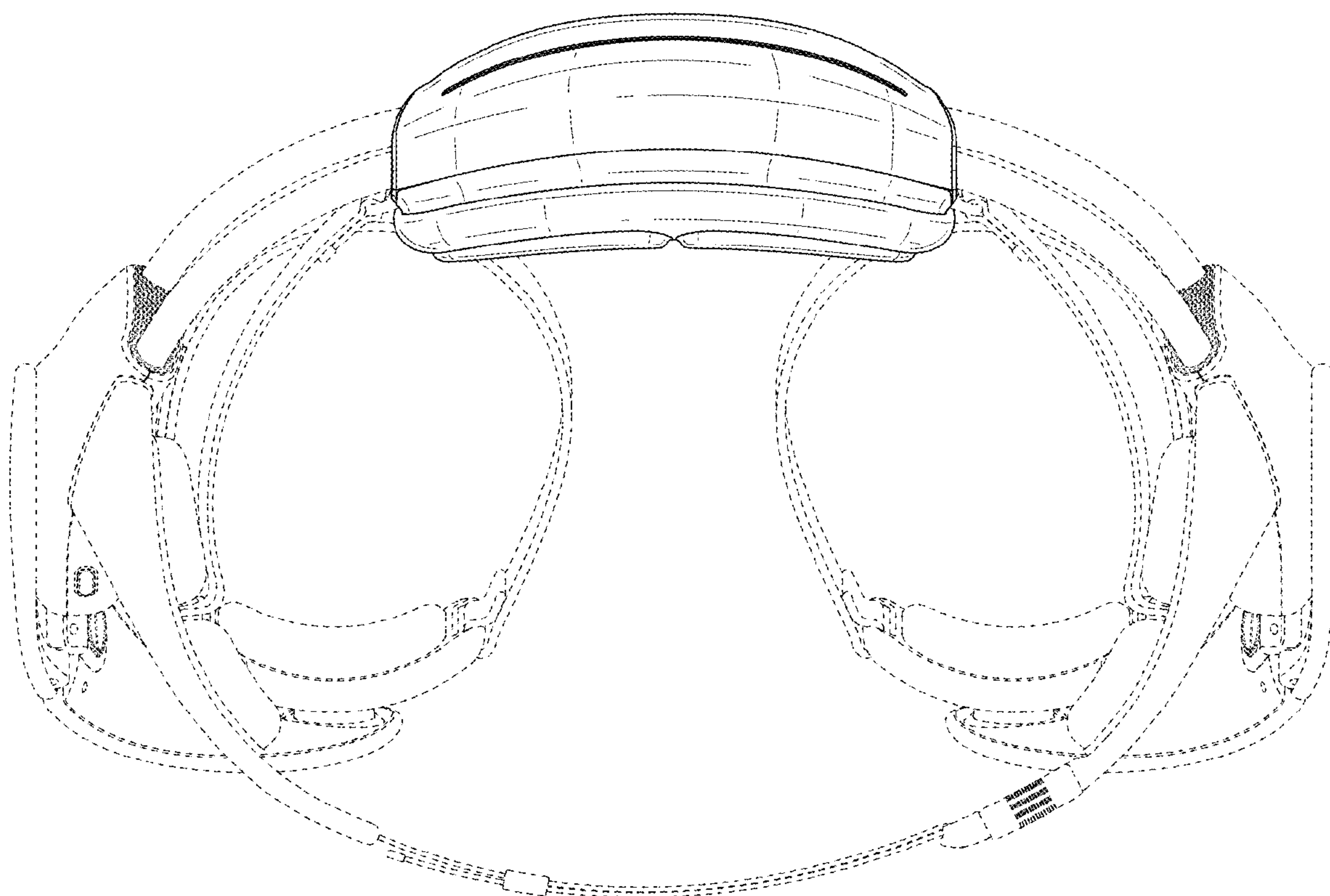

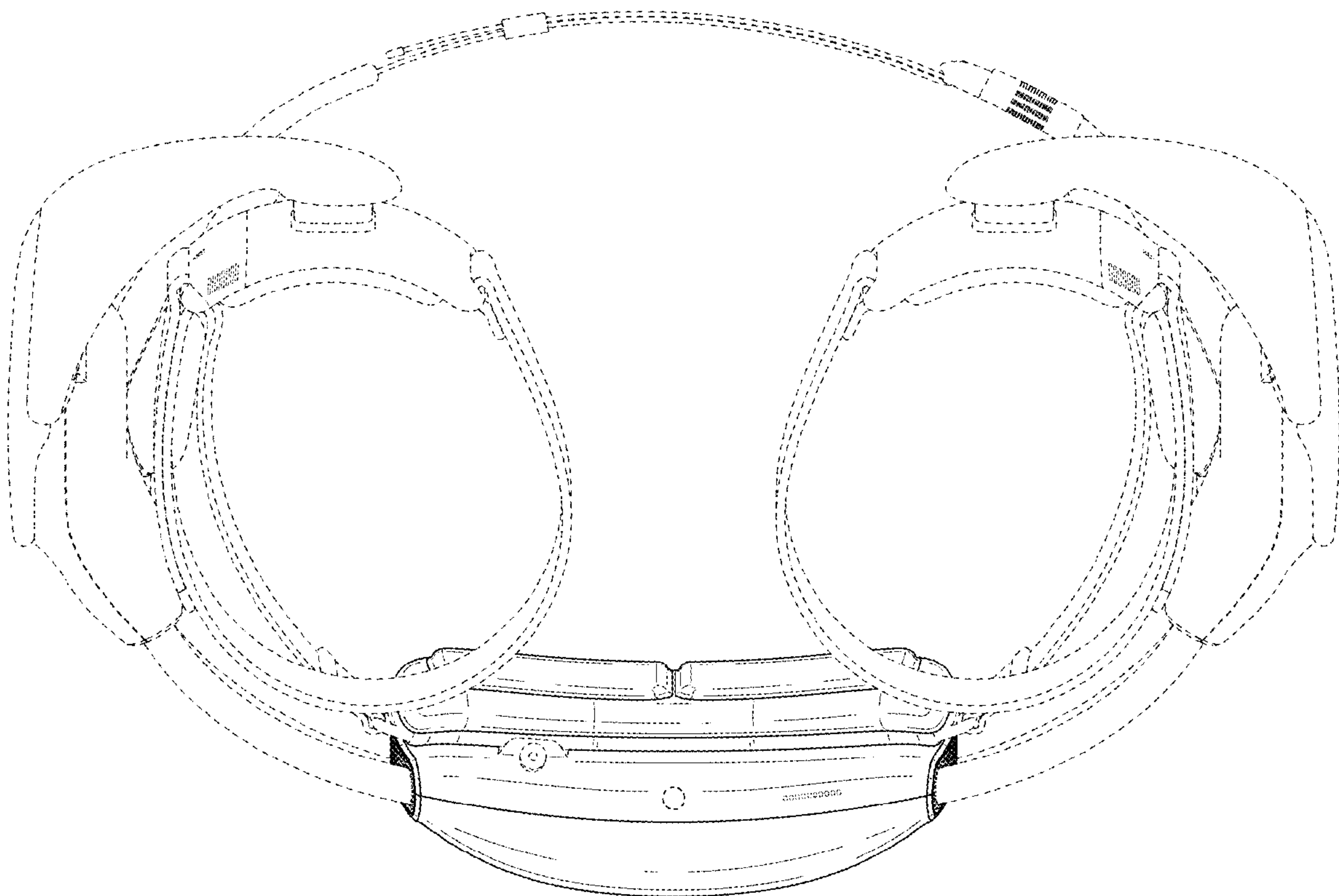

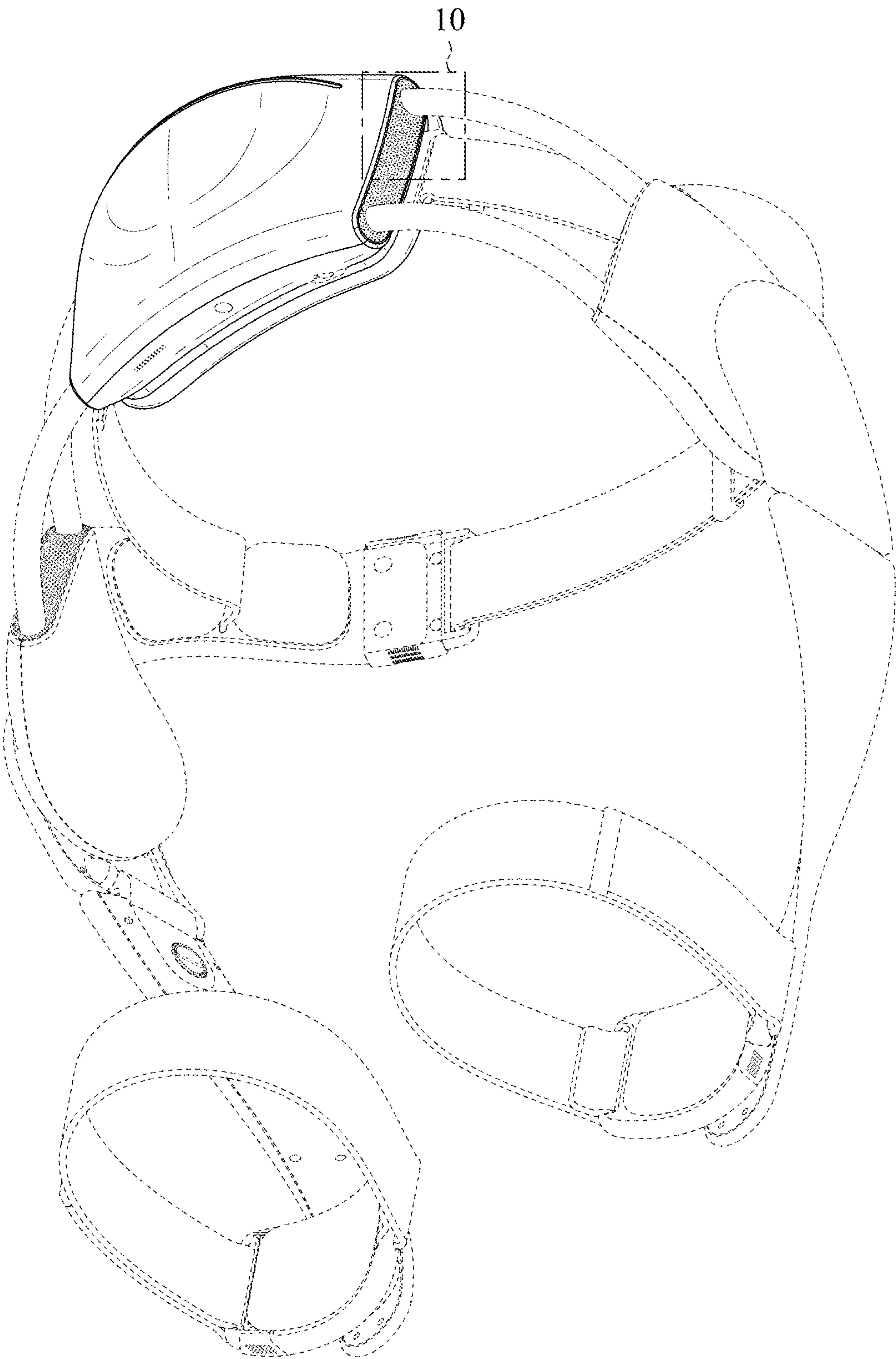

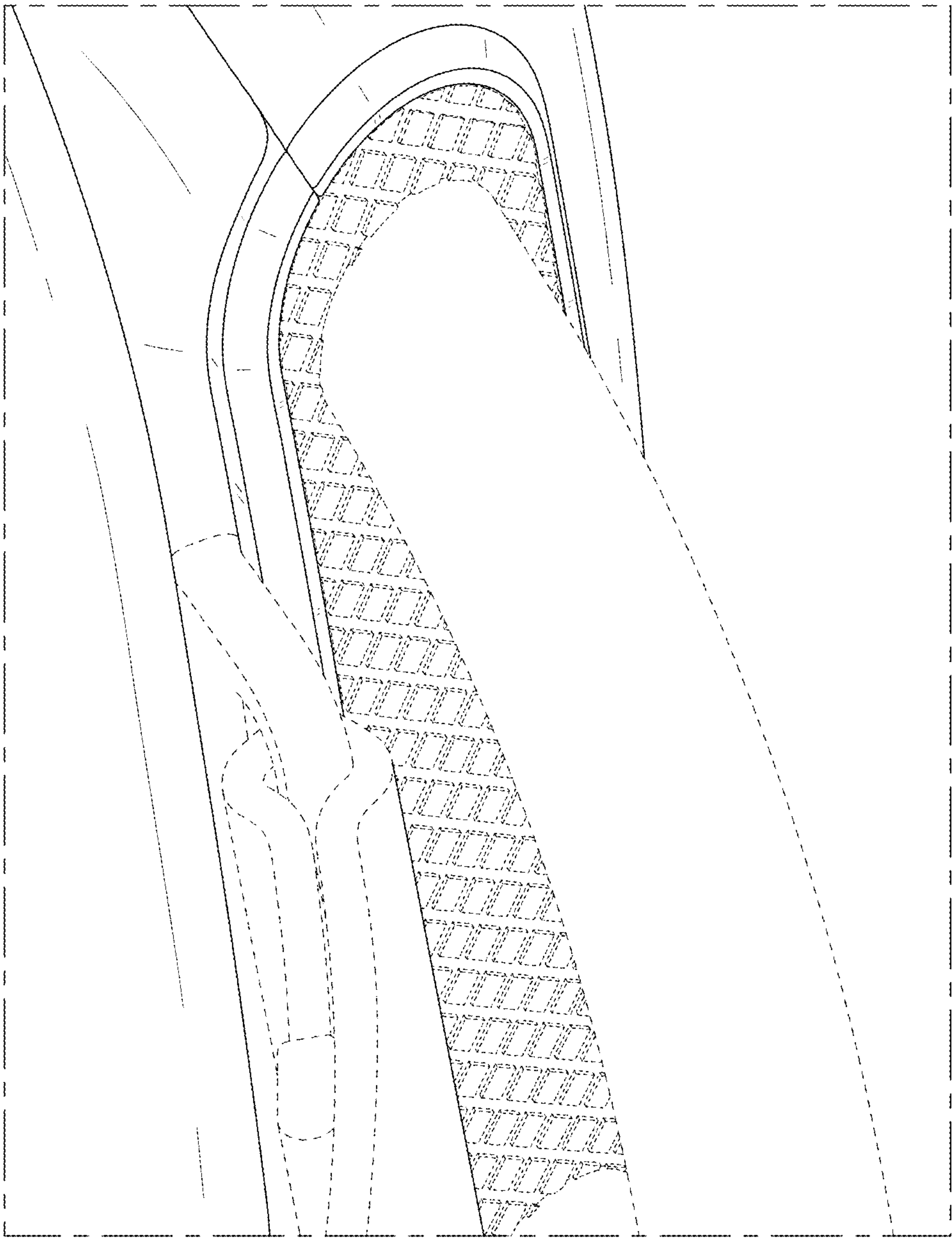
