FIG. 6 is a left-side elevational view thereof;

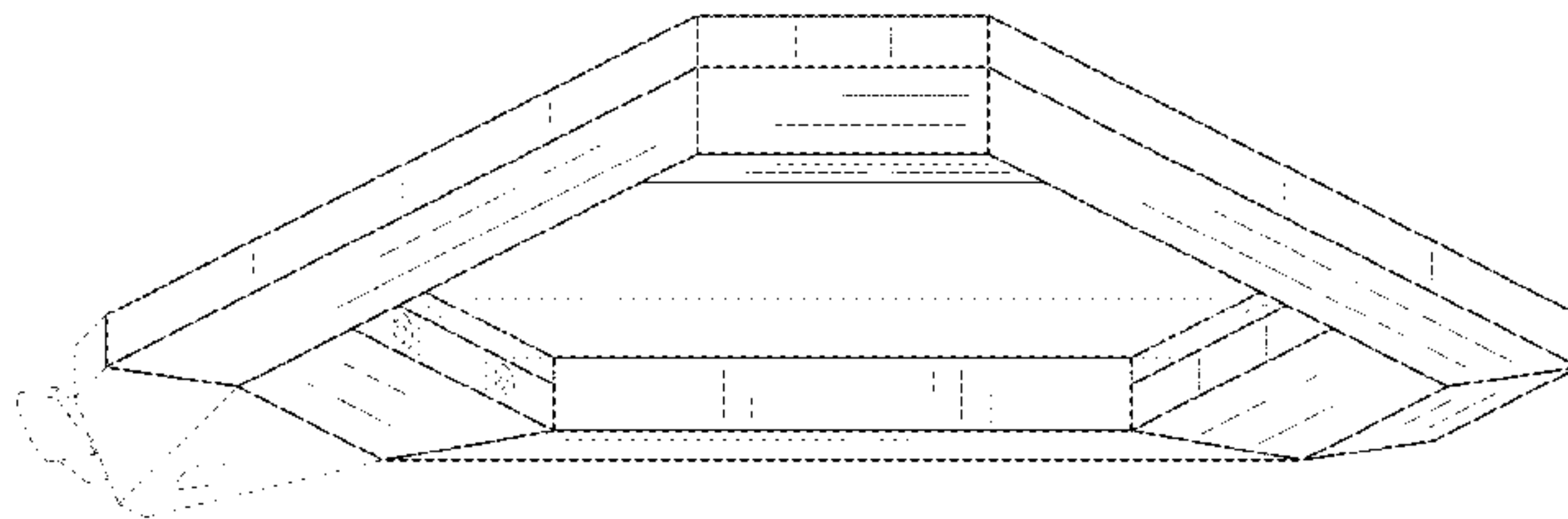
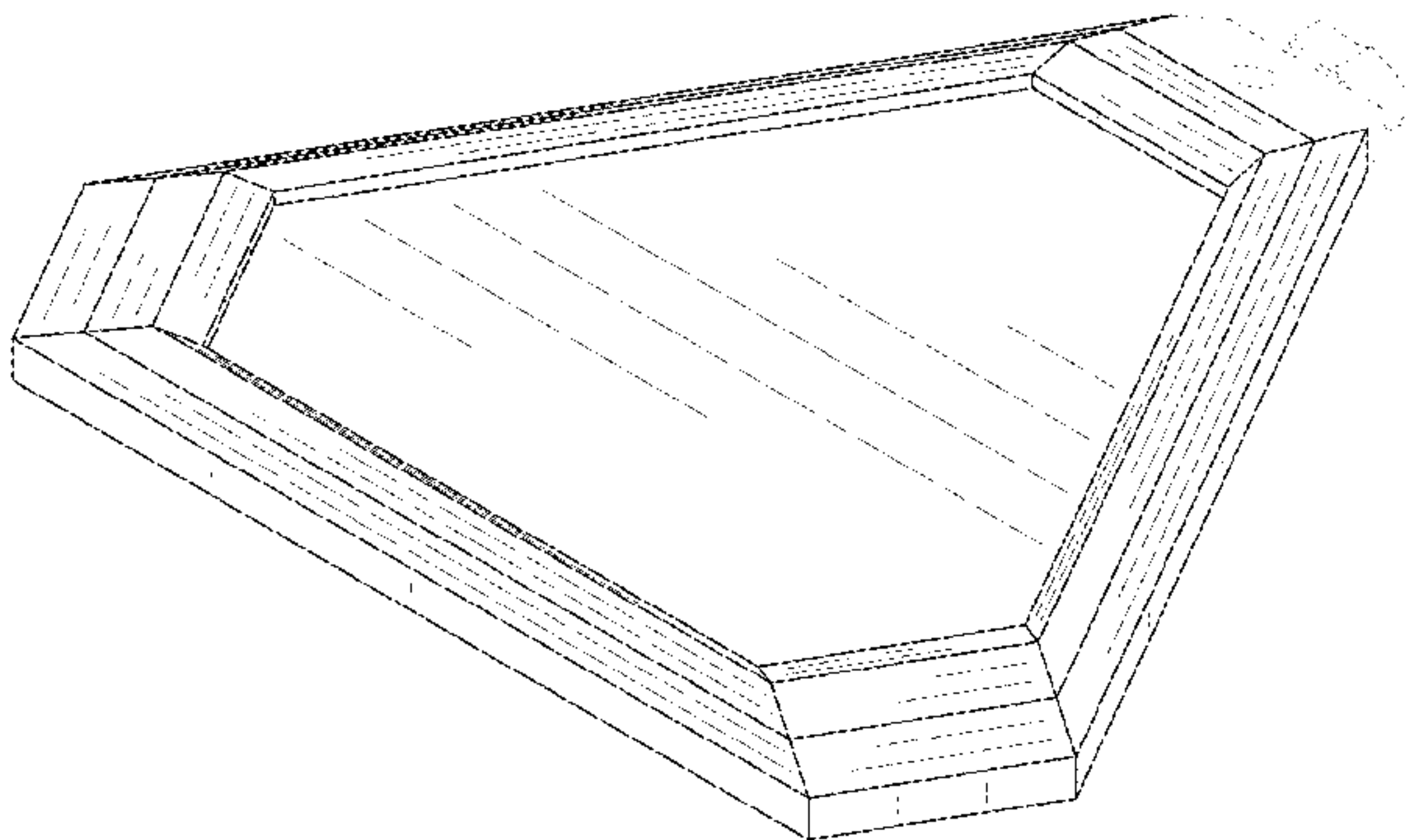
FIG. 7 is a right-side elevational view thereof;

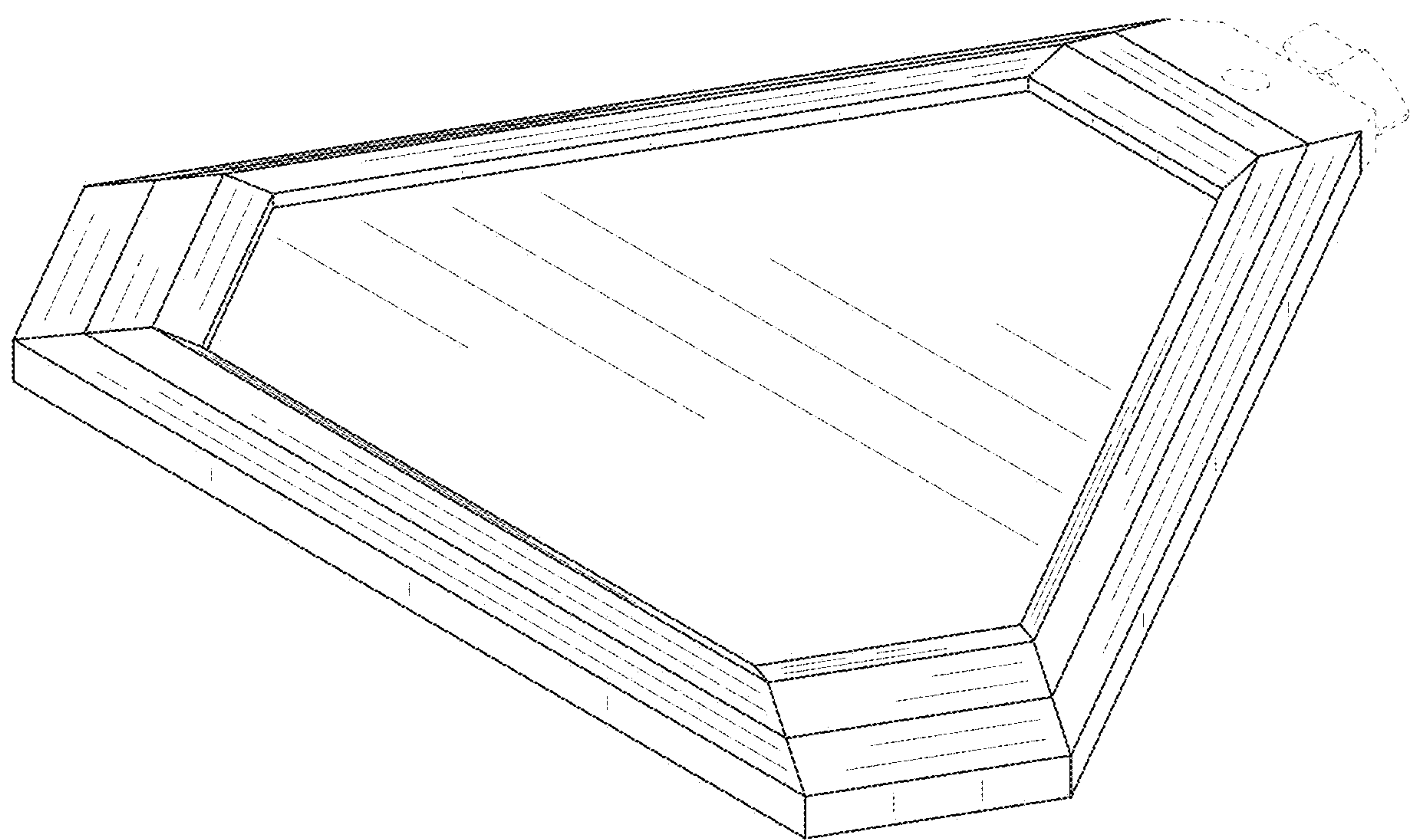

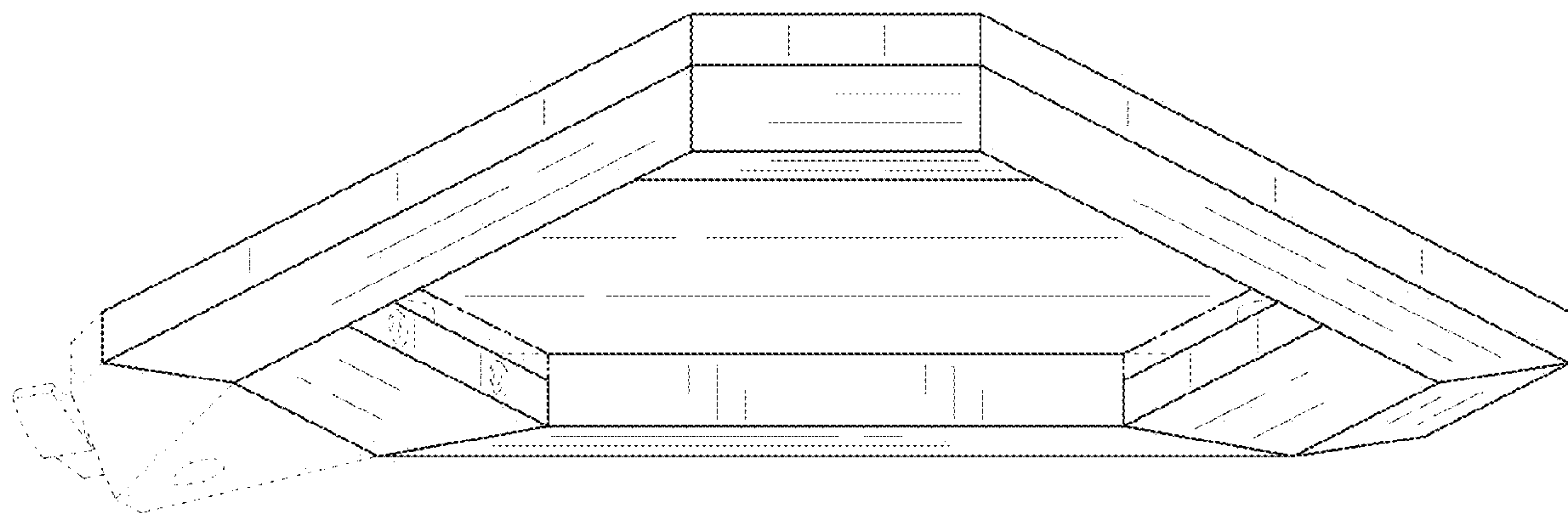

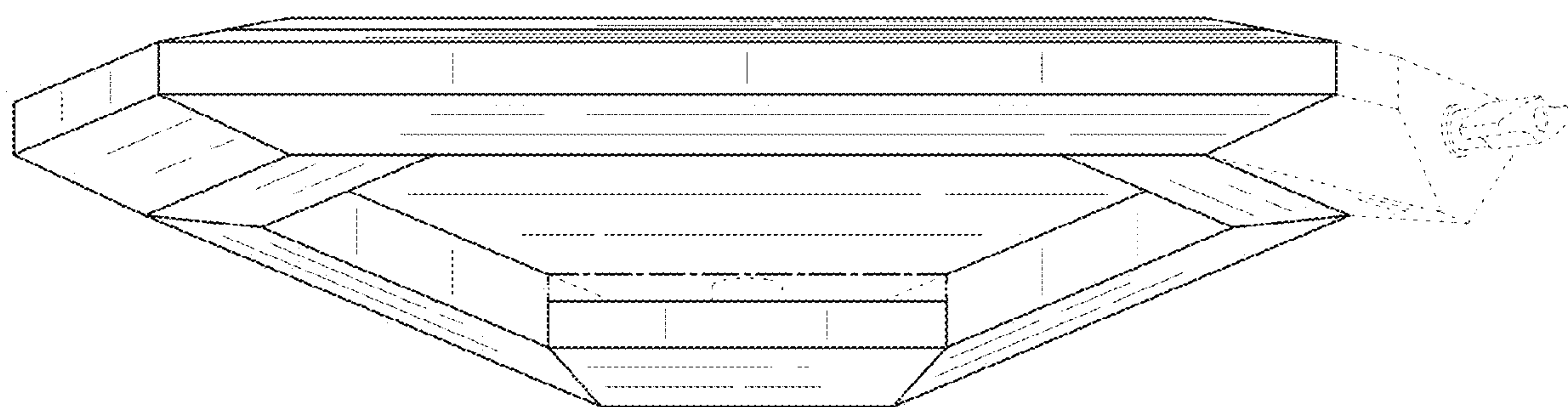

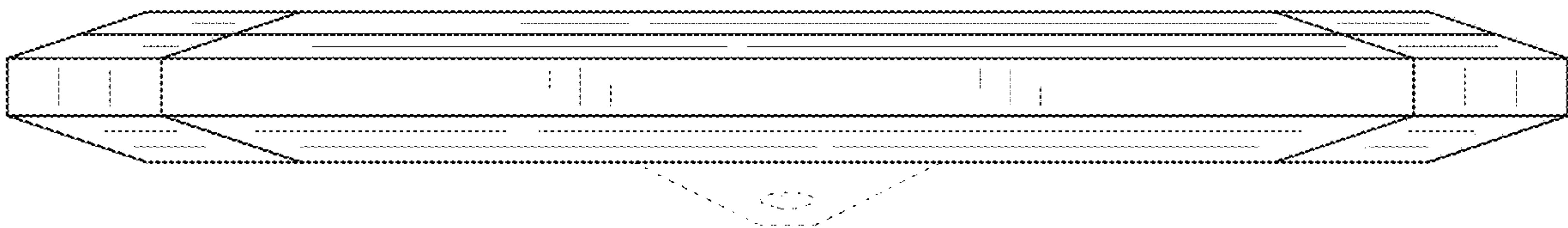

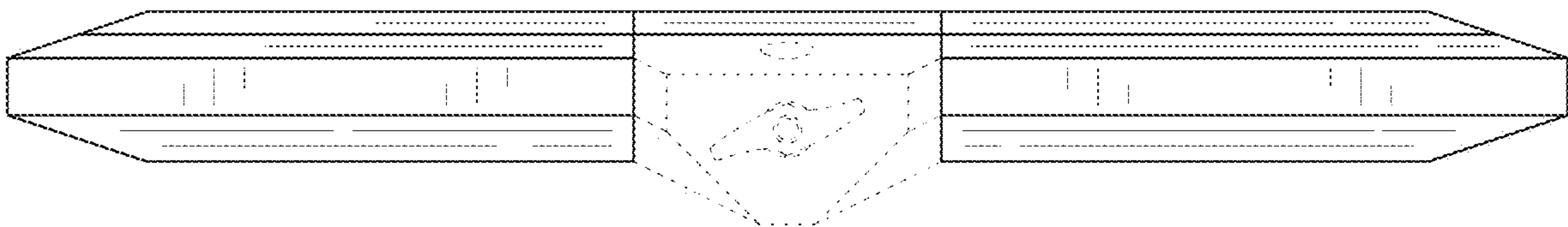

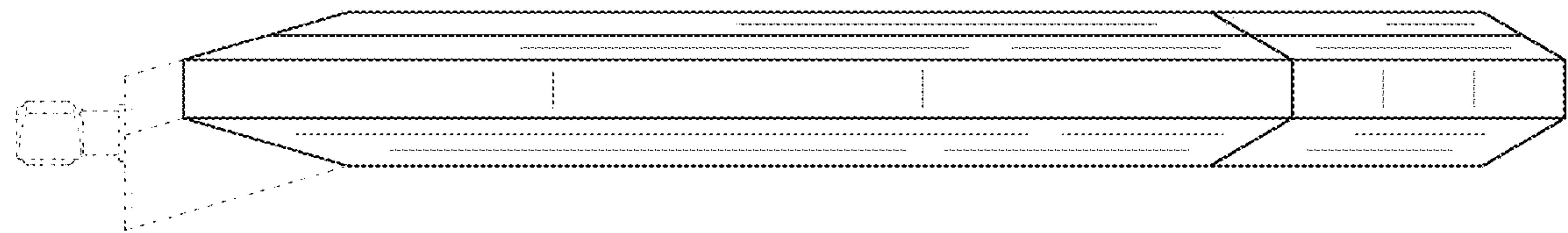

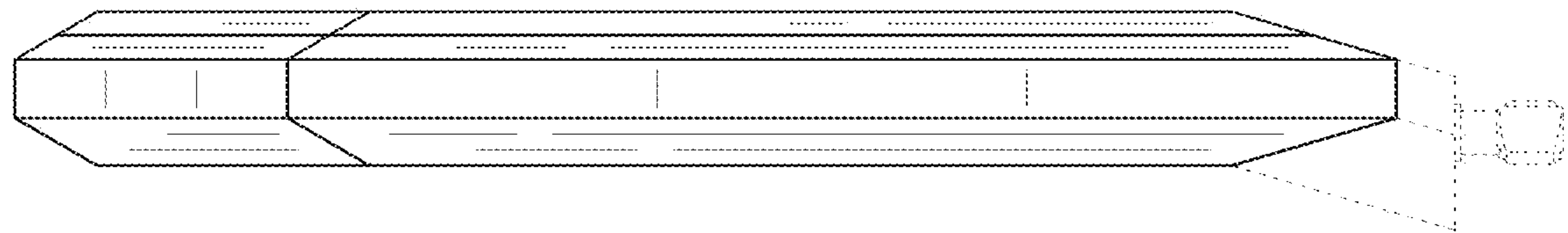

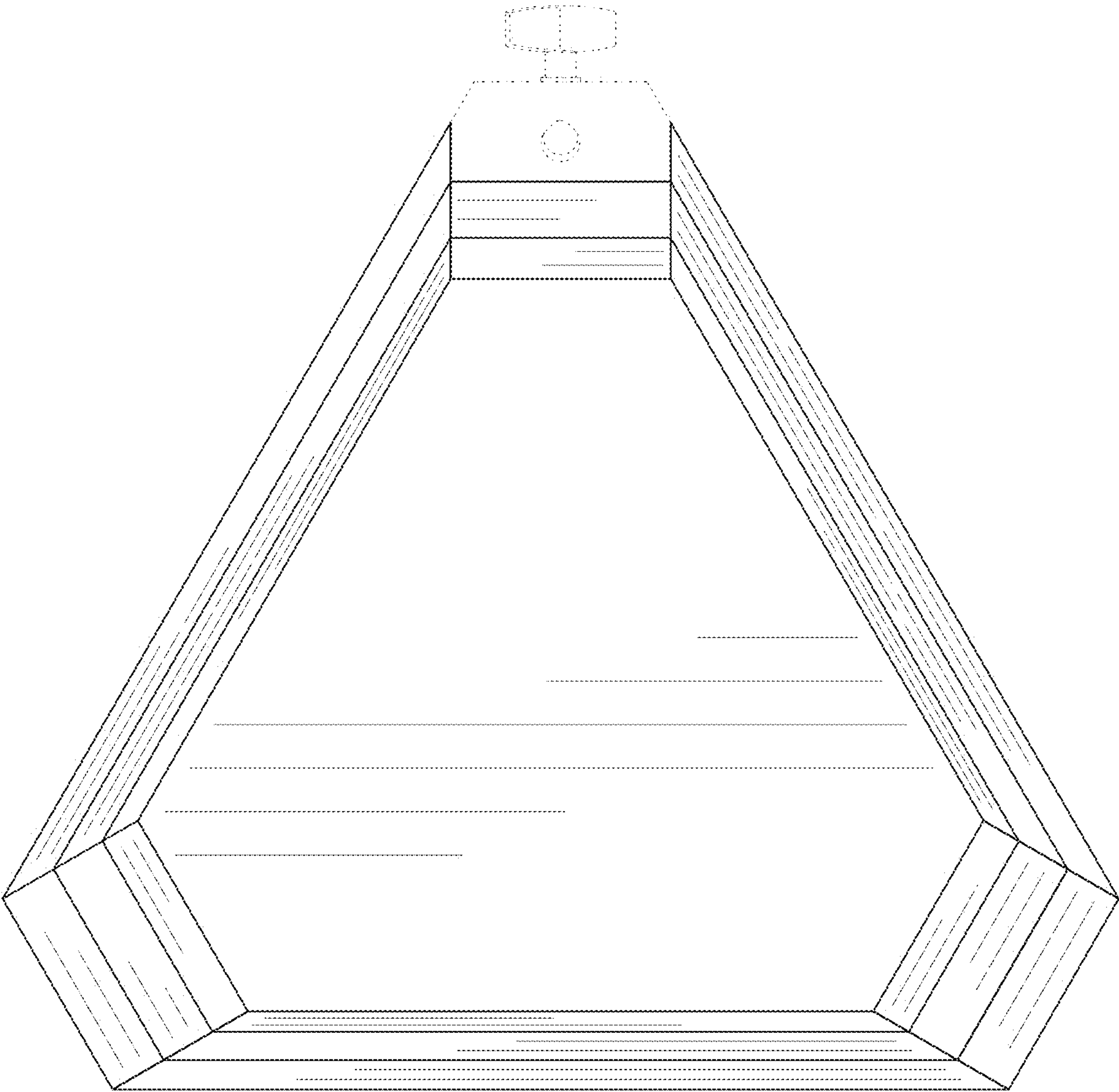

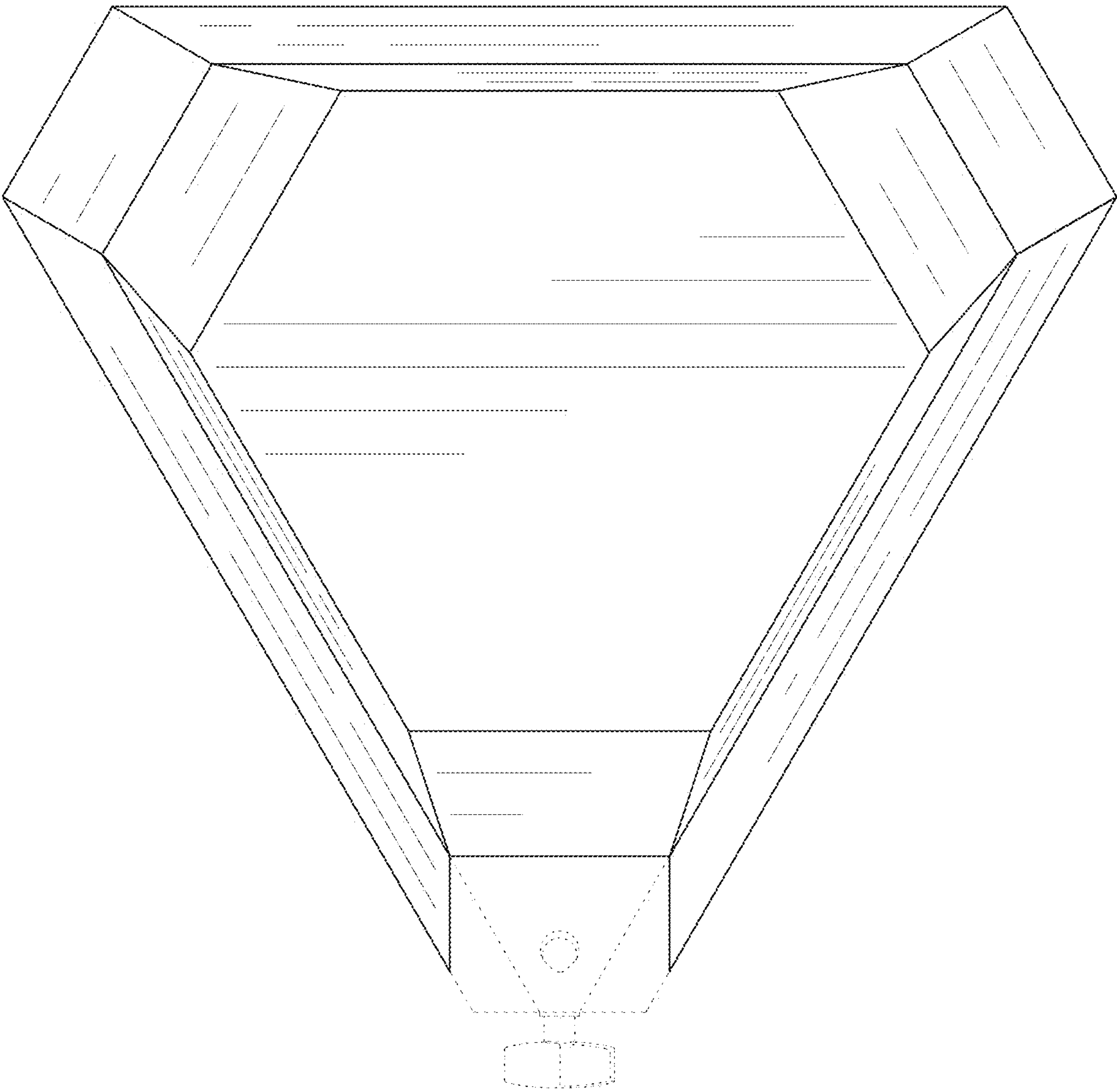
