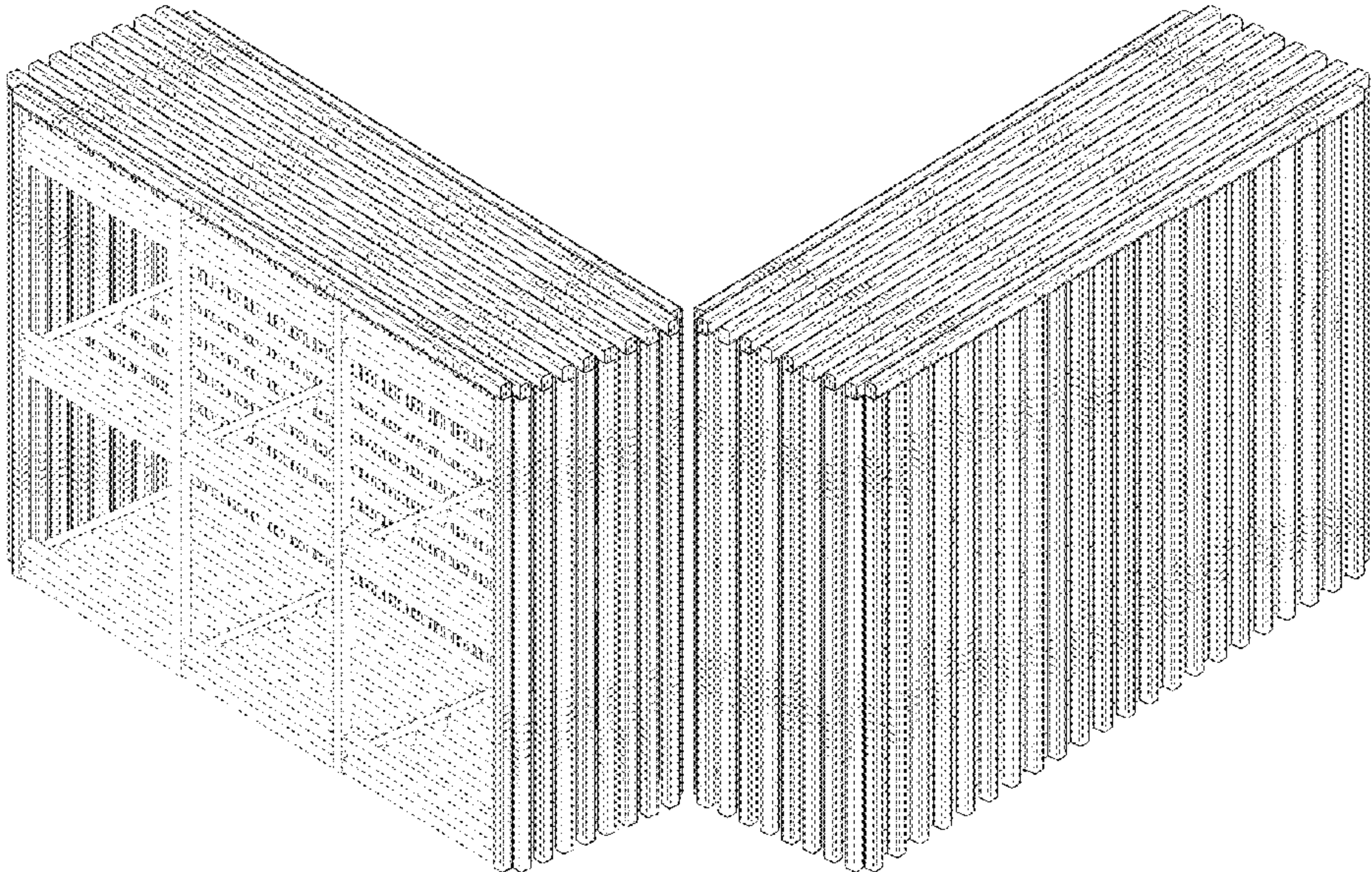
(57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for a beach cleaning station, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a beach cleaning station of the present invention;
FIG. 2 is an alternative perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a back view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a left side view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a right side view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 8 is a bottom view thereof; and,
FIG. 9 is a front perspective view of the beach cleaning station, shown in use with buckets placed within the station. The broken lines depict portions of the beach cleaning station that form no part of the claimed design. 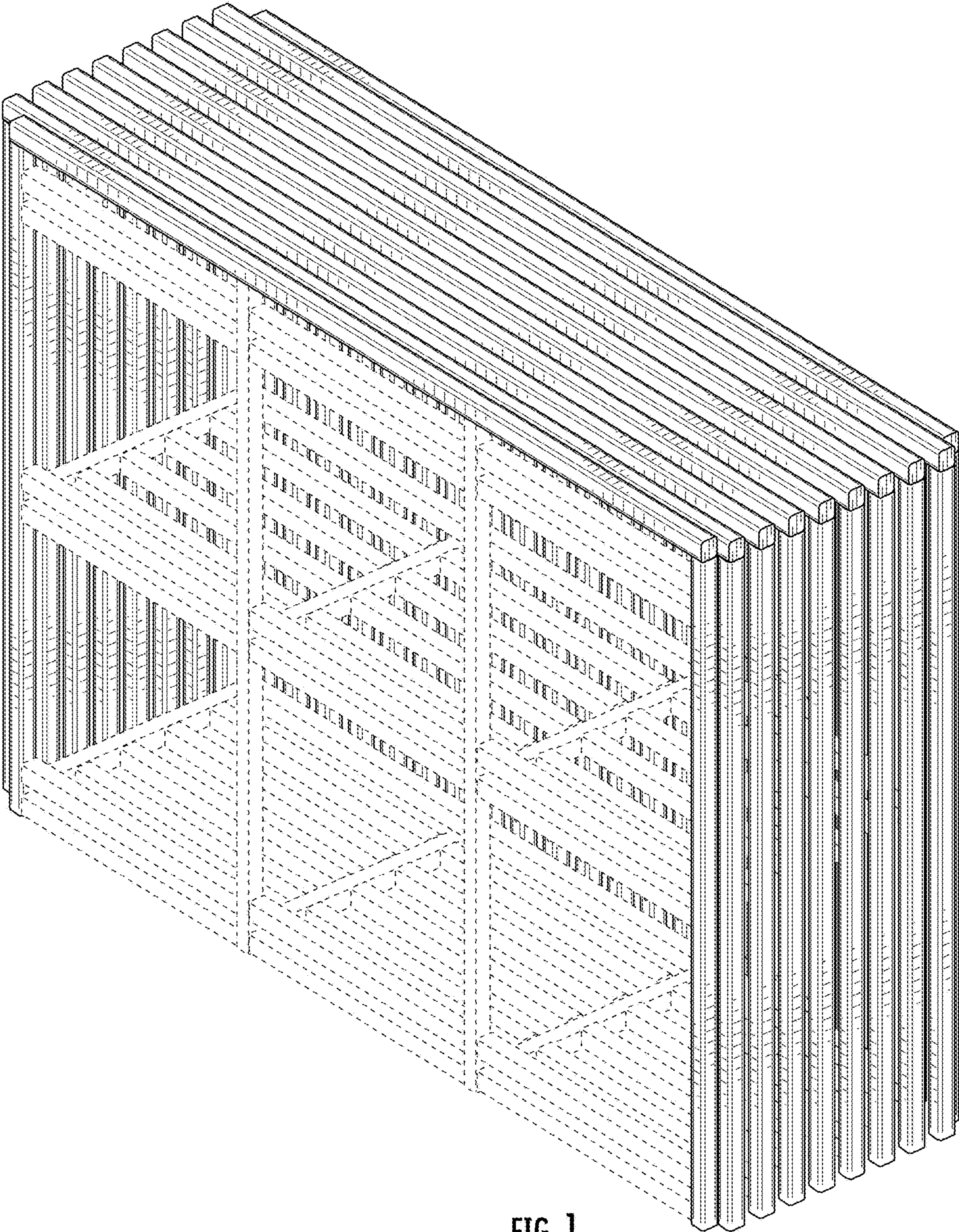

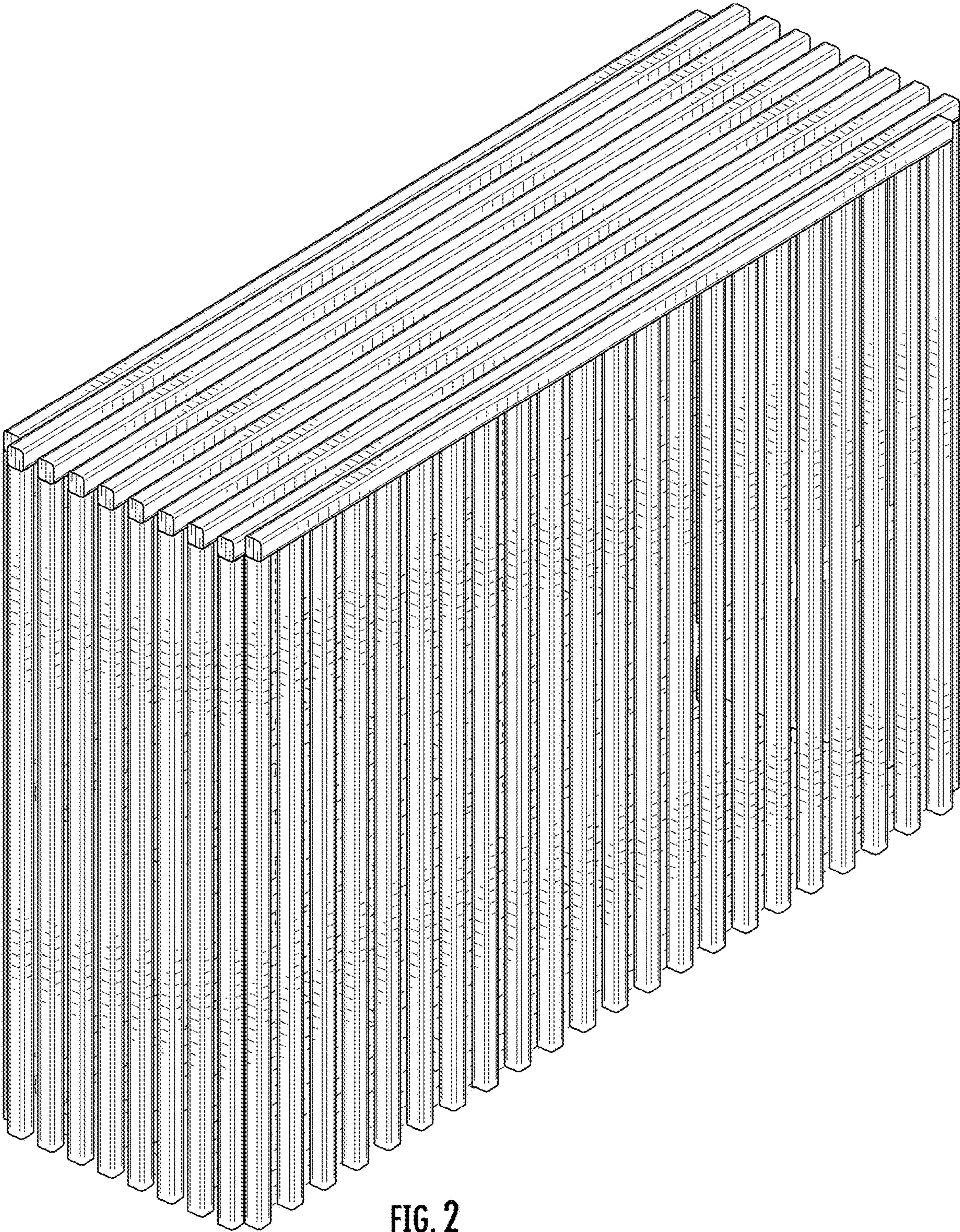

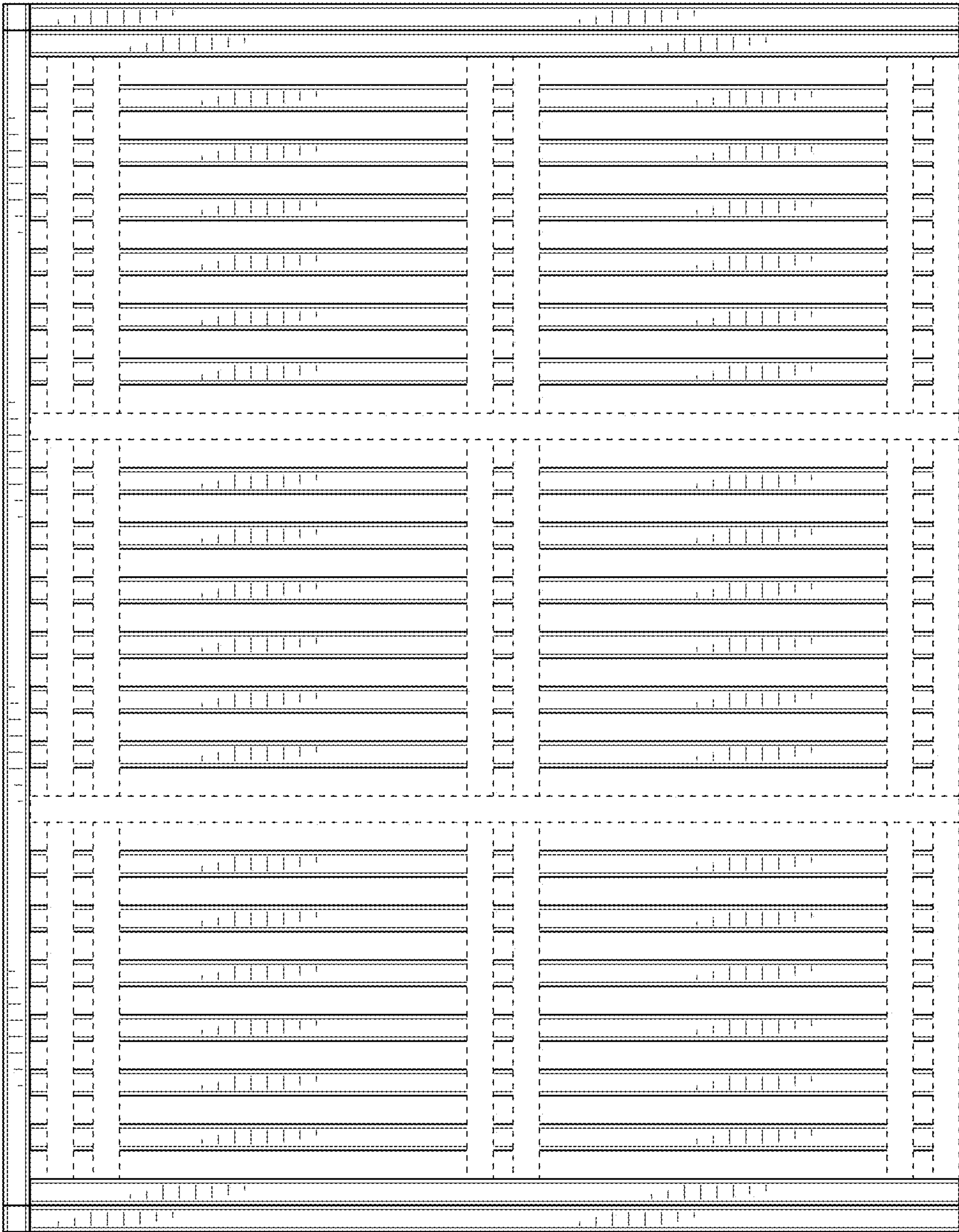

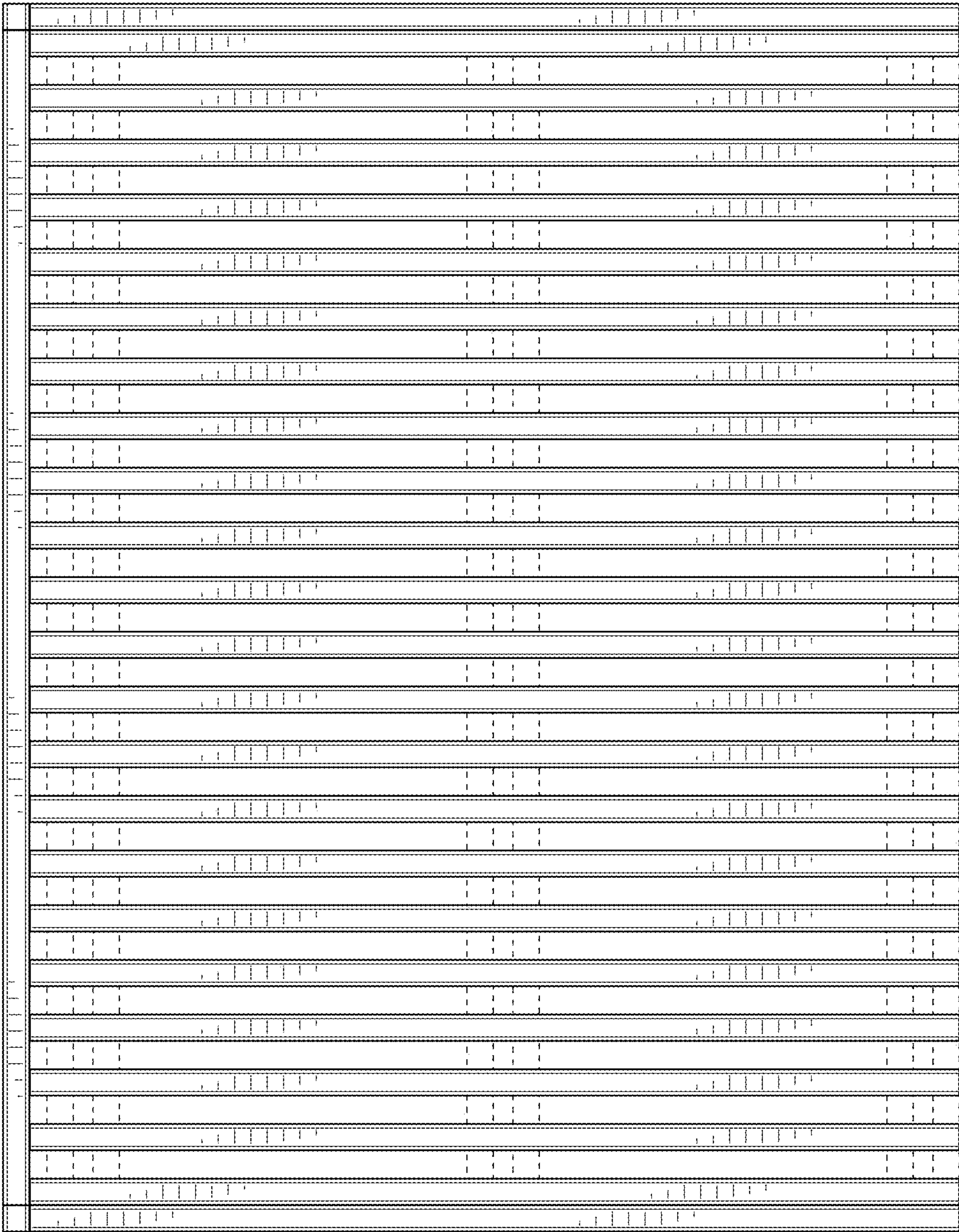

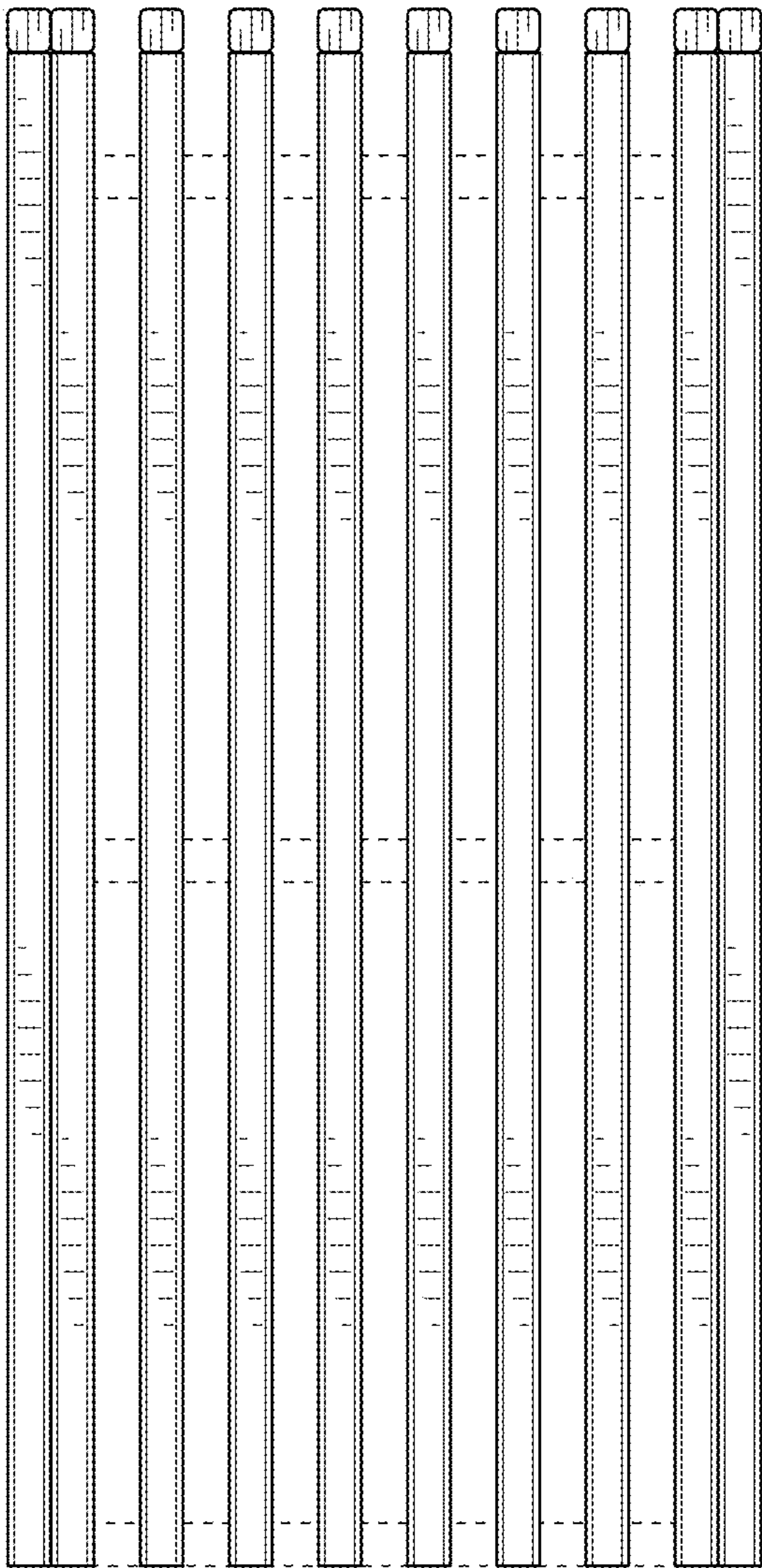

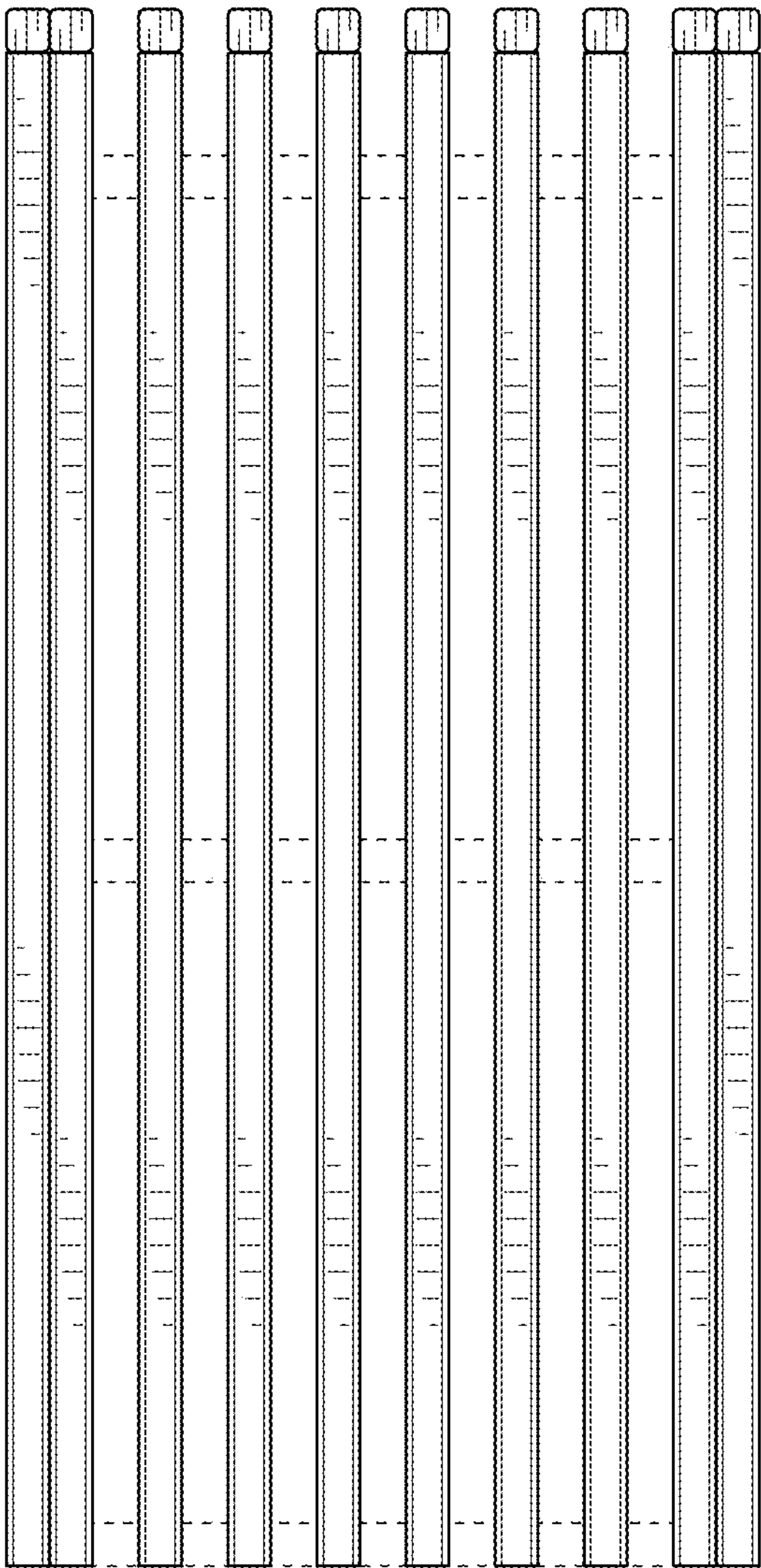

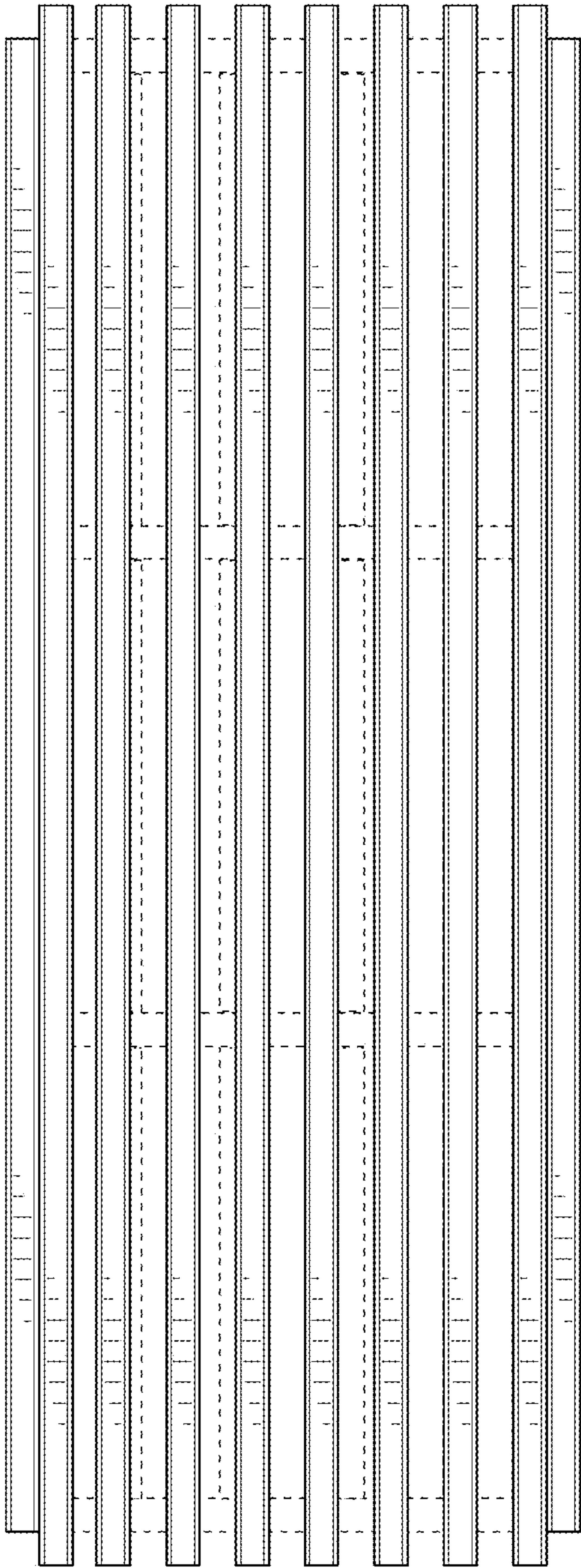

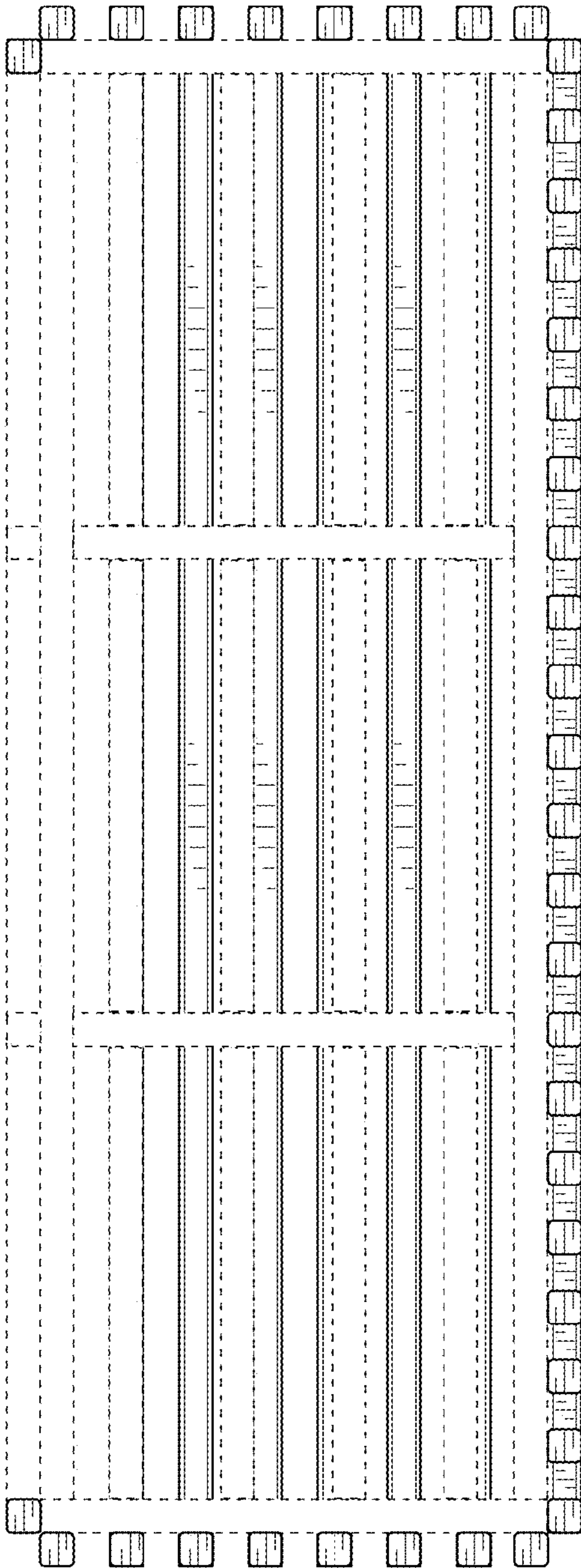

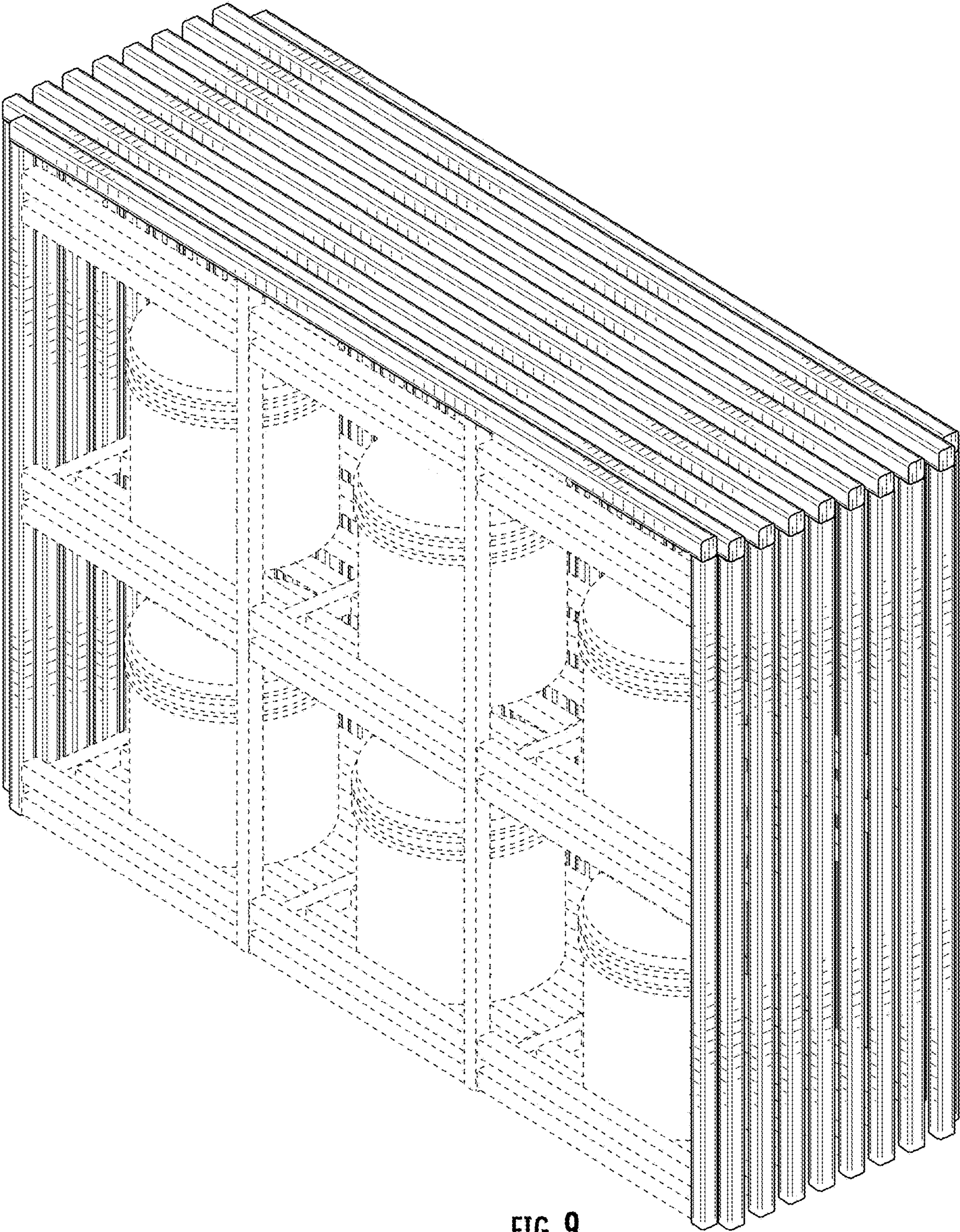
