DESCRIPTION

FIG. 11 is a rear elevation view of the tire of FIG. 7; and, FIG. 12 is a front elevation view of the tire of FIG. 7.

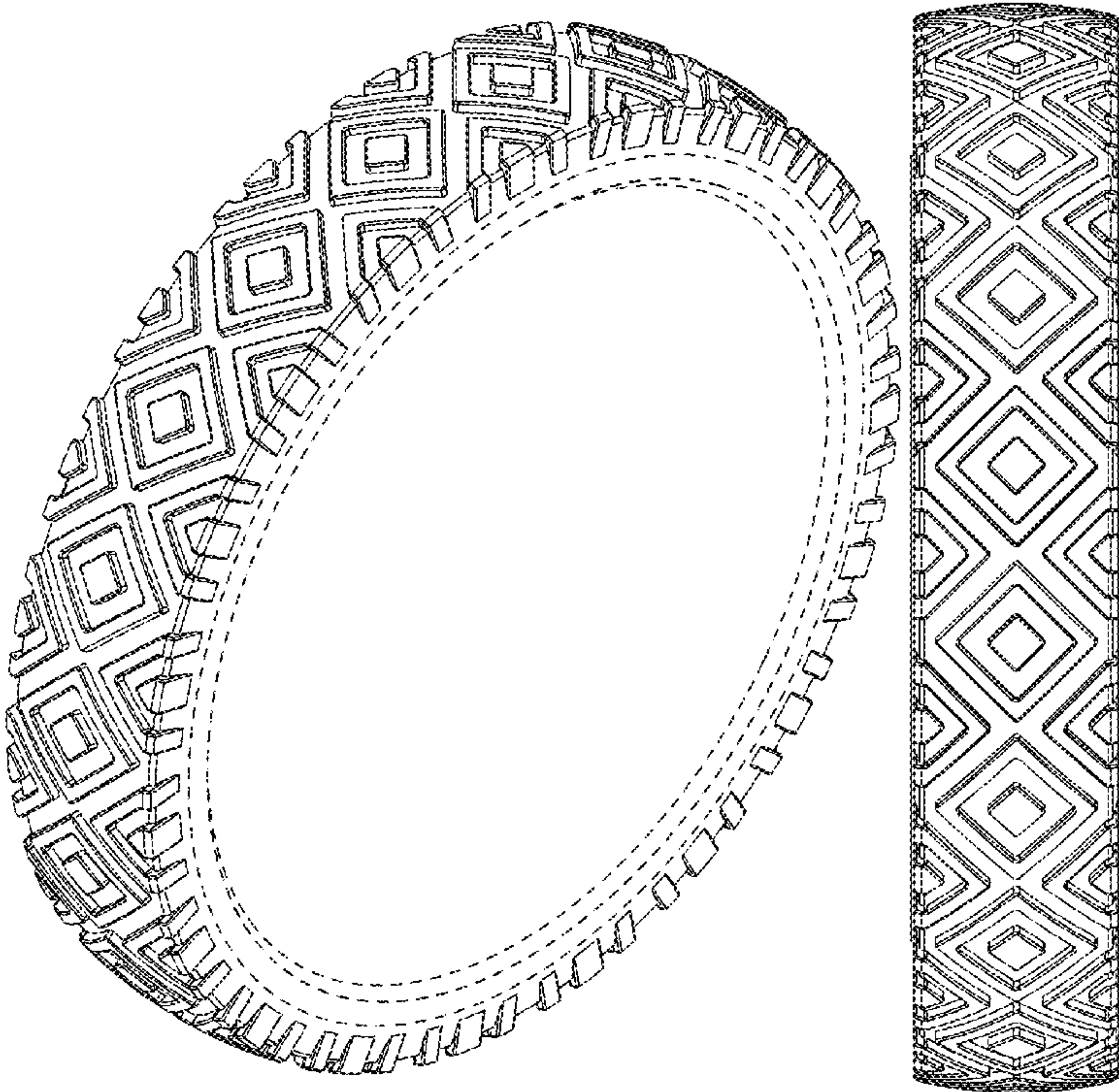

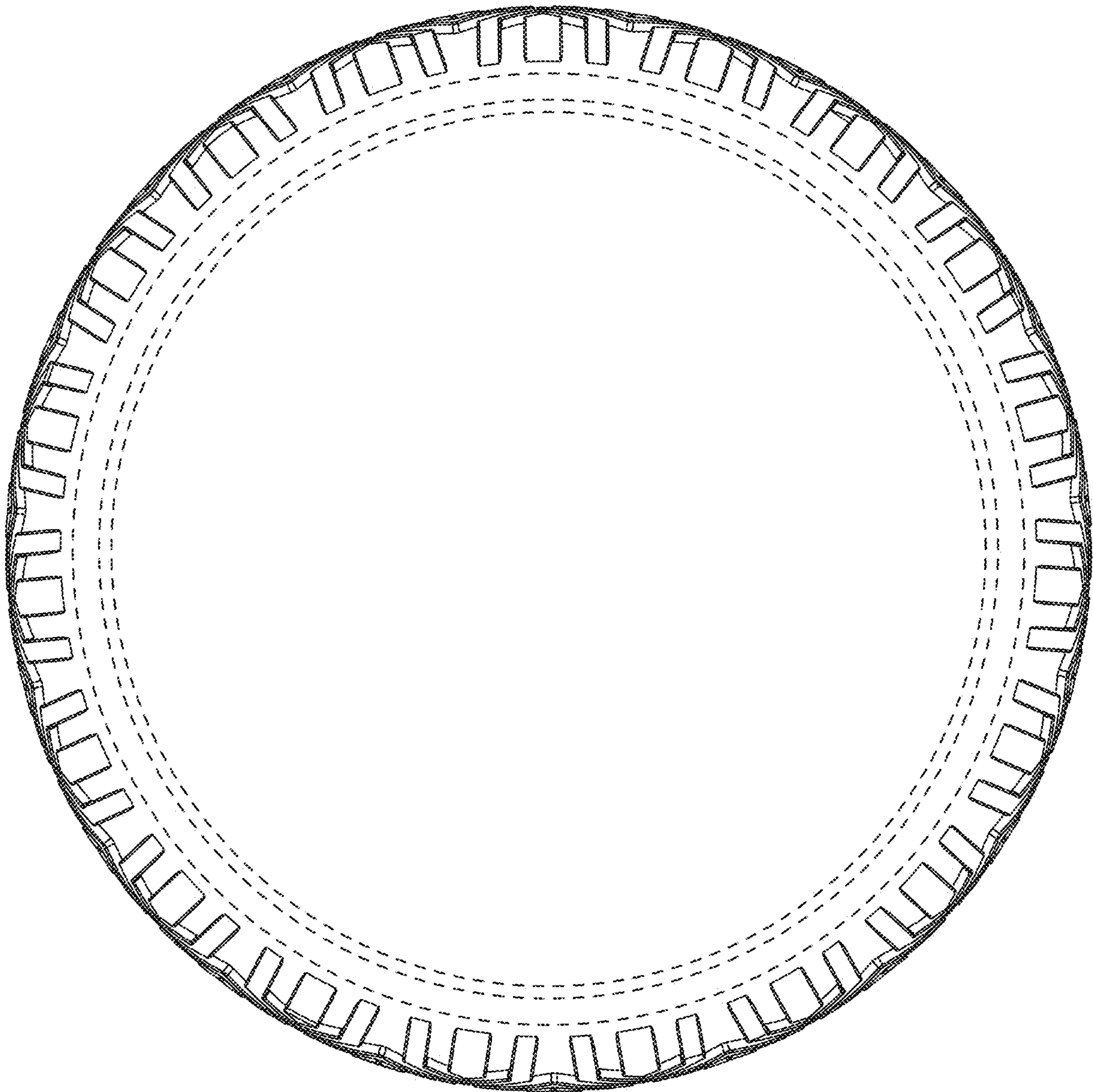

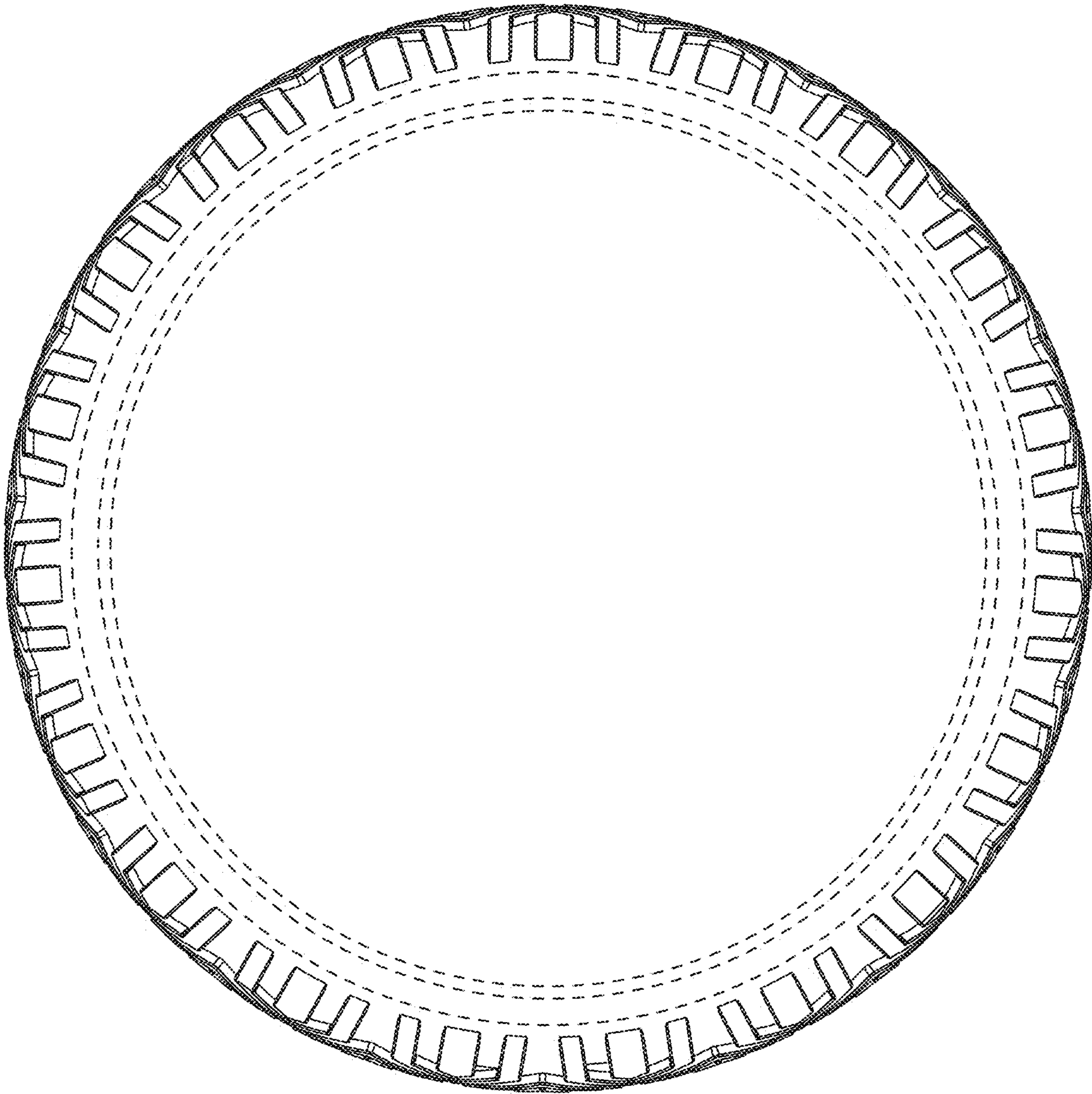

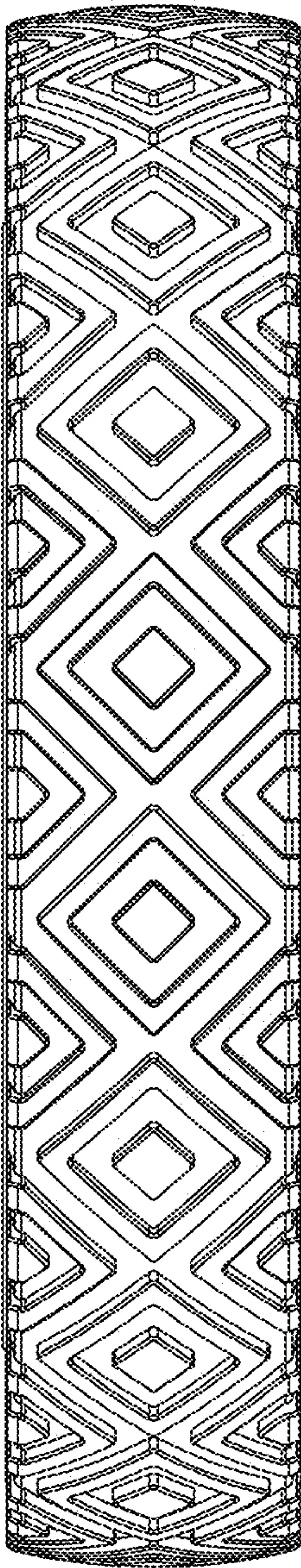

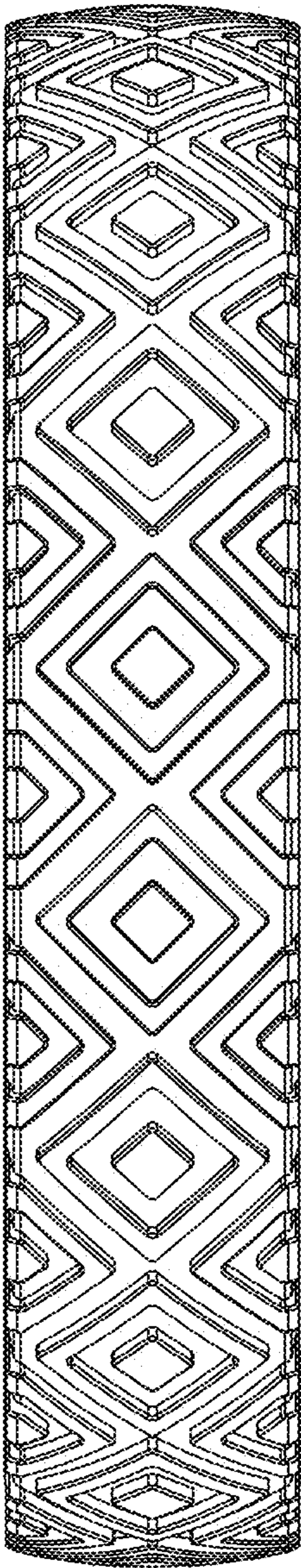

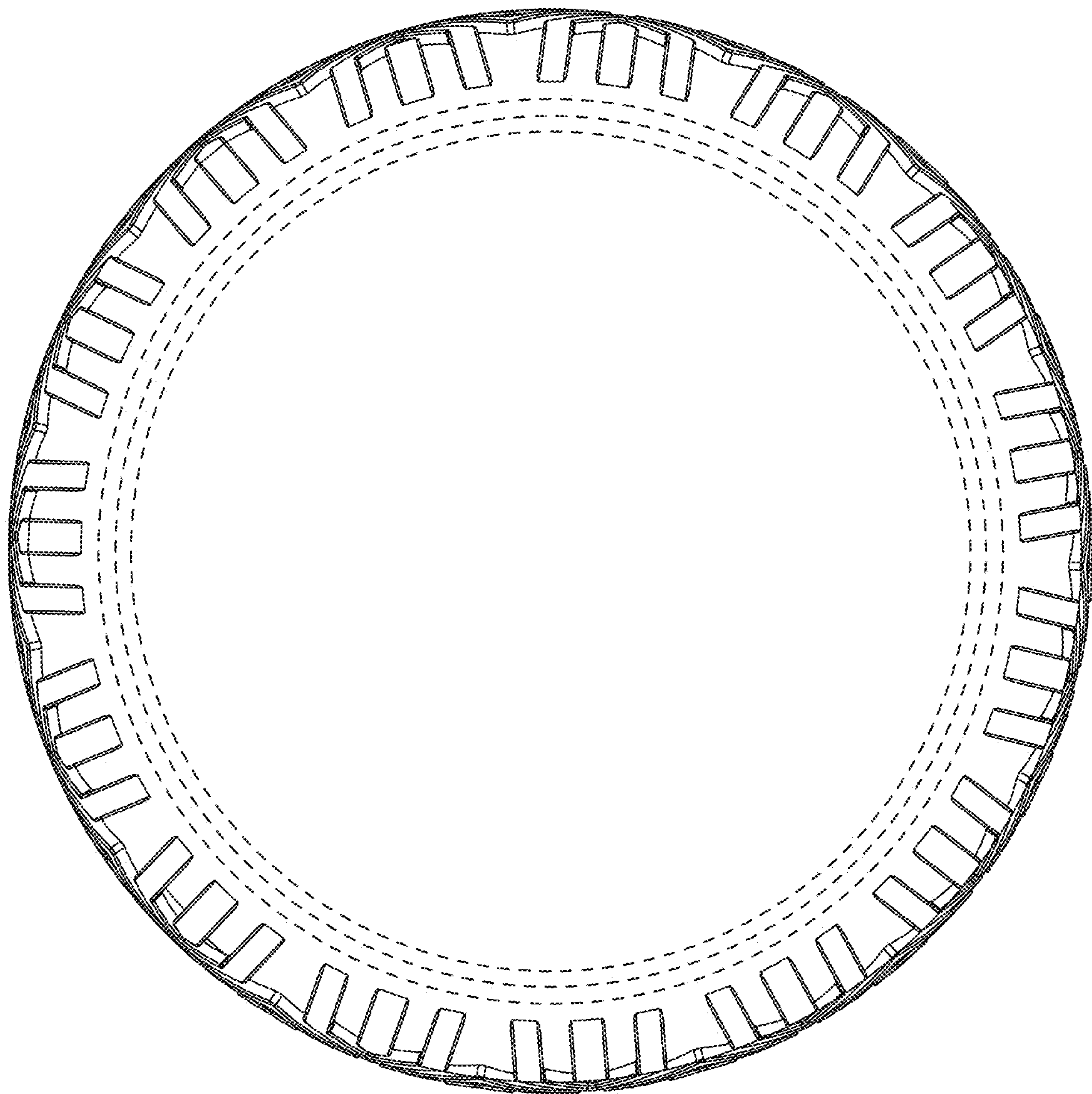

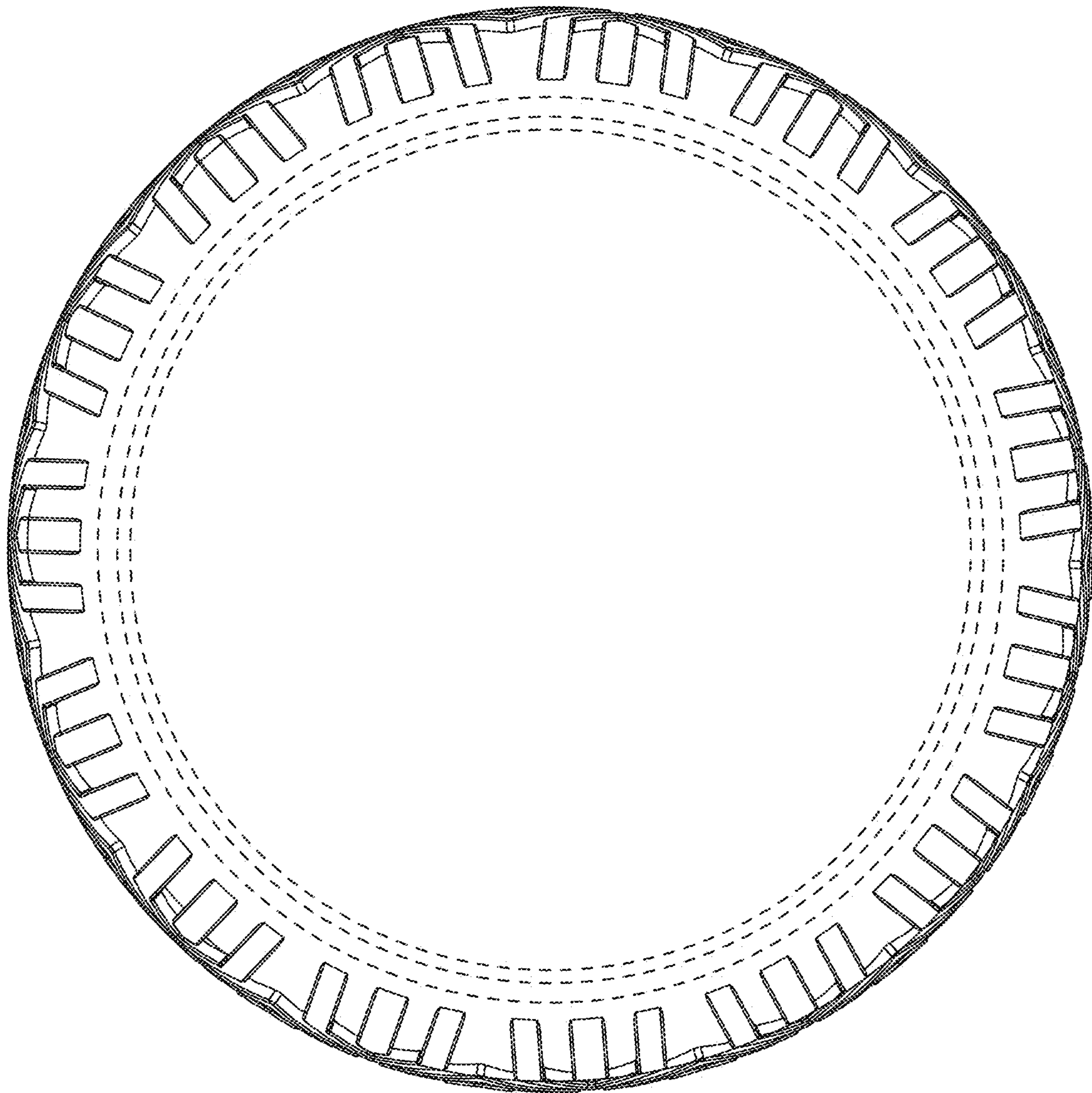

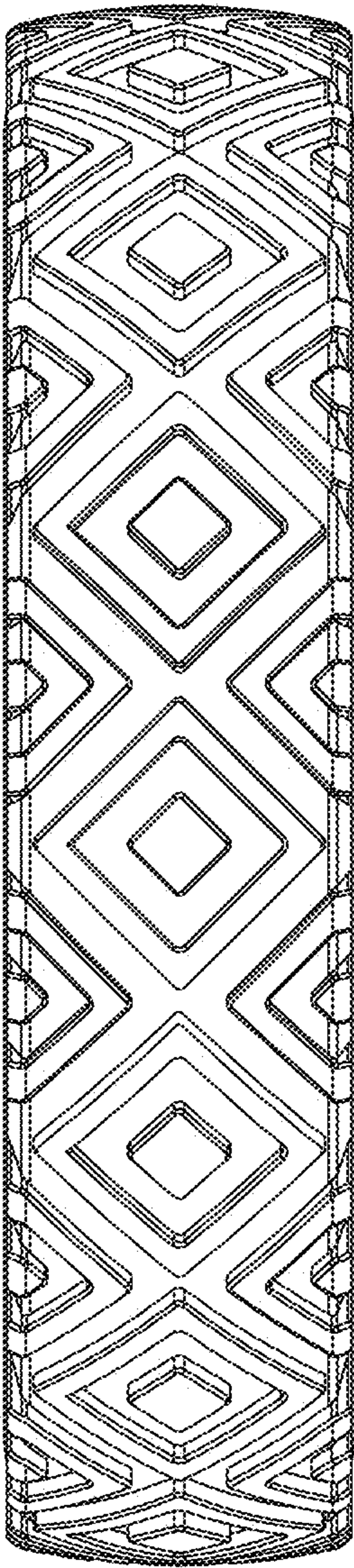

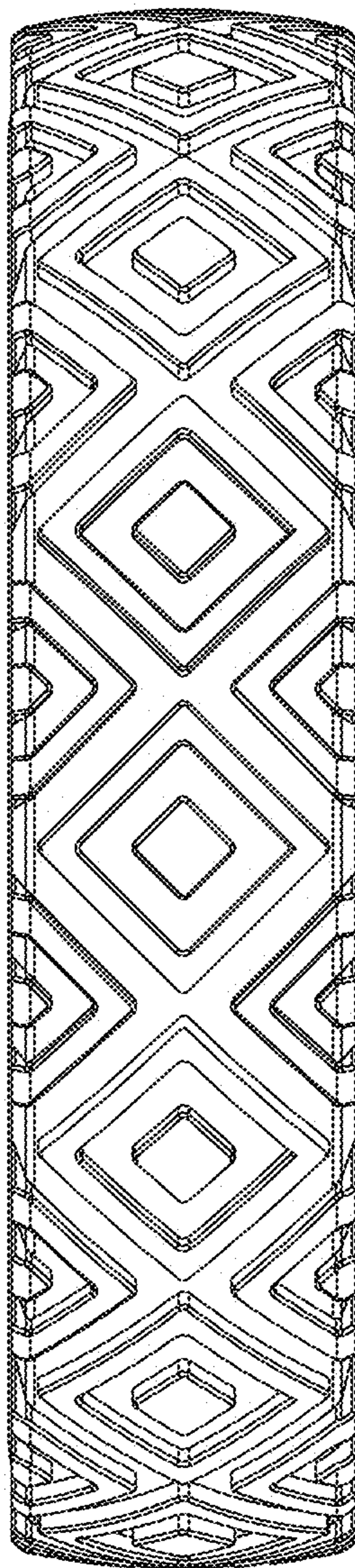
