DESCRIPTION

is a perspective view of a tyre taken from the front and a first side thereof;

is an enlarged, partial perspective view thereof taken along line 9-9 of FIG. 4; and,

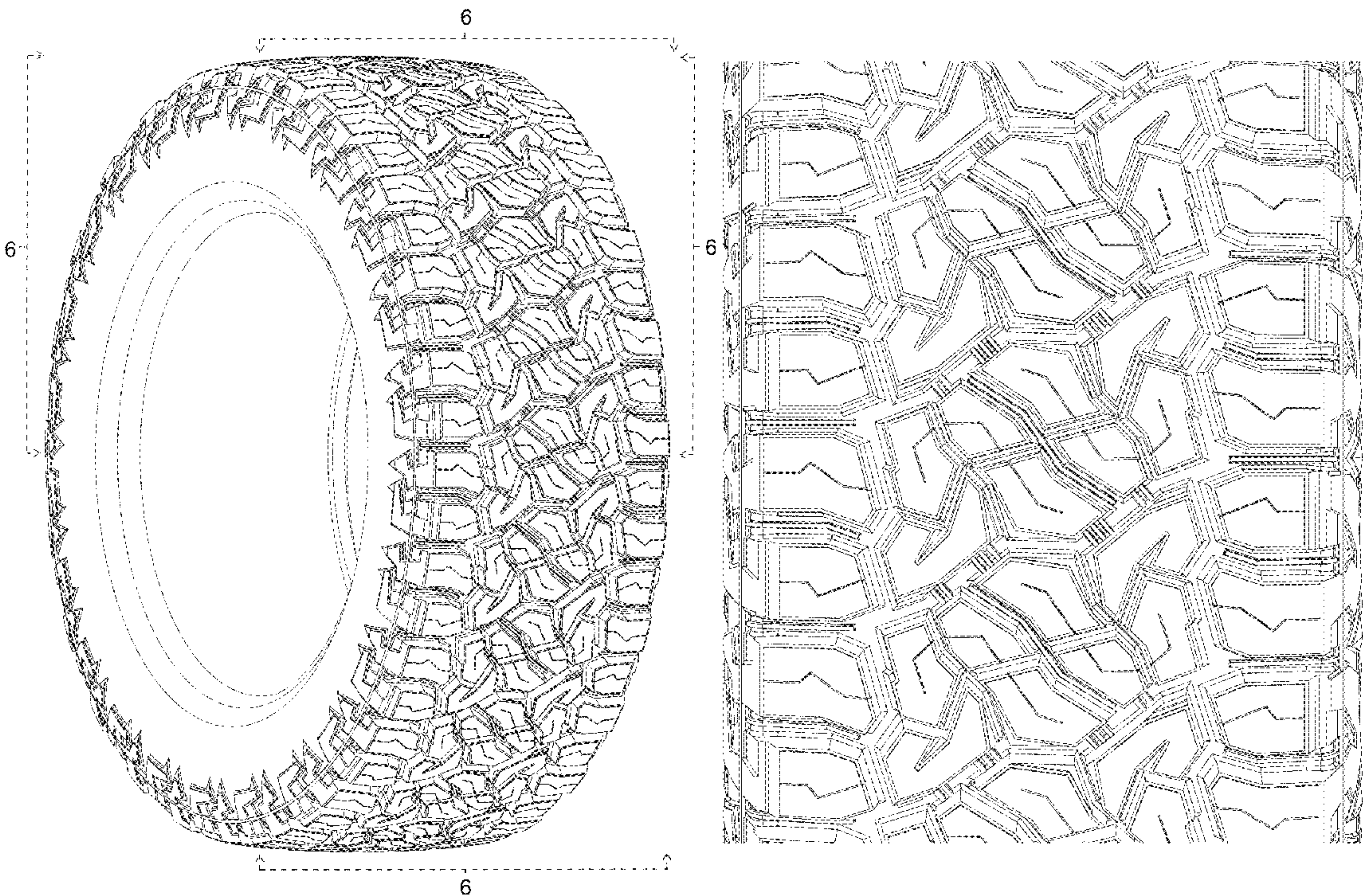
FIG. 10

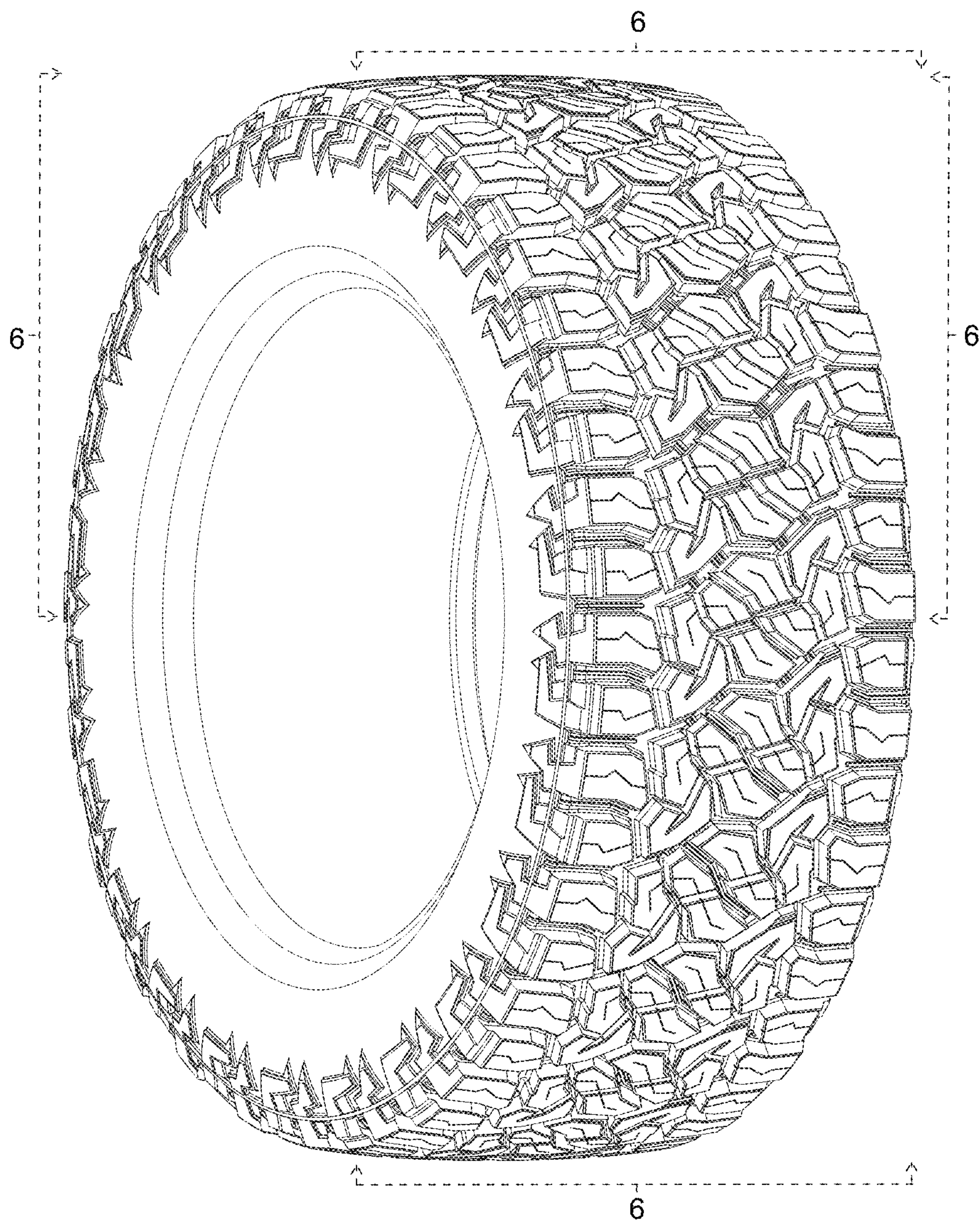

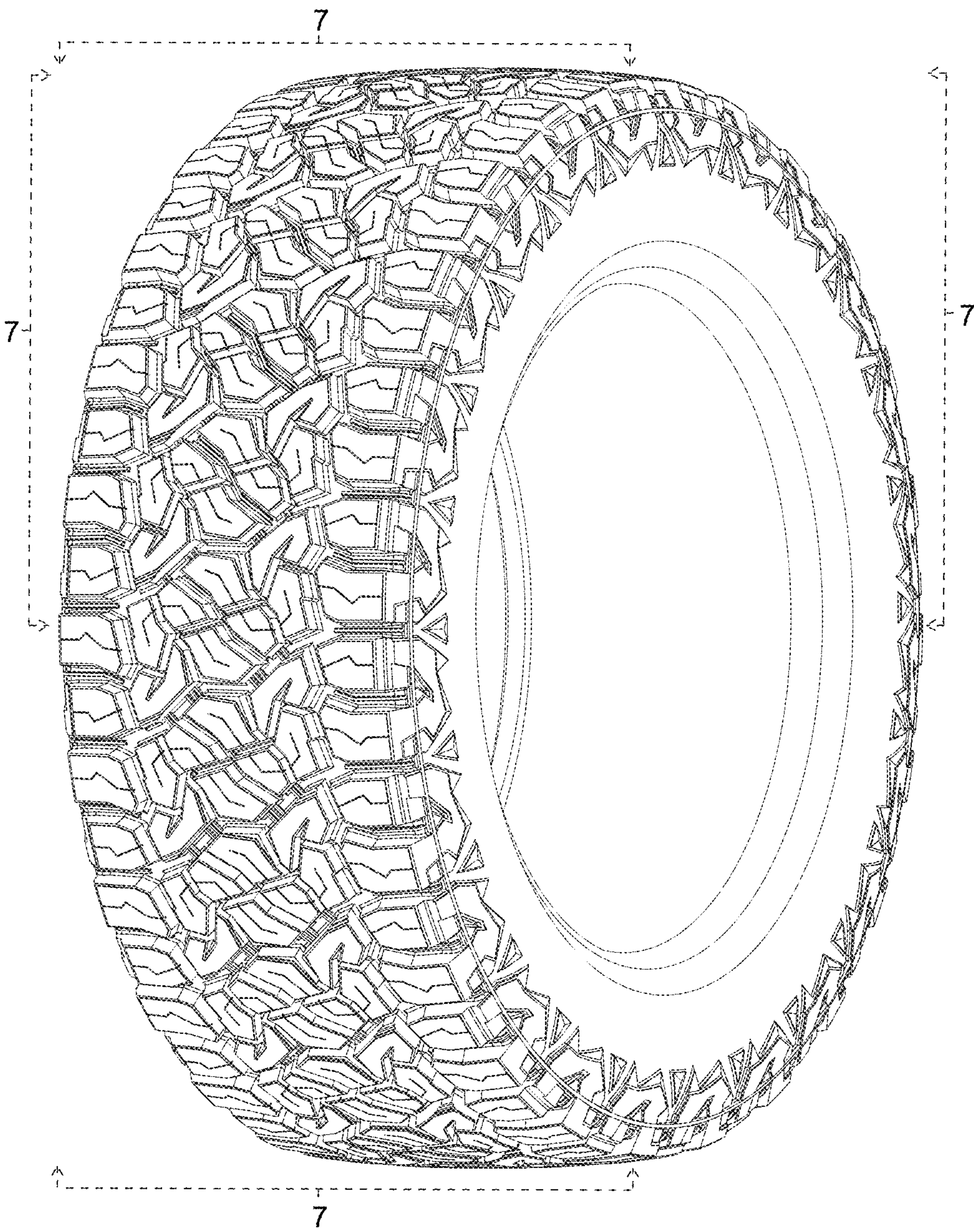

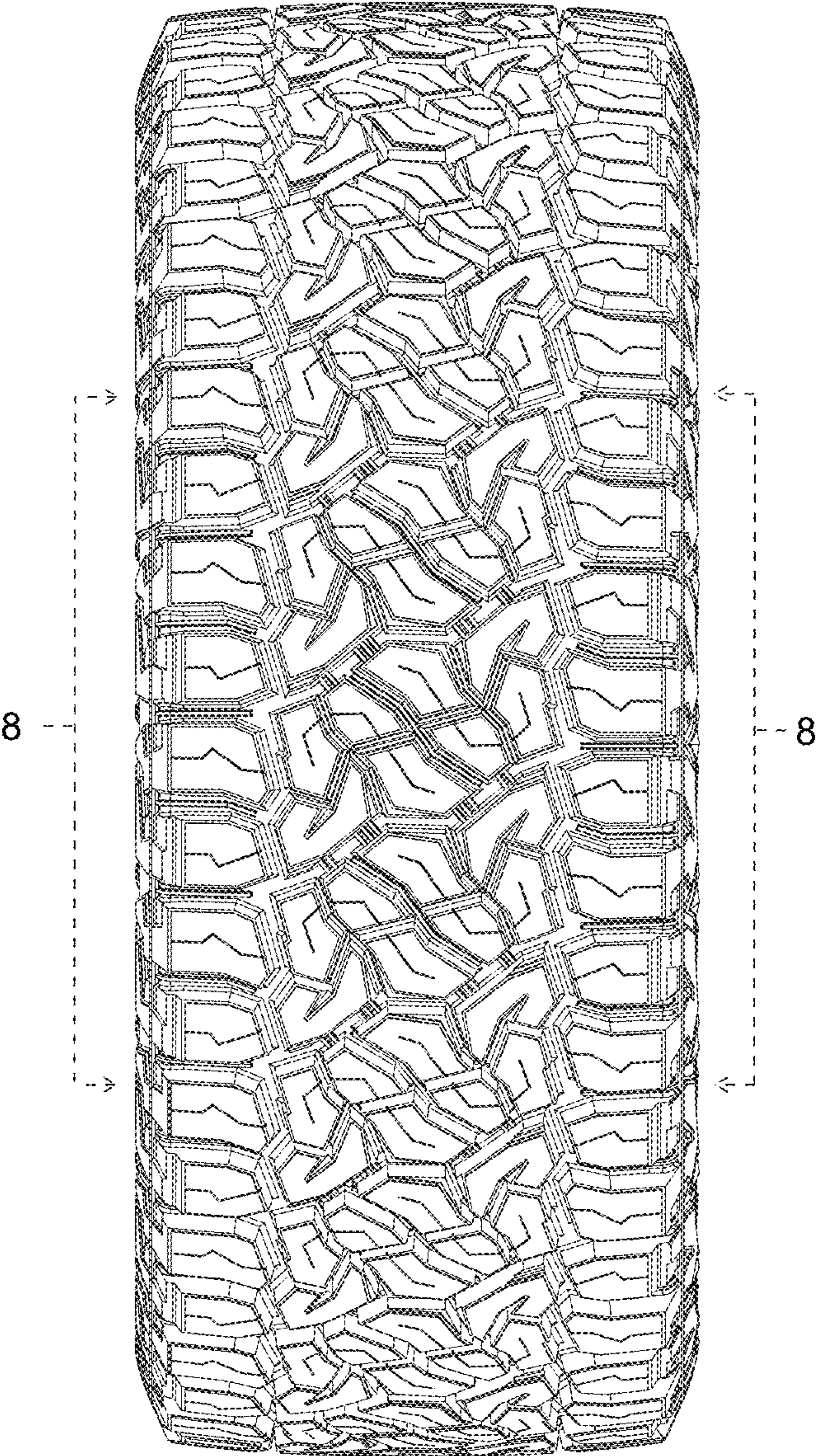

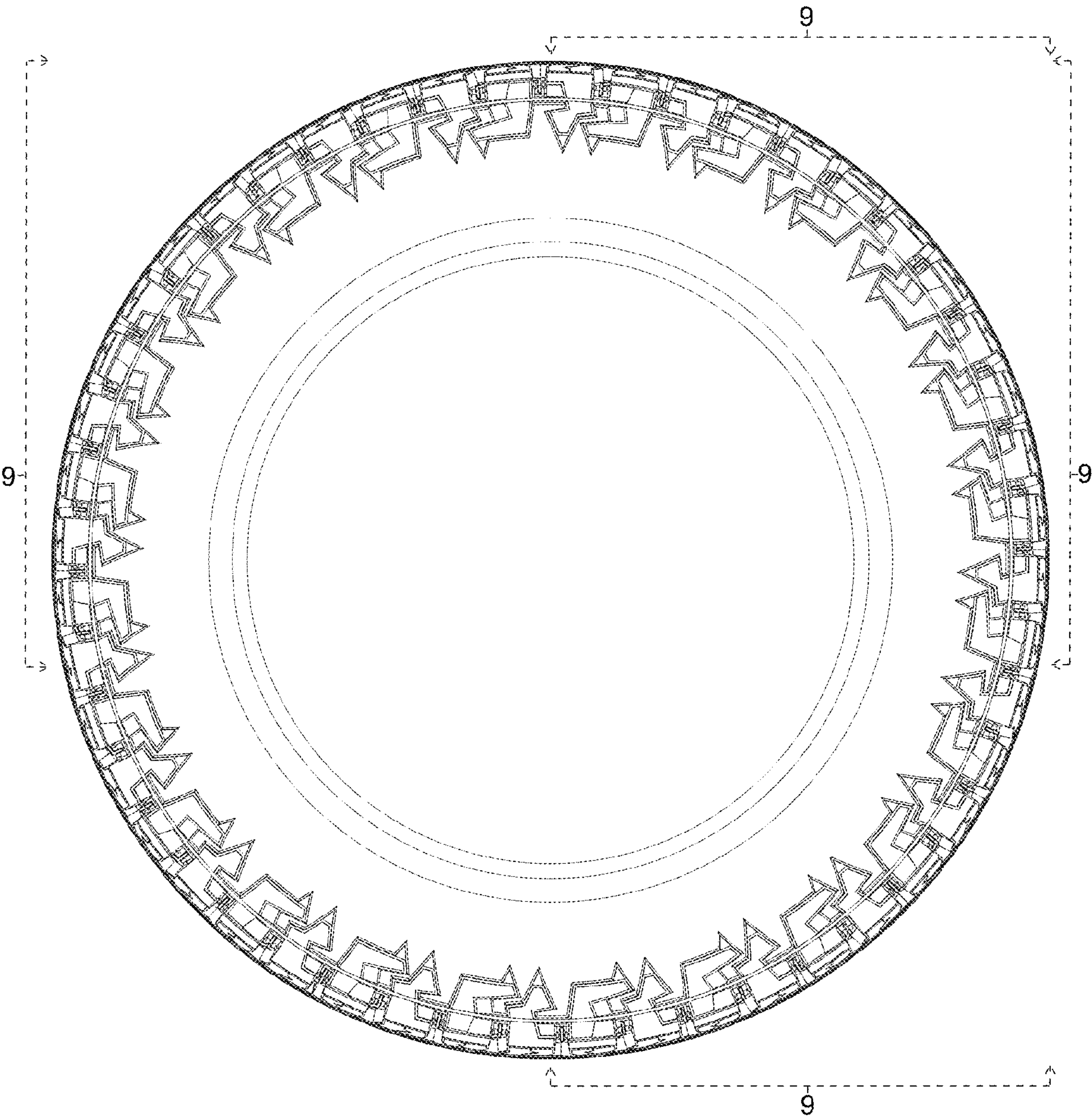

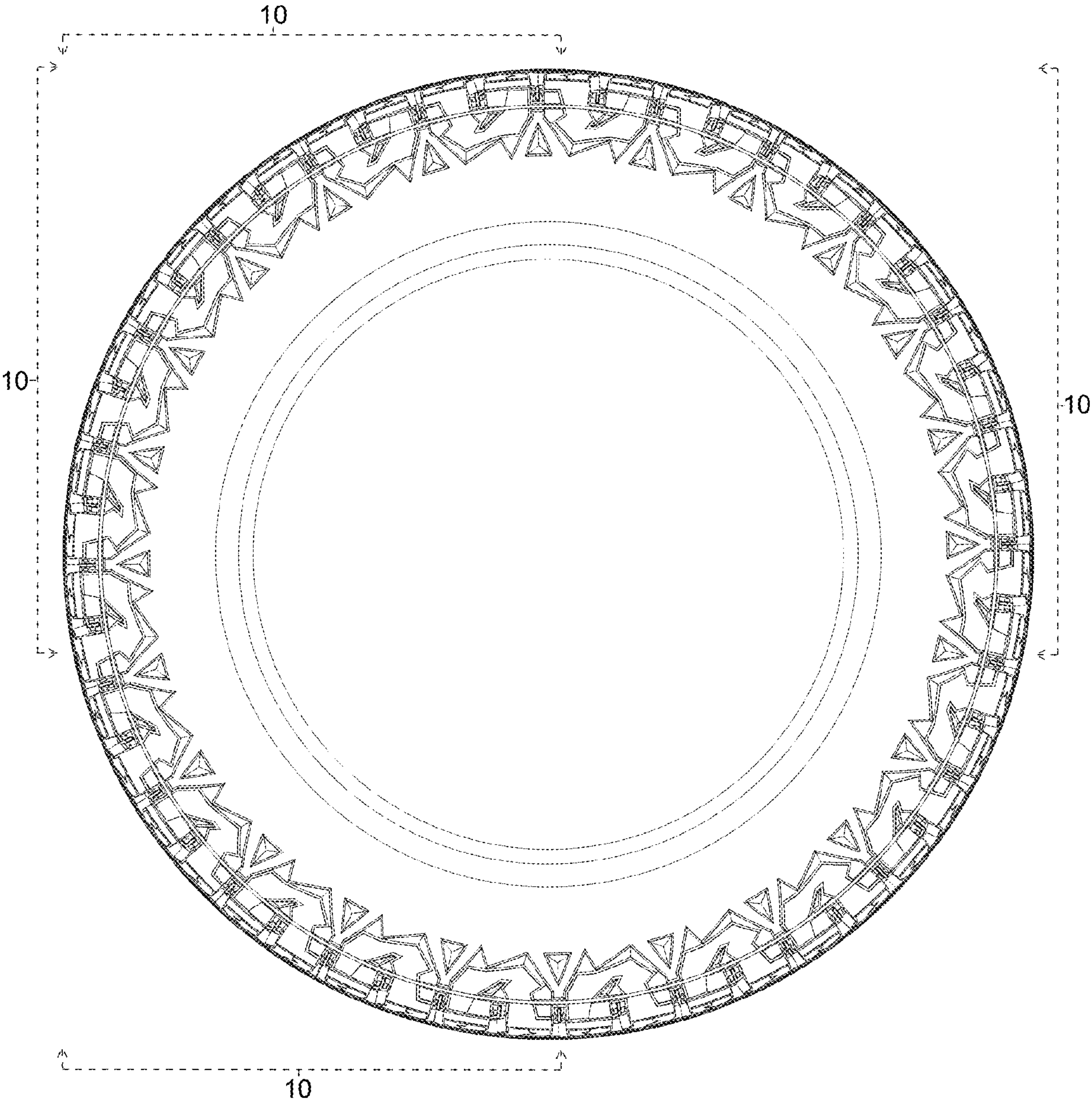

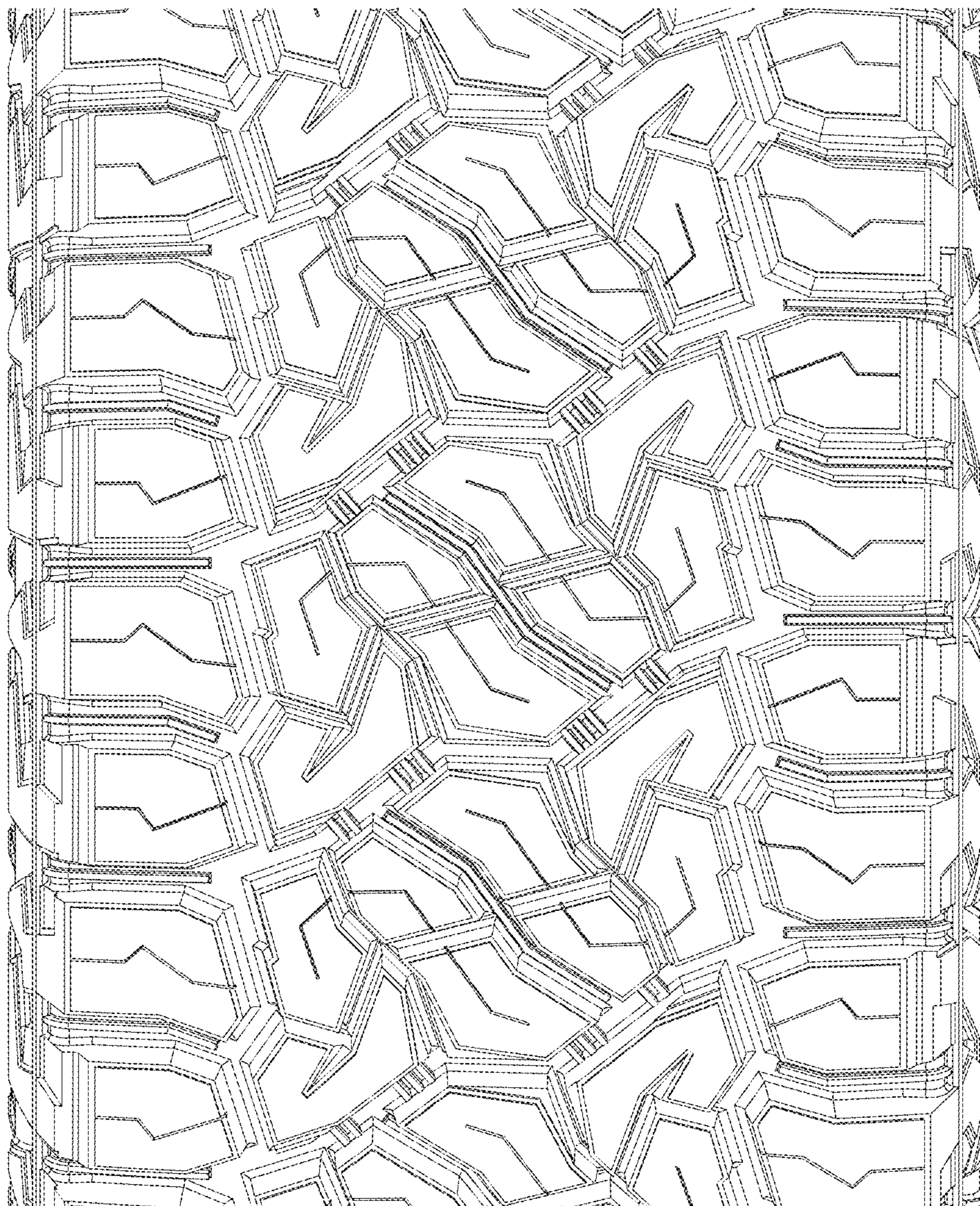

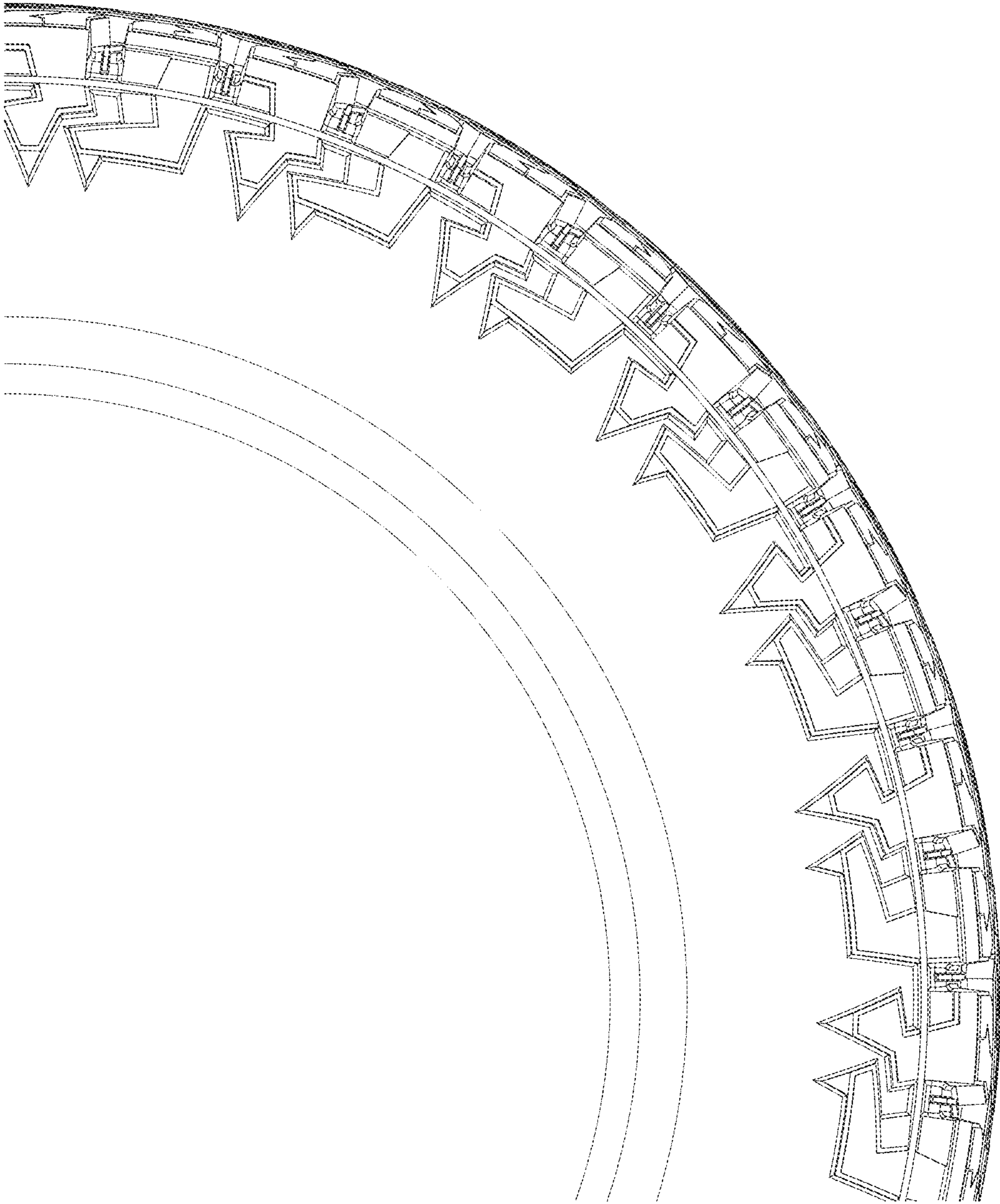

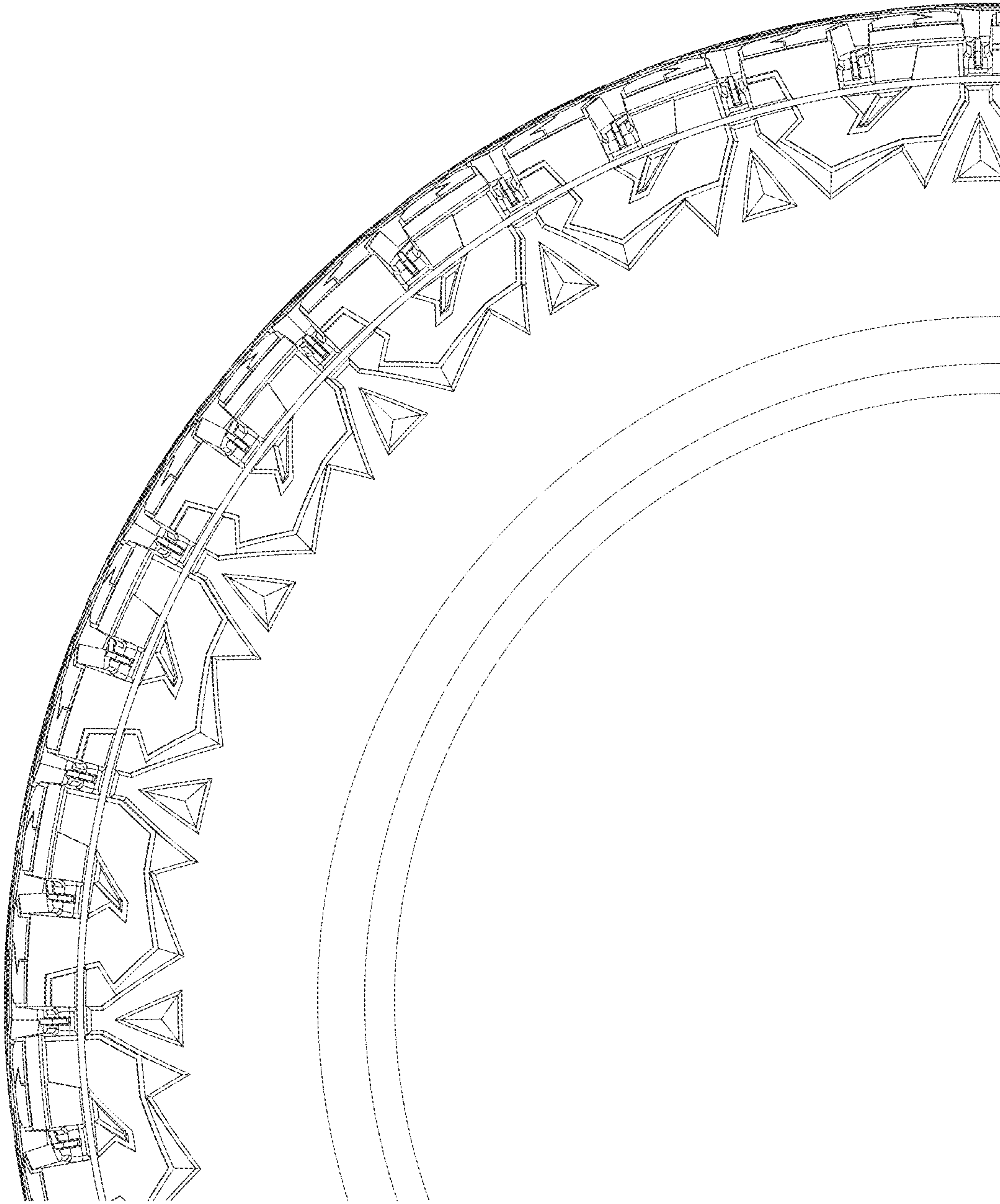
