FIG. 8 is a right-side view thereof.

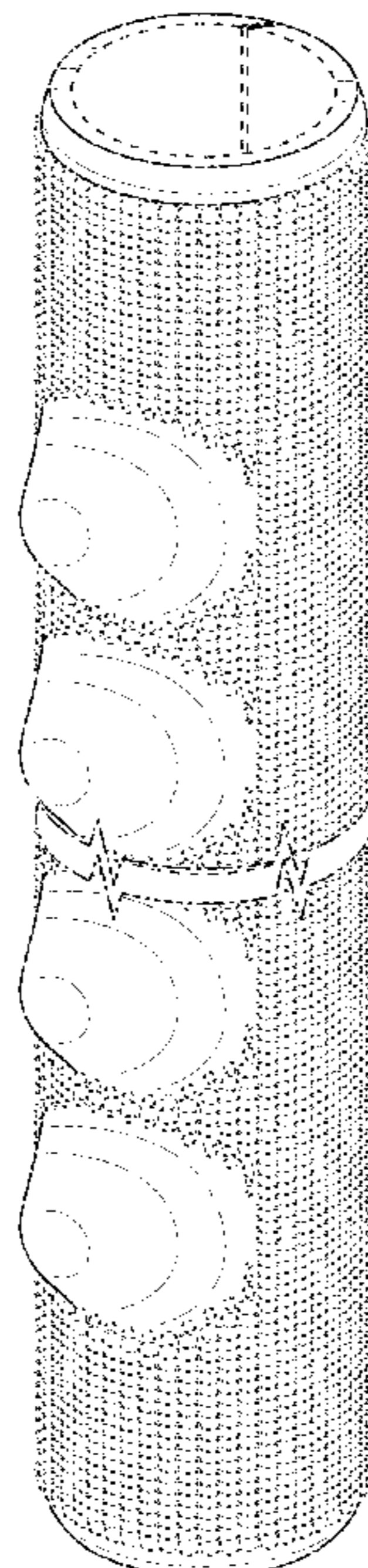

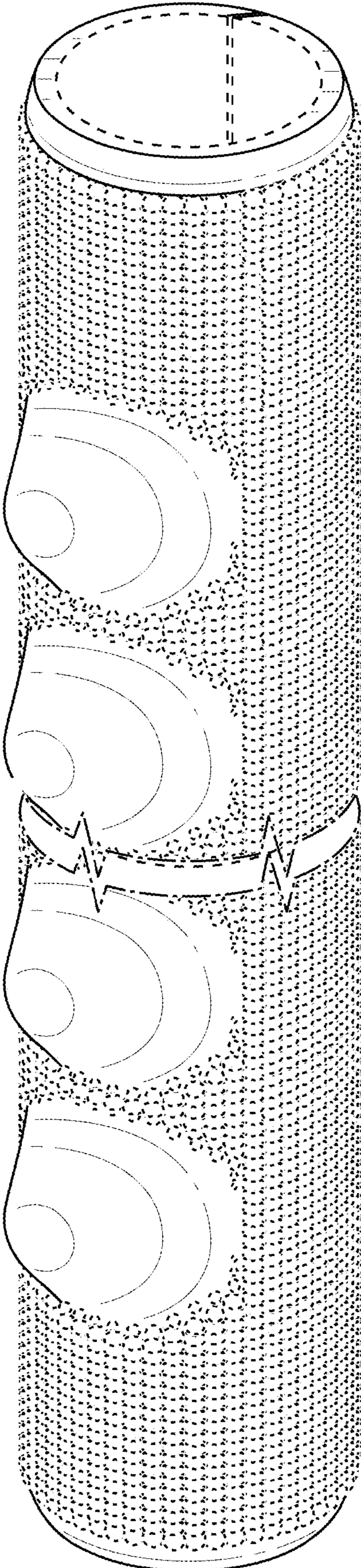

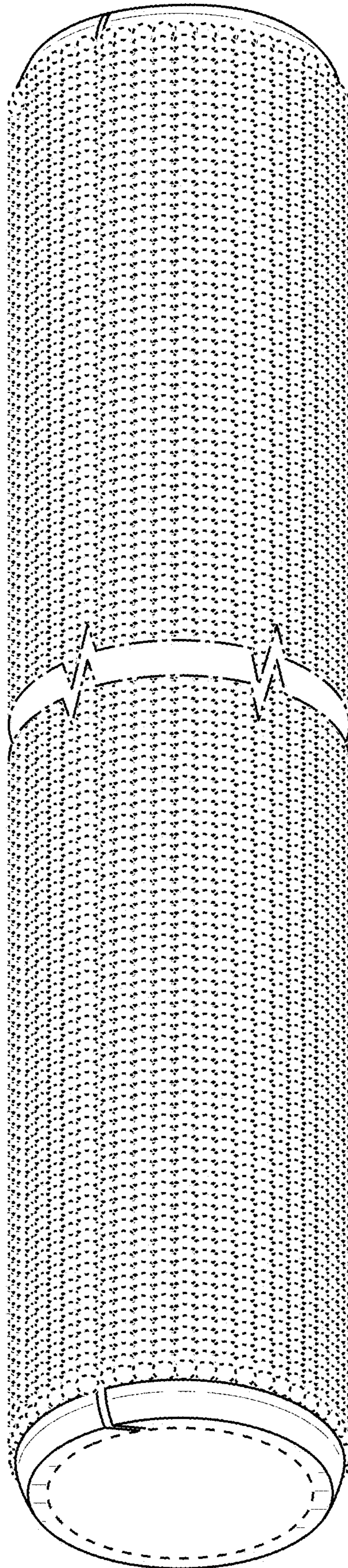

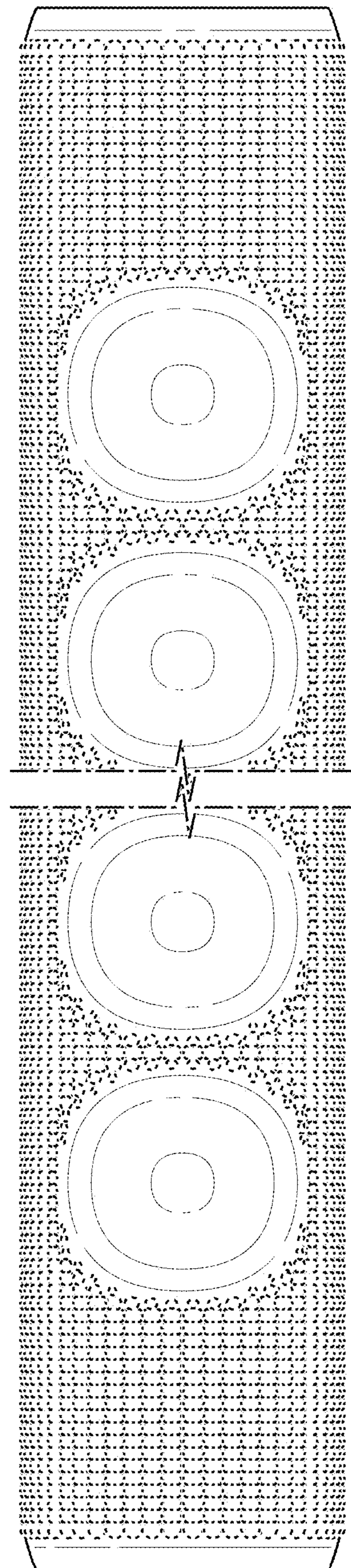

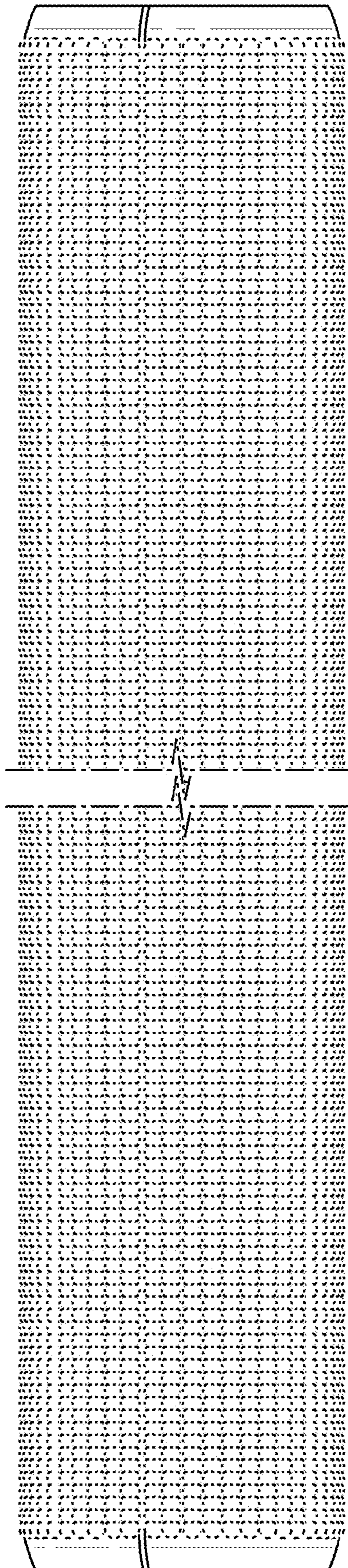

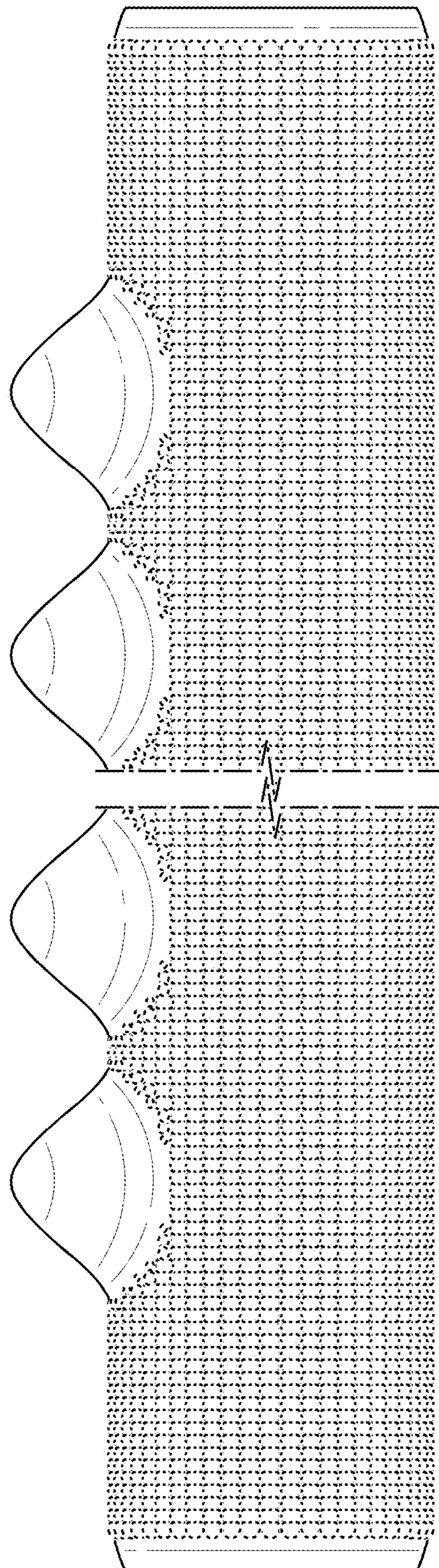

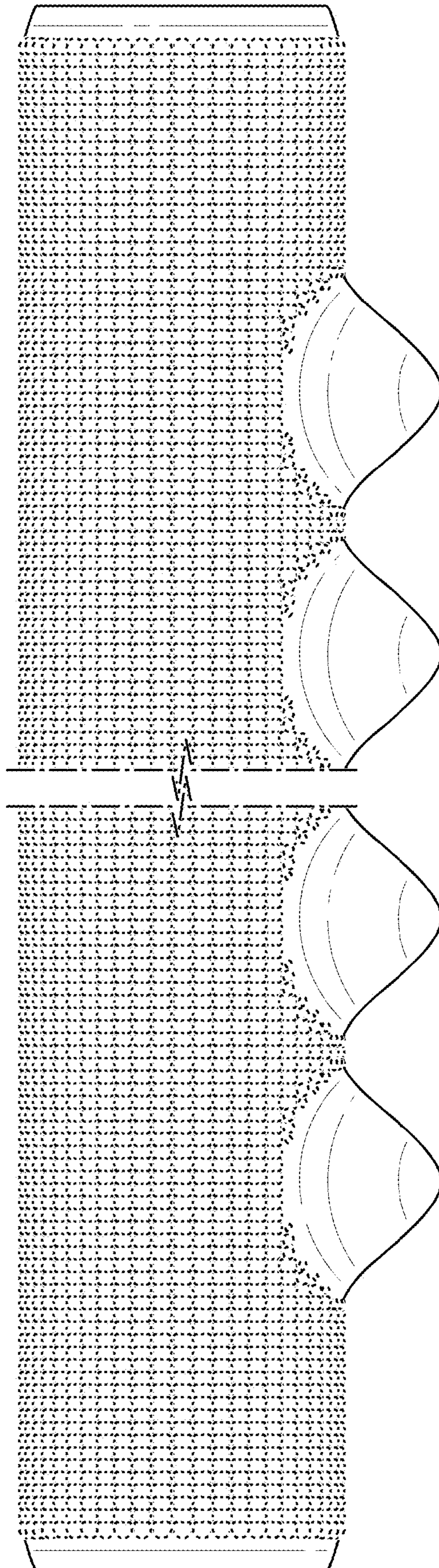

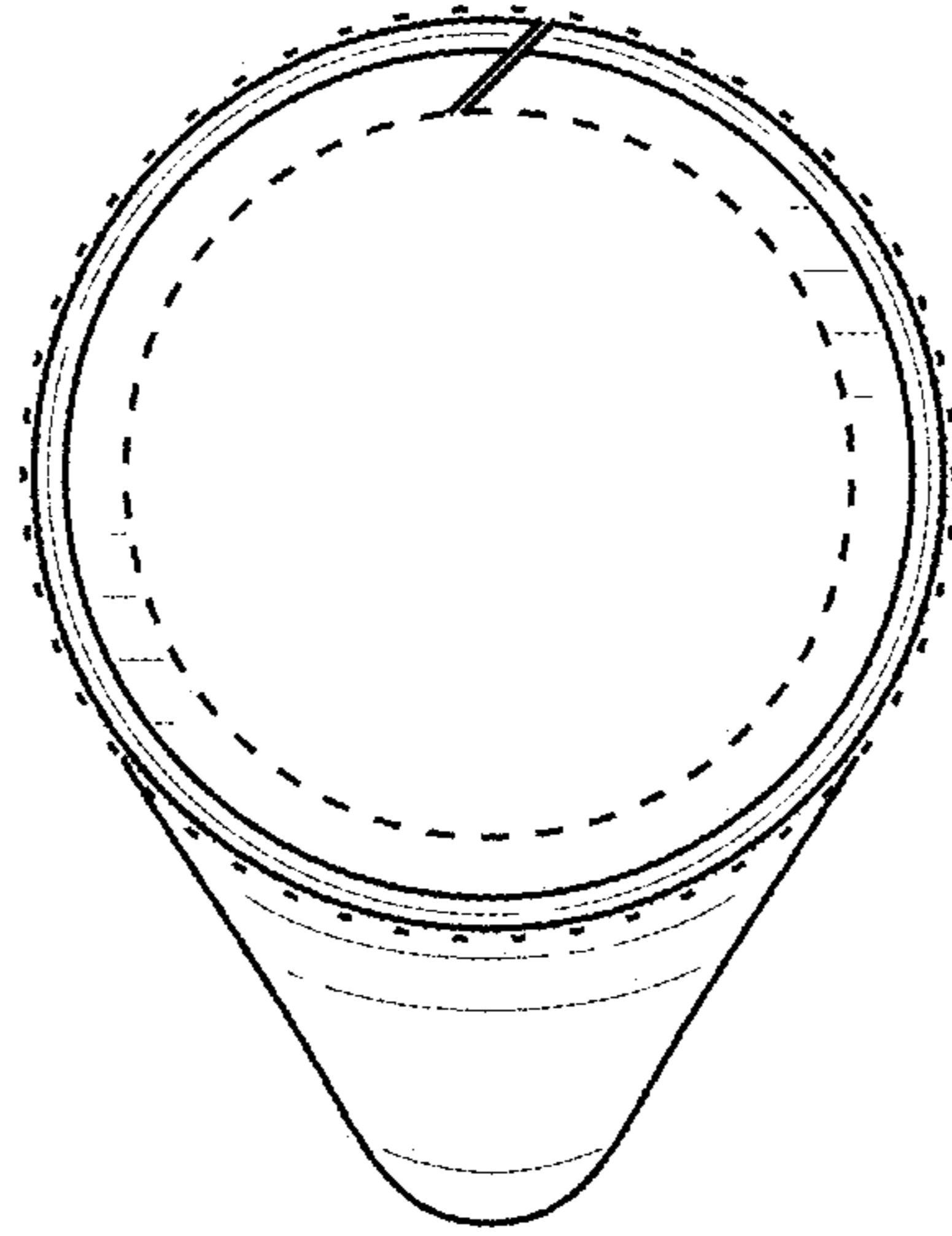

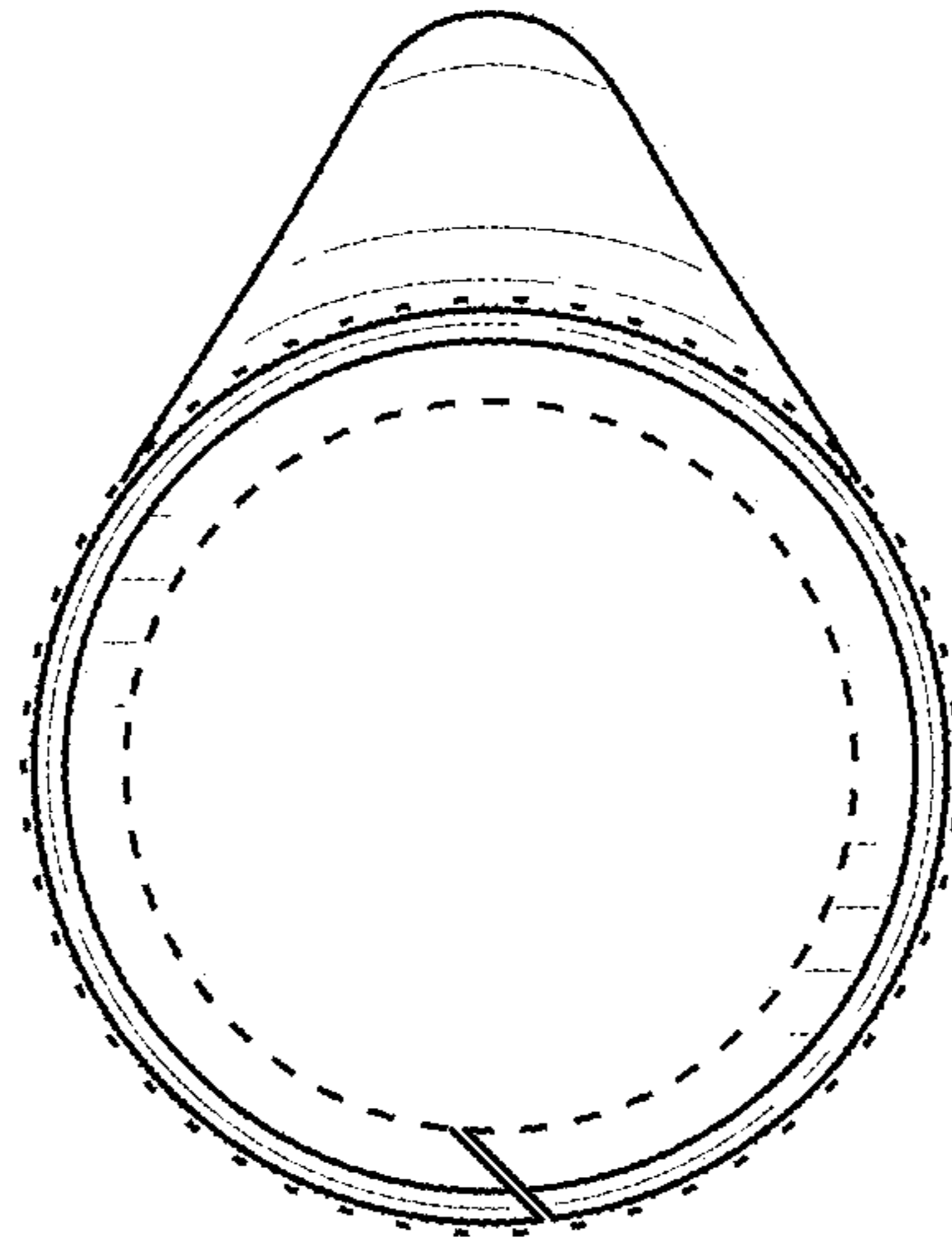
